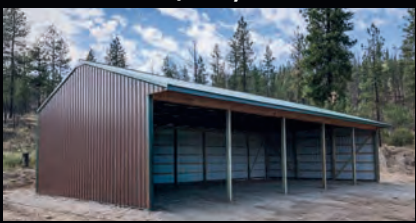

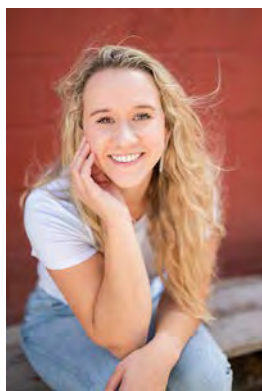

Crispy Air Fryer Potato Nuggets and Dip

Prep time: 10 minutes

Cook time: 24 minutes

Servings: 4

Potatoes:

- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1/2 teaspoon pepper
- 1 cup milk
- 1.5 cups panko breadcrumbs

- 1.5 pounds Little Potatoes

Chimichurri:

- 1 bunch cilantro
- 1 bunch parsley

Noxious Weeds Notice and Support Programs

— Bonner County Noxious Weeds Department —

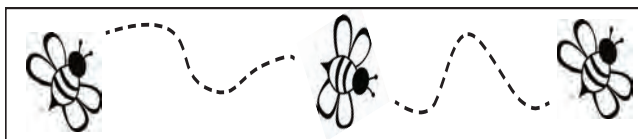


Greetings, Nickel's Worth readers. By statute, counties are required to circulate an annual noxious weeds notice. It shall contain the Idaho Noxious Weeds List and indicate those which are currently present or imminently threatening the county, and stipulate the obligation for control. The accompanying notice is included in this edition.

Statute grants enforcement authority to counties—however, many counties implement landowner compliance assistance programs as the primary tool to satisfy statutory obligations. For the EDRR (early detection, rapid response) noxious weeds, which are inventoried at low levels county-wide and meet eradication objectives, Bonner County offers targeted treatments at no charge.

For the noxious weeds that are inventoried at widespread levels, Bonner County offers a landowner herbicide reimbursement program. These are inherently ongoing programs that are primarily funded with state noxious weed cost share dollars.

PUBLIC NOTICE NOXIOUS WEEDS – BONNER COUNTY

State Noxious Weed Law: Idaho Statute (Title 22, Chapter 24) expresses that it is the duty & responsibility of all landowners to control noxious weeds on their land and property, in accordance with this chapter and with rules promulgated by the director (of the Idaho State Dept. of Agriculture)—§22- 2407. A general notice for control of noxious weeds shall contain the list of [Idaho] noxious weeds and identify those known to be in the county and shall stipulate the obligation to control—§22-2405. This published notice is considered legal & sufficient notice.

Caring for roses

In drier climates, the gardener must regularly provide water for rose bushes. Though generally one should water only the soil around the bushes, sprinkling water directly onto the plants keeps the foliage and blooms clean, retards powdery mildew and repels some pests. Insects that like to feed on rose bushes include aphids, Japanese beetles, spider mites and sawflies. Most of these can be controlled with neem oil or insecticidal soap; if you plant alliums near your roses, they can help repel aphids. - Brenda Weaver

IDAHO WEED LAW: The Idaho Weed Law (Idaho Code Title 22, Chapter 24)
Places the responsibility for controlling noxious weeds on the person who owns or manages the land. Any person with noxious weeds on their property is obligated to control those weeds.

STATEWIDE PROHIBITED GENERAL NOXIOUS WEED LIST

All plants and plant parts in the genera of Cytisus, Genista, Spartium, and Chamaecytisus additionally including "all" subtaxa of these plant genera are prohibited in Idaho.

Waking Up Dahlia Tubers

By late winter, gardeners are ready for signs of life. If your dahlia tubers have been resting in cool storage since last fall, now is the time to wake them up and get a head start on the season.

