





Dear EarthTalk: Are seaweed farms good for the planet or is that just industry hype? — Josiah Barnes

The production of seaweed has boomed to over 35 million tons in the past few years, while the industry has become a \$16.7 billion market. Its popularity is due to its notable ecological benefits, like its absorption of carbon, production of food and marine habitat production. Seaweed proponents praise them for being easy to grow and creating bioplastics while critics argue that there are significant shortcomings.

Seaweed farms are not only fast and easy to grow, but also notably versatile. Unlike terrestrial crops like trees, fruits, vegetables and herbs, seaweed requires no fertilizer, pesticides, freshwater or land to grow. Thus, it can easily adapt to diverse environments and survive without constant human intervention.

Furthermore, the growth of seaweed farms benefits marine life. Beyond improving water quality, the presence of seaweed farms buffers the effects of ocean acidification in surrounding areas, greatly aiding both prosperous and polluted environments. Seaweed farms also create forage and refuge habitats for commercially important fish, like cod and tuna, while acting as a food source for countless other species.

Seaweed can also decrease the impacts of carbon and other greenhouse gases. By absorbing both nutrients and carbon dioxide to grow, seaweed decreases the number of toxic emissions entering oceans and the atmosphere. Seaweed pulls more greenhouse gases from water than eelgrass, mangroves and salt marshes combined. It can also be cultivated to reduce heavy metals and other pollutants, acting as a sponge to rid the ocean of toxins. It also plays a critical role in the creation of bioplastics, which mitigate plastic pollution by replacing carbon-intensive products and greenhouse gases.

Despite the benefits, seaweed farms can be expensive and difficult to implement globally. The higher price decreases the demand for the algae, making it difficult for farmers to support the target growth of their farms. Furthermore, 98 percent of farmed seaweed is grown in Asia, illustrating the lack of geographic diversity worldwide.

So, scientists are looking for ways to expand the reach and impact of seaweed farms to maximize their benefits. Specifically, many are experimenting with growing seaweed aimed at reducing water pollutants like metals. Ultimately, Alexandra Cousteau, head of the non-profit Oceans2050, noted that "Seaweed farming offers a scalable, nature-based solution for carbon removal while delivering co-benefits such as biodiversity enhancement, economic opportunities, and food security."


- 4 medium North Carolina sweetpotatoes (about 2 pounds), divided
- 1 tablespoon, plus 1 teaspoon, olive oil, divided

- 1/4 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1/4 teaspoon onion powder
- 1/4 teaspoon paprika
- 1/8 teaspoon cayenne pepper
- · kosher salt, to taste
- · freshly ground black pepper, to taste
- all-purpose flour, for rolling out dough
- 1 pound whole-wheat pizza dough at room temperature, divided into four equal portions (4 ounces each)
- 1 cup freshly shredded Gouda cheese
- 4 large eggs
- 1/4 cup diced chives
- 1. Preheat oven to 400 F. Place 1 pound sweetpotatoes directly on rack and bake until soft, about 1 hour. Remove from oven and let cool 5-10 minutes. Peel and puree flesh until smooth; reserve
- 2. Increase oven heat to 450 F. Peel remaining sweetpotatoes and dice into 1/2-inch pieces. Toss 2 cups diced sweetpotatoes with 1 tablespoon olive oil, garlic powder, onion powder, paprika, cayenne and salt and pepper, to taste; place in even layer on baking sheet. Roast until softened but not crisp, 15-20 minutes, stirring halfway. Remove from oven.
- 3. Lightly flour clean, flat work surface. Roll each ball of dough out to about 1/4-inch thickness (about 7 inches diameter).
- With remaining oil, lightly coat rimless baking sheet. Transfer rolled out dough to baking sheet.
- Spread pureed sweetpotato over surface of each dough round, about 1/4 cup each, leaving about 1/2-inch border. Top each with 1/4 cup shredded Gouda. Add 1/2 cup roasted sweetpotato cubes, leaving open space in center of pizzas.
- 6. Carefully crack one egg into center of each pizza; bake 15 minutes until crusts are golden brown on bottom, cheese is melted and egg whites are fully set. Carefully remove pizzas from oven.
- 7. Season with salt and pepper, to taste. Top each pizza with 1 tablespoon diced chives.



