Vietnam Peace Day January 27th

Every year on January 27th Vietnam Peace Day commemorates the signing of the Paris Peace Accords. This event ended America's involvement in the Vietnam War.

For eight long years, the United States was involved in the Vietnam War. The U.S. entered the war in 1965. However, the conflict in Vietnam started long before then. Tensions existed between communist North Vietnam and democratic South Vietnam in the mid-1950s. During this time, America's only provided funding and military training to South Vietnam.

In 1961, President John F. Kennedy expanded the military aid program. In 1963, Lyndon B. Johnson became president. Two years later, the first American combat troops entered Vietnam. By 1966, there were 400,000 U.S. troops fighting in the Vietnam War. This number increased through the years, as did the number of people protesting the United States' involvement. Due to backlash, President Johnson did not seek reelection. In November 1968, Richard M. Nixon became President. He promised to

restore law and order and end the draft.

By the time the United States pulled out of the war in 1973, over 58,000 military members had died. About 75,000 American Vietnam vets were severely disabled. People in this country still have strong feelings about the Vietnam War. Many feel our country should not have gotten involved. This is especially true since communist North Vietnam overtook South Vietnam. The communist takeover officially ended the war in 1975. Since then, North and South Vietnam has been known as the Socialist Republic of Vietnam.

How To Observe Vietnam Peace Day



January 'Wildlife Express' **Dumpster Dives Into The World Of Raccoons**

Each Wildlife Express issue features an Idaho wildlife species and articles related to science and ecological concepts.

Raccoons-the mysterious, nocturnal "trash pandas" often seen rummaging around in both wild and urban settings-are the subject of this month's Wildlife Express.

Raccoons are animals that have done well living among humans. They are often one of the only larger wild mammals living full-time in a city. The reason raccoons can live in towns and cities is because they are not picky eaters. Raccoons are omnivores; they will eat just about anything. They will eat fruits, nuts, insects, birds, eggs, small mammals, worms, snakes, fish or frogs. Anything they can get their paws on may be a potential meal.

Be sure to check out the January edition of Wildlife Express to learn more about raccoons, the roles (or niches) animals play in an environment, winter survival habits of some critters and how to identify various animal skulls in the wild.

Wildlife Express is a monthly newsletter for elementary school-age children that teaches lessons about wildlife species and subjects. Each issue features an Idaho wildlife species and articles related to science and ecological concepts. The articles are written in an educational and entertaining fashion that gets students excited to read and learn about wildlife and their environments.





Holocaust **Remembrance Day** January 27th

International Day of Commemoration in Memory of the Victims of the Holocaust

Holocaust Remembrance Day - Each year on January 27th, the world remembers one of the most horrific events in modern history. This tragic event is known as the Holocaust. The holocaust occurred during WWII when Nazi Germany killed millions of innocent victims. The day is also known as Holocaust Remembrance Day.

Nazi Germany is one of the evilest regimes that ever existed. They persecuted and killed millions of people in just under four years. One group in particular that suffered were those of the Jewish faith. It is believed that six million Jews were killed during the Holocaust. The Nazis' persecution of the Jews became a genocide.

Genocide occurs when those of a particular ethnic group is deliberately killed. However, the Nazis killed more than just Jews. Hundreds of thousands of other groups of people died under the evil regime. These included:

- 7 million Soviet civilians
- · 3 million Soviet prisoners of war
- 1.8 million Polish civilians
- 312,000 Serb civilians
- Up to 250,000 people with disabilities
- Up to 250,000 Gypsies
- Around 1,900 Jehovah Witnesses
- Possibly thousands of homosexuals

Most Jews died in concentration camps. The most notorious concentration camp is Auschwitz, where approximately one million Jews died. While some of the Jews in the concentration camps died from disease or starvation, others died in the gas chambers. Other groups of people were forced to live in ghettos where they died of sickness or starvation. Still, others were rounded up, shot, and buried in mass

Many famous books and movies have been produced about the holocaust. One of the most famous books is Anne Frank: The Diary of a Young Girl. The book is a real-life account of the two years that Anne Frank and her Dutch family hid from the Nazis. The family was discovered and deported to a concentration camp. Anne was 15 years old when she died in the camp from typhus. Other books include The Hiding Place by Corrie Ten Boom, The Boy in the Striped Pajamas by John Boyne, and Born Survivors by Wendy Holden. Movies include Schindler's List, The Reader, Denial, and The Devil's Arithmetic.

