Martin Luther King Jr Day Third Monday in January — National Day Calendar —



On the third Monday in January, Martin Luther King Jr Day honors the American clergyman, activist, Civil Rights Movement leader. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.(January 15, 1929 – April 4, 1968) is best known for his role in advancing civil rights using nonviolent civil disobedience. King has become a national icon in the history of American progressivism.

Education

A gifted and friendly student, King attended Morehouse College, earning a B.A. in sociology. Combining a passion for racial equality with a rediscovered spirituality, King then attended Crozer Theological Seminary, following in his father's and grandfather's footsteps earning a Bachelors of Divinity.

Shortly after completing his Ph.D. in theology at Boston University in 1955, a 42-year-old Rosa Parks (See Rosa Parks Day observed December 1st) refused to give up her seat on a bus in Montgomery, Alabama. The opportunity for the NAACP to bring their civil rights efforts to the forefront was before them. and they chose King to lead the successful city-wide boycott of the Montgomery transit system.

Young Civil Rights Movement

Just over a year later, King and over 60 other ministers and activists founded the Southern Christian Leadership Conference. Together, they coordinated nonviolent protests and gave the young civil rights movement a voice.

Through the next twelve years, King would be influential in organizing marches, sit-ins, and political rallies for civil rights. For example, during a 1963 March on Washington, D.C. for Jobs and Freedom, King spoke before more than 200,000 regarding the challenges African Americans face. His "I Have a Dream" speech has gone down in many history books as one of the greatest speeches ever given. Brutally honest, with a call to action and a vision of hope, King's speech resonated throughout the nation.

Selma

In early 1964, 1,500 men and women met a wall of state troopers during a march outside Selma. There, King led the marchers in prayer and avoided any confrontation with authorities. On July 2, President force the issue of desegregation. Angry crowds often Lyndon B. Johnson signed the Civil Rights Act of met these busses, attacking the Freedom Riders. At 1964, outlawing discrimination based on race, color, least 60 Freedom Rides were conducted throughout became the youngest recipient of the Nobel Peace state Commerce Committee to enforce its ruling six Movement.

In early 1965, Selma, Alabama, became the center of the Civil Rights movement. Congress introduced new voting rights legislation. It proposed banning literacy tests and mandating federal oversight where tests were administered. Additionally, it gave the U.S. attorney general the duty of challenging the use of poll taxes for state and local elections. Televised violence in February of that year resulted in the death of Jimmie Lee Jackson. King's presence and President Johnson's support of the marchers helped bring peace. Throughout the next month, marchers continued between Selma and Montgomery. Congress passed the Voting Rights Act in August of that year.

Author, speaker, father, theologian, activist, King died on April 4, 1968, when James Earl Ray assassinated him in Memphis, Tennessee. King arrived in Memphis with other SCLC members supporting a sanitation workers' strike. They stayed at the Lorraine Motel, and Ray's bullet struck King on the balcony. Riots and violence would follow, and President Johnson would call for peace, referring to King as the "apostle of nonviolence."

Martin Luther King Jr Day History

While President Ronald Reagan signed the observance into law in 1983, Martin Luther King Jr. Day was first observed as a U.S. federal holiday in 1986.

Martin Luther King Jr. FAQ

Q. Is Martin Luther King Jr. the only American honored with a federal holiday?

A. No, but Martin Luther King Jr. is part of a select group of three men who have been honored with federal holidays. The other two are Abraham Lincoln and George Washington.

Q. Was Martin Luther King Jr. awarded the Nobel Peace Prize?

A. Yes. Martin Luther King Jr. became the youngest recipient of the Nobel Peace Prize in 1964.

Q. Was Martin Luther King Jr. a Freedom Rider?

A. No, but King did show his support for the Freedom Riders in several ways. In 1961 during the Civil Rights Movement, a group of young Black and White college students took to riding interstate busses to religion, sex, or national origin. That same year, King the South, affecting change that caused the Inter-Prize for his unswerving work in the Civil Rights years prior that denounced the separate but equal doctrine.

Advertising Toys


Antique toys, especially those that move and make noise, are popular with both young and old, and many are very expensive. Advertising toys bring back special memories and are wanted by those who collect advertising and those who want toys.

This car with "Moxie" on the side is in mint to good condition. It is a rare blue version of an 8-inch-long tin toy car with a man on a horse in a Moxie jacket and cap driving a Moxiemobile. It sold for \$2,600 at a Morford's auction in Cazenovia, New York.

