



- 8 ounces cream cheese, softened
- 3 tablespoons tomato paste
- 1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce
- 3 tablespoons pimento olives, chopped
- 2 tablespoons onions, chopped
- 2 tablespoons bacon, chopped
- 1/4 cup chopped Dandy Celery, plus additional whole sticks for serving, divided
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper
- 1/2 teaspoon granulated garlic

- 1 lime, juice only
- 1 teaspoon salt

- 10. Sprinkle layer of diced tomatoes over avocado puree in each container. Add layer of radish sticks.
- 11. Distribute Greek yogurt mixture evenly over cups.
- 12. Divide cheese over cups then layer black olives. Garnish with dollop of Greek yogurt and cilantro leaf.



- 3/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder

- 1 green onion, thinly sliced
- 1/2 cup shredded aged cheddar or other cheese

Place the cream cheese in a bowl and beat with an electric mixer on high for about 2 minutes, until it's light and fluffy. Scrape the bowl, then add the sour cream or mayo, salt, garlic powder and pepper. Beat on high for another minute. Taste and adjust the seasoning -this is your dip, after all.

Refrigerate for at least 1 hour so the flavors can get acquainted and settle in. Serve with breadsticks, pretzels, mini bagels, crackers or

Note: The longer it chills, the better it gets, which makes this a perfect make-ahead recipe for busy hosts. Leftovers keep in the fridge for up to a week, although "leftover dip" is mostly a theoretical concept.

What else can you add? Truly anything else you love, like chopped herbs, leftover roasted veggies, a spoonful of pesto, diced olives, sun-dried tomatoes, everything bagel seasoning. This recipe is here for your creativity and your fridge clean-outs.



By Presidential Proclamation, December 17th is Wright Brothers Day. Each year, a proclamation invites the people of the United States to observe this day with appropriate ceremonies and activities.

The US Code directs that Wright Brothers Day commemorates the first successful flights in a heavier than air, mechanically propelled airplane. Orville and Wilbur Wright made that first successful flight on December 17th, 1903, near Kitty Hawk, North Carolina. While other inventors created planes that flew, Orville and Wilbur invented the first mechanically propelled aeroplane. Those inventors who came before them inspired the Wright brothers in many ways, too.

From a young age, Orville Wright and his brother, Wilbur, developed a fascination with flight. Inspired by a rubber band propelled helicopter created by the inventor, Alphonse Penaud, the brothers dedicated their lives to the invention. They first found success manufacturing bicycles, including the Van Cleve and St. Clair.

They never lost interest in flight and continued to develop designs. By 1902, the future aviators were making progress with their gliders and nearing a successful mechanical flight. They sold their bicycle business, and onDecember 17th, 1903, achieved their goal.

Orville Wright made the first flight for 12 seconds and 120 feet around the Wright Brothers National Memorial site, just south of Kitty Hawk on that date. While the Wright Brothers were not the first to build and fly experimental aircraft, they are recognized as the first to inventaircraft controlsthat made the fixed-wing flight possible.

More in Flight

Wright Brothers Day also recognizes other accomplishments in aviation history. Many exciting accomplishments, adventure, and daring heroism take place in aviation. In fact, numerous museums and landmarks around the world will walk you through aviation's impressive timeline. From the National Aviation Hall of Fame in Ohio to March Field Air Museum in Riverside, California, and the Air and Space Museum in Washington, D.C., nearly every state in the U.S. fills the imagination with original and replica planes of the pioneers of flight. Even

NATIONAL WRIGHT BROTHERS DAY HISTORY

A joint resolution of Congress declared December 17th, 1963, as Wright Brothers Day. Congress later amended the resolution (77 Stat. 402; U.S.C. 143), designating December 17th of each year as Wright Brothers Day and authorized the President to issue annually a proclamation inviting the people of the United States to observe that day with appropriate ceremonies and activities.

Q. What was the name of the Wright Brothers' flying machine?

Mule Deer 2025

Here's where we are, and from where we've come

Mule deer hunters have reason to be optimistic about this fall, and cautious about the future. Mule deer harvest increased by 30% last fall over the 2023 season, and signs look promising we could see another harvest bump.

Positive signs for 2025

Mild-to-normal winters typically grow Idaho's mule deer herds, or more accurately, allow herds to grow. But as history has often shown, the good times don't last forever. A normal winter in 2024-25 means favorable odds we'll have as good or better mule deer hunting than last year. Survival of collared fawns last winter was around 58 percent, a tick up from the long-term average of 57 percent.

