

The comment period is open until Dec. 7th.

Idaho Fish and Game will be setting the new seasons for upland game, turkey, and furbearers for 2026-2027 in January 2026. Members of the public are highly encouraged to review the proposed seasons and changes and weigh in with their own comments. The comment period is open until Dec. 7th, 2025 at 6pm MST.

Fish and Game staff will also host a series of open houses at Fish and Game regional offices between Dec. 1st-7th. For a full list of upcoming open houses, scroll to the bottom of this article.

Season proposals are broken down by regions, making it simpler for folks to check out proposals specific to their neck of the woods. Department proposals will be presented to the Fish and Game Commission for their consideration at their January 2026 meeting at the Fish and Game Headquarters Office in Boise.

Christmas Card Day December 9th

— National Day Calendar —



Each year around this time, friends and families begin mailing their holiday cards. Christmas Card Day on December 9th serves as a reminder to get your stamps, envelopes, and cards together so you can share your holiday cheer.

Sending a card during the holidays hasn't always been a tradition. In Victorian England, sending Penny Post was inexpensive and frequent. It was also considered rude to ignore a written message. One particularly popular Victorian invented the holiday card out of necessity. Sir Henry Cole received frequent letters, and it left him little time for other responsibilities. In 1843, he asked his friend J.C. Horsley to illustrate a design he had in mind. Soon, Cole was off to the printer, and he mailed the first Christmas card in the Penny Post to friends, family, and many acquaintances.

Today, we mail a variety of cards at Christmastime. The tradition of Christmas cards continues in a broader sense. Social and electronic media keep us connected in this modern world more than ever before. However, the Christmas card continues to be a part of our annual tradition, even if it takes on a different style or pattern.

- · Photo cards Many families take an annual holiday photo specifically for mailing to friends and family. These photos may be snapshots or professional photos. Most families save them from social media, so they remain a surprise when they arrive in the mail, too.
- Christmas letter These letters often highlight the events for each family member for the year. Not everyone has social media, so it's a nice way to catch up with friends and family. The letters usually run a page in length, but some letter writers have a lot more to say.

NATIONAL CHRISTMAS CARD DAY HISTORY

While the origins of Christmas Card Day continue to be researched, Sir Henry Cole does receive credit for creating the first Christmas Card in 1843. However, the idea took several years to find its way to the United States. In 1850, Louis Prang immigrated from Prussia and opened a print shop in Boston. He mastered many methods of lithography from around the world, and after encouragement from his wife, he began producing floral Christmas cards in 1875.

Christmas Card FAQ

Q. When was the first Christmas stamp issued?

A. The United States Post Office issued its first Christmas Stamp on November 1, 1962. Jim Crawford designed the 4¢ stamp that featured a green wreath and two candles. "Christmas 1962" was written across the bottom on a red banner.

Q. How much does it cost to mail a Christmas card?

A. First-class stamps for a 1-ounce letter cost 58¢.

Lentil soup is one of those beautiful, budget-friendly meals that has been feeding families for centuries and checks every box: It's inexpensive, easy to prepare and full of plant-based protein and fiber. It freezes beautifully, too, which makes it a lifesaver during the upcoming holiday madness. Make a big pot now, freeze some for later, and you've got instant comfort waiting in your freezer -no drive-thru required.

This base recipe is delicious asis, but the beauty of lentils is how easily they adapt. Add a handful of sausage if you like, stir in extra veggies or season it with herbs and spices to change the flavor profile from classic to global. You'll find a few of my favorite variations below -- because even comfort food deserves a little variety.

