Beyond Thanksgiving: Unleash the Versatility of Cranberry Sauce!

Happy Thanksgiving week! Can we chat about cranberry sauce? This traditional Thanksgiving staple often finds itself relegated to the shadows, while its versatility and year-round potential are underappreciated by many.

Think about it. This stuff is awesome! Cranberries are a fruity, sweet, tart, affordable superfood. Packed with vitamin C, fiber and disease-fighting antioxidants. Often the only jolt of color on an otherwise 50 shades of beige plate. We should be using this wonderful sauce all year long.

Diva Tip: After Thanksgiving cranberries go on sale -- cheap! They freeze beautifully, so stock up.

Here is a classic, easy, makeahead recipe for cranberry sauce with orange.

EASIEST CRANBERRY ORANGE SAUCE

Yield: 2 cups

Total Time: 15 minutes

3/4 cup sugar

3/4 cup water

1 (12-ounce bag) fresh or frozen cranberries

1 orange

Pinch salt

Put your water and sugar into a medium saucepot over medium-high heat and bring to a boil.

Meanwhile, sort and rinse the cranberries, removing any that are discolored or mushy. When the water and sugar are boiling, add the cranberries. Reduce heat to medium, stirring occasionally. Continue to simmer until all the cranberries have popped and broken down.

As the cranberries cook, zest the orange then slice it in half and squeeze the juice into a bowl, yielding approximately 1/3 cup of juice. When the cranberries are cooked, remove the pot from the heat and stir in the orange juice and zest. It'll thicken as it cools. Serve immediately or refrigerate for up to 10 days, or freeze for up to three months.

Since you're making this, you should double the recipe. Here's why.

Let's see where the cranberry can go, shall we? Some ideas: Step aside, turkey sandwich. The cran can dance with many partners. Peanut butter, almond butter or cream cheese accompanied by a smear of cranberry makes your morning toast grand. You can top French toast, pancakes or waffles with a blend of cranberry sauce and maple syrup. Blend some with yogurt or layer cranberry sauce with Greek yogurt and granola to make colorful parfaits.

Add cranberry to a grilled cheese sandwich made with sharp cheddar. Spoon some over baked brie cheese, top with nuts and serve with crackers. Warm it up and enjoy as a sauce over ice cream and cakes. Spoon it into muffin, cupcake or cake batter. Or bake these bars.

CRANBERRY OATMEAL BARS

Yield: 9 servings

Total Time: 40 minutes

1 cup leftover cranberry sauce, canned or homemade

1/4 cup sugar

1 cup flour

1 cup old-fashioned rolled oats

2/3 cup (packed) light brown sugar

1/4 teaspoon salt

1/2 cup butter, cut into small pieces

2/3 cup chopped pecans

Preheat the oven to 350 degrees. Grease a 9-inch square baking pan, and/or line with parchment.

In a saucepan on the stovetop or in a microwavable bowl, combine the cranberry sauce and sugar. Bring to a boil to dissolve sugar so the mixture is thick and spreadable.

To make streusel: In a medium bowl, combine the flour, oats, brown sugar and salt. Using your fingertips, rub the butter into the dry ingredients until the mixture is crumbly. Add the pecans and combine.

Firmly press about half of the streusel into the baking pan. Spread the cranberry mixture over the top. Sprinkle with the remaining streusel. Bake until the top is lightly browned, about 30 minutes. Let cool completely before cutting into squares.

So, whether you're enjoying it with turkey or as a spread on your morning toast, remember, cranberry sauce adds a burst of flavor and color to your meals throughout the year. Cheers to making every day a cranberry day.

Mail-Order Meds Lose Efficacy if They're Not Stored Properly

DEAR DR. ROACH: How can you tell with at least a moderate degree of certainty that you might really have a heart or blood pressure problem, as opposed to just having an anxiety attack that is less serious? -- D.S.

ANSWER: All medicines should be stored in a cool, dark place, as direct sunlight and heat can damage their effectiveness. Studies have proven that medicines sent by mail order can indeed get out of their published temperature range. While this happens most often in mailboxes, I understand your point about medications "broiling" in hot temperatures during the shipment itself.

Liquid medicines, hormones and nitroglycerin are among the most sensitive. Medicines that need to be dosed exactly, such as transplant rejection medicines, biologicals, and seizure medicines, are also particularly likely to cause problems if they are damaged during shipping. Although some medicines are supposed to be shipped in packaging with cold packs and insulation, this isn't always the case.

I recommend using a local pharmacy, but many people have prescription plans that require them to use mail order. Many states have requirements about customers using retail pharmacies. If that's not the case for you, try to make sure that the medicine will be delivered when you are available to receive it.

If you have a temperature-sensitive medicine, such as the ones I mention above (you can ask your pharmacist about others), request that your mail-order pharmacy sends it in special packaging during warm weather. You might also consider having them shipped to a place where they will be put into a temperature-controlled environment right away.

DEAR DR. ROACH: Since I developed bronchiectasis, I have lost 15 pounds. I can't seem to get an answer as to why this disease would result in weight loss. Can you shed any light on this? -- E.K.G.

ANSWER: Bronchiectasis is a lung condition similar to chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD). It develops after a lung infection occurs in a person who is at risk due to a number of possible underlying conditions.

Weight loss with chronic lung disease, like COPD and bronchiectasis, is common. There are many possible reasons. One is that breathing can be hard work! It takes extra energy (as much as 10 times more energy) to breathe with chronic lung disease. Some medications used for bronchiectasis promote weight loss, often through poor appetite. Bronchiectasis is an inflammatory condition, so this can also lead to appetite suppression.

Although many healthy people want to lose weight, losing weight with chronic lung disease is a bad sign and a reason to make some dietary changes. I've often advocated for nuts and nut butters; the healthy fat in them contains a lot of calories, and fat is easier on your lungs, since it makes less CO2 than protein or carbohydrates. You also need to maintain muscle strength.

Finally, a new serious diagnosis always leads to a change in how we think of our bodies, so depression (which often exacerbates weight loss) is not uncommon. Your doctor or a mental health professional can help.





Each year on December 4th, National Dice Day recognizes an ancient gaming tool. Many games incorporate dice as a way to add random challenges or obstacles to the objectives. It's time to roll the dice and see where you land!

Players typically throw dice onto a flat surface from their hands or a cup. The uppermost face of the die after it comes to rest determines the value of the throw. One popular dice game is craps where wagers are made on the total value of the throw of the dice. Frequently used in board games, players use dice to randomize their moves, commonly by deciding the distance a piece will move on a board. Favorite board games using dice include backgammon and Monopoly.

The origin of dice is uncertain. However, it is known that they have been around for thousands of years. At the Burnt City, an archaeological site in

south-eastern Iran, archaeologists unearthed the oldest known dice as part of a 5000-year-old backgammon set.

Players originally made dice from the talus (ankle bone) of hoofed animals. They also used ivory, wood, and plastics in making dice. Dice also come in many shapes and colors.

Play a game using dice. Or hang those fuzzy dice on the rear-view mirror. If you have two dies, you might be in pair o' dice. Use #NationalDiceDay to post on social media.

- Q. What is the singular form of "dice"?
- A. The singular form of dice is "die."
- Q. How many sides are on a typical die?
- A. There are 6 sides to a typical die. However, there are many different kinds of dice.
- O. What are the dots on a die called?
- A. The dots on a die are called "pips". Each pip or combination of pips represents a number. Pips can also be found on golf balls and dominoes.

A brief history lesson

For some, winter is a time to hibernate in the comfort of a warm home, enjoying a hot drink by a crackling fire. For others, winter offers a unique opportunity to try their hand at landing the native and once rare burbot in the Kootenai River.



Referred to by some as the Kootenai leopard or ling cod, burbot in the Kootenai River are once again being pursued by anglers thanks to hard work of the Kootenai Tribe of Idaho, Idaho Fish and Game and other partners.

Fishing for burbot in the Kootenai River closed in 1992 because of a declining population. The population has since increased and the fishery reopened in Jan. 2019. As the fishery is relatively new, Fish and Game staff are closely monitoring how the fishery and the burbot population are doing. Although Fish and Game runs an extensive annual monitoring program on the river from Dec. through March, we need your help to collect additional information.

Never Let The Sun Set On A Dirty Firearm

As big game hunting season winds down, don't forget to clean up those firearms before stowing them in the gun safe.

Another season in the books. You and your trusty firearm spent countless hours roaming the mountain slopes and drainages that Idaho is known for and likely in all kinds of weather.

For all the times your firearm's had your back (literally), now is the point in the year when you have its back. Whether you hunted the forests of the Panhandle, the dry sagebrush seas in the southern portion of the state, or somewhere in between, you and your firearm earned some much-needed R&R. Your muscles will recover with some time off; but stashing a dirty gun for months can cause all kinds of problems next time you go to use it.

Here's a quick and easy guide (and reminder) to clean your firearms and condition them for next season.

Preparation

Before you run downstairs and take every clamp and screw off your firearm, do a little housekeeping. Pick out a suitable, clean work area with ample space to set aside parts and tools.

Make sure your workstation is well-lit and has good air flow, since you'll be working with cleaning agents.

A sturdy table is a must. Resting your prized firearm on a stack of cardboard boxes is a surefire way to break some expensive features. Also be sure that the table is not one that hosts the family at dinner time. Gun cleaning solvents are greasy and can be toxic, so don't clean your firearm on, say, the same table to process your game meat.

Know how your firearm works

Being a responsible firearm owner is more than just knowing where to point the muzzle and when to squeeze the trigger. Firearm assembly can vary from manufacturer to manufacturer, so making sure you have an updated copy of the firearm's manual is important in understanding how to take things apart, or even more importantly, how to put them back together. A lot of pride went in to building that firearm, and you should dedicate the same amount of pride to caring for it.

Elbow grease

It's time to get to work. Whether the bulk of your time was spent hunting deer with a rifle or grouse with a small-gauge shotgun, the principle is always the same. Different firearms, however, require different strategies when it comes to cleaning, but the tools and concept is roughly the same.

Tools you should have in your cleaning kit:

- Cleaning rod
- · Bore brush (that matches the caliber of your firearm)
- · Pull-through bore cleaning tool
- · Cleaning jags (slotted and form-fitting for holding patches)
- Cloth patches
- · Utility brushes
- · Cotton swabs
- Gun oil
- · Cleaning chemicals, including bore cleaners, action cleaners, and lubricants

HOT TIP: You might want to consider picking up a cleaning kit specific to the caliber of firearm you own. Not only does it save you time picking out tools individually, but most come with a case that keeps your tools tidy.

Cleaning a firearm can differ pretty greatly depending on the type of firearm, the type of ammunition fired through it, the length of the barrel, type of receiver, etc. But to keep things simple, here's a boiled down guide focusing on the basics using common cleaning tools.

- 1. Before you do anything, make sure the firearm is unloaded. Then remove the magazine.
- 2. Clean the firearm's barrel and chamber. Using either a brush or pull-through bore cleaning cable that matches your firearm's caliber, gently slide the brush or pull-through tool down the barrel from chamber to muzzle. Do this a few times and you will notice flakes of carbon and metal fouling — the result of pushing relatively soft metal or metal-cased objects down a relatively hard bore — exiting the barrel at the muzzle.
- 3. Now the barrel is clear of metal fragments and debris but still needs to be cleaned. Apply a few drops of bore solvent to a fresh patch (a square piece of lint-free fabric, usually made of cotton). Slide the moist patch through the barrel using a cleaning jag that matches the caliber of your firearm until it comes out the end of the barrel. Do not pull the patch back through the barrel, as this brings dirt and debris back into the nowwet barrel. The jag holds the patch in place like a scrunched up bowtie while the patch slides down and cleans the barrel.
- 4. With the barrel moistened by the cleaning solvent, give the firearm 10-15 minutes for the solvent to break down any remaining sediment.
- 5. Once time has passed, take a bore brush and scrub the inside of the barrel.
- Toss the old, dirty patch and replace with a clean new one. Run the dry, clean patch down the barrel several times. You may have to repeat this process with additional clean patches. Continue running the cleaning rod through the barrel until the patches no longer show any dirt.
- 7. Next, apply light lubricant to a bore cleaning tool and run the tool through the barrel to further clean and prevent corrosion.



- The firearm's barrel should now be cleaned. Be sure to wipe down the outside of the firearm as well, including the barrel's exterior and the feed
- 9. Carefully inspect the action and remove any debris, gunk, oil residue, etc. so it's clean and operates smoothly. Re-oil with a light lubricant if needed, but don't over do it or it could gum up the action, especially in freezing weather.

Now that you have tidied up your firearm's barrel, repeat the same steps above for your firearm's action. Whether your firearm is a pump-action, bolt-action or slide-action, cleaning the action is just as important as cleaning the barrel.

You may need to pick up some smaller brushes and tools specific to cleaning your firearm's action, which can vary greatly. Be sure to check out your firearm's manual for the best instructions on cleaning its action.

Until next season

Most hunters don't care if their firearms look pretty, they just want them to shoot right. Taking pride in your firearm is part of being a responsible hunter. You'll feel a lot better heading into the off season or reaching for that trusty firearm come next season with a clean, well-taken care of rifle or shotgun sitting in your safe. Maintain a properly cared for firearm and it will have your back for many more hunts in the future.

Try This Easy Meatless Tamale Casserole

Over the years, photos, reminders and kitschy magnets have covered my fridge door, along with cartoons and sayings. One snippet by humorist Calvin Trillin, often described as America's funniest food writer, held center stage for years: "The most remarkable thing about my mother is that for 30 years, she served the family nothing but leftovers. The original meal has never been found."

I laugh every time I recall the quip. Maybe it's because leftovers feel like a prize when I discover them in the back of the refrigerator. I know I can reheat them with extra dashes of fresh additions; then voila, a family meal is on the table!

If you've combed through recipes for recreating any leftover Thanksgiving turkey and trimmings before, you've no doubt got a plan in mind to gobble them up. But don't forget about those "leftover" Thanksgiving feast dry goods in your pantry, like the big bag of cornmeal you bought for just one batch of cornbread.

Use that cornmeal in this easy-to-make meatless tamale casserole. It's a delicious dish your kids can help prepare by measuring ingredients, beating eggs and greasing the pan while you chop and saute onions and garlic.

Serve this tasty tamale-inspired main course with a lovely, crisp fresh salad, or enjoy it as a side. It makes an ample amount for a family of four with, yes, plenty of leftovers.

MEATLESS TAMALE CASSEROLE Makes 6 servings

- 2 medium onions, chopped
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 2 tablespoons butter
- 2 tablespoons oil
- 1 tablespoon chili powder
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 15-ounce can diced tomatoes (substitute with fire-roasted style, if you prefer)

- 1 4-ounce can diced green chilies
- 1 15-ounce can corn, drained
- 1 cup milk
- 3 eggs, beaten
- 1 1/2 cups yellow cornmeal
- 1 1/2 cups pitted black olives
- 2 cups shredded sharp Cheddar cheese
- · Sour cream for serving

Preheat the oven to 400 F. Cut the sweet potatoes in half lengthwise. Place them flat side down and cut into thin long slices, about 1/4-inch thick. Place the thinly sliced pieces on their side and cut additional thin slices, making sure they are all uniform in thickness.

