



### **National Teddy Bear Day** September 9th

— National Day Calendar —



On September 9th, National Teddy Bear Day honors the history of one of childhood's favorite toys. We have all had a special cuddly teddy as a child. Some of us still have our teddy bear from our childhood. No matter what kind of teddy bear you had, the day is a perfect time to celebrate your childhood friend!

In 1902, American President Theodore Roosevelt refused to shoot a bear cub while hunting in Mississippi. The incident made national news. Clifford Berryman published a cartoon of the event in the Washington Post on November 16th, 1902, and the caricature became an instant classic.

The Berryman cartoon of Teddy Roosevelt and the cub inspired New York store owner Morris Michtom. He created a new toy and even had a name in mind. Michtom wrote President Roosevelt to ask permission to name the new toy a "Teddy Bear."

And then a third plane crashed into The Pentagon. And yet another crashed into a field in Shanksville, PA.

#### Memorial

Every year since that fateful day, the United States comes together to remember the fallen. We remember the first responders and those who made difficult decisions. Since that day, memorials have risen from the ashes.

### Large Tracts Program Land Closures Announced Due To Excessive Fire Danger

- Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game -

Large Tracts Program partners have announced fire-related closures on some of their lands effective Aug. 23

North Idaho Timber Group, a partner in the Large Tracts Program, just announced a closure of their lands in response to extreme fire danger. The closure is effective Aug. 23, 2023.

The press release below is from North Idaho Timber Group. Additional information will be released as it becomes available.

#### **For Immediate Release**

August 22, 2023- In response to extreme fire danger and strained fire suppression resources in North Idaho, Idaho Fish and Game's corporate partners have implemented fire-related closures or restrictions on private lands enrolled in the Large Tracts Access Program.

The North Idaho Timber Group, which includes Manulife Investment Management Timberland and Agriculture, Molpus Woodlands Group, and Stimson Lumber Company lands in North Idaho, will close all public roads and walk-in access on August 23, 2023, until further notice.

"While this type of restriction is not necessary during most fire seasons, this year is extraordinary in terms of wildfire risk for Idaho and all neighboring western states," Peter Stegner said in a statement on behalf of the North Idaho Timber Group. "This precautionary closure is in the best interests of the community and the environment, and we appreciate everyone's cooperation with this request during these highly unusual times."

According to the contracts between Fish and Game and Large Tracts Program participants, private land managers reserve the right to temporarily close specific lands for management purposes like active forestry operations, high fire danger, or other management needs. When access has to be restricted for a period of time, the lease payments to program participants are adjusted accordingly.

### Will Large Tracts Program closures affect access for hunters in the fall?

The only Large Tracts Program closure imminent

is for lands under the North Idaho Timber Group umbrella. Of course, that could change as the fire season continues, and hunters and anglers can stay abreast of current restrictions and closures on Large Tracts properties by visiting Fish and Game's Fire Information webpage.

In regard to the North Idaho Timber Group announcement, it is impossible to say at this point in the middle of a volatile fire season when the closure may end. Hunters and anglers need to remember that these are private, working timberlands, and that managers need to consider not only their business assets, but also public safety when making a determination on closures and when they are lifted.

"The situation will be evaluated on an ongoing basis, but we anticipate the closure will last until wetting rains reduce the hazard later in the season," Stegner said in the statement.

#### Fish and Game resources for fire information

While Fish and Game's Fire Information webpage is not the official fire information resource for wild-fires in Idaho, the agency's communications staff provide it as a tool to help Fish and Game customers in decision making.

To assist in your hunting, angling and outdoor adventures in summer and fall, Idaho Fish and Game will be working with the Forest Service, BLM, IDL and other resource agencies and Wildfire Teams to keep you up to date on fire closures as they are announced.

A number of Fish and Game regions have recently announced various levels of fire restrictions on department-owned property, including Wildlife Management Areas. The restrictions commonly reflect those on neighboring public lands managed by other federal and state agencies. Regional Fish and Game staff have and will continue to post updates on fire restrictions for department-owned lands to the Fire Information Page.

Fish and Game staff are compiling the latest fire activity and closures from InciWeb and making them available as real-time maps and downloads on our website. As more information becomes available, this page will be updated.





### National Video Games Day September 12th

On September 12th, National Video Games Day celebrates all the ways we enjoy a good video game challenge.

