

Mule Deer Taken In Hunting Unit 32a Tests Positive For Chronic Wasting Disease

- Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game -

This the first CWD outside Unit 14 and the first of the fall 2023 hunting season

Idaho Fish and Game recently received test results confirming a positive case of chronic wasting disease in a mule deer buck harvested roughly 7 miles south of New Meadows in Game Management Unit 32A. This is the first known case of CWD outside of Unit 14 north of Riggins, where the disease was first detected in Idaho in the fall of 2021.

Fish and Game would like to get as many samples as possible from animals in Unit 32A and adjacent units to try and determine the extent of the disease in that area. Fish and Game is asking that all hunters participating in deer or elk hunts that are still open in Units 32A, 22, 23, 24, and 32 have their harvested animal tested for the disease. Hunters can take heads of harvested deer and elk to any regional Fish and Game office for sampling or get directions at idfg.idaho.gov/cwd on how to remove lymph nodes themselves and submit them for sampling.

This is the first positive case of CWD from the 2023 fall hunting season, but more samples are currently at the lab and those test results will arrive throughout November and December.

"This is an unfortunate situation, but it's why we test throughout the state for this disease," Fish and Game Director Jim Fredericks said. "If it's on the landscape, we want to know where, and we rely on hunters to provide samples so we can test for it and continue to manage to limit the spread of this disease."

Fish and Game is also asking people to report any road killed deer and elk in the Highway 95 corridor between Riggins and Weiser and any deer or elk that appear sick. People can call the Nampa regional office at (208) 465-8465, or the McCall regional office at (208) 634-8137 to report. People can also use the roadkill reporting webpage.

Chronic wasting disease is a contagious, fatal neurological disease that affects deer, elk and moose. There is no cure for CWD, no reliable live test for wild animals, and no vaccine for CWD. It is found in 31 states and four Canadian provinces, including all neighboring states east of Idaho. The disease affects the brain of infected animals, and symptoms include excessive salivation, drooping head/ears, tremors, extremely low body weight, and unusual behavior, such as showing no fear of humans and lack of coordination.

The disease detection in Unit 32A will likely be managed differently than the 2021 CWD detection in Unit 14 because most mule deer migrate out of Unit 32A in early November and disperse into lower-elevation winter ranges in the surrounding units.

"This situation is considerably different than Unit 14 for that reason," Fredericks said. "In the Slate Creek area north of Riggins, most animals remain nearby year-round, but migration patterns and winter ranges of deer where this particular animal was harvested are more complex. Most animals have already moved out of the northern part of unit 32A and will not return until spring."

The Fish and Game Commission has a regularly scheduled meeting Nov. 15-16 in Lewiston where they will hear an update on the situation.



National Espresso Day November 23rd

Get the pure coffee essence on National Espresso Day! Whether you sip one cup or keep buzzing all day long, November 23rd is the day.

The word espresso in Italian means 'quick in time.' Before the advent of the espresso machine, espresso was simply a coffee expressly made for the person ordering it. It was also made with recently roasted and freshly ground beans. The cup was brewed shortly before serving. In the late 1800s, this practice was commonplace in cafés and restaurants.

While today's espresso maintains the freshness quality, it has undergone a transition in meaning. We've come to know espresso as a highly concentrated brew served in smaller quantities. We may also use espresso as a base for other delicious coffee

We can thank the espresso machine for this modern view of espresso. In 1901, Italian Luigi Bezzera invented the first successful espresso machine. The newer technologies produced a smaller, more concentrated cup more quickly than traditional coffee brewing methods. Additionally, this thicker, more intense brew created a creamy foam on top called the crema. The richer flavors and aromas of an espresso create delicious lattes, mochas, cappuccinos, macchiatos, and many café creations.

Beyond the range of beverages, the intense flavor of espresso lends itself to baking. Where coffee may become lost when blended with other flavors, espresso remains vibrant. Blend it with cream cheese, sugar and flour for a cheesecake. Add it to ladyfingers and make tiramisu. Many desserts call for espressos such as ice cream and crème brûlée.