Moxie was a drink introduced in 1885, two years before Coca-Cola. It claimed to be a health drink and was flavored with bitter herbs. The taste was so strange that people said you had to be brave to drink it. So by 1930, the word "moxie" become a slang term for brave or daring, and "He had a lot of moxie" became a common saying. The company was CURRENT PRICES purchased by Coca-Cola in 2018.

I have a book, "The Life of George Washington-Maps and Subscriber's Names," published in 1807 by C.P. Wayne of Philadelphia. The book includes several map "plans" for different states, a list of subscribers, and a signature of the subscriber. The book is in fair condition given its age. Can you tell me the approximate value?

This book is part of a biography of George Washington written by John Marshall between 1804 and 1807. It was originally published in five volumes. Marshall, who later became justice of the Supreme Court, was a friend of Washington and served with him in the Revolutionary War. First editions of the books are rare and sell for high prices. Copies of the book of maps have sold for several hundred to more than one thousand dollars. You should contact an antiquarian book dealer or an auction house that sells antique books to see what your book would sell for. Copies have sold from \$75 to \$1,700 in recent auctions.

Soup Swap Offers Fun by the Spoonful

What do you get when you mix a few friends, a few soups and a chilly afternoon? You get one fantastic get-together! It even has its own holiday. Saturday, Jan. 21 is National Soup Swap Day.

Here's how to throw the easiest, least

expensive, most appreciated party of the season: a soup swap. Invite a small number of friends, asking each to bring several quarts of their favorite homemade soup. One quart of each soup will be heated and sampled during the party, along with breads, snacks and beverages. Before going home, everyone exchanges soups. The best part is everyone goes home with a variety of soups to keep them cozy in

the cold days ahead.

Soup swaps work best when you invite four to six people. Everyone brings the same number of quarts of soup as there will be people attending the party. For example, if four people will attend, each should bring four quarts. This makes one quart to sample during the party and three quarts to give to friends. You won't bring home your own soup. The host will decide if they will provide soup garnishes like sour cream, crackers and breads, along with beverages, snacks and dessert. Or the guests can bring those items, potluck style.

Send invitations two weeks in

advance, and be sure to communicate clearly how the swap party works and what each guest should bring on your invitations. Ask about food allergies and share that information. It's fun to share recipes, so ask guests to provide printed recipes or to send them to you before the party, then you can print them as a party favor. Guests will label their soups with the name of soup, reheating instructions and any additional comments or ingredients if necessary.

As the host, decide how your guests should bring their soups to swap. Guests might bring their soup in containers that they don't mind giving away. You could consider getting inexpensive quart-size to-go soup containers at a restaurant supply store and sending them to guests before the party. Alternatively, see if everyone has quart-size canning jars they don't mind swapping.

During the party, you will need to heat one quart of each soup. Alternatively, ask guests to bring soup for sharing in their own slow cookers. The remaining quarts of soups should arrive frozen or refrigerated. I recommend either emptying a shelf of your refrigerator or preparing a cooler to keep the soups cold during the party. Here's a recipe for the easiest soup ever. It's fresh and light, with only

three ingredients, and it's cooked in the time it takes to boil the liquid.

TOMATO TORTELLINI SOUP

Yield: 4 quarts (8 to 12 servings) Time: 15 minutes

8 cups (64 ounces) chicken or vegetable broth

2 (28 ounce) cans diced tomatoes, Italian style (with liquid)

1 (19 ounce) bag of frozen cheese tortellini

In a soup pot, heat the stock and tomatoes to a boil over medium-high heat. When at a rolling boil, add the tortellini and cook according to the package directions. Turn off heat and serve hot.

Here are some variations to try:

Chicken Tomato Tortellini Soup – Add 4 cups shredded cooked chicken.

Cream of Tomato Tortellini Soup – Add 1 cup heavy cream after cooking the tortellini.

Fiesta Tomato Tortellini Soup

– Add 1/4 cup fresh cilantro and
use tomatoes with green chilies.
Squeeze the juice of one lime into
the soup



The Birds And The Seeds: Let's Talk About Winter Bird Feeding

Turn your backyard into a bird B&B with these helpful wintertime bird-feeding tips

We all know that neighbor that takes bird feeding to Olympic games-level extremes. With tree limbs sagging under the weight of countless feeders and a back lawn that looks like it was ripped straight from Augusta Country Club, they stand out on their back porch with arms outstretched as a myriad of birds swoop in to feed directly from their palms.

