Remembering Evelyn Seyforth

It happens to me every Easter season and usually starts when the weather finally changes from the never-ending winter to the first signs of spring. I'm taken back to a time and place of my younger days when Post Falls was a city of fewer than 2000 people, and you knew everyone you met on the street. There was a small grocery store on Spokane Street on the right side of the tracks that was owned and managed for over 50 years by the "Saint of the City". Her name was Evelyn Seyforth, and at this time of year, you could always count on hearing Christian music blaring from the store's outdoor speakers.

As a young child, I always stopped in to say hi on my way from school; there were no buses for kids in town in those days. Evelyn was always there to visit or give advice. You see, she was the conscience of the community and always had an opinion on what was going on. This was the woman who every Sunday drove all over town picking up kids and hauling them to Sunday school. If you told her on Friday you were going, and when she came by on Sunday, you had changed your mind to go fishing, you dreaded facing her after school next week.

I would visit her at home on occasion, and she would talk me into watching Billy Graham with her, not what an 11-year-old kid was very interested in.

As I grew older, I continued to stop in and see her at the store, staying friends with her until her passing some years ago. At her service, the Pastor pointed to her casket and said this:

"If you knew Evelyn, you know she's not in there".

It's been a long time now since Evelyn sold Seyforth Grocery and Lockers, but the building remains, occupied by another mini mart type store.

As I drive by now, I recall how she refused to sell beer and wine for over 50 years, even though she could have doubled her income, and never opened on Sunday for obvious reasons. I strain to listen to see if I can hear "The Old Rugged Cross" blaring from the speakers.

Fresno Reservoir Informational Public Meeting Being Held In Havre

— Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks —

The open house will be held April 9 at the Best Western on the hill

HAVRE— Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks will host an open house and present information on the Fresno fishery in Havre on April 9, starting at 6 p.m., at the Best Western Plus Inn and Suites "on the hill" at 1425 Highway 2 NW in Havre.

Havre-area FWP fisheries biologist Cody Nagel and Bureau of Reclamation (BOR) staff will provide updates, including:

- FWP reviewing the 10-year fisheries management plan and the status of the Fresno fishery, including a review of the 2025 netting results and other projects.
- BOR providing Milk River Project updates and 2026 water forecasts on the Milk River and Fresno Reservoir.

Fresno Reservoir annually ranks as a top 5 most popular fishing destination in Northeast Montana and records more than 12,350 angler days annually. Fresno also generates approximately \$1 million in angling related revenue annually.

The public is encouraged to attend to learn more about the Fresno fishery and get an update on the 10-year (2022-2031) management plan. To review the Fresno fisheries management plan, go here: <https://fwp.mt.gov/conservation/fisheries-management/fresno-reservoir> Hardcopies of the plan are available at the Glasgow and Havre FWP offices. 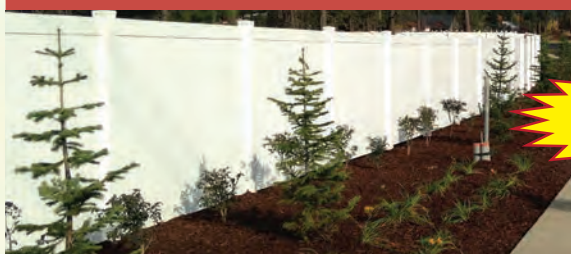

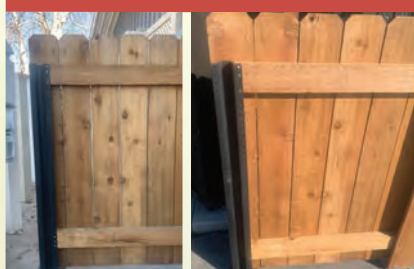

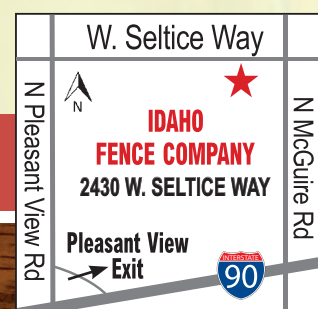

Edible Bird Nests Imitate Nature

Make simple no-bake bird's nest treats with your kids to celebrate spring! Drop jelly beans or natural-looking candy eggs in each one and tuck them in Easter baskets, or set them at each table setting for Easter Sunday dinner. Either way, these nests that imitate nature are adorable to look at, and since they taste so good with the chocolate-peanut-butter combo, they'll be an Easter "tweet" for all!