Espresso FAQ

- Q. How do you say "espresso"?
- A. The word "espresso" is pronounced like this: ess-press-oh.
- Q. Can I make espresso at home?

A. Yes. There are a few ways to make espresso at home, including using an espresso machine. If you do not have an espresso machine, you can use a French press. There are a few things to keep in mind when making espresso with a French press:

- 1. Pre-warm your press with hot water.
- 2. Coarsely grind your beans, about 2 tablespoons.
- 3. Use hot, not boiling water to your coffee grounds. Heat the water to just below 212F.
- Add a small amount of hot water to the grounds to allow them to bloom before adding about a full cup of water. You will see a few bubbles.
- 5. Allow the coffee to steep. Four minutes should be sufficient.
- 6. Be a patient plunger. Press it down slowly with equal pressure.

Make An Impact And Apply For The Citizens Shooting Range Advisory Committee By Dec. 1

Committee recommends grant awards for shooting ranges

Idaho Fish and Game is seeking members of the public who want to have an impact on shooting range decisions by volunteering to serve on a Citizens Shooting Range Advisory Committee, which will be responsible for providing annual input about public shooting range grant applications.

We are seeking to fill the representative position for the Panhandle Region.

Members of the public who actively use shooting ranges, have experience managing or volunteering at a range and are familiar with the elements for safe public shooting ranges in their community are encouraged to apply for the committee. Fish and Game's intent is that the committee will represent a wide range of shooting opportunities that includes hunters and recreational and competitive shooters.

"The program is an important process that keeps our public ranges accessible and safe for Idaho's

citizenry to learn and practice their shooting skills," Fish and Game Communications Bureau Chief Adam Park said.

The committee will be most active February through March, consistent with the shooting range grant cycle. Fish and Game will provide facilitation and logistical support to the committee, which will be administered with Idaho's Open Meeting procedures.

People interested in applying for a position on the Citizens Shooting Advisory Committee must fill out and submit an application by Dec. 1, 2023. Information is available on Fish and Game's Citizen Shooting Range Advisory Committee webpage at idfg.idaho.gov/shoot/advisory-committee.

The committee has seven members, one from each Fish and Game region. Representatives can serve up to two 2-year terms, with reappointment at the discretion of the Fish and Game director.

The Citizens Shooting Range Advisory Committee was created as a part of Idaho House Bill 396, which passed in 2020. The law created a new Public Shooting Range Fund, which is administered by the Fish and Game Commission. The Public Shooting Range Fund incorporates the financial resources previously used by Fish and Game for shooting range grants. The committee was created to advise Fish and Game about applications the agency solicits each year for these grants.

Idaho Fish and Game has partnered with nonprofit shooting organizations and state and local governments that own or manage shooting ranges, including archery ranges, since 1978. The funds come from federal manufacturer excise taxes collected on the sales of firearms, ammunition and archery equipment and from state fine and forfeiture monies remitted for wildlife crimes.





Pack River Delta Habitat Restoration Project Beginning November In North Idaho

Construction work for the Pack River Delta habitat restoration project will soon be in full swing for the 2023 work season

Idaho Fish and Game will soon begin a second phase of wildlife habitat restoration on the Pack River Delta in North Idaho.

An initial restoration project occurred on the Pack River Delta during winter 2009. The upcoming project will rebuild some of the landforms created during the 2009 project and build eight new islands and ten borrow areas to improve wildlife habitat on the delta.

Construction for the new project will primarily be in the central and southern portion of the Pack River Delta, north of the Burlington Northern Railroad line. A temporary bridge will be installed to span a main channel of the Pack River and provide access to the construction zone.

Contractors will begin staging material Nov. 13, and there may be some minor traffic delays along Highway 200 for a few weeks while contractors are building access from the highway down to the delta floor.



