From tags sales to season closures, there's a lot happening in Idaho during January that you should be aware of. Staying in the loop can be the difference between applying for that coveted controlled hunt tag and watching from the sidelines.


Be sure to stay up to date on all Fish and Game happenings. Here are some important dates you should know to help you plan.

January 2024

*Waterfowl Hunters: There are several migratory game bird hunting seasons that close during the month of January. Please see the 2023-2024 seasons and rules booklet for a full list of specific waterfowl closures.

- 1/1 New Year's Day Public Holiday (Fish and Game Offices Closed)
- 1/1 First day of the 2024 hunting/fishing season. Make sure to purchase a 2024 license.
- 1/1 OPEN: Spring steelhead season
- 1/1 Antler gathering closure in Southeast and Upper Snake regions starts (learn more at idfg. idaho.gov/article/antler-gathering-closure-seand-upper-snake-starts-jan-1)
- 1/15 Martin Luther King Jr. Day Public Holiday (Fish and Game Offices Closed)
- 1/15 Spring black bear controlled hunt application period starts
- 1/24-1/25 January Commission Meeting in Boise
- + 1/31 CLOSED: Forest grouse season in Area 1
- 1/31 CLOSED: California and Bobwhite quail
- 1/31 CLOSED: Chukar and gray partridge season

Note: Hunters, anglers and trappers should always double check the seasons and rules booklets to confirm opening and closing dates, as well as restrictions and rules pertaining to individual species.

National Bittersweet Chocolate Day

January 10th

Chocolate lovers, rejoice! National Bittersweet Chocolate Day on January 10th gives you the excuse to indulge in some chocolate satisfaction. (National Bittersweet Chocolate with Almonds Day is celebrated on November 7th.)

Chocolate comes from the seed of the tropical Theobroma cacao tree. Cacao, which has been cultivated for at least three millennia, is grown in Mexico, Central America, and Northern South America. The earliest known documentation of the use of cacao seeds is around 1100 BC. The cacao tree seed has an intensely bitter taste and must be fermented to develop the flavor.

Once the seeds have been fermented, the beans are then dried, cleaned, and roasted. After roasting, the shell is removed to produce cacao nibs. The cacao nibs are then ground into a cocoa mass which is pure chocolate in rough form. Usually, the cocoa mass is liquefied then molded with or without other ingredients. This is called chocolate liquor. The

chocolate liquor may then be processed into two components: cocoa solids and cocoa butter.

Bittersweet chocolate is chocolate liquor to which sugar, cocoa butter, and vanilla have been added. It does have less sugar and more liquor than semisweet chocolate. However, the two of them may be interchangeable when baking.

Studies have revealed that there are certain health benefits from eating bittersweet chocolate in moderation, such as lowering blood pressure and helping to protect the heart.

How To Observe Bittersweet Chocolate Day

Bittersweet chocolate offers many ways to celebrate. We can go in so many directions with bittersweet chocolate. Add a little to your baking or sprinkle a little in your morning coffee. Do you like pudding or chocolate chip cookies? This is the chocolate for you. The choice is up to you which delicious chocolate creation you make. However, once you decide, be sure to share your creations, too.

Q. Are there other days that celebrate bittersweet chocolate?



Basic Training

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: You often mention that owners should spend time with their dogs in basic obedience training. What are "the basics" exactly? -- Ferris T., Huntington, N.Y.

ANSWER: While the specifics of basic obedience training for dogs are better detailed through books or by professional trainers, I can list these training requirements here.

- Housetraining: The most basic and most important to you and your dog's peace of mind. Teaching a new dog where and when to eliminate, and training yourself to keep a proper schedule, is a crucial initial step.
- Heel: Your dog should walk calmly alongside you, and not struggle against the leash, pull you down

the street or chase after birds, cars or other dogs.

- Sit: A well-trained dog will sit on command. When training on the leash, have the dog sit on your left side.
- Down: The dog should lie down (on his belly, paws forward) on command.
- Stay: In the "sit" or "down" position, the dog should not move until you release him with a verbal command.
- Come: At your command, the dog should come to you, or respond to further directional commands (such as tugging the leash right or left to signal a turn).