Video game players across the United States enjoy this day with much enthusiasm. From their very earliest days, video games have been a blend of art form and industry.

On July 25, 1983, Walter Day and the Twin Galaxies Intergalactic Scoreboard out of Ottumwa, Iowa founded the United States National Video Game Team. Their early games used interactive electronic devices with various display formats. Thomas T. Goldsmith Jr. and Estle Ray Mann filed the first patent for an interactive electronic device in 1947. It was called the "Cathode ray tube amusement Device."

#### Some other early examples include:

- The Nimrod computer at the Festival of Britain (1951)
- 0X0 a tic-tac-toe computer game by Alexander S. Douglas for the EDSAC (1952)
- Tennis For Two An electronic interactive game engineered by William Higinbotham (1958)
- Spacewar (1961)

Each game used a different means of display. Some used a panel of lights or graphical display. Yet others featured an oscilloscope or the DEC PDP-1 vector display.

• It became the first commercially sold

coin-operated video game.

- Magnavox Odyssey launched the first home console in 1972.
- Atari's Pong followed with an arcade version in 1972 and a home version in 1975.

"The commercial success of Pong led numerous other companies to develop Pong clones and their own systems, spawning the video game industry."

### **Small Dog's Aggression** Is a Worry

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: I have a small, mixedbreed, mostly terrier named Cookie. He's a darling to me and my son, but to anyone else, he's a terror. He is a rescue, so I don't know what his early life was like or if he was properly socialized. But I'm worried about having company over because he will bark ferociously at any strangers. What can I do to stop this? - Janice L., Trenton, New Jersey

**DEAR JANICE:** A lack of socialization or an abusive home could be factors in Cookie's aggression. Genetics can also be at play: Some dog breeds were developed to be guard dogs or hunters and may be more aggressive if not trained well.

However, Cookie has accepted you and your son as family, and that is a positive sign. Follow these tips as you begin the process of reducing his aggression.

- Never force Cookie to meet new visitors or strangers on the street. Let him approach visitors on his own, with you supervising.
- Ask visitors (and people on the street) not to approach Cookie or try to pet him.
- Create a safe space where you can put Cookie when visitors arrive. A kennel cage with water, soft bed and favorite toys is ideal.
- If Cookie is physically aggressive (charging or snapping), he must stay in his kennel when visitors come, and should always be leashed and wear a muzzle when walking outdoors.

Next, talk to Cookie's veterinarian about a combination of anti-anxiety medication along with a training routine. I recommend working with a trainer so you can implement effective training methods as quickly as possible. With love, training and care, Cookie can become a confident, less aggressive dog.



### THE HISTORY CHANNEL

- On Sept. 18, 1769, John Harris, a spinet and harpsichord maker from Boston, completed the first spinet piano to be made in America. Upon its debut, the Boston Gazette averred that the instrument "in every respect does honour to that artist."
- On Sept. 19, 1676, Nathaniel Bacon and an army of rebel followers made up of farmers, slaves and indentured servants, set fire to Jamestown, the capital of the Virginia colony, in what came to be known as Bacon's Rebellion, a civil war that pitted Bacon against Virginia governor Sir William Berkeley.
- On Sept. 20, 1942, as part of the British war effort to conserve fuel, citizens were requested to bathe in no more than 5 inches of water. The royal family even painted black lines on all the household bathtubs at said depth, and put up posters around the palace with reminders of the need to conserve energy.
- On Sept. 21, 2012, David Villalobos jumped from the Wild Asia monorail train into a tiger den at the Bronx Zoo and was mauled by a 400-pound Siberian tiger named Bachuta. Quick-thinking employees chased the animal away using a fire extinguisher, and Villalobos, though injured, was able to roll under a wire to safety and survived.
- On Sept. 22, 1999, Saudi Arabia joined other Arab countries in a threat to boycott the Walt Disney entertainment company as a protest against the Israeli exhibit at the millennium show in Florida, which portrayed Jerusalem as the capital of Israel.
- On Sept. 23, 1989, foggy conditions led to one of the worst days for accidents on the German Autobahn, with five vehicular pileups involving 256 cars and a large number of serious injuries. The Autobahns in Germany have no speed limits, and cars sometimes travel as fast as 140 mph.
- On Sept. 24, 1906, Devil's Tower (also called Grizzly Bear Lodge) in northeastern Wyoming was named America's first national monument. The tower is a sacred site for many Plains Indians, and also a popular site for rock climbing.

