Quick breads allow a special treat to share and enjoy with coffee or tea. Other homemade breads, such as donuts, pretzels, muffins, and biscuits, add variety to our everyday meals. #### **Bread FAQ**

Q. Can I use brewer's yeast to make bread?

A. You could, but the bread won't be as light and fluffy as you're accustomed to. Baker's yeast produces more CO2 than brewer's yeast making it more ideal for bread making.

Q. Is yeast a living organism?

A. Yes. And under the right conditions, it reproduces rapidly. That's why certain yeasts are ideal for baking and brewing.

### International Check Your Wipers Day History



As of 2022, due to seasonality, MICHELIN® officially requested May 16th become National Check Your Wipers Day (Día Nacional de Revisar Tus Limpiaparabrisas) for countries in Latin America. 

### Supper Is on With a Wild Rice **Chicken Casserole**

Here's our tasty, family-friendly version of a "Minnesota Hotdish." If the term "hotdish" is new to you, think "casserole" because it's really the same thing -- a baked main-dish combo of vegetables, meat. and rice or potatoes, all mixed together with a cream sauce or canned soup.

This satisfying recipe melds tradition and taste in every bite with the nutty flavor of wild rice and the crunch of the water chestnuts. While our family hasn't entered this favorite in one of our Minnesota "hotdish competitions," I can assure you that it's still a winner with family and friends.

When you have Thanksgiving leftovers in your refrigerator, you can substitute the chicken for turkey, and a generous dollop of cranberry relish or sauce on the side makes a colorful, tasty accompaniment.

For scheduling convenience, the prep work can be done ahead, if you wish. Assemble the recipe with your kids in a casserole baking dish, cover and then refrigerate overnight. It will be ready to pop in the oven the next day for dinner. While it bakes, slice up hearty crusty bread, then toss salad greens with fresh orange slices and a vinaigrette. Now you're all set for a delicious, warm-you-up, cozy fall meal.

### WILD RICE CHICKEN CASSEROLE Serves 6-8

- 1 (10-1/2-ounce) can cream of chicken soup
- 1 (10-1/2-ounce) can cream of mushroom soup
- 3/4 cup mayonnaise
- 1 1/2 cups cooked wild rice
- 1 1/2 cups cooked long grain white rice

- 4 cups cut-up cooked chicken
- 1 cup diced celery
- 1 cup diced red pepper (substitute: green bell pepper)
- 3/4 cup chopped green onions
- 1 (8-ounce) can water chestnuts, drained and loosely chopped
- 1/3 cup slivered almonds, lightly toasted
- Chopped fresh parsley (optional)

Preheat oven to 350 F. In a large bowl, combine soups and mayonnaise. Stir in cooked wild and white rice, chicken, celery, red pepper, green onions, and water chestnuts.

Transfer into a 9-by-13-inch baking dish. Bake, uncovered, for 50-55 minutes until bubbly.

Remove from oven and sprinkle toasted almonds and fresh parsley on top. Serve piping hot.



### **SHOPPING TIP:**

In many grocery stores, there are 6-ounce boxes of combined long grain and wild rice that can yield 3 cups of cooked rice for this recipe.





### Ladderback Chair

Furniture made in America during its early days sometimes used expensive imported material like mahogany with hardware from Europe. But local woods, like pine, oak, walnut and cedar, iron and even paint were available and inexpensive. The use of a local wood helps identify furniture made in New Mexico, Louisiana and parts of Pennsylvania.

An early 19th-century ladderback chair from Louisiana was sold at a recent Neal auction. It was made of cypress wood, which is rot-resistant, hard and durable, has few knots, a light golden color, and, best of all, found near the furniture maker. The chair could also be dated from the shape of the stiles, rungs and its corn husk seat. Modern copies of this type of chair to be used outdoors are made of cypress because it lasts longer than other woods.