That's essentially it: five basic commands and housetraining. It doesn't sound like much, but teaching a dog of any age these skills will take at least several weeks, if not months. And they must be taught correctly: no hitting or yelling, maintaining dominance over the dog. Training books provide many more details on effective ways to do this, while a professional trainer can demonstrate additional effective techniques to ease the basic training process.

Remember that basic obedience training doesn't stop once these skills have been learned. Dogs need regular reinforcement, even if it's just a five-minute review during their daily walks.

Stir Up Muesli for Easy Breakfasts **All Week Long**

When you travel, which souvenirs end up meaning the most to you -- photos, clothing, impulse items stashed in the side pockets of your luggage? When I pondered the same question and reflected on special trips, I was surprised to discover that the recipes I've jotted down in my journal are the take-homes that really live on for me.

Travel and food -- a great combination! That's what my Australian-born-and-raised neighbor Felicity Britton, a globe-trotting mother of two daughters, and I got excited about in a recent conversation.

She recalled adventurous days in her 20s as a marketer for a major cruise line. The lavish, on-board breakfast buffet included a heaping bowl of creamystyle, cold muesli (oats mixed with yogurt, milk, nuts and fruit, etc.), which was specifically prepared for the tastes of the European guests.

"I loved it," she said. She inquired about the recipe and has prepared variations of it for over 20 year, making it a breakfast staple in her home.

"This must be some travel souvenir," I thought. Well, it is! The basic, healthy ingredients are easy for your kids to stir up in minutes for a week's worth of breakfasts that store nicely in your refrigerator. Your chosen daily add-ins of seasonal fruit make the possibilities endless.

The Top 'Big Fish' Stories Of 2023 Part 1 of 2

From a 40-pound lake monster in Hayden Lake to a 75-year-old record vindicated by passionate bass fishing sleuths, big fish stories covered all manner of strange circumstances last year.

From a 40-pound lake monster in Hayden Lake to a 75-year-old record vindicated by passionate bass fishing sleuths, angler stories covered all manner of strange in 2023. Anglers from all over the state hoisted up some incredible benchmarks last year (and have pictures to show for it).

In total, 2023 had 15 new state records, which included 6 certified-weight records, and 9 new catchand-release records. Making the cut this year are the following angler trophy stories.

The Panhandle Pike

When Thomas Francis stepped up to the water's shore on March 21, 2023, the furthest thing from his mind was becoming the next state-record Northern pike angler. Francis was planning on going after a Hayden Lake monster that day, but the 40.76-pound lake monster that eventually took the hook was beyond his wildest imagination.

"Pike is what I go after all the time. I spend almost everyday fishing for pike. As soon as the ice is off and until it comes back," Francis said.



There was still some ice on the lake when he showed up that day, so he couldn't cast right up to the shore, only to the edge of the ice.

"When my lure hit the water, I let it sink all the way to the bottom. As soon as my lure hit the bottom, I felt her hit. I fish with 80-pound test line, and she almost immediately started peeling drag, a lot of it," Francis said.

When Francis finally landed her, he knew the fish was going to be a state-record — or at least a close contender. After visiting a few different places to find a certified scale, they finally received a certified weight of 40.76 pounds.

Mysterious Record Largemouth Bass Vindicated On 75th Anniversary

One of the most popular stories from 2023 spoke of a 75-year-old state record for a largemouth bass caught by a mysterious individual named "Mrs. W. M. Taylor." You see, Idaho Fish and Game state records go way, way back, but the 10-pound, 15-ounce largemouth bass hauled out of Anderson Lake in Idaho's panhandle sometime in the 1940s was a little murky, but thanks to a team of fishing sleuths and their podcast, the story of the record fish was recently vindicated.

For decades, Mrs. Taylor's record has bewildered Fish and Game staff and anglers alike. The fish had little information about its catch, including no mention of length or girth measurements or even a catch date, making it a bit dubious. Despite the mystery, the fish stayed atop the record list for decades.



