City of Coeur d'Alene LEAF-FEST **Begins November 13th**

MONDAY, NOVEMBER 13th, 2023 marks the start of the City of Coeur d'Alene's annual leaf pick-up program. Please be sure to KEEP leaves on your property until Wednesday, November 1st. After Wednesday the 1st, please rake your leaves and pine needles about one foot away from the gutter/curb line to allow for water drainage. City crews and equipment are limited, so we need your help. Leaves will be picked up only once. Please do not put leaves in the street after city crews have completed your area and do not include bagged leaves, branches, debris or trash.

Pick-up will start south of Sherman Avenue and move north. We expect completion before December 1st. Follow our progress on maps.cdaid.org/leaf

REMEMBER:

Needles and

Leaves ONLY!

No branches,

grass clippings

or garden debris.

NO GARBAGE

KEEP leaves and needles on property until Wednesday, November 1st.

- Please move cars off the street if at all possible during leaf pick-up.
- · Keep the leaves about one foot away from the curb line to allow drainage.
- Be alert for leaf pick-up equipment traveling through your neighborhood. Keep a safe distance away from leaf pick-up heavy equipment.
- Recognize that we have a tough job to do in a very short window between
- when the leaves fall and when the snow flies. • City and private trucks are exempted from covering loads during the leaf
- pick-up period. Sweepers will follow city trucks to collect remaining/ excess leaves.

DO NOT:

- Place bagged leaves in the street.
- Mix branches, debris or other trash in with the leaves.
- Miss the deadline...We only have time for one pass.


A quick marinade adds a sweet and tangy glaze to grilled skinless drumsticks - a favorite with everyone in the family.

- can (8 ounces) crushed pineapple in unsweetened juice
- 1/4 cup (packed) brown sugar
- tablespoons soy sauce
- tablespoon (grated) fresh ginger, peeled
- clove garlic, crushed with press
- (about 4 pounds) chicken drumsticks, skin removed

- 2. Remove drumsticks from bag; discard bag with marinade. Place drumsticks on grill over medium heat and cook 15 minutes, turning over once. Cook drumsticks 10 to 15 minutes longer, or until drumsticks are golden and juices run clear when thickest part is pierced with tip of knife, brushing twice with reserved pineapple mixture and turning occasionally. Serves 4.

F&G Seeks Input On **Muzzleloader Ammunition Proposed Rule**




The rule change would allow projectiles made of metal or metal alloy, and with accuracy tips and pressure bases, to be used in hunting seasons designated as "muzzleloader only."

Idaho Fish and Game is seeking public input on a proposed rule change that would allow projectiles made of metal or metal alloy, and with accuracy tips and pressure bases, to be used in hunting seasons designated as "muzzleloader only."

This would be a change to the existing rule that only allows a patched round ball or conical non-jacketed projectile comprised wholly of lead or lead alloy. This rulemaking was initiated in response to hunter requests to address the decreasing availability of lead-only projectiles for muzzleloaders and the increased availability of other metal projectiles.

The proposed rule can be reviewed on pages 271-272 of Idaho Administrative Bulletin Volume 23-10 (see adminrules.idaho.gov/bulletin/2023/10. pdf). Written comments on the proposed rule will be accepted through Oct. 25, 2023, at the email address rules@idfg.idaho.gov.

Bake Fresh Pumpkin Bread

For years, it was an October tradition in our neighborhood to drop in at my friend's preholiday arts and crafts sale. Once we opened the heavy front door of her turn-of-the-century home, we were drawn in from the outdoor chill into an aroma of warm, freshly baked pumpkin bread served on trays in the dining room. Looking back, I wonder if people came for the pumpkin bread as much as for the art being sold.

This updated, foolproof recipe is moist and full of enticing autumn spices we love, and it's super-easy to make and bake with kids. No mixers or tricky steps. Just measure, whisk, stir and bake. Of course, you may put your own spin on the recipe and add chopped nuts and raisins to the batter, or even drizzle icing with a sprinkling of pepitas (a type of pumpkin seed) on top of the just-baked bread to make it fancy.

FAVORITE PUMPKIN BREAD Makes 1 loaf

- 1/2 cup vegetable oil
- 1-1/2 cups sugar
- 2 eggs, lightly beaten
- · 1 cup canned pumpkin
- 1-3/4 cups all-purpose flour
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cloves
- 1/2 teaspoon allspice
- 1/2 teaspoon ground nutmeg

- · 1 teaspoon salt
- · 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/4 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/4 cup water

To prepare the oven: Heat oven to 350° F.