That may be a bit of an exaggeration, but you don't need to be Snow White to attract backvard birds. Many species — including finches, chickadees, jays, nuthatches, sparrows, doves and more – may very well settle on your backyard bed and breakfast with a proper bird-feeding setup this winter.

Usually, feeding wild animals is not a smart move. Feeding birds, however, is a special case, since they don't often become dependent on feeders alone, and instead use feeders to supplement their daily natural diet. Winter feeding also gives a little assistance to our feathered friends during the harsh, colder months.

Here are a few ways to spice up your bird-feeding buffet and enjoy an enchanting opportunity to observe wildlife right in your own backyard.

Seed. It's what's for dinner

Before you go hanging your feeder (or feeders) all across your backyard, you'll need some seed. Depending on the types of birds you're hoping to attract, there are many feed and feeder options available. For instance, hanging-style feeders can attract songbirds, such as house finches, chickadee, jays, nuthatches and others. Thistle feeders can bring goldfinches, siskins and house finches, and suet can attract woodpeckers, chickadees and nuthatches.

There are many kinds of birdseed out there on the market. Be sure to source your birdseed from reputable sources to avoid dust, insects, weed seeds or any other impurities from making their way into your feeder. Black-oil sunflower seed is a favorite of many species. Millet and cracked corn are favorites for many ground-feeding birds. Finches and siskins love nyjer thistle.

To avoid freeloaders like squirrels, rats and mice ruining your supply, store birdseed in tight, waterproof containers. This will also help prevent mold.

Feeder placement

when it comes to drive-thru windows. Placing a bird backyard.

feeder too close to hazards can end up doing more harm than good. Avoid placing feeders near windows or doors, and keep placement height and accessibility in mind. Predators such as hawks or free-ranging house cats can quickly become uninvited backyard dinner guests when feeders are put out in the open or near low-hanging ledges.

Wash it all down

A hearty meal wouldn't be complete without a drink. Birds utilize birdbaths throughout the year not only to stay clean but to keep themselves hydrated – a luxury we humans should not try in our baths

If possible, include a birdbath in your backyard bed and breakfast. There are several types on the market, but you can't go wrong with a simple clay potting

This time of year, however, it might be a little troublesome keeping that bath ice-free. There are a couple solutions, including special birdbath heaters, to help keep their baths from freezing over. And no, they don't come with little mini Whirlpool jets and colored LED lights.

Sanitation

A bird's bath or feeder only does its job when it's clean. Imagine inviting over the whole cul-de-sac for a hot tub party and leaving the chlorine float in the garage. It's very important that backyard bird enthusiasts keep their feeders and birdbaths tidy and disinfect at least once a month to prevent the spreading of diseases.

Along those lines, aim for using perch-style feeders rather than open, saucer-style feeders. Because of their openness and contamination from bird feces, open feeders and baths can become a breeding ground for disease.

To clean your feeders, make a household bleach solution using one part household bleach mixed with nine parts lukewarm water. Make enough solution to immerse an empty, cleaned feeder completely for two to three minutes, then air dry.



No beak, no feathers, no service

Remember that feeding wildlife (other than birds) is not recommended. Birds are unique in that they don't solely rely or become hooked on free, backyard birdseed. The same cannot be said about other wildlife. If food set out for birds is being eaten by other wildlife, move the feeder to a safe location or discontinue feeding.

Feeding birds is a gratifying experience that can be enjoyed by anyone. So pull out the binoculars and the bird-watching guide and enjoy this simple pas-Birds don't have the same pleasures that we do time all year round right from the comfort of your







Hunter Recipes:

Smashed Quail With Mountain Dew Ponzu

Randy King Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game -



Randy King is a recipe contributor to Idaho Fish & Game and lives in Nampa, Idaho. He is a trained chef, passionate hunter and angler, author of the cookbook "Chef in the Wild," and has written food articles in numerous national publications.

One day while hunting along the Snake River, my buddy and I played "hop-scotch-boats" with another group of hunters. It never failed that when they would float past us - a covey of quail would flush. The boaters would offer shooting suggestions to us after we shot (often unsuccessfully) at the birds. Comments like "Oh! Just missed!" and "A little behind that one!" could be heard. They thought this was hilarious, though at the time Ryan and I were not as amused.

It ocurred to me later that this was a classic case of armchair quarterback, and an example of shared humor among people participating in the same activity. Most hunters I know, myself included, are fantastic at giving advice but struggle in the application. I would be lucky to get one in five birds, but still have expert advice on shooting tips, chokes, strategy. And in the end, the memories live on because the "misses" are the ones our friends don't let us forget.

Butchering & Field Dressing:

Pluck 8 quail and remove entrails, head, and lower

To "smash" the quail lay them on their backs and press firmly down on the breast. This will flatten out the bird, allowing it to cook more evenly.

Another option for a "smashed quail" it to spatchcock it by cut the backbone and ribs out of the bird with a pair of kitchen scissors. Place the bird breast side down and cut on along both sides of the backbone. Remove the rib cage with two additional cuts, and press flat.

Smashed Ponzu Quail with Soba **Noodle Salad Recipe:**

Like many people of my generation Mountain Dew was a food group growing up. The drink has two major flavors in it – citrus and sugar. A classic Asian-style ponzu sauce has three flavors – citrus, sugar and soy. Use the Mountain Dew as a base and you are 2/3 the way to a ponzu sauce.

Mountain Dew Ponzu

- · 1 can Mountain Dew
- ½ cup soy sauce
- 1 tsp red chili flakes
- · 2 green onions, sliced
- · 1 thumb sized chunk of ginger, peeled and sliced

Add all of the ingredients to a small sauce pan, and bring to a simmer for 10 minutes. Chill to room temperature. Remember to save a small amount of ponzu, that will not have raw meat in it, for pouring over the final cooked dish.

Put the quail and ponzu sauce in a Ziploc bag, and marinate in the fridge overnight.

Place marinated quail on a heated grill, and pour small amounts of the marinade over the meat. The ponzu is high in sugar so be careful not to burn the bird. Repeat until a firm crust of sauce forms on the

Soba Noodle Salad

With this recipe any type of round noodle will work. I have used angel hair and spaghetti in the past. Soba noodles are just a Japanese take on the thin round noodle made from wheat. You can find dried or fresh soba noodles in most grocery stores.

- · 12 oz cooked and chilled soba noodles
- · 1 lime, juice and zest
- 1 red pepper, sliced thin
- ½ red onion, sliced thin
- · 2 tablespoons soy sauce
- · 1 tablespoon sesame seeds
- · 2 each green onions
- · Salt and pepper

Toss all ingredients in a bowl. Mix zest and juice evenly. Season with salt and pepper.

Bringing it all together

Place a portion of soba noodle in the center of a plate. Pour a small amount of mountain dew ponzu around the noodles. Top with hot "smashed" quail and enjoy!

Public Comment Deadline For Several Proposals February 3 Part 1 of 2

— Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks —

HELENA - Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks is seeking public comment on several proposals slated to go to the Fish and Wildlife Commission in February. Comment is open through Feb. 3.

After public comment, commissioners can offer amendments to the proposals as they see fit. The proposals and supporting documents, commissioner amendments and collected public comment are available on the FWP website.

The commission will make a final decision on these proposals at its meeting on Feb. 22.

Fish removal projects for 2023-2026

For 2023-2026, there are 26 fish removal projects planned that have not previously been approved by the commission, all intended for native species conservation. There may be additional projects brought separately to the commission for approval, such as instances where illegal introductions or invasive species are discovered or for an unexpected conservation need. Proposed projects include a combination of chemical and mechanical removals.

Future Fisheries Improvement Projects, winter 2023 funding cycle

For the winter 2023 funding cycle, the Citizen Review Panel recommends funding 10 of 11 submitted proposals at a program cost of \$471,419.50. Matching funds total \$2.1 million and other contributions total \$380,000, producing a ratio of \$5.3 in external contributions to every \$1 of FFIP funding.

Paddlefish regulation proposed change for Intake **Bypass Channel**

The Intake Fish Bypass Channel, at Intake Diversion Dam on the Yellowstone River, was completed in April 2022. Objectives for the project are to improve upstream and downstream fish passage for pallid sturgeon and other native species, including paddlefish, while maintaining water diversions into the Lower Yellowstone Project Main Canal. Snagging for paddlefish is very popular in the lower Yellowstone and can lead to high concentrations of anglers targeting paddlefish during spawning migrations. Since it is not yet fully understood how the fish bypass channel will influence fish movements and angler behavior, the department proposes closing the bypass channel to snagging to avoid bycatch of migrating pallid sturgeon and other native species. Closing the bypass to snagging could also reduce potential conflicts between paddlefish anglers and FWP monitoring crews. The bypass channel will remain open for passage by boats and for angling by other methods.