Payette Lake Produces New State Record Lake Trout

Fishery rebounds following netting efforts

Aaron Goettsche of Stansburry Park, Utah Breaks Catch-and-Release Record

Aaron Goettsche is no stranger to monster Lake Trout. An avid angler, fishing rod maker, and longtime veteran on Utah's/Wyoming's famous Flaming Gorge Reservoir – a world-renowned fishery known for producing Lake Trout over 30 pounds and occasional giants up to 60 – Aaron knows what a trophy

But in recent years, another lake has stolen his heart: Payette Lake in McCall, Idaho.

Aaron has spent the past three years chasing Lake Trout in Payette Lake, steadily dialing in the fishery and landing some incredible catches along the way. Then, on June 19, 2025, while trolling solo in the morning in about 80 feet of water, he caught the fish of a lifetime, just barely beating the standing catchand-release record set by Dylan Smith in 2018. Aaron's 42-inch lunker earned him the new Idaho state record for catch-and-release Lake Trout, solidifying Payette Lake as a legitimate trophy water once again.

A Rebounding Trophy Fishery

Though Payette Lake has produced big Lake Trout for over 30 years, things weren't always so rosy. In the early 2000s, biologists noticed signs of trouble. Lake Trout were getting thin from poor prey available, and the kokanee numbers - their main prey food item – were dropping quickly.

"It wasn't uncommon to catch a 30-inch fish that looked like a snake," said Jordan Messner, Regional Fisheries Manager for Idaho Fish and Game in McCall.

With the lake out of balance, Idaho Fish and Game launched a major plan to boost kokanee numbers while improving the quality of the Lake Trout population.

The Recovery Plan: Kokanee + Suppression = **Restore Balance**


In 2018, Idaho Fish and Game biologists started a two-pronged approach:

- 1. Stock more kokanee to rebuild the prey base
- 2. Suppress smaller Lake Trout to reduce competition and predation on kokanee

The suppression program targets Lake Trout under 27 inches to remove them from the lake. So far, over 3,000 Lake Trout have been removed since 2018. The goal is to reduce the Lake Trout population to reduce competition and increase kokanee survival. With fewer mouths to feed, the remaining Lake Trout should be healthier and grow faster.

"We're thinning out the juvenile Lake Trout so the ones that survive have more food - and they grow big," said Messner. At the same time, biologists are working hard to stock more kokanee in the lake.

Ongoing monitoring confirms the success of the strategy: average relative weight (a measure of how "fat" a fish is) has steadily improved since the program began.

A Fishery on the Rise

Anglers are noticing the improvements in both the kokanee and Lake Trout fishing. In June 2023, biologists caught and released a 54-pound Lake Trout, just three pounds shy of the Idaho state weight record! That means another record is likely just around the corner.

Want to Catch One? Here's How

If you're dreaming of record-breaking Lake Trout, it's time to get serious about your gear and tactics. Here's some tips for targeting these deep water predators:

- Technique: Trolling or jigging near the bottom are the go-to methods.
- Depth: Focus on 35-80 feet, where Lake Trout tend to hold tight to structure.
- · Locations: Target underwater ridges, drop-offs, and boulder piles.
- Bait: Mimic kokanee. Use realistic lures, tipped jigs, and scent-Lake Trout can be selective, especially when food is abundant.

Be prepared for a potential record fish. Catch-andrelease records will need a photo of the fish on a tape measure, or measuring board. You can find all the info and how to apply on the State Record Fish Page at idfg.idaho.gov/fish/record.

Make Homemade Guacamole as a **Weekend Treat**

It's a rare day when I don't have an avocado "in waiting" on my kitchen counter. And when it's just ripe, guacamole is bound to be on the dinner menu as an appetizer with tortilla chips or as a final crowning dollop on a quesadilla, a taco or grilled fish.

You can add some zip to a weekend meal with the yummy taste of guacamole. Who can resist the tempting combination of creamy avocado, fresh garlic, seasonings and zesty lime?

And while you are at it, let your school-aged kids pitch in to help with an easy step or two. As they squeeze the last wedge of lime, invite friends over for an impromptu get-together. It just might be the relaxing antidote everyone needs after a busy workweek.

