



#### Easy, Elegant Meal on a Budget

At Divas on a Dime, I'm always on the lookout for exceptional recipes that use inexpensive ingredients. So, how do you serve a salmon entree to four people for under \$10? The answer is simple: make Easy Salmon

Souffle is a tastefully classy brunch, lunch, dinner or late supper. Fluffy, moist eggs rising heavenward past the rim of the baking dish, blended with canned salmon and a touch of dill. This is cheap eats at its absolute finest. The closest eggs can get to being Queen for a Day.

Souffles have a reputation for being difficult, but that's undeserved. If you follow instructions, it works every time. If you can whip egg whites and make a white sauce, you can totally make souf-

It's important to have everything gathered, measured and ready before you begin. Before you beat the egg whites, make sure your bowl and beaters are impeccably clean with no traces of oil or yolk. Either will prevent the whites from forming bubbles and attaining full volume.

#### EASY SALMON SOUFFLE'

Yield: 2 to 4 servings Total Time: 60 minutes 1 (14.75 ounce) can salmon

3 tablespoons + 1 teaspoon butter

2 tablespoons grated Parmesan

cheese

- 4 eggs, separated, at room tempera-
- I tablespoon green onion, thinly sliced
- 3 tablespoons flour
- 1 cup milk
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper l teaspoon dried dill

Begin by flaking the salmon, removing any bones and dark skin, then set aside.

Butter a round souffle or baking dish (7 1/2 to 8 inches in diameter and 3 inches deep) with 1 teaspoon butter. Sprinkle with grated Parmesan cheese. Set aside. Separate your room temperature eggs, being certain the whites have absolutely no yolk in them.



This salmon souffle makes a classy and affordable brunch.

Place oven rack in the bottom third of the oven; preheat oven to 400 F.

In a medium saucepan, over medium-low heat, melt remaining butter. Add the onion and saute until softened. Whisk in flour and cook for 2 minutes. Whisk constantly as you add milk, salt, pepper and dill. Switch to a wooden spoon, stir and simmer until very thick. Remove from heat, add the salmon, and let cool a few minutes. Add the yolks, one at a time,

combine and set aside. This is your

With a stand or hand mixer, beat egg whites until they form stiff peaks. Using a spatula, fold one-third of vour whites into the base to lighten the mixture. Gently fold the rest of the whites into the base until just combined. Don't over mix, or you'll deflate your souffle.

Pour into the prepared baking dish. Place souffle in the oven and turn the temperature down to 375 F.

Bake for 35-40 minutes or until golden brown. Don't peek! Don't open the oven door until at least  $3\bar{5}$  minutes have passed. To test for doneness, insert a bamboo skewer or a piece of dry spaghetti into the souffle. If it comes out clean, it's done. Serve immediately. The souffle will begin to

deflate in about 3 minutes, so have the camera ready.

To serve, plunge two serving spoons, back-to-back, into the center of the souffle and pull the crust apart. Divide into servings.

Suggested sides are a green salad, steamed little potatoes, sauteed asparagus and baguette. Wine pairings would be champaign or sparkling wine, chardonnay, dry rose or sauvignon blanc.

Remember this recipe for Valentine's Day to impress your sweetheart. As you bring this cloudlike perfection to the table you say: "Oh, this little ol' thing? I made this just for you because I'm a DIVA!"

#### **Thrifty African Chicken Stew for Kwanzaa**

This chicken peanut stew is an adaptation of a tasty dish that was often prepared for celebrations in the village where I lived years ago in the Republic of Congo. Extended families would sit around a table with a large cooking pot in the center filled with the steaming stew. We ate together, as I listened to traditional stories of their past.

And now, when we make this thrifty and tasty stew in our home, my family does the same.

Share this recipe and your stories with family and friends as you celebrate Kwanzaa this week and other special events in the coming new year.