VERY VERSATILE LENTIL SOUP

- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1 medium onion, diced
- 4 carrots, chopped
- 3 celery ribs, chopped
- 3-4 cloves garlic, minced

6 cups broth (vegetable, chicken or beef)

- 1 1/2 cups dry green or brown lentils
- 1 (14.5 ounce) can diced tomatoes with juices
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon black pepper
- 2 cups fresh chopped spinach, optional

Stovetop Method: In a large pot, saute onion, carrot and celery in olive oil until softened, about 5 minutes. Add garlic and cook for one minute more. Stir in lentils, tomatoes, broth, salt and pepper. Bring to a boil, then reduce heat and simmer, covered, for about 35 minutes or until lentils are tender. Stir in spinach until wilted. Taste and adjust seasoning.

Slow Cooker: Combine all ingredients (except spinach) and cook on Low for 6-8 hours. Stir in spinach at the end.

Optional Add-Ins for Variety

Smoky Sausage: Saute 1 (13 ounce) smoked sausage (like kielbasa) with the vegetables. Add 1/2 teaspoon smoked paprika and 1/4 teaspoon dried thyme.



English Christmas

With its rings of holly branches, this majolica platter carries the spirit of Christmas. And with its \$7,735 sale price at Strawser Auction Group, it's certainly something to celebrate! But a closer look shows its symbols are a little different from the decorations most of us may be used to.

The birds around the rim are robins; not something you often see on American Christmas decorations, but very popular in the United Kingdom. Robins are often seen there in the winter because they migrate there from Scandinavia and Continental Europe.

Then there are the portrait medallions of a white-bearded man who looks a little, but not entirely, like Santa Claus. Instead of a red suit with a matching fur-trimmed hat, he wears a brown robe, carries a staff and is crowned with a wreath of holly.

This must be Father Christmas, the English personification of the holiday's festivities. He dates to at least the 15th century and may be influenced by the folkloric figure of the Holly King of winter, whose perpetual battle with the Oak King of summer (who is sometimes represented by a robin) dramatizes the cycle of seasons. As you may have guessed, this platter is an English piece. It was made by George Jones, one of the most celebrated makers of Victorian majolica.

I found a silver link bracelet in my aunt's jewelry box after her death at age 93 in 2002, so I believe it's old and would like some idea of its value. I took it to a jeweler who used a loupe to look at the mark on the underside of the clasp. She said it read "JB" over "830S."

The first clue to the bracelet's value is the "830S." That is the silver content, meaning it is 83% silver and 17% alloy of other metals. The standard for sterling silver is 925, meaning 92.5% silver. While not sterling silver, 830 silver still has a relatively high silver content, and its higher percentage of alloy means it is more durable than 925 silver. The "JB" mark was used by John Baalerund, whose

business operated from 1935 to 1988 in Oslo, Norway. He was known for his enameled silver jewelry. Silver jewelry by Scandinavian designers was extremely popular in the mid-20th century. Today, 830S silver bracelets from that period generally sell for about \$50 to \$150.

TIP: Candle drippings can be removed from fabric with the help of ice cubes. Rub the wax with the ice until the wax hardens. Scrape off the hard wax with a credit card or stiff cardboard. If some wax remains, put a blotter over it, and then iron with a warm iron.



Breaking Down the Difference Between a Cold and Influenza

DEAR DR. ROACH: What is the difference between a cold and the flu? -- A.T.R.

ANSWER: Both colds and influenza (the "flu") are respiratory illnesses that are caused by viruses. Influenza is caused specifically by the influenza viruses, which come in two main types (A and B). Influenza A is further broken down into different subtypes based on hemagglutinin (H) and neuraminidase (N).

H1N1 and H3N2 are currently the most-common circulating influenza A viruses. Even within these subclasses, there is strong variability among flu viruses, which is one reason why we need a new flu vaccine each year.

Many viruses cause colds. Rhinoviruses ("rhino-" is the Greek word for nose) are the most common, but corona-, parainfluenza- and enteroviruses, as well as respiratory syncytial viruses, are all wellknown causes of respiratory illnesses, which can be difficult or impossible to tell apart from any other type of cold.

