City of Coeur d'Alene LEAF-FEST Begins November 13th

MONDAY, NOVEMBER 13th, 2023 marks the start of the City of Coeur d'Alene's annual leaf pick-up program. Please be sure to **KEEP** leaves on your property until **Wednesday, November 1st**. After Wednesday the 1st, please rake your leaves and pine needles about one foot away from the gutter/curb line to allow for water drainage. City crews and equipment are limited, so we need your help. Leaves will be picked up only once. Please do not put leaves in the street after city crews have completed your area and **do not** include bagged leaves, branches, debris or trash.

Pick-up will start south of Sherman Avenue and move north. We expect completion before December 1st. Follow our progress on maps.cdaid.org/leaf

LEAF-FEST
DO'S &
DON'TS

DO:

- KEEP leaves and needles on property until **Wednesday, November 1st**.
- Please move cars off the street if at all possible during leaf pick-up.
- Keep the leaves about one foot away from the curb line to allow drainage.
- Be alert for leaf pick-up equipment traveling through your neighborhood.
- Keep a safe distance away from leaf pick-up heavy equipment.
- Recognize that we have a tough job to do in a very short window between when the leaves fall and when the snow flies.
- City and private trucks are exempted from covering loads during the leaf pick-up period. Sweepers will follow city trucks to collect remaining/excess leaves.

DO NOT:

- Place bagged leaves in the street.
- Mix branches, debris or other trash in with the leaves.
- Miss the deadline...We only have time for one pass.

No branches,
grass clippings
or garden debris.

Sportsmen Can Enjoy Vast Amounts Of Cleared Trails On Snow Peak Wildlife Management Area In North Idaho

Idaho Fish and Game in partnership with Idaho Panhandle National Forests successfully cleared 39 of the 50 miles of trails on Snow Peak WMA

During summer 2023 and in partnership with Idaho Panhandle National Forests and Montana Conservation Corp., Idaho Fish and Game successfully cleared 39 of the 50 miles of trails on the 32,000-acre Snow Peak Wildlife Management Area. The work was made possible by a grant from the Recreational Trails Program through Idaho Parks and Recreation.

Crews cleared logs from 39 miles of trails and brushed 22 miles of the cleared trails. Horse packing crews from the U.S. Forest Service helped with getting gear and tools into areas of the WMA that hadn't had trail work done in more than a decade.

As a result of the work:

- 67% of all trails on the WMA are currently cleared.
- It is now possible to hike or horseback ride several loops on the WMA including from Sawtooth Saddle down Buck Creek Trail #100 and up either Canyon Creek Trail #99 or Papoose Mountain Trail #101.
- Other trails cleared include Snow Peak Trail #55 to the Snow Peak Lookout, Surveyor's Trail #40 to the Little North Fork of the Clearwater River and Surveyor's Ridge Trail #141.

Sportsmen and outdoor recreationists can now enjoy better access to the wild areas that make Snow Peak WMA so special. This time of year fall colors are breathtaking, and folks might even find a huckleberry to snack on.

Fish and Game manages six WMAs across the Panhandle and an additional 25 across the rest of the state. Fish and Game WMAs are managed for both wildlife habitat and sportsmen access and opportunity. To learn more, visit the WMA webpage on the Fish and Game website at idfg.idaho.gov/visit/wma.

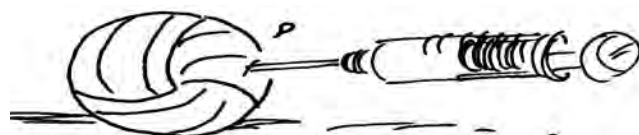

National Sundae Day November 11th

— National Day Calendar —



On November 11th, National Sundae Day brings a celebration to ice cream lovers across the country. Enjoy one of every flavor and bring a friend!

An ice cream sundae typically consists of one or two scoops of ice cream topped with syrup or sauce. The sundae is often topped with whipped cream, maraschino cherry, sprinkles, pineapple or a variety of other toppings.

Sundae History

While the oldest known record of an ice cream sundae is an Ithaca, NY advertisement, the originator of the dessert is still debated. The October 5, 1892 ad in the Ithaca Daily Journal spelled the ice cream treat with the conventional day of the week spelling – Sunday.

However, Two Rivers, Wisconsin claims Druggist Edward Berners served the first ice cream sundae in 1881. According to the story, customer George Hallauer ordered an ice cream soda on a Sunday. Ordinances at the time prohibited the sale of ice cream sodas on the Sabbath. Even so, Berners came up with a compromise. He served the ice cream in a dish minus the soda.

Additionally, he topped it with chocolate syrup. Given the day, he called it a Sundae. One interesting catch – Berners was 18 at the time the story takes place.