HOMEMADE GUACAMOLE

Makes about 2 cups

- · 2 ripe Haas avocados, peeled and pitted
- 2 tablespoons lime or lemon juice
- 1/4 cup red onion, finely chopped
- 1/2 medium jalapeno pepper, seeded and finely chopped (see note below)
- · 1 garlic clove, minced
- · Salt and freshly ground black pepper to taste
- 1/2 medium tomato, seeded and diced (optional)

• 1 tablespoon finely chopped cilantro or parsley (optional)

Mash avocados in a mixing bowl with a fork or potato masher, leaving some chunks. Add lime juice, onion, jalapeno, garlic, salt and pepper. Stir well.

Fold in tomato and add cilantro or parsley, if you wish. Serve immediately, or place plastic wrap directly on top of the guacamole. Leave on the counter to enhance the flavors until it's ready to serve within an hour or two.



Cook's Tips:

Stretch the recipe by stirring in a 1/2 cup of smallcurd cottage cheese just before you spoon it into a serving bowl.



Iridescent Glass

In the late 19th century, interior decorator Louis Comfort Tiffany was in search of new colors to use in his leaded glass windows. He hired glassmaker Arthur J. Nash to make iridescent glass. The company was producing iridescent vases and accessories by 1894. It is said that Tiffany was inspired by glass he saw in Europe; possibly ancient glass from 19th-century archaeological digs.

Glass has been made for thousands of years, with the earliest known blown glass made in Jerusalem about 50 B.C., and evidence that glassblowing was practiced in Italy about the same time. As bottle diggers know, glass slowly corrodes from exposure to the moisture and chemicals present in soil. This corrosion causes the surface to refract light in different ways, creating a shimmering, multicolor effect.

Tiffany imitated this effect by coating the glass they made with metallic salts. Buyers liked the look; many other glassmakers made their own versions of iridescent glass. Today's collectors love it, too. Tiffany iridescent glass, which Louis Comfort Tiffany called Favrile, often sells for high prices. This Tiffany Favrile compote with iridescent hues of gold and blue sold for \$1,071 at Forsythe's Auctions, more than doubling its presale high estimate of \$400.

I have three to four old iron standing ashtrays which I have been using as plant stands. Are they worth anything?

A Using old standing ashtrays as plant stands is a fantastic way to repurpose antiques! Iron standing ashtrays can sell for anywhere from about \$50 to \$300. The value of yours depends on their condition, age and maker. Art deco designs of the 1920s - 1930s, when standing ashtrays were at their most popular, tend to sell for higher prices. If you can identify a maker, the value will be higher;

especially if they were made by any of the famous ironsmiths active in the art deco period.

TIP: Glass signatures, including Steuben, Quezal and Tiffany, are being faked. Do not trust a signature. Be sure the glass is the proper shape to have been made by the original factory or artist. Fake marks are written with a diamond-tipped drill or are acid-stamped. All look real.



Burger in a Bag Brings a New Twist on a Labor Day Picnic Favorite

Nothing beats the flavor of simple hamburger patties grilled outdoors. At least, that's what I thought, until my friend Joani invited us to her deck this summer for a memorable, new version that she calls "Burger in a Bag." It's a creative twist on a traditional picnic staple that will add both extra fun and new flavors to your Labor Day get-together with friends and family.

Basically, guests build their own hamburger patty by choosing tasty add-ins and combining them in a bag before they are cooked on the grill. The activity brings on giggles and laughter as picky eaters and foodies alike concoct their unique combinations.

Here's the fun: Before guests arrive, divide up 82% lean ground beef into quarter-pound chunks. Set each chunk in the bottom of a new, quart-sized plastic storage bag. Place all bags in a large bowl. Keep refrigerated until ready to use.

Make mini flags to ID the burgers. Cut 1-inch-wide flag shapes from different colors of construction paper. Poke holes into the sides and weave the paper onto the toothpicks. Set in a jar by the grill.

Spoon chopped and grated add-in food options into individual bowls and set a spoon in each bowl. Place on a large tray with sauces, seasonings and spices.

SUGGESTED BURDER ADD-INS:

- · A selection of cheeses, grated
- Red onions, finely chopped
- · Fresh mushrooms, sliced and sauteed with butter, salt and pepper
- · Green olives with pimento, chopped

- · Pitted black olives, chopped
- · Fresh jalapenos, seeded and finely chopped, or canned diced jalapenos, drained
- · Fresh bell peppers, seeded and chopped
- Cooked bacon, chopped
- Worcestershire sauce
- · Tabasco or sriracha hot chili sauce
- · Barbecue sauce
- · Salt, pepper and other seasonings, chopped herbs and spices

When the grill is hot, present each guest with a bag of meat. Invite them to spoon, shake and pour in small amounts of their favorite add-ins without touching the meat with their hands. Close the bag, leaving the top partially open.

With hands on the outside of the bag, gently smoosh, squish and mash the add-ins into the meat. Form into a firm, round "patty" shape. Bring the bag to the grill and let the cook remove it from the bag with a spatula designated for raw meat. With clean hands, the cook should reshape the patty if necessary. Top with a mini flag.

The cook should grill the hamburgers on both sides, replacing the flags with every flip, until the internal temperature reaches 160 F.



Enjoy burgers in warm buns with condiments such as ketchup, mustard, a tomato slice, lettuce, or avocado.







Metformin Can Help All People, Not Just Diabetics, Lose Weight

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am a 75-year-old woman who isn't prediabetic or diabetic. My BMI is 31.2. My doctor has prescribed a trial of metformin for weight loss as an alternative to starting Ozempic or one of the other weight-loss drugs. I have lost three pounds in a month, which is a start; exercise and healthier eating is also encouraged.

What are your thoughts on this new weight-loss tool and its possible long-term success? -- J.H.

ANSWER: Metformin, a treatment for diabetes that works mostly by preventing the liver from making sugar, isn't new and has been used to help people lose weight for at least 20 years. While it was first shown to help people with prediabetes or diabetes, it is also effective at helping people with normal blood sugar lose weight. However, the effectiveness is modest, with most people losing around 2-3 kilograms (about 5 pounds), which is stable as long as people continue taking the medicine.

I certainly agree with the changes in lifestyle. In studies, people who adhere to a healthier diet and exercise are likely to lose more weight than people who take metformin without lifestyle changes.

I've had occasional patients who get motivated by the success of metformin, making it easier for them to comply with the diet and exercise changes. I've also had people say that the weight they lose with metformin makes it easier to exercise. Metformin is moderately successful in preventing diabetes, but it is not as effective for weight loss as approved weight-loss medicines such as semaglutide (Ozempic).

Some of my patients have read about metformin as an anti-aging drug based on animal data, and there are studies ongoing to see whether this is true in humans. I do not recommend its use for this purpose outside of a clinical trial.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I'm unable to find out from my health care provider's clinic whether they offer a vaccine for the specific variant of COVID that is now said to be spreading. Do you know if there is a vaccine for this, and who is making it? -- J.A.

ANSWER: The Vaccines and Related Biological Products Advisory Committee at the Food and Drug Administration recommends against a new vaccine formulation this fall, so it appears that we will be using the same vaccine as last year. Fortunately the current vaccine appears to be effective against the new NB.1.8.1 variant, which is now present in all areas that are monitored by the World Health Organization.

The FDA has approved a new, more-effective Moderna vaccine, but at the time of this writing, it has not yet been approved by the Centers for Disease Control. The new vaccine gives high protection with less antigens. However, the specific variants of COVID used for the vaccine will not be updated this year.

DR. ROACH WRITES: Many readers were concerned about the advice given to a reader by his physician to use petrolatum (Vaseline) in his nose, because of a condition called exogenous lipoid pneumonia. This is a very uncommon condition but can occur when large amounts of petroleum jelly are placed in the nose, especially when the person lays down to sleep and inhales it while asleep.

This condition can be avoided by only using a thin film in the nostrils and by not doing so immediately before bed so that any excess will come out of the nose. If a small amount is swallowed, this is not dangerous as it passes through the digestive system without being absorbed.





What You Need to Know About Glaucoma

More than 4.2 million Americans live with glaucoma, a leading cause of vision loss in the nation. Although there is no cure for glaucoma, early detection and treatment can stop this condition in its tracks.

"Glaucoma is a leading cause of vision loss and blindness in the United States, but it's estimated that half of people with glaucoma don't know they have it," said Michael F. Chiang, M.D. "Glaucoma has no early symptoms, and the only way to check if you have it is to get a comprehensive dilated eye exam. There's no cure for glaucoma, but starting treatment as early as possible can help stop vision loss."

Regular eye exams are among the best lines of defense because symptoms may not appear until the disease has progressed significantly. Knowing more about how to spot the condition and what you can do about it may help protect your vision in the long run.

Glaucoma is actually a group of eye diseases that damage the optic nerve in the back of the eye and cause vision loss and blindness. The most common type in the United States is open-angle glaucoma. Other, less common, types include angle-closure glaucoma and congenital glaucoma.

Causes

For some people, glaucoma is the result of another medical condition, but that's not always the case. While experts still aren't sure exactly what causes open-angle glaucoma, it's believed to be related to the pressure that builds in the eye when fluid doesn't drain fast enough. Over time, the pressure causes nerve damage, which then leads to vision loss.

Risk Factors

Glaucoma is not preventable and can affect anyone. However, some groups of people are at higher risk, including those over age 60 - particularly Hispanic or Latino individuals. African American individuals over age 40 are also at greater risk, as are people with a family history of glaucoma.

Symptoms

Early on, most people do not experience any symptoms of glaucoma. Over time, you may start to notice disruptions to your vision, such as blind spots or decreased peripheral vision (what you see from the sides of your eyes) in one or both eyes. This loss may be especially prevalent closest to your nose. Symptoms typically progress so slowly that people get used to it and don't realize their vision is changing, which is why so many people with glaucoma don't know they have it.

Intense eye pain, nausea, red eyes and blurry vision are all potential signs of angle-closure glaucoma, and immediate emergency treatment is necessary.

Diagnosis

The only way to properly diagnose glaucoma is through a dilated eye exam, including visual field testing to check your side vision. This routine test is painless and involves looking straight ahead while your doctor checks how well you can see objects off to the side or at the top or bottom of your field of vision.

Treatment

Without treatment, glaucoma can eventually lead to blindness. Treatment won't undo any vision damage, but it can stop it from getting worse. Treatment may involve prescription eye drops to reduce eye pressure. Other treatment options include a laser procedure or surgery to help fluid drain. Vision rehabilitation services and devices may help if vision loss affects your everyday activities.



Dear EarthTalk: Are the Chinese actually way ahead of U.S., European and Japanese automakers regarding EVs? And are we ever going to see Chinese cars on American

roads? – P.L., via email

China has quickly become a dominant force in the global electric vehicle (EV) market, surpassing car makers in the U.S., Europe and Japan. Western car companies used to be the leaders in innovation, but Chinese car makers have surged ahead recently, producing affordable, high-tech EVs at record speed. This has raised concerns in the U.S. about whether Chinese automakers will soon enter the American market and how that could affect domestic car companies. With growing competition and trade tensions, the question remains: Are Chinese EVs really ahead? And will they ever make it onto American roads?

One of the main factors that brings China's EV success is robust government support. For years, China has offered substantial subsidies, tax incentives and infrastructure investments to enhance EV sales and manufacturing. China also has control over a large part of the worldwide battery supply chain, which provides its car makers an edge regard to cost and access to crucial components. Firms such as BYD, Nio and XPeng have emerged as global leaders, providing EVs that are not only less expensive than Western options, but also equipped with advanced technology. These elements enable China to sell its EVs globally, surpassing American and European car makers in both production scale and cost-effectiveness.

Although they've achieved global success. Chinese

EVs still face hurdles to enter the U.S. market. High tariffs increase the cost of export, and persistent geopolitical tensions between the U.S. and China further complicates trade. Concerns also exist about cybersecurity and intellectual property. As some lawmakers suggest, vehicles made in China may pose a security threat due to their sophisticated data collection and connectivity capabilities. Additionally, American car makers and lawmakers have opposed permitting Chinese competition, worrying it might undermine local EV manufacturing and lead to job reductions.

Because of these barriers, some Chinese carmakers are looking at different ways to enter the market. One possible strategy is making EVs in Mexico, whereby they'd benefit from the USMCA trade agreement and potentially avoid some tariffs. Others might partner with Western brands to supply batteries or technology, which would let them compete in a more indirect way. Many American EVs already have Chinese components, so even without full vehicle imports, China still plays a big role in the U.S. industry.

Competition between China and Western automakers is likely to get more intense. U.S. and European governments are giving more subsidies for domestic EV production, trying to close the gap. But if China keeps expanding fast, it may be really hard for Western automakers to catch up. Whether or not Chinese EVs show up in American dealerships, their influence on the global car industry can't be denied.

KOVELS Antiques & Collecting

Writing Antiques

Every antique tells a story. It's often one of change, sometimes over a relatively small amount of time. Look at the simple act of writing. Most of us probably have several ballpoint pens scattered throughout a desk -- and most of our writing, whether it's a professional project, a school paper or just filling out a form, is done on the computer anyway.

It's only about a century ago -- not that much time, in the world of antiques -- that you had to dip a nib pen into an inkwell to sign your name. Fountain pens, which use ink cartridges, were invented about 1880, but inkwells remained in use into the 20th century. They were often decorative and could be luxury items, made of precious metals, fine porcelain or cut glass. They could also be novelties, like this one, shaped like an early car and made of an inexpensive metal like pewter or spelter, which sold for \$82 at an auction by Morford's Antique Advertising Auctions at antiqueadvertising.com.

It would have been a useful and stylish item when it was made in the 1910s or 1920s, possibly a status symbol for the proud owner of a Model T. Now, it captures a moment in time when writing was done with a dip pen, instead of a cheap ballpoint or a computer screen, and cars were a new advance in technology instead of something in everyone's driveway.

Q I bought an old king-size canopy bed, but I don't know which era it is from. Can you please assist me?

Canopy beds were popular from the late 1700s to the early 1800s (often called the Federal period in American furniture), and again in the Colonial Revival of the 1930s. The easiest way to determine the era of an antique bed is to measure it. American bed sizes were standardized by the 1920s. A king-size bed is 76 inches wide by 80 inches long. If that is your bed's size, it was probably made in the 20th century. Beds made before 1900 are usually shorter and narrower than standard sizes, so it can

be difficult to find a mattress that fits an antique bed. Before the mid-1800s, mattresses were held in place with ropes, which had to be tightened periodically. A bed from this period will have holes, sometimes pegs, in the side rails for the ropes. Wooden slats to support the mattress were introduced by the mid-1800s.

TIP: Clean a glass inkwell carefully. The old ink may cover a crack. Wash in warm water with mild dishwashing liquid or soap, never dishwasher detergent. Don't use ammonia if the glass is decorated or iridescent.

Many of Idaho's lakes and ponds are soon going to be bolstered with Idaho Fish and Game stocking over 75,000 catchable-sized rainbow trout this September. Wondering if the stocking trucks are going to be backing up to your favorite fishing hole? We asked our Fish and Game hatchery staff to boil down some of the most notable stocking highlights coming to your local fishery this month.

Fishing for stocked rainbow trout can be a great way to introduce budding anglers to the sport by using simple, inexpensive setups. Many of these fisheries highlighted below are easy to access, family-friendly fishing destinations. All you need to get started is a fishing license, and youth (under 14) fish for free. If you need a license, purchasing one on the fly is easy to do with your smartphone—and you can start fishing immediately!

Panhandle Region

Fernan Lake – 4,825 rainbow trout

A popular fishing spot 10 minutes from downtown Coeur d'Alene, anglers of all abilities can enjoy fishing from floating docks, miles of shoreline, or from

Post Falls Park Pond - 800 rainbow trout

This park offers a great fishing spot for kids and anglers with special needs. Anglers can easily fish

the small pond from a fishing bridge, shore, or fishing platforms. Take some time to also enjoy the adjacent park, nature trails, falls, and picnic areas.

Smith Lake - 540 rainbow trout

Located north of Bonners Ferry, diverse fishing opportunities are offered here in a peaceful, forested setting. There is a Forest Service campground and picnic area nearby.

Clearwater Region

Campbells Pond – 300 rainbow trout

This is a scenic forest pond where anglers can expect solid catch rates. Good fishing can be had from the bank with several docks, including one handicap-accessible dock.



Fish And Wildlife **Commission Passes New Wolf Regulations**

– Montana Fish. Wildlife & Parks –

HELENA -The Montana Fish and Wildlife Commission finalized wolf hunting and trapping regulations during a lengthy meeting Thursday where commissioners heard passionate comments from people around the country.

The Commission debated several amendments to the 2025/2026 Furbearer and Wolf Hunting and Trapping Regulations proposal that FWP released in early July. Though the regulations cover all furbearer trapping and wolf hunting and trapping, the central focus of the discussion was crafting a new set of wolf regulations.

For the 2025/2026 wolf hunting and trapping season the Commission approved a 452 statewide wolf quota, which includes a sub-quota of 60 wolves in Region 3, and separate quotas of three wolves each in Wolf Management Units 313 and

The Commission established that a person may harvest 15 wolves via trapping and 15 wolves via hunting, provided that five wolves from each method of take are harvested in FWP Region 1 or Region 2. Hunters must purchase a wolf license for each wolf they harvest via hunting, but they may purchase up to 15 licenses before going afield.