Bring the tuber storage containers into a room-temperature space and check on them once a week. Within a week or two, small pink or green "eyes" will begin forming at the crown. These buds signal that the tuber is ready to grow.

Once the eyes are visible, plant each tuber in a 4-inch pot filled with fresh potting mix. Lightly moisten the soil before planting so it is evenly damp, not wet. Position slightly below the soil surface. Do not water again at this stage.

Place the pots under grow lights or in a bright location to encourage sturdy growth. After green shoots emerge through the soil, begin to water sparingly. In a few short weeks, you'll have strong young plants ready to harden off and move outdoors once the danger of frost has passed.

Vermiculture: Using Worms to Compost

odor, it may even be possible to put the worm bin in your house during the winter months. However, if an offensive odor does develop, check to ensure that you are not feeding the worms too much, or adding too much water to the bedding. It is important to fluff the bedding to increase air circulation periodically.

The next thing to consider is bedding material for the worms. The bottom of the worm bin should be covered with material such as shredded newspaper, cardboard, or dried leaves two to four inches deep. Non-chlorinated water should be used to make this material as wet as a damp sponge. Peat moss can also be used as bedding material. It holds water well; however, since it doesn't have nutritional value, it needs to be used in conjunction with other bedding materials. Remember to add a handful of soil to the bedding material, since worms need the grit in soil to break down food. Your worm's food must be broken down by muscle action in their gizzards, since they do not have teeth.

Worms eventually digest this bedding material, but they also need food to survive. A good rule of thumb is that two pounds of worms will need one pound of kitchen waste per day.

Eggshells are also recommended for worms. They are a good source of calcium, increase the pH of the bin and promote reproduction. Eggshells from hard-boiled eggs can be crushed and put directly into the worm bin. However, raw eggshells could carry diseases that are harmful to your worms and will stink when they rot. Boiling the empty eggshells for five minutes will prevent these negative effects from occurring. Worms will eat any kind of raw fruit and vegetables, except for acidic ones. Chop fruit and vegetable scraps up into small bits, to speed their decomposition. Worms also like to eat regular cornmeal, without salt or other additives. There are some kitchen scraps that should never be fed to worms. For example, fats and oils lower the pH, stink when they rot, and may attract undesirable pests. Meat and dairy products in the worm bin will result in the same negative effects.

Feeding the worms is easy. Simply pull back the bedding, add chopped up food scraps, and then cover up the scraps with the bedding. Bury the scraps in a different location each time.

When the bedding starts to look like dark, fertile soil, it can be used in your garden. This is an important step; because the finished worm compost will become toxic to the worms if they are left in the worm bin too long. (Not to mention you want to use this wonderful soil in your garden.) One way to harvest the soil is by moving the bedding to one side of the worm bin and adding new bedding and food to the other side of the bin. In about a month, most of the worms will have migrated to the area with fresh bedding and food. Another way to harvest the worm soil is to simply dump material that the worms have processed on a tarp outside. Wait an hour or so for the worms to go down to the bottom of the pile to avoid the light. Take the soil, retrieve the worms and place them in your worm bin with fresh food and fresh bedding to start the process over again.

The soil produced by the worms can be used in many ways. For example, the worm's harvest can enrich potting soil at a ratio of ¼ worm castings to ¾ potting mix. One-fourth inch of this material can also be added to the top of houseplants every 45-60 days, removing some of the houseplants' soil if necessary. A sprinkling of worm castings can also be added to the bottom of a seed row or put in the hole when you are transplanting. To use around trees and mature shrubs, merely put the castings around your tree, two to three inches from the base of your tree and continue out to the drip line, working the worm castings into the soil and water after application.

Using worms to make rich, fertile soil is easy and fun to do. Once you've tried doing it, you will undoubtedly become very enthusiastic about its benefits to both the environment and your garden.