Ithaca's claim to the ice cream sundae takes place at Platt & Colt Pharmacy in 1892 where Reverend John M. Scott stops to order a bowl of ice cream. When Chester Platt, proprietor, began preparing the ice cream for his customer, he didn't stop at just a couple of scoops of vanilla. Platt drizzled cherry syrup over the ice cream and topped them with a bright red, candied cherry. The dessert looked and tasted so delightful it required its own name. Since the day was Sunday, it was named for the day it was created. Ithaca also has historical evidence supporting the story, including an advertisement for a Cherry Sundae.

Behaving Well Around Service Animals

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: Can you kindly remind your readers that service animals and companion animals are not there for other people's amusement? Too often, people who see a service dog in public will rush up and try to pet the dog or even hug them. Please educate them on the proper etiquette when they see a service pet. -- Janine D. in Syracuse, New York

DEAR JANINE: Thank you for this timely reminder. Service animals are highly trained to provide assistance to their owners for specific health or mobility issues. Companion animals provide crucial emotional support to owners as well.

With any pet, it's not just good manners to ask before approaching or trying to touch them. It's also a safe way to interact with pets and their owners.

This is especially important with service and companion animals. They're doing a job when out in public. For example, seizure alert dogs are trained to detect an approaching seizure and will gently warn their owners to get to a safe place. Mobility assistance dogs help owners maintain their balance, or with tasks like pressing buttons and opening doors.

It isn't always evident that they're working, either. For example, you may see an autism support dog sitting or lying next to their owner. They're not off duty; they're helping their person stay calmer in a social setting.

Some good behaviors around service animals include:

- Speak to the owner/handler, not to the animal.
- Don't touch, talk to, feed or handle the service animal.
- Guide/service dogs have the right of way.

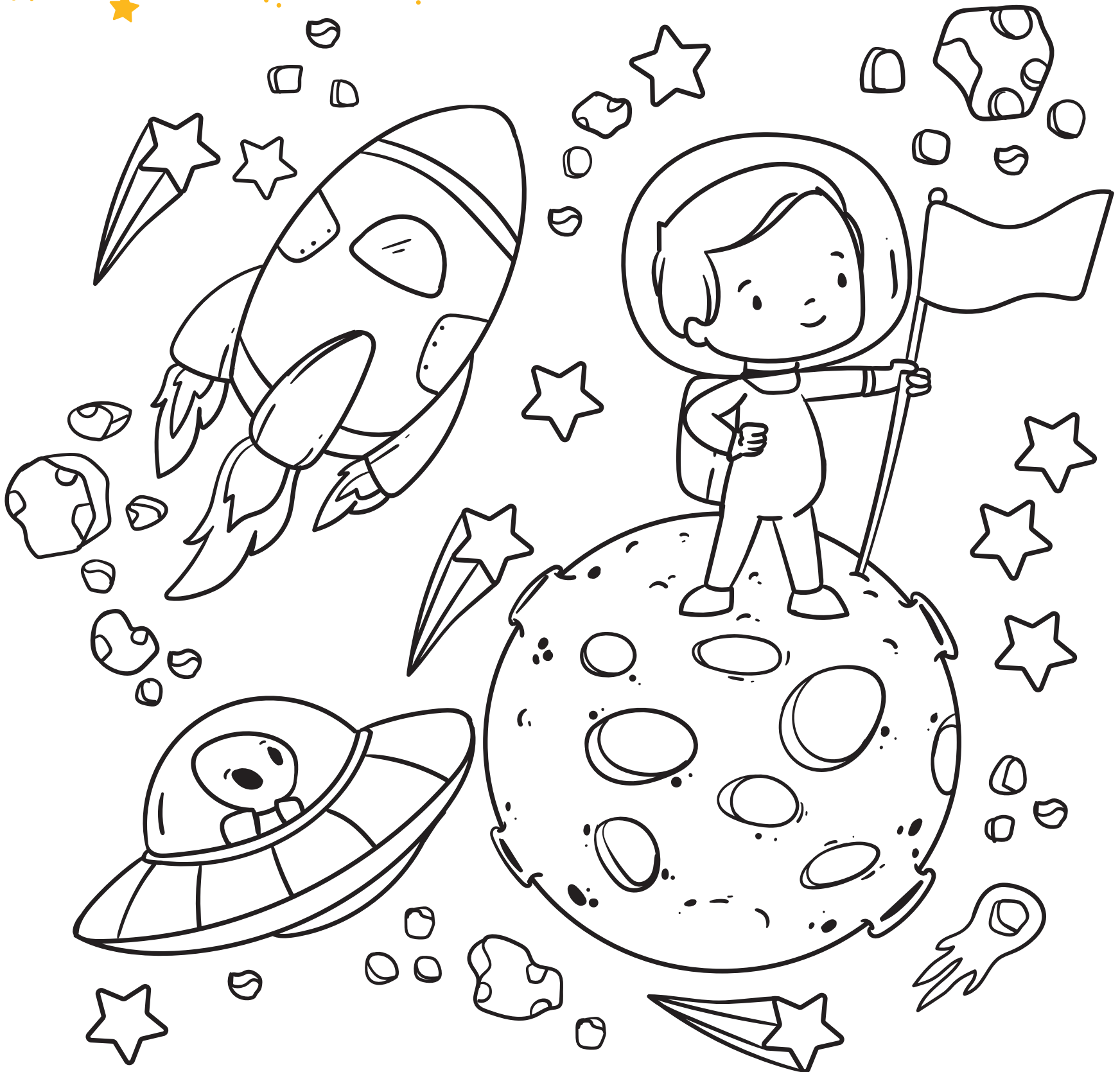
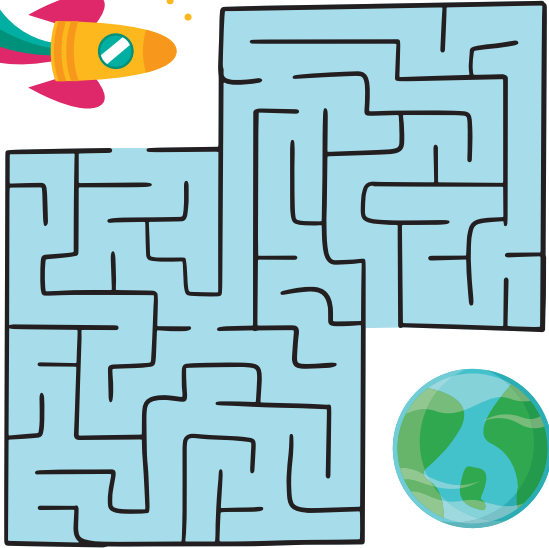