Upper Missouri River Reservoirs 2022 regulation changes

Monitoring surveys in 2021 and 2022 found that yellow perch abundance in Holter Reservoir was well above management goals. For yellow perch management, the plan recommends more liberal fishing regulations when abundance increases above goal range. To maximize yellow perch fishing opportunity while minimizing the impact to the population, the department is proposing to change the Holter Reservoir harvest regulation for yellow perch from 25 daily and in possession to 25 daily and 50 in possession.

In the river section from Toston to Canyon Ferry, monitoring has shown stable walleye abundance, but size structure is comprised primarily of large fish. In the river section, the department proposes to modify the current regulation of 10 daily, only one over 15 inches, to the Central Fishing District standard regulation of five walleye per day, 10 in possession. The current regulation, which only allows harvest of one fish over 15 inches, is unnecessarily restrictive and there is no biological reason to restrict walleye harvest to this extent. In addition, the standard walleye limit for the Central Fishing District has the advantage of being simple and easy to implement.

Bear Creek Angus Conservation Easement restate-

Since 1994, FWP has held a conservation easement (CE) on the Bear Creek Angus Ranch. A restatement in 2000 and 2001 separated this easement into four portions, one of which is the Bear Creek Ostler Portion. This portion represents 768 acres adjacent to the Bear Creek Wildlife Management Area (WMA). The current CE terms allow for four building envelopes which total 40 acres, three of which allow for residential site development. The current CE also contains an agricultural subdivision clause, which allows the property to be divided and sold to separate owners. This proposal, which was brought to FWP by the landowners, would allow the landowners to remove from the CE and sell 1 acre with an existing residential house and outbuildings. In exchange, they would reduce the current size of building envelopes from 40 acres to 16.5 acres, preserving 23.5 acres for wildlife habitat. The proposal also includes removing from the CE an option for a 5□acre building envelope next to Bear Creek WMA, which is consistently used by wintering elk and deer, and removing language related to agricultural subdivision, ensuring the property would remain as one ownership unit into the future. This proposal would not involve any monetary exchange between the parties.

Otter Creek LLS Islands -- expansion of Indian Fort Fishing Access Site on the Yellowstone River

FWP proposes to acquire two land parcels totaling 107 acres that are part of an island complex in the Yellowstone River upstream of Reed Point. FWP plans to preserve them in a natural state and to provide recreational access using \$140,150 in Natural Resource Damage Program (NRDP) mitigation funds resulting from the 2011 Silvertip Oil Spill. This site is adjacent to the Indian Fort Fishing Access Site and four river miles below Bratten Fishing Access Site (FAS). The islands are in a reach of the Yellowstone that FWP considers high priority for additional public access. The NRDP funding may be used to secure unprotected cottonwood riparian areas to allow for natural function of river processes and recruitment of large woody debris – typically cottonwoods – to the river during floods. This natural function builds islands and provides habitat for terrestrial and aquatic species. The landowner approached the NRDP with a desire for the parcels to be sold to an entity that would preserve the sites to support natural river function and provide public

Grilled Sweet Potatoes

We steam and slice sweet potatoes, and then give them a turn on the grill to create this deliciously unexpected side dish.

- 2-1/2 pounds sweet potatoes, peeled if you like
 - 1 tablespoon olive oil
 - 1/4 teaspoon salt
 - 1/4 teaspoon coarsely ground black pepper Parsley, for garnish
- 1. Prepare outdoor grill for covered, direct grilling on medium.
- 2. In 5- to 6-quart saucepot or Dutch oven, place collapsible steamer basket and 1 inch water. Cover saucepot; heat water to boiling on high on range top. Cut sweet potatoes into 1/2-inch-thick diagonal slices.



Improvements Are On The Way To The Farragut **Shooting Range Center**

Use of the Farragut Shooting Range Center is increasing, and so is opportunity for its patrons

Many new opportunities are already being enjoyed by the public at the Farragut Shooting Range Center, and more are to come in the years ahead. If you've never been to the range before, here's a glimpse at what it has to offer.