Do you know that the average family of four wastes an estimated 122 pounds of edible food every year? This uneaten food does not have to become part of our landfill. Red worms can change some of that organic waste into rich soil that is full of nutrients. There are many advantages in using worms to assist in the composting process or vermicomposting. For example, worms can reduce composting time from 240 days to just 30 days. They also produce healthy soil that is full of microbes, and microbial activity. Worm castings are rich in humus, and provide the soil with important nutrients of nitrogen, phosphorus and potassium. In addition, the nutrients in worm castings are readily available to plants and serve as a "time release" of these nutrients. Putting these worms to work, or vermicomposting, is a simple process and can become a gardener's best friend. Given a home, appropriate bedding, and proper food, red worms will thrive and will soon produce soil that will be the envy of your neighborhood.

Any wooden box, or rigid plastic container can be used for a worm bin. A wooden container should be made of untreated wood. Chemically treated wood may be harmful to the worm or leach into the compost material. It is acceptable to use a big Rubbermaid type bin, or an old drawer to provide a home for your worms.

With a bigger container, more red worms can be harbored. A good rule of thumb is one pound of red worms for every square foot of surface area. The depth of this container should be no more than 8 to 12 inches. Red worms are not burrowing creatures and will not go below this point. A bin that is deeper than that may result in compaction of the bedding and food. This compaction leads to anaerobic (lack of oxygen) conditions and unpleasant odors.

It is also important that the worm bin is well ventilated. Several 1/8-inch holes should be drilled in a plastic container four inches from the bottom. If this is not done, the worms will stay at the bottom of the container and may drown. If the container is made of untreated wood, drilling holes is unnecessary. Proper ventilation is provided by the structure of the wood.

Since worms need a moist, dark area, a cover on the bin will help ensure these requirements are met. The lid should be removable and can be made of canvas or burlap held in place with a bungee cord or a piece of wood. If it is not feasible to make a bin, a bin can be easily purchased from an Internet site.

When considering where to place your worm bin, remember that the optimum temperature for worms is between 60-80 degrees Fahrenheit. Since a properly maintained worm bin will not have an offensive

Bringing Fishers Home to the Panhandle Region

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game —



Project aims to augment fisher populations in North Idaho.

Idaho Fish and Game — in cooperation with the Coeur d'Alene Tribe, U.S. Army Corp of Engineers, and Idaho Trappers Association — completed the first year of a project to move fishers, a member of the weasel family related to wolverine and marten, from the Clearwater Region to Panhandle Region.

The Coeur d'Alene Mountains in the Panhandle contain good fisher habitat, but the area currently only supports a very small and isolated number of animals. Fish and Game initiated the project to increase the local fisher population and improve connectivity between fisher populations in the Cabinet Mountains to the north and the St. Joe-Clearwater-Nez Perce fisher population to the south.

The project will also gather information on movements and sites used for resting and denning. This information will be used to develop forest management strategies to benefit fishers and other wildlife.

Fishers rely on mature forested habitats, requiring large trees and snags for resting and denning.

About the project

Trappers with the Idaho Trappers Association began live-trapping for fisher in early-November and continued through mid-December. Participating trappers were reimbursed through an Idaho Fish and Game Commission Community Challenge Grant. In addition, trappers were also reimbursed by the Upper Snake River Trappers, National Trappers Foundation, and Montana Trappers Association.

All captured fishers were taken to a temporary holding facility where they were housed, fed and monitored to minimize stress. Before being released, animals were anesthetized, processed for biological samples and then fitted with satellite GPS collars to track their movements and habitat use.

In total, 11 fishers were released into Unit 4 of the Coeur d'Alene Mountains, including seven males and four females. Fish and Game, along with partners, plan to continue the project for one or two more years, with the goal of moving up to 30 fishers.

The project aims to ensure healthy fisher populations for future generations.

F&G To Host Hybrid Public Meeting For Negotiated Rulemaking On April 15

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game —



This rulemaking is being initiated to explore the opportunity to expand electronic tagging (e-tagging) options for game birds.