To prepare the pan: Place a piece of parchment or wax paper on the bottom of a greased 9-by-5-by-3inch loaf pan.

To prepare the batter: Whisk together oil, sugar, eggs and pumpkin in a mixing bowl.

Meanwhile, in a separate bowl, sift together flour, cinnamon, cloves, allspice, nutmeg, salt, baking soda and baking powder.

Stir dry ingredients into wet ingredients alternatively with the water. Avoid overmixing. Pour into

To bake: Bake in the middle of the oven for 60 minutes, or until wooden pick or knife inserted in the center comes out clean.

Cool for 10 minutes, then turn out onto a cooling rack to cool completely.

Hot Tips For Processing Salmon And Steelhead

- Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game -



Learn how to get the most from your harvested fish.

Fall salmon and steelhead fishing is in full swing, and many happy anglers are celebrating the fall season with delicious fish in their coolers and on their tables. Filleting and processing large salmon and steelhead can be intimidating to some people, so this article was written to help those individuals and maybe provide some new tricks to the seasoned anglers to ensure you get the most out of your catch.

Caring for your catch starts on the river, and it is good practice to bleed salmon and steelhead immediately after catching them and then quickly get them in a cooler and covered with ice. This will ensure your catch stays fresh until you get home.

When you are ready to process your catch, start with a clean working area and wipe the exterior of your fish of any blood and slime. Use a sharp fillet knife to remove the fillets from your fish, working carefully to remove as much meat as possible. Many people struggle to get a good fillet off the second side of their fish once the first side is removed. One trick to get better fillets from both sides is to make all the major cuts on each side (down the back, through the tail, and over/through the ribs) before removing either fillet from the fish. Try this next time you fillet a salmon, steelhead, or trout and see if it helps get more consistent fillets.

Once the fillets are removed, trim any fatty areas from the fillet and remove the pin bones if desired. If you plan to freeze any of your catch, a vacuum sealer is a good way to package your fish before freezing it. Many people stop processing at this point, discard the remainder of the carcass, and fail to realize there are several other useable parts on a salmon, steelhead, or trout.

One way to get more meat from your catch is to use a spoon to scrape up the meat that remains on the carcass after the filleting process. Notice how clean the ribs and area above the backbone are in the photo on the right compared to the one on the left after scraping the carcass with a spoon. Do this to both sides of a large fish and you will be surprised how much meat you can recover. This meat is great for making salmon cakes or using in other recipes such as stir fry.

Another meat source hiding in plain sight is what is known as the "collar". The collar meat is located just behind the head and gill operculum and extends from the back to the belly and has some of

the richest meat on the fish in terms of fat content. Check out this link to see a video on how to remove the collars from a salmon: https://www.vipoutdoors. com/how-to-remove-salmon-collars/


With the fillets, rib/backbone meat, and collars removed you have most of the edible parts that your catch will yield, but there are still other useable parts on your fish! Chinook and steelhead belly meat can be cooked and eaten, but is more often used by anglers as bait to target other species including sturgeon and catfish. The tough skin of the belly meat keeps the bait firmly attached to the hook and the oily flesh makes it an attractive bait.

Eggs are another prized part of harvested fish and most anglers who are fortunate to harvest a female fish know the eggs they carry with them make great bait for future outings. Removing the egg skeins and preserving them using various egg cures for future salmon and steelhead fishing trips is just one more way to make the most of your catch and hedge your bets towards successful trips in the future.



By now your salmon or steelhead carcass is looking pretty thin and has been put to good use. Instead of throwing the rest in the garbage, consider burying the carcass in your garden to fertilize future crops. You will be amazed how quickly a buried fish carcass can be broken down, leaving valuable nutrients in the soil. Lastly, if you're really feeling adventurous, consider using the head in a delicious fish head soup recipe like the one found here: https://www.seriouseats.com/salmon-head-soup-recipe

The next time you harvest a salmon, steelhead or large trout, try to get the most out of that fish by incorporating some of these tips into your fish processing routine!





Hagfish Day Third Wednesday in October

On the third Wednesday in October, Hagfish Day brings awareness to the evolved but slimy hagfish.

Hagfish are considered to be the ugliest of species. The idea behind this observance is to encourage everyone to look beyond the exterior of the Hagfish and appreciate how highly evolved they are. Not unlike a book cover, the day points out the benefits of looking deeper into the subject.