The ladderback chair sold in the auction is 32 inches high and a comfortable 17 inches deep. It sold for \$427. Cypress furniture is still being used but mainly for outdoor and garden furniture.

If your stroller or carriage is very decorative, a buyer might use it to hold magazines or plants. If it's in great condition and an unusual shape, it could sell for \$200 to \$300.







### F&G's Stocked Access Sites Provide Golden Opportunity For Idaho Pheasant Hunters

– Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game -



Fish and Game will stock 30,000 pheasants across the 24 permitted areas, including 14 WMAs, in 2023

The 2023 fall pheasant season is in full swing as upland hunters take to nearly two dozen Wildlife Management Areas (WMAs) and other private and federal property sites across the state.

The ring-necked pheasant (Phasianus colchicus for you bird nerds out there) is among the most colorful game bird species found in Idaho, and WMAs are a popular place to hunt them. Pheasants are often found in lowland fields and brushy roadsides, and sport an uncanny copper-and-gold plumage with a bright red and green head.

Fish and Game will be stocking nearly 30,000 of these birds across the 24 permitted areas, including 14 WMAs.

"Pheasants are among the most popular game bird species for upland game hunters in the state," said Jeff Knetter, Upland Game and Migratory Game Bird Coordinator. "Hunters and supporters of pheasant hunting asked us to expand the pheasant stocking program to include additional properties."

In recent years, Fish and Game has doubled the traditional number of pheasant stocking sites across the Gem State

So what does this mean for hunters? For residents and nonresidents alike, fall in Idaho is arguably the high point of the hunting season. The trees are vibrant, the air is crisp and pure and many game species are available for hunters to have a truly interactive experience with nature.

Because pheasants often inhabit private lands, gaining access to these prized birds can be a challenge, so Fish and Game provides its WMAs for an easily accessible place to go pheasant hunting. Fish and Game also partners with private landowners and federal agencies to provide additional access to pheasant hunting and stocks birds at these locations. WMAs and other stocking sites offer hunters a golden opportunity to access pheasant-rich hunting

properties up and down the state with no shortage of fall scenery.

### Know the rules where pheasants are stocked

All pheasant stocking areas fall under the same rules as Wildlife Management Areas where pheasants have been stocked in the past, which include:

- Each Upland Game Bird Permit allows the take of six pheasants, and multiple permits may be purchased.
- The two pheasant daily bag limit, and six pheasant possession limit apply.
- When a pheasant is reduced to possession, the hunter must immediately validate the permit by entering the harvest date and location in non-erasable ink and remove a notch from the permit for each pheasant taken.
- Shooting hours are from 10 a.m. to one half hour after sunset, during the pheasant season, with the exception of the Clearwater Region, where shooting time is 8 a.m. and online sign-up is required.
- All upland game bird hunters are required to wear at least 36 squares inches of visible hunter orange above the waist during pheasant season (a hunter orange hat meets this requirement). This includes all upland game bird hunters on Upland Game Bird Permit Release Areas, not just those pursuing pheasants. This is not a requirement for upland game hunters who are hunting other sites
- The permit is not required to hunt any other upland game bird species in Idaho, including in Upland Game Bird Permit Release Areas.
- The Upland Game Bird Permit is not required for pheasant hunting outside of Upland Game Bird Permit Release Areas.



Pheasant hunting rules, including shooting hours and bag limits, are different for hunting outside of areas where pheasants are stocked. Those rules can also be found in the Idaho Upland Game, Turkey and Furbearer seasons and rules brochure (find it at idfg.idaho.gov/rules/upland), and are largely unchanged from previous years.

An estimated 432,000 diarrheal deaths occur each year because of inadequate sanitation. About 670 million people around the world are forced to practice open defecation. The lack of toilets and a sanitation system makes some cities unlivable. This includes Dhaka, the

capital of Bangladesh. The city contains very few public restrooms. Most of them don't work or are unusable. On this awareness day, many toilet-making companies try to come up with solutions for cities like Dhaka to solve their sanitation problems. A Swedish company called Separett is working on a waterless toilet solution to help people all over the world. Thanks to awareness spread by World Toilet Day, villages like Majhi in Nepal, no longer have to resort to open defecation in fields and ponds around their home.

