City of Coeur d'Alene LEAF-FEST
Begins November 13th

MONDAY, NOVEMBER 13th, 2023 marks the start of the City of Coeur d'Alene's annual leaf pick-up program. Please be sure to **KEEP** leaves on your property until **Wednesday, November 1st**. After Wednesday the 1st, please rake your leaves and pine needles about one foot away from the gutter/curb line to allow for water drainage. City crews and equipment are limited, so we need your help. Leaves will be picked up only once. Please do not put leaves in the street after city crews have completed your area and **do not** include bagged leaves, branches, debris or trash.

Pick-up will start south of Sherman Avenue and move north. We expect completion before December 1st. Follow our progress on maps.cdaid.org/leaf

LEAF-FEST DO'S & DON'TS

DO:

- KEEP leaves and needles on property until **Wednesday, November 1st**.
- Please move cars off the street if at all possible during leaf pick-up.
- Keep the leaves about one foot away from the curb line to allow drainage.
- Be alert for leaf pick-up equipment traveling through your neighborhood.
- Keep a safe distance away from leaf pick-up heavy equipment.
- Recognize that we have a tough job to do in a very short window between when the leaves fall and when the snow flies.
- City and private trucks are exempted from covering loads during the leaf pick-up period. Sweepers will follow city trucks to collect remaining/excess leaves.

REMEMBER: Needles and Leaves ONLY! No branches, grass clippings or garden debris. NO GARBAGE

DO NOT:

- Place bagged leaves in the street.
- Mix branches, debris or other trash in with the leaves.
- Miss the deadline...We only have time for one pass.

Halloween October 31st

— National Day Calendar —



On October 31, Halloween brings out the ghouls and goblins, creatures, and strange folk. They come creeping about the neighborhood seeking favors over trickery.

People of all ages look forward to Halloween traditions. While dressing up and baking, we carve up glowing pumpkins. Children breathe life into storybook characters while practicing their trick or treat. In twos and threes, they traipse through the neighborhood, collecting their bounty in pillow sacks. A ghost, a pirate, a robot or Dorothy, and Toto. No matter their age, they come to the door. They knock or ring. Here and there, a screech or a boo!

The crisp air and autumn colors set the mood. Seasonings fill our senses with a taste of autumn. So we set forth on an adventure and finish with a warm apple cider around a flickering fire.

How To Observe Halloween

Typical festive Halloween activities include trick-or-treating (or the related "guising"). While many attend costume parties, bob for apples, and light bonfires, others look forward to counting trick or treaters. Many people decorate with sprays of fall leaves, scarecrows, and pumpkins carved into jack-o-lanterns. Attractions include visiting a haunted house, playing pranks, telling scary stories, and watching horror films.

However, trick or treating has also changed. In the United States, some organizations offer trick-or-treat events for children to come dressed up and collect candy in a safe environment. They may also offer Halloween parties for children to attend, too.

In many parts of the world, the Christian religious observances of All Hallows' Eve, including attending church services and lighting candles on the graves of the dead, remains popular. Although, in other locations, these solemn customs are less pronounced in favor of a more commercialized and secularized celebration.

Because many Western Christian denominations encourage, although no longer required, abstinence from meat on All Hallows' Eve, the tradition of eating certain vegetarian foods for this vigil day developed, including the consumption of apples, colcannon, cider, potato pancakes, and soul cakes.

For the safest Halloween trick or treating tips, be sure to check out the Centers for Disease Control guidelines. Then, get your spook on and use #Halloween to post on social media.

Halloween History

The observance dates back to an ancient pagan harvest festival marking the end of summer and the beckoning of winter. Seasons overlapped during Samhain (pronounced sah-win), and revelers believed the worlds of the living and the dead crossed. The living would wear costumes and light, bright bonfires to help protect them, allowing them to interact with the spirits.

Similar celebrations honoring the dead took place in Roman traditions, which were gradually blended and soon replaced the Celtic ceremonies. However, All Martyrs Day, established by Pope Boniface IV in 609 A.D., was eventually moved by Pope Gregory III to November 1. Later, it became known as All Saint's Day. The eve of this celebration became known as All Hallows Eve or Halloween.