The hagfish offers many benefits to the ecosystem. Despite its unappealing exterior, it scavenges the ocean floor, cleaning up the debris of dead marine animals. The slime they produce protects them from predators. While it's thinner than human hair, the slime is stronger than nylon. Researchers are seeking the potential commercial, medical and environmental uses of slime. The military also sees its potential. For example, Navy researchers developed a synthetic hagfish slime using E.coli bacteria. U.S.

Biochemist Dr. Josh Kogot and materials engineer Dr. Ryan Kincer hope the strong synthetic slime can provide added protection for naval vessels.

In some cultures, this eel is even considered a delicacy. Though the meat is mild, it can have a bitter aftertaste.

A. With 76 species of hagfish in the world, the smallest hagfish grows to about 18 cm and the largest to 127 cm.

A. Hagfish populate the cold waters of all the world's oceans.



Hunt Safe With These 10 Survival Tips When Hunting Big Game

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game —




Hunters can take precautions and prepare for an unexpected situations in the woods.

Every hunting season, hunters get lost in the woods, and while most escape no worse than tired, chilled and hungry, the hazards of being lost in Idaho's woods shouldn't be underestimated.

Hunters can take precautions and prepare for an unexpected situations in the woods.

Know the area you're hunting

Always be conscious of your surroundings, prominent points, river or creek drainages, and occasionally turn around and look behind you so you will remember what it looks like when you're coming back. If you're on a trail, don't hesitate to put a temporary marker at intersections. Things can look different on your return, especially if you return in the dark.



Don't rely solely on electronics

Devices like GPS, cell phones and two-way radios are handy, but dead batteries and other malfunctions render them useless. A map and compass are less likely to fail, but you also have to know how to use them.

Tell someone your plans and set a check-in time

Often hunters are out longer than expected, especially when they are pursuing big game animals far from a road. You may want to set an absolute deadline and have someone who can alert the authorities if you haven't returned, or contacted someone by that time. Ditto for your hunting partner. Hunters often get separated, so set up a rendezvous time and place and decide in advance when a third party will seek help if you or your partners do not return in time.



Watch for extreme weather changes

You're more likely to get lost or turned around in poor visibility when it's raining, foggy or snowing, which are also conditions when it's potentially more hazardous to be lost in the woods. Cold, wet weather can mean the difference between an uncomfortable

situation and life-threatening one.

Remember even on clear days temperatures can change dramatically. A warm, sunny afternoon can quickly drop to subfreezing after dark, and daily temperature swings of 30 to 40 degrees are fairly common during fall.

Dress for, or carry clothes, for the worst weather you're likely to encounter

It's also common to quickly go from warm and sunny to raining or snowing. Dressing in layers is a good way to account for weather changes, and wearing a daypack means you can stash clothes when they're not in use and keep them handy when you need them.

Avoid cotton clothing, which is comfortable when dry, but provides no warmth when wet. Modern, synthetic fabrics will insulate even when damp or wet and will typically dry faster when they get wet. They are more comfortable in nearly all conditions than cotton.

Wool is also better than cotton, and modern merino wool is itch-free and comfortable in a wide range of temperatures.



Be prepared to build a fire

Whether matches, lighter or other devices, carry a fire starter that's weatherproof, and it's good to have a backup. Know how to start a fire in all weather conditions, but remember cold weather doesn't end fire season, so never leave a fire that's not completely extinguished.

Bring a flash light or headlamp and extra batteries

They're valuable for navigating in early mornings or after dark and keep you from getting lost, as well as just being handy for a variety of purposes.

If you get lost, warmth, shelter and water should be your priorities

You can go days without food, but staying warm and hydrated are critical to your survival. You're not going to starve if you're out longer than anticipated, but it's never a bad idea to carry extra food with you. Commercial survival kits provide most of the essentials, but many are overkill, so don't carry more than you will likely need.

Think about exactly what you would want for an extended stay in the woods and keep those items with you at all times. If you get lost, admit it to yourself and prepare to spend the night out. Build a fire for warmth and set up shelter. Wandering around will make it harder for search and rescue personnel to find you. It also fuels your anxiety, preventing you from thinking clearly and making good decisions.

Don't forget your vehicle and ATV

Have your vehicle ready for the backcountry and prepared for minor breakdowns, such as flat tires or dead batteries. A separate survival kit for your vehicle is a good idea.