Place the cut potatoes in a single layer on a nonstick or parchment-lined rimmed cookie sheet. Drizzle with olive oil and sprinkle with salt and pepper. Toss well. Bake for 15 minutes, rotate the sheet and continue baking for another 10-15 minutes until golden brown and tender. Serve hot.



EXTRA SERVING IDEAS

- Spicy dipping sauce: Stir together 4 tablespoons low-fat mayonnaise with 1 teaspoon of sriracha hot chili sauce. Or substitute a squeeze of fresh lime juice for the sauce.
- Garlic dipping sauce: Stir together 2 tablespoons low-fat mayonnaise with 2 tablespoons fat-free Greek yogurt and 1 clove of garlic, crushed and minced.
- Season the fries before baking with any number of herbs and spices such as thyme, parsley, cumin, chili powder or smoked paprika.



DEAR DR. ROACH: I have been told at the age of 70 that I am in the early stages of the eye disease macular degeneration. The doctor told me to take PreserVision AREDS 2 vitamins. He said that I will be taking them for the rest of my life. I started them immediately, and a few nights later, I started having severe left leg cramps to the point where I woke out of a sound sleep to jump out of bed and shake off the cramp. Is this typical? -- C.L.

ANSWER: For the dry form of age-related macular degeneration, the AREDS and AREDS2 vitamins are the usual treatment. Although they are not a cure, they do slow progression of the disease.

My experience with these has been that they almost never cause side effects, and muscle cramping is not a reported side effect by the manufacturer. The timing, however, certainly is suspicious. You can try stopping them for a few days, then restarting them to see if the cramps are truly affected by the vitamins.

If they are, you have two choices. The first is to deal with cramps the same way that people who get them at night for no particular reason deal with it, which is by getting regular moderate exercise and stretching the calf and hamstring muscles before bed.

Having weight on the toes is a trigger for many people, so very light bed covers that aren't tucked in can be surprisingly helpful. I've had a few readers come up with devices to keep all weight off of their toes in

Your second option is to discuss an alternative with your eye professional. The AREDS and AREDS2 formulas were shown to be helpful, but some eye professionals only choose a few components of the formula.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I recently had a CT scan of my chest and pelvis that resulted in an incidental finding of "mild bibasilar atelectasis." My doctor does not seem to be concerned at all. Should they be? -- J.M.


ANSWER: "Bibasilar atelectasis" is a scary-sounding term unfamiliar to most people, so I understand why you might be concerned. "Atelectasis" refers to non-inflation of the tiny air structures in the lung called the alveoli. The bottom of the lungs are the bases, so "bibasilar atelectasis" means a partial collapse of the lung at the bases.

This is very common in people who aren't breathing deeply, such as those who undergo surgery. In healthy people, this finding is not likely to represent serious disease of the lung. Before (and while you were getting) your CT scan, you might not have been breathing very deeply, allowing a very small portion of the lungs to deflate a bit. A few really deep breaths are all that is usually needed to open up those air sacs again. Sighing is a mechanism found in virtually all animals that helps treat and prevent atelectasis.

If that was the only finding on your CT scan, and you are otherwise healthy, your doctor is right not to be concerned, although I wish that they had explained it a little better to keep you from getting concerned in the first place.

National Cookie Day December 4th

— National Day Calendar —



National Cookie Day on December 4th serves up a sweet treat. Bakers across the country warm up the ovens for holiday baking, and we enjoy giving tins of cookies to friends and family all season long.

We can thank the Dutch for more than windmills and tulips. The English word "cookie" is derived from the Dutch word koekie, meaning "little cake."

Hard cookie-like wafers have existed for as long as baking has been documented. Not surprisingly, they traveled well, too. However, they were usually not sweet enough to be considered cookies by modern-day standards.

The origin of the cookie appears to begin in Persia in the 7th century, soon after the use of sugar became common in the region. They then spread to Europe through the Muslim conquest of Spain. Cookies were common at all levels of society throughout Europe by the 14th century, from the royal cuisine to the street vendors.

Cookies arrived in America in the 17th century. Macaroons and gingerbread cookies were among the popular early American cookies.

In most English-speaking countries outside of North America, the most common word for cookie is "biscuit." In some regions, both terms, cookies, and biscuits are used.

Cookies are classified into different categories, with the most common ones being:

Bar cookies – Drop cookies – Filled cookies

Molded cookies - No bake cookies

Pressed cookies - Refrigerator cookies

Rolled cookies - Sandwich cookies

How To Observe National Cookie Day

Pick up some cookies at your local bakery. Remember to share some of your cookies with your family and friends! A great way to get started is by making a list of your favorite cookies to bake and enjoy. Then organize your baking tools and start your assembly

National Cookie Day History

In 1976, Sesame Street included National Cookie Day on its calendar for the first time on November 26th. The Cookie Monster also proclaimed his own National Cookie Day in the 1980 book The Sesame Street Dictionary.

Then in 1987, Matt Nader of the Blue Chip Cookie Company out of San Francisco created Cookie Day, celebrating it on December 4th.

Cookies FAQ

Q. Why do recipes say to mix dry and wet ingredients separately?

A. There are two important reasons why recipes for baked goods call for mixing dry and wet ingredients separately. First, mixing these ingredients separately helps to disperse the spices, leavening agents, and flavorings equally through the mix. Second, this practice prevents us from overmixing the ingredients. When we overmix ingredients, the gluten in the flour becomes tough and will create a tougher final product.

Q. Should I use butter or margarine in my cookies?

A. Real butter is best for cookie baking (unless the recipes specifically calls for a different fat or oil). Cookies baked with butter develop richer, tastier









Savor the Season With a **Quick Chicken Enchilada** Casserole

The holidays are in full swing with all the hustle and bustle and seemingly endless to-do lists.

You know what we need? (Besides more money, lower prices and an extra week before Christmas.) We need a recipe for an easy, comforting, home-cooked meal the whole family will love that doesn't break the bank.

Today I'm sharing a recipe that's a true gem; a Chicken Enchilada Verde Casserole that's not only easy on the wallet but also on your precious time. This is your ticket to a cozy, heartwarming dinner with a recipe that easily doubles so you can make one for dinner tonight and stash the second in the freezer for a zero-effort dinner when you are too tired from all the fun to cook.

Please note this is enchilada casserole, not enchiladas. I find layering like lasagna is faster and easier to prepare and serve than rolled enchiladas. But if you have the time, use this recipe to roll enchiladas to your heart's content.

This recipe calls for corn tortillas, but you could use flour tortillas if that's what you have. I love the way corn tortillas absorb the sauce and become almost fluffy. Besides, if you buy a package of 30 corn tortillas, you have enough to double this recipe.

15 yellow corn tortillas, cut in

3 cups Mexican cheese blend, shredded

Optional Garnish: onions, cilantro, avocado, tomatoes, sour cream and tortilla chips

Preheat oven to 350 degrees with the rack in the middle position. Grease a 9-by-13-inch pan, then pour 1 cup of enchilada sauce and spread around the bottom. Set it aside.

In a mixing bowl, whisk together 1 cup enchilada sauce, sour cream, cumin, chile powder, salt and pepper. Add the shredded chicken and pinto beans, then stir to combine.



Make two cozy, comforting casseroles and freeze one for later.

In the 9-by-13 pan, place 9 tortilla halves on top of the enchilada sauce. Placing the cut sides along the sides of the pan offers better coverage for layering.

Spread half of the chicken mixture on top of the tortillas. Evenly distribute 1 cup of cheese over the chicken mixture.

Place another layer of 9 tortilla halves followed by the remaining chicken mixture and 1 cup of cheese.

Layer the last tortilla halves on top followed by the remaining enchilada sauce. Top with the last cup of cheese. Bake for 30 minutes, or until it's nice and bubbly. Allow this to rest for 15 minutes before serving. Garnish as desired.

Store leftovers in the fridge for three to four days. Or freeze for up to three months. Thaw overnight in the fridge and reheat in 350 degree oven for 45 minutes when completely thawed.

If you have the budget to add some ingredients to this casserole, you could happily add a can of diced tomatoes with chiles and/ or a can of diced green chiles. And no one would be mad at you if you added more cheese.

So whip up this Chicken Enchilada Casserole, savor the flavors of comfort food and take a moment to cherish the warmth it brings to your table. And remember, doubling the recipe can be a lifesaver during these busy times, either for yourself or as a gift for another holiday harried household. Enjoy!



From tags sales to season openers, there's a lot happening in Idaho during December that you should be aware of. Staying in the loop can be the difference between applying for that coveted controlled hunt tag and watching from the sidelines.

Be sure to stay up to date on all Fish and Game happenings. Here are some important dates you should know to help you plan.

December 2023

- 12/1 Nonresident deer and elk tag sale at 10 a.m. MST
- 12/1-12/2 MK Nature Center Bird Seed Sale
- 12/25 Christmas Day Public Holiday (Fish and Game Offices Closed)
- 12/31 CLOSED: Pheasant hunting season in Areas 1 and 3
- 12/31 CLOSED: Forest grouse season in most of the state

Note: Hunters, anglers and trappers should always double check the seasons and rules booklets to confirm opening and closing dates, as well as restrictions and rules pertaining to individual species.

Nonresident Deer And Elk Tags Go On Sale Dec. 1

Hunters should expect high demand for tags and long waits

Nonresident deer and elk tags for the 2024 hunting season go on sale at 10 a.m. MST on Dec. 1. Licenses and tags can be bought online at GoOutdoorsIdaho. com, through the Idaho Fish and Game mobile apps for IOS and Android, or by phone at (800) 554-8685. They can also be bought in person at license vendor locations, or Fish and Game regional offices during normal business hours.

Expect long waits and popular tags to sell out fast

Demand for tags is expected to be extremely high. Hunters should expect long waits to buy tags and possible system slowness. We ask that hunters be patient and don't panic if there is a slow-down in the sales system. Fish and Game staff will monitor the sale and work as quickly as possible to resolve any issues that may arise.

If updates regarding the sale are necessary, staff will post information on our social media channels, including Facebook, X (Twitter), Instagram, and Threads, or through our nonresident email distribution list. Be sure to follow Fish and Game on social media and sign up for nonresident emails before the

How to prepare before the sale

To prepare for the 2024 license and tag sale, we suggest all nonresident hunters:

- · Review the Big Game regulations on Fish and Game's website at idfg.idaho.gov/rules/big-game. Hunters should know the deer Game Management Unit and/or Elk Management Zone for the tags they want to buy.
- Review the number of tags available for the unit/ zone wanted, and have back-up options if the first choice is sold out.
- · Deer hunters must select whether they want a regular deer tag or a white-tailed deer tag, which affects the season length in some units. See "Deer General Seasons" in the 2024 Big Game Seasons and Rules booklet.
- · Hunters buying online must create and/or log into their account to purchase a deer and/or elk tag. We encourage hunters to create and review accounts prior to Dec. 1 to ensure all information on the account, such as Hunter Education and mailing address, is up to date.
- Hunters born after 1974 must have proof of hunter education certification on file prior to purchasing a hunting license and tags. Archery hunters must also prove their archery certification.
- Do not buy hunting licenses in advance of the sale, and instead, plan to purchase your license when you buy tags. Remember that hunting licenses are nonrefundable.

What you need to know for Dec. 1

If purchasing a deer or elk tag on Dec. 1 online, or through the mobile app, a virtual waiting room will open before 10 a.m. The virtual waiting room uses browser cookies to keep your place in line. We strongly encourage all hunters to enable cookies on their browser settings and do not use privacy mode so you won't lose your place in line. (For more details about cookies and browser settings, see the bottom of the page.)

Hunters are also encouraged to only log into the virtual waiting room through one device and plan to stay on that device throughout their transaction. Logging in through multiple devices can lead to system slow downs and does not create any advantage since only one place is line can be used to purchase tags.

At 10 a.m. MST, each person logged into the virtual waiting room will be randomly assigned a place in line to buy a license and a deer and/or elk tag. Hunters should plan to stay on their device while waiting

for their place in line, and avoid using multiple devices or leaving the waiting room.

After the hunter reaches the front of the line, they need to log into their GoOutdoorsIdaho.com account within 15 minutes by entering the required information on the login screen. Once logged into their account, the hunter should click "Buy a License, Permit, or Tag" in the upper left of the customer account home page to be directed to the list of items to purchase. A hunting license can be added to the cart when you're buying the tag.

For those looking to purchase for multiple people, each person needs to log in on a separate device.

After a tag is selected and added to the shopping cart, the buyer has 30 minutes to complete the transaction. If the transaction is not completed within 30 minutes, that tag may be removed from the shopping cart and made available to other hunters.

Due to high sales volumes, customers may not get a purchase confirmation email for 12 to 24 hours. Tags will be mailed within 15 business days.

Expect tag quantities to change rapidly during the

There will be no real-time tally of how many tags remain available for each deer hunting unit and elk zone. Fish and Game staff will post when zones and units are completely sold out on the virtual waiting room page, but as tags are added and removed from shopping carts across all sales locations, available quantities of tags will quickly change. Quantities displayed to hunters when selecting a tag during the checkout process are the most up-to-date numbers. Fish and Game's website will have limited information available during the sale.

Don't panic buy

Buyers are reminded to make sure they know what hunting unit/elk zone they're buying as well as the species, season dates, and weapon type for which the tag is valid. Tags may be refunded at a discount, or exchanged if other tags are available during future sales, but the license and other fees are nonrefundable.

Disabled American Veterans (DAV) nonresident deer and elk tags

There will be 500 nonresident DAV deer tags and 300 nonresident DAV elk tags available at discounted prices at 10 a.m. MST on Dec. 1. These tags will sell fast, and after these discounted tags are gone, nonresident DAV hunters can still buy available tags, but at full nonresident prices.

Disabled American Veterans must be at least 40 percent service-connected disability to buy discounted tags, and they must submit the required DAV certification documents to Fish and Game before Dec. 1 so that there is time for the buyer's profile to be reviewed and updated with DAV status. Any DAV certification documentation submitted to Fish and Game after Nov. 27 may not be reviewed in time for the Dec. 1 sale.

Idaho lifetime license holders must wait to buy tags

Nonresidents with Idaho lifetime hunting licenses cannot buy deer and elk tags during this sale. They can buy tags during the 2024 resident tag sales period, and are not subject to the nonresident tag limits.

Junior mentored hunters

Nonresident junior mentored hunters planning to hunt in a capped elk zone should try to buy capped zone tags on Dec. 1 because they will likely sell out fast. Reminder that all junior mentored hunters must be accompanied by an adult 18-years or older who holds a license and tag that is valid for the same species as the youth hunter.

Cookies and browsers

Your browser cookie settings should be set to "allow" and you should avoid using Privacy Mode (i.e., Incognito or Privacy Browsing) or system settings/ software that automatically deletes your search and/ or cookie history. Not allowing cookies or using Privacy Mode could result in losing your place online, and Fish and Game cannot adjust your spot as a result. For app users, verify you have the latest Go Outdoors Idaho app version downloaded on your smartphone. If you are unsure, open your preferred app store, and at the top right, tap the profile icon. Apps with an update available are labeled "Update available."