Hyaluronic Acid Can Improve Joint Pain, but Isn't Recommended

DEAR DR. ROACH: A friend recommended hyaluronic acid for joint pain in my wrist and hand. I have been taking 180 mg once a day for a couple months now and have experienced notable success. I also feel that my neck pain and range of motion in my neck have improved. My question is, what exactly is hyaluronic acid? Is it safe, and are there any side effects I should be aware of? -- T.E.

ANSWER: Hyaluronic acid is a naturally occurring substance composed of long strings of sugar. Because of this structure, it carries a great deal of water, so it acts as a shock absorber and lubricant for several places in the body, including the joints. Hyaluronic supplements are usually purified from chicken cartilage, but can also be produced by bacterial fermentation. The body makes about 5,000 mg of hyaluronic acid daily.

Multiple studies on injections of hyaluronic acid have shown that it is only slightly better than a placebo at treating arthritis, especially of the knee. I have stopped recommending injection treatments to my patients with knee arthritis, as they are quite expensive. Oral hyaluronic acid, however, is inexpensive. There have been several small studies showing benefit (again, mostly for the knee rather than the neck), but I couldn't find any well-done large studies that were convincing.

There is very little harm from hyaluronic acid. TITLE: None of the studies I've read found any serious side effects; however, that doesn't mean it is completely safe, since supplements aren't regulated the way prescription medicines are. But I can conclude that oral hyaluronic acid is possibly effective and probably safe for treatment of osteoarthritis.

The studies have mostly used doses in the 100-200 mg range, but I have seen supplements for sale that have 20 mg or less of hyaluronic acid. I'm glad you are taking a similar dosage to what is shown to be effective.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I have had muscle twitches in virtually every part of my body for about 50 years now. These fasciculations usually occur somewhere on my body every day. My legs and arms are the most common areas. There is no discomfort, and they rarely last more than a minute or two. Why do these occur, and should they be of any concern? I am an active, healthy 58-year-old male who isn't on any medication. -- D.I.

ANSWER: Muscle fasciculations are common. Most people get them from time to time, sometimes in the small muscles like the eyelid and sometimes in the large muscles like your legs and arms. Fasciculation can be a sign of a serious neurological problem, such as a lower motor neuron disease. If the muscle doesn't receive proper neurological signals, it increases its receptors so that the muscle can be easily stimulated, causing twitching.

If you had suddenly developed this, especially with weakness or atrophy of your muscles, that would be very worrisome, and you should see a neurologist right away. However, since it has been going on so long, it is very unlikely to be a serious disease.

You probably have benign fasciculation syndrome, which, as its name suggests, is not a worrisome condition and usually does not worsen over time.

Veterans Day

November 11th

— National Day Calendar —



Veterans Day on November 11th honors military veterans who served in the United States Armed Forces. The federal holiday coincides with Armistice Day and Remembrance Day, which marks World War I. These observances reflect the end of significant hostilities at the 11th hour on the 11th day of the 11th month of 1918 when the Armistice with Germany took effect. Initially, the United States observed Armistice Day as well. However, it evolved into the current Veterans Day in 1954.

Veterans Day is not to be confused with Memorial Day or Armed Forces Day. Veterans Day celebrates all United States military veterans. However, Memorial Day is set aside for remembering the men and women who died while serving. Additionally, Armed Forces Day recognizes the men and women currently serving in the United States military.

