





City of Coeur d'Alene LEAF-FEST **Begins November 13th**

MONDAY, NOVEMBER 13th, 2023 marks the start of the City of Coeur d'Alene's annual leaf pick-up program. Please be sure to KEEP leaves on your property until Wednesday, November 1st. After Wednesday the 1st, please rake your leaves and pine needles about one foot away from the gutter/curb line to allow for water drainage. City crews and equipment are limited, so we need your help. Leaves will be picked up only once. Please do not put leaves in the street after city crews have completed your area and do not include bagged leaves, branches, debris or trash.

Pick-up will start south of Sherman Avenue and move north. We expect completion before December 1st. Follow our progress on maps.cdaid.org/leaf

REMEMBER:

Needles and

Leaves ONLY!

No branches,

grass clippings

or garden debris.

NO GARBAGE

KEEP leaves and needles on property until **Wednesday, November 1st**.

- Please move cars off the street if at all possible during leaf pick-up.
- Keep the leaves about one foot away from the curb line to allow drainage. • Be alert for leaf pick-up equipment traveling through your neighborhood.
- Keep a safe distance away from leaf pick-up heavy equipment.
- Recognize that we have a tough job to do in a very short window between
- when the leaves fall and when the snow flies. • City and private trucks are exempted from covering loads during the leaf

pick-up period. Sweepers will follow city trucks to collect remaining/ excess leaves.

DO NOT:

- Place bagged leaves in the street.
- Mix branches, debris or other trash in with the leaves.
- Miss the deadline...We only have time for one pass.



Q. My spouse and I cannot decide on a color to paint our bedroom. Which color would support better sleep?



F&G Biologists Believe Walleye Are Now Established And Reproducing In Lake Lowell

Fish and Game biologists learned on Oct. 10 that Lake Lowell now likely has a reproducing population of walleye. While the effects to Lake Lowell and other area fisheries are uncertain at this point, they are concerned about what this might mean for this fishery and others in Southwest Idaho.

During a recent warmwater fish survey of the outlet of Lake Lowell, Fish and Game staff encountered and killed 31 walleye of two different size classes. Most of the walleye were on the small side – around 7 inches in length – leading biologists to believe that they are successfully reproducing in the lake.

"We are not certain how walleye got into Lake Lowell in the first place, but their introduction was not sanctioned by Fish and Game and Lake Lowell is not a place we want them," said Art Butts, regional fisheries manager.

A reproducing population of walleye was something that biologists in the region had been hoping to avoid amid infrequent - but periodic - reports of anglers catching walleye there in recent years. They had a number of reasons to hold onto that hope: First, no walleye were encountered during a 2022 fish composition survey of the lake; second, all of the walleye reported by anglers in recent years had been larger adults, which biologists suspected had been illegally transferred into Lake Lowell.

But that changed in late September – just weeks before the survey - when Fish and Game confirmed a report of an angler catching a 7-inch walleye. With that report of a single, smaller fish, Butts had to consider the possibility that walleye were reproducing in Lake Lowell. After the survey, the possibility shifted to a probability.

'With the sheer number of walleye we sampled from just about 200 yards of the canal, and with the majority of those fish being in a smaller size class, it is a really strong piece of evidence showing that we have a self-sustaining population of walleye here," Butts said. "And that's really concerning."

What's wrong with walleye?

Walleye are nonnative in Idaho and are managed in a limited numbers of waters in the state because they can be harmful to other gamefish populations, take over popular fishing waters and lead to a decrease in fish available for anglers.

"Put simply, walleye are fish that voraciously eat other fish," Butts said. "They are native to the Midwest where they rely on a prolific prey base that is just not present in Idaho waters – and that means they are instead going to prey on gamefish species, particularly panfish and trout, that are popular with anglers."

In waters where introduced walleye are not compatible with an existing fishery, walleye anglers might enjoy good fishing for a few years before the other shoe drops and the fishery becomes almost entirely composed of stunted, skinny walleye. This results in an unbalanced fishery that is equally unappealing to anglers who might have valued the panfish opportunity that previously existed there (or bass that relied on that prey base to grow to desirable sizes), as well as walleye anglers.