"We're growing mule deer herds with 58% survival," Fish and Game's Deer/Elk Coordinator Toby Boudreau said.

Idaho is a big state, fawn survival wasn't uniform, and there are also some troubling signs ahead. But first, the good news. After the Southeast Region was hit hard by a catastrophic winter in 2022, it posted some of the highest fawn survival rates in the state last winter, which bodes well for their rebounding mule deer herds.

Things were opposite in the Southwest Region where despite a normal winter in Unit 39, which is one of the state's most-popular mule deer units, only 31% of collared fawns survived. No need to panic, yet, because Unit 39 still has one of the biggest mule deer herds in the state, but low fawn survival is a sign that the herd is reaching the limits of its habitat. Biologists have been seeing lighter fawns coming into recent winters, and fawn weight is an accurate predictor of their winter survival.

"Light fawns often indicates some habitat limitations on summer range," Boudreau said.

In short, too many mouths and not enough groceries. The solution could be something that's counter intuitive to many hunters - the need to harvest more deer, including does, to get a healthy and sustainable herd. Otherwise, a hard winter could hit those herds harder and drop them farther.

But when we look across southern Idaho, mule deer herds are healthy and growing in most areas, so the potential is there for an above-average hunting season.

What does "average" really mean?

Here's where things get squishy. When we talk about "better hunting" we tend to be short sighted. Last year's harvest was the highest since 2018, but 37% less than 2015 (highest of the decade) and below the 10-year average.


The harvests in 2015 and 2016 were each more than 10,000 deer above the 10-year average, which were followed by the catastrophic winter of 2016-'17. Since then, the annual harvests have ranged from 18,329 to 26,973.

As mentioned earlier, mule deer's historic population cycles are fairly predictable. Herds grow when conditions allow, then plummet after a hard winter, then start rebuilding.

"It's winter that decides which way that cycle goes," Boudreau said.

It's also hard to say what "average" Idaho mule deer hunting means when you look across past decades. The 50-year chart shows a similar trend to the 10-year graph. A decade of unusually high mule deer harvests between the 1980s and 1990s drove up the 50-year average, and only 3 years have had "above average" harvests since then.

So we're currently in rebuilding mode, but there's no guarantee how long it will continue because you can't predict when the next hard winter will hit.

Looking way back

Mule deer are an iconic western game animal that Idahoans have hunted for over a century. And with each generation, you will hear "it's not like it used to be." That's true, and always has been true, because of the cyclical nature of mule deer populations, as well as the ever-changing landscapes they inhabit.

When you factor in Idaho's population growth, development, changes in habitat, wildfires, drought, increases in elk herds, and other factors that influence mule deer herds, each decade looks different. And yes, some are worse than others.


If you're looking for a return to the "good ol' days," which were often much shorter than people remember, you see how dynamic mule deer populations can be, and how difficult, if not impossible, it can be to duplicate those years when the planets aligned and mule deer thrived for a glorious, but limited, time period. In short, it's different now than it was a couple decades ago, and it will likely be different from now in a couple more decades.

But things look pretty good for now. Not historically great, but better than we've seen in recent years. Not to overstate the obvious, but more deer in the mountains and sagebrush means better chances for a higher harvest. And things get better because consecutive normal winters also likely means more mature bucks.

Take a deep dive into the history of mule deer in Idaho

Wildlife biologist Eric Freeman from the Southeast Region presented the Idaho Fish and Game Commission with this presentation on the history of Idaho's mule deer herds. Good Time To Apply For Apprentice Program

— Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks -

HELENA – If your youth is planning to apply as an apprentice hunter, it's a good idea to apply now. The apprentice hunter law allows people ages 10 and older to hunt as apprentices with an adult mentor for two seasons without completing a Hunter Education course. The program is also for adults wanting to learn to hunt.

Hopeful hunters are encouraged to visit the website at fwp.mt.gov/hunt/education/apprentice-hunter and read the apprentice hunter packet before seeking certification. Packets are also available at regional offices. There are guidelines for both the apprentice and the required mentor, including what apprentices can and cannot do, who can act as a mentor and how the certification process works.