Through the Colonial era in America, Halloween celebrations were considered taboo due to religious beliefs. By the Victorian era, though, Halloween traditions featured fall festivals, parties, and foods involving communities and neighborhoods.

Clearwater River Sets New State Record Coho Salmon

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game —



Breaks previous record by narrow margin

Matt Hosking of Lewiston, Idaho set a new state
record with this 11.78-pound coho salmon, caught
from the Clearwater River on October 13, 2023.

Congratulations to Matt Hosking of Lewiston, Ida-
ho on setting a new state record for coho salmon.
Matt caught the colossal coho in the Clearwater Riv-
er in on October 13th, 2023. Impressed by the size,
Matt kept the 32.68-inch salmon in hopes of a re-
cord. After weighing the fish on a certified scale at
a local grocery, the 11.78-pound coho salmon was

just big enough to squeeze past the previous "certi-
fied weight" record by a mere 0.48 oz!

This 11.78-pound coho salmon was 32.7 inches
long, swimming past the previous record to set a
new Certified Weight State Record for Idaho.

This will be the third year in a row where Idaho will
see a strong return of coho salmon, with over 15,000
adults passing over Lower Granite Dam. There has
only been one other year where Idaho received a
similar number of coho salmon.

Joe DuPont - the Clearwater Region Fishery Man-
ager - says fish like this are rare. "There are bigger
Coho out there, but not many. Based on the 2,400
Coho we have trapped at Lower Granite Dam this
year, only 2 would surpass the size of this fish."
Those are pretty slim odds to beat!

The success of the Coho Salmon fishery in the
Clearwater River has been a result of efforts by the
Nez Perce Tribe, who began the program back in
1994.

Help Fish And Game Detect License Fraud

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game —



License fraud is an abuse of the system, and it impacts Idaho's residents and fish and wildlife populations

A recent survey asked Idaho sportsmen and women what they viewed as the most severe and egregious wildlife violations - from fishing without a license, to spotlighting, to killing wildlife outside of legal seasons and more.

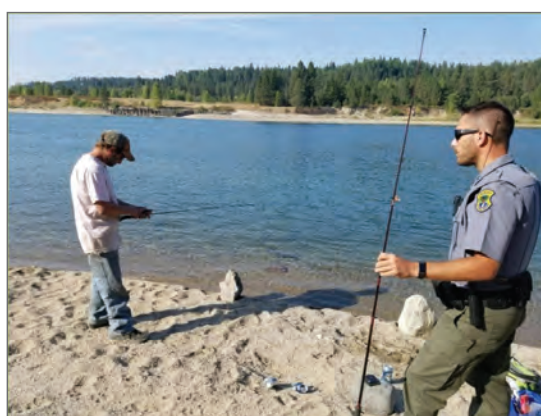
One of the top responses may come as a bit of a surprise to some: license fraud. It's no secret that prices for licenses, tags and permits are substantially cheaper and more readily available for residents of Idaho than for nonresidents. This is intentional - providing a benefit for the residents of Idaho to enjoy the wildlife resources of Idaho.

The benefits to residents are substantial. For example, the price difference between a resident sportsman's package and the non-resident equivalent in licenses, tags and permits is close to \$2,000. Plus, big game tag availability is considerably higher for residents than nonresidents.

These lower-cost and higher-availability residency benefits are very appealing, for obvious reasons. Sometimes the benefits are so appealing that some individuals cheat the system by falsifying residency status to get resident pricing and availability on licenses and tags. Those who fraudulently purchase licenses and tags are abusing resident privileges and committing a type of wildlife crime known as license fraud.

Each year, conservation officers throughout the state investigate license fraud and hold violators accountable; however, license fraud cases can be very difficult to detect.

Citizens can play an important role in helping us buckle down on this crime! Remembering these three simple steps can help ensure that Idaho's wildlife resources are enjoyed fairly and equitably by all.

Know Idaho's residency requirements

Residency requirements to purchase resident hunting, fishing and trapping licenses in Idaho are strict, and they're strict for a reason.

Those wishing to purchase a resident license must be a permanent resident in Idaho for at least six

months prior to making a resident purchase of any kind. They must also have and present a current Idaho driver's license, or for non-drivers, be able to show six months of permanent residency.

Furthermore, they must not claim any resident privileges in another state - including privileges like claiming a homeowner's exemption, filing income taxes, voting or buying resident licenses.

Be on the lookout for license fraud

License fraud cases can be difficult for conservation officers to detect, and those cheating the system may slide under the radar - possibly for years.

However, instances of license fraud are more common than some may think. Simply being aware of the problem and knowing Idaho's residency requirements will hopefully allow you to recognize situations when someone is taking advantage of resident privileges when they shouldn't.

Clues to look for include those that live out of state but use a friend or family member's address in Idaho, folks that have moved out of state but continue to recreate in Idaho or people claiming to have "dual residency".

As you interact with neighbors and folks in the field, pay attention to what you are hearing and make note of any potential red flags.

Report license fraud to CAP

Despite Idaho sportsmen and women indicating strong disdain for instances of license fraud and abuse of Idaho's resident privileges, conservation officers receive comparatively few tips about license fraud crimes each year. We need your help!

If you know or suspect someone who's cheating the system, it's important that you do the right thing and report the crime to a conservation officer. Reports can be made anonymously and completely confidential.

License fraud is a serious wildlife crime that abuses and impacts Idaho's residents and fish and wildlife populations. Please consider doing your part and reporting any and all wildlife crimes, including license fraud, by calling the Citizens Against Poaching (CAP) hotline. Reports of wildlife crimes can be made anonymously at 1-800-632-5999 or online at idfg.idaho.gov/d7/tipline.


The CAP hotline is staffed and available twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week.

These despicable people look for "Lost Pet" signs and call the owner's number, claiming that they are a nearby shelter and that they've found their pet. But there's a catch: In order to get the pet back, the owner must pay the shelter using an online payment app or by sending gift cards. And here's the cruelest part: The scammers don't have their pet. They just take the money and disappear. Please sound the alarm. – Denise O., San Francisco

DEAR DENISE: Absolutely, and thank you for this alert! Losing a pet is heartbreaking. Scammers always strike when we're at our most vulnerable, and

it's easy to fall for their scheme when we would do anything to get our pet back home.

If you're contacted by someone claiming to have found your lost pet, always use caution. Look for these red flags:

- The person claims you need to pay a fine to get your pet back, using an online payment service or gift cards.
- The scammer says they need to send you a Google verification code.
- The scammer refuses to send you a photo of your pet.

Here's what to do next:

- Call a friend and get their perspective. It's hard to think clearly when you're upset.
- Call the scammer's number back. If they don't answer, or it's a wrong number, it's a scam.
- Report the scam call to the local police department. They can't recover your pet, but they can alert others in your community.

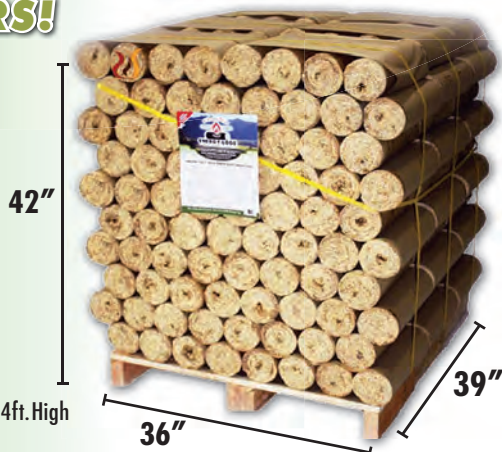

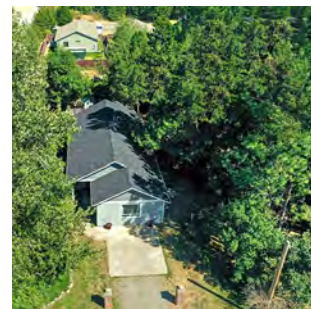

Make a Simple French Chocolate Mousse in a Blender

French-born Nicole Winters enjoys telling the story of serving her favorite chocolate dessert from her childhood at a gathering of over 20 friends and family. When her 3-year-old grandson, Jacob, stepped up to the dessert table after the meal, a woman offered him a small bowl and asked, "Would you like some chocolate pudding?" "It's not pudding; it's mousse au chocolat!" He confidently exclaimed with a perfect French accent.

"I was so surprised," said Nicole. "He had just been in the kitchen cooking with me the day before when I taught him how to say those French words. Cooking together is an enjoyable way for me to pass on family food traditions from my background and culture to my children and grandchildren, which I believe is so important," she added.

Since her easy blender version of rich "mousse au chocolat" (chocolate mousse) doesn't use raw eggs like the traditional French recipe, and it comes together effortlessly in just 10 minutes, it captured my attention as a potential dessert for the upcoming holiday menus.

I gave it a whirl in our blender, poured it into small dessert bowls and let it chill in the refrigerator overnight. Topped with fresh raspberries or a dollop of whipped cream, it's a keeper.

EASY BLENDER CHOCOLATE MOUSSE DESSERT

Makes 6 servings

- 1 cup mini semisweet chocolate chips
- 2 tablespoons sugar
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 3/4 cup whole milk
- Cream cheese (3 ounces), cut into several pieces
- Fresh raspberries or whipped cream for topping

Place chocolate chips, sugar and vanilla in your blender. Heat milk in a saucepan to an almost scalding temperature. (It should be steaming.) Immediately pour it into the blender over the chocolate chips, sugar and vanilla. Cover and blend for 30 seconds.

Add cream cheese pieces and blend until smooth. Pour into six small dessert dishes or a dessert bowl. Refrigerate at least two hours, until set.

To serve, top each dish or serving dish with a few raspberries or a dollop of whipped cream. A little sprig of fresh mint is a nice added touch for special occasions.

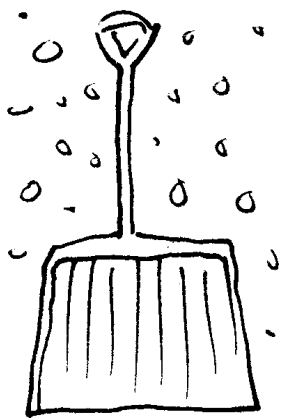

Cat and Dog Can Coexist

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: I periodically dog-sit for a neighbor, keeping her small Beagle, Downy, at my house while she travels. The problem is my cat, Sparks. He is absolutely infuriated when I bring Downy home, even though Downy doesn't bark at him. Sparks will yowl and glare at the dog every time they're in the same room. And now, Sparks is peeing on the rug next to my bed the entire time that Downy visits. What can I do about this? – Cheryl J., Reno, Nevada

DEAR CHERYL: Ouch! Cats are notoriously territorial, not just with dogs but with other cats, too. And Sparks does not seem to be settling in to the notion that Downy is an OK guest to have.

It's clear that you'll have to keep the two of them

separate when Downy is visiting. But by leaving a mess on your bedroom rug, Sparks is signaling that separation may not be enough. The situation is really stressing him out. He's drawing the line by marking your rug, a clear statement: This is my territory!

The quickest way to resolve the issue, of course, is to stop dog-sitting for your friend -- or dog-sit by periodically visiting her home throughout the day to spend time with Downy and make sure he has food and water.

But if that's not possible, and you intend to keep Downy at your house instead, you've got only a few options.

- Keep a clear separation between Downy and the cat. Place their food bowls in separate rooms with the door closed between them.
- Change out the rug in your bedroom for a new one, and spray it with cat pheromone (available at pet stores) to try to stop Sparks from peeing on it.
- Consider giving Sparks an anti-anxiety medication (available from the veterinarian) to reduce his stress.

Best of luck. Be patient with both pets; they may never be comfortable around each other, but you may be able to keep them both from being too anxious.

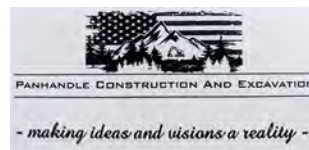

If you've spent much time fishing on Lake Pend Oreille, then maybe you've been lucky enough to catch a big rainbow trout. If not, you've likely seen pictures of the truly impressive fish that reside there.

In recent years, Lake Pend Oreille has been producing more rainbow trout over 20 pounds than anywhere else on Earth! This world-class trophy fishery is firing on all cylinders right now, and Idaho Fish and Game is working hard to keep it that way.

To effectively manage this trophy fishery, Fish and Game monitors the rainbow trout population and angler fishing success; however, it's hard to get all the information needed through traditional fish survey methods.

Anglers, this is where you come in – Fish and Game needs your help and is inviting fisherman to participate in an Angler Science program to help gather information that will help Fish and Game manage the trophy rainbow trout fishery.

The Lake Pend Oreille Angler Science Program is comprised of anglers who help Fish and Game collect monitoring data for fish in LPO, mainly through completing logbooks and reporting tagged fish.

To-date, we have learned some important information from the angler science program. For example, catch rates were higher in 2022 than in 2021, and rainbow trout over 30 inches continue to make up greater than 15% of the catch.

Moments in time

THE HISTORY CHANNEL

- **On Nov. 6, 1869**, Rutgers beat Princeton, then known as the College of New Jersey, 6-4 in the first college football game. Played with a soccer ball before roughly 100 fans in New Brunswick, New Jersey, it more resembled rugby than today's version of football.
- **On Nov. 7, 2016**, American lawyer and public official Janet Reno, who was the first female attorney general of the United States from 1993-2001, died at age 78 from complications related to Parkinson's disease.
- **On Nov. 8, 1994**, Salvatore "Sonny" Bono was elected to the U.S. House of Representatives. Best known as the pop-singer husband of Cher, after their divorce he left the music world behind to launch several successful restaurants, until frustration with bureaucratic hurdles around one of his construction projects in Palm Springs, California, sparked his foray into politics.
- **On Nov. 9, 1971**, John List murdered his family in their Westfield, New Jersey, home before disappearing. Though police quickly identified the Sunday School teacher and Boy Scout troop leader as the most likely suspect in the case, it would take another 18 years for them to locate him and bring him to justice.
- **On Nov. 10, 1808**, the Osage tribe agreed to abandon their lands in Missouri and Arkansas in exchange for a reservation in Oklahoma. The decision eventually made them the richest surviving Native American nation in North America after they amassed enormous wealth in the 20th century from oil and gas deposits.
- **On Nov. 11, 1942**, Congress approved lowering the draft age to 18 and raising the upper limit to age 37, though initially Black citizens were passed over because of racist assumptions about their abilities and the viability of a mixed-race military. As World War II progressed, however, they were included and finally allowed to serve in combat.
- **On Nov. 12, 1799**, American astronomer Andrew Ellicott observed the Leonids meteor shower from a ship off the Florida Keys. In the first recorded instance of such an event in North America, he wrote that the "whole heaven appeared as if illuminated with sky rockets, and I was in constant expectation of some of them falling on the vessel. They continued until put out by the light of the sun after day break."

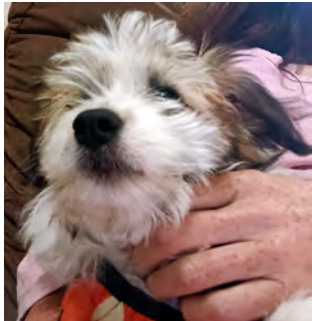

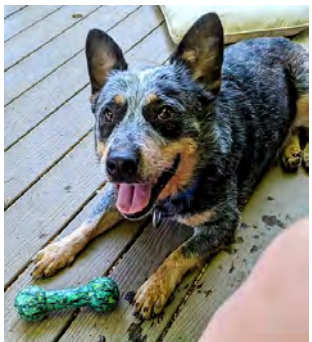

Be A Good Witness: How Citizens Play A Vital Role In Solving Wildlife Crime

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game —



Simply put, one of the best ways to assist is to be a good witness.