In November 2023, Fish and Game's very own Sportfish Coordinator Martin Koenig was contacted by The Big Bass Podcast's Ken Duke, whose show takes a deep dive into legendary fishing stories. Duke discovered that "Mrs. W. M. Taylor" was in fact her husband's name, a dentist in Spokane, Washington, where the family lived. Listing the record using her married (husband's) name may have been the tradition for that era, but it made rectifying the records a bit more difficult.

After some sleuthing through newspaper records and archives, Duke discovered the angler's actual name was Mary Alice Hurt Taylor, who would have been 63 years old when she caught the big bass on Oct. 22, 1948 — nearly 75 years from today.

Fishing may not have been popular recreation for women of her day, which makes Mary's story even more interesting. Mary Taylor wasn't just a casual angler that happened to get lucky one fall day on Anderson Lake. In fact, she had a previous track record as a trophy bass angler. Only four years prior, she took 6th place in the 1944 Field & Stream contest with a 9-pound, 11-ounce largemouth bass caught on Oct. 21 from, you guessed it, the same lake.

Thanks to some clever fish record sleuthing, the plot holes in "Mrs." Taylor's once-convoluted fish tale were filled in, leading Idaho Fish and Game record keepers to update its entry for the state's largest largemouth bass, caught on that legendary day by Mary Alice Taylor.

The Top 'Big Fish' **Stories Of 2023**

Part 2 of 2

One River, Three Records

Idaho's Clearwater River is legendary in its own right as a salmon and steelhead mecca. In the month of October 2023 alone, the river lived up to its reputation and produced not one, but three state records.



On Oct. 6, McCall angler Kyriacos Panayiotou waded out into the cool waters of the Clearwater hoping to hook one of the river's famous monster steelhead.

"The full floating spey line was at approximately 120 to 130 feet when the fly started to swing," Panayiotou recalls. "At around 30 degrees, this beautiful wild steelhead buck boiled to the surface and grabbed the fly with authority. The vintage Hardy Perfect reel could do nothing in slowing down this fish — it's something that I'll never forget."

The fish measured 41 inches long, a full 1.75 inches longer than the previous catch-and-release state record set in 2021. While Kyriacos Panayiotou had to let the huge wild steelhead go, he took home a new Idaho catch-and-release record and a lifetime memory. Then on Oct. 13, Matt Hosking of Lewiston landed a 11.78-pound coho salmon, earning the top spot of the certified-weight state record list, edging out the previous record by a mere half ounce. The hookjawed monster stretched out at 32.68 inches long. Read the full story at idfg.idaho.gov/article/clear water-river-sets-new-state-record-coho-salmon.

A few weeks later on Oct. 28, Jase Groesbeck of Kamiah hooked into another big coho salmon. After measuring the fish at 31 inches, he released it back into the Clearwater River and took home a catchand-release state record.



As if three new state records weren't enough, Fish and Game also received applications for two more record steelhead from the Clearwater River last fall. Mark Mestaz of Boise and Brandon Kruger of Sioux Falls, Iowa, both landed (and released) steelhead over 40 inches.

Despite their impressive catches, their records were turned down because of insufficient evidence documenting their length. These records are getting hard to beat, and anglers need to remember to bring along a tape measure!

A Big Year for Yellowstone... Not That Yellowstone

Back in 2016, Fish and Game separated out records for each of Idaho's four subspecies of cutthroat trout: Bonneville, Yellowstone, Westslope and Lahontan. There have been many catch-and-release records, but a new certified-weight record for Yellowstone cutthroat trout has been lacking.

While ice fishing on New Years Day on Henrys Lake, Spencer Smith of Chubbuck harvested a 2.88-pound Yellowstone cutthroat trout. He earned the first certified weight state record for Yellowstone cutthroat trout and earned extra bragging rights as the first record fish of 2023!

Honorable Mentions

Gary Hardesty of Coeur d'Alene was night-fishing the Kootenai River on Feb. 11, hoping to find the elusive burbot. He landed a 16-inch burbot and beat the previous catch-and-release record of 14.3 inches set in 2022 by Laura Lambert.

Tiger Trout

Adding to the fun, Jesse Barger of Mackay set a catch-and-release record tiger trout at 23.5 inches from Lehman Pond, only to be passed up by a 26-incher caught on the same day by Chandra Jensen of Moore. Sounds like a local rivalry is in store for 2024!