How To Observe #VeteransDay

Since Veterans Day is a federally designated holiday, many businesses and schools close for the day. Additionally, employers may recognize their veteran employees through special events. Throughout the day, local, state, and federal organizations host Veterans Day ceremonies.

Non-essential federal government offices close on this holiday, including all United States Post Offices. As a result, postal workers make no deliveries. Additionally, all federal workers receive holiday pay on Veterans Day. However, those who are required to work sometimes receive holiday pay in addition to their wages.

Attend a ceremony and take a veteran you know out for a meal. Organize a veteran appreciation luncheon at your work or in your community.

The United States Marine Corps customarily observes its birthday (November 10, 1775) and Veterans Day as a 96-hour liberty period.

Veterans Day Spelling

It is grammatically acceptable to write or print the holiday as Veteran's Day or Veterans' Day. However, the United States government declared

the observance using the attributive (no apostrophe) rather than the possessive case in the official spelling.

Thank a veteran and use #VeteransDay to post on social media.

Veterans Day History

U.S. President Woodrow Wilson first proclaimed Armistice Day on November 11, 1919. At the time, he said, "To us in America, the reflections of Armistice Day will be filled with solemn pride in the heroism of those who died in the country's service and with gratitude for the victory, both because of the thing from which it has freed us and because of the opportunity it has given America to show her sympathy with peace and justice in the councils of the nations."

The United States Congress passed a concurrent resolution on June 4, 1926. The resolution requested that President Calvin Coolidge issue another proclamation to observe November 11th with appropriate ceremonies. A Congressional Act (52 Stat. 351; 5 U.S. Code, Sec. 87a) approved May 13, 1938, made the 11th of November in each year a legal holiday: "a day to be dedicated to the cause of world peace and to be thereafter celebrated and known as 'Armistice Day.'"

Raymond Weeks

In 1945, World War II veteran Raymond Weeks from Birmingham, Alabama, expressed an idea. Weeks proposed to expand Armistice Day to celebrate all veterans who served in the U.S. military. Weeks led a delegation to Gen. Dwight Eisenhower, who supported the idea of National Veterans Day. Then in 1947, Weeks led the first national celebration in Alabama. Annually, the country recognized its veterans until he died in 1985. President Reagan honored him at the White House in 1982. Weeks earned the Presidential Citizenship Medal as the driving force for the national holiday. Elizabeth Dole prepared the briefing for President Reagan, calling Weeks the "Father of Veterans Day."

1954

U.S. Representative Ed Rees from Emporia, Kansas, presented a bill establishing the holiday through Congress. President Dwight D. Eisenhower, also from Kansas, signed the bill into law on May 26, 1954.

Congress amended this act on June 1, 1954, replacing "Armistice" with "Veterans," and it has been known as Veterans Day since.

1971

Initially, the country observed Veterans Day on November 11th. However, starting in 1971, the Uniform Monday Holiday Act required the federal holiday to be moved. Congress scheduled the observance for the fourth Monday of October. In 1978, Congress moved it back to its original celebration on November 11th. While the legal holiday remains on November 11th, if that date happens to be on a Saturday or Sunday, then organizations that formally observe the holiday will generally be closed on the adjacent Friday or Monday, respectively.

Late Fall And Winter Can Be Productive For Stream Fishing

Part 1 of 2

Dress for the weather and catch some trout and whitefish

People may see anglers wading streams during frigid weather and wonder “what are they doing?” The short answer is, probably catching fish.

Late fall and winter are often overlooked on Idaho's rivers and streams for the simple reason many people don't want to deal with the cold, but trout and whitefish remain fairly active during cold temperatures, and there's no reason you can't catch them.

In fact, late-season fishing has its advantage. Many streams are at their lowest levels of the year, which concentrates fish in smaller areas. Most rivers and streams are also nearly empty of anglers, so you get your pick of prime fishing spots.

Find the right river or stream

Spring-fed rivers and streams, and those fed by dam releases often fish well during winter months because temperatures tend to be slightly warmer and more stable.

Late fall and winter are often overlooked on Idaho's rivers and streams for the simple reason many people don't want to deal with the cold, but trout and whitefish remain fairly active during cold temperatures, and there's no reason you can't catch them.

In fact, late-season fishing has its advantage. Many streams are at their lowest levels of the year, which concentrates fish in smaller areas. Most rivers and streams are also nearly empty of anglers, so you get your pick of prime fishing spots.

Find the right river or stream

Spring-fed rivers and streams, and those fed by dam releases often fish well during winter months because temperatures tend to be slightly warmer and more stable.

Rainbow trout are a favorite winter quarry, and where you find them, you will often find whitefish,

which are also fun to catch. (Read more about catching whitefish.)

You will find trout and whitefish in similar places you find them other times of year, but in late season, they often favor deeper, slower water, although you can still catch them in riffles as well.

Also remember that while fish remain active during winter, they're still a cold-blooded animal, and they may be a little sluggish. They're unlikely to chase food, but they will take it, or a good imitation of it, when it's placed in front of them.

