MONDAY, NOVEMBER 13th, 2023 marks the start of the City of Coeur d'Alene's annual leaf pick-up program. Please be sure to KEEP leaves on your property until Wednesday, November 1st. After Wednesday the 1st, please rake your leaves and pine needles about one foot away from the gutter/curb line to allow for water drainage. City crews and equipment are limited, so we need your help. Leaves will be picked up only once. Please do not put leaves in the street after city crews have completed your area and do not include bagged leaves, branches, debris or trash.

Pick-up will start south of Sherman Avenue and move north. We expect completion before December 1st. Follow our progress on maps.cdaid.org/leaf

**REMEMBER:** 

**Needles and** 

**Leaves ONLY!** 

No branches,

grass clippings

or garden debris.

**NO GARBAGE** 

**Begins November 13th** 

**KEEP** leaves and needles on property until **Wednesday, November 1st**.

- Please move cars off the street if at all possible during leaf pick-up.
- Keep the leaves about one foot away from the curb line to allow drainage. Be alert for leaf pick-up equipment traveling through your neighborhood.
- Keep a safe distance away from leaf pick-up heavy equipment.
- · Recognize that we have a tough job to do in a very short window between when the leaves fall and when the snow flies.
- City and private trucks are exempted from covering loads during the leaf pick-up period. Sweepers will follow city trucks to collect remaining/ excess leaves.

### DO NOT:

- Place bagged leaves in the street.
- · Mix branches, debris or other trash in with the leaves.
- · Miss the deadline...We only have time for one pass.





### **Senior Companions Program in Need of Volunteers**

— Panhandle Health District —



Senior Companions Program volunteers at their annual appreciation luncheon

The Senior Companions Program sponsored by Panhandle Health District (PHD) is a volunteer program that provides companionship and respite care to the elderly and disabled. The program needs additional volunteers to serve seniors in the five northern counties: Benewah, Bonner, Boundary, Kootenai, and Shoshone. The Companions program allows low-income senior volunteers an opportunity to assist those who need minor help to continue living independently. Senior Companions visit clients in their homes, but it is not an inhome care program.

"We are always seeking volunteers to assist with companionship for this fun and rewarding program," said Daniel Perry, Senior Companions Program coordinator. "Over the past year we've lost about thirty-five percent of our volunteers due to some leaving the area, others have gone from being a volunteer to becoming clients of the program, and a few unfortunately have passed."

Senior Companions are volunteers, 55 or older, who provide a meaningful service to homebound individuals and their families through weekly home visits. The Companion program had around 54 volunteers in 2022, and that number has dwindled down to 36 volunteers. The client list has done the opposite and has continued to grow, reaching up to 133 community members requesting a companion.

"We continue to see a high need for Senior Companions in our north Idaho area and it's heartbreaking to know so many clients have to be kept on a waitlist until we can find a companion for them," said Perry. "Volunteers play cards or a board game, drive to doctor appointments, or accompany clients to the grocery store. Sometimes they just sit, chat and enjoy each other's company because the social aspect of the program for both the volunteer and the client is beneficial."

The goal of Senior Companions — a Senior Corps program that operates under the umbrella of Americorps — is to help the clients live as independently as possible. The Companion program is offered to clients free of charge. Senior Companion volunteers receive a tax-free hourly stipend, mileage reimbursement, and other benefits.

Companions and clients are matched based on shared interests and experiences to ensure a positive experience for everyone. Volunteering also has health benefits. In national studies, volunteers report lower instances of depression, anxiety, and chronic pain, as well as higher self-esteem.

The Senior Companions Program touches hundreds of lives in north Idaho. Last year, volunteers put in over 30,000 hours and drove more than 135,000 miles serving clients.



The goal of FWP's Future Fisheries Program is to restore rivers, streams and lakes to improve Montana's wild fish habitat. Entities can receive funding for qualifying projects that benefit Montana's wild fish. Each project is assessed by an independent review panel and final funding decisions are made by the Fish and Wildlife Commission.

### **Daylight Saving Time Ends** First Sunday in November

— National Day Calendar —



Daylight Saving Time ends on the first Sunday in November at 2:00 AM.