Non-Game

In the non-game categories, top catch-and-release records went to Akeley Fahnholz for landing a 14.13inch peamouth (a native minnow species) from the Snake River, while Jon Urban of Eagle topped the list with a 6-inch redside shiner caught in the Boise River.

Robert Astin of Hayden set a new certified weight record for tench at 4.28 pounds from Hayden Lake using bowfishing (archery) equipment.

Checking Records in Real-Time

Catch-and-release records are no longer printed in the Idaho Fishing Seasons and Regulations booklets. Instead, the online rulebook will be accessible via a QR code which folks can scan (in the booklet) with their mobile phones that will direct them to Fish and Game's up-to-date table of records. With anglers breaking records left and right, Fish and Game staff are working to keep state record information accessible and current.








Habitat Connectivity by Design: How Engineering Shapes Idaho's Streams

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game —



Engineers working for the Department of Fish and Game juggle many projects like designing buildings, hatcheries, and fishing access areas. But a few engineers get to design in-stream structures and habitat restoration projects to help fish move through the Idaho landscape.

One of these engineers is Jared Bragg, the engineer from the Anadromous Fish Screen Program in Salmon, Idaho. Jared gets the opportunity to come up with new and exciting solutions to provide better fish passage through the river while also helping restore habitat connectivity.

Sometimes fish encounter obstacles like old culverts or rock dams that prevent them from swimming up or down stream. That's where Jared steps in. Along with a team of biologists, land managers, and construction contractors, he designs and installs new bridges, fish screens (to prevent fish from ending up in an irrigation ditch), and passage projects throughout Idaho.

Designing one of these fish passage structures involves multiple phases, starting with a site visit. Jared, along with his biologist and construction colleagues, visits the project site to determine the best location for the structure. During this visit, the design team look for potential challenges, such as tricky terrain and construction access. Jared and the team also talk with landowners and land managers to understand how the project will impact the surrounding area. Replacing this diversion structure will help fish passage, but it will also improve the transport of water to the landowner's hydro-electric facility.



Surveying GPS stations allow Jared to survey whole construction sites by himself. The tripod station is set at a known elevation point, and Jared measures other elevations around the site that he uses to build a 3D model of the landscape.

Using advanced surveying GPS units, Jared conducts detailed surveys, creating a complete digital model of the landscape. Here, he notes the location of the hydroelectric facility, the storage pond, and the diversion. Back at the office, Jared imports the digital landscape into the design software and starts the detailed design process. Working with the digital model, he carefully constructs the fish passage structure.



Back at the office, Jared uses engineering software to build a 3D model of the landscape at the site. After he creates the landscape, he can design the project to fit the site.

As the fish passage structure design nears completion, Jared works closely with contractors and land managers to incorporate changes that optimize its operations. They integrate these modifications into the final design, ensuring that the structure aligns seamlessly with its surroundings.

When the designs are ready, it's time to bring them to life! Jared teams up with construction crews to ensure everything is executed flawlessly and that the structure operates effectively. This hands-on approach ensures that every aspect of the project is considered as the crew builds the structure.

But his work doesn't end there. The final phase involves follow-up and adaptive management. For the next few months Jared and the team monitor the structure, making sure it functions as intended. If any tweaks or adjustments are necessary at this stage, Jared rolls up his sleeves and makes it happen.

Dear EarthTalk: How are AI and robotics combining to revolutionize recycling? - B.C., New York, NY

A survey conducted by the Carton Council of North America in 2018 showed that 94 percent of Americans support recycling. That same year, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) reported that the recycling rate was only 32.1 percent. Why is this

Local governments are responsible for creating recycling programs. Cities that have invested in recycling infrastructure, education and incentive programs, like San Francisco and Los Angeles, claim recycling rates of over 70 percent. Contrarily, cities with smaller budgets and staff and contamination issues have eliminated curbside recycling altogether. (Chesapeake, VA Pembroke Pines, FL are two examples.)

The adoption of single-stream recycling, where various recyclables are placed in a single container, has significantly increased household participation. But it has also contributed to a 25 percent contamination rate of recycled material. Contamination occurs when non-recyclable items are mixed with recyclables, making it challenging or impossible to sort and safely process these materials. Common contaminants include non-recyclable plastics (bubble wrap, trash bags, cling wrap, etc.) and food

Contamination is more than a mere inconvenience. In 2016, China received over 16 million tons of plastic, paper and metals from the U.S., 30 percent of which was contaminated and later dumped in the

Chinese countryside and waterways. In 2017, China passed the National Sword Policy, banning the importation of materials that the U.S. had previously sent in for recycling. As a result, U.S. recycling facilities have had to make substantial improvements in the quality of their recyclables.

How does AI play a role in improving recycling? The 1990s saw the introduction of optical sensing and computational intelligence to distinguish between various types of plastic and paper. These systems typically achieved 80 to 95 percent purity, with human workers tasked to manually remove contaminants. Enter artificial intelligence! Recycling requires rapid identification of objects with diverse shapes, sizes and orientations on conveyor belts. AI-driven systems demonstrate near-100-percent accuracy by relying on image analysis of attributes, including color, opacity and form. A vast dataset of recyclable material images, collected globally and meticulously annotated, are regularly updated to improve reliability.

One company, AMP Robotics, has pioneered in the AI-recycling industry since 2014. Equipped with a powerful network, their 1,800 pound 'pick-andplace' robots are twice as efficient as human employees, identifying and sorting 80 items per minute. Now recycling facilities equipped with artificial intelligence robots are able to sort greater quantities of trash while reducing operating costs.

Perhaps we can even stop contamination at the point of disposal, right at home. CleanRobotics has created a receptacle named TrashBot that uses imaging, AI algorithms, and robotics to detect and sort waste as it is being thrown away. This prevents contamination and makes the sorting process easier down the line.







One of the best ways to enhance a space is by adding house plants. The busy holidays cause many of us to neglect some of our regular routines, including houseplant care. Houseplant Benefits

- Boost productivity Some studies have shown that indoor plants may improve productivity and performance in the workplace and in school.

Humidity enhances a home's comfort level, and we also breathe easier when the humidity in our homes is balanced. Also, plants are prettier than humidifiers.

Q. Are succulents easier to grow?

State of Deer and Elk:

Counting herds, and how hunters help through mandatory hunter reports

Biologists use a variety of methods to know the health of the herds, and hunters play an important role

Deer and elk live throughout Idaho in habitats ranging from desert to mixed conifer forests, and a big part of a wildlife manager's job is to estimate how many are out there.

What role do hunters play in that? More than you might realize. If each deer and elk hunter spends a few moments filling out a mandatory hunter report, they make a valuable contribution to wildlife management that can lead to more hunting opportunity, but more on that later.

Counting herds around the state

When we think of counting deer and elk populations, the first thing that comes to mind is biologists flying in helicopters and getting a bird's-eye view of deer and elk herds when animals are concentrated on winter range.

But many hunters assume surveys happen every year in each of Fish and Game's 99 game management units, which unfortunately is impossible.

Aerial surveys take a lot of time, personnel and resources. Fish and Game doesn't own helicopters, and renting them costs tens of thousands of dollars for each deer or elk survey.

Because of that, Fish and Game must rotate their survey resources around the state, and most deer and elk populations typically get an aerial survey about every 5 to 6 years, and there are different kinds of surveys.

More than just the number of animals

There are actually two kinds of aerial surveys Fish and Game conducts: abundance surveys and composition surveys.

An "abundance" survey is designed to estimate how many animals are in a wintering population. To be accurate and consistent, Fish and Game biologists use a strict protocol that standardizes observer training, flight speed and altitude, and flight pattern.

Biologists also know they can't see every animal due to vegetation cover and animal behavior, so there's a correction made that's been developed through research that calculates how many animals likely went undetected.

A "composition" survey is a little different. Biologists count a minimum number of animals, say 500 to 1,000 deer or elk in a geographic area, and carefully track how many are male or female, and adult or young.

What do biologists do with the data?

Knowing how many deer and elk are in a population is useful to understanding how the herds are currently fairing, and what the long-term trends are.