- 1 tablespoon grated fresh peeled ginger
- 1 teaspoon Asian sesame oil
- 1 whole (1¼ pounds) pork tenderloin
- 1/2 medium pineapple, untrimmed
- 2 tablespoons brown sugar
- 1. Prepare outdoor grill for covered direct grilling over medium heat. In small bowl, combine hoisin, honey, ginger and oil.
- 2. Place pork on hot grill rack. Cover grill and cook pork 18 to 20 minutes, turning occasionally.
- 3. With serrated knife, cut pineapple half into 4 wedges. Rub cut sides of pineapple with brown sugar.

#### Make a Family-Style **Salade Nicoise**

It's market time! On weekend mornings, I like to saunter through our neighborhood farmers market amid the crowds of people in shorts and sandals, who, like me, are attracted to the "picked at their peak" vegetables, flowers, eggs, honey and jams in colorful stalls. Adults and kids alike visit with vendors, while friends happily bump into one another for a chat.

Since produce is overflowing at markets and grocery stores, there's no better time to make a fresh, easy-to-prepare dish that the whole family will love. I was once inspired by my friend, Ann Francois, to make a big salade nicoise for the centerpiece of her dining table at a gathering of our friends.

While I have vivid memories of traveling in southern France and feasting on this country salad typically composed of tomatoes, tuna, hard-boiled-egg halves and anchovies on a bed of lettuce dressed with a vinaigrette, Ann's version featured the addition of locally sourced new potatoes and mounds of green beans. Each ingredient was artfully arranged on a platter and served with crusty French bread.

Make this healthy salad with your kids for a light, simple-to-prepare, end-of-summer main course. What makes it so family-friendly is that you can tweak it to suit everyone's tastes. Add artichoke hearts, capers or grilled red peppers. Don't like anchovies? Skip them!

#### **SALADE NICOISE**

Serves 6

- 1/2 cup extra-virgin olive oil
- 2 tablespoons red wine vinegar
- 1 tablespoon fresh lemon juice

- 1 teaspoon Dijon mustard
- · 1 clove garlic, minced
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- · Freshly ground black pepper
- 1 head Boston lettuce, separated into leaves, washed and dried
- 1 pound firm green beans, preferably French string beans (haricot verts), cooked just beyond the tender-crisp stage and chilled
- 1 pound new potatoes, cooked and halved
- 2-3 (5 or 6 ounce) cans albacore solid white tuna, drained and flaked, or grilled fresh tuna, cut into chunks
- 3 large vine-ripe tomatoes, sliced into wedges
- 3 hard-boiled eggs, halved lengthwise
- 1 cup pitted black olives
- 1 (2 ounce) can anchovy fillets rinsed and patted dry (optional)

Make the Vinaigrette: In a jar, let kids combine the oil, vinegar, lemon juice, mustard, garlic, salt and pepper. Shake vigorously, then set aside.


Assemble the Salad: Working together with your kids, arrange the lettuce over a large serving platter. Top with mounds of the green beans, potatoes, tuna, tomatoes, eggs and olives. Drape the anchovy fillets (if using) over potatoes.

Drizzle vinaigrette over the salad. Serve.



While boating or catching some rays at the end of this summer and you're going for a swim, don't forget to check the water temperature before jumping in. This often overlooked preparation is very important for safety. Even if the weather forecasts are predicting sunny hot days, the water temperature most likely won't match the warmth of the surrounding

air. Swimming in cold water can be unpleasant and is dangerous.

Hypothermia is your body's reaction to cold temperatures which can reduce your survival. The risk of hypothermia in the summer is greatest for activities in and around very cold water, especially when swimming. You may think that you get hypothermia in icy winter temperatures, but cold water can have the same effect, when the temperature isn't nearly as low.


Lastly, remember to always wear a life jacket when in or near water. When selecting a life jacket, you should check that it is U.S. Coast Guard approved, appropriate for the specific water activity and fits properly. With that in mind, the best life jacket is the one you will wear.