The Pack River delta is comanaged by the Corps of Engineers and Fish and Game as part of the Pend Oreille Wildlife Management Area. While sportsman can still hunt in the Pack River Delta during construction, hunters are encouraged to be mindful and respectful of workers and heavy equipment in the area. Construction work is anticipated to occur Monday through Friday during daylight hours through the winter and into early spring.

If you choose to hunt in the delta, please anticipate workers and heavy equipment to be present and

active while you are there. To provide added safety to the workers on the project, yellow "Safety Zone" signs will be installed. Please do not shoot toward or within the safety zones.

Here are a few simple precautions to follow while hunting the delta:

- · Abide by all yellow "Safety Zone" signs, and don't hunt behind or shoot toward them
- · Always know your surroundings and what is beyond your shot direction to avoid unintentionally shooting toward workers or heavy equipment
- · Stay clear of the bridge crossing
- Consider hunting in some of your other spots, or perhaps explore a new area

We recognize the timing of construction overlaps with waterfowl and trapping seasons; however, the project will restore and improve delta habitat by stabilizing banks, creating emergent benches and islands and planting vegetation aimed at protecting and improving wildlife habitat, hunting and fishing opportunities into the future.





Idaho Fish and Game staff will be collecting samples from deer at hunter check stations across the Panhandle over two weekends in November as part of a statewide surveillance program for chronic wasting disease. Staff are asking for help from hunters in providing samples from their harvested deer.

Chronic wasting disease was detected for the first time in Idaho in 2021 after more than 20 years of proactive surveillance and testing. The first detections were in Unit 14, which is located south of Grangeville. Another detection recently occurred in Unit 32A near New Meadows. Chronic wasting disease is a contagious and fatal neurological disease that affects deer, elk and moose, and there is no cure.

Although CWD has not been detected in the Panhandle, Libby, Montana, which is a short 22-mile jaunt east of the Idaho Panhandle border, has confirmed white-tailed deer, moose and mule deer with CWD in recent years.



Check stations will be operated Nov. 11, 12, 18 and 19 from 10 a.m. to sunset. Check stations will be located:

- Priest River: along State Highway 57
- St. Maries: south on State Highway 3
- **Bonners Ferry:** Idaho Department of Lands (6327 Main Street)

Fish and Game also has freezers across the region where hunters can deposit their own lymph node samples or deer heads. Each freezer has instructions attached to it and information tags are to be filled out for each head and sample. All samples should be kept cool or frozen until transferred to a freezer. Panhandle freezers are located:

- Bonners Ferry: Far North Outfitters, 6791 S Main Street
- Sagle: WaterLife Discovery Center, 1591 Lakeshore Drive
- Plummer: Heyburn State Park, 57 Chatcolet Road
- **Kingston:** Kwikstop Gas Station, 123 Stemm Loop



Hunters can also bring their own lymph node samples or deer heads into the Regional Office at 2885 W Kathleen Avenue, Coeur d'Alene from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Testing takes approximately four to six weeks after samples are submitted. For deer sampled at check stations or the Regional Office, hunters will be given a business card with a unique barcode number on it. The number can be entered into the IDFG sample results website at idfg.idaho.gov/cwd/lookup, where status updates and final testing results will be posted. Hunters that submit samples at freezers locations throughout the region will only be contacted if a sample is positive.

Helpful Tips To Remember When Interacting With Fish And Game Conservation Officers

With most hunting seasons already open, Idaho's hunting, fishing and trapping culture is being enjoyed by many.

Amidst the hustle and bustle this time of year, Idaho Fish and Game's conservation officers are also hitting the woods to help keep people safe and to ensure Idaho's wildlife resources are enjoyed safely, ethically and sustainably.

If you've spent much time hunting, fishing, trapping or otherwise recreating in Idaho's great outdoors, you've probably bumped into a conservation officer. Hopefully for most, the visit was pleasant, productive and ended with a handshake!

A recent interview with Conservation Officer Jacob Berl in the Panhandle Region provided three helpful tips for interacting with officers.