The herd's gender and age composition helps biologists understand if there is a healthy mix of animals with enough adults to produce the next generation, as well as enough young to replace the adults that may be harvested or lost to other types of mortality.

Composition surveys also help a wildlife manager know if they're meeting management goals for certain game management units, for example, a controlled hunt unit where the expectation is to increase the number of older buck and bulls.



What role do hunters play in tracking deer and elk populations?

More than you might expect. Because there can be years between surveys, mandatory hunter reports help managers understand what may be happening in between aerial surveys.

Changes in what hunters harvest may reflect changes in the deer and elk populations, so if harvest changes dramatically in a season or two, it helps managers understand that something may have changed since the last survey, or that another survey is needed.

In recent years, only about 60 percent of hunters filled out their mandatory hunter reports, which meant biologists had to fill in those blanks with expensive telephone surveys, or use statistical estimates to round out the data, neither of which is as accurate as hunters taking a few minutes to fill out a report.

It's a simple way hunters can do their part to help manage deer and elk.

So why ask about the number of antler points? Fair question. That's another way of knowing the ball-park age of the bull or buck and another piece of information for the wildlife manager to assess if the current harvest is likely to be sustainable, or if more harvest could be allowed.

It's also important to know if a hunter didn't harvest, and even if they didn't hunt, so everyone who bought a deer, elk or pronghorn tag needs to fill out a harvest report.

How better data means better hunting

The more accurate hunter reports are that Fish and Game receives, the better biologists understand what's happening to deer and elk herds on the ground, and the quicker they can react with any needed management changes.

When biologists receive fewer hunter reports, they have to rely on estimates while also trying to filter out statistical biases.

For example, successful hunters tend to report at a higher rate than unsuccessful hunters, which means if you take the success rate of the 60 percent who reported and apply it to the 40 percent who did not report, you would likely end up with a higher harvest estimate than what actually occurred. That could lead managers to believe a herd was over harvested, and result in more conservative hunting seasons.



Biologists can correct some of those statistical inaccuracies, but with more hunters reporting, there's less need for estimates. And if wildlife managers are unsure of the data, they err on the side of caution when proposing upcoming hunting seasons, particularly the number of tags available for controlled hunts.

Aerial surveys backed by hunter reports have for decades been the mainstay of data used by biologists across most of Idaho, but in thickly wooded portions of northern Idaho, aerial surveys are not as effective. In those places, hunter reports are the best tool wildlife managers have to gauge the health of the herd, so good data is even more critical.

Taking a snapshot of deer and elk

Fish and Game biologists and researchers started experimenting with remote cameras to estimate elk populations back in 2014, and that ground-breaking research has been used to estimate the state-wide wolf population for the last four years.

Fish and Game staff places hundreds of cameras in selected areas, then millions of photos are taken and

sorted using artificial intelligence. Biologists then use that data and computer modeling to estimate a game population.

A simultaneous camera survey and aerial survey in winter of 2019 in a portion of southern Idaho came to almost identical numbers.

Fish and Game's staff is currently applying their camera expertise to estimate deer and elk populations in portions of the Clearwater, Panhandle, Southeast and Magic Valley regions.

So far, it's looking promising, and wildlife managers are hopeful it can be another way to estimate deer and elk populations more frequently without the time and expense of flying, but there's more research to be done to fine tune it.



In the meantime, hunter reports remain the yardstick for managing white-tailed deer and elk herds in thick, woody areas where aerial surveys are not as effective.


While aerial surveys and hunter reports remain go-to methods for estimating deer and elk populations, they work in correlation with other information, such as survival of radio-collared animals and other methods of tracking wildlife.

They're all part of the tools for effective wildlife management, and hunters will continue to be a vital part of it.



S'more Ideas to Start a New Year of Family Fun

The art of a roast is simple. Put a marshmallow on a stick and rotate it slowly over coals, just long enough to turn the white outside a toasty golden brown. But as all experienced marshmallow roasters know, if you leave it one second too long, the lusciousness instantly turns charcoal black. Patience is the key -- a good lesson for rookie roasters of any age.