Unfortunately, there are so many of these viruses, some of which change quickly and others that escape our immune system, so it is (so far) impossible to get immunity by an infection or a vaccine to all the cold viruses. Viruses are generally less severe than

It isn't always easy to tell flu from a cold, especially in young people. Both can cause a fever, cough, runny nose and sore throat. However, the flu often causes muscle aches, which can be severe. The flu tends to cause higher fevers, more cough and worse headaches, and it often comes along suddenly. ("I got hit by the flu truck.") Runny nose and nasal congestion tends to be worse with a cold.

Since there is specific antiviral treatments for influenza, clinicians will sometimes make decisions on whether to treat a person based on their symptoms, or they may get a lab test to look for the flu specifically. (Some tests will also check for COVID-19, a special type of coronavirus, at the same time.)

People who are at a high risk for severe flu may be recommended antiviral treatment, whereas there is not a specific antiviral treatment for colds. It's particularly important for people over 65 and those with any heart, lung or immune system issues to get the influenza vaccine. The optimum time to get it was from October through the end of November.

DEAR DR. ROACH: What do we now call what was once referred to as a "nervous breakdown" in the 20th century? -- A.M.

ANSWER: I asked this question to my psychiatry professor way back in the late 20th century when I was a first-year medical student. My professor replied that the term didn't have a meaning anymore. There is no formal medical or psychiatric diagnosis of a "nervous breakdown." The term is used by laypeople to describe when a person has severe impairment of their day-to-day function as a result of a psychiatric diagnosis, especially mood disorders like generalized anxiety disorder or major depressive disorder.

An adjustment disorder may resemble a major depressive disorder, but it occurs within a few months of a traumatic life event. A severe case might also be termed a "nervous breakdown." It is not usually used to describe a person with acute psychosis (a term meaning a grossly distorted sense of reality), such as a person with schizophrenia or bipolar affective disorder in their acute and uncontrolled state.

All these conditions have effective treatments. Treatment starts by talking to someone, who might be your own regular doctor or a mental health professional. For people who are in acute distress with thoughts of hurting themselves, the 988 Suicide and Crisis Lifeline is an option in the United States and



Archery Hunters OK After Grizzly Bear Encounters In Taylor Fork

Bears remain active during fall hunting seasons

— Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks —

BIG SKY – Fortunately, three archery hunters are uninjured after two recent encounters with grizzly bears in the Taylor Fork south of Big Sky.

The first encounter involved two hunters on Sept. 29. They were hunting in the vicinity of a known elk carcass when they saw a grizzly bear. To make their presence known, the hunters yelled at the bear. The bear reportedly came toward the hunters, and they each fired once with handguns. Both the bear and the hunters left the site without further incident.

Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks staff learned of the encounter on Oct. 1, and after interviewing the hunters, determined it was unlikely the bear was

On Oct. 3, a lone hunter reportedly encountered a grizzly bear at close range. The bear charged, and the hunter deployed bear spray, which stopped the charge. The hunter left the area and reported the incident to FWP.

Be bear aware

Fall hunting seasons overlap with when bears are actively preparing for hibernation. Some areas with dense concentrations of grizzly bears are very accessible to hunters, especially during the archery season. Bears will continue to be active during other hunting seasons this fall.

Montana is bear country. Avoiding conflicts with bears is far better than dealing with conflicts. Here are some precautions to help hunters avoid negative bear encounters:

- · Carry bear spray and be prepared to use it immediately.
- · Watch for and be extra cautious around bear sign, creeks and areas with limited visibility. Most attacks happen in surprise, close encounters.
- · Stay away from animal carcasses, which often attract bears.
- Hunt with a group of people. This can help you make localized noise to alert bears to your presence, and it may also increase your chances of survival in the event of a bear attack.
- Be aware that elk calls and cover scents can attract bears.
- Bring the equipment and people needed to help field dress game and remove the meat from the kill site quickly.
- · If you need to leave part of the meat in the field during retrieval, hang it at least 10 feet off the ground, if possible, and at least 100 yards from the gut pile. Leave it in an open area where it can be observed from a distance of at least 200
- · Upon your return, observe the meat with binoculars. Make noise while approaching the meat. If it has been disturbed or if a bear is in the area, leave and call FWP.
- Follow food storage orders from the applicable land management agency.