The UN encouraged Member States to implement policies to increase access to sanitation for the poor. The resolution also called for an end to open defecation. Do you remember your grandmother or your mother snipping the buttons off shirts headed for the rag basket? Those buttons are often collected in jars or tins. Maybe you even played games or strung them for ornaments and crafts. The buttons were fun to stack into piles, sort by color or size, or scatter and slide across the floor or table making up different games each time.

Crafters across the country utilize buttons in creative ways, too. They are some of the best at finding new uses for old items. There are thousands of button collectors in the United States.

### **Button FAQ**

Q. How big is the largest button collection?

A. In 2001, Guinness World Records certified Dalton Stevens' collection in South Carolina as the world's largest button collection in the world. His collection of 439,900 buttons contains no duplicates. He was also known as The Button King. His collection is housed in a museum in Bishopville, South Carolina. Another button collection can be found at the Waterbury Button Museum in Waterbury, CT.

Q. Do vintage buttons have any value?

A. Surprisingly, some antique buttons demand a hefty price tag before being shuffled off to the rag bin. Rare and significantly aged (more than 100 years) buttons have a market. If your grandmother left you her button jar, look for buttons made from just about anything but plastic to get started. Correction, we should say modern plastic. Early plastics like celluloid or Bakelite are both highly collectible. Other materials to look for include:

# **Know The Rules For Motorized Travel In Some Big Game Hunting Units**

- Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game -



It's on the hunter to know and understand the motorized hunting rule when hunting big game in certain game management units.

With increasing use of motorized vehicles such as side-by-sides and ATVs by big game hunters, everyone, especially those using motorized vehicles, need to be aware of the motorized hunting rule. The rule applies when someone is actively hunting big game using a motorized vehicle. The rule is in effect from Aug. 30 through Dec. 31 of each year, and applies only to hunting of big game animals, including moose, bighorn sheep and mountain goat.

Between these dates and in the designated game management units, big game hunters may use motorized vehicles only on established roadways open to motorized traffic and capable of being traveled by full-sized automobiles. Hunters using a motorized vehicle may not go cross-country, meaning off road when hunting big game.

The rule is specific to 30 hunting units, primarily in central and southern Idaho.. For more information about specific hunt units see page 106 in the Big Game regulation booklet.

The motorized hunting rule does not apply when hunting upland game birds or upland game animals

### What is an established roadway?

The definition of an established roadway as it relates to this rule is that the road is established, built, maintained, approved or designated by a government entity. And, the road is capable of being traveled by a full-sized vehicle.

## Can hunters use a motorized vehicle on Forest Service or BLM designated trails?

If motorized travel is allowed by the Forest Service or BLM, you may use a motorized vehicle on trails to retrieve downed game or pack in/out your camping gear as long as you follow the restrictions in place by the land owner. However, you may not hunt while packing camping gear.

### When in doubt, stay on the road!

It is the responsibility of the hunter to know and understand the rules and regulations of the area where they hunt. For vehicle travel, it's especially important to know and follow the vehicle use restrictions for the area you are hunting. ### **Make Apple Pecan Granola** a Seasonal Specialty

As waves of autumn color highlight neighborhoods, parks and hillsides, I find my tastes shifting with the season. Although my taste buds aren't necessarily craving a popular pumpkin spice latte at local coffee shops, I'm eager to prepare traditional harvest foods, like roasted acorn squash soup or a loaf of pumpkin bread.

Wherever the spirit and tastes of fall take your family as you reboot for the season -- whether it's an apple orchard, pumpkin patch or nature center -- check out this granola recipe when you get back home. Packed with dried apples, pecans, pumpkin seeds, cinnamon and lots of healthy oats, it captures the tastes and crisp feel of the season.

Prepare it with your kids and store in a big, clear jar with a scoop inside for easy access on school days. Combined with milk and yogurt, it makes a convenient and healthy breakfast staple to keep life easy during the morning rush out the door.

Make shopping for healthy ingredients part of the cooking adventure with your kids. Discover how you can economize by purchasing most of the ingredients in bulk.

### **APPLE PECAN GRANOLA** Makes about 7 cups

- 4 cups rolled oats (not quick cooking)
- 1 cup coarsely chopped pecans
- 1 cup hulled, raw pumpkin seeds
- 1 cup hulled, raw sunflower seeds
- 1/3 cup brown sugar

- 1 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/3 cup olive or melted coconut oil
- 1/4 cup pure maple syrup
- · 2 egg whites, slightly beaten
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 cup dried apples, chopped into bite-size pieces

Preheat the oven to 350 F. Line a large rimmed baking sheet with parchment paper or spray with nonstick spray.

Combine the oats, pecans, pumpkin seeds, sunflower seeds, brown sugar, cinnamon and salt in a large mixing bowl.

Stir together the oil, syrup, egg whites and vanilla in a small bowl. Add to dry ingredients and toss well until fully coated.

Spread the mixture evenly on the baking sheet. Bake, stirring every 10 minutes until lightly golden and toasted -- about 25-30 minutes. Stir in the apples during the last 10 minutes.

Cool completely before serving. Store in an airtight container for up to a week.

Cook's Note: Substitute brown sugar with honey or agave syrup and combine with liquid ingredients before tossing with dry ingredients.

### Careful...That May Not Be The Trophy Bull You Think It Is

Taking a shot on that suspiciously still bull might seem tempting, but it could also be a very costly

You pull the binoculars up to your eyes and, lo and behold, that blurry brown object just off the side of the road appears to be an elk. And not just any elk — a massive six-point bull. Or so it seems.

Taking a shot on that suspiciously still bull might seem tempting, but it could also be a very costly mistake that causes you to lose your money and your hunting license.

Idaho Fish and Game conservation officers deploy "artificial simulated animals" during hunting season to catch law-breaking hunters. Commonly called ASAs, they are lifelike copies of deer, elk and other game species that look and act like the real thing.

"Officers watch the animal and respond if someone violates the law," said Greg Wooten, Fish and Game Chief of Enforcement. "This tool is extremely important in our effort to curtail illegal activity that is otherwise undetectable."

Simulated animals are used to address complaints of spotlighting, trespassing and road hunting.

"This is similar to other law enforcement agencies watching an intersection based on reports of frequent instances of failing to stop at a stop sign, or monitoring speed compliance using radar," Wooten said.

Anyone found guilty of shooting an artificial animal may lose his or her license, face a fine up to \$1,000 and possible six months in jail. Shooters will pay a \$50 restitution penalty to help maintain

Violations that accompany this activity include shooting from a road, trespassing, shooting from a motorized vehicle and more. These unlawful activities generate the highest numbers of complaints from other hunters and non-hunting citizens. Due to the unique circumstances required to detect these violations using routine patrols, most states and Canadian provinces started using ASAs in the late 1980s.





### **Hunters And Trappers Should Expect Low Water Levels This Year On Portions Of Boundary-Smith Creek** WMA In North Idaho

Wetland cell 3 on Boundary-Smith Creek WMA will have no water during the 2023-24 hunting and trapping seasons

Hunter and trappers planning this year to visit the Boundary-Smith Creek Wildlife Management Area, located north of Bonners Ferry, should know that the northernmost large wetland along Westside Road, known as wetland cell 3, will not have water in it during the 2023-24 hunting and trapping seasons. Water that would have been used in cell 3 will be diverted into the wetlands in the northwest corner of the WMA, known as wetland cells 1 and 2.