Some key details to note:

- · Certification can be done at FWP regional offices or online via the Online Licenses Service ols. fwp.mt.gov/. A person must be certified before purchasing appropriate licenses, which will then show apprentice status
- If the mentor is not related to an apprentice who is under the age of 18, a legal guardian's signature also will be needed on the Mentor form, and the parent must provide his or her driver's license
- · A youth need not accompany the adult to certify as an apprentice, but he or she must understand the guidelines.

An Apprentice MUST:

- Be at least 10 years old at the time of license purchase
- Pay a \$5 certificate fee; the apprentice license must be purchased separately from the adult's
- · Hunt with a mentor who is at least 21 and who has a current hunting license

· Have the appropriate current Montana hunting licenses for the species being hunted; the licenses must show that he/she is apprentice hunter

· Stay within sight of the nonhunting mentor at all times

An Apprentice MAY:


- · Be a resident or nonresident
- Obtain apprentice certification for no more than two license years before he or she must complete a hunter safety and education course

An Apprentice is NOT ELIGIBLE to:

- Obtain a special bow and arrow license without first completing a Bowhunter Education course (must be 11 to take bow ed)
- · Obtain a resident hound training license for chasing mountain lion
- · Participate in a hunting license or permit drawing with a limited quota
- · Obtain any bighorn sheep, black bear, wolf or mountain lion license
- · Obtain an elk license if under 15 years of age

A Mentor MUST:

- Be 21 or older
- · Be related to the apprentice by blood, adoption or marriage; or be the apprentice's legal guardian or be designated by the apprentice's legal guardian (guardian must complete form and show ID)
- · Have a current Montana hunting license
- Complete the Apprentice Hunter Mentor form
- · Agree to accompany and supervise the apprentice hunter and remain within sight of and direct voice contact with the apprentice at all times while in the field
- Confirm that the apprentice possesses the physical and psychological capacity to safely and ethically engage in hunting activities







Getting a COVID Booster Before a Cruise Is Prudent for Couple

DEAR DR. ROACH: My husband and I will be traveling to the United Kingdom in July and will be on a ship with about 700 passengers. We are wondering whether it would be smart (or unnecessary) to get a COVID booster before the trip. We are both in our late 60s and have had all the available COVID shots. (The last one we received was on Oct. 10,

I have mild asthma, and we both have BMIs of about 30 with no other health issues. There is so much information and misinformation on these vaccinations, so I would appreciate your educated opinion. -- O.W.I.

ANSWER: In my opinion, it would be very smart to get a COVID shot before you go, ideally at least two weeks ahead but no more than three months ahead. The vaccine takes about two weeks to work and gives its best protection for about three months.

At the time of this writing, a new strain (NB.1.8.1) is rapidly spreading in other countries and in North America. It would be very prudent for you both to get the vaccine, especially given your risk factors of being over 65, being a little overweight, and (in your case) having mild asthma. You may very well be exposed on a cruise ship, which is where some of the earliest COVID cases came from.

In the United States, the Food and Drug Administration has recently set new requirements on who can get the vaccine, and they have done so without the input of experts -- the basic scientists, clinicians and epidemiologists who should all be giving input on vaccine policies. In short, administrators have removed your doctor's ability to decide whether you are appropriate for the vaccine.

Since you are over 65, you and your husband should still be able to get the vaccine unless the FDA further restricts the ability to get vaccines. For others in similar situations, I recommend getting the vaccine while you still have this choice.

DR. ROACH WRITES: Quite a few readers asked me about a recent high-profile case of advanced prostate cancer -- President Joe Biden -- and how this could have happened.

I first answer with humility. I don't know what the screening was like for President Biden. Although I have read reports that he was not being screened, I am not confident that I know enough to have an opinion on the appropriateness of the screening strategy used in his case.

Second, I answer from my knowledge on the biology of prostate cancer, which is that not all prostate cancers can be caught through screening. A PSA level can be low even with advanced cancer. Also, some prostate cancers can grow very quickly in between screenings. Both of these would be uncommon,

Screening does reduce the risk of death from prostate cancer but does not eliminate it. Prostate cancer death rates have decreased by about half in the U.S., partly from screening and partly due to improvements in medical, radiological and surgical treatment

Third and most importantly, I answer with compassion. Looking backward is not helpful to the person who is facing a difficult diagnosis. I wish the best for President Biden and his family, and I am confident that he will get the best care available.

Chocolate FAQ

Q. What does it mean to temper chocolate?

A. Tempering is a process that improves the quality of a substance. In the case of chocolate, it improves its resiliency and shine. It's recommended to use tempered chocolate when dipping or making candy.