Question: What do you hope for when interacting with folks while on the clock?

Answer: "My guess is that most folks have had the opportunity to chat with a conservation officer at some point in their outdoor career. Although these interactions are usually friendly and benign, folks often report feeling uneasy during interactions with law enforcement. Interactions with conservation officers don't need to be stressful. In fact, they should be quite the opposite! After all, most people we connect with are law-abiding sportsmen enjoying the great outdoors."

Question: What tips would you give folks for interacting with their local conservation officer?

Answer: "I have three practical tips to offer, and these tips should make interactions more pleasant and productive for both sportsmen and officers.

Tip 1: Be kind and patient

When making a contact, we usually don't know who we are dealing with—a license check could simply be a grandparent taking kids fishing, or it could

be a felon on the run who decided to get off the grid. This uncertainty adds to the challenge and danger of our jobs. The best approach during a contact is simply to be kind, patient and understanding - all qualities you can expect from your local conservation officer, as well. Our goal is to treat all citizens fairly. All good relationships are built on honesty and trust, and your relationship with your local game warden should be no different.

Tip 2: Ask questions

I'm sure most folks have heard the age-old adage, "there is no such thing as a dumb question". Well in the world of wildlife and law enforcement, those words might as well be scripture. Our job is to assist sportsmen in their understanding of Fish and Game rules and regulations. In a perfect world, everyone would know, understand and properly follow regulations, and I'd be out of a job! However, regulations can be complex and confusing, despite our best efforts to simplify them whenever possible. Sometimes mistakes are made and if you don't ask questions, you'll never get an answer. What better time to ask questions than when you have a conservation officer standing right in front of you? We aren't encyclopedias of knowledge, but chances are, we can answer most of your questions about the do's and don'ts and perhaps even share a tidbit about the next fishing hole around the corner. You just have to

Tip 3: Help by reporting violations

Most ethical hunters, anglers and trappers will tell you that nothing upsets them more than seeing others abuse the wildlife and natural resources that we all collectively love. I couldn't agree more. It's no secret that we can't be everywhere at the same time, and wildlife can't speak for themselves. So we need you to be the eyes and ears, do what's right and report wildlife crimes. It's that simple. Reports of wildlife crimes can be made anonymously through our Citizens Against Poaching hotline (1-800-632-5999) or online."

Question: Any parting words for people?

Answer: "Research shows that those who know, trust and have developed a relationship with their local conservation officer are more likely to report wildlife crimes when they see them. A great time to foster that relationship is the next time you're contacted by a conservation officer. If you know of or suspect wildlife crimes, please consider sharing your information with an officer the next time you see them. I can guarantee they will appreciate what you have to share, and more importantly, so will the

Interactions with an Idaho conservation officer should be positive and improve your outdoor experience. Hopefully by keeping these three simple tips in mind, you'll be more at ease and better prepared for the next time you see an officer in the field.





Make Pavlova, a Luscious **Meringue Dessert**

It was autumn when Lisa and Gareth Hedges and their two children moved to America from New Zealand. Sure, they had heard about Thanksgiving through movies and books, but they hadn't experienced it firsthand until they were invited by new American friends to celebrate together. Now the gathering has become a meaningful tradition for both families.

Thankful to be included around the table, Lisa recalled the first year that she offered to contribute something to the menu, although she humbly admitted that she didn't know how to make the green bean and mushroom soup vegetable dish or how to bake a pecan, apple or pumpkin pie.

"But I could make a dessert from New Zealand," she said to the hosts. "It's called Pavlova, a favorite for special events and holidays. It begins as a big blob of meringue -- crunchy on the outside and soft and smooth in the middle. When slathered with whipped cream and garnished with berries and fruit, such as kiwi slices or passion fruit, it's transformed into something beautiful and delicious."

When Lisa recently shared her Pavlova with me, I immediately understood why it's a hit at their Thanksgiving dessert table. It would be a great addition to festivities during any time of year.

