

Dog Goes on Strike Against Leashes

Dear Paw's Corner: My dog "Perry" tugs, fights and whines when I put a collar and leash on him. He will even flop down and refuse to move. I don't know what to do. -- Mike D., Roanoke, Virginia

Dear Mike: Oh, that's frustrating! But you can help Perry to tolerate his collar and leash by making some adjustments and rebuilding a positive association with the leash. Here are a few tips to start with:

• Check the fit and comfort of Perry's collar. Sometimes owners buy stylish collars that look great on their pet but are uncomfortable and either too big or too small.

- Consider a chest halter instead of a collar. This provides a supportive fit and when you tug on the leash, pressure is distributed around a dog's torso rather than its neck.
- Re-introduce Perry to the new collar or halter gradually. Show him the new gear while offering a treat at the same time. When he's eating, gently drape the leash over his back. Give lots of praise at the same time. This starts to create positive connections with the new gear.
- Conduct obedience training at home, in 10-minute sessions, while Perry wears the new collar or halter. Review basic commands of "come," "sit," "stay" and "lie down." Leave the leash off at first.
- Add the leash, but don't tug on it. Continue obedience training while Perry wears the new gear. Take the gear off when done.
- Gradually increase the time your dog wears the collar or harness and leash.

This will take patience, lots of love and encouragement. Always be positive with Perry while retraining to the leash. 

DRY HANKIE TRICK

Stuff a piece of facial tissue or a hankie into the bottom of a tall plastic cup. Turn the cup upside-down and submerge it directly into a sink, bathtub or backyard wading pool filled with water. Push the cup all the way to the bottom of the sink, tub or pool, and bring it straight up and out of

- 2. Now, roll the goop in your hand to form a ball. As you hold it tightly, it behaves like a solid. Squeeze it, and then let it drip through your fingers to discover its unique properties as it flows into the bowl in ribbons. Or, place it on a cookie sheet, press it flat, roll it in a ball or let it go.



Hunter Recipes: Smoked Wild Goose Pho

— Randy King Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game —



Utilize last night's waterfowl leftovers in this tasty recipe

As the days get shorter and colder, the menu again turns to soup season. One of our favorite dishes to order at a restaurant is Vietnamese pho (pronounced "fuh"), and using the leftovers from a smoked goose or duck provides the perfect base for this meal. After years of failing to replicate the flavor of restaurants, this recipe finally succeeds in providing the authentic flavor profile, and using smoked goose is a delicious variation that puts a wild-game-spin on this ultimate comfort food.

The recipe requires a few ingredients that you may not have readily available in your cupboard or fridge, but it is worth it. It's so good that even my 8-year-old daughter requests "goose soup" for her birthday meal, and the dish has been met with unending compliments from anyone who has tasted it.

The smoked goose recipe was provided in a previous Idaho Fish and Game blog and has an option for stovetop cooking or Instant Pot preparation.

Pho broth:

- 1 smoked wild goose carcass
- 3 star anise
- 4 cloves
- 1 cinnamon stick
- 1 tablespoon whole peppercorns
- 1 teaspoon coriander
- 1 teaspoon cardamom
- 1/3 cup fish sauce
- 2 tablespoon soy sauce
- $\bullet 11/2$ tablespoon brown sugar
- 1 inch knob ginger, grated
- 3 cloves garlic, smashed
- 1 onion, halved
- 2 carrots, diced into large chunks
- 2 celery sticks, diced into large chunks

- 1 fennel bulb, halved
- 1 bunch cilantro (uncut with stems)

This recipe can either be made in a large pot or in a pressure cooker, depending on how much time you have. This is a simpler version of pho because we don't roast the veggies, but the smoked goose helps give the broth a roasted flavor. If you have time you can give your veggies a roasted char under the broiler before boiling, but I promise you won't miss it! I also don't tie my spices in cheesecloth. If you have some and want to bundle your spices, this can save a little time in the straining process later. Otherwise, they will all strain out in the end.

Stovetop directions:

In a large pot with a secure lid, add all of the ingredients. Fill with water to cover the goose. Cover and simmer on low heat for at least five hours. I turn my broth on in the morning, let it simmer all day, and top it off with water as needed, maybe once or twice.