Whitefish school up in the fall and typically spawn in November, so where you catch one, you're likely to find more.

Tweak your techniques

Winter fishing doesn't really require any special tactics, just remember the basics of stream fishing, such as figuring out where the fish are and what they're likely to be feeding on, and adjust for the conditions.

Drifting bait or fly fishing with nymphs are often your best tactics.If you see dimples on the water, it may be fish feeding to eat insects, which will like be tiny midges or mayflies, and trout will also rise to the surface to take a dry fly.

Try different sections of the river and try to figure out where fish are holding and feeding. After you catch a fish, seek out similar water, but remember, fish may move around during the day. But where you find them one day during winter, they're likely to remain nearby, so keep those places in mind when you return.



Fly anglers should not overlook streamers. They can look like a big, easy meal when presented slowly, but don't expect trout to vigorously chase them like during summer. Even dead drifting a streamer can be effective.

Repeatedly cover likely looking water before moving on. You may be surprised that you can catch multiple fish in a fairly small area, so cast and drift (or slowly retrieve) your bait or fly numerous times before moving to the next spot.

Late Fall And Winter Can Be Productive For Stream Fishing

Part 2 of 2

Here are some places to check out around the state. See Fish and Game's Fishing Planner at idfg.idaho.gov/ifwis/fishingplanner to learn more about each location.

- *Boise River:* Don't overlook this river during late season because low winter flows actually make it more accessible and wader-friendly than during summer. It has healthy populations of rainbow trout, whitefish and brown trout. But don't expect gullible fish because they experience a lot of fishing pressure.
- *South Fork of the Boise River:* This popular stretch below Anderson Ranch Dam doesn't get any less popular during winter. Water coming out of the reservoir provides stable conditions and thousands of trout per mile make it a destination for late season anglers. Trout and whitefish tend to be above-average in size.
- *Big Wood River:* This river has long been popular during winter for catch-and-release trout fishing. It rarely freezes, and if you fish it on the right day, you can catch trout on dry flies. Bring your midge and baetis patterns.
- *Malad River:* This spring-fed stream is a fun winter fishing spot because it's easily accessible from the Hagerman area and has lots of trout. Bring your light tackle because they tend to run small, but they're plentiful and feisty.
- *Lower Lochsa, and Selway rivers:* All provide good opportunities to catch whitefish during winter, and also have catch-and-release trout fishing.
- *St. Joe River:* This river provides winter fishing opportunities for cutthroat trout and whitefish.
- *North Fork of the Coeur d'Alene River:* Lower section also has fishing for whitefish and cutthroat trout


- and is accessible during winter.
- *Snake River below American Falls:* This section of the Snake has produced some excellent trophy trout fishing in recent years, and there are plenty of others. The relatively mild climate and dam release keeps this fishing accessible and productive during winter.
 - *Snake River (Tilden to Shelley):* This section is slated to get nearly 40,000 rainbow trout stocked in November. Several thousand fish will be released near Tilden, Blackfoot, Firth and Shelley.
 - *Portneuf River:* Upper section is your best bet, and Fish and Game provides several access areas so you can get to the river.
 - *South Fork of the Snake River:* This has year-round trout fishing and there's no limit on rainbow trout. There's also lots of opportunity to catch whitefish during winter.
- Here are late-season fishing tips:
- **Sleep in:** There's rarely a need to be there at first light. You will usually have better fishing late morning to early afternoon when the water warms a few degrees.
 - **Stay close to home:** Winter is a good time to explore your local trout fisheries, or rediscover them.
 - **Plan short trips:** There's no getting around the effects of cold weather, and eventually it will take its toll. Plan to fish for an hour or two and call it good. If you can last longer, consider it a bonus.
 - **Bring hand warmers:** Your hands are most likely to get wet, and they can easily get chilled. A hand warmer will quickly rewarm them. An extra pair of gloves is also a good idea because one pair usually gets wet.
 - **Think about traction:** Rocks are slippery when wet, and more slippery when icy. Wading boots with cleats are a good option. It's also good to have a set of dry clothes in your vehicle in case you take an unexpected plunge.
 - **Keep your feet warm:** Probably goes without saying, but you may be wading in water that's barely above freezing, so wear thick socks or two pairs. If your feet get cold, you will be uncomfortable.
 - **See it as adventure:** Things will look and feel different, but the trip will be rewarding if you appreciate those differences. Catching a few fish never hurts, either.
 - **Check the regulations:** Some rivers and streams have different rules for winter, such as catch-and-release fishing only, restrictions on bait, or they may be closed to fishing. See details in the 2022-2024 fishing seasons and rules brochure at idfg.idaho.gov/sites/default/files/seasons-rules-fish-2022-2024.pdf.