Water levels on Boundary-Smith Creek WMA are managed by a series of water control structures, which allows Idaho Fish and Game to raise and lower water levels as needed for waterfowl habitat. wetland health and to provide hunting and trapping opportunities.

The water control infrastructure on the WMA has been aging over the past 20 years, and it is beginning to fail. Folks who have visited the WMA over the past few years have likely noticed the lower-than-normal water levels in wetland cell 3, due almost exclusively to leaky water control structures.

Fish and Game has been working with the USDA Natural Resource and Conservation Service to replace the failing structures; last winter, four water control structures were replaced. Fully functioning water control structures throughout the WMA will result in better habitat for waterfowl and furbearers,

while providing better opportunities for sportsmen and women.


During summer 2023, Idaho Fish and Game began preparing cell 3 for water control structure replacement to take place during winter 2023-24. With the drawdown, Fish and Game staff have worked to improve habitat in the wetland cell by removing cattails, aerating the soil and seeding desirable waterfowl food plants. Water levels in cell 3 will remain drawn down until the structures are replaced.

During summers 2021-22 Fish and Game staff conducted vegetation and moist soils work in cells 1 and 2 by conducting cattail removal/thinning and soil aeration. These areas have since been reflooded and have shown an excellent response with a variety of beneficial plants that waterfowl need to grow and prepare for migration.

Remember to show up early to scout for your hunt as the areas cells 1 and 2 occupy are large and there are plenty of places to set up if you don't mind walking a bit. The outlook for the early season hunt looks good and should be productive for waterfowl hunters. As always, please be aware that Grizzly bears are common on the WMA.

### Simplify Your Duck Hunting Game This Year With This Back-To-Basics Guide

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game —



Duck hunting doesn't have to be complicated, and with a little effort, you can successfully find and hunt them.

Waterfowl hunting has a reputation for being expensive, but hunters don't need to shell out (pardon the pun) tons of money on a boat or a truckload of waterfowl gear to be successful. That's especially true in a state with as much public land as Idaho.

Jump shooting is a low-cost option for public land hunts, but it is not the only one. The classic method of hunting over decoys is a good option for public land waterfowl hunters. The excitement that comes with watching ducks work a decoy spread (circling them to see if it is safe to land), the interactive component of calling, and the close shooting provide an experience that many waterfowl hunters live for.

Public land hunters may have to work a little harder to set themselves up for success when hunting over decoys, including dedicating time for scouting, and being willing to put in extra effort to get away from most of the hunting pressure. But for those who are willing to make the commitment, there are many walk-in public hunting spots scattered throughout the state that can produce good waterfowl hunting – and it doesn't take hundreds of decoys. Idaho waterfowlers can put together a successful hunt with nothing more than what they carry in on their backs.

That includes:

- Shotgun
- Idaho hunting license
- Migratory bird (HIP) permit
- Nontoxic shotgun shells
- Federal migratory bird stamp
- Six to 24 decoys
- Waders
- Camouflage clothing
- Duck call(s)

By finding and setting decoys in a place where ducks already want to be, hunters can eliminate the need for a large decoy spread that might be needed to attract birds from far away.

With a smartphone or a computer, you have everything you need to start looking for a potential waterfowl spot. The first step is finding water, and when walking in with decoys, it pays to think small. Using Fish and Game's Hunt Planner or some sort of GPS mapping tool, hunters should scour smaller rivers and streams for public access points, and search for

potentially overlooked pockets of water — creeks, sloughs, ponds, etc. — on all different kinds public property, including those that are more traditionally associated with upland game hunting.

Don't ignore traditional waterfowl spots including larger rivers, reservoirs, wildlife refuges and Fish and Game's Wildlife Management Areas and habitat areas. For these, try to identify spots where there is likely to be less hunting pressure, such as areas inaccessible by boat or off the beaten path.

Once you've compiled a list of potential locations, it's time to get out and see what it looks like from ground level, and more important, whether the ducks like it.

Observe your potential spots frequently to see if ducks are using them, both before and throughout the season. While not necessary, a decent pair of binoculars makes spotting far-off ducks a lot easier.

After you confirm ducks are using a location, study it closely to pattern the birds and determine when they are arriving and departing. That might be at first light, but it could be also be mid-morning (which means a couple hours of extra sleep and warmer temperatures), or in the afternoon or early evening. In any case, you'll want to have your decoys out and be ready to hunt before they start pouring in. Putting in this work ahead of a hunt can minimize the amount of time you are staring at empty skies, and allow you to plan a more efficient and productive hunt.

Hunters shouldn't put all their effort into one location because it does not take much hunting pressure to discourage ducks from using it. This is especially true of smaller waters. Work to find and pattern ducks at several locations, avoid over-pressuring any single spot. Continue to scout various spots throughout the season, and above all else, be adaptable and mobile. For the best results, public land hunters need to be able to adjust their strategy based on where the birds are, and where other hunters are not.



### Develop your game plan(s)

Once you've tracked down some promising public areas, consider concealment (i.e. is there natural cover, or if you have to build or bring a blind) and be adaptable. Ducks will generally land into the wind, so you will want to set up with the wind at your back if possible. Identify a number of different places you can set up at each location depending on the wind direction.

Think about where you might want to position your decoys. Keep in mind that your decoys should be within effective shotgun range (somewhere around 40 yards). If you are hunting without a dog, you will also want to make sure that the water is shallow enough for you to safely wade, both to set out your decoys and to retrieve downed birds.

If it's a spot that you're likely to find other hunters, consider making a weekday trip if you can. On weekends or holidays, focus your efforts on your more secluded locations.

Another consideration is weather. Earlier in the season, small waters, such as ponds, sloughs and backwaters may be a good option, but may freeze as the temperatures begin dropping, and you will have to shift your focus elsewhere. This is where scouting for a variety of options pays dividends.

Idaho's varied geography means duck hunting opportunities are different depending where you're located, but most areas have places where a person can hunt waterfowl, and it doesn't require a huge commitment of money and gear to be successful.

### **Mysterious State Record Largemouth Vindicated On 75th Anniversary**

### New details and the legacy of the lady that landed it

Anyone that has looked over Idaho's list of State Record Fish has likely noticed the issue with the largemouth bass from Anderson Lake. The 10 lb 15 oz fish has appeared on the list with no length or girth measurements. The angler's name of "Mrs. W. M. Taylor" is a bit odd, and there isn't even a date of catch, making it look downright suspicious. Despite these oddities, the lunker bass with scant information has stood as the record for over 60 years... until now. Thanks to a team of big bass enthusiasts who uncovered the history of this record, we have new details about this controversial entry on Idaho's record fish list.

### Validation 75 years later

Last week, I was contacted by Ken Duke - a longtime outdoor writer and serious bass fishing enthusiast. Add "big bass historian" to that list of credentials too. Ken and his team at the The Big Bass Podcast took a deep dive into this incomplete record and found a truly interesting story. Check out the details in their podcast episode, "Mystery, Murder, and a State Record" at www.youtube.com/ watch?v=sJCIGWop-gc.

It turns out that the "Mrs. W. M. Taylor" was in fact her husband's name, a dentist in Spokane, Washington where the family lived. Listing the record using her married (husband's) name may have been the tradition for that era, but it made rectifying the records a bit more difficult.