PAVLOVA Serves 6

Ingredients for meringue:

- 4 large egg whites, at room temperature
- 1 1/4 cups sugar, preferably superfine or ultrafine pure cane baker's sugar, such as C&H Baker's Sugar

- 2 teaspoons cornstarch
- · 1 teaspoon white wine vinegar
- · 1 teaspoon pure vanilla extract

Ingredients for topping:

- · 2 cups whipped cream
- Kiwi slices and fresh berries (such as strawberries and raspberries) or other fruit of your choice

To prepare oven and baking sheet: Heat oven to 300 F. Draw a 9-inch circle on a sheet of parchment paper, cut to fit a sheet pan. Turn paper over and lay

To make meringue: Using an electric mixer, beat egg whites and salt on high speed until firm, about 1 minute. With mixer still on high, slowly add sugar and beat until stiff, glossy peaks form, about 4 minutes. With a spatula, gently fold in cornstarch, vinegar and vanilla to combine.



Mound the meringue in the center of the 9-inch circle. Using a spatula, spread out evenly to form a disk. Bake 1 hour. Turn off oven and let meringue cool completely before removing from the oven, about 1 hour.

To serve, set meringue on a plate, and top with whipped cream and desired fruit.





Fibonacci Day November 23rd

Every November 23rd, Fibonacci Day honors Leonardo Bonacci, one of the most influential mathematicians of the Middle Ages. The date corresponds to the first numbers of the Fibonacci sequence - 1 1 2

Fibonacci is an Italian mathematician who is also known as Leonardo of Pisa and Leonardo Fibonacci. Some say Fibonacci invented the Fibonacci sequence. This pattern of counting means that each number is the sum of the previous two. (0,1,1,2,3,5,8,13, etc.) Computer data storage and processing uses this number sequence today. The sequence is also useful in the trading of stocks and architecture. Another unexpected place we find the sequence is in nature. DNA patterns and hurricanes contain patterns showing this sequence. Math and science classes refer to the Fibonacci sequence as "nature's secret code" or "nature's universal rule." Additionally, the number sequence is tied to the golden ratio and the golden triangle.

The Fibonacci numbers were published in his book, Liber Abaci in the year 1202. Fibonacci's book introduced the Western World to the Hindu-Arabic

numeral system we use today. This numeral system writes numbers as 1,2,3, etc. instead of Roman numerals I, II, III, etc.

Fibonacci was born in 1170. As a young boy, he traveled with his father, an Italian merchant named Guglielmo. During his travels, he learned about the Hindu-Arabic numeral system. As he traveled around the Mediterranean Coast, Fibonacci met with merchants and learned their arithmetic systems. In the 19th century, the city of Pisa erected a statue of Fibonacci. Today it stands in the western gallery of the Camposanto.

What do horses and dogs have to do with beer? The Anheuser-Busch brewing company, owner of the Budweiser brand, turned to making non-alcoholic products during Prohibition. Its repeal in 1933 was still a cause for celebration. August A. Busch, Jr., gave his father, the CEO of Anheuser-Busch, a gift of a hitch of Clydesdale horses pulling a beer cart. The hitch delivered the first post-Prohibition Budweiser beer.

A horse-drawn beer wagon proved to be an effective marketing tool, and the company got another hitch to make promotional tours. Dalmatians joined the tours in the 1950s, referencing the old practice of breweries having dogs to protect their horses and wagons during deliveries. In 1986, the Budweiser Clydesdales made their first appearance in a Super Bowl commercial. The company still has Clydesdale teams going on tours to this day.

During a recent thrifting excursion, I saw something I'd never seen before: A Blue Willow CorningWare warming tray with cord. The tray, working and with its cord, was only \$5.99. I passed it up and I've been kicking myself about it. What do you think?