The Commission approved a regulation allowing a trapper to gain prior authorization from FWP to temporarily leave the live wolf in the trap for the purpose of radio collaring by FWP. In this circumstance the wolf would not be harvested, but the trapper would immediately notify FWP, per the prior authorization arrangement, and a FWP official would radio collar the wolf and release it from the trap.


The Commission approved regulation changes to require that all harvested wolves must be presented to FWP for inspection within 10 days of harvest for pelt tagging, tissue sampling, and tooth extraction. A trapper must present the hide and skull for tagging and sampling within 10 days of harvest. It is now illegal to leave a wolf hide and skull in the field after harvest, even if the hunter or trapper doesn't want to keep the animal.

The Commission removed trapping setbacks on roads closed to motor vehicle and OHV traffic (except snowmobiles and unless in a designated no trapping area) in Mineral County and on the Spotted Bear Ranger District in northwest Montana.

FWP staff will finalize the regulations and release them online in the coming days. Printed regulations will be available later this summer.

Archery wolf season opens Sept. 6. Trapping season will open Dec. 1, except within the geographic area identified by federal court order. Just like last season, trapping within the geographic area will be limited to Jan. 1 to Feb. 15. The geographic area is all of FWP regions 1, 2 and 3, and portions of regions 4 and 5. This area, with limited trapping dates, is the same as last year, according to the FWP proposal.

Outside this geographic area, wolf trapping closes March 15, 2026, or when a quota is met.



5 Things to Say When Someone Dies

Funeral directors share what truly comforts the grieving

When someone you know loses a loved one, finding the right words can be difficult. A bit of compassion goes a long way and knowing the right thing to say matters.

According to funeral professionals who guide families through loss daily, the approach matters.

"Just know we are here to walk with you every step," funeral director Randy Anderson said.

Here are five thoughtful things to say when someone dies, based on insights from spokespeople from the National Funeral Directors Association (NFDA), which represents funeral directors who support families every day during the grieving process:

1. "I'm here for you."

Offering your presence, whether to listen, help with daily tasks or just sit quietly, lets the grieving person know they are not alone.

"I let them know I am here to listen," funeral director Allyse Worland said. "Do more listening and less talking. I am still here for you, even after the service."

2. "Tell me about your loved one."

Inviting stories and memories honors the deceased and helps keep their spirit alive

"Tell me about your loved one," funeral director Stephen Kemp said. "What made them special? Positive stories are always helpful."

3. "What can I do to support you right now?"

Rather than a vague "let me know if you need anything," this question encourages specific offers of help, which can be easier for someone in grief to accept.

"Offer actual support instead of just saying 'sorry' or 'thoughts and prayers,'" Worland said.

4. "It's OK to feel whatever you're feeling."

Grief is a uniquely personal experience that can evoke a range of emotions. Validating those feelings removes pressure to "be strong" or "move on" too quickly.

"Sometimes you don't have to say anything," funeral director Camelia Clarke said. "A hug or touch says it all.

5. "I don't have the words, but I am here for you."

Sometimes, words fall short. Acknowledging this honestly while offering your presence can be deeply comforting.

"Your presence and ear are what they need," Kemp

Funeral directors caution against common but unhelpful phrases such as "They're in a better place" or "At least they lived a long life," which may unintentionally minimize the bereaved's pain.

"Less is more," funeral director Daniel Ford said. "Sometimes, a 'hi' and a hug or handshake is enough.

Families and friends leaning on the expertise of funeral professionals who guide families through planning meaningful services and providing ongoing grief support is encouraged by the NFDA.

"We are here to help you every step of the way," funeral director Chris Robinson said. "It's a hard time for you, and we will help you through it."

Offering free resources, RememberingALife.com helps families honor their loved ones and navigate grief. These include planning guides, grief support tools, creative activities and checklists.

For example, the planning guide helps families organize a meaningful tribute, whether traditional or smaller memorial gatherings, even if delayed due to circumstances like the COVID-19 pandemic. 

No Grill, No Problem 5 easy tailgate foods that don't require cooking

He serves guac, hummus and buffalo ranch with tortilla chips, pretzels and veggie sticks in single-serve disposable cups – no double-dipping, no mess.