After some sleuthing through newspaper records and archives, Ken discovered the angler's actual name was Mary Alice Hurt Taylor. According to the 1949 Field and Stream magazine contest records, Mary Taylor caught the huge largemouth on South Bend rod, using a Shakespeare reel, Ashaway line and a Pflueger "Pal-O-Mine" lure (a classic wooden crankbait with a metal bill and treble hooks). Mary would have been 63 years old when she caught the big bass on October 22, 1948. It weighed in at 10 lbs. 15 oz. and took second place in the "Northern Division" of the national contest. At that time, Field and Stream contests required documentation of the fish weighed on a certified scale along with witnesses, making this previously doubtful record very much

### Why the missing details?

I did some historical sleuthing of my own to understand why the details had been missing for so long. I began digging through old issues of Fish and Game's then magazine, the Idaho Wildlife Review. It turns out, the first official "Idaho Record Fish" list wasn't published until the 1959 September/October issue of the Idaho Wildlife Review. At that time, Fish and Game staff only knew of a handful of verifiable big fish. In that article, they describe how they were just starting the first official list. To help fill out the list, they requested anglers to send in proof of their biggest catch, and they would update the list accordingly.

When the list first came out in 1959, the biggest Largemouth bass was listed at 9 lbs. 15 oz caught by S. Simenson from Payette Slough in 1949. However, word of the new Idaho state record list must have been spreading. By the January/February issue of 1962, the list first shows Mrs. M. W. Taylor with 10 lbs. 15 oz from Anderson Lake, where it has stood ever since.

At that time, documentation was likely hard to come by for a fish that had been caught 13 years prior. The 1962 article mentions that, "This fish had been caught sometime between 1941 and 1951... obtained from records of the Field and Stream fishing contest." It's hard to say why the date of the catch and other details weren't available. Regardless, Idaho Fish and Game has kept the record on the books despite the scarcity of information.



Idaho Fish and Game didn't start keeping an official list of 'state record' fish until 1959, over 10 years after this record bass was caught. This might help explain the lack of details in the original listing, which persisted until 2023.

### A trophy track record

Fishing may not have been popular recreation for women of her day, which makes Mary's story more interesting. Mary Taylor wasn't just a casual angler that happened to get lucky one fall day on Anderson Lake. In fact, she had a previous track record as a trophy bass angler. Only four years prior, she took 6th place in the 1944 Field & Stream contest with a 9 lbs. 11 oz largemouth bass caught on October 21 from the same lake! Anderson Lake - one of the chain lakes along Lake Coeur d'Alene - is only a few miles from Cave Lake, the home of the current catch-and-release state record Largemouth bass. Mary's previous documented trophy bass only adds more credibility to her long-standing Idaho record.

Thanks to Ken Duke, Nathan Benson, and Terry Battisti of The Big Bass Podcast for researching this story and providing the details that blew the dust of this state record and set it straight. I'm certain Mary Alice Hurt Taylor would be happy to see her own name finally on the list. On the 75th anniversary of Mary's record catch, we have updated the Certified Weight State Record Fish list to reflect all the details of Idaho's biggest bass. I just wish it hadn't taken so

These days, Idaho's list of record fish is updated quickly with news of a record catch. While the printed version appears in the annual seasons and rules booklet, the online list (at idfg.idaho.gov/fish/record) from the state record fish page is the most current list. Record applications and supporting evidence are closely verified to help keep the program as legitimate as possible. While some records have stood for decades, others are broken often, especially "catch-and-release" records, which has contributed to the program's popularity with anglers.


### Idaho's Steelhead Fishery Update: Oct. 25, 2023

Hi everybody. It has been almost two months since my last steelhead update, so I figured it was time to give you all another update. Plus, now that the steelhead return over Bonneville Dam is complete, I can say with confidence what the returns to different areas are like.

### Steelhead Returns to the Upper Salmon, Little Salmon, and Snake Rivers

To help portray how this year's return compares to past years, I have put together the figure below. This figure shows how many Idaho hatchery steelhead (based on PIT tags) have passed over Bonneville Dam this year (2023) that are bound for the upper Salmon, Little Salmon, and Snake rivers in comparison to the previous 13 years. The good news is the return of steelhead to these three combined areas (27,601) is the best we have seen since 2016. Just over 18,000 of these fish will be returning to the upper Salmon River basin, 5,000 to the Little Salmon River, and about 4,500 to the Snake River. Despite the improvement in this return, they are a long ways from what we observed prior to 2016.