There are many other works, such as theater productions, music, and poetry. Many of the works were created by victims and survivors of the holocaust. Other works commemorate the many heroes who helped save thousands of Jews and other victims from certain death.

How To Observe Holocaust Remembrance Day

Many events are held throughout the world to commemorate this solemn day. The United Nations hosts a Holocaust memorial ceremony. The ceremony includes testimonies by Holocaust survivors, special music, and memorial prayers. There are also photographic exhibits, panel discussions, film screenings. and book signings. Sadly, there are some that try to deny the holocaust ever happened. This is one more reason to take part in this day. If the holocaust is forgotten or denied, it will be easier for history to repeat itself. Share this day on social media with #HolocaustRemembranceDay or #NeverForget.

Holocaust Remembrance Day History

On January 24, 2005, the United Nations General Assembly marked the 60th anniversary of the liberation of the Nazi concentration camps. Later that year on November 1, the UN General Assembly designated January 27th as the International Day of Commemoration in Memory of the Victims of the Holocaust. It is also referred to as Holocaust Remembrance Day. It was on January 27th in 1945 that Soviet troops liberated the Auschwitz-Birkenau concentration camp.



DEAR DR. ROACH: Recently, I was rejected from donating plasma (not blood) because my iron that day was 57 mcmol/L, and the maximum allowable was 54 mcmol/L. I was rescheduled to get retested in a few days. The technician said to eat beans and similar foods to lower my iron levels.

I checked my own records and didn't find any results that fell below the cutoff. My red blood cell count was 5.15; my white blood cell count was 6.0; my hemoglobin level was 16.1 g/dL; and my hematocrit level was 48.5%, all within the healthy range.

Which test results could they be referring to, and how do I lower my iron? -- S.L.

ANSWER: Blood banks typically screen donors for anemia, which is frequently caused by iron deficiency, but I'm confused as to why they are screening you with iron tests because that is typically not done. Moreover, they are telling you that your iron is too high, which is the opposite of the iron-deficiency anemia that is usually looked for.

I recommend that you see your own physician and get retested. If we take the blood bank at their word, and your iron level is too high, that raises the possibility of hereditary hemochromatosis (HH), which is caused by a defect of iron absorption. With this condition, your body absorbs as much iron as possible, even if it doesn't need any. This causes iron overload, which damages the heart, liver, bone marrow, adrenal glands, skin and joints, just to name a few.

HH is easy to treat once the diagnosis is made. However, making the diagnosis requires thinking about the possibility, and it's uncommon enough that a lot of healthcare professionals don't think about it right away. Your doctor should test your iron and iron-binding capacity, as well as your ferritin level, which tends to correlate with the total amount of body iron stores.

But I don't want to jump to conclusions, which is why your own doctor should test you to see if you really do have excess iron.

DEAR DR. ROACH: Like a lot of older men (I'm 74), I get up often at night to dribble a little urine. I have found that if I go downstairs, walk to the kitchen, then climb back upstairs, I can often urinate again as much as I did the first time. Can you explain?

Also, I've noticed that on nights that I have popcorn with salt, I get up less often. Could a person take a salt tablet before bedtime to reproduce this effect? -- S.C.


ANSWER: Both men and women can have voiding problems due to bladder issues, but men can also have symptoms due to an enlarged prostate. I can't tell which of these you might have because, for both, there are underlying reasons as to why you might be able to urinate again a few minutes after going the first time. But it's more common in men with prostate trouble.

Exercise isn't usually needed; just giving yourself a few minutes can often be enough to cause you to void again. I recommend voiding twice before bed if getting up at night is a problem. You may find that changing positions while urinating can be helpful to fully empty your bladder.

As far as salt goes, it makes your body hold on to water. While you could take a salt tablet, you might get thirsty at night. In addition, excess salt increases most people's risk for heart attack and stroke, so I don't recommend it.

Seed Swap FAQ

Q. How do I harvest seeds for a seed swap?

A. Collect fully ripe seeds of an individual plant lay them out to dry on a plate and expose them to the air for several days. The length of time will vary depending on the seed, but 2-3 days should be sufficient for most seeds. Place them in a labeled jar or envelope so you can easily identify the seeds. When you're ready to swap, place seeds in individually labeled envelopes.

