

Stuffed Boneless Pork Loin Roast

Prep time: 40 minutes

Cook time: 95 minutes

Servings: 6

- 1 Coleman Natural boneless pork roast (3-4 pounds)
- 1 tablespoon extra-virgin olive oil
- 1 tablespoon butter
- 1/2 cup diced celery
- 1/2 cup diced carrots

- 1/2 cup diced onions
- 2 large eggs
- 1/2 cup milk

salt, to taste

pepper, to taste

- 1 tablespoon fresh sage
- 1 tablespoon fresh rosemary
- 2 cups cubed fresh bread, crust removed
- 1 apple, diced

gravy, for serving

- 1. Preheat oven to 375 F.
- 2. Butterfly roast.
- 3. In large skillet over medium-high heat, heat oil and butter. Add celery, carrots and onions; cook until softened, about 5 minutes.
- 4. While vegetables are cooking, whisk eggs; milk; salt, to taste; and pepper, to taste, until well combined. Mince sage and rosemary.
- 5. In large bowl, combine bread, vegetable mixture, liquid ingredients, apples, sage and rosemary. Gently toss until bread absorbs most of the liquid.
- 6. Cut three pieces of butcher's twine about 4 inches longer than the longest side of butter-flied roast. Lay string on cutting board horizontally and lay roast on top of string to cover.
- 7. Place half of the stuffing mixture onto butterflied pork loin and press down firmly. Roll roast up and tie with butcher's twine to hold it together, taking care not to tie too tightly, and press any stuffing that comes loose back into ends of roast.
- 8. Place stuffed and tied roast, fat cap up, on rack over baking sheet. Season liberally with salt and pepper; roast until meat thermometer inserted into roast registers 140 F, 75-90 minutes.
- 9. Place remaining stuffing in a small ovenproof casserole dish and cover with foil. After roasting 30 minutes, place extra stuffing in oven to cook alongside roast.
- 10. Remove foil from extra stuffing and remove roast from oven. Let rest for 10 minutes then remove the extra stuffing from oven.
- 11. Cut twine from roast and discard. Cut roast into six thick slices, taking care not to lose stuffing. Serve with extra stuffing and gravy.







Love Your Leftovers with This Non-Traditional Turkey Soup

There's no wrong way to love your Thanksgiving leftovers. But if you want to do something unbelievably right this year, make this.

Meet my twist on mulligatawny soup, a rich, fragrant, Indian-in-spired classic flavored with curry, coconut and just enough nostalgia. It's been a family favorite for years, and I credit my British mother (and Britain's long love affair with Indian cuisine) for bringing it into our holiday rotation.

What makes it special is the playful mix of familiar and exotic. You get traditional Thanksgiving flavors like tender turkey, carrots and a hint of clove, but with a bright, unexpected accent of curry and apple. Mulligatawny is usually vegetarian, or sometimes made with chicken or beef, but turkey? Not so much. Until now.

This version is so good, it deserves its own name: Mulliga-Turkey Soup.

Every spoonful is an adventure -- creamy coconut, savory broth, sweet pops of apple. And oh, that apple! When you scoop one up, it's like finding buried treasure. The crisp, tart fruit adds sparkle to every bite.

If you're sensitive to spice, the apple's tartness and a squeeze of lemon can make the curry come through a little bolder. A drizzle of sour cream or Greek yogurt will mellow the heat and make your bowl look restaurant ready.

Sprinkle on fresh cilantro, add a few lemon slices for garnish and serve with warm naan or pita on the side.

One spoonful, and you'll never look at turkey leftovers the same way again.

MULLIGA-TURKEY SOUP

Yield: 8-10 servings

Total time: 45 minutes



Thanksgiving turkey gets a spicy new life in this curry-kissed coconut soup.

1 tablespoon olive oil

3/4 cup yellow onion, diced

2 cups carrot, sliced

2 Granny Smith apples, peeled, cored and chopped

1 tablespoon garlic, finely diced (more if you love garlic)

1/2 teaspoon kosher salt

1/4 teaspoon pepper

1/4 cup all-purpose flour

2 tablespoons curry powder

1/2 teaspoon cumin

1/8 teaspoon cloves

6 cups turkey stock, or 3 (14 oz.) cans chicken broth

2 cups cooked turkey, diced -- more if you have it

3 cups cooked rice (white, brown or basmati)

1 (14 oz.) can unsweetened coconut cream

 $1/4~\mathrm{cup}$ lemon juice

Cilantro

Plain Greek yogurt, optional garnish

In a large soup pot over medium-high heat, warm the oil until it shimmers. Add the onion and carrot and saute for about 3 minutes, just until they start to soften. Toss in the apple and cook another 2 minutes -- your kitchen should start smelling pretty amazing right about now.