Northwest Montana Hunters See Steady Harvest Through Second Weekend Of General Season

— Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks –

FORT PECK- Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks Fort Peck fisheries and hatchery staff wrapped up the annual Chinook salmon egg-taking efforts this past week. A total of 895,131 Chinook eggs were collected, which filled all available egg incubation jars and space at the Fort Peck Multispecies Fish Hatchery.

The average size of Chinook salmon females collected was an impressive 15.1 pounds. In comparison, in 2024, females averaged 18.9 pounds. The difference in weight can be attributed to the abundance of younger Chinook salmon collected in 2025. Age analysis for the salmon captured this fall still must be completed, but it seems that a majority were age three. In 2024, 92 percent of the females captured and used during the spawning process were age four salmon. The large fish this year resulted in an average of 2.60 pounds of eggs per female. These healthy females produced an average of 4,662 eggs per female, which is slightly down from the 4,708 eggs per female, seen in 2024.

Barring any major setbacks at the hatchery, the number of eggs collected in 2025 should be more than enough to ensure at least 200,000 fingerlings will be stocked back into Fort Peck Reservoir in the spring of 2026. The Fort Peck Fisheries Management Plan calls for a minimum of 200,000 fingerlings be stocked annually, but this number can increase depending on egg and fingerling survival.

Water quality and quantity issues at the Fort Peck Hatchery limit the number of salmon that can be produced on any given year. FWP is working to alleviate the water shortage and sediment issues by working with the US Army Corps of Engineers on a new water delivery system. This new line would deliver cold, clean water from the Fort Peck dam penstocks and provide more water for hatchery use, allowing the hatchery to possibly utilize more space and raise more and larger fish. This project will also reduce the sediment load entering the hatchery (water is currently pumped from the Dredge Cut Ponds), that is detrimental to fish egg and fish fry survivability.

Last year, a total of 842,709 chinook eggs were collected and 232,369 Chinook were stocked back into Fort Peck Reservoir in the spring of 2025. Many anglers assume that the more salmon stocked, the greater number will be available to anglers in future years. Although this is important, the number of cisco (the primary forage fish of salmon) that hatch in the spring during salmon stocking appears to be one of the main drivers to salmon survival and success over the ensuing years. For example, a very large year class of cisco hatched in 2023 that resulted in some excellent growth and survival for the salmon stocked that year. Those are the same salmon that were caught this past summer and fall by anglers. Unfortunately, cisco recruitment (i.e., spawning and hatching success) since 2023 has been very low, which may have negatively impacted Chinook survival in those years.

Early data analysis indicates that the numbers of smaller, two-year-old salmon caught in 2025 were lower compared to the 2024 season. This would suggest that fewer 3-year-old salmon will be around in 2026. However, there is a good chance that not all 3-year-old Chinooks spawned this season and could carry over into 2026 as larger, 4-year-old fish much like what occurred in 2024.








Raise the Steaks:

5 tips and styles for processing your deer and elk meat a new way **Part 1 of 2**




It's hard to beat a perfectly cooked steak, but other methods of preparation can be just as satisfying.

It's hard to beat a well-prepped, perfectly cooked steak – especially after all the time and effort you spent hauling it out of the mountains. But other methods of preparation can be just as satisfying. All it takes is a little bit of work and some kitchen ingenuity.

Now, if you're as devout a steak snob as Ron Swanson then this article probably ain't for you. And it's understandable; that deer or elk lying in your freezer is finite, like an annual birthday cake. There's no quick trips down to the supermarket to replenish your supply when your recipe runs short. So ensuring you make the most of your animal and process it how it fits your menu best is the most important

With that said, here are five prep tips and styles to help get the most out of that fall big game harvest.