If you haven't checked out the new 3D targets along the 20-station 3D archery range through the woods, make sure to swing by for a fun shoot. There you will find full-size targets for deer, mountain goat, moose and many other animals.

The walking path to access the 3D range is now plowed through the winter, so it is available for year-around use.

Idaho Fish and Game recently conducted a survey of range patrons to gauge their level of satisfaction with range offerings, along with a list of desires and frustrations.

When asked what they most enjoyed about the range, patrons responded with:

- · "safe, controlled and well managed"
- "clean grounds and impeccably maintained shooting areas"
- · "knowledgeable and friendly Range Safety Officers"

When asked what they found less than satisfactory, patrons responded with:

- · "location of vault toilet"
- "no long distance shooting opportunity"

When asked if they would support an increase in the daily use fee from \$5 to \$10, 96% of patrons responded, "yes".

Fish and Game appreciates the feedback, and we are listening. We have improved our staffing capacity at the range to better serve range patrons. In addition, the volunteer RSOs that work at the range are all NRA-certified, and they are all passionate about shooting sports. They are the backbone of daily operations at the range.

We are exploring options to install an additional restroom on the range, and while we would love to offer long-distance shooting opportunity, we are currently unable to do so because of legal restrictions until 2038.

Despite that, we have plans to offer more opportunity in the future, including a youth 3D archery range, a raised 3D archery shooting platform (to simulate shooting from a tree stand), enhanced parking areas, a 25-yard multi-use range (airgun, pellet gun and archery), new clay throwers for the four shotgun stands and more.



It's no secret that the cost of doing business these days has increased. To support our ability to provide impeccable service and enhanced opportunity to range patrons, we will be increasing the daily use fee from \$5 to \$10 effective January 1, 2023. The additional revenue generated from the fee increase will be exclusively dedicated to operations, maintenance and enhancement of the Farragut Shooting Range Center. Thank you for your continued support of the range!

Kids Can Help Bake This One-Step Lemon Pound Cake

Dog-eared recipes deserve some review now and again, and I'm glad I rediscovered this classic from my mom's recipe box. It's a never-fail, fabulous, one-step pound cake that is a perfect "first" cake baking experience for kids.

Read the recipe together and let them search for the dry ingredients in the pantry, measuring cups from a kitchen drawer, eggs and sour cream from the refrigerator, and lemons in the fruit bowl. Grate, measure, pour and mix it all together in just

Nothing could be easier than dumping it all in a bowl and mixing it up for a delicious cake to serve as your next afternoon snack or as a dessert at a family picnic. You can easily change up the flavor by substituting orange zest for lemon, and even reducing the sour cream and replacing it with orange juice. Don't be surprised if it becomes your family's signature recipe. Let's get started:

ONE-STEP LEMON POUND CAKE

- 2-1/4 cups flour
 - cups sugar
 - 1/2 teaspoon salt
 - teaspoon baking soda
 - cup soft unsalted butter, at room temperature

- 1 cup sour cream, at room temperature
- eggs, at room temperature
- teaspoon pure vanilla extract
- teaspoons grated lemon zest

To glaze:

- cup confectioners' sugar, sifted
- 2 tablespoons freshly squeezed lemon juice

Preheat oven to 325° F. Grease and flour one Bundt cake pan. Put all of the cake ingredients into a mixer bowl and blend at low speed for about 1 minute. Beat an additional 3 minutes at medium speed. It will be a light yellow color and creamy. Pour into prepared pan.

Bake 55-60 minutes, or until toothpick inserted into the middle comes out clean. Cool the cake upright on a rack for 15 minutes. Remove from pan and cool completely before glazing.

To glaze, combine the confectioners' sugar and lemon juice in a bowl, mixing with a whisk until smooth. Add more juice for a pourable consistency. Drizzle over the top of the cooled cake and let the glaze dry.

Introducing, The Burbot

It's known as a 'Kootenai leopard' and it tastes like lobster. Introducing, the burbot

This month's Wildlife Express shines a light on these nocturnal, winter-spawning freshwater cod that call the Kootenai River home

Riddle me this: What lives in the Kootenai River, has the body of a cod, the meat of a lobster and the soul patch of Frank Zappa? No, that's not a trick question. There really is a species of freshwater cod that calls the Kootenai River home, but that almost came to an end just 20 years ago. Herein lies the tale of one of Idaho's strangest fish – the burbot.