#### Here is what you'll need for 6-8 servings:

One 3 to 3-1/2 pound fryer chicken, cut up

- 1/2 cup flour
  - 2 tablespoons peanut oil
  - 1 14-ounce can stewed tomatoes, drained
  - 1 large sweet potato, peeled and cubed
  - 1 large onion, chopped
- 1/4 cup canned chopped chilies, mild or hot to taste (optional)
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 2 cups chicken broth, canned or fresh
- 1/2 cup chopped unsalted peanuts
- 3 hard-boiled eggs (optional)
  Chopped parsley garnish

#### GET STARTED!

Preheat the oven to 350 F. Let your child measure and pour flour into a clean plastic or paper bag.


Shake the chicken in the flour. An adult may fry the flour-coated pieces in the oil for several minutes in a large frying pan, until golden brown. The chicken doesn't need to be cooked through at this stage.

Place the chicken in a large ovenproof casserole dish or stew pot. Let your child add the tomatoes, sweet potato, onion, chilies and salt. Pour the chicken broth over the chicken and sprinkle with the chopped peanuts. Cover and place in the oven for one hour.

#### SERVE IT!

When the stew is finished cooking, if you wish, slice the peeled hard-boiled eggs in half and arrange them around the edge of the steaming stew. Sprinkle with fresh parsley. Place at the middle of the table along with a bowl of rice, and serve with a big spoon.

Parenting Tip: Some people like their chilies mild, others hot. Many kids prefer to skip them altogether! If your kids would rather not have them, better to put the chilies on hold and make a dish the whole family can gather around.

Satisfy Your Sweet Tooth With an Apple Tarte Tatin

Here's a simple name game to play with your kids as you prepare this delicious treat: Think of food and recipes named after people. There's Melba toast, named after Nellie Melba, a famous Australian opera singer from the 19th century; oysters Rockefeller; fettuccine Alfredo; and of course Granny Smith apples. Her apple is ideal for a quick-to-prepare dessert called Tarte Tatin, named after the French Tatin sisters.

Kids who are able to handle a peeler or a small knife peel can core the apples, while you tell them that years ago in France, Stephanie Tatin was making a pie in such a hurry that she mistakenly put the apples in the pan before the pastry. She added the pastry on top so that it wouldn't go to waste. Thus, a new caramelized upside-down apple pie was created, a yummy recipe you can now try at home.

#### **APPLE TARTE TATIN** Serves 8

- 4-5 apples, such as Granny Smith or Golden Delicious
- 3/4 cup sugar
- 1 rolled-dough pie crust (homemade or purchased in the refrigerated section of your store)

Heat oven to 375° F. Peel the apples, cut in half, and core with a melon baller, if you have one. Slice two of the halves into quarters lengthwise.

In an ovenproof, 10-inch skillet, an adult should heat the sugar over medium-high heat until it beings to caramelize. Reduce to medium heat and keep an eye on it at all times as it transforms into a golden liquid; be sure not to let it darken too much.

Remove pan from heat and arrange the apple halves tightly, cut-side down, in a circular fashion. Fill in spaces and the center with quarter slices. Cook on medium-high heat for about 10-15 minutes, or until the apples soften.

Use a fork to turn the softened apples cut-side up on the skillet and carefully drape the pie crust dough evenly over the top. With a spatula, tuck the dough under slightly around the apples. Poke a hole in the center with the tip of a knife.

Bake for 20-25 minutes, or until the crust is lightly golden. Remove from oven and cover the skillet with a large serving plate. Hold the pan and plate together using pot holders, and flip with a steady movement, keeping the tart in one piece. (Note: The liquid is extremely hot.) Remove skillet to reveal the dessert.

Cool, and then serve with vanilla or cinnamonspice ice cream.

Note: If you don't have an ovenproof skillet, add the caramelized sugar and semi-cooked apples to a standard greased pie pan. Cover with pie crust and continue as described above.



# Mustard Pot

Mettlach, Germany, is a town known for manufacturing beer steins at the Villeroy and Boch factories since about 1842. They made all types of pottery.

It started in 1809 when Pierre-Joseph Boch established a company in the remains of a cathedral built in 786 A.D. To avoid destroying the trees used for the factory's fuel, a coal-burning kiln was developed by 1816. Famous artists were hired to create the designs. There were eight V&B factories making ceramics.