BIRD'S NEST TREATS

Makes 18 small nests

- 1 cup semisweet chocolate chips or butterscotch chips
- 1/2 cup creamy or crunchy peanut butter (I used Smucker's Natural Peanut Butter)
- 1 tablespoon butter
- 2 1/2 cups plain crushed natural shredded wheat cereal (young kids like the job of crushing it in their hands)
- 1/2 cup chopped nuts such as almonds and pecans (optional)
- Jelly beans, peanut M&M's, or candy that resembles speckled bird eggs

Here's the fun!

Stir together the crushed shredded wheat and chopped nuts in a large mixing bowl. An adult should melt the chips, peanut butter and butter in a double boiler or heavy saucepan to a smooth consistency, stirring frequently.

Pour the mixture over the shredded wheat cereal mixture and stir lightly until well-coated. Drop 2 tablespoons of the "nest" ingredients in muffin-pan cups that are lined with aluminum foil. Let your child shape the mini nests by making an indentation using their clean fingers or the back of a spoon. Chill to set.

Carefully peel off the foil and arrange molded nests on plates, or set in baskets. Set jelly beans and speckled egg candies in the nests. Keep extra nests refrigerated until ready to serve.

Suit your tastes: Instead of candies, fill the nests with "fruity" bird eggs. Try red or green grapes, blueberries, or melon balls.

Spring Turkey Hunting Season Opens April 15th

Non-residents must wait 10 days to hunt public or access program land

— Montana FWP —

HELENA – Montana's spring male turkey season opens April 15th. Turkey hunters can purchase a turkey license for a general area at FWP offices, a License Ambassador location or online at ols.fwp.mt.gov.

A new regulation requires nonresident hunters on public lands and privately owned lands that are a part of a hunting access program to wait 10 days later than residents for all upland game bird species except mountain grouse.

Regulations are available at FWP offices, license providers and online at fwp.mt.gov.

When transporting a spring turkey in the state on Montana, hunters must keep one leg and foot naturally attached for evidence of sex. Montana law requires landowner permission for hunting on all private land.

All Upland Game Bird Enhancement Program enrollments are currently closed and only open during the fall hunting season. Similarly, most Block Management Areas are also closed, but some open for spring turkey opportunities. No shed hunting, hiking or other recreational activities are allowed on these properties without landowner permission. Be sure to check the FWP website for the dates and locations these properties open.

FWP Seeking Public Input on Recommendations from the Fish Creek Collaborative Trail Planning Effort

— Montana Fish & Wildlife —

MISSOULA – Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks is seeking public review and input on recommendations from the Fish Creek Collaborative (FCC) citizen advisory group and its trail planning effort. The group worked on ideas for a multi-use trail system in western Montana's Fish Creek Complex in the fall of 2025 and released its draft recommendations this week.

The goal of the FCC was to develop trail recommendations that would enhance recreational access for a variety of users while protecting natural resources and ensuring a high-quality visitor experience. Review the group's work and draft recommendations, and provide comment through April 17th, 2026 at fwp.mt.gov/conservation/fish-creek-watershed-recreation-planning.

Citizen group members were selected through an application process in the summer of 2025 to represent a diversity of recreation perspectives, experiences, and geographic areas. The group held two

planning workshops in the fall of 2025 to discuss trail development, management, and conservation priorities across the Fish Creek Complex. The planning area includes Fish Creek State Park and Wildlife Management Area and considers other surrounding lands.

FCC worked collaboratively to develop recommendations for a sustainable, site-level trail plan. Their work represents a step towards implementation of FWP's broader Fish Creek Recreation Strategy, which was finalized in September 2024 following two years of public engagement.

The FCC served an advisory role to FWP, and its recommendations are intended to inform potential next steps. The FCC's recommendations were written by the citizen committee, not by FWP, and the package released for public comment reflects their unedited input. The recommendations provide general guidance for the agency but do not provide final approval of any specific projects, which would require additional planning, funding decisions, and environmental review as applicable.

After the comment period closes on April 17th, FWP will review and summarize the public comments received on the FCC recommendations. The input will help inform FWP's internal review and consideration of next steps. Any additional information and next steps will be updated online at fwp.mt.gov/conservation/fish-creek-watershed-recreation-planning.