Walleye Aren't Bad Fish, Just The Wrong Fish For Idaho

Like a romcom movie, the relationship between walleye and Idaho is complicated. Some anglers enjoy them as a tasty fish, but walleye tend to upset the balance of existing fish populations, so it won't be an entertaining story if walleye populations expand across the state.

Idaho and walleye just aren't a good match in most places, and here's why. Walleye are native to large Midwestern lakes that tend to have large and prolific forage bases of minnows, shiners, chubs and other small baitfish. Those baitfish are not available in most Idaho waters, so walleye are likely to eat other game fish that are highly valued by Idaho anglers. Eventually, those other fish species could be gone, or greatly diminished, and the end result could be a bunch of unhealthy, unsustainable walleye populations.

Not exactly a happy movie ending, and unfortunately, the prequels have already played out in far too many waters in surrounding states.

That's why Idaho Fish and Game is extremely selective where it provides walleye fishing, which is currently limited to three locations: Salmon Falls Creek Reservoir, Onieda Reservoir, and Oakley Reservoir.

Fish and Game asks anglers to kill all walleye they catch outside of those waters, and to report any of

those fish to a regional Fish and Game office.

Walleye are being discovered by Fish and Game biologists in waters where they aren't wanted and were likely illegally released. Most recently in Lake Lowell near Caldwell, but sporadically in other Idaho waters as well. Some are also naturally migrating into places where they could harm resident and ocean-going fish populations, such as in lower Snake River near Lewiston.

Fish and Game has an ongoing project in Lake Pend Oreille in North Idaho to keep established walleye populations from growing and consuming kokanee that provide a popular fishing opportunity, as well as feeding trophy trout populations in Idaho's largest lake.

Not a bad fish, just the wrong fish for Idaho

Some anglers have accused Fish and Game biologists of being biased against walleye, which isn't true. Biologists have spent decades surveying anglers for their preferences, and biologists have done their best to provide diverse fishing opportunities that are geared toward angler preferences, which includes walleye fishing.

However, in most Idaho waters, biologists aren't managing a single species, they're managing multiple species that must be somewhat compatible with each other. Any given water can only support so many fish, and while it's common for game fish to feed on each other, there's an opportunity to maintain a reasonable balance between species.

Biologists take all those factors into consideration before introducing a fish species into any water. Unfortunately, in the case of Lake Lowell, someone decided to illegally release walleye that are showing signs of successfully reproducing.

"When a highly predatory species is introduced to a water outside that established process, as walleye were in Lake Lowell, we are forced to dedicate a lot of resources towards assessing the impact on the existing fishery, and unfortunately, most of our anglers are robbed of the opportunity to weigh in on the matter," Fish and Game's Southwest Region Fisheries Manager Art Butts said.

Walleye are a valued fish with a checkered history

Walleye are among the favorite fish species in the some parts of the country, particularly the upper Midwest and Great Lakes area where the fish flourish and anglers love to catch and eat them.

But numerous cases in the Northwest and Rocky Mountain states have shown a fairly predictable trend after walleye populations are established in waters that didn't previously have them. At best, the available fish species shift and another fishing opportunity is added. But more often, a limited walleye fishing opportunity displaces established and valued fish populations of other species.

Case in point is Canyon Ferry Reservoir in west-central Montana. The reservoir had a thriving perch population, as well as a healthy trout population. In the 1990s, anglers started catching walleye, which were previously unknown in the reservoir.