Instant Pot directions:

Place all ingredients into an Instant Pot. Fill the water to the max fill line. Secure the lid and set to high pressure for 50 minutes. If you're in a hurry, you can vent the steam. Otherwise, let the steam vent on its own.

Once you've achieved your ideal cook time with either method, remove the broth from the heat and let it cool. Carefully strain the liquid to remove all of the solids. Keep an eye out for the peppercorns and cloves. Season the broth with salt and pepper to taste. Shred the meat off the goose and reserve for later. Discard the carcass and veggies. Return the broth to the pot and reheat to serve. Enjoy!

In a separate pot, cook rice noodles according to the directions on the package.

To serve:

· Add cooked rice noodles to a bowl of pho broth

Top with the following ingredients according to your preference:

- shredded goose meat
- fresh bean sprouts
- $\bullet \ \ chopped \ green \ onions$
- lime wedge
- fresh cilantro leaves
- fresh basil leaves
- hoisin sauce (dollop)
- oyster sauce (dollop)
- soy sauce (splash)
- sriracha sauce
- chili oil
- jalapeno slices

Celebrate Fortune, Happiness and Health in the Chinese New Year

This year, Chinese New Year begins on Sunday, Jan. 22 and will culminate with the Lantern Festival on Feb. 5 as we welcome the year of the Rabbit.

You know me, if festivities are happening, I'm on board! In the Chinese culture, eggs symbolize birth or a new start, so this week I'm sharing the Chinese American classic Egg Fu Yung. This Chinese restaurant favorite is like an omelet filled with crisp vegetables served with a sweet and savory sauce.

It's surprisingly easy to prepare, very inexpensive, and it's delicious.

The only thing you probably don't have on hand would be mung bean sprouts. They're usually under \$2, commonly found packaged in the produce department near the tofu or canned in the ethnic food aisle of your grocery store. Bean sprouts make this dish fresh and crispy, but if you absolutely can't find them, substitute thinly sliced celery, bok choy or napa cabbage instead. They have the same crunch and a similar taste.





Building Partnerships To Benefit Wild Steelhead In The Potlatch River



The Idaho Department of Fish and Game (IDFG) and partners are working to improve habitat conditions for wild steelhead in the Potlatch River in northern Idaho through stream restoration projects.

Restoring steelhead and their habitat in the Potlatch River requires a network of habitat restoration experts, funders, and management groups. However, our most vital partners are private landowners. Most of the Potlatch watershed is privately owned and without willing landowners this program would not succeed. IDFG personnel work directly with private landowners to access their properties to restore steelhead habitat and conduct sampling work. Fortunately, there are landowners who want to see steelhead flourish once again in the Potlatch River and are joining the effort to make a difference.

An important part of maintaining great relationships with participating landowners is respecting their property and ensuring they benefit from the partnership as well. We ensure that our restoration projects always leave landowner's property in as good or better condition than when we started. That can include things like re-vegetating and re-grading areas that were disturbed by equipment, building and repairing fences, or even providing off-site watering opportunities for livestock. In the end, we want all partners to come away with a sense of accomplishment and pride that they were part of the project. Ultimately, with the help of private landowners we expect these projects will result in more wild steelhead returning to the Potlatch River.





Smallmouth bass state record falls once more

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game —



Dworshak Reservoir continues string of big bass

It was a typical cold, December day in central Idaho with rain down low and snow in the mountains. While many anglers might have been thinking about ice-fishing, winter steelhead or even putting a fresh coat of wax on their skis and hitting the slopes, Joey Walton had other plans: big smallmouth bass. Knowing he had to make the long run across the reservoir, he set out early in search of a trophy.

Having been looking for a record fish for months, and already catching several smallmouths this season just shy of the current record, he knew he was in for a challenge. On that cold thirteenth day of December, his hard work finally paid off when Walton finally connected with the fish he had been looking for. After using a measuring board to verify an accurate length and getting some quick photos, Joey released the 23.75-inch giant smallmouth back into the frigid waters of Dworshak Reservoir, and took home a new catch-and-release state record instead.