Idaho Fish and Game will hold a public meeting in-person and virtually to take comments on upcoming proposed rules on Wednesday, April 15. The meeting will be held in person at Fish and Game Headquarters, located at 600 S. Walnut St. in Boise. Those interested in attending or providing comments can also tune in via Zoom at us06web.zoom.us/j/83077793532.

The proposed rulemaking aims to explore the opportunity to expand electronic tagging (e-tagging) options for game birds (see more at idfg.idaho.gov/about/rulemaking/13-0109-2601). By allowing e-tagging validation, Fish and Game is attempting to modernize processes and eliminate the need for a paper tag in the field for those interested. This will help mitigate the trouble of faded, washed-out, or lost paper tags.

Fish and Game is interested in e-tagging validation for turkeys and Wildlife Management Area-planted pheasants, initially, with potential to expand programming to cranes, sage-grouse, and swans. The rulemaking would allow for e-tagging and create provisions around the application of the e-tagging validation methodology.

Electronic tagging (e-tagging) is currently a method for anglers to tag their harvested salmon/steelhead electronically rather than with the traditional paper permits or tags. E-tagging allows the angler to e-tag their harvested fish via smartphone and electronically submit their harvest information.

Rulemaking is different than season and bag limits set by the Fish and Game Commission. Rulemaking involves different procedures and involves legislative approval.

McGill Spur Access Site On Clearwater River Closed Until Further Notice

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game —



Due to extensive storm damage and unstable terrain, the McGill Spur Access Site, which provides public access to the Clearwater River west of Ahsahka, is closed until further notice. Recent torrential rains caused the creek adjacent to the site to flood out of its channel, carving a new flow path through the access area. Concurrently, three landslides occurred on the property, depositing material throughout the site and significantly altering the stream's original course.

This combination of flooding and hillside movement has resulted in unsafe conditions at the site. The public is strongly encouraged to stay out of the area until it is officially reopened for use.

Unfortunately, the scope of the damage and ongoing instability mean that site repairs cannot be completed in time for the April 25 Chinook salmon season opener. Anglers planning to fish during the

spring Chinook season are asked to use other access locations until further notice.

Crews from the Idaho Fish and Game Access Site program and Fisheries staff are working diligently to repair and stabilize the site as safely and efficiently as possible. We apologize for the temporary inconvenience and appreciate the public's patience and understanding.

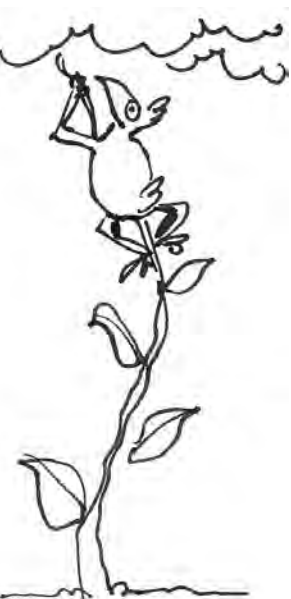

Grow Healthier Plants (and Use Less Water) by Improving Your Soil

Almost every gardener knows the frustration: One corner of the garden bursts with life while another struggles to hang on. Flowers are slow to open, vegetables disappoint and the soil seems to drink up water and ask for more.

Moose, Bighorn Sheep, And Mountain Goat Controlled Hunt Application Period Opens April 1

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game —



To apply, each applicant must possess a 2026 Idaho hunting or combination license.

The application period for moose, bighorn sheep, and mountain goat controlled hunts opens April 1 and runs through April 30. Hunters can apply online, at any Fish and Game office, license vendor, or by calling 1 (800) 554-8685.

Apply online at GoOutdoorsIdaho.com.

Resident and nonresident can apply for moose, bighorn sheep, and mountain goat hunts, but nonresidents are limited to no more than 10% of the total number of tags for each species. To apply, each applicant must possess a 2026 Idaho hunting or combination license. There is a nonrefundable application fee of \$16.75 for residents and \$45.75 for nonresidents.

Moose, sheep, and goat hunt applicants must pay the tag fee along with the application fee when they apply. The total application fees for moose, bighorn sheep and mountain goat are:

- Residents under Price Lock: \$183.50

- Residents without Price Lock: \$216.50
- Nonresidents: \$2,672.50

Moose, sheep, and goat drawing results will be online in early June. Tag fees will be refunded to those who did not draw, but hunting license and application fees are non-refundable.

Hunters are reminded that moose, bighorn sheep, and mountain goat controlled hunt tags are excluded from designation by any parent or grandparent to their minor child or grandchild.

A person is allowed to apply for one of these three species in a year, and those who apply for a moose, sheep, or goat hunt are ineligible for most deer, elk, and pronghorn controlled hunt drawings.

For more information, review the 2025-2026 Moose, Bighorn Sheep, and Mountain Goat Seasons and Rules booklet, which is available online at idfg.idaho.gov/rules/moose-sheep-goat, at Fish and Game offices, and license vendors.

Moose, sheep, and goat tags are among Idaho's most coveted hunts and also among the most successful for harvest.

In 2025, hunter success was:

- Moose: 87%
- Bighorn Sheep: (California = 71%; Rocky Mountain = 81%)
- Mountain Goat: 100%

Moose hunters are reminded that in addition to the controlled hunts, there are four moose tags available through Fish and Game's Super Hunt program. Details on the Super Hunt program can be found on Page 42 of the 2025-26 Moose, Bighorn Sheep, and Mountain Goat Seasons and Rules booklet. The deadline for entries for the first Super Hunt drawing is May 31.

- 2 eggs
- 2 cups milk
- 3 pounds chicken breast, cut into strips
- 2 cups flour
- 1/4 cup barbecue seasoning of choice
- 1/4 cup mesquite seasoning
- salt, to taste
- pepper, to taste
- dipping sauce of choice (optional)

1. Fill Dutch oven or large frying pan halfway with oil and butter; heat over medium heat.
2. In large bowl, mix eggs and milk then place chicken strips in mixture.
3. In separate bowl, mix flour, barbecue seasoning and mesquite seasoning. Add salt and pepper, to taste.
4. Remove 4-6 chicken strips from milk mixture and cover completely in flour mixture.
5. Drop pinch of flour in hot oil; if it crackles, it's hot enough. Once hot, fry battered chicken 4 minutes then, using tongs or fork, turn over and fry 4 minutes. When done, chicken will be golden and almost float. Remove from frying pan and repeat with remaining chicken.
6. Serve with dipping sauce of choice, if desired.

Biologists Observe Leks To Estimate Bird Populations

— Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks —

Spring is well-known to be the season of breeding, especially for birds. Grouse, however, take it to another level.

One thing that makes grouse breeding strategies unique is the use of a lek. A lek is defined by Merriam-Webster as "an assembly area where animals gather for competitive courtship displays." Male grouse use these leks to attract females, usually in the early morning and evenings of early spring. Biologists use these leks as a convenient way to count birds.

Mountain grouse males, such as the dusky grouse, ruffed grouse and spruce grouse, perform their breeding displays in forested areas, usually on their own or in small groups, and aren't really "leks" per se. Biologists can do general counts for these birds, listening at certain distance increments for evidence of a display taking place.

For prairie grouse like sharptails and sage-grouse, on the other hand, the lek display and area is more of a region-wide social event. Prairie grouse leks are large, accommodating dozens of birds, and are often found on fairly flat, elevated areas with sparse vegetation, allowing biologists to observe numbers from afar without disturbing the dance.

This prairie lek site gives eager males a proper stage to strut their stuff, display, make noise and occasionally "fight" to try and impress the females, who are the ones that do the choosing. Statistics show that a very small percentage of the males mate with the majority of the females.

The displays are different depending upon the species. Male sharptailed grouse are very active – think

a rave-type club – where they stomp their feet up to 40 times per second with tails erect looking like little wind-up toys, inflate colorful neck sacs and make many different sounds to show their worth.

Male sage-grouse are more subtle – think a jazz lounge – where they perform a booming "wet-blurp" sound and showcase a prominent air sac and colorful feather display, mostly by puffing up their chest and strutting around with their tail feathers fanned out.

Birds return to lekking grounds, for the most part, year after year and sometimes for decades. Occasionally, birds will abandon a lek, especially if populations become low or if there are constant disturbances or threats. However, as things change over years, old leks will become active again.

FWP staff, other land agencies and some volunteers stay busy every spring counting prairie birds in the early morning hours on specific long-studied leks, while keeping their eyes and ears out for new or yet undiscovered leks. These efforts give biologists a general idea of population trends from year to year.

Keep in mind, however, that although the number of birds on the lek is important for estimating current populations, even more important for upland bird season forecasts are the success of nesting, chick-rearing and brood survival throughout the spring and summer.

All birds seen on spring leks are at least 1 year old and considered adults. During hunting season, juvenile birds are more frequently harvested than adults, so a good bird season really depends on good brood survival AFTER the lek.

If you ever get a chance to observe a lek, arrive at least 45 minutes before sunrise, be a good distance away and remain in your vehicle if possible, stay quiet and avoid disrupting the lek at all costs. If the party gets busted, it could significantly set back breeding opportunity.

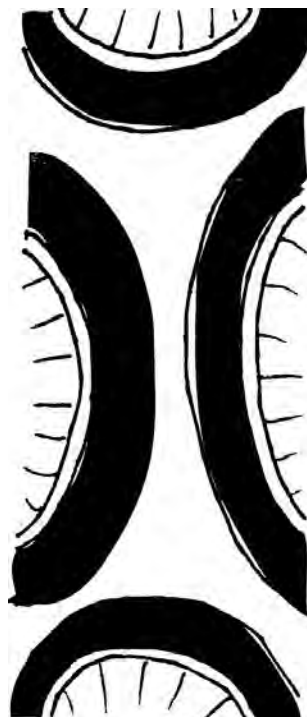

Cooney Comeback: State Park Reservoir Repairs to be Completed Spring '26

— Montana Fish, Wildlife, & Parks —

BILLINGS, Montana — June 2022 will long be remembered for catastrophic flooding on the Yellowstone River and its tributaries. Many communities in southern Montana suffered significant damage, and several continue to repair infrastructure.

When such disasters strike, Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks strives to safely maintain access at its sites. Occasionally, this requires major construction. At Cooney State Park south of Billings, sustained high water and destructive wave action from the flood caused severe erosion and washouts at multiple sites along the shoreline, limiting access to the park's abundant recreational resources.

This spring, FWP will complete a shoreline restoration project to preserve the park's infrastructure and ensure quality, safe experiences for current and future park visitors. Visitors can still enjoy all Cooney has to offer during the construction, which is scheduled to run from April 6 to May 13, but visitors should expect increased equipment and truck traffic.

"No one likes construction traffic and noise, especially when trying to relax at the lake," said Ryder Pagen, Region 5 recreation manager. "However, sometimes a project of this nature and scope is necessary to maintain and protect our sites."

Created in 1937, Cooney is a 733-acre irrigation reservoir that sits on Red Lodge Creek, a tributary of Rock Creek. Although the primary purpose of the reservoir's stored water is irrigation, Cooney boasts abundant recreational opportunities. The area

became a state park in 1969 and, today, consistently ranks among one of the busiest in Montana.

In 2024, 186,672 visitors came through Cooney State Park. Visitors to the park enjoy a variety of recreational opportunities, most notably walleye and rainbow trout fishing, boating and camping. Currently, the park manages and maintains 82 campsites, three boat ramps, several day-use areas with vault latrines, a comfort station and a fish-cleaning station. Facilities are typically full every weekend between Memorial Day and Labor Day.

Since the 2022 flood, erosion and damage has accelerated along Cooney's shoreline, encroaching on the park's infrastructure and at times limiting recreational opportunities at this popular park. Due to the soil composition of the area and significant wave energy during high winds, Cooney's shores are especially susceptible to erosion.

The construction project this spring will re-establish and stabilize eroded shoreline at Marshall Cove and Red Lodge campgrounds and along Lake Shore Road near Fisherman's Point Campground. Rock riprap and gravel will be used to maintain and protect the campgrounds and county road, improve environmental conditions at the lake and plan for future flood control. In Marshall Cove Campground, there will be additional construction to raise the height of the shoreline road and boat ramp and a new access road into the day-use area will also be constructed.

Construction will take place when the water level in the reservoir is low to allow crew access to the project sites without causing significant water turbidity. Restrictions will be in place at 17 campsites within Marshall Cove and Red Lodge campgrounds, and the Marshall Cove boat ramp will be closed for the duration of the project. Otherwise, the park will remain open to visitors and all use.



Lebanese Green Beans Stewed with Tomatoes and Garlic
Recipe courtesy of Jeanette Chawki and the League of Kitchens on behalf of Finish

Servings: 4-6

- 2 pounds string beans or flat green beans
- 1/8 pound garlic (about 18 medium cloves)
- 7 1/2 cups water, divided
- 1 1/4 pounds plum tomatoes (about 5)
- 1 tablespoon sweet red pepper paste
- 1 1/2 teaspoons tomato paste
- 1/2 teaspoon white sugar
- 1/2-1 teaspoon crushed Aleppo pepper flakes
- 1/2 cup extra-virgin olive oil
- 1 tablespoon kosher salt, or to taste
- 1 large white or yellow onion, for serving

thin pita, lavash or another flatbread, for serving (optional)

1. Trim ends of string beans or flat green beans. Put beans in bowl. Use hands to break beans into 2-3 pieces about 1 1/2 inches long.
2. Peel garlic. Trim rough or damaged root ends and cut large cloves in half lengthwise.
3. In medium saucepan, bring 6 cups water to boil. Once boiling, carefully add plum tomatoes and cook just until skins begin to break, 4-5 minutes. Turn off heat and drain. When tomatoes are cool enough to handle, remove and discard skin.
4. Cut tomatoes into rough 1/2-inch chunks, removing any white or green parts near stem. Put tomato chunks in bowl. In separate small bowl, stir sweet red pepper paste, tomato paste, white sugar, crushed Aleppo pepper flakes and 1/2 cup water until paste is dissolved into liquid; set aside.
5. In large wok or skillet with deep sides over high heat, heat extra-virgin olive oil.
6. Add garlic and fry, shaking pot occasionally, until cloves lightly brown, about 90 seconds. Add green beans and stir with wooden spoon. Turn heat to medium-low and stir in kosher salt. Add 1 cup water and stir. Raise heat to high to bring water back to simmer then lower to medium-low. Cover and cook, stirring occasionally, just until beans are cooked through, about 20 minutes.
7. Stir in tomatoes and pepper paste mixture, increase heat to high and cook until liquid boils. Cover pot, keeping lid slightly ajar, reduce heat to medium-low and cook until tomatoes are soft, sauce has thickened slightly and garlic is tender, about 20 minutes. Taste for salt and add if needed. Keep warm until ready to serve.
8. Put down clean dish towel and place onion on top. Smash onion with heavy cutting board 2-5 times then peel it.
9. Squeeze whole onion over sink between hands to remove some juices. Wash onion under cold running water, squeeze it between hands again then pull it apart into pieces, removing roots and any stem, and put it on small serving plate.
10. If using pita, separate circles into two thin pieces. Bake or toast thin pita, lavash or other flatbread until crispy or blackened in spots. For sandwiches, warm bread.
11. Serve stewed green beans and raw onion with pita, lavash or other flatbread, either open-faced or rolled into sandwich.