"These are the sort of things Fish and Game would weigh if we were considering introducing any new

species to a fishery through the established, legal process - not just walleye," Butts said. "It's not something we would do without thorough consideration and forethought.

"When a highly invasive species is introduced to a water outside that established process, as walleye were in Lake Lowell, we are forced to dedicate a lot of resources towards assessing the impact on the existing fishery, and unfortunately, most of our anglers are robbed of the opportunity to weigh in on the matter."

Lake Lowell isn't a fit for walleye, but control strategies are limited

Fish and Game provides walleye in a few, carefully selected reservoirs that are in closed systems so the fish can't migrate into other waters, and where walleye are suitable for those bodies of water.

"Fish and Game doesn't view walleye as 'bad fish," Butts added. "But we do want to ensure that they are only in places where they are compatible with existing fisheries."

Walleye have migrated from neighboring states through river systems, and they can use canals and other waterways to migrate from one location to another. That's a major reason why Lake Lowell specifically is a bad place for an established walleye population.

"Most of the year, Lake Lowell is an open source to the Snake River through the canal systems," Butts said. "In theory, these fish could reach the Snake and go downstream into the Hells Canyon Complex of reservoirs and even below Hells Canyon itself, which is a major migration corridor for salmon and steelhead. They could also move up into the tributaries, including the Boise River."

In addition to walleye being able to move into new areas on their own from Lake Lowell, having another established population of walleye creates a new source for irresponsible people to illegally transport this highly predatory species to other, unconnected waters. Unfortunately, this is a known and confirmed issue within the Southwest Region. Fish and Game confirmed in early 2023 that a walleye caught in Lake Cascade was illegally introduced from another body of water using microchemistry analysis.

"Having a source water within the region could compound the issue and make it easier for irresponsible people to move these fish to places they shouldn't be," Butts said.

What it means for the Lake Lowell fishery itself

How might an established walleye population affect the Lake Lowell fishery itself? Frankly, fisheries staff don't know at this point.

"What we do know is that Lake Lowell is a forage fish-limited system, and it ebbs and flows with good and bad water years," Butts said.

The condition of largemouth bass, which is the primary species Fish and Game manages for at Lake Lowell, fluctuate according to the number of forage fish available. Walleye add another competitor to the mix that are likely to directly compete with bass for a variable forage base, but how that will ultimately play out remains to be seen.

"Now that walleye appear to be established, there aren't many viable control strategies for Lake Lowell," Butts said. "Unfortunately, we're going to have to wait and see. It is likely that this will alter the va riety and abundance of fish species in Lake Lowell, and it's going to make things more difficult as we try to manage for our bass, bluegill, perch and catfish populations here."

How anglers can help

Fish and Game asks anglers who catch a walleve (in waters where they are not supposed to be) to kill, remove and report them to a regional office. Anglers can keep the fillets, but are being asked to save the carcass and bring it to a regional office, or notify department staff and arrange for a pickup.

"Because we do not have any legally established walleye fisheries in the entire Southwest Region and these fish shouldn't be present here - we would also like walleye carcasses if anglers happen to catch one in another waterbody," Butts said.

National Sweetest Day History

National Sweetest Day found its beginnings in Pixie Sticks and Fun-Dip.

a holiday founded by the National Confectioners' Association in 1916 called Candy Day. On October 14, 1916, candy shops around the country filled newspapers announcing their sweetest treats and delights. Originally designated to be celebrated the second Saturday of every October, the confectioners' convention in Detroit in May of 1916 made the final resolution. Walter C. Hughes, the secretary of the National Confectioners' Association, encouraged Americans to patronizes their local candy shops, bakers, and druggist for the highest quality confections.

Candy Day

Early advertisements found in Indiana, Minnesota, and Texas newspapers mention the "Sweetest Day of the Year" in reference to Candy Day. However, it was not the official name of the day - not yet.

By 1917 war raging in Europe, and many retailers encouraged patrons to "Get one for yourself and one for the boys overseas!"

Then in April of 1918, the United States officially entered the war in Europe, and with that came rationing. Sugar, as well as many other commodities, became scarce. Sponsors shelved the holiday just as it was starting to see such success.

Sweetest Day of the Year Returns

With the end of the war in 1919, sweetness returned to October. So sweet, in fact, Candy Day became an entire week. Then in 1923, the day kicked into full charitable swing.

Sweetest Day's theme of charity and giving became apparent in 1921. At the time, four Michigan confectioners united with the Red Cross. Those confectioners included the Detroit Retail Confectioners, Detroit Wholesale Confections Club, Detroit Jobbing Confectioners Association, and the Michigan Confectioners Club. Together, they distributed thousands of bags of candy to hospitals, orphanages, shelters, and homes across Michigan. The celebration also included 100 regulation army target balloons, which dropped coupons worth a box of candy.

In 1929, Sweetest Day settled into its current home, the third Saturday in October.





Sour FAQ

Q. What are the five basic tastes?

A. Many experts agree that we taste five basic tastes on our tongues. Those five basic tastes are sweet, sour, salty, bitter, and umami, also known as savory. Heart Is Deconditioned to Exercise After Airbag Injury

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am a 69-year-old who used to walk up 75 to 90 flights of steps several days a week as exercise. After a steering wheel airbag went off and damaged my heart, I am afraid my ability to do that stopped. After years of medication, I am now on a pacemaker, which definitely

Could the exercise have weakened my heart to such a degree that it could be viewed as overdoing it, therefore exacerbating my condition? -- Anon.

ANSWER: In general, exercise does not harm the heart. On the contrary, exercise is almost always good for the heart. However, there are exceptions. In healthy people, there is an optimal amount of exercise, and extreme levels of exercise (on the order of running more than 10 miles a day every day) begin to decrease the benefit that a person gets from exercise. (This remains controversial, but I am convinced from the data.)

In people with severe heart disease (the kind with blockages in the arteries), overdoing exercise can lead to a heart attack, but this is an exception. For every person who gets harmed by overexercising, there must be a hundred who don't get adequate exercise.

The fact that you have improved a lot on the pacemaker suggests that at least part of your problem wasn't with the pump function of your heart, nor

with the arteries leading to your heart. The problem lies with the electrical supply.

Once a pacemaker is in, that problem is immediately alleviated, but the heart may still be deconditioned ("out of shape"). Regular exercise will help the problem.

Your cardiologist can better answer the question for you and also give you advice on how to build up your exercise tolerance over time.

DEAR DR. ROACH: Colds and flus seem to linger in my lungs and nose for a week or more after all other symptoms have passed. If my phlegm and mucus are clear or white, and I feel healthy otherwise, am I still considered infectious? -- S.C.

ANSWER: The color of sputum and mucus is not a reliable indicator of whether an infection is caused by bacteria or viruses, nor of whether you are still infectious. Colds and flus like COVID are caused by viruses. A person is most infectious starting from a day or two before they get symptoms up until a day or two after symptoms start. Most people are no longer infectious after five to seven days of having symptoms, but unfortunately, that's not always 100% certain.

Part of the body's response to infection is to make a great deal of mucus to wash the infection away. This can lead to us feeling very uncomfortable with copious sneezing, runny noses and productive cough. In some people, this tendency is more prolonged. It sounds like you might be one of those people in whom the body's response to infection causes more symptoms than the infection itself.

We can test pretty well for COVID infectiousness with at-home testing, but those home tests don't exist for the flu or other viruses. Following the same advice for COVID -- staying home for at least 24 hours after a fever has gone, or remaining in isolation for at least five days without a fever -- will minimize your infectiousness to others.

Game Boards

On top of the world! In September 1909, The New York Times published Robert Peary's claims of reaching the North Pole in April of that year, crediting him with the pole's discovery. However, just a week earlier, another newspaper claimed that Frederick Cook had reached the pole the year before. Both claims have been disputed since then, but they were sensations at the time.