I think you should have bought it. That CorningWare tray is worth at least \$25 elsewhere. It isn't rare, but CorningWare is undergoing a resurgence of popularity. Prices for vintage pieces are going up. Blue Willow is one of the most recognizable patterns. Corning Glass Works developed the glass for Thomas Edison's light bulb. In July








West-Central Montana Hunter Check Stations Reporting A Few More Hunter Trips And Slightly Lower Harvest

— Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks –



MISSOULA – After the first three weekends of big game season, hunter traffic through the west-central Montana hunter check stations is up slightly from last season overall, while harvest totals are down just a bit from 2022.

Each hunter check station tells a piece of the overall story. For example, at the check station south of Darby in the Bitterroot Valley, harvest totals are not down. FWP check station staff tallied 127 elk through the station so far, compared to 126 at this point in 2022. The Darby station is reporting 24 mule deer, which is identical to 2022, and 44 white-tailed deer, up from 39 at this point in the 2022 season. Hunter traffic through the station is also up from 2022.

At the station near Anaconda, trends are tracking in line with the region overall, which means that hunter traffic through the station is up while harvest is down slightly. FWP wildlife staff tallied 512 hunter visits over the season's first three weekends, compared to 458 at this point in 2022 and 18 elk compared to 25, eight mule deer compared to 11, and four white-tailed deer compared to one.

The hunter check station just outside of Bonner is the only station in the region that has seen a slight decrease in both hunter traffic and harvest this season. The station logged 2,063 hunter stops so far, compared to 2,146 at this point in 2022 and 170 animals overall, compared to 194 after the third weekend in 2022.

Hunter wildlife check stations only sample a small portion of the hunter effort and harvests across the region, but they track important trends and biological information. Because the stations operate on the same days and hours each year, biologists are able to use check station data to see how harvest is shaping up compared to historical averages and to collect information on wildlife age, health, and other hunter observations from the field.

Hunters must stop at all check stations that they pass, even if they have not harvested any animals. The general big game season runs through Sunday, Nov. 26.





Thanksgiving Day 4th Thursday in November

— National Day Calendar —

Thanksgiving Day is observed each year in the United States on the fourth Thursday in November. The observance is a time when families and friends gather and give thanks for many reasons, each often as different as each person who gathers around the

In 1621, the Plymouth colonists and Wampanoag Indians shared an autumn harvest feast that many acknowledge today as one of the first Thanksgiving celebrations in the colonies. For more than two centuries, days of thanksgiving were celebrated by individual colonies and states. However, it wasn't until 1863, amid the Civil War, that President Abraham Lincoln proclaimed a national Thanksgiving Day to be held each November.

How To Observe #ThanksgivingDay

In many American households, the Thanksgiving celebration has lost much of its original religious significance; instead, it now centers on cooking and sharing a bountiful meal with family and friends. The pilgrims may not have even served turkey that fateful day in 1621. Today, however, the bird is so ubiquitous, it has become synonymous with the holiday. In fact, nearly 90 percent of Americans eat the bird-whether roasted, baked or deep-friedon Thanksgiving, according to the National Turkey Federation. Other traditional foods include stuffing, mashed potatoes, cranberry sauce, and pumpkin pie. Another common Thanksgiving tradition is volunteering to ensure everyone has a meal on the big day. Some communities often host food drives and free dinners for the less fortunate.

Parades are also an integral part of the holiday. Presented by Macy's department store since 1924, New York City's Thanksgiving Day parade is the largest and most famous, attracting some 2 to 3 million spectators along its 2.5-mile route and drawing an enormous television audience. It typically features marching bands, performers, elaborate floats conveying various celebrities and giant balloons shaped like cartoon characters.

Beginning in the mid-20th century and perhaps even earlier, the President of the United States has "pardoned" one or two Thanksgiving turkeys each year, sparing the birds from slaughter and sending them to a farm for retirement. Several U.S. governors also perform the annual turkey pardoning ritual, too.

THANKSGIVING DAY HISTORY

Plymouth

In September 1620, a small ship called the Mayflower left Plymouth, England. The ship carried 102 passengers—an assortment of religious separatists seeking a new home where they could freely practice their faith and other individuals lured by the promise of prosperity and land ownership in the New World. After a treacherous and uncomfortable crossing that lasted 66 days, they dropped anchor near the tip of Cape Cod, far north of their intended destination at the mouth of the Hudson River. One month later, the Mayflower crossed Massachusetts Bay. Here, the Pilgrims, as they are now commonly known, began the work of establishing a village at Plymouth.

Throughout that first brutal winter, most of the colonists remained on board the ship. They suffered from exposure, scurvy, and outbreaks of contagious disease. Only half of the Mayflower's original passengers and crew lived. When the remaining settlers moved ashore in March, they received an astonishing visit. An Abenaki Indian greeted them in English. Several days later, he returned with another Native American named Squanto.

Squanto, a member of the Pawtuxet tribe, had been kidnapped by an English sea captain and sold into slavery before escaping to London and returning to his homeland on an exploratory expedition. Squanto taught the Pilgrims, weakened by malnutrition and illness, how to cultivate corn, extract sap from maple trees, catch fish in the rivers and avoid poisonous plants. He also helped the settlers forge an alliance with the Wampanoag, a local tribe. The alliance would endure for more than 50 years. Tragically, it remains one of the sole examples of harmony between European colonists and Native Americans.

First Thanksgiving

In November 1621, after the first successful corn harvest, Governor William Bradford organized a celebratory feast. He invited a group of the fledgling colony's Native American allies, including the Wampanoag chief Massasoit. The event is remembered as America's "first Thanksgiving. However, the Pilgrims likely never used the term to describe the day. The festival lasted three days.

While no record exists of the historic banquet's menu, the Pilgrim chronicler Edward Winslow wrote in his journal that Governor Bradford sent four men on a "fowling" mission in preparation for the event and that the Wampanoag guests arrived bearing five deer. Historians suggest that many of the dishes likely used traditional Native American spices and cooking methods. Because the Pilgrims had no oven and the Mayflower's sugar supply had dwindled by the fall of 1621, the meal did not feature sweets. In other words, no pies, cakes or other desserts graced the table, even though they have become a hallmark of contemporary celebrations.

The Next Thanksgivings

Pilgrims held their second Thanksgiving celebration in 1623 to mark the end of a long drought that had threatened the year's harvest and prompted Governor Bradford to call for a religious fast. Days of fasting and thanksgiving on an annual or occasional basis became common practice in other New England settlements as well. During the American Revolution, the Continental Congress designated one or more days of thanksgiving a year. In 1789, George Washington issued the first Thanksgiving proclamation by the national government of the United States; in it, he called upon Americans to express their gratitude for the happy conclusion to the country's war of independence and the successful ratification of the U.S. Constitution. His successors John Adams and James Madison also designated days of thanks during their presidencies.

In 1817, New York became the first of several states to adopt an annual Thanksgiving holiday officially; each celebrated it on a different day, however, and the American South remained largely unfamiliar with the tradition.

National Observance

In 1827, the noted magazine editor and prolific writer Sarah Josepha Hale-author, among countless other things, of the nursery rhyme "Mary Had a Little Lamb"—launched a campaign to establish Thanksgiving as a national holiday. For 36 years, she published numerous editorials. The editor sent scores of letters to governors, senators, presidents, and other politicians.

At the height of the Civil War in 1863, Abraham Lincoln finally heeded her request. In a proclamation, he entreated all Americans to ask God to "commend to his tender care all those who have become widows, orphans, mourners or sufferers in the lamentable civil strife" and to "heal the wounds of the nation." President Lincoln scheduled Thanksgiving for the final Thursday in November. It was celebrated on that day every year until 1939 when Franklin D. Roosevelt moved the holiday up a week in an attempt to spur retail sales during the Great Depression. Roosevelt's plan, known derisively as Franksgiving, was met with passionate opposition. In 1941, the president reluctantly signed a bill making Thanksgiving the fourth Thursday in November.