### **FWP To Work With Partners To Determine Cause Of Trout Declines On Rivers In** Southwest Montana

— Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks -

#### Studies to focus on fish mortality, origins and health

HELENA - Dead trout. Sick trout. Trout with fungus on their skin. What is going on with the fish of the Big Hole, Beaverhead and Ruby Rivers?

Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks in partnership with the Montana Cooperative Fishery Research Unit (MCFRU) at Montana State University wants to find out. Together, they are launching three studies to determine what is affecting fish abundance in these streams. A fourth study, conducted by FWP, will look at fish health and building capacity to sample fish for diseases.

"Those who work and recreate on these rivers are troubled by what they see happening to the trout populations," said FWP Director Dustin Temple. "FWP is troubled, too, and staff have a plan in place to figure out what's driving the decline in trout health and abundance. FWP along with private and public partners have a long history of effective conservation work on these rivers. This plan is the first next step towards understanding how those same partners can turn the current circumstance around."

FWP fisheries staff in southwest Montana and MC-FRU are finalizing how best to tackle this challenge. While the details are new, this collaborative is a familiar one. The research unit is a long-standing collaboration among FWP, MSU, U.S. Geological Survey and the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service. Its mission is to conduct fisheries research, educate future fishery professionals and provide technical assistance to fisheries biologists working for state and federal agencies, nonprofits and industry.

"We've worked with FWP on hundreds of projects since our inception in 1963," said Dr. Al Zale, the leader of MCFRU and a professor at MSU.

Those projects included native species restoration, fish diseases - especially whirling disease, catchand-release mortality, predation, Missouri and Yellowstone river fisheries and much more.

FWP's Region 3 fisheries manager Mike Duncan and his staff are comparing notes with MCFRU.

"We all met several times to come up with a plan of what knowledge gaps to fill," Duncan said.

The three studies with MCFRU will focus on adult mortality, juvenile origins and survival and fish diseases.

Since 2011, trout numbers in these rivers have steadily declined and are now near historic lows. While those declines can be linked to low flows and warm water temperatures, the research projects will take a more in-depth look at other factors that may be affecting these fisheries.

The adult mortality study will involve tagging and tracking fish, Duncan said. FWP staff will capture and tag fish on the Big Hole, Beaverhead and Ruby rivers, along with the Madison River. The project will assess how flows, water temperatures, angling and disease influence survival.

As part of the study, fish biologists Matt Jaeger and Jim Olsen are developing adaptive management plans that will inform fishing regulations on the Big Hole, Beaverhead and Ruby rivers. "This could include spawning closures and catch-and-release as examples," Duncan said.

The juvenile study will look at where fish are born and their spawning and rearing habitat. "We'll mainly be looking in tributaries," Duncan said. Biologists will sample the fish's otolith, or ear bone, to determine where the fish has lived and traveled during its life. This work will help focus and direct potential habitat projects.

The third project will examine the level that disease is impacting trout populations on these three rivers. It will include testing for novel pathogens and help determine better ways to routinely sample fish for disease in the future.

Some of these projects will involve recruiting graduate students to work with MCFRU. "These usually take four or five years in fisheries science because of the seasonal cycles that regulate nature," Zale said.

To accompany these projects, FWP will increase fish health monitoring and reporting resources. "We want to get a better handle on environment triggers and how pathogens are affecting the fisheries." Duncan said.

The public can participate in fish health monitoring by reporting dead and sick-looking fish on the new web portal fwp.mt.gov/sickfish.



### A Low-Labor Labor Day

It's a quandary. How do we avoid spending Labor Day laboring in the kitchen, but also celebrate the last hurrah of summer with a delicious meal? Here's how!

To finish this off, we'll have pillowy pita bread, warmed on the grill. This delicious combination is seasonal, festive and affordable.

#### MEDITERRANEAN CHICKEN AND VEGGIE KABOBS

Total Time: 35 minutes Yield: 4 kabobs

#### What You'll Need:

- 4 long metal skewers or bamboo skewers
- 1 1/2 pounds boneless, skinless chicken thighs, cut into 1 1/2-inch pieces
- 2 large red bell peppers, cut into 1 1/2-inch pieces
- 1 medium zucchini, sliced into 1/2inch rounds
- medium summer squash, sliced into
- 1/2-inch rounds 1 medium red onion, cut into 1 1/2-
- inch pieces 1 cup bottled Italian dressing Pita bread for serving

#### Here's How:

If you're using bamboo skewers, soak them in water for 30 minutes prior to use.