In 1836, Mettlach merged with Villeroy & Boch, forming a company run by Eugene, son of Pierre-Joseph. Modern improvements continued. They adopted new styles, new products like tableware, and new types of ceramics. After a fire destroyed the factory and records in 1925, they reproduced many old items.

Collectors since the 1970s pay the highest prices for the pre-fire pieces. "Earlyware Relief" pieces were made before 1880. They were formed in a mold, often to look like a tree trunk and sometimes tan colored. Molded pieces resembling vines were added and colored green or brown with platinum accents. # Green Beans With Mixed Mushrooms

This simple side borrows the casserole's basic flavors, but gives them grabbed-from-the-garden goodness with field-picked beans, thin-sliced onions and earthy criminis and shiitakes.

- tablespoons olive oil
- 4 sprigs fresh thyme
- large (10 to 12 ounces each) onions, thinly sliced
- clove garlic, crushed with press
- ounces cremini mushrooms, thinly sliced
- ounces shiitake mushrooms, stems discarded, thinly sliced Salt Pepper
- pounds green beans, trimmed
- 1. Heat covered 7- to 8-quart saucepot of water to boiling on high.
- 2. Meanwhile, in 12-inch skillet, heat oil on medium-high. Add thyme and onions; cook 10 to 12 minutes or until browned and very tender, stirring occasionally. Stir in garlic and cook 1 minute. Add mushrooms and cook 5 minutes or until tender, stirring occasionally. Stir in 1/2 teaspoon salt and 1/2 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper. Remove and discard thyme.
- 3. Add green beans and 2 teaspoons salt to boiling water. Cook, uncovered, 8 to 9 minutes or until tender, stirring occasionally. Drain and rinse with cold water.
- 4. When ready to serve, return green beans to saucepot and add mushroom mixture, stirring to combine. Cook on medium until beans are heated through, stirring occasionally. Serves 12.

TIP: If making ahead, transfer mushroom mixture to medium bowl. Cover; refrigerate up to overnight. Transfer beans to resealable plastic bag; refrigerate up to overnight.



Take advantage of every fishing and hunting day this year, with nearly a dozen hunting and fishing opportunities popping off during the first few months of the year

A lot of hunters and anglers see the cold, bitter months of January and February as the so-called "off-season." It's easy to see why — you step foot outside and instantly need a defroster for your lungs.

But with a little bit of mental preparation, the right gear and (most importantly) an up-to-date hunting and/or fishing license, you can take advantage of every day the calendar gives you and beat that cabin fever, with nearly a dozen hook-and-bullet opportunities around the state.

It's quick, painless, and above all else gives you peace of mind that all is squared away when your favorite season later in the year sneaks up on you. Here, in no particular order, are 9 reasons to buy your 2023 licenses and ensure a full year of hunting and fishing.

#### Fancy Up Those Winter Meals With Small Game

Whether or not you're still recovering from a long, fall big game hunt, going after small game with a .22 long rifle or shotgun is an excellent way to stay active and fill your freezer or saucepot with some tasty mountain critter morsels.

Getting that 2023 hunting license allows you to keep targeting red (pine) squirrels, cottontail rabbits and snowshoe hares all the way through March 31. The best part is it doesn't require long packouts, is relatively inexpensive and keeps those legs limber for when spring rolls around.

#### Up Your Upland Game Late Into The Season

If squirrels or hares don't excite you, there's still plenty of time and reason to go after some of Idaho's upland birds, specifically chukar, Hungarian partridge, California quail and (in some places) forest grouse. If your dogs are itching to get out into the foothills and flush some birds this winter, you, your shotgun and your 2023 hunting license can expect little traffic and potentially good success.

Just be mindful of where you're hunting. This time of year is critical big game wintering time, and many of the same lowland places you might drum up upland birds are also the temporary wintering grounds of deer and elk.