1. Be your own butcher

At this point in the game, your time in the field, gutting and quartering the animal, might be all the knife-wielding you're willing to spend. Many hunters have their big game animals processed by professional butchers. But processing your own deer or elk can actually be a fun learning experience and a chance to call the shots in how you want your animal

With a large, sanitary cutting surface, sharp knives and ample patience, prepare your cuts of meat one at a time. Processing a whole hindquarter is more time consuming than folks realize, so don't get caught leaving the rest of the meat out too long at room temperature. Bacteria grows most rapidly between 40 degrees and 140 degrees Fahrenheit, doubling in number in as little as 20 minutes.

Try to keep the on-deck meat in the fridge until you're ready to process it. It's better to take your time on one slab of the animal knowing the rest is kept cool.

HOT TIP: The colder the meat is, the easier it is to



2. Trim, trim, trim

Few things determine a cut of meat's palatability more than sloppy knifework. Deer and elk meat is mostly lean to begin with, but fat and membranous tissue left attached can definitely ruin an appetite, depending on who you ask.

Deer and elk fat is different than beef or pork fat. Typically deer and elk fat tastes gross, but that's just general consensus and one writer's opinion. The goal when processing your deer or elk (or really any red meat for that matter) is to get rid of as much fat, stray hairs and dirt, and membrane as you can. It may feel like you're wasting bits of your hard-earned animal, but with some patience and skillful knifework, you can ensure your freezer will be filled with the best-tasting cuts of meat.



3. Low and slow

Some cuts lend themselves better to roasts than others. While steaks hog all the glory, roasts are an overlooked approach to serving up big game - and perhaps the simplest.

One of the best perks of being your own butcher is determining how much of one cut you set aside, then fill your freezer accordingly. Then when Sunday morning rolls around, all you have to do is pull a roast out of the freezer and pick up only a few ingredients from the store.

Roasts are not only simple, but they can feed a lot of people – or one person for several days. Slow-cooking for longer periods, whether in a crockpot or oven, keeps the meat tender and savory.

With nothing more than a crockpot, a can of stock and some root vegetables, you can have a cheap and easy supper cooking in the background while you go about your day. There is no shortage of roast recipes, including ones for wild game meat specifically. Do some digging and find one that takes the traditional "potatoes and carrots" to a whole other level.

HOT TIP: You'll hear the dish osso buco thrown around a lot these days. Meaning "bone with a hole," making osso buco can be a creative, new way to slow cook the bone-in shanks and impress your friends with your fluency of Italian.

Recent F&G Check Station on I-90 Shows Need for Improved CWD Transport Compliance

– Idaho Fish & Game –

Many hunters were unaware of rules related to chronic wasting disease.

Staff from Idaho Fish and Game's Panhandle Regional Office operated a check station on Nov. 16 along Interstate 90 near Fourth of July Pass. The purpose of the station was to monitor hunter compliance with Idaho's wildlife laws and to evaluate whether big game harvested out of state or from an Idaho chronic wasting disease management zone was being transported in accordance with CWD regulations.



Like many other states, Idaho prohibits transporting or importing the spine or brain tissue of deer, elk, and moose harvested in states where CWD has been detected. Nearly all of Idaho's neighboring states—and most states nationwide—are currently CWD-positive.

While the recent check station represents only a brief snapshot in time, Fish and Game staff observed that compliance with CWD-related transport rules was very low. Chronic wasting disease is a fatal neurological disease that poses a significant risk to Idaho's big game herds, and following transport rules is one of the most effective ways hunters can help slow its spread.



Hunters who pursue big game outside of Idaho and plan to bring any parts into or through the state are encouraged to review Idaho's legal transport requirements by visiting the CWD webpage on the Idaho Fish and Game website. Hunters who pursue big game within Idaho's CWD management zones should also take time to understand the zone-specific rules and requirements before heading into the field

Idaho law authorizes Fish and Game to operate check stations to enforce wildlife regulations and collect biological data that supports wildlife management. All hunters, anglers and trappers—with or without game—are required to stop when encountering an official Fish and Game check station.