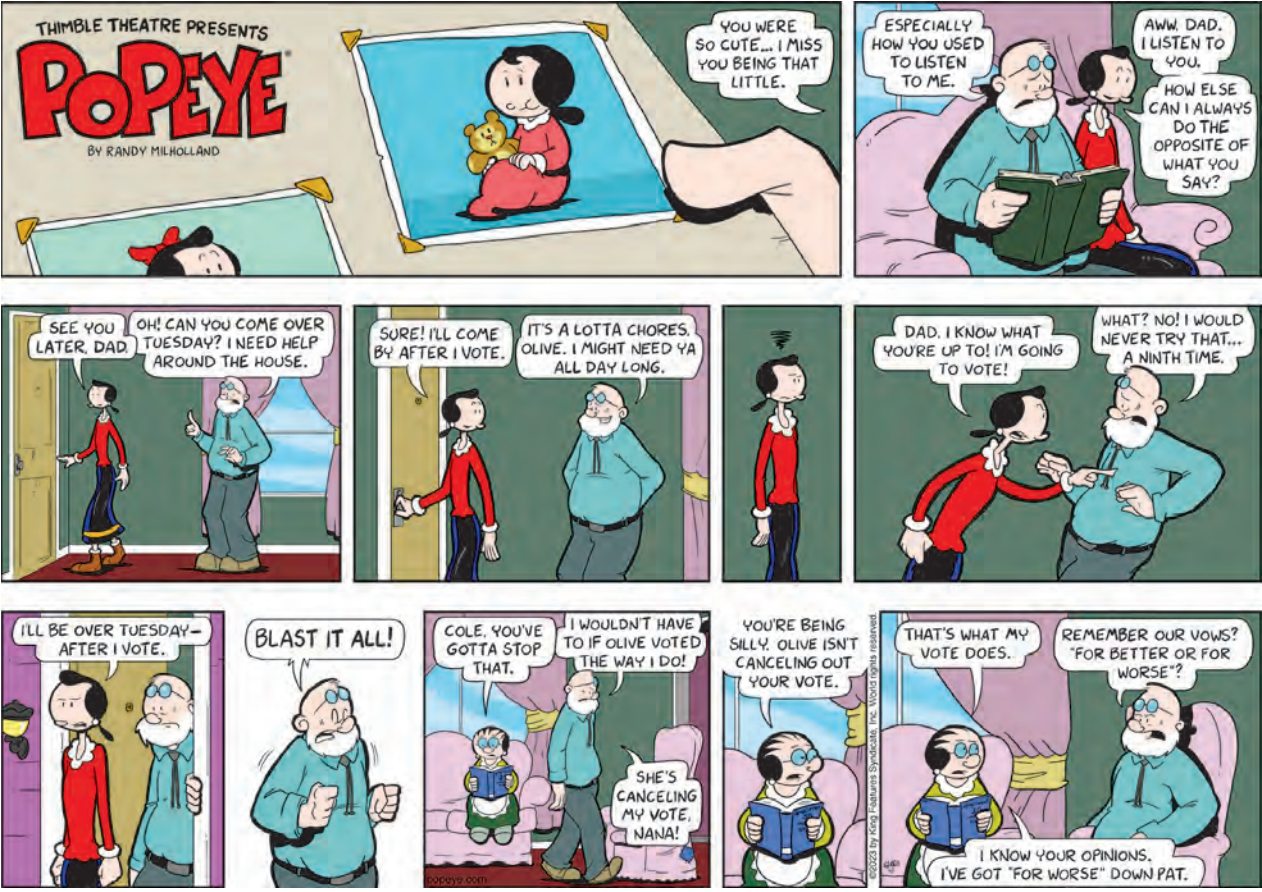

Walleye Aren't Bad Fish, Just The Wrong Fish For Idaho

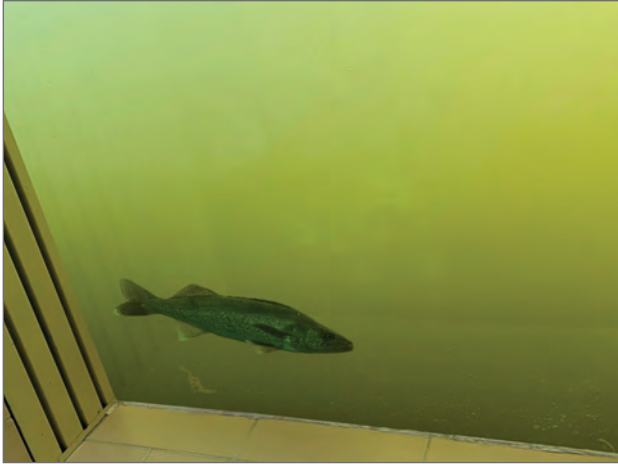
Walleye populations quickly grew and by 2000, their average size had grown to the point they were effective predators of perch and trout. By 2004, nearly all the perch were gone, and trout populations had also plummeted. Montana shored up the trout population by planting catchable fish rather than fingerlings, but overall, trout angling efforts were roughly halved.

Anglers turned to walleye, which offset some of the loss of angling effort, but perch populations never recovered, and interest in trout fishing declined. Walleye fishing continues at Canyon Ferry Reservoir, but largely for small to medium-sized fish because they've consumed most of the available forage.

Moses Lake in Washington is another case where walleye have dramatically changed a fishery. In the early 1980s, the lake's crappie population crashed, and when Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife biologists surveyed the lake, they discovered a walleye population.

According to WDFW fisheries biologists Marc Peterson, the walleye population there "expanded before we knew what was going on."

In the decades since, he's seen walleye shift the lake's entire fish population from crappie, bluegill and largemouth bass to mostly walleye and smallmouth bass as the predominate species. He added that other fish species still exist, and their populations can fluctuate from year to year, but "you can change the complexion of a lake's entire fish composition with walleye."

Idaho's salmon and steelhead runs could take a hit

Walleye have long existed in the Columbia River, and now they are migrating upstream into the Snake River, and monitoring at Lower Granite Dam downstream from Lewiston is showing more walleye moving upstream.

"Salmon and steelhead did not evolve with these nonnative predators and can be especially vulnerable to predation," Fish and Game anadromous fish biologist Marika Dobos said. "Walleye only add to the many difficulties that salmon and steelhead face, and as walleye expand their range and abundance in large rivers, more hungry mouths will be

eating salmon, steelhead and other native species. This is especially important for wild juvenile salmon and steelhead that often overwinter and rear in large rivers in Idaho before making their journey to the ocean."

Protecting Lake Pend Oreille

Fish and Game biologists are working to keep walleye at low density in Lake Pend Oreille by using commercial netting and angling. A commercial fishing company nets walleye for several weeks each spring, and biologists implant transmitters in walleye to track their location and share that information with anglers to improve their catch rates. Anglers can get money by turning in walleye heads they harvest, and this helps increase fishing effort for walleye. This program has been largely successful so far, but will likely need to continue indefinitely to balance the lake's predator and prey populations and sustain one of the most popular recreational fisheries in Idaho.

Too risky to take a chance

Biologists understand that each body of water reacts a little differently to a new species. Many of Idaho's large lakes and reservoirs see one species thrive, then decline, then come back on a cyclical basis because shifting environmental conditions often favor one species over another.

But considering the basic needs of walleye, which is a large, prolific forage base, the odds are in their favor when competing with other game fish.

Idahoans have repeatedly told Fish and Game biologists their preference, which is overwhelmingly healthy trout populations, followed by bass, panfish, salmon and steelhead, catfish, etc. Other anglers are simply interested in any fish they can catch, and a minority of anglers have asked for more walleye opportunities.

Biologists know choices have to be made because while many waters can support a variety of fish, including species that compete with each other, but adding a predatory fish like walleye typically means they will come at the expense of, and possibly the eradication, of other fish that Idaho anglers prefer.

Walleye and illegal transplants will cost all anglers

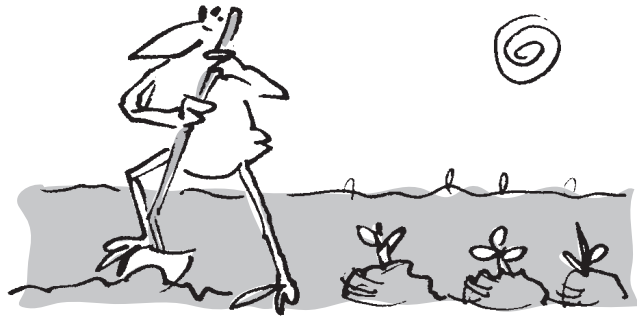
Regardless of how walleye get into Idaho, biologists have to deal with them, which will take them away from other projects. Because walleye could potentially (and likely) negatively effect on other fish populations, biologists will have to spend more time and effort surveying those waters and using different management strategies to minimize their impact.

For example, biologists may have to shift from stocking inexpensive fingerlings to more expensive catchables so the small trout don't get consumed by walleye. That could easily cost tens of thousands of angler dollars annually.

One simple solution

People simply should never move live fish from one body of water to another, and they should report anyone who does. It's not only illegal, it can be very harmful and risky to other wildlife and habitat.

Currently, Fish and Game has been able to manage walleye where they occur, but they can only do so much, so keeping walleye out of other waters will benefit Idaho's valued fisheries.

Moments in time

THE HISTORY CHANNEL

- On Nov. 20, 1998, the first module of the International Space Station, Zarya (“Dawn”), was launched. Russian-built and American-owned, its name signified the concept of a new era of international space cooperation.
- On Nov. 21, 1931, the horror film “Frankenstein” was released, starring Boris Karloff as the monster created from corpses. Based on Mary Shelley’s 1818 novel “Frankenstein; or, The Modern Prometheus,” it was a commercial success and is still widely considered one of the greatest movies of all time.
- On Nov. 22, 1718, the infamous pirate Blackbeard was killed off the coast of North Carolina by British naval lieutenant Robert Maynard, who’d been dispatched by Virginia’s Lieutenant Governor Alexander Spotswood to track him down. As a warning to others who might be pondering a career in piracy, Spotswood had the buccaneer’s head mounted on a pike at the mouth of the Hampton River.
- On Nov. 23, 1976, 49-year-old Frenchman Jacques Mayol, sometimes known as “Dolphin Man,” became the first person to dive 100 meters into the sea without the use of breathing equipment. Seven years later, he broke his record with a dive of 105 meters.
- On Nov. 24, 2012, a fire in the Tazreen Fashion clothing factory in Dhaka, Bangladesh, killed over 110 people and injured another 200. The tragedy shed light on poor working conditions for employees who made export clothing in the country and led to major labor reforms in Bangladesh and the fashion world, which promised to take steps to ethically source its products.
- On Nov. 25, 1834, Delmonico’s, one of New York’s finest restaurants, offered its customers a meal of soup, steak, coffee and half a pie for 12 cents. Even as we sigh for the “good old days,” however, we should remember that this meal would also cost an unskilled laborer about an hour’s wage.
- On Nov. 26, 1865, “Alice’s Adventures in Wonderland” by Lewis Carroll (born Charles Lutwidge Dodgson), a mathematics don at Oxford University, was published in the U.S. The beloved children’s classic, which has never gone out of print, has been translated into 174 languages and adapted for the cinema, art, ballet, opera, musicals, theme parks, board games and video games.