Extra Idea: Make s'mores indoors in the microwave. On a small saucer, place a piece of a milk-chocolate bar on top of half of a graham cracker. Add one large marshmallow or several mini marshmallows.

Cook in your microwave on high for about 10-15 seconds, or until marshmallows puff and grow.

An adult should remove the plate from the microwave, top with the other half of the graham cracker and gently press down on the gooey marshmallow. Let cool a bit so that the snack isn't too hot.

Note: If you don't have a microwave, a toaster oven works fine, too. Cook the layered cracker, chocolate and marshmallow on the tray at 350 F until the marshmallow begins to brown. Remove and top with the other cracker half. Six s'mores will fit on most trays.



Application Period Starts January 2nd For Smith River Permits

— Montana Fish. Wildlife & Parks —

Changes coming for the 2024 season

HELENA - Floaters hoping for a Smith River permit can apply Jan. 2 through Feb. 15. However, a few changes are coming this year that applicants should be aware of.

Celebrated for its spectacular scenery, remote location and excellent trout fishing, the Smith River is one of Montana's most sought-after outdoor recreation experiences. Permits are required to float the 59-mile section of river between Camp Baker and Eden Bridge and are issued each year through a lottery. Parties of up to 15 people can float with one permit. A person applying for a Smith River permit must be a minimum of 12 years of age at the time they submit their permit application.

Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks staff will remove pit toilets at the float-in campsites along the Smith River during the spring of 2024. All float parties, private and commercial, will be required to pack out their human waste from the Smith River corridor. This requirement is similar to many other river systems in the West and necessary to keep the corridor pristine for visitors now and for decades to come. The rules implementing this pack-out system were passed by the Montana Parks Board in late 2023.

Floaters will need to pack portable toilet systems. To see a list of FWP-approved, portable, hard-sided toilets that will be allowed, click here. Alternative waste disposal systems, including bag systems, such as Clean Waste and RESTOP2, will not be allowed.

Floaters can clean and sanitize their portable toilet system with a SCAT (Sanitizing Containers with Alternative Technology) machine, which has been installed at the Eden Bridge take-out.

"Removal of the pit toilets will not only help reduce impacts to natural and cultural resources, but also allow more time for the river rangers to focus on other duties, such as public safety and recreation ecology projects like noxious weed control and stabilizing erosion at boat camp landings," said Colin Maas, FWP Recreation Manager for the Smith River.

2024 is the first year applicants can buy a bonus point for the Smith River Permit. A bonus point is essentially an extra chance you can purchase for the permit drawing. These points accumulate year after year if you are unsuccessful in the drawing. Residents can purchase a bonus point for \$5; nonresidents can purchase a bonus point for \$50. The bonus point is applied to your application the year it is purchased. You can apply for a permit through FWP's online licensing system. For more information on bonus points, click here.

Finally, starting in 2024, the number of permits available for nonresidents may not exceed 10 percent of the available permits. This new law was passed as part of House Bill 846 in the 2023 Legislative Session.





Consequences Of Dogs Chasing Wildlife

– Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game



Dogs and deer don't mix

Springtime and early summer bring young wildlife into conflict with our furry friends far too often. A young deer does not have the ability or instinct to avoid the playful ruff housing of dogs, and even a mature 5x5 white-tailed buck often doesn't have the stamina to outrun or hide from multiple hounds.

Whether the dog owner failed to maintain control of the pets or is negligent in their care, this deer succumbed to exhaustion and multiple bites over its body. Instead of being harvested by a happy archery hunter, this deer was euthanized. The meat could not be salvaged due to the extent of its injuries. Senior Conservation Officer Brian Perkes said, "It is unfortunate that at the height of archery season, this deer was not able to be utilized."


Dog owners are encouraged to take responsibility to manage their pets and follow local regulations when leashes are required. Any dog found at large can result in the owner receiving an infraction. A dog chasing big game, other than legal and permitted hound hunters for bear and mountain lions, could also receive an infraction, but the results could be much more severe.

A dog found actively tracking, pursuing, harassing, attacking or killing big game animals can be euthanized by law enforcement personnel. No one wants this to occur to either wildlife or the dog.