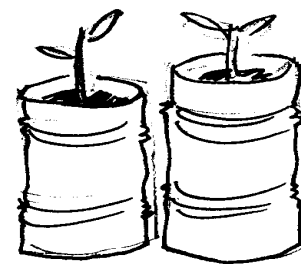

Each year on April 10th, National Farm Animals Day focuses attention on the humane care of farm animals. The day also aims to find homes for abandoned and abused farm animals.

#NationalFarmAnimalsDay

A variety of animals have been domesticated and raised on farms for food. They provide eggs, milk, cheese, meat, wool, leather, and other products. Most farmers raise their livestock responsibly. Providing a quality environment for them to grow benefits the animal and the farmer, too. Farmers invest in their livestock from the time they're born, providing nutritious food, and ensuring robust and healthy development. They also provide ideal conditions for their breed. Farmers are continually educating themselves about the livestock they raise so they can provide them with the best care possible.

However, some people do abuse and neglect their animals. When poor conditions are discovered, and animals are malnourished, it's essential to report the case to a veterinarian for review.

Q. What is a good way to expose children to farm animals?

A. Most of us grow up in the city or suburbs, but that doesn't mean you can't learn more about the animals who live on a farm. Some great ways to expose children to farm animals include:

- Many zoos include a farm display that includes animals like sheep, goats, pigs, cows, chickens, and ducks.
- Visit a petting zoo. These smaller zoos are home to domesticated animals found on a farm. They often serve as a rescue service, too.
- Visit a hobby farm. Many hobby farms host times for school-age children to visit their animals in residence. They learn what they eat, where they sleep, and how the farmers care for them.
- Tour a working farm. Many farmers offer opportunities for school-age children to visit and learn more about farming.
- Attend a fair. Each year, counties and states host events like 4-H Fairs for farmers and farmer children to showcase their hard work.

Q. What kinds of animals are found on farms?

A. Every farm is different and raises different breeds of animals. Some of the animals found on a farm include: chickens, sheep, goats, cattle, horses, donkeys, rabbits, emus, buffalo, pigs, alpacas, turkeys, fish, ducks, and geese

National Living Donor Day April 11th

— National Day Calendar —

National Living Donor Day on April 11th celebrates and honors the brave people who step up and save lives by donating their living organs and tissue to heal those in need.

According to organdonor.gov, there are over 104,000 people in the United States on the national transplant waiting list. National Living Donor Day presents an opportunity to educate and encourage people to consider saving a life through living organ or tissue donation.

April is already recognized as National Donate Life Awareness Month. While the monthly celebration generates a positive impact on saving lives, the focus tends to encourage individuals to sign up with the deceased donor registry to donate upon death. However, there is a significant opportunity to complement these initiatives by designating a specific day during the month of April that focuses on raising awareness of living organ donation. By bringing awareness to National Living Donor Day, we can demonstrate the importance of living donors by saving as many lives as possible by using living donor transplants.

What Is Living Organ Donation?

A living organ donation is a medical procedure that removes a healthy organ, portion of an organ, or tissue from a living person. The organ is then transplanted into another person whose organ is no longer working properly. Living organ donation allows the recipient to live a longer and healthier life. In addition, the donor contributes to the life of another to continue their own personal journey.

Finding an organ donor can be a difficult process for many. Organ donation does not discriminate and those in need of a donation include people of every age, race, and gender. In fact, the demographic is so diverse, no specific category fits one person. Some people may wait for years for a deceased donor. However, living donors can alleviate and often eliminate the stress of waiting or wondering if an organ donation will happen before it's too late.

Anyone can sign up to be a donor. Medical tests can help determine which recipient would benefit from your donation. Oftentimes, people misunderstand who qualifies to become an organ donor. An organ donor can be:

- Anyone between the ages of 18 - 60 years of age at most transplant centers.
- A parent, sibling or adult child.
- Other relatives, such as an uncle, aunt, or cousin.
- A biologically unrelated person who knows the recipient, such as a friend, co-worker, significant other, or spouse of a friend.
- Anyone who knows the recipient's need for the organ.
- A good Samaritan living donor simply decides to donate because they are a match to a stranger who is in need of an organ.

Many people wonder what makes for a good living donor candidate. Generally speaking, a good candidate is someone who has been mentally and physically healthy throughout their life. However, there are other factors that go into deciding if you should become a living donor. Ultimately, the decision is up to you. Some living donors want to be a part of something meaningful, while others have a personal interest in why they choose to be living donors. Whether the living donor chooses to help for charitable reasons or because they believe in a specific organization, living donors save lives.