What's The Deal With Burbot?

Burbot – also known as bubbot, cusk, freshwater cod, ling, lingcod and eelpout – are the only freshwater cod species in North America, and they have a special place in Idaho's heart. With a face that only a mother could love, these long-bodied, cold-water fish are not your run-of-the-mill sport fish. Burbot have flat heads and long bodies that sprout long pectoral fins just behind their gills. Their back-half is eel-like, with stumpy rounded fins. Burbot have brownish-yellow mottled skin, earning them the nickname "Kootenai leopards" among anglers.

As the name implies, these "leopard-like" fish are predatory and feed during the night. They hang out during the day in deep, slow-moving pools, then seek out food such as crayfish or small fish in shallow water. With the help of inward slanting teeth and a funky little chin whisker called a barbel, burbot have no trouble scoping out and hanging on to prey.

Burbot march to the beat of their own drum in more ways than one, but when it comes to reproduction, things get even weirder. Unlike most freshwater fish that spawn in spring or early summer, burbot prefer to do their business in winter. Some Kootenai River burbot will even migrate from watersheds up in Canada, roughly 75 miles away. Spawning can occur from December to late March, with most spawning happening mid-February through mid-March. Females will lay anywhere between 60,000 to 3 million eggs, each being the size a grain of sand. Burbot will often live to 8 to 10 years old, and even longer in other parts of the world.

Unbeknownst to many Idaho anglers, burbot are a healthy sport fish living right here in our backyard, but it didn't always use to be that way.

Bouncing Back

Just 20 years ago, anglers would be hard-pressed to hook a burbot in Idaho's Kootenai River. It was estimated that only 50 fish remained in 2004. Thanks to state's fish species.

an international, multi-state effort including Idaho Fish and Game, the Kootenai Tribe of Idaho and fisheries biologists from Canada and Montana, Kootenai River's burbot population recovered.

Research began in the 1990's, with burbot fishing closed down in 1992 because of a decline in numbers. Biologists started using hoop nets - a non-invasive fish trap - to capture, tag and study these fish. Researchers also tagged burbot with PIT tags to track migration.

In 2004, the Kootenai Tribe of Idaho began operating a burbot hatchery in hopes of increasing the population. The Kootenai Tribe took Canadian-spawned burbot eggs back to the hatchery and hatched the tiny eggs from there. Once they reached adolescence, the young fish were released into the Kootenai River.

From the decades' long research, two important takeaways were found: Burbot weren't very successful at spawning naturally, and hatchery-raised burbot were surviving but still relied on the hatchery to produce more fish for the population to continue growing.

In 2019, the burbot population finally hit its restoration goal. Partners from the original recovery project are still monitoring burbot populations in the Kootenai River fishery.

You Had Me At Lobster Cod

Hit up your buddy to take the rods out on the Kootenai River and its tributaries in mid-winter and you might get a solid "no" before you can even finish your sentence. But tickle their fancy with a prized fresh-water cod that tastes like lobster and it might change their tune.

Anglers will most likely find burbot between mid-February and mid-March when spawning is at its peak, but because burbot fly by night usually, it can be a little challenging to locate them. But before you cast off these unicorn fish as a myth, here are a few fishing tips to help you track down a "Kootenai leopard":

- Fish shallow flats (5-15 feet deep) at dusk or during the night.
- Try river junctions where smaller streams flow into the mainstem of the river.
- If fishing during the day, try dropping a line in 40plus foot deep holes. Burbot like to rest in these deep pockets during the day.
- · Anglers can also try ice fishing for burbot on Bonner Lake.
- Worms and shrimp work well for bait.
- Use weights to get the line down deep towards the bottom.

Fishing for burbot can be a great way to kick off any angler's new year. Be sure to dress warm and bring extra layers in case that North Idaho weather takes a turn. Whether you land one of these leopard-like cod or simply use it as a way to get outdoors this winter, burbot fishing is not only a chance to put a delicious, native fish on the supper table, but a true reminder of the persistence and revitalization of one of our



Public Comment Deadline For Several Proposals February 3 Part 2 of 2

- Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks -

HELENA - Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks is seeking public comment on several proposals slated to go to the Fish and Wildlife Commission in February. Comment is open through Feb. 3.

After public comment, commissioners can offer amendments to the proposals as they see fit. The proposals and supporting documents, commissioner amendments and collected public comment are available on the FWP website.