Q. How do I temper chocolate?

A. There are a few different methods for tempering chocolate. One is to heat chocolate slowly in a microwave in 30-second intervals. When the chocolate starts to melt you are getting close. Stop heating the chocolate when it is soft but is still holding some of its shape. When you stir the chocolate, it should become smooth and lose its shape. Seeding chocolate is another method for tempering chocolate. Separate 1/3 of the chocolate and chop it into pea-sized bits. This is the seed chocolate. Melt the remaining 2/3 of the chocolate in a double boiler. The temperature you bring the chocolate to will depend on the type of chocolate.

- Dark Chocolate 120°F
- Milk Chocolate 115°F
- White Chocolate- 110°F

Remove the melted chocolate from the heat and stir in the seed chocolate. Keep stirring until the chocolate reaches a temperature of:

- Dark Chocolate 82°F
- Milk Chocolate 80°F
- White Chocolate- 78°F

Return the chocolate to the double boiler and bring it to the following temperature:

- Dark Chocolate 90°F
- Milk Chocolate 86°F
- White Chocolate- 82°F

Remove from the heat and begin dipping!





















Pheasant Pot Pie

- Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks -

If your freezer is anything like mine, it's starting to stack up with pheasants. Here's a classic recipe for Pheasant Pot Pie from a 2014 issue of Montana Outdoors.

CRUST

- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- ½ cup canola or vegetable oil
- 5 tablespoons water (plus 2 tablespoons for egg wash)
- 1 egg (for egg wash)

PREPARATION: Mix oil and 5 tablespoons of water and stir into flour to form dough. Divide into two equal parts. Roll out each part between wax paper to make two pastries.

FILLING

2½ pounds boneless pheasant, grouse, or turkey meat, cut into 1-inch pieces

Salt and pepper

- 3 tablespoons olive or vegetable oil
- 3 garlic cloves, minced 3 celery ribs, diced
- 1 cup butternut squash or carrots, chopped into 1-inch chunks
- 3 cups chicken stock
- 5 tablespoons butter 3/4 cup all-purpose flour
- 1 cup heavy cream
- 1 teaspoon dried rosemary
- ½ cup frozen pearl onions, cut in half
- ½ cup frozen peas

PREPARATION: Preheat oven to 375°. Heat 2 tablespoons of the oil over medium-high heat in a large cast-iron skillet. Salt and pepper meat and add to the pan. Cook until browned, stirring occasionally. Set meat aside.

Add remaining 1 tablespoon oil to the pan along with the garlic, celery, and squash (or carrots), and cook until slightly soft. Set aside.

Bring stock to a simmering boil in a small pot. In a saucepan, melt butter over medium heat. Whisk in flour for 1 minute. Add stock and cream. Once mixture boils, turn heat down and simmer, whisking all the while, for 5 minutes. Add rosemary and season with salt and pepper.

To the cream mixture, stir in meat and all vegetables.

Place one pastry in a 9-inch glass pie pan. Trim so it's ½-inch wider than the glass edge. Spoon filling into the pastry-lined pan. Top with second pastry. Pinch the two edges together to seal. Cut slits in several places in top for steam to escape.

Make egg wash by mixing egg with 2 tablespoons water. Brush top pastry with mixture.

Bake pot pie for 35 minutes or until crust is golden.



Homemade Pumpkin Ravioli with White Wine and Herb Butter Sauce

- 1 can (15 ounces) pumpkin puree
- 1 large egg, lightly beaten
- 1/3 cup grated Pecorino Romano cheese, plus additional for serving (optional)
- 2 tablespoons plain dried breadcrumbs
- 2 teaspoons sugar
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1 pinch ground nutmeg
- 48 round dumpling wrappers

Sauce:

- 6 tablespoons cold unsalted butter, divided
- 1/3 cup chopped shallots
- cup dry white wine
- 3 tablespoons heavy cream
- tablespoons chopped fresh sage
- 1 tablespoon chopped fresh chives
- teaspoon salt
- 1. To make ravioli: Line fine mesh sieve with dampened cheesecloth. Add pumpkin puree and strain 1 hour. Transfer to bowl and stir in egg, cheese, breadcrumbs, sugar, salt and nutmeg.
- Arrange six dumpling wrappers on work surface in single layer. Place 1 tablespoon pumpkin mixture in center of each and brush edges with water. Place second wrapper over filling, carefully pushing out any air bubbles then pressing edges to seal.
- 3. Transfer ravioli to baking sheet covered with parchment paper. Place sheet of plastic wrap over ravioli. Repeat with remaining wrappers and filling.