Q. Should I provide planting and growing information with the seeds?

A. Information such as when to plant, types of soil that worked best for you, sun vs. shade plant, and germination info are helpful to others. If you can provide these details, please do. However, not every gardener keeps track of this information.

O. Are seed swaps a good way to start gardening? A. Yes. While most people swap seeds to add variety to their gardens, gardeners also enjoy spreading their love of flowers and vegetables to new gardeners.





National Bubble Wrap Day Last Monday in January

National Bubble Wrap Day (also known as National Bubble Wrap Appreciation Day) on the last Monday in January recognizes a fascinating piece of invention. Today, bubble wrap's primary purpose is to protect fragile items either in shipping or storage. Of course, people also take enjoyment from popping the bubbles in bubble wrap, too.

However, when two engineers created bubble wrap, the use as packaging didn't pop into their minds right away. Marc Chavannes and Alfred Fielding first sealed two shower curtains together in 1956 in the town of Hawthorne, New Jersey. This technique created a smattering of air bubbles. The two engineers initially thought their creation would make a great wallpaper! However, sales for the wallpaper never materialized. So, Chavannes and Fielding moved to sell the product as greenhouse insulation.

The product was originally named Air Cap and produced by the Sealed Air Corporation which was founded in 1960. In 1961, the product evolved into the Bubble Wrap we know today when it protected IBM's 1401 computer when it started shipping.

Sealed Air Corporation trademarked Bubble Wrap and has been filling shipping needs ever since.



1/2 medium onion, chopped

4 medium sweet potatoes, peeled and cut into 1/2inch cubes

medium red or green bell pepper, chopped 1/2

2/3 cup fat-free, low-sodium vegetable broth

2 teaspoons minced garlic

2 teaspoons smoked paprika

1 teaspoon ground cumin

teaspoon dried thyme, crumbled 1/2

1/2teaspoon coarsely ground pepper

1/8 teaspoon salt

4 large eggs

hot pepper sauce (optional)

In pressure cooker set on saute, heat oil. Cook onion 3 minutes, or until soft, stirring frequently. Turn off pressure cooker.

Stir in potatoes, bell pepper, broth, garlic, paprika, cumin, thyme, pepper and salt. Secure lid. Cook on high pressure 3 minutes. Quickly release pressure. Turn off pressure cooker.



Yield: 12 cups

Total Time: 60 minutes

- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1 medium onion, chopped
- 3 celery ribs, chopped
- 3 medium carrots, chopped
- 1 butternut squash (2 to 3 pounds), peeled and cut into 1-inch cubes (about 6 cups)
- 2 teaspoons dried parsley flakes
- 2 garlic cloves, minced (or 1 teaspoon dried minced garlic)
- 1 teaspoon rubbed sage or poultry seasoning
- 1 teaspoon curry powder
- 1/2 teaspoon kosher salt
- 1 cup pearl barley
- 4 cups (32 ounces) chicken or vegetable broth
- 4 cups water
- 2 cups (one pound) cooked chicken, turkey or sausage

Kosher salt and fresh-cracked pepper, to tastels

Stovetop Instructions:

In a large soup pot, over medium-low heat, cook chopped onion in olive oil for one minute. Add celery, carrots and squash, and saute for about 10 minutes, stirring frequently. Add the seasonings and barley, and give it a good stir to combine.

Pour in the broth and water, bring to a boil, then simmer gently for 40 minutes. Add your cooked protein of choice and heat through; add salt and pepper to taste.

Allow natural pressure release for 10 minutes, then quick release any remaining pressure. Stir in cooked chicken, turkey or sausage and heat through. Season the soup with salt and pepper to taste and serve.

Estrace Cream Is Safe to Use in Woman Who Had Melanoma

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am a 70-year-old woman who has been using Estrace vaginal cream weekly for several years. I am in excellent health, work out daily, run half-marathons and have my own business. I take 10 mg of atorvastatin daily. Ten years ago, I had melanoma removed from my arm.

