



World Kebab Day Second Friday in July

World Kebab Day is the second Friday in July on the National Day Calendar. This delicious food holiday celebrates the origins of kebabs and how to make them.

There is a good chance you have eaten a kebab at one time or another. For those who have never had one, a kebab is basically food on a stick. The food usually consists of roasted or grilled meat. Some people add veggies to their kebabs.

This easy-to-eat delicacy most likely originated in Turkey. It's believed that soldiers used to grill chunks of freshly hunted animals on swords over open fires in the field. A Turkish script from 1377 backs up this idea. From Turkey, the kebab spread to other parts of the Middle East. Many countries around the world have since adopted their own version of the kebab.

The type of food used on a kebab depends upon location. For example, people in China make their kebabs with chunks of mutton. In Cyprus, kebabs are made with ground pork sausage. Many places in Iran use either lamb or grilled chicken on their kebabs. Common vegetables used for kebabs include grilled zucchini, mushrooms, corn, onions, and peppers. Some unusual kinds of foods people have used include ice cream, pizza, salad, pasta, and a combination of fruit and brownies. As long as the food can be put on a skewer and eaten with one hand, it is considered a kebab!





Chill Out and Get Patriotic: Homemade Ice Pops to Beat the Summer Heat

Before you dash to the grocery store, why don't we make popsicles at home? Here's a refreshing treat bursting with red, white and blue colors and fresh fruity flavors that bring relief on hot summer days.

Store bought pops are often full of sugar, artificial flavoring and dyes. How else can you get those neon colors not found in nature? While it's fun for the kiddies to stick out their electric blue tongues, we can make healthy, delicious and nutritious pops they will love.

Do-it-yourself popsicles are so easy, you can literally put any flavorful fluid you wish in a popsicle mold, freeze it and make people happy. The molds can be found online, in practically any grocery Savor the season with patriotic ice pops. store, even at dollar stores. Or you can opt for a nostalgic throwback and use craft sticks in little paper cups like back in the day. Remember ripping the paper off those chunky juicy ice pops?

Making popsicles at home can be

as healthy and virtuous or as indulgent and decadent as you wish. They don't have to be complicated; you can simply freeze fruit juice, soda or instant pudding, and the kids will love them. Make them with yogurt, fresh fruit, and roll them in granola, and they're a breakfast treat. Make them with coffee or your favorite cocktail ingredients, and they're an adult treat. And the best part, you can have an infinity of flavors, and they're still totally cheap!

The recipe I'm sharing today is meant to truly help you beat the summer's heat. We're making a very healthy, light, refreshing popsicle brimming with electrolytes. Electrolytes are minerals (which include calcium, magnesium, potassium and sodium) your body needs. Electrolytes regulate hydration, muscle and nerve function, blood pressure and your body's pH levels. Imbalances or deficiencies in electrolytes can cause everything from muscle cramps and fatigue to irregular heartbeat and seizures. When we perspire, we lose electrolytes. How fun to concoct a popsicle that helps to replace them!



We start with a coconut water base and add a simple syrup made with ginger. Coconut water rehydrates and replenishes electrolytes, especially

potassium. When choosing coconut water, look for one that's 100% juice with minimal ingredients — ideally just "coconut water." Ginger is a powerful anti-inflammatory with antioxidant properties. Next, we add watermelon and blueberries, both packed with antioxidants, vitamins and minerals.

PATRIOTIC ICE POPS

Yield: approximately 3 3/4 cups Servings: 10 (3-ounce) ice pops

2 tablespoons candied ginger, minced 1/4 cup sugar

Pinch sea salt 2 cups coconut water

1 1/2 cups watermelon, cubed

1/2 cup blueberries or blackberries In a small saucepan, bring ginger,

sugar, salt and 1/4 cup water to a boil. Let this reduce for about 5 minutes or until approximately 1/3 cup. Set aside to cool. When cooled, add the coconut water and stir. Use either a small melon baller or knife to make bite-size pieces of watermelon that will fit into your ice pop molds. Divide the watermelon pieces and berries among the popsicle molds. Fill with the coconut ginger mixture, and add your popsicle sticks. Freeze at

least 4 hours, or better, overnight. What a perfect way to end a

summer evening on the patio, feeling like a kid again. See you next week!







(eLivingtoday.com) No matter how much experience you have on the water, prepping your boat – and your passengers – before leaving the dock can make for a more enjoyable experience.

To prepare for a safe and comfortable trip, review this pre-departure checklist to ensure your vessel is in good working order and well-stocked for the adventure:

- Documentation Have all required documentation for planned activities, including boat registration, fishing permits and boater education cards readily accessible.
- Float Plan File a float plan with a responsible party who will remain on land. Provide contact info, explain where you're going, when you intend to return and what to do in case he or she doesn't hear from you.
- Weather Forecast Always check the forecast before you head out on the water. To regularly monitor any changes, keep a handheld radio onboard.
- Fuel Before leaving, check that your fuel level is adequate for the trip and that other fluids, like oil and coolant, are at the proper levels.
- Batteries Check to make sure the boat's battery, as well as battery-operated items like flashlights and handheld radios, are fully charged and operational.
- Lights Check to make sure you have properly functioning navigation and instrument lights and pack a flashlight, as well.
- Life Jackets Ensure you have at least one U.S. Coast Guard-approved personal floatation device per passenger with a minimum of two onboard. If your boat is longer than 16 feet, you'll also need a throwable device.
- Anchor Keep at least one anchor, attached to an anchor line, and at least two fenders for docking onboard.
- Bilge Before launching your boat, ensure the bilge is dry, clear of waste and has a properly functioning pump.
- Fire Extinguisher Keep a U.S. Coast Guard-approved fire extinguisher securely mounted in an accessible place.
- Distress Signals Store flares and day signals in a dry, accessible location and ensure all passengers onboard know how to use them. Also have a noise-making device, such as an air horn, bell or whistle, capable of producing a 4-second blast audible for at least 1/2 mile readily available.
- Tools Keep a basic toolbox onboard with commonly used tools and spare parts like wrenches, screwdrivers, batteries, fuel filters, hull plugs and light bulbs.
- First-Aid Kit Keep a well-stocked first-aid kit

 and extra sunscreen in an accessible location in case of accidents.

My Cat Follows Me Everywhere

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: I adopted a cat from a shelter just before Thanksgiving of last year. Blue is a beautiful boy who settled right into my home. He's very well socialized and doesn't even claw the furniture. However, he follows me everywhere! Even to the bathroom - I have to close the door in his face. At night, he meows and paws at my bedroom door. He runs under the bed when I leave the house, and he sulks for quite a while when I return. How can I stop his clingy ways? -Beth in Syracuse, New York

DEAR BETH: There's a fine line between "cuddly" and "clingy," and Blue has hopped right over it. If it helps, know that you're not alone. Studies over the past decade show that cats bond to their humans much more strongly than we thought. Underneath that aloof exterior is a loyal heart of gold.

Cats who've had to spend time in a shelter may become overly clingy once they reach their forever home. They're finally with a forever family, and they don't want to let go! It's also tempting to give in to their demands for treats or to take over your bedroom to make up for their lost time.

Keep enforcing boundaries, but try to introduce positive stimuli before and after you shut him out of the bathroom or bedroom. Two important factors to be aware of are: 1. A daily routine and 2. Combating boredom. Commit to spending time with your cat before leaving for work, after returning and before going to bed. Incorporate play, using toys or laser pointers that he can chase.

Don't give up. You and Blue will figure out a routine and comfort level that works for both of you.



Winner Winner, Walleye **Dinner! Anglers Are Cashing In On Lake Pend Oreille Walleve**

Anglers on Lake Pend Oreille earned over \$5,000 catching walleye during May and June

For most fisherman, the notion of getting paid to fish is a pie-in-the-sky dream. For five lucky anglers on Lake Pend Oreille, that dream recently became a reality. During May and June 2023, each of the five anglers caught and turned in a reward-tagged walleye from the lake, earning them each a payout of \$1,000. You read that right, a thousand bucks each!

Chris Lewandowski from Bonners Ferry has been fishing for walleye on Lake Pend Oreille for almost a decade. His first walleye trip of 2023 yielded more than just a gallon bag of walleye fillets.

"I had a feeling I was going to win something, but when I got the call that I had won \$1,000. I was in disbelief and shock, to be honest," said Lewandowski.

Lewandowski's winning fish was one of six he caught that day. "I love to fish, especially with my family. When you can catch a really great tasting fish and win money on top of that, that is a pretty good deal," he said.

Lewandowski learned about the Lake Pend Oreille angler incentive program a few years ago; he had turned in lake trout heads before, so he knew the

"It's really cool that anglers on Lake Pend Oreille get to actively be a part of managing the different fisheries in the lake, including walleye," said Lewandowski.

He hasn't spent his winnings yet; however, he has been considering getting a new pontoon boat, so the money will likely go toward that purchase.

The scoop on walleye

Walleye fishing has been picking up lately, and it should continue to provide good opportunity in the weeks ahead. More walleye heads were turned in during June than in any other month since the Lake Pend Oreille walleye angler incentive program started in March 2019. The number of walleye heads turned in by anglers during June easily surpassed the total number of heads turned in from January to May 2023. In the past, the highest number of heads have been turned in during July, so right now is the time to get out and chase some walleve!

Since the walleye angler incentive program started in 2019, over 50% of the reward-tagged walleye have been caught in the northern end of Lake Pend Oreille. In fact, all five of the winning walleye caught in May and June came from the north end of the lake. So, if you're looking to get out and fish for walleye, consider spending some time in that portion of the lake.

Fish and Game biologists provide regular updates on known walleye locations in Lake Pend Oreille to help get anglers and walleyes to cross paths. Make sure to check for walleye location updates on the Fish and Game website and Facebook page before heading out on your next walleye outing.

Catching that lucky reward-tagged walleye isn't the only way to win big. For every walleye head turned in, an entry is earned to a monthly drawing for ten rewards worth \$100 each. Think of it as a raffle, where each walleye head is a raffle ticket. The more tickets you have in the hat, the more likely you are





"Make-do" Mirror

"Use it up, wear it out, make it do, or do without." These were words to live by in the days before mass production, online shopping and overnight shipping.

This leaf-shaped hand mirror in an irregular wooden frame is a "make-do" mirror, made by setting a broken mirror in a frame so it could still be used. It sold for \$438 at Cowan's Auctions. The shape of the mirror and the chip carving on its frame and handle show it was made with care – a piece of folk art as well as a utilitarian object.

I recently saw some dishes with red, green and yellow flowers labeled "Delft." I always thought Delft was blue and white. Was I mistaken, or were the dishes mislabeled?

Delft, or delftware, is a type of tin-glazed pottery like faience and majolica. It was first made in the city of Delft in Holland in the 17th century, and later in England and other countries. It is often white with blue decorations but sometimes can be multicolored, known as polychrome. Pieces are usually everyday-ware like dishes and tiles. Delft marked "Holland" was made in 1891 or later. If it is marked "Delft," it is probably from the 20th or 21st century. Today, blue-and-white porcelain may be marked and sold as Delft. Authentic Delft is pottery and softer than porcelain, so antique pieces often show signs of wear. Prices depend on age and condition.

I have a set of three wooden nesting tables. They've been in our family for as a long as I can remember. They are lightweight and small. The top on the largest one is only 20 inches by 14 inches. Who invented nesting tables and are antique ones valuable?

Nesting tables were made in England in the 18th century. The cabinet maker Thomas Sheraton is credited with being the first to make them. They were designed to be functional while taking up very little space in small English houses. Sets of antique nesting tables similar to yours have recently

sold for \$90 to \$240.

TIP: To get rid of mildew on wooden furniture, wipe the wood with a cloth dipped in a mixture of 1 cup of water, 1 tablespoon of bleach and 1 tablespoon of liquid dishwashing detergent. Then wipe the wood dry.





World Emoji Day July 17th

July 17th recognizes World Emoji Day and many of the world's symbolic icons for digital calendars. The day encourages us to use emojis to send unique messages.

Before the emoji, there were emoticons. Emoticons (emotion + icon) was developed as an expression of emotions in the cold hard texts that were devoid of them.

Emoji, a Japanese expression, roughly means "picture word" and was created by Shigetaka Kurita in 1990. While working for the Japanese telecom company NTT Docomo, Kurita would design these

picture words as a feature on their pagers to make them more appealing to teens.

The release of the first iPhone by Apple in 2007 had an emoji keyboard embedded into the phone to nab the Japanese market. While not intended for U.S. users to find, they did and quickly figured out how to use it.

Every year new emojis (both emoji and emojis are acceptable plural forms of the word) are developed. The emojipedia.org keeps track of all the emoji updates across all platforms and operating systems. Over 1800 emojis cover much more than just emotions. From transportation, food, an assortment of wild and domesticated animals to social platforms, weather, and bodily functions, emojis virtually speak for themselves.

When it comes to celebration emojis, the designers created a variety to make sure we could express our excitement. Whether we celebrate the arrival of a new baby, an anniversary, or a birthday, there's something for every celebration. In fact, if we search our emojis carefully, we could probably Celebrate Every Day® on National Day Calendar® emoji style.





Two Men Charged For 2022 Trespass On BlackfootClearwater Wildlife Management Area

– Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks –

Early entry to WMAs disrupts wildlife and takes opportunity from others

SEELEY LAKE – Two men faced criminal trespass charges this spring in Missoula County Justice Court from an incident that occurred on March 22, 2022 on Montana Fish, Wildlife & Park's Blackfoot-Clearwater Wildlife Management Area (WMA), south of Seeley Lake, Montana.

Ivan Yarmolich of Missoula and Logan Baston of Anchorage, Alaska entered the WMA during a closed season to look for shed antlers. The property, along with many Montana WMAs, is closed to the public from late fall to early spring to help reduce stress on wintering wildlife.

FWP Criminal Investigator Justin Singleterry said, "Yarmolich and Baston were trespassing on the WMA nearly two months before the public opener to hunt for elk shed antlers. Antlers can weigh anywhere from five to 15 pounds on average and fetch about \$15 to \$20 per pound from an antler buyer."

The Blackfoot-Clearwater WMA opens to the public at noon on May 15 each year, with many lining up to hunt for shed antlers.

On June 20, 2023, Yarmolich entered a guilty plea and received a \$585 fine, along with two years loss of hunting, fishing, trapping privileges, and two years ban from Montana WMAs. The revocation of

Yarmolich's hunting, fishing, and trapping privileges is recognized by 48 U.S. member states of the Interstate Wildlife Violator Compact. In May 2023, Baston settled for a deferred prosecution agreement and was banned from WMAs for six months.

"This was not the first time Yarmolich has been caught trespassing to steal antlers," Singleterry said. "He was federally charged and prosecuted for a 2013 trespass onto the National Bison Range and then again in 2014 for trespassing on the Sun River Wildlife Management Area owned by FWP."

Due to the popularity and value of shed hunting, FWP wardens have seen an increase in trespass on WMAs during the closed season. People entering WMAs during closed seasons can disrupt wildlife during their more vulnerable times. Trespass also takes opportunity away from others.

FWP game wardens work to deter trespassing on WMAs by sharing information about the importance of winter closures to wildlife and by monitoring closed areas through patrols, using remote cameras, and other surveillance techniques.

Anyone with possible information about crimes involving fish, wildlife or park regulations is encouraged to visit myfwp.mt.gov/fwpPub/tipmont to provide details or call the FWP violation reporting hot line at 1-800-TIP-MONT (1-800-847-6668). Callers may be eligible for a cash reward of up to \$1,000.

Fish Tacos Are Great Eats for Get-Togethers

Let's talk tacos. Growing up in California, Wednesday was taco day on the school cafeteria menu. No brown-bagging it for me that day. I was a taco fanatic.

No wonder I was surprised when I married a Minnesotan and discovered that the humble taco was as unusual to him as other West-Coast favorites like artichokes, pomegranates and avocados. Wasting no time, I introduced him and his Midwest friends to beef tacos – not too spicy – and they were an instant hit.

Fast-forward to three kids and dozens of taco shells later, making and eating tacos together on weekends has become a family culinary tradition.

Nowadays, we've embraced the fish taco trend. We fill warmed corn tortillas with fresh seasoned white fish, or alternate with salmon or grilled shrimp. Stuffed with shredded cabbage and topped with what's on hand and a squeeze of lime, it's a tasty meal on a weeknight after work or when friends drop by during the long summer days.

Fish tacos are simple, prep-wise, since most ingredients can be readied in advance. Kids can help you chop, stir and arrange toppings in serving bowls on a buffet table. They also might want to make a few handwritten signs on folded index cards to identify the contents.

GRILLED FISH TACOS

Makes 12

- 1-1/2 pounds tilapia, cod, halibut or catfish fillets
- 1-1/2 tables poons olive or vegetable oil

- 1 teaspoon ground cumin and/or chili powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper
- 2 cups finely shredded cabbage
- · 12 tortillas of your choice
- 2 limes, cut into wedges
- Extra favorite toppings such as sour cream, salsa, sriracha sauce, radish slices, chopped scallions, sliced avocado, Cotija or feta cheese, snipped fresh cilantro, etc.

Brush fish with oil, and season with cumin and/or chili powder, salt and pepper. Grill on medium heat. Transfer fish to a warm platter and separate into bite-size chunks.

Meanwhile, heat tortillas in oven, or char on a grill rack on each side until warmed and softened. Wrap in a clean towel to keep warm.

Fill tortillas with fish, cabbage, a squeeze of lime juice and additional toppings to taste.

Cook's Notes:

- Instead of grilling, cook seasoned fish in a frying pan with 1 tablespoon of oil until golden.
- Substitute white fish with grilled seasoned salmon or medium-size shrimp.