Keep a dry set of clothes in your vehicle

This isn't necessarily a survival matter, but being soggy and wet can range from uncomfortable to miserable. Changing into warm, dry clothes for the drive back to home or to camp is a big bonus for a small amount of effort.

Fall Is For Planting

– Stacey Mann -



I love fall. I love the cool mornings, the leaves turning colors and the crispness in the air. Fall is also cooler days, rain and a great time for planting. Actually, fall is the BEST time for planting. Let me explain.

Say you buy some plants at a nursery in the spring. The plants' job for that season is to leaf out, (grow foliage) and flower, make a seed head to distribute its seed (reproduce), survive the hot summer and then start the dormancy cycle, knowing it needs to survive a long cold winter. It must do all these things while the weather is getting hotter and hotter, the plant sometimes gets heat stressed, nevertheless, it has to do its job.

When you plant a plant in the fall, the only job that plants needs to do is put all its energy into the root system. It has already done all the things I mentioned above, so it knows that it just needs to get ready for dormancy. Falls has much cooler days and nights, and also much needed rain. The fall planted plants don't need to produce flowers, no seed to ripen, no foliage to maintain, just get rooted in.

Roots grow very fast and easy in the cool fall weather. Many years back I did an experiment (I'm really a closet scientist). I took a 4" perennial and ripped the root system apart, I then put it in a one-gallon pot and set it outside in the fall. I wanted to see how the root system was doing with the cool weather, so I pulled the perennial out of the gallon container to check. The root system had already reached the edge of the pot in just 3 weeks and the gallon was fully rooted now.

That experiment taught me how fast and easy it



is for a plant to get established in the fall when the weather is cooler. The plant doesn't have to work as hard as it does any other time of year. I know that spring is the favorite time to plant, I get the spring fever frenzy also, but fall is often forgotten in the gardening world because people don't understand how well plants establish in the fall. It is really not too late to plant; it is an excellent time to plant. Once the ground is frozen, its too late, but up until then, it's a great planting time.

I have planted perennials, trees, shrubs and bulbs right up until Thanksgiving some years. I put the turkey in the oven and went outside and planted a huge number of perennials and bulbs one crazy year in my youth. I don't recommend waiting until Thanksgiving to plant, I'm just trying to make the point that it is not too late to plant until you can't get a shovel into the ground. September and October are my favorite time to plant. I am even redoing some of my flower beds this fall and I'm so excited to do it.

You will be pleasantly surprised next spring when you plant perennial this fall. The plants will be triple the size as it was when you planted it. The roots still grow in the winter under all the snow, and your plants will be bursting with energy waiting to delight you next spring because it will be all rooted and established.

The last reason that you might want to plant in the fall is plants are on SALE! We have loved and nurtured these plants all year long and now it is time to get them to good homes. All the nurseries in town have great sales going on and you can get some really great plants for next to nothing.

I challenge you to give it a try. I guarantee you will not be disappointed. Also consider yanking out all your tired old petunias in your containers and refreshing them with mums, kale, pansies, etc. These plants can handle hard frosts and will look beautiful well into early November. I planted a kale planter a few years back and the kale looked great until Christmas, no joke.

FWP Requests That Recreationists Be On The Lookout For Greater Short-Horned Lizards This Fall

— Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks –

GLASGOW - As you are hitting the field this fall, be sure to take a break from scanning the horizon for game and look down at the ground once in a while. Not only will this help you avoid stepping on a cactus or a rattlesnake, but you might also see one of eastern Montana's rarely seen critters...the greater short-horned lizard, commonly known as a "horny toad." If you do, Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks would like to know about it.

The greater short- horned lizard, Phrynosoma hernandesi, was once considered the second most abundant reptile along the Missouri River in Montana in the late 19th Century, second only to the western rattlesnake. Currently, however, these lizards are considered a 'Species of Greatest Inventory Need' in Montana due to insufficient data on their population and distribution.

According to Nicole Hussey, FWP wildlife biologist in Region 6, "We have been conducting surveys in eastern Montana to try and determine status and distribution as well as fill in data gaps; however, their elusive nature and cryptic coloration make them extremely difficult to locate."

"This is where we can use outdoor recreationists' help," continued Hussey, "because oftentimes people just accidentally come across one."

Hussey and other biologists are seeking the help of folks out trekking around the countryside to provide incidental observations in addition to our structured survey efforts.

"If you happen to observe one anywhere in the state," says Hussey, "please record the location, get GPS coordinates if possible, and note the date, number observed, and take a photo with something in the picture for scale if you can."

Observations can be reported to your local FWP biologist.

A few things about the greater short-horned lizard:

- · Adult greater short-horned lizards are diurnal, meaning they are most active during the warmer daylight hours.
- · Coloration is cryptic with the soil (blends in) and can vary by locality.
- The broad, flattened body separates this lizard from the other three lizard species regularly documented in Montana, and the range overlaps only with the common sagebrush lizard, which is much more slender.
- The head has a "heart-shaped" appearance when viewed from above.
- They are usually easiest to spot when they move and catch your eye.

Habitat:

- · Greater short-horned lizards are found in the eastern half of Montana, but in scattered locations throughout their range.
- · They are often found on south or east-facing slopes of coulees and ridge tops, and some open
- · They prefer habitats with sagebrush, creeping iuniper, or rabbitbrush with sparse bunch grass, patches of bare ground, and shale-like soil. They are even found in some ponderosa pine stands.

Fun Fact:

They can shoot blood out of their eyes! As a defense mechanism against canid and felid predators, the greater short-horned lizard will shoot pressurized blood from its eye. The blood has a repulsive taste that comes from consuming venomous har-

Decorative Andirons

Shining red and yellow eyes peer from the dancing shadows. This could be a scene from a haunted forest – or a cozy living room fireplace.

A cast iron figure of an owl perched on a twisted branch decorates each of these andirons, which sold as a pair for \$660 at Morphy Auctions. They use the fire to their advantage with colored glass marbles that catch the light for eyes. Appropriately, they are marked "Bright Eyes" on the reverse.

Andirons have been used for hundreds of years to hold the logs off the fireplace floor, allowing for air circulation and letting the fire burn brighter. They are also decorative, with styles changing over time. Animal and bird figures became popular by the 19th century.

Owls have been used in art and decoration since ancient times. Their big bright eyes and ability to see at night make them a symbol of wisdom. But being nocturnal, not to mention their eerie calls, means they are also associated with darkness and bad luck. Of course, around Halloween, when it's time to be scary, a sign of bad luck can be a good thing!

I found the strangest tea set in my father's attic. It must be for children because the pieces are small. The background is white with an old lady holding a baby, a jester, and a frog smoking a pipe printed in red. The border and flowers are red, too. Most pieces have "Punch" printed on the bottom. There are 16 pieces, and all are in great condition. Can you tell me anything about the set and its possible value?

The tea set is a children's set made by Charles Allerton & Sons, Staffordshire, England, in the late 19th century. The figures you describe are the famous slapstick puppets, Punch and Judy and their baby. The Punch character originated in 16th-century Italy. A routine comedy performance usually ends with another puppet (often his wife, Judy) the target of a hit by Punch's "slapstick." Slapstick also

began in 16th-century Italy when two thin pieces of wood were slapped together to make a loud exaggerated slapping sound during comedy shows. The puppets have been popular for about 350 years. Tea sets like yours have recently sold for \$110 to \$160.

TIP: Early (18th-century) glass is thinner than later glass. Early mirrors reflect a darker image than new mirrors.

On October 13th, the United States Navy observes its birthday every year.

The United States Navy (USN) is the United States Armed Forces' naval warfare service branch and one of the seven uniformed services of the United States. The U.S. Navy is currently the largest, most powerful navy in the world, with the highest combined battle fleet tonnage. The service has over 340,000 personnel on active duty and more than 71,000 in the Navy Reserve.

With only two ships and a crew of eighty men, the Continental Navy was born on October 13, 1775. The decision of the Continental Congress set the Continental Navy on course to carry arms to the British army, not to defend against it. However, these two ships and crew represent the birth of the United States Navy.

Throughout the Revolutionary War, their importance grew. Today, the United States maintains 40 naval bases across the country, including the world's largest Naval Station Norfolk, in Norfolk, Virginia.

Below the sea, submarines became a part of the Navy during World War II. 



Improperly notched tags are one of the most common violations conservation officers see in the field.

With that animal down, you're overcome with waves of emotions as all the months of effort and training have paid off. The next step, in your mind, might be gutting and quartering the animal, or figuring out the packout route back to the truck.

It's easy to forget in all the excitement that a hunter's next priority after shooting an animal is tagging it. And doing so properly.

Improperly notched tags are one of the most common violations conservation officers see in the field.

So as a reminder for hunters, after you harvest your animal, you must validate your tag by completely removing the correct day and month - just like in the picture - and attaching it to the largest portion of the carcass.







Prescribed Fire Planned For Threemile Wildlife **Management Area In The Bitterroot Valley**

— Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks —

Burn is weather dependent; expect to see smoke periodically this month

STEVENSVILLE - A 275-acre prescribed burn is planned for the Threemile Wildlife Management Area (WMA), located northeast of Stevensville in the Bitterroot Valley, beginning this week.

The objectives of the prescribed burn are to enhance wildlife habitat and reduce fuel loads. The burn is expected to occur from now through mid to late October, and residents and visitors should expect to see smoke periodically.

Prescribed fire is a short disturbance for longterm benefits of fuel reduction and wildlife habitat enhancement on the WMA, and this particular project was proposed as part of phase 2 of the Threemile WMA forest habitat work, approved by the Montana Fish and Wildlife Commission in 2019.

Specific project objectives are focused on enhancing forage for big game wildlife, restoring open forest conditions dominated by ponderosa pine, and reducing fuel loading. The treatment is aimed at creating a condition that would allow fire to burn at a low severity appropriate for the habitat type, reduce susceptibility to bark beetle infestations, and promote aspen growth and regeneration.

The project is a cooperative effort between Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks, the Bitterroot National Forest, and the Montana Department of Natural Resources and Conservation. Funding for this habitat management work was provided by FWP and grants through the Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation.

Smoke from Threemile WMA will be visible from many places in the Bitterroot Valley, including from Highway 93. The project is weather dependent, but burning is expected to start this week with most completed prior to the start of the general deer and elk season (October 21, 2023).

Early fall is a typical time for prescribed burns to occur region-wide, so recreationists and residents could expect to see smoke from other public lands as well. To minimize smoke impact on communities, the exact timing of the burns will depend on weather, fuel moisture levels, and air flow.



Reminder About Important Changes To Waterfowl Seasons In The Panhandle

- Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game -



2023-24 waterfowl seasons in the Panhandle differ from those in previous years

Hunters are reminded that season dates for Canada geese in Area 3 now include a split season. It is important for hunters to remember the Canada goose season will be closed for a 12-day period from Oct. 23–Nov. 3, opening again on Nov. 4. For more information, see page 9 in the 2023-24 Idaho Migratory Game Bird Seasons and Rules.

2023-24 duck season dates in Area 3:

- Oct. 7, 2023-Jan. 19, 2024
- Scaup Season: Oct. 26, 2023-Jan. 19, 2024

2023-24 Canada goose season dates in Area 3:

- Oct. 7- Oct. 22, 2023
- Nov. 4, 2023–Jan. 31, 2024



The changes were adopted by the Idaho Fish and Game Commission at their April 2023 meeting based on public input received during the 2023-24 waterfowl season setting process.

Some hunters in north Idaho expressed dissatisfaction with the season structure during the 2022-23 season and a desire to hunt Canada geese through Jan. 31. Results from previous surveys suggested

duck hunters preferred seasons that started and ended early. Furthermore, Canada goose hunters preferred seasons that started and ended as late as possible but occurred at the same time as duck seasons. It has been difficult to satisfy these desires with the season structure proposed in recent years.

To better meet hunter preferences for late-season Canada goose hunting opportunity, Fish and Game proposed two Canada goose season options in the Panhandle for public consideration. One option was for a continuous Canada goose season (no split) at the same time as the duck season; the second option was a split-season, with opening day starting at the same time as the duck season (Oct. 7), a 12-day closure of the season from Oct. 23–Nov. 3 and the remainder of the season from Nov. 4–Jan. 31.

Feedback received from waterfowl hunters during the March 2023 season setting public comment period indicated approximately 75% of respondents supported the split-season option for Canada geese in the Panhandle.



Fish and Game relies on public input, especially when making recommendations to the Commission about proposed changes to any hunting seasons and rules. Members of the public are always encouraged to participate in surveys and public comment periods to help shape the nature and outcome of proposals, management plans and more.



Q. Should I go against or with the grain when shaving my scalp?

A. The schools of thought are divided on the topic of against or with the grain. If you want a closer shave, go against the grain. If you prefer to be gentle with your skin, go with the grain. This guidance applies where ever you are shaving.

Q. Do I need to wear sunblock if my scalp is bald?

A. Yes. Any exposed skin will be at risk of sunburn and damage when outdoors. Wearing a hat is another option.

Q. How often should I shave my head?

A. Shaving every other day or every third day will prevent your scalp from becoming dry and