This year (2022) may be remembered as one of the best for Dworshak Reservoir, having produced a string of impressive smallmouth bass. The previous article at idfg.idaho.gov/blog/2022/05/ dworshak-reservoir-tops-state-record-bassonce-again describes how bass growth can explode in years of abundant food. If conditions remain consistent, there could be another record coming. But don't get your hopes up, as the 9.72-pound weight record (also 23.75-inches long) of Dan Steigers's fish from 2006, and this latest catch-and-release record will require a truly exceptional fish to be broken. Still, there's optimism in the air as we look forward to seeing what 2023 might bring to the record books.



Helicopters, GPS Collars And Big Game Animals – Another Day On The Job

– Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game –



Fish and Game staff across the state are beginning annual efforts to deploy GPS collars on moose calves, elk and deer

To most folks, the notion of riding in a helicopter to locate, capture and place a GPS collar on a deer, elk or moose seems like something only seen in movies or nature documentaries. For many of our staff, it's another day on the job, and it's all done with the goal of understanding and managing big game populations to provide continued hunting opportunities for sportsmen.

When asked why the information is important, Barb Moore, Regional Wildlife Biologist in the Panhandle Region replied, "When an animal has a collar on it, we learn so much about habitats it uses, when and where it moves and if it dies, what caused it to die. All of this allows us to make informed decisions when it comes to season setting, tag numbers and

predator management."

A recent example of how information gained from collars guided season setting and tag numbers is the general cow season on or within one mile of private land in the Panhandle.

"From our collaring information, we learned that front-country elk populations, which reside mostly on private land, have higher survival rates than their back-country counterparts, which live mostly on public land. As a result, front-country elk populations are better equipped to withstand more cow harvest," Moore explained.

Here in the Panhandle Region, collars will soon be deployed in Units 1 and 6, with a particular focus on moose calves beginning Dec. 19. Collars will also be put on elk calves in those units.

Why focus on moose calves, you may be asking? Collar data on moose cows and calves over the past three years have indicated that across the state, survival of adult cow moose is around 90%. The story is quite different for moose calves who survive at a much lower rate, so our staff are trying to understand why that is. Getting collars out this year will be a big part of answering that question.

Mark Hurley, Principal Wildlife Research Biologist, said, "The biggest piece of information we are missing relative to declines in moose populations is how well calves survive from 6 to 12 months of age. If we can understand what happens in that six-month time window, we hope it will shed some light onto what is limiting moose populations in Idaho."

Biologists in Region 1 are planning to deploy around 50 collars between moose and elk calves this year. Getting collars out isn't easy and doesn't always go according to plan. Depending on weather conditions, the effort may take several days and up to a week, so if you see or hear a chopper in the mountains, you know our staff are still at it!

If Flea Collar Causes Reaction in Your Pet

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: I'm worried by recent reports that a certain brand of flea collar has been making dogs sick, and many have died. I live in an area where fleas and ticks are rampant, and flea collars are essential for my two pups. What can I do if they have a reaction to a new collar? — Jane in South Carolina

DEAR JANE: It's understandable that you're worried. At the moment, the issues with the flea collar in question, Seresto, are being reviewed by the EPA, and no recall or warning has been issued.

Flea collars are widely available from different manufacturers. They're a popular choice because of the ease of use and affordability. However, any of them can cause side effects, and it's important to monitor your pet for them. A common one is a skin reaction directly underneath the collar shortly after it's put on for the first time. Your dog may scratch at the area; you may see reddening of the skin. Some reactions include hair loss around the collar.

The itching is usually temporary. Consult your pet's veterinarian if you see redness or hair loss, if the scratching and whining continues, or if your dog shows other signs of distress. If your pet is lethargic, drooling, vomiting or behaving strangely right after a new collar is put on, contact the vet immediately; it likely needs emergency treatment.

To prevent these and other side effects, make sure to purchase the correct collar for your dog's size and age. Putting a collar designed for a 100-pound dog onto a 15-pound dog can cause dangerous side effects because a small dog's body just can't process that much flea treatment.







2 Steps to Save a Life: The Importance of Hands-Only CPR

- Family Features -



More than 350,000 sudden cardiac arrests occur annually outside hospital settings. However, a hands-on emergency intervention like cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), especially if performed immediately, can double or triple a cardiac arrest victim's chance of survival.