4. Smoke 'em if you got 'em

Setting aside some meat for the smoker is a classic move in many a hunter's playbook. There are tons of ways to smoke wild game meat, but some of the most popular include summer sausage and pepperoni sticks. Both options are delicious, portable foods that can help fuel next year's hunt with this year's

Of the two, sausage can be a little more difficult with the added step of stuffing the meat into casings. After grinding a mixture of venison and pork then stuffing the casing, you smoke the sausages at low temperature for several hours. These make fantastic appetizers and camp food, and you can freeze them for later use.

Pepperoni sticks, also portable, are the perfect pocket snacks next to jerky (more on that next). Like summer sausage, they do require some extra work grinding the meat and incorporating the right amount of spices. You can find pepperoni-size casings at specialty stores, sporting goods stores or online, as well as whole kits for making pepperoni sticks.



Ever the crowd-favorite, making jerky can be a fairly simple process and doubles as a reward when your stomach starts growling 4 miles from the truck. Jerky easily finds a home in your hunting pack and stays edible for a long time (if frozen).

The key with making jerky lies in the thinness of the meat. You'll want to thinly slice the larger chunks of meat into strips. Then, you soak the slices in a marinade for several hours or overnight, before smoking or drying them.

Drying is most commonly done in a food dehydrator, but smokers or even your oven at its lowest setting with the door open ajar can do the job just fine. The key is just low, low heat for a long, long time.

There are many jerky recipes available in cookbooks or the internet. Remember when making jerky the pieces should be dry, but still supple. Too dry and it will be brittle and crunchy, which is overcooked. Although jerking is a method of preserving, it's still best to store it in the refrigerator or freezer.

FUN FACT: No, the word "jerky" does not get its name from the act of ripping dried meat with your teeth. Instead, the word comes from the Quechuan (Incan) word ch'arki, meaning "dried flesh," and didn't come into the American English vocabulary until 1850.

More tips for processing game meat

- · Pay attention to sanitary guidelines and cooking temperatures. Use a meat thermometer to ensure meat has reached the proper temperature when smoking or drying.
- You know what flavors you like and dislike, so learn the basics of a recipe and adjust to suit your tastes. Don't be afraid to experiment.
- If it's your first attempt with a new recipe, start with a small batch. If it doesn't turn out how you like, you can change it for your next batch.
- If you're making patty sausage, cook some as soon as it's done. Put a small, thin patty in an oiled frying pan, cook it a few minutes and taste it, then add more seasoning if needed.
- When freezing, don't put too much meat into one package. Aim for each package to hold enough for one meal.
- · Take advantage of prepackaged seasoning mixes. They take a lot of the hassle out of figuring out which spices to use and how much, and many are created for wild game, not domestic meats.
- Get a kitchen scale that will weigh about 10 pounds of meat. It will ensure you get the right ratio of game meat to pork, pork fat, or beef fat.







Fish and Game Invites Anglers to Help Study Trophy Rainbow Trout in Lake Pend Oreille — and Win Prizes Doing It

Lake Pend Oreille anglers can contribute valuable data on rainbow trout populations during the 2025 season and become eligible for great prizes

Idaho Fish and Game is calling on local anglers in the Panhandle Region to help support the state's premier trophy rainbow trout fishery in Lake Pend Oreille — and have a chance to win prizes in the process.

Through the 2025 Lake Pend Oreille Angler Science Program, anglers can contribute valuable data to fisheries management while enjoying time on the water and earning rewards for their participation.



Lake Pend Oreille continues to produce more rainbow trout over 20 pounds than anywhere else on Earth, making it a destination fishery for anglers. To ensure this world-class fishery remains healthy and productive, Fish and Game biologists collect monitoring data to track population trends and angler success. But traditional survey methods only tell part of the story — and that's where anglers can make a difference.