Every year, Idaho Fish and Game conservation officers rely on citizen reports to identify and investigate wildlife violations throughout the state. Without dedicated sportsmen and women doing the right thing — making the call and reporting — many wildlife violations would go undetected, undocumented and unsolved.

Concerned citizens often ask how they can help or assist our officers. Simply put, one of the best ways to assist is to be a good witness.

Being a good witness not only helps our officers, but it ultimately increases the likelihood that the violator abusing Idaho's wildlife resources is held accountable.

Here are three simple steps to help you be a good witness if and when you see a wildlife violation.

1. Document as much as you can

As the old saying goes, a picture is worth a thousand words. The same holds true for documenting wildlife violations when you see them.

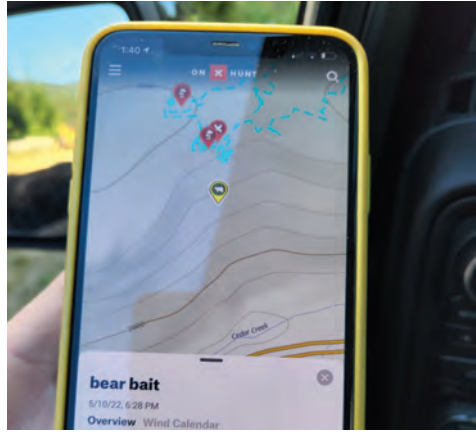
These days it's rare for someone to venture into the woods without a cell phone capable of taking pictures and videos. Getting a photo or video of the violation or violator, without disturbing the scene, is incredibly helpful for our officers.

Documenting the location of the crime with a GPS point or a dropped pin from your phone is also

incredibly helpful. It's also helpful to write down a few notes of what you observed so that details aren't forgotten when relaying information to an officer.

In short, the more detailed information you're able to document and provide, the higher the likelihood that our officers will be able to crack the case and hold the violator accountable.

2. Focus on the suspect

Conservation officers often receive reports of wildlife crimes but have little to no information about the offender. Identifying a suspect is often a challenge, so documenting and providing identifying information on possible suspects is crucial to cracking the case.

Vehicle information often proves vital to identifying suspects. License plates are golden, but so too are descriptions and photos of vehicles. Physical descriptions of suspects are also very helpful, particularly focusing on unique characteristics like tattoos, hair color and style and facial hair.

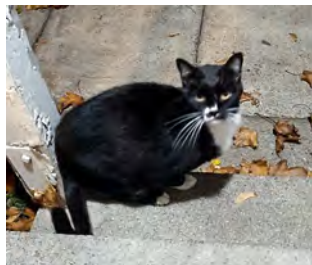
3. Don't delay in reporting

Conservation officers usually respond to calls after a wildlife crime has already been committed - playing catch up from the start. Time is of the essence when officers are responding and investigating. As time goes on, suspects get away, evidence disappears, trails go cold and cases go unsolved.

The sooner you're able to report the violation you observed or know about, the more likely officers will be able to make the case and hold the violator accountable. The Citizens Against Poaching hotline is staffed and available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, for this exact reason — so please don't delay in making the call!

Brush Up On Idaho's Trespassing Laws Before You Go Hunting Or Fishing

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game —



Hunters, anglers and other sportsmen and women should be aware of Idaho trespass laws before they head into the field. Trespass laws changed in 2018, and even though that feels like forever ago, it's still worthy of a reminder. Here are some basic things to remember:

- You need permission to be on private land.
 - It's the responsibility of the hunter/angler to know if they're on private land.
 - The laws affecting how landowners must post their property changed in recent years.
 - Fines have been stiffened for trespass violations.
- "Trespass laws changed in 2018, but the core philosophies have not," said Chief Greg Wooten, Idaho Fish and Game's Enforcement Bureau. "It's still the sportsman's responsibility to know when they're on private property and obtain permission to be there."*

Hunters, anglers, trappers and other people should know that land is private, and they are not allowed without permission if:

- The property is associated with a residence or business;
- Or cultivated;
- Or fenced or enclosed in a way that delineates the private property;
- Or unfenced and uncultivated but is posted with conspicuous "no trespassing" signs or bright orange/fluorescent paint at all property corners and boundaries where the property intersects navigable streams, roads, gates and rights-of-way entering the land and posted in a way that people can see the postings.