Stir in the garlic, salt and pepper. Sprinkle the flour, curry powder, cumin and cloves over the mixture and stir to coat every bit. Let it cook, stirring often, for 2 to 3 minutes, until the flour smells toasty and the spices bloom into that irresistible, nutty aroma.

Slowly pour in the broth while stirring, scraping up any flavorful bits from the bottom of the pot. Bring to a gentle simmer and cook for about 10 minutes, or until the vegetables are tender.

Now, add the cooked rice, turkey, coconut cream and lemon juice. Stir and let everything get cozy together for another 10 minutes at a gentle simmer. Taste and adjust the seasoning with a little more salt or pepper if needed.

Ladle into bowls and top with a dollop of Greek yogurt or sour cream, a sprinkle of fresh cilantro, and maybe a few lemon slices if you're feeling fancy.

This soup freezes like a dream, which means you can be thankful for your leftovers all over again.





Don't Let a Lack of Gear Stop You from Waterfowl Hunting

Part 1 of 2

– Idaho Fish & Game –



Here's a back-to-basics approach to duck hunting that any hunter can use.

Waterfowl hunting has a reputation for being expensive, but hunters don't need to shell out tons of money on a boat or a truckload of waterfowl gear to be successful. That's especially true in a state with as much public land as Idaho.

Jump shooting is a low-cost option for public land hunts, but it is not the only one. The classic method of hunting over decoys is a good option for public land waterfowl hunters. The excitement that comes with watching ducks work a decoy spread (circling them to see if it is safe to land), the interactive component of calling and close shooting provide an experience that many waterfowl hunters live for.

Public land hunters may have to work a little harder to set themselves up for success when hunting over decoys, including dedicating time for scouting, and being willing to put in extra effort to get away from most of the hunting pressure.

But for those who are willing to make the commitment, there are many walk-in public hunting spots scattered throughout the state that can produce good waterfowl hunting - and it doesn't take hundreds of decoys. Idaho waterfowlers can put together a successful hunt with nothing more than what they carry in on their backs, including:

- A shotgun
- · Idaho hunting license
- Migratory bird (HIP) permit
- Nontoxic shotgun shells

Hot Tip: Alternatively, if you don't feel like shelling out (pun intended) hundreds of dollars on new decoys, you can always scour your local Craigslist or pawn shops for well-seasoned, used decoys. With a little elbow grease, you can give them the "old ultra-flat Rustoleum rattlecan renovation." That's the Brian Pearson way.

By finding and setting decoys in a place where ducks already want to be, hunters can eliminate the need for a large decoy spread that might be needed to attract birds from far away.

With a smartphone or a computer, you have everything you need to start looking for a potential waterfowl spot. The first step is finding water, and when walking in with decoys, it pays to think small. Using Fish and Game's Hunt Planner or some sort of GPS mapping tool, hunters should scour smaller rivers and streams for public access points, and search for potentially overlooked pockets of water - creeks, sloughs, ponds, etc. - on all different kinds public property, including those that are more traditionally associated with upland game hunting.

Don't ignore traditional waterfowl spots including larger rivers, reservoirs, wildlife refuges and Fish and Game's Wildlife Management Areas and habitat areas. For these, try to identify spots where there is likely to be less hunting pressure, such as areas inaccessible by boat or off the beaten path.

The Snake River and its reservoirs also provide some prime access to waterfowl hunting for southern Idaho.

Don't Let a Lack of Gear Stop You from Waterfowl Hunting

Part 2 of 2

– Idaho Fish & Game –

Once you've compiled a list of potential locations, it's time to get out and see what it looks like from ground level, and more important, whether the ducks like it. Observe your potential spots frequently to see if ducks are using them, both before and throughout the season. While not necessary, a decent pair of binoculars makes spotting far-off ducks a lot easier.

After you confirm ducks are using a location, study it closely to pattern the birds and determine when they are arriving and departing. That might be at first light, but it could be also be mid-morning (which means a couple hours of extra sleep and warmer temperatures), or in the afternoon or early evening.