The practice of Daylight saving time (DST) (also known as summer time) advances clocks during the summer months. It causes us to lose an hour for one day. However, the practice allows people to get up earlier in the morning and experience more daylight in the evening. Typically, users of DST adjust clocks forward one hour near the start of spring. Then, they change them back again in the autumn.

The system has received both advocacy and criticism. Setting clocks forward benefits retail business, sports, and other activities exploiting sunlight after working hours. However, the practice causes problems for evening entertainment and other activities tied to the sun or darkness. For example, farming and fireworks shows are both affected.

Although some early proponents of DST aimed to reduce evening use of incandescent lighting (formerly a primary use of electricity, modern heating and cooling), usage patterns differ greatly.

Additionally, research about how DST currently affects energy use is limited or contradictory.

Problems sometimes caused by DST clock shifts

- they complicate timekeeping
- · can disrupt meetings, travel, billing, record keeping, medical devices, heavy equipment,
- it especially impacts sleep patterns

Software can often adjust computer clocks automatically, but this can be limited and error-prone. Programming is particularly problematic when various jurisdictions change the dates and timings of DST changes.




### **Daylight Saving Time Ends History**

National Bison Day, on the first Saturday in November, honors one of the most majestic beasts to roam the land.

The official National Mammal of the United States, the iconic North American Bison, has played a cultural, economic and environmental role in the history of the country. Central to the livelihood of Native Americans, they are also a healthy food source and vital to religious ceremonies.

The bison is the largest land mammal in North America, with males weighing up to 2,000 pounds and standing up to 6 feet tall. While cows may be smaller at 1,000 pounds and up to 5 feet tall, they're still mighty powerful. However, Bison only live up to 20 years.

The dark brown to black, thick shaggy coat of the full-grown bison keeps them warm during long, cold winters on the plains. When they're born, the calves sport a reddish coat.

While giant herds once covered the plains, hunters nearly decimated them by the 1800s. Now, bison

populate all 50 states living in national parks, refuges and on tribal and private lands.



### **Basic Training**

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: You often mention that owners should spend time with their dogs in basic obedience training. What are "the basics" exactly? -- Ferris T., Huntington, N.Y.

ANSWER: While the specifics of basic obedience training for dogs are better detailed through books or by professional trainers, I can list these training requirements here.

- · Housetraining: The most basic and most important to you and your dog's peace of mind. Teaching a new dog where and when to eliminate, and training yourself to keep a proper schedule, is a crucial initial step.
- · Heel: Your dog should walk calmly alongside you, and not struggle against the leash, pull you down

the street or chase after birds, cars or other dogs.

- · Sit: A well-trained dog will sit on command. When training on the leash, have the dog sit on your left
- Down: The dog should lie down (on his belly, paws forward) on command.
- · Stay: In the "sit" or "down" position, the dog should not move until you release him with a verbal command.
- Come: At your command, the dog should come to you, or respond to further directional commands (such as tugging the leash right or left to signal a

That's essentially it: five basic commands and housetraining. It doesn't sound like much, but teaching a dog of any age these skills will take at least several weeks, if not months. And they must be taught correctly: no hitting or yelling, maintaining dominance over the dog. Training books provide many more details on effective ways to do this, while a professional trainer can demonstrate additional effective techniques to ease the basic training

Remember that basic obedience training doesn't stop once these skills have been learned. Dogs need regular reinforcement, even if it's just a five-minute review during their daily walks.







There is a rumor in a contemporary travel book titled Tour to London, by Pierre Jean Grosley, that formed the popular myth that bread and meat sustained Lord Sandwich at the gambling table. It is said that Lord Sandwich was a very conversant gambler and did not take the time to have a meal during his long hours playing at the card table. When hungry, he would ask his servants to bring him slices of meat between two slices of bread. This practice was a habit that was well known to his gambling friends who soon began to order "the same as Sandwich," and from this, the sandwich was born.

N.A.M. Rodger, who wrote Sandwich's biography, suggests that because of Sandwich's commitment to the navy, politics, and the arts, the first sandwich was more likely to have been consumed at his work desk.

Before being known as sandwiches, the food seems just to have been called bread and meat or bread and cheese.







### World Jellyfish Day November 3rd

– National Day Calendar –



On November 3rd, World Jellyfish Day celebrates this invertebrate that has been on Earth for millions of years. The day also encourages us to learn more about these unique aquatic animals.

Despite its name, the jellyfish isn't actually a fish. This is because a fish's anatomy centers around its spine. A jellyfish, on the other hand, doesn't even have a spine. In fact, jellyfish don't have gills, a brain, heart, bones, or blood. Instead, a jellyfish is made up of 95 percent water. They also have skin, through which they absorb oxygen. The body of the jellyfish is called a bell. A jellyfish swims by contracting and relaxing the muscles around this bell. Their tentacles contain stingers, which protect them from prev.

### **Jellyfish Facts**

- Some jellyfish can still sting after they are dead.
- · Jellyfish are older than dinosaurs and have been around for over 500 million years.
- Nearly 2,500 jellyfish polyps made their way to space aboard Space Shuttle Columbia in 1991.
- · Some jellyfish tentacles measure 10 feet long and contain 5,000 stinging cells.

### · Jellyfish are found in all five oceans.

- There are over 200 species of jellyfish and some of them are edible.
- · A group of jellyfish is called a bloom, swarm, or smack.
- · Jellyfish eat crabs, fish, and tiny plants and digest their food very quickly.

Some jellyfish are pink, yellow, blue, purple, and other vibrant colors. Jellyfish are usually luminescent, which makes them especially beautiful. If you spot one, don't get too captivated by its beauty. If you do, you may be in danger of getting stung. Some jellyfish stings are very painful, but others can be deadly. This is especially true of the box jellyfish. This type of jellyfish is usually found in Australia, the Philippines, and the central Pacific Ocean. If you do happen to get stung by a jellyfish, rinse the affected area with vinegar. You can also try to pluck the tentacles from the skin with tweezers.

On this day, aquariums all around the world host special jellyfish exhibits. It's also a day for marine biologists and aquarists to educate the general public about this unique invertebrate. To participate:

Put small piles of nuts near cheeses, line up cold cuts in rows, and then fill in spaces with dried fruit, grapes, sweet cherries and berries. Pile on a variety of crackers here and there.

If you have space, spoon prepared hummus into tiny bowls for spreading on crackers. Peanut butter, jelly and honey will make the selection even more kid-friendly. Add style with a few edible blooms, such as nasturtiums, or use a pretty silk flower or two.

As kids become more comfortable in the kitchen, teach them how to mix their own sweet and savory dips, slice vegetables, and wrap breadsticks, pretzels or asparagus with cheese or meat.

Extra Family Fun: When guests arrive, your young child might like to play the role of a "waiter" and take orders from adults of their choices from the cheese board. They can assemble the "order" on a small plate and deliver it to the guest.



### **Roast Skinny Sweet Potato Fries**

There's skinny this and skinny that -- as in skinny jeans or a skinny latte -- so I couldn't resist calling my family's favorite new version of roasted sweet potatoes: "Skinny Sweet Potato Fries."

It happened at the kitchen counter recently when a basketful of the tuberous root from our local farmer's market inspired me. Instead of cutting the sweet potatoes in wedges like I've always done when roasting autumn vegetables, I slimmed the slices, turning them into a new experience and a tasty side to ribs, burgers, sandwiches and fish. They make a delicious and unique fall appetizer or healthy snack, too.

Sweet potatoes have a rich, nutty and sweet flavor, and they're full of good-for-you beta-carotene, antioxidants and fiber. Transformed into these fries, the vegetable is mouthwatering, satisfying and fun for dipping with good old ketchup (a kid-favorite) or in a tasty low-fat mayonnaise/sriracha combo.

### **SKINNY SWEET POTATO FRIES** Serves 4

- 4 medium sweet potatoes approximately 5 inches long, peeled
- 1 tablespoon olive or vegetable oil
- 1 teaspoon kosher salt (or to taste)
- · Pepper

Preheat the oven to 400 F. Cut the sweet potatoes in half lengthwise. Place them flat side down and cut into thin long slices, about 1/4-inch thick. Place the thinly sliced pieces on their side and cut additional thin slices, making sure they are all uniform in thickness.

Place the cut potatoes in a single layer on a nonstick or parchment-lined rimmed cookie sheet. Drizzle with olive oil and sprinkle with salt and pepper. Toss well. Bake for 15 minutes, rotate the sheet and continue baking for another 10-15 minutes until golden brown and tender. Serve hot.

### **EXTRA SERVING IDEAS**

- Spicy dipping sauce: Stir together 4 tablespoons low-fat mayonnaise with 1 teaspoon of sriracha hot chili sauce. Or substitute a squeeze of fresh lime juice for the sauce.
- Garlic dipping sauce: Stir together 2 tablespoons low-fat mayonnaise with 2 tablespoons fat-free Greek yogurt and 1 clove of garlic, crushed and minced.
- Season the fries before baking with any number of herbs and spices such as thyme, parsley, cumin, chili powder or smoked paprika.

### **Hunting Doesn't Just Happen In The Mountains...** It Starts In Your Closet **Part 1 of 2**

Here's how your hunting attire can make or break your late-fall hunting trip.

Regardless if you're a greenhorn or seasoned hunter, assessing the weather and dressing accordingly can be a bit of a tightrope walk. Those pre-dawn hours while you're waiting for the propane stove to fire up might have you reaching for that thick down jacket, but 100 yards into your hike you may be shedding like a husky in August.

Picking the right clothing for a fall hunt is just as important as picking which rifle to shoot or which lunch to pack. Idaho's unpredictable weather is the butt of many a joke and can hang a person out to dry (figuratively speaking) if they're not prepared.

As the temperature dips hunting tends to improve, so consider these tips so you can make the most of your hunts regardless of the weather.

### All about that base

A hunter's baselayer is the first line of defense against Idaho's frigid weather. When picked right, it can keep a hunter warm and comfortable throughout the entire hunt, dawn to dusk. But when slapped together or overlooked, it can let the cold in like a bear in a donut shop.

Today's modern baselayers make the term 'long underwear' seem antiquated. Baselayer technology has come a long way, giving hunters tons of options for a warm and comfortable defense against the

The key to picking the right baselayer is wool or synthetic fabric that wicks away moisture and retains its warming properties when damp or wet. There are several thickness options (lightweight, mid-weight, etc.) to choose from, but generally be shy about shedding layers if, or when, you start speaking, unless you're hunting in severe cold or

sitting in a tree stand for 8 straight hours, light- and medium-weight wool or synthetic baselayers are the way to go.

Now if bullets kill big game, cotton kills hunters. Not literally, of course, but wearing wet cotton on a sub-40-degree day is about as fun as snowshoeing in sandals. When wet, whether that be sweat or latefall rain-sleet mix, cotton sucks the warmth out of the body, so avoid it at all costs.

But freezing isn't the only potential consequence from a poorly picked baselayer. It is easy to "dress for the cold" when you're still sitting on the tailgate back at camp, but overdoing it with a heavyweight baselayer can soon become a poor decision the moment you start climbing that first ridge. Because baselayers are unlikely to come off during the course of a hunt, remember to find a happy medium with thickness and anticipate the day warming up.

### Layer up

It's not unheard of in Idaho for a crisp sunny morning to turn into a rainy midday slog, which bring us to the next step: layers.

Layers provide warmth and protection from the weather and can quickly be added or removed as the day unravels. The word "layer" can mean a lot of things, but generally speaking a 4-inch-thick goose down parka is probably best left at the car, unless of course you plan on sitting in a tree stand or blind all day. But generally, consider wearing (or bringing) a fleece sweater or sweatshirt. One with a hoodie is an added bonus, especially when you need a quick way to warm the ears and neck.

Everyone's definition of cold is different, so know your body and know the properties of your layers before heading out on your hunt. Look ahead at the day's forecast (if you can) and gauge which layers you think will get the job done.

Along those lines, also consider the layer's protective properties. If you're going to be hunting with rain or sleet in the forecast, think about bringing a waterproof sweater or windbreaker.

The same goes for pants, too. More often than not this time of year, all that dense forest undergrowth will be steeped in early-morning dew. As you trudge through the brush, be sure your pants and outer layers not only repel water but don't sound like a thousand people eating potato chips either.

Also remember smaller bodies, such as women or kids, may need thicker layers than a large man, and everyone is a little different in their cold tolerance. But one thing everyone shares is it's much easier to stay warm and comfortable when you're dry, so remember that wicking baselayer and don't

### Waterproof vs. water resistant, which is better?

If you've ever stood in the clothing department at your local sporting goods store, you've probably pondered this blurry marketing feature before. Some items say water-resistant, and others waterproof, and others waterproof and breathable.

What really is the difference, and does the product say one thing but demonstrate another? As frustrating as that dilemma can be, picking the right type of water protection can be a gamechanger depending on which part of the state or which climate you're hunting in.

As the names imply, waterproof means that the fabric should prevent any moisture from getting in, while water-resistant means that it will do its best to prevent any moisture from getting in, but eventually, it's going to soak through.

But any fabric that keeps moisture out also keeps most moisture in, and that presents a big decision for hunters: Do you want to be dry or dry-ish?

Most waterproof options tend to be less breathable - or don't breathe at all - allowing moisture to accumulate inside and make you feel damp and therefore, cold. Except for some very high-end and expensive pieces of clothing, waterproof fabrics don't breathe well enough to vent all the moisture an active hunter produces, so there's bound to be some condensation inside.

On the flip side, water-resistant clothing tends to be more breathable and can wick more moisture away from your body. But on the occasion a heavy storm rolls in, those clothes will ultimately get soaked, leaving you out to dry, only not dry.

Hunters should anticipate roughly what type of weather or climate they will be hunting in and decide whether they need waterproof or water-resistant clothing, and there's no reason they can't use both. Wear a water-resistant jacket in most situations, but have a lightweight, packable and fully waterproof jacket as a backup for when it really starts pouring.

### Don't forget about your extremities

It may be tempting to leave a little extra room in your pack by leaving the gloves or beanie back at camp, but when the weather takes a turn, they can be just the comfort you need in a pinch.

Like your baselayer, consider picking up some wool or synthetic gloves and/or beanie for your latefall or winter hunt. Your extremities lose a lot of heat when exposed to the cold, but like layers it can be easy to go overboard with picking the right head and handwear. If you're planning on seeing snow, waterproof mitts might be a better choice than simple wool mittens. But if you plan on glassing up the hillsides with morning lows around 40, you may be fine with a light pair of water-resistant gloves.

Same with what you put on your head. Unless you're trapping beavers on the Kootenai River in January, you should probably leave that fur-lined Ushanka back at the car. Instead, a simple beanie or baseball cap can be a light choice that gives your noggin a little extra warmth in the cold.



### Experience is the best teacher

At the end of the day, everyone's different. Experiment with different fabrics and layers, test them before and during the hunt and determine which setup is right for you. Hunting is all about being versatile; you don't sling six different rifles over your back during a deer hunt. Find a comfortable baselayer (if necessary), try out different layering options and figure out what level of water repellency you'll need when hunting.

Buying and testing hunting clothes might not be as cool as sighting in a new rifle or glassing a distant hillside with new binoculars, but it will make you more comfortable during the early-morning hike in – or maybe even the sweaty, grueling pack out – and help ensure you're comfortable and safe from the elements while out in the field.

### Imbruvica Shouldn't Be Withheld **Long Before or After Procedures**

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am 75 and have had Waldenstrom macroglobulinemia for three years, which has been treated with ibrutinib (Imbruvica) and is now in remission. A side effect of Imbruvica is bleeding, and it requires the drug to be withheld before procedures.

I need a colonoscopy and a prostate biopsy now. Ideally, how long before and after the procedures should Imbruvica be withheld? If the procedures cannot be performed a day apart, how long is too long an interval between them? How often can Imbruvica be withheld?

Also, at my age, how long is the recovery period required for anesthesia when undergoing two separate procedures? -- T.

ANSWER: Waldenstrom macroglobulinemia is a rare disease -- a type of blood lymphoma and a cancer of the bone marrow. Ibrutinib is a new effective treatment for many people who have this condition and sustain remissions from the disease.

As you correctly say, bleeding can be a problem with this medicine, and it is generally held for three to seven days before and after surgery (depending on the type of procedure and the risk involved). Because a prostate biopsy is a low-risk procedure and a colonoscopy has almost no risk (unless a biopsy is required, then making it a low-risk procedure), most experts would only hold the medication for three days before and after the procedure.