Note: If private property adjoins or is contained within public lands, the fence line adjacent to public land should be posted with "no trespassing signs" or bright orange or fluorescent paint at the corners of the fence adjoining public land and at all navigable streams, roads, gates and rights-of-way entering the private land from public land and posted in a way that people can see the postings.

People can use a variety of tools to determine whether they're on public or private lands, including maps, GPS, software (some of which also shows private land ownership), smart phone apps and more.

Hunters and anglers seeking permission to be on private lands should get written permission from the landowner. A permission form is available on page 2 of the 2023 Big Game Season and Rules booklet and at Fish and Game offices.

Other methods of permission are still legal, but written "is the most solid permission you can have," Wooten said.

Sportsmen and women should also beware of penalties for trespassing. Hunters and anglers have long faced a mandatory one-year revocation of hunting and fishing privileges if they are convicted of trespassing while engaging those activities. There are also steep fines for repeat offenders, and for a person convicted of trespassing three times within a 10-year period, there's a minimum \$5,000 fine, one to five year license suspension and they could be charged with a felony.

Roundup Mule Deer Management Hunt Scheduled To Begin Late November

— Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks —



Licenses go on sale November 1 at 5am.

BILLINGS – Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks and the City of Roundup have scheduled an archery-only mule deer hunt in and around Roundup to reduce the number of urban deer. Fifty either-sex mule deer licenses for this hunt will go on sale Wednesday, Nov. 1, beginning at 5 a.m. online and at any FWP license provider and will be limited to two per person. The licenses are available for residents and non-residents. A current Conservation License and Bow & Arrow License is required for purchase.

High mule deer numbers in and around Roundup have resulted in unacceptable property damage and concerns for human safety. FWP, in conjunction with the Roundup City Council, Mayor, and the Musselshell County Commissioners, developed the City of Roundup Deer Management Plan in 2014 to address the urban deer population. Public hunting with archery equipment in and around the town is the primary method outlined in this management plan to meet the goal of reducing the urban mule deer population. In 2022, 90 either-sex mule deer licenses were sold and 10 deer, six bucks and four

does, were harvested. Success rates for the hunt have ranged from 8% to 18% since the management hunts began in 2014.

Roundup city officials and the Musselshell County Sheriff's Department have observed fewer aggressive deer and vehicle-deer collisions since the special hunts began. This is the tenth annual Roundup Mule Deer Management Hunt.

Important details for the Roundup Mule Deer Management Hunt:

- The Roundup Mule Deer Management Hunt will run from Nov. 27 to Feb. 15, 2024.
- Hunters must obtain permission to hunt from the Roundup City Offices at 406-323-2804. Offices are open Monday to Friday, 8am–5pm and are located at 34 3rd Ave. West.
- Licenses for this hunt are \$10 each for residents and \$75 each for non-residents.
- The City of Roundup may assign hunters to specific hunting sites.
- Hunting will take place on designated property owned by the City of Roundup and Musselshell County, as outlined in the map.
- Hunters must bag and properly dispose of deer viscera at the Roundup Landfill.
- Hunters must report their harvest to the Roundup City Offices at 406-323-2804.
- Only archery equipment is allowed for this hunt, as defined in the 2023 regulations.
- These Roundup Management B licenses do not count towards an individual hunter's limit of deer B licenses they may have in one year.

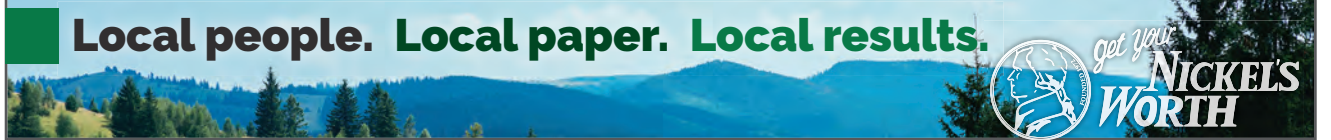