The commission will make a final decision on these proposals at its meeting on Feb. 22.

501 Pemberton Lane acquisition, Billings

FWP proposes to purchase a 2.442 acre lot at 501 Pemberton Lane in Billings for administrative use. The lot would support FWP and Region 5 operations. The Pemberton Lane lot provides an opportunity to meet many of the current administrative needs in a location that is very close to existing FWP facilities. It would initially be used for storage of equipment and materials, though there is future potential for an indoor shop or administrative facility, and housing for seasonal staff and RV pads and hookups is possible. It may also be possible to utilize the space for Hunter and Bowhunter Education field courses.

If the purchase is approved, FWP would install sidewalks, lighting, and security fencing at the site. FWP would also install sidewalks along 2300 Lake Elmo Drive, the Region 5 administrative office, and a loading zone within the office driveway. During project development, FWP received public requests to install a sidewalk along Lake Elmo Drive for park visitors. This would increase safety for pedestrians as they access the recently improved trail at Lake Elmo State Park. The appraised value (and purchase price) of the Pemberton Lane lot is \$290,000. Due diligence and closing costs are estimated at \$5,200. The cost of improvements for the new lot is estimated at \$177,000. Improvements at the existing office are estimated at \$43,000. Estimated total project cost for the purchase and both areas of improvement are \$515,200.

Ruby Dam Fishing Access Site lease agreement

Ruby Dam FAS is a day-use site at the mouth of Ruby Dam about 7 miles south of Alder on the Ruby Dam Road. FWP operates Ruby Dam FAS under a no-cost recreational lease from Montana Department of Natural Resources and Conservation. The most recent lease expired in August 2022, and FWP wishes to enter a new lease on that site that would be in effect from February 2023 through December 2032. The major terms in the lease remain the same as before: FWP would be responsible for recreational management and maintenance of the site. New terms in the lease would allow for a rustic campground to be added. If that action is contemplated

in the future, the department would conduct EA and public comment process before making a decision. No development is contemplated at this time.

Closure of Fresno Tailwater Fishing Access Site for Bureau of Reclamation Safety of Dams Project

Fresno Tailwater FAS sits below the Fresno Dam in Hill County northwest of Havre. The FAS is part of a memorandum of understand between the Bureau of Reclamation (BOR) and FWP. Ninety percent of the developed FAS site is on BOR property. In the spring of 2023, the BOR will initiate a Safety of Dams project on Fresno Dam that is projected for completion in October 2025. The FAS and the access road to the FAS will be heavily used by contractors to haul and stage materials and equipment during the project. Additionally, Fresno Reservoir will be dewatered. Given the size of the project and necessary activity in and around the FAS, the BOR has asked FWP to close the site to public access during the project.


2023-24 Flathead Indian Reservation Non-Member Fishing and Hunting Regulations

The Confederated Salish and Kootenai Tribes (CSKT) and the State of Montana have a cooperative management agreement on the Flathead Indian Reservation (created under MCA 87-1-228 and through a subsequent state-tribal agreement) that provides for presentation and approval of coordinated tribal regulations and season frameworks for fishing and bird hunting regulations to the Fish and Wildlife Commission. Tribal recommendations are presented to the Confederated Salish and Kootenai Tribal Council, which votes on tentative proposals and opens them to general public review and comment. The council then meets for final adoption. The proposals are also presented to the joint Flathead Reservation Fish and Wildlife Board. Commission approval is subject to final tribal council approval. The tribe is not proposing any hunting or fishing regulation changes for non-members for the 2023-24 regulation year, which spans March 1, 2023, through Feb. 28, 2024.

Wildlife Management Area public use rules

The commission has adopted public use rules biennially, and more recently, annually for FWP lands specifically acquired for the purpose of providing effective fish and wildlife habitat. Those department lands comprise Wildlife Management Areas (WMAs), Wildlife Habitat Protection Areas, and Fisheries Conservation Areas. Rules adopted on a regular schedule are referred to as "seasonal rules" and in this proposal would serve as the public use rules for calendar year 2023. The purpose of these rules is to manage public uses while protecting fish and wildlife habitats. FWP is also currently working on public use Administrative Rules (ARM 12.8.201 12.8.219), revising and combining into one public use rule set for all types of department lands. The revised ARM rules are scheduled to be completed by fall 2023 for 2024 implementation.