In any case, you'll want to have your decoys out and be ready to hunt before they start pouring in. Putting in this work ahead of a hunt can minimize the amount of time you are staring at empty skies, and allow you to plan a more efficient and productive bunt.

Hunters shouldn't put all their effort into one location because it does not take much hunting pressure to discourage ducks from using it. This is especially true of smaller waters. Work to find and pattern ducks at several locations, avoid over-pressuring any single spot. Continue to scout various spots throughout the season, and above all else, be adaptable and mobile. For the best results, public land hunters need to be able to adjust their strategy

Develop your game plan(s)

Once you've tracked down some promising public areas, consider concealment (i.e. is there natural cover, or if you have to build or bring a blind) and be adaptable. Ducks will generally land into the wind, so you will want to set up with the wind at your back if possible. Identify a number of different places you can set up at each location depending on the wind direction.

Think about where you might want to position your decoys. Keep in mind that your decoys should be within effective shotgun range (somewhere around 40 yards). If you are hunting without a dog, you will also want to make sure that the water is shallow enough for you to safely wade, both to set out your decoys, and to retrieve downed birds.



If it's a spot that you're likely to find other hunters, consider making a weekday trip if you can. On weekends or holidays, focus your efforts on your more secluded locations.

Another consideration is weather. Earlier in the season, small waters, such as ponds, sloughs and backwaters may be a good option, but may freeze as the temperatures begin dropping, and you will have to shift your focus elsewhere. This is where scouting for a variety of options pays dividends.

Idaho's varied geography means duck hunting opportunities are different depending where you're located, but most areas have places where a person can hunt waterfowl, and it doesn't require a huge commitment of money and gear to be successful.





On the day after Thanksgiving, National Day of Listening encourages you to gather your family and friends and record family history and stories for preservation. The program, created by StoryCorps, reminds us of the value our stories hold.

Have you ever wondered what Grandma's favorite memory is or how your father got that scar on his brow? What's the story behind a friend's nickname? Recording stories and sharing them gives breath to them. When we gather with family and friends, we often reminisce. And while not all memories are pleasant, they hold a power over us that needs to be released. Telling them and sharing them lets our friends and families learn some of the lessons, some of our culture and heritage. Our stories connect us, and hearing others' stories opens our eyes to the broader world.

We're made of many experiences and the experiences of those who've gone before us. Spend the day listening to their stories. Record them. Share them. Interview someone close to you or someone new to you. Let them become an indelible part of your life.

How To Observe #NationalDayOfListening

Interview a friend or family member and record the interview.

StoryCorps provides a DIY guide as well as lists of Great Questions based on who you interview.

There is no format requirement for recording the interviews on National Day of Listening. Whether you record them onto digital devices, a tape recorder, or pen and paper, the essential part is to record the story for future generations. If you record in a digital format, you can also upload the recording to StoryCorps using an app or use #NationalDayofListening to post on social media.

National Day Of Listening History

In 2008, the non-profit organization, StoryCorps, launched the National Day of Listening to encourage families to set aside the day after Thanksgiving as a time to share and record the history of their family, friends, and community.

Listening FAQ

Q. Why is listening important?

A. We listen for a variety of reasons and the way we listen changes based on those reasons.

Reasons We Listen

- Informational We listen to gain information, knowledge, or understanding about a topic or someone's background.
- Critical We listen to evaluate, compare, or judge. We use this type of listening when someone is trying to convince us of something like a sales pitch, job interview, political debate.
- Empathetic We listen to provide comfort to the speaker, usually someone who has experienced a loss or trauma.
- Enjoyment We listen to the stories our family tells, television shows, radio programs, and music because it entertains or brings us joy.


Q. How do I make sure I'm listening?

A. There are several ways to engage in active listening.

- Eliminate distractions. Shut the door, turn off the TV or radio, and put down their phone.
- · Make eye contact. Don't stare into their eyes; that's creepy. Look toward their face and let your eyes meet as you hear their words. Eye contact conveys to the speaker that they have your attention.
- · Nod, tilt your head, make facial expressions when appropriate. If you're paying attention, these actions will happen naturally, nod when you understand or agree smile when the speaker tells a funny experience tilting your head to show interest
- · Ask questions. Not only does this show you're listening but encourages the speaker to keep talking.
- Repeat what the speaker said in your own words.



About 1 million Fingerling Kokanee Will Be Ready For Spring Stocking

Thanks to newer captive broodstock program

– Idaho Fish & Game –



This is the first batch of kokanee fingerlings produced by adults that were raised in hatcheries.

A million fingerling kokanee are headed to Idaho waters in 2026 thanks to Idaho Fish and Game's new captive broodstock program aimed at supplementing eggs taken from "wild" fish. It's the first batch produced by Idaho Fish and Game's newest hatchery project aimed at providing stability to the annual number of kokanee fingerlings that can be stocked each spring.

Most kokanee caught by anglers were born in hatcheries, but the eggs that produce them are typically taken from adults that were released as fingerlings and survived in the wild before being recaptured for spawning. The survival rate of those adults is driven by natural conditions, which can fluctuate annually.

Fish and Game aims to stock around 7 million kokanee fingerlings each spring, but a bad year for adult survival can affect how many fingerlings are available in the future because there's fewer to adults to spawn and produce the next generation. While Fish and Game can't change natural conditions, hatchery production can buffer some of the ups and downs.

"Kokanee fishing is really popular and important to a lot of anglers, so we're doing our best to meet

their expectations," said Joe Kozfkay, Fish and Game's state fisheries manager. "We face a lot of uncontrollable natural variables that can make that challenging, but raising broodstock will improve our response to some of that natural variability."

Starting a broodstock from scratch

The new captive broodstock program didn't happen overnight. To start it, eggs taken from adult fish in the North Fork Payette River north of McCall were sent to Cabinet Gorge Fish Hatchery in the Panhandle. The eggs were hatched, and the fry reared for a year. Then about 15,000 of them were transferred to the Grace Fish Hatchery in the Southeast Region and reared two more years to spawning age.

In September, the first crop of adult kokanee spawners yielded over 1.6 million eggs, which were then shipped to Mackay Fish Hatchery in the Upper Snake Region, where they will be reared until next spring. With normal attrition of eggs and young fish, Fish and Game expects about a million fingerlings will be available to stock in the spring.



"Wild-origin kokanee and their eggs will still be used to meet most of our kokanee management goals, but the kokanee broodstock project demonstrates it will be a valuable tool to supplement our annual egg supply," Southeast Fish Hatchery Complex Manager Bryan Grant said.

Fortunately for anglers, this year isn't a one-anddone study. The next three generations of captive spawners are currently being raised in hatcheries. Given the positive results of the first crop, fisheries managers and hatchery staff are hopeful for greater success in 2026 as hatcheries continue to dial in their captive kokanee spawning techniques.

Celebrate the Holidays With an **Appetizer Party**

Planning a party with friends and family this year? Make it easy by turning your buffet table into an informal appetizer table. Pop out the pits and gently squeeze the sides to create a space for your filling. Next, crack walnuts with a nutcracker to get two perfect halves. (Kids love this activity!)

Pick out the nuts, then insert one of the halves in the cavity of a date. Set in rows on a platter. For a sweeter dessert version, roll the walnut-filled date in powdered sugar. Use your imagination and preferences for other fillings, such as a thin wedge of Brie cheese with a pecan. Or how about a tiny spoonful of peanut butter topped with a pretzel nugget?

NATIVE AMERICAN HISTORY DAY HISTORY

Riding horseback from state to state in 1914, Red Fox James, a Blackfoot Indian, sought endorsement from 24 states to support a national day recognizing and honoring Native Americans. He presented these endorsements to the White House the following year. At the time, the U.S. government didn't proclaim a national day. However, the state of New York declared the second Saturday in May as American Indian Day.

In 1986, the 99th Congress passed a joint resolution authorizing the President to proclaim November 23-30, 1986, as American Indian Week. President Ronald Reagan declared the first American Indian week that year and each year following his presidency. President George H.W. Bush continued the proclamations until 1990, when he approved a joint resolution to declare November as National American Indian Heritage Month. This tradition has continued annually. In 2008 the Native American Heritage Day Act was enacted by Congress and signed by President George W. Bush on October 8, 2008.

Native American FAQ

Q. How many Native American tribes remain today?

A. There are 574 federally recognized tribes in the United States. There are additional tribes recognized only at the state level. In addition, hundreds of other tribes continue to go through the process of federal recognition.

Q. What is a reservation?

A. A tribal reservation is a section of land reserved for the tribe. In some instances, this was land set aside by the tribe before relinquishing their remaining land to the government. In other instances, the government designated the land through government actions.

Q. Do only Native Americans live on reservations?

A. No. Some non-natives live and own land on reservations. And, not all Native Americans choose to live on a reservation.

Q. What foods do we eat today come from Native American culture?

A. Across the United States, Native American culture is as diverse as any other, including Native American food. Many foods cultivated by Native Americans are incorporated into the food tradition of the United States, such as pumpkin and corn. However, some dishes are quintessentially Native American.

Native American Dishes

Frybread - Native Americans developed this delicious bread out of necessity. Unable to obtain traditional foods such as beans, corn, and wild rice, Native Americans utilized the foods made available to them by the government. Try frybread sprinkled with powdered sugar, cinnamon, or honey. Another way to enjoy fry bread is an Indian Taco, topped with ground beef, lettuce, tomatoes, and cheese.

Wild Rice - Unlike white rice, wild rice is native to North America and was a staple food for indigenous people. Today it's still served in various dishes, including soups or combined with mushrooms, nuts, berries, and herbs.

Succotash - This stew usually contains corn, squash, and beans and dates back to the 17th century. While recipes evolved, they include these primary three ingredients. The result is a hearty, flavorful stew packed with nutrients.

Restoring Scenic Bay: The Lake Pend Oreille Idaho Club's Lake Enhancement **Project Scheduled May '26**

Lake Pend Oreille is one of Idaho's most treasured natural resources, providing habitat for native fish and trophy species, clean water for communities, and world-class recreation for residents and visitors alike. An important part of the fishery is Scenic Bay-located beside Bayview, the U.S. Navy's Acoustic Research Detachment, multiple marinas, and contains some of the lake's kokanee spawning beds.

Since 2022, the Lake Pend Oreille Idaho Club (LPOIC) has been leading an ambitious underwater cleanup through its Lake Enhancement Program. The next chapter of this multi-year effort is scheduled for the first week of May 2026.

The club is calling on volunteers and donors to help make the effort a success.

Why the Cleanup of Scenic Bay Matters: Kokanee salmon are the backbone of the Lake Pend Oreille fishery. These small, land-locked salmon are essential prey for trophy rainbow trout, westslope cutthroat trout, and the federally listed bull trout.

Scenic Bay's gravel beds are among the most productive kokanee spawning grounds in the lake because well-oxygenated groundwater flows through the gravel, giving kokanee eggs a higher chance of survival.

But over decades, those same beds have been compromised by an accumulation of trash and discarded equipment-barrels, batteries, engines, plastic totes, tires, and more. Left in place, debris can leach toxins and decrease productive kokanee spawning.

The Work Ahead

What: Scenic Bay Lakebed Cleanup will span four days and involve:

- Professional Divers removing large or hazardous debris from the lakebed.
- Volunteers collecting, weighing, sorting, and loading materials onshore.

Who: LPOIC members, Bayview Chamber of Commerce and community volunteers, local businesses, professional and volunteer divers, and the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office

• LPOIC will provide lunches for participants

When: First week of May 2026 (4 days)

- Specific dates will be published in April.
- A repeat of the cleanup is planned for 2027 and

Where: Scenic Bay Marina, Bayview, Idaho

Why: Restore kokanee spawning beds, improve recreation safety, reduce pollution





Past cleanups show just how much muscle is required: in just six hours, more than 7,000 pounds of debris were removed from Scenic Bay.

Safety: Safety is a top priority. LPOIC develops a detailed operations plan, applies for the required Marine Event Permit from the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office, and coordinates with Timberlake Fire District for emergency response.

Community Investment: The cost of this cleanup is significant. Hiring a barge and professional divers represents the largest expenses, but every dollar raised helps protect the lake.

Donations ensure:

- Continued debris removal from spawning beds.
- Safe operations with trained professionals.
- Long-term improvement to kokanee habitat.

Looking Forward: The Scenic Bay cleanup is more than a spring event—it's a commitment to the longterm health of Lake Pend Oreille. By restoring kokanee spawning grounds, reducing pollution, and making the bay safer for recreation, LPOIC and its partners are investing in the future of both the lake and the communities that depend on it.