Number of Snake and Salmon River steelhead over Bonneville Dam

One of the things we evaluate with these returns is how many of these steelhead are destined for traps where we can collect them for broodstock. If not enough fish are returning to these places to meet broodstock goals, then we will need to make our regulations more restrictive. I put together the figure below that compares how many fish have passed over Bonneville Dam (based on PIT tags) that are destined for traps in the Snake and Salmon rivers this year (2023) to previous years.

The blue portion of the bars show the number of steelhead that spent one year in the ocean and the yellow portion shows how many spent two or three years in the ocean. Those bars with text above them were the years when we applied more restrictive regulations to ensure that we would meet broodstock needs. Now that we have had more experience managing these fisheries with smaller returns, we recognize that we were probably overly restrictive during some of the years. Limit restrictions probably aren't necessary when over 12,000 fish destined for our traps pass over Bonneville Dam.

With over 21,000 of these steelhead passing over Bonneville Dam this year, we are not worried about collecting the broodstock we need. That means these fisheries will be able to continue with our normal regulations (3-fish daily limit). Steelhead over Bonneville Dam to Snake & Salmon traps


Right now (Oct. 25), steelhead are spread out from the Idaho/Washington border upstream to Hells Canyon Dam and the upper Salmon River. Fish passage over Lower Granite Dam is declining and

movement will likely slow to a trickle come late November. Catch rates have not been great (typically >15 hrs/fish) to date although they are gradually picking up. We observed the best catch rates of the year last week with catch rates at 10-14/hrs fish in the Snake, and 15-25 hrs/fish in the Salmon. I suspect this colder and wetter climate we are experiencing right now will result in better catch rates in the near future.

### Steelhead Returns to the Clearwater River Basin

Hatchery steelhead returning to the Clearwater River basin this year have been a pleasant surprise. We were forecasting that about 8,400 2-ocean steelhead would pass over Bonneville Dam this year, but instead, we observed closer to 16,000 of these fish (based on PIT tags). When you combine all ages of steelhead that have passed over Bonneville Dam this year, they total over 21,000 fish (see figure below).

In my previous steelhead update (8/30/2023), I indicated the models were projecting that we could see up to 35,000 steelhead pass over Bonneville Dam. You may recall that I was skeptical of this projection as all indications were this steelhead return was one of the earliest we had ever seen. It turns out this return is the earliest we have ever seen since we have started tracking returns using PIT tags (since 2010) and explains why this projection was on the high side. Regardless, the 21,000 steelhead returning this year is about average when compared to the previous 13 years and should provide some good fishing opportunities without the need to adjust seasons or limits.

One thing I want to point out in the figure above is that almost 5,000 1-ocean steelhead that are destined for the Clearwater River basin have passed over Bonneville Dam this year (see yellow portion of bar for 2023). That ties for the second most we have seen since 2010. Typically, when the 1-ocean return is good one year, the following year's 2-ocean's return will be good. That could mean good things for next year's Clearwater return.

Also, if you look at the figure above, you should notice that we have been seeing an up and down pattern with the number of fish that have returned from one year to the next since 2012. Next year we are scheduled for an up year! Additionally, since 2018, the succeeding "up year" has increased. If that trend continues, next year could be amazing. Here's to hoping!

Steelhead fishing in the Clearwater River has been variable this fall with the better catch rates occurring around Lewiston and Dworshak Hatchery. More of the fish destined for the South Fork Clearwater are starting to move into this fishery, and these fish tend to spread out more than the fish destined for Dworshak Hatchery. Hopefully this will result in more consistent fishing throughout the Clearwater River. As I mentioned in the Snake and Salmon section, this cooler and wetter weather should improve fishing throughout the Clearwater River basin.