My concern is the use of Estrace. My gynecologist recommended that I use it after a Pap smear, but my primary care physician is not of the same mind. I would appreciate your opinion on this. My mother had breast cancer in her 80s, my sister had uterine cancer, and my brother passed away from bladder cancer. -- C.S.

ANSWER: As far as the safety of using estradiol (Estrace), the bioidentical hormone to major natural estrogen, I am definitely of the same opinion as your gynecologist. When used topically, it works on the vulva and the lining of the vagina, keeping the tissue healthy.

Without estrogen, the tissues that line the female perineum can become atrophic (thinned), predisposing a woman to discomfort, infections and incontinence. The Pap smear may have resulted in a finding that was suggestive of vaginal atrophy (increased neutrophils). Without treatment, the labia can even fuse together.

With long-term use, the estrogen levels in the body are only slightly higher in women who use topical

estrogen compared to those who do not, so the absorption into the body is minimal. The only case where I get concerned is with someone who has a personal history of an estrogen-sensitive tumor, such as endometrial cancer and some breast cancers. In those cases, I discuss options with both the patient and their oncologist.

DEAR DR. ROACH: Are you aware of any correlation between celiac disease and restless legs syndrome (RLS)? My 72-year-old husband has had RLS for decades. He currently takes gabapentin and pramipexole, but still has symptoms. Plus, he has periodic limb movement disorder (PLMD), which occurs while he's asleep. He isn't aware of it, but it can keep me awake; we sleep in separate beds when it gets bad. -- C.S.

ANSWER: The terminology can be confusing. Most people with RLS have periodic limb movements of sleep (PLMS), which sound very similar to your husband's symptom. PLMD is a separate sleep issue that doesn't include other RLS features, such as an uncomfortable sensation in the legs while they're at rest that causes an urge to move them. A person with RLS often has PLMS, but doesn't have PLMD.

There is an increased risk of RLS among people with celiac disease. Most authorities tie these two together through iron deficiency. Unless celiac disease is managed with meticulous attention to diet, the body has difficulty absorbing iron.

Iron deficiency is very frequently found in people with RLS, and iron deficiency makes RLS worse. The diagnosis of iron deficiency needs to be made carefully because most people with RLS and iron deficiency do not have anemia. A ferritin level, rather than a blood count test, is the best initial test. If he does have iron deficiency, then treatment with iron supplementation can sometimes dramatically improve those nighttime symptoms.



Information on the spring 2024 controlled black bear hunt can be found in the 2023 Idaho Big Game Seasons and Rules booklet (see it at idfg.idaho.gov/sites/default/files/biggame2023_1stedition_final_update-12-26-23.

Hunters must have a 2024 hunting license in order to apply for controlled hunts, and there are several ways to apply:

- Online: Hunters can apply at gooutdoors idaho.com, or on the Fish and Game mobile app. There is a service charge of 3% of the transaction in addition to the nonrefundable controlled hunt application fee.
- · Licensed Vendors: At any Fish and Game regional office or license vendor.
- Telephone: Applications can be placed over the phone by calling 1 (800) 554-8685.
- · Mail in applications are no longer accepted.

Controlled hunts are hunts with a limited number of tags allocated by a random drawing, unlike a general season hunt, which allows hunters to purchase tags over the counter. Controlled hunts are often desirable because of location and timing, and success rates are usually higher than general season hunts.

Junior hunters must be between the ages of 10 and 17 to participate in any bear controlled hunt, but a 9-year-old may buy a junior license to apply, provided the hunter is 10 years old at the time of the hunt for which they are applying.

Controlled hunt applications for spring 2024 black bear close on Feb. 15. Successful spring black bear applicants will be notified no later than March 10. Any leftover tags for spring bear controlled hunts go on sale April 1.

- Grated Parmesan cheese or crumbled feta


Slice peppers into six 1/3-inch-thick rounds, keeping the cut edges smooth and even. Remove seeds and core pieces.





2 teaspoons lime zest

1/2 cup fresh lime juice

2 medium garlic cloves, minced

1 tablespoon chipotle pepper canned in adobo sauce, minced, plus 2 tablespoons adobo sauce

1 1/2 pounds boneless, skinless chicken breasts, fat discarded

nonstick cooking spray

3 bunches asparagus spears, trimmed

1/4 teaspoon salt

1/2 teaspoon black pepper, divided

2 tablespoons canola oil or corn oil