About the Angler Science Program

The Lake Pend Oreille Angler Science Program partners with the fishing community to gather information that helps biologists better understand rainbow trout catch rates, harvest and survival. Participants primarily contribute by recording catch data in logbooks and reporting tagged fish.

To date, angler participation has provided valuable insights. For example, catch rate of rainbow trout greater than 32 inches in 2024 was twice as high compared to 2023, and rainbow trout over 25 inches represented 50% of the total catch.

"Anglers play a critical role in helping us understand and sustain the trophy trout fishery on Lake Pend Oreille," said Andy Dux, Regional Fishery Manager for Fish and Game's Panhandle Region. "The information they provide directly informs our management decisions and ensures future generations can enjoy the same world-class fishing opportunities."

Report Tagged Rainbow Trout

Fish and Game is also conducting a tagging study to better understand rainbow trout dynamics. Tags are located on the backs of fish and include a unique number, phone number, website and - on select tags - a reward value.

Reward tags are worth \$25, \$50, \$100 or \$200. Anglers who catch a tagged trout are asked to report the tag number and capture location to Fish and Game.

Participation is free, and every data point submitted helps biologists make informed management decisions.



Bake a Dramatic Puff Pancake for Breakfast

When relatives come to your home during these last few months of the year, make weekend breakfasts extra special when you put this delicious puff pancake on your menu! Also called a Dutch baby, this version of the recipe is simple to prepare with kids and dramatic to serve when it's piping hot and coming right out of the oven. Believe me, mouths will be watering when it arrives at the table. Take a bow, then serve with fresh fruit or your other favorite toppings:

DRAMATIC PUFF PANCAKE

Serves 4

- · 4 eggs
- 1 cup skim or whole milk
- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 1 tablespoon sugar
- 1/8 teaspoon salt
- 3 tablespoons unsalted butter
- 1 tablespoon powdered sugar and a squeeze of fresh lemon (toppings)

Preheat oven to 425 F. Let one of your kids count and crack the eggs into a mixing bowl. Inspect it to be sure that there are no remaining shells. Beat eggs with a beater until they're light and pale.Another child may measure and gradually beat in the milk, flour, sugar and salt.

Meanwhile, place butter in a 10- or 12-inch castiron or ovenproof skillet, or a 9-by-13-inch oven-safe glass baking dish. An adult should place it in the oven until it is hot and the butter sizzles.

Remove from oven and pour batter into the hot butter. Return to oven and bake for 20-25 minutes, or until puffy and golden-brown on the edges. (Keep oven door closed until done.)

Squeeze lemon juice on top, dust with powdered sugar, and serve tableside immediately. Serve with fresh fruit, such as berries, grapes and kiwi slices.



Alternate Blender Method: Put eggs in a blender and whirl for 1 minute. With the motor running, add milk, then slowly add in flour, sugar and salt. Whirl for an additional 30 seconds. Proceed with recipe starting by placing butter in the oven.

Every year on December 11th, International Mountain Day aims to increase awareness about the importance of mountains. The conservation of mountains is a key factor in sustainable development.

Mountains cover 27% of the earth's landmass. According to the United Nations, 15% of the world's population lives in the mountains. The mountains are also home to one-quarter of the world's land animals and plants. Additionally, across the globe mountains provide freshwater to half of the world's population. International Mountain Day History

In 1992, the UN held the Commission on Sustainable Development (CSD). As part of the CSD, the UN adopted a document called "Managing Fragile Ecosystems: Sustainable Mountain Development." Due to the emphasis on the importance of mountains, the UN declared 2002 the UN International Year of Mountains. In 2003, the United Nations General Assembly designated December 11th as International Mountain Day. The Food and Agricultural Organization of the United Nations (FAO) is responsible for leading the observance of this day. Recent themes have included:


