Our History

— from St. Maries Chamber of Commerce —

St. Maries dates back more than a hundred years, when the first pioneers looking for logging opportunities traveled up the St. Joe River from Coeur d'Alene. At the junction of the St. Maries and St. Joseph rivers, Joseph Fisher decided that was a prime place for a sawmill because of good transportation and lots of timber. St. Maries quickly became a hard-working lumberjack town, and was also renowned for the paddle wheelers that ferried people and supplies to Coeur d'Alene. St. Maries has long been a transportation hub for the St. Joe River Valley dating back to 1880 when steamboats provided the principal means of getting to and from the town.

After the turn of the century, the city became incorporated, two larger mills were built, and the steamboats which plied the St. Joe river and Coeur d'Alene Lake provided cheap, rapid transportation. The coming of the railroads, plus the opening of the Coeur d'Alene Indian Reservation to homesteading, provided stimuli for further growth in the first decade and a half.

World War I increased the demand on the lumber industry. In spite of the tremendous loss of timber in the Fire of 1910, there were still plenty of virgin stands to meet the demands of sawmills. The Great Depression was a severe blow to the area. Sawmills shut down and there was very little work in the woods. In the late 1930's, just before the last large mill in the area was about to be auctioned off, the people of St. Maries rallied to help provide the capital to save the mill and open it again as the St. Maries Lumber Company. World War II years were all-out production years and the decade following saw the demand for lumber continuing into the late 1950's.

The recessions of the 50's put the local economy on a roller coaster until 1961 when the St. Maries Lumber Company, the largest employer and biggest mill in the area, burned. The people rallied again and formed the Benewah County Development Corporation, which took advantage of federal assistance to get a plywood mill built on the site of the lumber mill. The plywood mill has been expanded several times and is under the ownership of Potlatch Corporation, manufacturing plywood, dimension lumber and wood chips. In addition, Regulus Stud Mill was opened in St. Maries, thus providing a market and milling for tree sizes which were previously unusable.

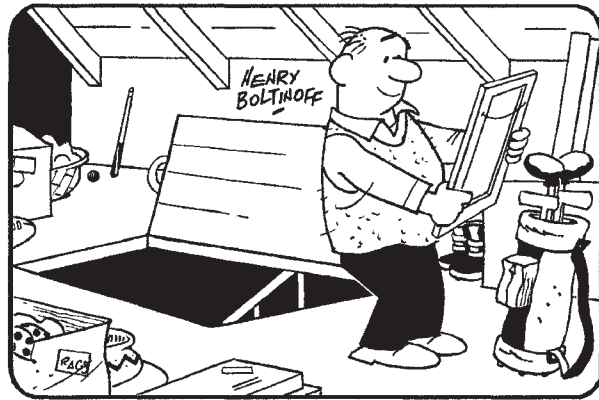

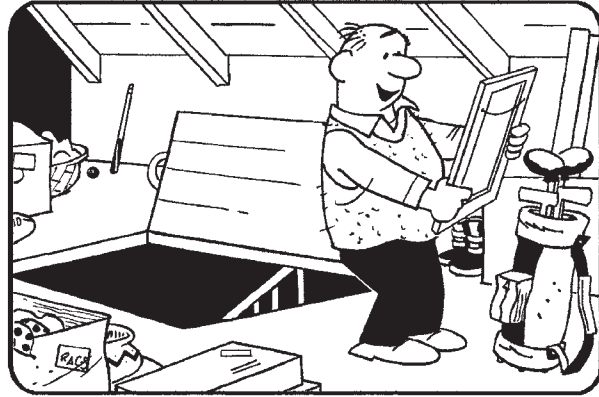



Moments in time

THE HISTORY CHANNEL

On June 22, 1611, after a winter spent trapped by ice in what is now northeastern Canada's Hudson Bay, the starving crew of the Discovery launched a mutiny against their captain, English navigator Henry Hudson, setting him, his teenage son, and seven of his supporters adrift in a small open boat. They were never seen again.

On June 23, 1956, Gamal Abdel Nasser was elected the first president of the Republic of Egypt. Nasser had overthrown the country's monarchy four years earlier, in a military coup, and was the sole candidate on the ballot. His new constitution, making Egypt a one-party socialist state with Islam as its official religion, was also almost unanimously approved by voters.

On June 24, 1374, a "dancing plague" swept through Germany, causing medieval villagers to writhe and whirl uncontrollably and leaving many people in a state of exhausted collapse in the streets or dead from heart attacks and strokes. The cause is still unknown, though ergot poisoning, mass hysteria and religious devotion have all been suggested.

On June 25, 1910, Congress passed the Mann Act, which was ostensibly intended to keep young women from being enticed into prostitution, but was more about a way to make various types of consensual sexual activity a crime.

On June 26, 1948, American and British pilots began delivering food, water, clothing, medicine and fuel by airplane to Berlin after the city was isolated by a Soviet Union blockade. Some in President Harry Truman's administration had called for a military response to the blockade, but Truman believed such an action could incite another world war.

On June 27, 1985, the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials de-certified the iconic Route 66, which in its heyday stretched about 2,400 miles over a span of eight states from Chicago, Illinois, to Santa Monica, California, and voted to remove all its highway signs.

On June 28, 2007, the bald eagle was removed from America's List of Endangered and Threatened Wildlife.

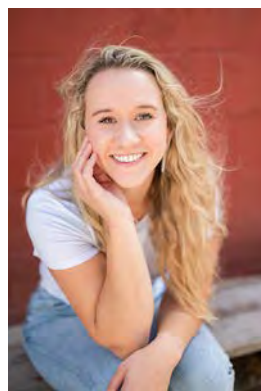

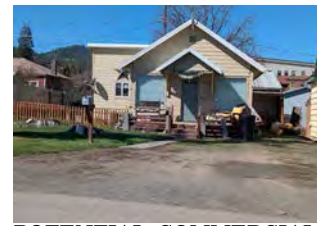

Homemade Pizza Night Starts With Simple Dough

There's something really satisfying about making pizza dough from scratch.

Maybe it's because pizza has become one of those "special occasion" meals for many families. Between delivery fees, rising restaurant prices and the mysterious extra charges that appear out of thin air, pizza night can cost nearly as much as a decent steak dinner used to. Ah, the good old days.

The good news? Pizza dough is surprisingly simple to make at home.

Flour. Water. Yeast. Olive oil. Sugar. Salt. That's it.

No stand mixer required. No dough hook. No dramatic tossing of dough over your head while opera music plays in the background. (Although I highly recommend you try that at least once.) Just one bowl, a spoon and about 10 minutes of actual hands-on effort.

The rest of the time, the yeast does the work while you go about your day being the sort of person who casually has homemade pizza dough rising on the counter.

And honestly? That feels rather fabulous.

Homemade pizza dough costs a fraction of prepared crusts or takeout, and the flavor is delicious. The crust bakes up chewy, crisp around the edges and fills the kitchen with the aroma of fresh bread.

It's also very versatile. Use it for traditional pizzas, flatbreads, calzones, breadsticks, garlic knots or individual pizzas everyone can customize.

If you've never worked with yeast before, pizza dough is a great place to start. It's surprisingly forgiving, and once you see how easy it is, you'll find yourself eyeing leftovers and thinking, "That could totally become a pizza."

EASY PIZZA DOUGH

Yield: 6-8 servings

Total Time: 1 hour 30 mins.

- 1 1/2 cups lukewarm water (about 110 degrees)
- 2 packets (1/4 ounce each) instant dry yeast
- 2 teaspoons granulated sugar
- 1/4 cup olive oil, plus more for bowl and drizzling



A simple homemade crust makes pizza night feel both affordable and special.

- 1 teaspoon coarse salt
 - 4 cups all-purpose flour, plus more for work surface
- Pour water into a large bowl. Sprinkle yeast over the top and let stand until foamy, about 5 minutes. Whisk in sugar, olive oil and salt. Stir in flour until a sticky dough forms.

Lightly oil another large bowl. Transfer dough to bowl and drizzle lightly with olive oil. Cover and let rise in a warm place until

doubled in size, about 1 hour.

Turn dough onto a lightly floured surface and knead gently two to three times. Form into a round and let rest 10 minutes.

One batch of dough makes a large round pizza, two medium pizzas, individual pizzas or can be stretched to fit a 15-by-21-inch three-quarter sheet pan.

Bake topped pizza at 475 F degrees until crust is golden and toppings are bubbly, about 12 to 15 minutes depending on thickness.

For a well-balanced large pizza, use about 1/2-2/3 cup sauce, 1 1/2 to 2 cups shredded cheese, and about 2 cups total toppings. It can be tempting to pile on every topping in sight, but a lighter hand produces a crispier crust and better flavor. Think "picture-perfect pizza" rather than "edible yard sale."

For the pizza pictured, I used about 1/2 cup sauce, 12 ounces freshly shredded mozzarella, 3 ounces salami, thinly sliced zucchini, mushrooms, red bell pepper, sweet onion and a sprinkle of Parmesan cheese. The vegetables roast and caramelize as the pizza bakes, creating plenty of flavor without requiring a mountain of toppings.

Pulling a homemade pizza from the oven is delicious, but the satisfaction of making it yourself is the real reward.

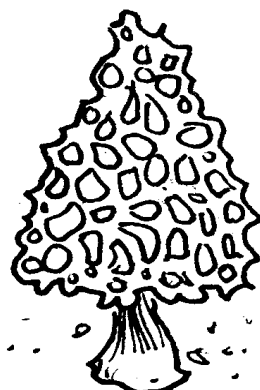

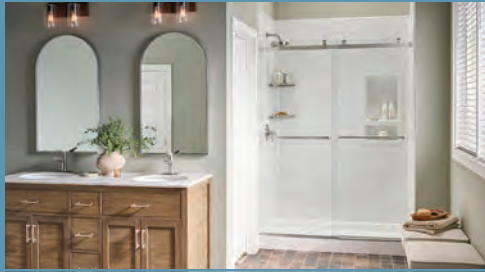

National Pop Goes The Weasel Day

June 14th

On June 14 each year, National Pop Goes the Weasel Day celebrates a nursery rhyme children have been singing for more than 300 years. On this day, people dig back into their memories to the nursery rhymes they learned as children and celebrate the day singing "Pop Goes the Weasel."

The origins of this nursery rhyme are believed to date back to the 1700s. Of course, there are many different versions of this nursery rhyme. All are fun, and especially have the same catchy tune.

The original version went as such:

Half a pound of tuppenny rice,
Half a pound of treacle.

That's the way the money goes,
Pop! goes the weasel.
Up and down the City road,
In and out the Eagle,
That's the way the money goes,
Pop! goes the weasel.

"The Eagle", in the second verse, may refer to The Eagle freehold pub, which was once at the corner of Shepherdess Walk and City Road in London. In 1825 the pub was as a music house. Then, in 1901, it was demolished and rebuilt once more into a public house. It bears a plaque with this version of "Pop Goes the Weasel," along with the history of the pub.

An alternative version:

A penny for a spool of thread,
A penny for a needle.
That's the way the money goes,
Pop! goes the weasel.

In this version, the weasel is interpreted as being a shuttle or bobbin used by silk weavers and being pawned in a similar way. Possibly as the suits or jackets owned by the Cockneys.

Jump Hour Watches

Take a moment and picture a pocket watch. Are you thinking of a hunting case watch with elaborate relief decorations and an engraved monogram? A minimalist open-faced watch with a 14K gold case? Maybe a chain and a fancy fob? One thing is safe to assume: The watch probably tells time with hands on a dial. "Jump hour" watches like the one pictured here show that isn't always the case.

The jump hour, or jumping hour, watch movement was patented in 1883 by Josef Pallweber, an Austrian engineer. This new type of mechanism included rotating discs with the numerals for the hours and minutes. Windows in the watch face reveal the appropriate numeral. Instead of the familiar hand sweeping the watch's face in one fluid movement, the hours appear to "jump" from one discrete number to the next, like today's digital timekeepers.

The jump hour mechanism was extremely complicated, so not many were made. They experienced a resurgence in the 1920s, when their sleek look and nod to advancing technology fit in with the art deco movement. Jump hour watches from any time are still rare. Unsurprisingly, they sell for high prices at auctions. This one, a Swiss watch with a gun-metal case from about 1900, had a presale estimate of \$80 to \$120 at an auction by Jeffrey S. Evans & Associates. It sold for \$960, more than surpassing expectations.

Q: I have a small china doll. Its surface is rough and not glossy. The hair is sculpted with short curls and painted blond. The face is painted with blue eyes, and socks and shoes are painted on. The arms and legs are attached with wire. The only mark is the word "Germany" on the back. How old is it, and how much is it worth?

A: Your doll is made of bisque, an unglazed porcelain. Collectors call dolls like yours "all-bisque" to distinguish them from bisque-headed dolls, which are larger, mounted on bodies made of material like wood, leather, or composition, and usually

have a maker's mark. Sometimes small dolls like yours are called "penny dolls" or "dollhouse dolls." Dolls were marked with the name of their country after 1891. All-bisque dolls were made up to the mid-20th century. Dolls like yours are usually worth about \$20 to \$30.

Unusual features, like a molded hat, or an identifiable maker can increase the value. For more information, look for books like "The Collector's Encyclopedia of Dolls" by Dorothy S., Elizabeth A., and Evelyn J. Coleman or Patricia Smith's "Album of All-Bisque Dolls" at your library, or contact a collector's club like the United Federation of Doll Clubs Inc. (ufdc.org) or a doll auction.

TIP: Vintage watches should be cleaned regularly, probably once a year.

Layer on cured meats followed by slices of brie cheese. For brie, cut off any large pieces of rind.

In small bowl, toss arugula with lemon juice and salt. Add arugula to sandwich followed by top half of baguette.

Cut baguette into four even sandwiches and eat immediately or wrap each one tightly in paper or plastic wrap.

Dust Off That Old Fishing Gear for Free Fishing Day and Beyond

— Idaho Fish and Game —



Free Fishing Day is June 13, and it's a great opportunity to be outdoors and get acquainted with Idaho's great fishing spots. Fishing is an inexpensive sport because you can get all the gear you need for about \$50 (or less). But odds are good you have some old fishing gear laying around the house, or someone in your family has some you can borrow. You can also check garage sales or second-hand stores. Even if it hasn't been used in years, it will probably still catch fish.

So dig out that old, trusty, dusty fishing gear and let's get it ready to fish.

The rod (aka fishing pole)

Does it have all the eyes intact? Great, it's probably ready to go. If it's a sectional rod, check if the sections come apart. If not, put some penetrating oil on it, such as WD-40 or Break Free. The sections should easily disassemble and reassemble. If they won't come apart, you can still fish with it, it will be just a little trickier to transport.

Next, check the reel seat. Chances are good there's already a reel on it, but check the locking ring to see if it's still functioning. If it's corroded, apply more lubricating oil, or if it has a reel that feels solidly attached, leave it alone because there's no urgent need to replace the reel so long as it's working properly.



The reel

These come in many shapes and sizes, but all reels must do two things: reel in line, and let line out. If the handle cranks freely, it will probably reel in line, so you're off to a good start. Now figure out if it will let line out. Depending on the type of reel, this is accomplished by flipping the bail on a "spinning" reel, or pushing a button on a "baitcaster."

If your reel does those things, you're probably ready to go. But there's another thing to check and that's the drag, which allows line under tension to gradually unspool in case you have a fish pulling

hard enough to break the line. Drag is important, but if you're catching smallish fish, such as panfish or trout under 12 inches, it's not critical.

The line

This is probably the most overlooked thing if you're resurrecting old fishing tackle, and what will most likely to ruin your fishing trip because it will be kinky and tangle easily. If the reel hasn't been used in a year or so, replace the line. Line is inexpensive, and you can replace the line yourself, or take the reel to a sporting goods store or tackle shop and have them do it.



Basic bait and tackle

Now we're getting to the fun stuff, and it's no exaggeration to say there are millions of things to put on the end of your line to catch a fish.

But a few pieces of basic tackle will catch nearly any fish, which includes hooks, weights (or bobbers) and bait. An earthworm will catch a huge variety of fish and is probably crawling around in your yard, but it may be easier to spend a few bucks on a dozen nightcrawlers.

Consider those items your starter kit. And if for some reason you have a working rod and reel, but no tackle, you can get all of them for about \$10 or less.

Lures

If you have a tackle box with some random-looking lures, give them a try. Even if it's grandpa's old tackle box, there's no reason that what worked then won't still work now. It helps to know what fish a particular lure was designed to attract, but a lot of lures look nothing like anything in the natural world, and they can catch a surprising number of fish species.

If you notice they have rusty hooks, or their silver, gold or bronze finishes have tarnished. You can buy replacement hooks for a fraction of what a new lure costs, so go ahead and replace them. If they're tarnished, a small piece of steel wool will brighten them.

Where to go

Now you have all you need to go fishing, and Idaho Fish and Game can help with that. Fishing is free on June 13, meaning no fishing license is required for people 14 years and older on that day. (Children 13 and younger are not required to have a fishing license in Idaho.)

Next take a look at Fish and Game's Fishing Planner, which provides information about nearly every body of water in the state that has public fishing.

The Cost of Poaching:

FWP's TIPMONT board approves more than \$48,000 in total fines

— Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks —

HELENA – Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks game wardens are wrapping up details from the 2025 hunting and fishing seasons, and while the numbers of poaching cases varied from region to region as compared to previous years, statewide FWP saw an uptick in TIPMONT reports.

TIPMONT is a program that encourages the public to report poaching crimes. Poaching includes a variety of crimes including illegal shed hunting, vandalism, littering, cultural resource theft and other resource crimes. Anyone who reports a crime could be eligible for a cash reward of up to \$1,000.

“By reporting poaching, individuals contribute to the conservation of endangered species and the overall health of natural habitats,” said FWP Operation Sergeant and TIPMONT Coordinator Brooke Shelley.

The TIPMONT Board met recently to review TIPMONT reports. This five-member board determines reward payouts to informants who provide information that results in convictions.

For 2025, the board approved the following:

- \$28,100 in reward money issued to the public
- \$48,553 in total fines for the defendants in the cases presented to the board
- 66 years loss of hunting/fishing/trapping privileges for the defendants
- 153 total charges in these cases
- \$71,010 in restitution the defendants have been ordered to pay

These numbers are significantly higher than they were for the 2024 season, when there were 83 total charges and \$37,250 in restitution. But that is partly due to the time of year of the TIPMONT board meeting, Brooke explained. For the 2024 season, the meeting was held in July when funds for the program were renewed. For 2025, the Enforcement Division was going through a recruitment process in July and, at that point, decided to hold the meeting until after the 2025 hunting season.

“If we break it down by year though, we definitely had more and bigger cases submitted for the 2025 hunting season,” Brooke said.

Region 6 – Northeast Montana

From northeast Montana, Game Warden Captain Shane Reno reports that hunting violations in the region were slightly below average this year. In particular, violations such as shooting from the road and hunting without landowner permission were down.

“This is likely due to a drop in the population of deer in the region,” Reno said. “Mule deer numbers are trending down, and whitetail experienced a bout with EHD (epizootic hemorrhagic disease) early this past fall.”

“The unlawful use of licenses is becoming a more concerning issue every year it seems especially now with nonresident license opportunities becoming more limited,” Reno said.

Wardens routinely worked on traditional residency-type cases, where ineligible nonresident hunters purchase a resident license, he said.

One case this past fall involved a hunter who shot and killed two bull elk in a limited-draw permit area. In another example, hunters who could not get over-the-counter B Licenses for whitetail deer in the area they typically hunt, purchased available licenses in another part of the state with the intention of using them in Region 6, Reno said. Citations were issued, and the deer were seized.

Region 7 – Eastern Montana

Southeast Montana Warden Captain Justin Feddes reports that the 2025 hunting season was noticeably busier than previous years, especially in areas where deer populations have started to recover.

“Word began to spread about specific areas of the Region where hunters were seeing better deer numbers. Subsequent groups of hunters then focused on these areas, especially later in the season, resulting in an uptick in violations and reports,” Feddes said.

Citations and warnings issued by Region 7 game wardens in 2025 increased considerably from the 2023 and 2024 hunting seasons with the primary violations including hunting without landowner permission and tagging issues. Less prevalent violations included the harvest of mule deer does on public land and wrong district violations related to the splitting of the Region 7 antelope district in 2024.

“The Montana Legislature and Fish and Wildlife Commission occasionally change laws and regulations related to legal chase of game animals,” Feddes added. “Game wardens primarily focus on educating hunters when these changes occur, but it is the ultimate responsibility of the hunter to know the rules and regulations before they head into the field.”

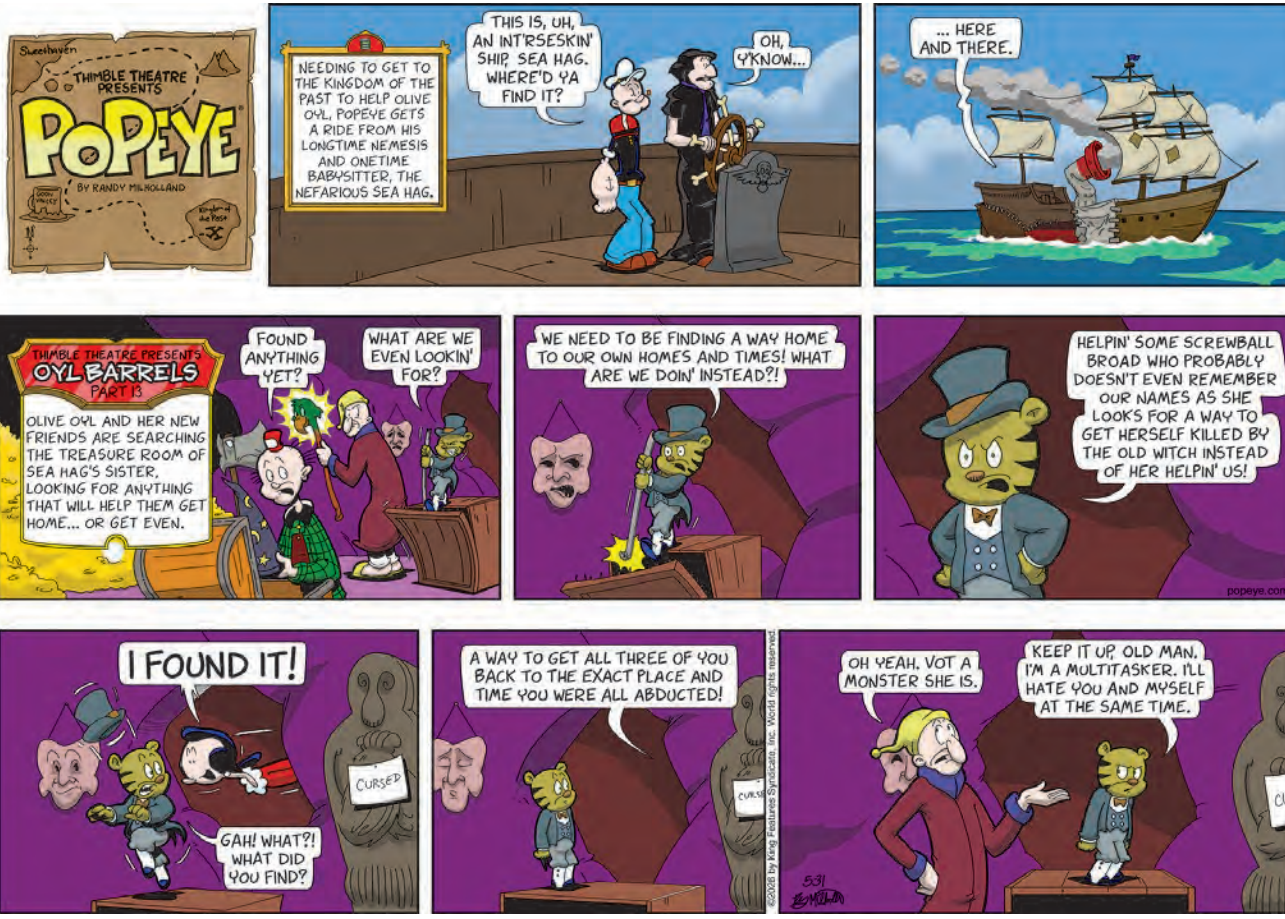