• *Mailing cards* In Victorian England, sending Penny Post was inexpensive and frequent. Not responding to it was equally inexcusable. Being popular and busy led Sir Henry Cole to invent a holiday card nearly out of necessity. In 1843, he asked his friend, J.C. Horsley to illustrate a design he had in mind. Soon, Cole was off to the printer and the first Christmas card mailed in the Penny Post

- *Caroling* Wassailing and caroling history go hand in hand. Originally, wassail referred to a mulled, sweet drink. It came to be known as going from house to house during the winter months and eventually as caroling. The carolers are often given hot beverages to drink to keep them warm as they travel. - *Fruitcake* The American tradition of eating or giving fruitcake at Christmas is somehow connected to the Victorian tradition of serving Christmas pudding. Both are molded, but that's about where the similarities end.

One of the earliest references to celebrating the birth of Jesus Christ is in a homily by John Chrysostom, a 4th-century archbishop. Christmas is a relatively new celebration when considering church holy days. Passover, Lent, and Easter were celebrated long before Christmas.

Winter Solstice

These regions celebrated the Winter Solstice. Christmas adopted many of the customs associated with the Winter Solstice. These customs included decorating with evergreen trees and their boughs. It also included large feasts and a bearded man delivering gifts. In medieval times, Christmas was a solemn observance of the birth of Jesus Christ, and very little feasting, singing, and carousing was going on. The first record of the word "Cristes Maesse" being used was in a book from 1038 from Saxon England.

As Christianity spread into northern and western Europe, Christmas adopted many of the customs associated with the winter solstice. Decorating with evergreen trees and their boughs, holly, and mistletoe, a bearded man delivering gifts and even the large feasts all hearken back to these celebrations.

Caroling, Nativity scenes, and gift-giving (primarily to nobility with hopes of favors in return) began taking hold around the Renaissance period. Royalty and nobility had a considerable influence on this era. The Renaissance period covered a broad expanse of time (1300-1700) and was filled with an influx of inspiration, invention, and art. All of it influenced Christmas. Some Christians, like the Puritans didn't celebrate Christmas at all. This was largely due to the holiday's pagan background. Christmas was illegal in Massachusetts between 1659 and 1681.

Christmas in The United States

One hundred years after the founding of the United States, Christmas became a federal holiday.

By the mid to late 1800s, communication and transportation were changing rapidly. Time and distance isolated people causing customs and traditions to be diverse from place to place. Celebrations occurring in Georgia were completely unique from those celebrated in New York. Nearly overnight that began to change. Telegraphs and railroads made the passage of information and people, if not instant, significantly faster than ever before. Longing for the old days, for times when the family was a central theme in American's lives, Christmas brought those nostalgic feelings under one significant day.

Louis Prang, a German immigrant and printer by trade, introduced the American Christmas card in 1875. The Christmas card gradually replaced customs of personal visits or written Christmas letters.

As the population grew, so did commerce and an increase in both charitable and personal gift giving followed. However, many givers and recipients still valued handmade gifts over store-bought.

Literature such as Clement Moore's poem *An Account of Visit from Saint Nicholas* (1823) and Charles Dickens' *A Christmas Carol* (1843) influenced the Norman Rockwell vision of the Christmas we celebrate today.

Christmas Day December 25th

— National Day Calendar -



Every year on December 25th, over 2 billion people around the world celebrate Christmas Day. Traditionally, Christmas is a celebration of the birth of Jesus Christ. Nonreligious people and those of different faiths celebrate the day as a cultural event.

Also known as Christmas Day, this holiday is derived from the Old English Crīstesmæsse which means Christ's Mass. Today, Christmas is a public holiday in most countries. Only about a dozen countries do not recognize Christmas as a public holiday. Christmas traditions vary around the world and have evolved over time. They borrow from other traditions and cultures, too. Over time, beliefs and customs blended as peoples migrated and attitudes changed.

One of the most popular Christmas customs is gift-giving. This custom has its roots in the Magi who brought gifts to Jesus shortly after his birth. Unfortunately, the gift-giving aspect of Christmas has led to its commercialization. On average, Americans spend \$700 on Christmas gifts and goodies. Altogether, this equals \$465 billion. In recent years, there has been a call to simplify the holiday and to get back to the "reason for the season."

Christmas Traditions

- Candy canes While plain, unflavored candy sticks and canes existed as early as the 1600s, it wasn't until 1920 that the hooked version became exceptionally popular. Bob McCormack of Albany, Georgia took the peppermint candy, gave it a red and white striped twist. His handmade candies were given a manufacturing boost when his brother-in-law and priest, Gregory Keller, invented the machine that launched Bob's Candies into mass production. However, Keller's invention wasn't the first of its kind.
- *Poinsettia* Another tradition that blossomed in the United States during the 1920s, the poinsettia's legend takes place in Mexico. According to the legend, a girl wanted desperately to celebrate Jesus's birthday. Worried, the girl feared she would have no gift to offer because she was so poor. An angel tells her to give any gift with love. After gathering weeds from alongside the road, the young girl placed them in the manger. Miraculously the weeds bloomed into beautiful red stars.
- *Christmas trees* Evergreens, fir trees, and other plants have been a part of the winter festivals and traditions since ancient times. The first person to place a tree in a house for the purposes of Christmas may have been the German preacher Martin Luther in the 16th century.

- 3. In same pan, add chopped onion and cook over low heat, stirring occasionally, until pieces are soft and lightly caramelized.
- 4. Add butternut squash cubes to onions along with 2 cups chicken broth. Cover and bring to boil. Reduce heat and cook until squash is soft and most liquid is reduced.
- 5. Pour squash and onions into bowl and add milk, remaining chicken broth, dry mustard, nutmeg and pinch of salt and pepper. Using KitchenAid Evergreen Design Series Tilt-Head Stand Mixer, puree mixture until smooth and creamy.
- 6. Pour pureed sauce into saute pan. Over low heat, add Parmesan cheese and 3/4 cup sharp cheddar cheese a little at a time, stirring constantly. Add noodles and stir well.
- 7. Add salt and pepper, to taste. Top with chopped bacon, remaining cheese and chopped parsley, if desired.



Make Peppermint Bark Holiday Candy

The holiday season tastes like peppermint, and most of us can't get enough. Peppermint mocha brightens the morning, peppermint ice cream makes us dreamy at night, and cute red-and-whitestriped candy canes evoke festive childhood memories during the hours in between.

While on the topic of peppermint whatevers, I can't leave out yummy -- and trendy -- peppermint bark. Who can resist the sweet layers of dark and white chocolate topped with crunchy peppermint bits? The bright holiday tins filled with the confection at high-end kitchenware stores are tempting to buy, but they're also pricey.

This year, make your own batch or two of peppermint bark with this easy, economical version using ingredients from the baking section and candy aisle of the grocery store. Older kids can melt the candy coating (almond bark) in the microwave, while preschoolers can pound candy canes into small bits with a toy hammer to sprinkle on top. Working together with you, the entire prep takes less than half an hour. The kids can scoot off to another activity while the bark cools and hardens.

EASY HOLIDAY PEPPERMINT BARK

Yield: Makes about 1 3/4 pounds

1 pound good-quality chocolate confectionary coating, broken into pieces (Look for it in the grocery baking section, sometimes labeled "almond bark" or "candy coating.")

1 1/2 teaspoons pure peppermint extract

12 ounces good-quality white vanilla-flavored confectionery coating, broken into pieces

1/2 cup crushed candy canes

Line a baking sheet with foil sprayed with nonstick cooking spray. In a microwave-safe bowl, heat chocolate coating uncovered for 90 seconds on high power, and stir. Continue to microwave and stir at 30-second intervals until almost melted. (Be sure to use a dry bowl and utensils.)

Add 1 teaspoon peppermint extract, and stir until smooth. Pour onto the foil-lined baking sheet. Spread evenly into a thin layer, approximately 10 by 14 inches.

In another microwave-safe bowl, heat white coating as you did with chocolate. Add 1/2 teaspoon peppermint extract (optional) and stir until smooth. Spoon evenly over chocolate layer, which should be setting up but not hard, as you want the white layer to bond with the base layer.


Immediately sprinkle peppermint pieces all over and lightly press them into the white layer with a spatula or a spoon. Don't wait on this step, or the top layer will harden and the candies won't stick.

Let stand for an hour, or refrigerate until hardened. Break into pieces.