The journey to the North Pole inspired commemorative figurines, souvenirs and games. This North Pole game has a patent date of 1910. It is a game of skill in which the player rolls one of the included metal balls along the winding track, earning points for each hole the ball passes without falling in. The rules are printed on the back of the board, along with a scene of two explorers approaching the pole.

This game sold for \$480 at Morphy Auctions. The lot included the colorfully lithographed tin game board, two metal balls, the instructions sheet and the box with a color picture of a family in early 1900s dress playing the game. Commercial game boards sell for higher prices when they come with the original box and pieces.

How can I safely clean old coins?

Coins should not be cleaned. Collectors want coins with the patina unchanged. If your coins are collectible, they should be protected from fingerprints and stored properly. Don't touch the coins to examine them unless you are wearing white gloves. The oil from your skin will damage the coin. If you must touch a coin, hold it by the edge. Coins should not be stored loose in a box or envelope. They may be scratched. Paper, cardboard, plastic and wood give off chemical vapors that speed corrosion. You can buy archival coin holders online or at a coin shop. Coins should be kept in a cool, dry location. You can find more information on properly storing coins on the American Numismatic Association website, money.org.

TIP: Clean cast iron with coarse salt and a soft sponge. The salt is abrasive enough to remove bits of food and absorb oil without harming the pan's seasoning. Rinse and wipe dry.

Know Your Species Before Heading Into The Mountains This Fall

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game —



It may seem easy, but correctly identifying your target species can be a challenge at times

Is that a mule deer or a white-tailed deer? A moose or an elk? A black bear or a grizzly bear? These are questions asked and thoughts pondered by many a sportsman each hunting season.

While it may seem like an easy task, correctly identifying your target species can be challenging at times. Weather conditions, distance from the animal and misleading appearances can be factors that complicate the task.

Freshen up your identification skills by reviewing characteristics of a few species in Idaho that are commonly misidentified.

Mule Deer vs. White-tailed Deer

Mule deer:

- · Large ears relative to their heads
- · White rumps
- · Rope-like tail with a black tip
- · Antlers of older males fork and fork again



White-tailed deer:

- · Small ears relative to their heads
- Brown rump
- · Brown tail with white fringe
- · Bottom of erect tail is completely white
- · Antlers of older males consist of main beams with tines pointing upward



Moose vs. Elk

Moose

- · Dark brown to almost black fur; uniform color across the body
- · Dewlap or "beard" (fur-covered skin below the
- · Dorsal hump behind the neck
- Wide palmate or paddle-shaped antlers (male)
- · Long, broad nose with visible fatty pads near nostrils

• Solitary; though females may be seen with calves or yearlings



Elk:

- Tan to brown in color with light-colored rump; darker neck and head
- No dewlap
- · Narrow, more pointed nose
- · Branched antlers (single beam with tines); in older males, antlers sweep back toward the rump
- · Social; commonly observed in small groups or



Black Bear vs. Grizzly Bear

Black bear:

- · No prominent shoulder hump
- Straight face profile
- · Tall ears
- · Short claws (1-2 inches)



Grizzly bear:

- · Prominent shoulder hump
- Dished face profile
- · Short, rounded ears
- Long claws (2-4 inches)



Never rely on size and color to determine the species of bear, as both can be misleading. Pictured below is a nearly black-colored grizzly bear. For additional training resources on identifying bear species, check out idfg.idaho.gov/hunt/bear-info/overview.



Yes, this is a grizzly bear - albeit a nearly all-black colored one.

Why it matters

Cases of misidentification result in the harvest of animals that were not intended to be harvested both by sportsmen and Idaho Fish and Game.

Hunting seasons and rules are set using the best information available to ensure hunting, trapping and fishing remain available to future generations. While a few cases of misidentification may not negatively affect a wildlife population, more widespread occurrences can.

In addition, cases of misidentification may result in citations being issued, which negatively impacts the sportsmen involved. It is the responsibility of hunters to correctly identify their target species and know when and where hunting for that species is allowed. Make sure to review the 2023 Idaho Big Game Season and Rules brochure (idfg.idaho.gov/sites/default/ files/seasons-rules-big-game-2023-2024.pdf) so you are in the know.