According to the American Heart Association, 70% of cardiac arrests – electrical malfunctions in the heart that cause an irregular heartbeat (arrhythmia) and disrupt the flow of blood to the brain, lungs and other organs – occur at home, but often family and friends who witness a child, spouse, parent or friend going into cardiac arrest hesitate to perform potentially lifesaving CPR for fear of making the situation worse.

"By equipping people with Hands-Only CPR training, we are empowering them to spring into action if a loved one needs help, as the majority of cardiac arrests occur at home," said Dr. Anezi Uzendu, M.D., interventional cardiologist and American Heart Association volunteer.

As part of its Hands-Only CPR campaign, nationally supported by the Elevance Health Foundation, the American Heart Association aims to increase awareness about the importance of bystander CPR and offers these two simple steps:

- 1. Call 911.
- 2. Push hard and fast in the center of the chest of the individual experiencing cardiac arrest.

Using the beat of a familiar song with 100-120 beats per minute, such as "Stayin' Alive" by the Bee Gees, can help you stay on pace with the necessary compressions.

"Being able to efficiently perform Hands-Only CPR in the moment can mean the difference between life and death, and by following these two simple steps we can increase someone's chance of survival from cardiac arrest," said Shantanu Agrawal, M.D., board certified emergency medicine doctor and chief health officer at Elevance Health. Family History of Breast Cancer Prompts Man to Get Examined

DEAR DR. ROACH: My mother and both of her sisters had breast cancer in their 30s, with my mother eventually passing after her third bout at age 43. They all grew up in the same house that I grew up in. I'm now a 34-year-old father of three small children. I don't want to die early because I need to be around for them, but the generalized advice I'm seeing is that I don't need a cancer screening until my 40s.

Am I overly sensitive, or am I missing something that I should potentially screen for? - M.M.

ANSWER: With your mother and two aunts having breast cancer at such a young age, I would be concerned about an inheritable cancer gene such as BRCA1 and BRCA2. This gene may not have been identifiable at the time they had their cancers, as the first test became available in 1996. It is worth a discussion with a genetic counselor to consider testing for you.

Men with the BRCA1/2 genetic mutations are at risk to develop breast cancer themselves and are recommended to do monthly breast selfexaminations starting at age 35, with a clinician exam yearly. A PSA test is also recommended for men who are positive for BRCA2 (and maybe for men with BRCA1), as men with these mutations are more at risk for prostate cancer at a younger age than average-risk men.

Although BRCA increases the risk of colon cancer, ToYourGoodHealth@med.cornell.edu. all men should get colorectal cancer screenings at

age 45, regardless of BRCA status. Those with a strong family history of colon cancer should speak with an expert about the right time to begin screening.

I honor you for considering your family and expect you are doing as much as you can with your lifestyle to keep yourself healthy. A diet including plenty of fresh fruits and vegetables, with little to no processed meat, has been shown to reduce cancer risk as well as heart disease risk, which is still the major cause of death in industrial societies.

The most likely causes of death in men your age include motor vehicle accidents and suicide. These are not completely preventable, but driving safely, not texting while driving, never driving while intoxicated and seeking help with symptoms of depression go a long way at reducing your immediate risk so that you can continue to be there for your children.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I first tested positive for COVID eight days ago. Should I start Paxlovid now? - P.M.

ANSWER: This medicine has made a huge reduction in the number of people who get so sick from COVID that they need to be hospitalized, but only when used properly. This means it has to be used at the right time -- ideally within 24 hours of getting sick and certainly within five days. It's not likely to be of any help to you eight days after symptom onset.

The medicine is of most value to people who are at high risk of severe COVID. This includes people who are unvaccinated, people over 65 and people with high-risk conditions such as advanced HIV, organ transplantation or other severe problems with the immune system (including cancer chemotherapy and similar powerful drugs used for autoimmune diseases). Healthy, younger, vaccinated people with initial mild to moderate symptoms are at low risk for severe COVID (as of the time of this writing, with the omicron strains currently circulating) and do not benefit much from Paxlovid.



THE HISTORY CHANNEL

- On Jan. 30, 1661, Oliver Cromwell was ritually executed. That is, his corpse was. The former Lord Protector of the Commonwealth of England was posthumously convicted of high treason and his remains hanged and beheaded, two years after his actual demise.
- On Feb. 4, 1789, George Washington was unanimously elected as the first president of the United States. His campaign cost nothing, as he did no public campaigning, since he didn't really want to take office. He was also the only U.S. president to be inaugurated in two cities (New York and Philadelphia).



Whirligigs

Whirligigs were invented centuries ago. They are both toys and tools, indicators of wind direction and the weather. Sources disagree on where the first were made; it was probably in China about 400 B.C. or by Native Americans about 550 B.C. The whirligig must have a spinning part and a base and many were made in fanciful shapes. The oldest known pictures of a whirligig were in tapestries made in medieval times.

There are many names and many shapes of whirligigs. Old sources call them pinwheels, gee-haws, whirlyjigs or whirlys. Vintage examples have waving arms, flags, angels' wings, a man chopping wood, horses running and much more. They are also popular children's toys or garden ornaments.

A political whirligig was sold by Garth's Auctions in Ohio a few years ago. It is a figure of President Theodore Roosevelt with a top hat and monocle riding on a penny farthing cycle. Roosevelt served from 1901 to 1909, so it must have been made after 1901. He is holding a red counterbalance vane that turns the bike with the wind. The handmade whirligig sold at Garth's for \$865.

Apache wedding moccasins. Apache Indians killed my great-grandfather in Bisbee, Arizona, in 1885. He was the deputy sheriff. His gravestone reads, "Killed by Apache Indians." I'd like to find the appropriate museum or collector that would be interested in them.

• Indian moccasins can sell for several hundred dollars. Value depends on decoration, rarity and condition. Any information you have about the moccasins and how they were obtained adds provenance. Several museums, including some in Arizona, have collections of Native American items. Search the internet to find them. Those near the area where your great-grandfather lived might be interested in the connection to the local legend. If you want to sell the

moccasins, look for an auction house that sells Indian items. They can give you an idea of their value and sell them for you. Be sure to ask what their commission and other charges are.

Wake Up to a Baked Oatmeal Breakfast

Why did it take me so long to put "Baked Oatmeal" on our family's wake-up menu? I was completely enthralled with the tasty porridgebased dish at a bed and breakfast in Chicago a few years back. Prepared to Goldilocks' "just right" standard, I recall how the serving's perfect, cinnamony, smooth middle complemented the crispy edges. Doused with warm milk and topped with my choice of dried apricots, it was satisfying – and kept me going through a vigorous morning of sightseeing.

I left the memory on the back burner – until now. Here's a basic, fail-proof recipe you and your kids can tinker with seasonally. That means a mix and match of add-ins and add-ons to satisfy one's own tastes. Ground flax? Toss it in. Chia seeds? Sprinkle them on top. Blueberries in season? Top off the bowl with luscious freshness, color and vitamins.

BAKED OATMEAL Serves 6

- 2 cups old-fashioned rolled oats
- cup brown sugar
- teaspoon baking powder
- teaspoons cinnamon
- 1/2teaspoon salt
- large egg, beaten
- 1-1/2 cups milk

- 1/4 cup unsalted butter, melted
- teaspoon pure vanilla extract
- cup raisins
- 1/2 cup loosely chopped walnuts

Optional serving toppings: cranberries, apricots or cherries, coconut, berries, diced fresh fruit such as apples, bananas and peaches

To prepare oven and pan: Preheat oven to 350° F. Generously butter the inside of an 8-inch square baking dish or coat with cooking spray.

To make oatmeal: In a large bowl, mix together the oats, brown sugar, baking powder, cinnamon

In another bowl, whisk together the beaten egg, milk, butter and vanilla. Add liquid mixture to oat mixture and stir well. Stir in raisins and walnuts.

To bake oatmeal: Pour mixture into baking dish. Bake for 35 minutes, or until the top is golden and the oat mixture has set. Serve warm.

Extra idea: Heat leftover portions in the microwave for additional easy breakfasts.




