THE HISTORY CHANNEL

- **On April 15, 1945,** British troops liberated the German Bergen-Belsen concentration camp, where they discovered thousands of dead and rotting corpses, and many more thousands of sick and starving prisoners confined to severely overcrowded and dirty compounds. The prisoners were suffering from acute typhus, typhoid and tuberculosis due to a lack of running water. More than 30,000 others had died in the previous months, many from typhus, but even more from starvation.
- **On April 16, 1964,** The Rolling Stones' debut album, "The Rolling Stones," issued in the U.S. as "England's Newest Hit Makers," was released. The band consisted of lead singer Mick Jagger, rhythm guitarist Brian Jones, lead guitarist Keith Richards, bassist Bill Wyman and drummer Charlie Watts.
- **On April 17, 1985,** the U.S. government announced a campaign to increase organ donation awareness with the hope of making the procedure as widespread as donating blood, following similar campaigns from other countries around the world as organ transplants became more common.
- **On April 18, 1997,** major floods in Grand Forks, N.D., caused by the Red River's breaching a dike, necessitated the evacuation of 50,000 residents from their homes. In some areas, only the roofs of their houses were visible.
- **On April 19, 1897,** the world's oldest annual marathon run took place for the first time. Today the Boston Marathon ranks among the world's most prestigious road racing events, with an average of 20,000 participants, and is one of five members of the World Marathon Majors, which also include the cities of London, Berlin, Chicago and New York.
- **On April 20, 2008,** Pope Benedict XVI visited Ground Zero in New York, the scene of the Sept. 11, 2001, attacks on the city's Twin Towers, at the end of his six-day tour of America. He greeted survivors, fire and police workers, and relatives of some of the 2,749 people who died at the scene, and prayed for the rescuers and victims, as well as "those whose hearts and minds are consumed with hatred," before celebrating Mass at New York's Yankee stadium.
- **On April 21, 1918,** Baron Manfred von Richthofen, the German ace pilot popularly known as the "Red Baron" and credited with 80 confirmed air combat victories, was killed in action during World War I.

FWP Reminder: Be Bear Aware When Recreating Outdoors

— Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks —



Remove or secure food attractants and keep a clean campsite

HELENA – As spring weather approaches, we're all anxious to head outdoors, and bears are leaving their winter dens. This time of year, bears are waking up from hibernation and are pretty hungry. So, it's best for you, and for the bears, not to leave out anything that will attract their appetite or their curiosity.

If you're outside working or recreating, you need to be aware that bears are out there, too. Anytime bears are not in hibernation, which is typically between the beginning of March and the end of November, is the time to be bear aware, according to Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks Wildlife information Specialist Danielle Oyler.

"Being bear aware means that you assume bears can be around, even if you don't see them," Oyler said. "You shouldn't leave anything around your home or campsite that will attract a bear."

These attractants include garbage, bird feeders and pet food. The most common human-bear conflicts involve unsecured food attractants.

Bears can be found throughout Montana. In recent years, grizzly bear populations have expanded and can be found anywhere west of Billings, Oyler said.

"Most bears want to avoid contact with people," Oyler said. "But the best thing to do to avoid an unpleasant encounter with a bear is to assume bears are around and be prepared."

This includes carrying bear spray and knowing how to use it. Oyler said to deploy the spray when the bear is about 25 feet away.

"If you feel threatened, stand your ground and use your bear spray," she said.

Visit fwp.mt.gov/bear-aware for login information and for more information on being bear aware.

Here are some general tips to stay bear aware:

- Travel in groups whenever possible and plan to be out in the daylight hours.
- Avoid carcass sites and concentrations of ravens and other scavengers.
- Watch for signs of bears such as bear scat, diggings, torn-up logs and turned over rocks, and partly consumed animal carcasses.
- Make noise, especially near streams or in thick

forest where hearing and visibility is impaired. This can be the key to avoiding encounters. Most bears will avoid humans when they know humans are present.

- Don't approach a bear.

Camping in bear country:

- Keep food and anything with a scent out of tents.
- Dispose of garbage in bear-resistant containers; otherwise, take it with you and dispose of it properly elsewhere. Do not bury or burn garbage.
- Properly store unattended food and anything else with a scent. Food storage options are:
 - Bear boxes
 - Hard-sided vehicles (car, truck, RV). Avoid leaving attractants in vehicles for extended periods of time (backcountry trips)
 - Certified bear-resistant containers
 - Electric fencing

Fishing in bear country:

- Make noise when approaching streams or rivers where visibility is poor and/or rushing water makes it difficult for bears to hear you approaching.
- Carry bear spray on you, especially if you are wading or shore fishing.
- When possible, clean fish at a designated fish-cleaning station, or at home.
- If you live in bear country, place entrails and fish waste into the freezer until the morning of garbage day. Do not leave fish waste outside in garbage cans for multiple days, as bears will be attracted to the smell.
- Cut filleted fish carcasses into smaller pieces that can be easily carried away in the current.
- Toss all fish waste into deep, fast-moving currents. Do not leave entrails or other fish waste on the bank or in shallow water.
- Store fish on ice in a certified bear-proof container. Coolers are not bear proof. If you use a cooler, keep it near you and closely attend it.

Biking and running in bear country:

- Anyone traveling quickly on trails is at higher risk of surprising a bear.
- Traveling fast around corners can increase the chance of an encounter.
- Watch for signs of bear activity and avoid riding in these areas.
- Avoid being on trails at night or at dusk or dawn.
- Avoid riding fast on trails that feature seasonal food sources for bears, such as berries.
- Do not run or ride while intentionally impacting your ability to hear natural noises (i.e. wearing ear buds or headphones).
- Make noise when line of sight is poor.
- When possible, ride in groups and stay together.
- If you encounter a bear, stop, get off your bike, and follow bear encounter recommendations.
- Never try to outrun or outride a bear.
- Carry bear spray on your person not on your bicycle or backpack.

F&G Director Responds To Legal Decision Regarding Wolf Trapping And Grizzly Bears

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game —



Decision will affect wolf trapping by public trappers in some parts of the state

A March 19, 2024 federal court decision will change wolf trapping seasons in some regions of Idaho based on their alleged potential effect on grizzly bears.

"We're very disappointed in this decision," Fish and Game Director Jim Fredericks said. "While wolf trapping seasons will change to comply with the order, we're considering our legal options to reverse a decision we believe is wrong based on the law and on-the-ground reality."

The ruling perpetuates misunderstandings about wolves, grizzly bears and trapping in Idaho, Fredericks added.

"Idaho has had wolf trapping seasons for over 10 years. We've proceeded cautiously regarding expansion of wolf seasons over the years, including protections for our grizzly bear populations," he said. "There's no evidence of a grizzly bear injured, or even caught, in a legally set trap during our wolf trapping seasons."

Prior to this decision, Fish and Game wolf trapping seasons varied across the state, based on public and private lands, potential conflict with other land users, and wolf conflicts with livestock and people.

All wolf trapping seasons allow foothold trapping, which are nonlethal traps, designed to allow a trapper to release animals they do not want to keep, or cannot legally keep. Snaring wolves is more restricted, and it is not allowed in areas that grizzlies inhabit except during winter when bears hibernate.

Fredericks added that not only does the lawsuit and decision undermine support for the Endangered Species Act, it's also counterproductive to the grizzly bear conservation that Idaho and neighboring states have done to sustain and increase grizzly populations.

"For over 40 years, local and state governments, collaborative conservation organizations, landowners, local communities, outdoor recreationists, and others have worked together to build social tolerance for grizzly bears in Idaho," Fredericks said. "That includes campaigns on how to live and recreate in grizzly bear habitat. Instead of supporting or recognizing those remarkably successful efforts, this decision calls our efforts into question."

The decision also casts doubt on further expansion of grizzly populations through reintroductions currently being proposed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service.

"For anyone who's questioned why many Idahoans are very concerned about the potential expansion of grizzly bear range in Idaho, I would say look no further," Fredericks said. "Without hard evidence, the decision punishes our successful grizzly bear conservation efforts. The decision also restricts recreational opportunities and limits state wildlife management based on a notion of grizzly bear habitat, including outside of occupied ESA recovery areas and resident grizzly bear populations."

While the decision restricts how Fish and Game manages wolf trapping seasons, it does not affect other state management authorities to address wolf predation on livestock and backcountry elk herds and other objectives identified in Fish and Game's Gray Wolf Management Plan.

National Go For Broke Day April 5th

— National Day Calendar —



National Go For Broke Day on April 5th encourages us to give it our all. No matter our goal, there's a reason to persevere despite all the odds.

The phrase "Go for broke" has roots in Hawaiian Pidgin, meaning "wager everything."

Our strongest research points to the 442nd Regimental Combat Team of the United States Army as the reason for this day. The 442nd RCT was a regimental size fighting unit composed mainly of American soldiers of Japanese descent. They selflessly volunteered to fight in World War II. The 442nd RCT is considered to be the most decorated infantry regiment in the history of the United States Army. "Go for Broke" was the 442nd Regimental Combat Team motto.

The story doesn't end there, though, and the date of April 5th is significant. On that day, the first Medal of Honor recipient from this regiment died in action near Seravazza, Italy, 1945.

Private First Class Sadao Munemori sacrificed his life for the men in his unit when they were pinned down by enemy fire near Seravazza, Italy. The unit continued in battle near Serravezza, Carrara, and Fosdinovo, Italy, until April 14, 1945. As a result of their actions, they received the Presidential Unit Citation for outstanding accomplishments in combat.

The unit would earn seven more Presidential Unit Citations during their service.

Not only were they the most decorated unit for their size and length of service, but they were also awarded 21 Medals of Honor. The 442nd Regimental Combat Team also earned 52 Distinguished Service Crosses, 1 Distinguished Service Medal, 560 Silver Stars, 22 Legion of Merit Medals, 15 Soldier's Medals, 4,000 Bronze Stars, and 486 Purple Hearts.

Go for Broke Day truly signifies giving it your all regardless of the obstacles ahead.

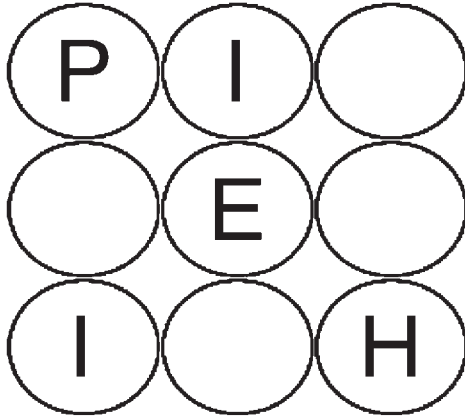

Updated: F&G Commission Approves Cuts To Antlerless Deer And Antelope Hunts To Help Herds Recover

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game —



The Idaho Fish and Game Commission originally cut deer and pronghorn controlled hunt tags in May 2023 due to winter severity in the Southeast and Upper Snake Regions.

Fish and Game Commissioners in March approved the following changes to deer and pronghorn hunts for 2024. Many of these hunts were also altered in 2023 to help mule deer and pronghorn recover after the harsh 2023-24 winter.

These changes will be reflected in the 2024 Big Game Seasons and Rules booklet:
