

Muzzleloader Heritage **Season Opens Soon**

— Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks —

HELENA – Muzzleloader heritage season opens on Saturday, Dec. 13, and runs through Sunday, Dec. 21. This season is for heritage muzzleloaders only; no other means of taking game, such as archery, is allowed. Note that some areas have elk shoulder seasons through Feb. 15, where firearms and archery equipment may be allowed.

Hunters should also note that many of Montana's Block Management Areas (BMAs), even though they are open for upland bird or waterfowl through Jan. 1, do not allow deer or elk hunting during the muzzleloader heritage season. Make sure to check BMA rules before you hunt.

In addition, although some Wildlife Management Areas (WMAs) are open year-round, many other WMAs are closed through May 15. If you are planning to hunt on a WMA, see a list of WMAs and their seasonal closure dates here.

Hunters should check the hunting regulations to make sure they are compliant with all rules and regulations for this season. Hunters should also be aware that trapping seasons are open in several districts.


Keep vigilant with grizzly bear awareness

Bears are still active in certain areas. All bears are potentially dangerous. Hunters should be prepared to encounter a bear. Here are some tips to keep in mind:

- Stay alert and look for bear activity, especially where visibility or hearing is limited (woods, bushy areas, streams).
- Travel in a group and keep members together (especially kids).
- · Make noise whenever possible to avoid surprising a bear, especially where visibility or hearing is limited.
- Carry bear spray close at hand and know how to use it.
- · Avoid traveling at night, dawn or dusk.
- carcass Avoid sites and scavenger concentrations.


The Idaho Department of Fish and Game stocks an eye-popping total of more than 30-million hatchery fish into Idaho waters each year. Stocking by the Department has been ongoing in one form or another for over a century. The number of species and strains can vary from year to year, but generally, stocking is primarily made up of 16 different species of trout and salmon. The Department uses all kinds of transportation to get fish to their final destination – including bikes, planes, and llamas.



Typically, fish are stocked from hatchery vehicles ranging in size from pick-up trucks outfitted with small fish tanks all the way up to semi-trucks capable of transporting millions of fish at a time. Staff take into consideration road and trail access, trail use restrictions, past stocking records, the species, size, and number of fish planning to be stocked, time of year, weather conditions, personnel availability, and cost before deciding how and when to stock fish in each location. At locations where staff are unable to access the waterbody with a hatchery truck, we have a variety of alternative fish-stocking methods available.



Since the 1940s, the Department has utilized fixedwing aircraft to stock alpine lakes. As the pilot flies over the lake, a passenger in the plane releases fish with water out of the bottom of the plane. For remote lakes that are surrounded by challenging terrain including mountain ranges and trees, helicopters can be used. These helicopters are equipped with a specialized bucket that hangs below the helicopter from a cable, enabling the pilot to open and close the bottom of the bucket. This set-up allows the pilot to lower the bucket into the lake to collect water, fly to a landing site where staff can load the bucket with fish, and then return to the lake to release the fish by opening the bucket just above the water's surface.



In certain situations, ATVs, bikes, backpacks, or even pack animals are used. Fish are loaded into coolers or buckets that are filled with water and equipped with portable aerators, or they are placed into bags full of oxygen and water. These fish are then driven or packed to their destination. It's never a dull day when stocking fish in Idaho's backcountry.





The stocking program is made possible by our committed hatchery personnel who spawn, rear, and stock fish year-round. Depending on the waterbody, fish are stocked as fertilized eggs, fry (0-3 inches), fingerling (3-6 inches), sub-catchable (6-10 inches), or catchable (greater than 10 inches) size. While some stocking efforts aim to support conservation and population restoration or research efforts, that vast majority is to provide you, the angler, with more recreational fishing opportunities.



Smoked Prime Rib

Cook time: 4 hours

Servings: 30

- 6-8 pounds prime rib
- 2 tablespoons kosher salt
- · 2 tablespoons coarse ground black pepper
- · vegetable oil spray
- 1. Season prime rib generously with salt and
- 2. Lightly coat grill grates with vegetable oil spray. Close cooking chamber lid.
- Place 3-5 pounds charcoal in center of firebox. Open firebox air vent approximately 1-2 inches and smokestack damper halfway. With firebox lid open, stand back, carefully light charcoal and burn until covered with light ash, approximately 20 minutes.

- 4. Once coals ash over, add wood chunks. Do not shut firebox lid until smoke is clean, often called "blue smoke."
- 5. Close firebox lid. Adjust firebox air vent and smokestack damper to regulate cooking temperature until it reaches ideal smoking temperature between 325-350 F.
- Place prime rib on cooking grate in cooking 6. chamber. Maintain consistent cooking temperature by adding wood chunks as needed. Monitor internal temperature of prime rib throughout cooking process. Smoke 3-4 hours; rotate and flip every hour.
- 7. Remove roast when meat thermometer registers 135 F for medium-rare; 145 F for medium.
- Transfer roast to carving board; tent loosely with aluminum foil. Let stand 15-20 minutes. Temperature will continue to rise 10-15 F to reach 145 F for medium-rare; 160 F for medium.



Prime Rib Pasta with Broccoli and Cheese

Cook time: 10 minutes

Servings: 2

- · 6 tablespoons butter, divided
- 1 pound cooked leftover prime rib, cut into 1/2inch pieces
- 1 tablespoon minced garlic
- 1 pound penne pasta, cooked
- · 1 pound broccoli, blanched
- 1/2 cup julienned sun-dried tomatoes
- 1/2 cup cherry tomatoes, halved
- 1/2 cup beef broth
- 1 teaspoon salt
- · 1 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper
- 1/4 cup fresh lemon juice
- 1 tablespoon white truffle oil
- 1/2 cup shredded Parmesan cheese
- 1/4 cup chopped fresh parsley
- 1. Preheat large skillet over medium heat until hot. Add 2 tablespoons butter. When melted, add leftover prime rib; cook 3-5 minutes, or until lightly browned.
- 2. Add garlic and cook 1-2 minutes, or until fragrant. Stir in cooked pasta, broccoli, tomatoes and remaining butter. Add broth, salt and pepper. Cook 2-3 minutes, or until warmed through. Drizzle with lemon juice and truffle oil; sprinkle with cheese and parsley before serving.

Cooking tip: Drizzle with extra truffle oil before serving to enhance aroma.



Did you know that a stay-at-home mother created a cake recipe that won \$25,000? Back then, that was enough to purchase a 2000 sq. ft. house in La Jolla, California, where the winner lived with her husband and their two young boys.

Back in 1951, Pillsbury held their 3rd Grand National Recipe and Baking Contest, and first prize went to Mrs. Samual P. (Helen) Weston for her innovative idea of adding half of the chocolate frosting to the cake batter before baking it.

The best part, in my opinion? It's actually quite simple to recreate and doesn't require any fancy hard-to-obtain ingredients or appliances.

Now of course, being that the contest was held by Pillsbury, the recipe calls for their particular brand of enriched flour, and while I haven't tried it without, I'm sure any all-purpose flour would do just fine.

The ingredients are listed below, followed by the recipe as it appeared in the recipe book that was released following the awards.

Starlight Double-Delight Cake

Ingredients (room temperature)

6 oz. cream cheese

½ cup shortening (for frosting)

½ cup shortening (for cake)

 $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon vanilla extract

½ teaspoon peppermint extract

 $6\ cups$ (pound and half) sifted confectioners' sugar

¼ cup hot water

4 oz. melted chocolate, milk or semi-sweet

24 cups sifted Pillsbury's Best enriched flour

1½ teaspoons baking soda

1 teaspoon salt

3 eggs

34 cup milk

Bake at 350° F for 30-40 minutes. Makes two 9-inch round layers. All ingredients should be at room temperature.

Frosting

Cream: 2 packages (3 oz. size) cream cheese

½ cup shortening

½ teaspoon vanilla

½ teaspoon mint flavoring or 2-3 drops of peppermint. Blend well. (If desired, mint flavoring may be omitted and vanilla increased to 1 teaspoon.)

Measure: 6 cups (1 $\frac{1}{2}$ lbs.) sifted confectioners' sugar. Blend half of sugar into cream cheese mixture. Add $\frac{1}{4}$ hot water alternately with balance of sugar.

Blend in: 4 squares (4 oz.) chocolate, melted. Mix until smooth.

<u>Cake</u>

Combine: ¼ additional shortening and 2 cups of the chocolate frosting mixture; mix thoroughly.

Blend in: 3 eggs, one at a time. Beat for 1 minute.

Sift together: 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ cups sifted "Pillsbury Best En riched Flour", 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon soda, and 1 teaspoon salt.

Measure: ¾ cup milk; add alternately with dry ingredients to creamed mixture, beginning and ending with dry ingredients. Blend thoroughly after each addition. (With electric mixer use low speed.)

Pour: into 2 well-greased and lightly floured 9-inch round layer pans, at least 1 ¼ inches deep.

Bake: in moderate oven (350° F) 30 to 40 minutes. Cool; frost with remaining chocolate frosting.

* If desired, cake may be baked in 13x9x2-inch pan for 45 to 55 minutes. If you use Pillsbury's Best Enriched Self-Rising Flour, omit the baking soda and salt.





Have you ever had this candy? It goes by lots of names. Growing up in Oregon, we'd visit a candy shop in Cannon Beach that called it "seafoam." My British mother called it "cinder toffee." I've heard sponge toffee, golden crunchers, hokey pokey, fairy food, but "honeycomb candy" seems to be the most official moniker.

If you've ever watched honeycomb bubble up like a magic trick and thought, "Oh no, that looks dangerous, I'll need adult supervision," you're not alone. This humble confection has a reputation for being fussy, fiery and fit only for professional chocolatiers wearing Kevlar gloves.

But here's the truth: Honeycomb is gloriously simple, ridiculously inexpensive and one of the most impressive homemade holiday gifts you can whip up with nothing more than sugar, baking soda and 10 brave minutes.

Let's walk through it together so you can make a batch with confidence, and maybe show off a little.

What Is Honeycomb, Exactly?

Honeycomb candy is a sweet, light-as-air caramel that expands dramatically when baking soda hits molten sugar. It tastes like caramel clouds with a satisfying shatter, and once you dip it in chocolate, you've created the world's cheapest fancy-pants gourmet gift.

Why This Candy Scares People (and Why It Shouldn't)

The fear comes from two things:

Sugar gets very hot (300 F -- the "hard crack" stage). And the moment you add baking soda, it erupts like a volcano. Cool, right?

But with the right setup and a little focus, everything stays controlled and delightful. Honeycomb is one of those recipes where organization matters more than skill. If you can make toast without burning the house down, vou can make this.

Have these things ready to go before you begin.

- * Baking soda, measured and ready
- * A large pot (the mixture will triple in size)
- * A parchment-lined pan
- * A heatproof spatula
- * A candy thermometer

Once the syrup hits 300° F, it keeps climbing -- so you'll be moving quickly.



Crunchy, golden honeycomb candy looks fancy but comes together in minutes.

Homemade Honeycomb Candy

Yield: 1 (8x8) pan

Total Time: 20 minutes

1/3 cup water

1 cup sugar

1/3 cup light corn syrup (or honey or maple syrup)

2½ teaspoons baking soda

1/4 teaspoon cream of tartar

Chocolate for dipping (optional but encouraged)

Line an 8-by-8-inch pan with parchment paper. Pre-measure your baking soda mixed with cream of tartar, and keep them nearby.

Combine water, sugar and corn syrup in a medium saucepan over medium heat, stirring just until combined. Once it bubbles, stop stirring. Attach a candy thermometer and let it boil, undisturbed, to

Remove from heat and quickly stir in baking soda, it will foam dramatically. Stir just until incorporated, then immediately pour into your prepared pan.

Let cool completely (about an hour). Break into pieces. Optional: dip or drizzle with melted chocolate. The recipe can be doubled to yield a 9-by-13-inch pan.

Tips for Success. Don't refrigerate; it gets sticky. Store airtight to keep it crisp. Chocolate coating helps it last longer. And, of course: Don't touch hot sugar.





By reporting tagged fish, you help Fish and Game better understand catch rates, harvest and survival—all critical to improving the fishery.

Some tags also carry a \$100 reward, so this winter could be your lucky year.

If you catch a tagged burbot, please report the tag number and catch location to Fish and Game online or through your Angler Science Program creel packet.



A brief history lesson of burbot on the Kootenai River

For some, winter is a time to settle in by the fire. For others, it's the perfect season to chase the native—and once rare—burbot of the Kootenai River.

Nicknamed the Kootenai leopard or ling cod, bur-



bot virtually disappeared from the fishery by the early 1990s. Due to declining populations, burbot fishing on the Kootenai River was closed in 1992. Thanks to the hard work of the Kootenai Tribe of Idaho, Idaho Fish and Game and other partners, the population rebounded, and the river reopened to burbot fishing in January 2019.

Because the fishery is still relatively new, Fish and Game carefully monitors burbot each winter from December through March. Angler participation provides an essential boost to those efforts.







Holiday Biscotti: Beautiful, Giftable and Surprisingly Simple

If the holiday season had a signature cookie, biscotti wouldn't be it. However, it would be this cookie's elegant cousin who shows up beautifully dressed, stays cheerful for weeks and never crumbles under pressure. These crisp Italian cookies are made for gifting, packing, mailing, dunking and showing off, all while looking like you spent far more effort than you did

They're sturdy enough to ship across the country, pretty enough for a cookie plate and wonderfully adaptable. Once you have the simple base recipe, you can flavor them in many ways. Tuck a few into a basket with some coffee or tea, a pretty tea towel and a thrifted mug, and you've got a gift that feels thoughtful and homemade without breaking the bank.

This year, I'm sharing my base biscotti recipe plus several festive variations, each one perfect for adding a little sparkle to your holiday baking.

HOLIDAY BISCOTTI

Yield: 20-24 servings

*Total Time: 55 minutes + cooling*For the base dough:

4 tablespoons unsalted butter, softened

3/4 cup granulated sugar

2 large eggs

1 to 2 teaspoons extract (see flavor variations)

2 cups all-purpose flour, or half all-purpose + half whole wheat

1 teaspoon baking powder

1/2 teaspoon salt

Add-ins as per flavor variation

Heat oven to 350 F. Line a baking sheet with parchment.

Beat butter and sugar until creamy. Add eggs and extract; mix well. In another bowl, whisk flour, baking powder and salt. Gradually add to wet mixture until combined. Stir in flavor addins, if using.

Divide dough in half. Shape into two 8-inch logs and flatten to 3/4 inch thick. Wet hands help if dough is sticky. Sprinkle with coarse sugar if desired.

Bake 20-25 minutes, until lightly golden and firm to the touch. Cool on the pan for 15 minutes.

Slice logs diagonally into 3/4-inch slices. Lay cut side up on the sheet and bake 12-16 minutes, until dry. Cool completely.

Flavor Variations

Classic Vanilla-Almond: 1 1/2 teaspoons vanilla + 1/2 teaspoon almond extract. Add 3/4 cup sliced almonds.

Cherry-Almond (pictured): 1 teaspoon almond + 1 teaspoon vanilla. Add 1/2 cup dried cherries, 1/2 cup sliced almonds. Sprinkle tops with decorating sugar before baking.

Triple Chocolate: 1 teaspoon vanilla, reduce flour by 1/4 cup, add 1/4 cup cocoa powder. Stir in 1 cup mini chocolate chips

+ 1/2 cup nuts of choice. Dip in chocolate.

Cranberry-Orange-Pistachio: Add 1 teaspoon vanilla + 1 teaspoon orange extract Add-ins: 1/2 cup dried cranberries, 1/2 cup chopped pistachios and zest of an orange. Dip ends in white chocolate and sprinkle with more orange zest.

Dark Chocolate-Orange-Hazelnut (pictured): Add 1 teaspoon vanilla + 1 teaspoon orange extracts. Add-ins: 1/2 cup chopped hazelnuts, 1/2 cup mini dark chocolate chips and zest of an orange. Dip the ends in dark chocolate and sprinkle with chopped hazelnuts.

Peppermint Mocha (pictured): Add 1 teaspoon vanilla + 1 teaspoon peppermint. Reduce flour by 1/4 cup and add 1/4 cup cocoa powder, 1 teaspoon espresso powder, 1/2 cup mini chocolate chips. Dip one side in chocolate and sprinkle with crushed candy canes.

Ginger Spice (pictured): Add 1 teaspoon vanilla. Add-ins: 2 teaspoons ginger + 2 teaspoons cinnamon + 1/4 teaspoon cloves + 1/4 cup chopped candied ginger. Optional: Drizzle with glaze made from powdered sugar + maple syrup.

Whichever flavor you choose, biscotti are the kind of homemade gifts that feel thoughtful without demanding hours in the kitchen. Bake a batch, share with friends and enjoy a little holiday magic.





Baked Alaska Citrus

Greet the new year with a showy, wintry dessert your family will ooh and ahh over. It's a take on traditional Baked Alaska that you may have enjoyed at a fancy restaurant. This mini version is much easier, using fresh grapefruit in its own "bowl" instead of cake, but still keeps the wow factor with billowing warm meringue on top and chilly ice cream nestled inside.

Timing is everything. Do some simple prep work beforehand. Then, as the table is being cleared after your main course, preheat the oven and whip the egg whites while your child spoons fruit into the grapefruit bowls and tops each one with ice cream and mounds of sweet meringue.

GRAPEFRUIT BAKED ALASKA

- 4 grapefruits
- 6 scoops vanilla ice cream
- 3 egg whites (1/2 cup) at room temperature
- 1/4 teaspoon cream of tartar
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract

One hour or more before serving:

- 1. Prepare grapefruit by cutting evenly in half crosswise. Use a grapefruit knife to cut out fruit sections. Place in a bowl and drain juice (enjoy drinking it for a snack). If grapefruit is rather tart, add some sugar. Cover and refrigerate.
- 2. Remove and discard membranes in six of the halves to form hollow "bowls," and discard the two remaining grapefruit halves. (You are using 6 halves

for the dessert, but the fruit from 4 grapefruits to have ample servings.)

3. Pre-scoop ice cream in six rounds on a tray lined with wax paper or plastic wrap. Place back in freezer.

15 minutes before serving:


- 4. Heat oven to 400 degrees. Line baking sheet with parchment paper or foil. Ask one of your kids to spoon the refrigerated grapefruit pieces evenly into the six grapefruit "bowls" and set them on the baking sheet.
- 5. In a mixing bowl, beat the egg whites until frothy and foamy with an electric mixer set at low speed. Add the cream of tartar. Increase speed until soft peaks form. Start adding the sugar slowly, a tablespoon at a time. Let your kids watch as the mixture changes and enlarges, and glossy, stiff peaks form.
- 6. Set an ice-cream round in the center of each fruit-filled bowl. Immediately spoon the glossy, stiff meringue on top and seal edges around the cut grapefruit rim with a butter knife. Bake in the middle of the oven for 5 minutes, or until meringue is golden.
- 7. Serve immediately on dessert plates.

Tip: For a special occasion such as New Year's Eve, top each one with a birthday candle and light.



Discussing Sinus Node Dysfunction and Its Symptoms/ Treatment

DEAR DR. ROACH: Last year at age 76, I was diagnosed with sinus node dysfunction after several episodes of what I'd call being "spaced out" (for lack of a better term). I couldn't explain these instances to myself, much less anyone else lest they think I was crazy, until I had one where I passed out. This scared me, and I told my husband, who immediately made a doctor's appointment.

The wise physician assistant sent me to a cardiologist who had me wear a heart monitor for two weeks. During this time, I had another episode that lasted for seven seconds, according to the very alarmed cardiologist. I was immediately scheduled for pacemaker surgery.

Could you please discuss sinus node dysfunction and enlighten me as to what caused it? -- G.W.T.

ANSWER: The sinus of your heart has nothing to do with your nose as you might guess; it's a structure in the right atrium where blood flows into the heart from the venae cavae. It contains a structure called the "sinus node" or "sinoatrial node" that serves as the natural pacemaker for the heart.

If the SA node makes an electrical impulse, but it is poorly conducted, this results in an SA block. The sinus node may be too slow (sinus bradycardia), or it may fail to make an impulse for a period of time or even permanently (sinus pauses and sinus arrest). All of these are included in the umbrella term of "sinus node dysfunction" (which used to be called "sick sinus syndrome" since it's accompanied by periods of a too-fast heart rate).

When the sinus node fails to provide an impulse, other pacemakers in the heart will usually provide an "escape" beat, which prevents the symptom of being "spaced out." Some people describe this as fatigue or lightheadedness. If there is no escape beat, then you will get a sinus pause as you did. When the sinus pause is very long, the person will often faint (which we term "syncope").

One of my fellow residents got a call from the attending cardiologist who was reading the heart monitor of a patient on the inpatient service and had found a sinus pause that lasted for 17 seconds. (I can still recall the cardiologist saying, "Good god, man! Is this patient still alive?" to the utter horror of my fellow resident, who literally ran to the patient's bedside. The patient was alive, fortunately.)

The placement of a permanent pacemaker is the definitive treatment for sinus node dysfunction, but not everyone needs this. It's also important to look for exacerbating factors (especially medicines but also thyroid disease, blockages of the heart arteries, liver disease, and low oxygen, among others) that can affect the sinus node.

These factors can make the disease of the sinus node become symptomatic due to fibrosis of the area around the SA node and its accompanying conduction tissue. Most of the time, no specific cause for sinus node dysfunction can be found, but systemic diseases like amyloidosis, sarcoidosis and hemochromatosis are rare causes of sinus node dysfunction.

DEAR DR. ROACH: When is a cough considered chronic? -- B.B.A.

ANSWER: We do have formal definitions. An acute cough is present for less than three weeks, and infections -- both viral (cold, flu, bronchitis) and bacterial (bronchitis, pneumonia) -- are the most common causes. A subacute cough is present for three to six weeks. Postinfectious irritability is a common cause. but asthma and chronic rhinitis are also common.

A chronic cough is present for longer than six weeks. There are many causes, but asthma, reflux disease (GERD), and postnasal drip are the most common. Medications (ACE inhibitors), eosinophilic bronchitis, and certain chronic infections (like pertussis or tuberculosis) should be considered as well.





- 1/8 teaspoon, plus 1 pinch, salt, divided, to taste
- 1/8 teaspoon, plus 1 pinch, pepper, divided, to
- 1 small bunch fresh cilantro
- 12 scallops with empty shells
- 1 tablespoon butter
- 1. Peel and cut one Florida Grapefruit into segments. Squeeze remaining grapefruit and reserve juice.
- Wash and finely chop fennel. In bowl, mix fennel with olive oil, sherry vinegar and 1 pinch salt and
- 3. Mix and add fresh cilantro. Keep a few leaves for garnish.
- 4. In hot frying pan, drizzle with olive oil then sear scallops 1 minute on each side.
- 5. Remove scallops from pan then deglaze with reserved Florida Grapefruit juice. Let it simmer slightly and add butter to make sauce. Add 1/8 teaspoon salt and pepper.

- 6. Place 1 tablespoon fennel salad in washed shell, top with three scallops and coat with grapefruit butter.
- 7. Finish with reserved cilantro leaves and fresh grapefruit segments.

Florida Citrus Vinaigrette:

- 1/3 cup Florida Grapefruit Juice
- 1/3 cup Florida Orange Juice
- 2 teaspoons orange zest
- 2 tablespoons cider vinegar
- 2 teaspoons honey
- 1 tablespoon Dijon mustard
- 1/3 cup olive oil
- 2 tablespoons shallots
- sea salt, to taste
- fresh pepper, to taste

Pickled Onion:

- 1 red onion, thinly sliced
- 1/2 cup white vinegar or cider vinegar
- 1/2 cup water
- 1 tablespoon sugar
- 1 teaspoon salt

Burrata Salad:

- 4 Florida Grapefruit, peeled and cut into segments
- 3 oranges, peeled and cut into segments
- 1 bunch radishes, sliced thin and cut into sticks
- 1/3 cup pistachios, grilled and coarsely chopped
- 1 cup arugula
- 2 tablespoons dill, chopped
- sea salt, to taste
- pepper, to taste
- 8 ounces burrata
- 1. To make vinaigrette: In small bowl, mix Florida Grapefruit Juice, Florida Orange Juice, orange zest, cider vinegar, honey, Dijon, olive oil and shallots until dressing is emulsified. Season with salt and pepper, to taste. Set aside. Vinaigrette will keep 7 days in refrigerator.
- 2. To make pickled onion: Place sliced onion in airtight canning jar.
- 3. In small saucepan, combine vinegar, water, sugar and salt. Bring to boil and pour over sliced onion in jar. Add small amount of water to completely cover onion. Refrigerate at least 2 hours before serving. Pickled onions will keep 15 days in refrigerator.
- 4. To make burrata salad: In bowl, combine Florida Grapefruit and Orange segments; add radish sticks, toasted pistachios, arugula and dill. Season with salt and pepper, to taste.
- 5. Place salad on large plate, top with coarsely chopped burrata and drizzle generously with citrus vinaigrette and pickled onion.