The 4-1-1 of Living Donors

In 2022, there were 5,863 living donor kidney transplants comprising approximately 23% of kidney transplants in the U.S. In addition, there were 603 living donor liver transplants comprising approximately 6% of liver transplants in the U.S. By increasing the number of living organ donors, the transplant wait list has the potential to be eliminated, ensuring that no one dies while waiting for the availability of a deceased organ.

The most common type of living donation is kidney donation, where a donor donates one of their kidneys to a recipient. The second most common is liver donation, where a donor donates a portion of their liver to a recipient.

A major area of opportunity with living organ donation awareness is to educate the general public on the magical capability of the human liver. A significant amount of people in the U.S. are unaware that the liver is the only human organ that can regenerate. Not only does it regenerate in the donor to full size, but it also regenerates to full size in the recipient. Proof that combining the innate capabilities of the human body with innovative ideas from the human mind can result in modern medical miracles.

For most living donors, the cost of testing, transplant surgery and follow-up care is covered by the recipient's health care insurance.

Ways to Support National Living Donor Day

- Visit with your physician to begin the steps to becoming a living donor.
- Support organizations that help find matches for those on the national donor list.
- Help out a family who is recovering from a donor surgery.
- Hold a fundraiser to alleviate costs for a living donor or recipient of a donor surgery.
- Learn about the different types of organs and tissue a living donor can give.
- Honor and support the transplant medical professionals and health systems that make living organ donation possible.
- Share your story about becoming a living donor or receiving an organ donation on social media using #NationalLivingDonorDay.

A Living Testament

In 2023, the Living Liver Foundation and National Day Calendar formed a working collaboration to celebrate National Living Donor Day on April 11 each year. The day celebrates and honors the brave people who step up and save lives by donating their living organs and tissue to heal those in need. Dave and Lynn Galbenski, founders of the Living Liver Foundation, are asking for our help to spread the word and encourage living donor transplants. We share their goal to save the lives of up to 17 people per day that might otherwise die while on the transplant list.

The Story Behind National Living Donor Day

On November 25, 2019, Dave Galbenski underwent a successful living donor liver transplant at Henry Ford Hospital in Detroit, Michigan. Thanks to the courage, compassion, and generosity of his brother-in-law, Mark Dybis, who stepped forward to become his living liver donor. From that moment, Dave made a commitment to use his time, talents, and energy to promote living donor awareness to pay this tremendous gift of life forward.

In 2020, Dave and Mark began to publicly tell their story to raise awareness of the impact of living organ donation. By providing key information and resources about living organ donation, Dave and Mark are inspiring others to potentially consider becoming a living donor.

Over 25,000 Catchable Rainbow Trout Headed For Lakes In The Panhandle Region In April

Spring and fishing go hand-in-hand

Warm weather is here and so are the rainbow trout! Over 25,000 catchable-size (10 to 12 inch) rainbow trout will be stocked in the Panhandle Region in April.

Stocking of all waters is tentative and dependent on river/lake/pond conditions (angler safety concerns); dates may change due to weather or staffing constraints.

For maps of these fishing locations and other angling destinations in Idaho please visit the Idaho Fish Planner at idfg.idaho.gov/ifwis/fishingplanner.

Many of the waters highlighted below are easy to

access, family-friendly fishing destinations. All you need to get started is a fishing license and some basic tackle. Annual adult fishing licenses cost around \$30, junior licenses (ages 14-17) cost \$16, and youth under 14 fish for free.

Fishing for stocked rainbow trout, particularly in community ponds, is a great way to introduce new anglers to the sport by using simple (and relatively thrifty) set-ups like worm/marshmallow combinations or commercial baits like Power Bait or Crave, either near the bottom or below a bobber. The Learn to Fish webpage (idfg.idaho.gov/fish/basics) offers diagrams for basic bait rigs.

Most Idaho waters are open to fishing year-round, but some may have slightly different rules. Be sure to pick up a 2025-27 Idaho Fishing Seasons and Rules booklet, which outlines season dates, special regulations and bag limits at any Idaho Fish and Game offices or most sporting goods stores statewide, or you can see it online at idfg.idaho.gov/sites/default/files/seasons-rules-fish-2025-2027.pdf.

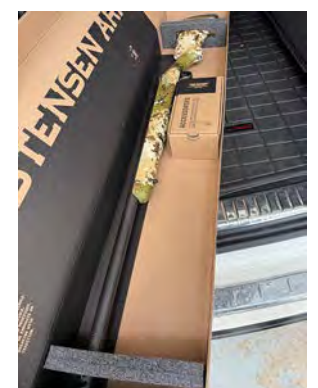

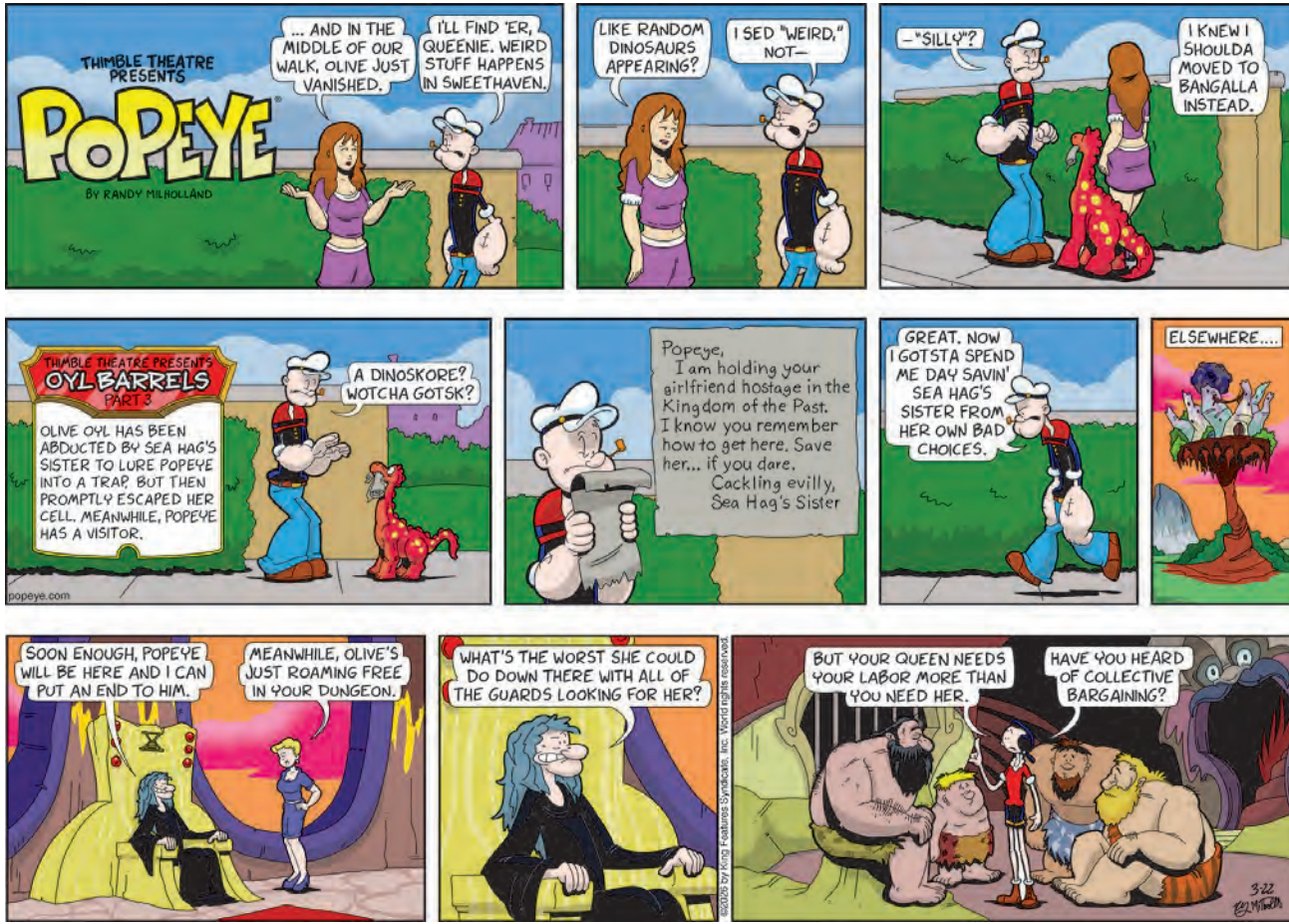