Thread the chicken and vegetables onto the skewers. Place the kabobs into a 9-inch-by-13-inch casserole

dish and pour the Italian dressing on top. Cover with plastic wrap and marinate in the refrigerator for a least 30 minutes or up to 24 hours.

Cook for 8 to 10 minutes per side, or until the chicken is cooked through. Let the kabobs rest for 5 minutes before serving. While you wait, warm the pita bread on the grill.

#### EASY TZATZIKI SAUCE WITH **FETA**

Yield: 4 (1/3 cup) servings Time: 10 minutes

#### What You'll Need:

1 (approximately 10 ounce) cucumber

1 cup plain Greek yogurt

Juice and zest of one lemon 2 cloves garlic, minced

2 tablespoons chopped fresh dill or 2 teaspoons dried dill

1/4 cup (2 ounces) feta cheese, crumbled

Black pepper, to taste

#### Here's How:

Using a box grater, grate the cucumber on the largest grating side, then squeeze it in a clean kitchen towel to


remove most (but not all) of the liquid. Place the cucumber in a medium bowl and add the yogurt, lemon, garlic, dill and feta. Stir to combine and set aside so the flavors can marry. This can be made in advance and refrigerated, if desired. Before serving, add black pepper to taste and squeeze a lemon wedge over the bowl and stir once more. This recipe easily doubles, and any leftovers can be refrigerated for three to four days.

## EarthTalk® From the Editors of E - The Environmental Magazine



Fixing it and keeping it up and running might be the greenest thing you can do if your ride has seen better days.

Dear EarthTalk: The engine is fried on my old Honda Civic. What's the most environmentally friendly thing to do with this car? – Tom C. Venice, CA

Studies show that the typical combustion engine has a lifetime expectation of about 200,000 miles. For the average American, reaching this mileage takes about 14 years. Surprisingly, a survey by Zebra found that the average American only keeps their longest-owned car for eight years. The manufacturing of new cars, even electric ones, generates heavy emissions, contributing to pollution. Large automotive conglomerates like Stellantis (parent company of well-known brands like RAM, Maserati, Jeep, Chrysler and Dodge) are now focusing on extending car lifetimes and reusing parts to reduce carbon emissions.

One obvious option is engine repair or replacement. Repairing or replacing your car's engine, though it may seem like a weak investment, is more environmentally friendly than buying a brand-new car. However, older cars often have poor fuel efficiency, so it is good to check online databases to compare your old car's fuel efficiency with newer models you're considering.

Another possibility is to convert your gasoline-powered engine to electric. But it is no easy task, as you'll have to not only remove and replace the engine itself but also the transmission, gas tank and exhaust system. This option is certainly more eco-friendly than buying a new car, and you'll save on fuel costs. However, the immediate costs for the conversion kits, accessories and installation service can range from \$7,000 to \$20,000, making it reasonable only if you plan to keep your car for a while.

If your car is truly beyond repair, buying a hybrid or electric vehicle is likely the best option. Then if you're truly eco-motivated, you can choose to recycle your old car's parts yourself. In doing so, make sure to do so responsibly. Drain and recycle used motor oil. Some recycling centers accept it for re-refining and repurposing, and certain locations of Auto Zone and O'Reilly Auto Parts will recycle engine oil and filters for no cost. The same firms may also be willing to buy your car's battery for a small amount. The car's tires, if in good condition, can be held onto for spares or sold for repurposing.

Beyond those simple tasks, you'll need an auto-sal-vage yard or junkyard to handle the rest. They will crush the car frame and chassis. The metal is then melted and repurposed. Car glass is laminated, so it cannot be mainstream recycled. However, your local junkyard may have contacts with large auto glass manufacturers, many of whom, according to only1autoglass, "are innovating and coming up with new ways to recycle auto glass, for multiple reuses." This practice isn't the norm throughout the industry, says only1, but it is gaining in popularity.



#### **Spinal Cord Injury Misdiagnosed** as Blood Pressure Stroke

DEAR DR. ROACH: Have you ever heard of a "low blood pressure stroke"? That was my husband's (incorrect) diagnosis several years back when he suddenly could not move his arms and legs. He was told that not enough oxygen was getting to his spine. (His blood pressure is historically low, usually around 90/60.)

That lasted about seven months, and he was bedridden the entire time. He then went to a neurosurgeon and was (correctly) diagnosed with a spinal cord injury. He had C1-C2 surgery and had use of his limbs the next day. After months of physical therapy, he regained a lot of function.

We've never heard of that diagnosis before or after his experience. Does it really exist? - E.S.K.

ANSWER: The brain has tremendous ability to regulate its own blood flow under a very wide range of blood pressures, but there are some limits. When a person is used to very high blood pressure levels, such as 200/110 for months or years, a sudden drop to 90/60 (or even 120/80 sometimes) can cause a stroke. That's the main reason we don't lower blood pressure too quickly in people who have had very high blood pressure levels for a long time. It takes weeks or months for the brain to recover its ability to regulate blood flow.

In a person who has a heart attack, prolonged low blood pressure (or no blood pressure) will also cause brain damage. That's why starting CPR as quickly as possible is so critical in order to preserve brain function.

In both of these cases, not enough blood is getting to the central nervous system (the brain, the spinal cord and the retinas), which can lead to cell death - the hallmark of a stroke. But these are extreme cases.

A healthy person whose normal blood pressure is around 90/60 is at risk for fainting when suddenly standing; however, they are at a lower-than-average risk for heart disease and stroke. The diagnosis of "a low blood pressure stroke" for your husband doesn't make any sense at all to me, and advanced imaging of the brain should have made it abundantly clear that it was not the right diagnosis.

I'm shocked that he wasn't treated correctly for that long. But I'm very happy to hear that his neurosurgeon did not assume the diagnosis of a stroke, instead making the correct diagnosis and performing the procedure to help him recover. Your husband is fortunate that he still had neurological function to recover after such a long time, since spinal cord injuries generally heal better when treated promptly.

DEAR DR. ROACH: My primary care physician and blood specialist claim there is nothing that will increase white blood cell count. Are there any supplements that I can take or foods I can eat to improve the low count? - R.J.L.

**ANSWER:** The question is, why is your white blood cell count low? Some people have low white blood cell counts for no reason; it runs in families, so there aren't any health concerns there. However, there are a large variety of blood diseases that cause low white cell counts. Some affect the lymphocytes, while others affect the granulocytes (the two main types of white cells).

Nutritional deficiencies are extremely rare in North America (vitamin B12, folic acid and copper are the exceptions that should be looked for), so neither diet nor supplements are usually helpful. If there's an absence of blood disease or symptoms, low white blood cell counts usually do not need treatment.

### **Hood Ornament**

Looking for a little luxury? This "Spirit of Ecstasy" figure replicates the hood ornament from Rolls-Royce cars. In 1909, car enthusiast John Douglas-Scott-Montagu commissioned sculptor Charles Sykes to create a mascot for his Rolls-Royce. Sykes made a sculpture of a woman bent at the waist, leaning forward so her robe flows behind her like wings. The model was Eleanor Thornton, Montagu's secretary and, secretly, lover.

By 1911, Sykes's sculpture was made the official Rolls-Royce hood ornament. "Spirit of Ecstasy" is its official name, but it is also known as the "Flying Lady" or the "Silver Lady." The hood ornament was originally silver plated, but has since been made in other silver tone metals like chrome or stainless steel.

This brass version is a reproduction. It sold for \$210 at Morphy Auctions – a very low price when compared to an actual Rolls-Royce car.

My grandmother loved Precious Moments figurines. She gave me the Precious Moments figurine of a bride called "Someday My Love" when I got married 20 years ago. Is it worth anything?

Precious Moments, like Beanie Babies, were wildly popular and people collected them assuming they would increase in value. Most have not. Artist and illustrator Samuel Butcher began drawing pictures of stylized, cute children in the 1970s. He and a friend began a company to make and sell greeting cards and posters that featured his "Precious Moments" artwork. In 1978, Enesco Corp. developed a line of porcelain Precious Moments figurines. Demand was high. Sales kept growing, too many different figurines were made and the market crashed. Many buyers still love them, but they sell for very low prices. Your "Someday My Love" figurine was made in 1988. It sells for anywhere from \$14 to \$25.