#### Ice Fishing

No matter where you live in the state, chances are good you're no more than a quick car ride from a prime ice fishing destination. Ice fishing can be a hoot, whether solo, with friends, with kids, or all of the above. At this point in the year, many of Idaho's ice fisheries have been hardening up from long periods of cold temperatures. Those cold temps can definitely deter some folks from walking out onto a frozen lake and drilling a 10-inch hole to fish through. But with the right gear and relatively inexpensive equipment, you can be taking part in one of the most leisurely activities of the entire year.

Before you load up the station wagon with family and fishing gear, be sure to check your destination's ice fishing conditions. If all looks safe, here are some of the best tips, as shared by Fish and Game staff, to help you catch fish through the ice.

#### Stay Price Locked

Fish and Game has a unique opportunity for hunters and anglers to ensure they only pay what they paid back in 2017. Purchasing an annual hunting, fishing or combo license consecutively since 2017 guarantees your rate is locked in. And right now, there's no better time to keep that streak alive.

If you're not Price Locked, you can still get 2017 prices by buying a 3-year license.

#### Steelhead Fans Rejoice

Idaho's spring steelhead season kicked off Jan. 1, and no, we're not talking about hockey. If you're into standing on (or in) a frigid river bank during winter in hopes of landing one of the most sought-after fish in the state, you're in luck. Steelhead fishing is a fun and challenging way to keep your angling prowess sharpened when the mercury plummets. Be sure to check out the current steelhead fishing rules and regulations before you go out.

#### The Waterfowl Season's Only At Halftime

You don't need to have a big, extravagant holiday like Thanksgiving or Christmas on the horizon to goad you into goose or duck hunting. In fact, Idaho's waterfowl season is merely half over (or half beginning, depending on how you look at it).

Most duck and Canada geese seasons are open during at least part of January, while white-fronted geese run into February, and as late as March for light geese in parts of the state. See the migratory game bird hunting seasons and rules booklet, as closure dates vary depending on species and location.

#### Don't Rule Out Winter Stream Fishing

Sure, the passerby and maybe even fellow anglers might look at you crazy for standing out on a river, risking frostbite, just to catch a few rainbow trout. But truth is, winter can be an amazing time to hook fish and observe some incredible natural scenery on quiet waters.

Winter is when many fly anglers sneak out to a popular rivers to catch fish in the same stretches of water that are filled with anglers during peak season. They know the fish are still there and willing to take a fly, or lure if you're not a fly angler, and have a whole stretch of the river to yourself.

There are many benefits and strategies when it comes to winter stream fishing.

#### Burbot. That's right. Burbot.

What's a burbot, you might ask? It might not be the coverfish of Field and Stream magazine, but the experience and prized table fare make burbot the Kootenai River's a beloved celebrity.

There's a whole history to these deep-water creatures — which is highly worth the read — but the burbot are not your average sportfish. When you hit up your buddy to fish the Kootenai River in mid-winter, you might get a resounding "no" before you can even finish your sentence. But the moment you tell them there's a freshwater member of the cod family that tastes like lobster living down there, prepare for their tune to change.

#### **Hunting Large Predators**

Mountain lion and wolf hunting seasons are open during winter depending on location. Be sure to check out the big game hunting seasons and rules before heading out. Many hunters also enjoy the challenges of predator hunting during winter, and coyotes pelts are in prime condition.

#### Get It All (Almost) With A Sportsman's Package

If you're someone that likes to have their bases covered, than the resident Sportsman's Package option is the way to go. At only \$124.25 at Price Locked — or \$144.60 if you're not — you get nearly all the hunting and fishing opportunities Idaho has to offer on one consolidated ticket.

The Sportsman's Package includes a resident adult hunting and fishing license, plus tags for deer, elk, bear, mountain lion, wolf, turkey, salmon and steelhead. Archery and muzzleloader are validated on the license. (You still need a federal migratory bird permit and waterfowl stamp for those species).

#### Case of Hot Flashes Yet to Be **Resolved Despite Therapy**

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am 78; I had a hysterectomy in 1976 due to excessive vaginal bleeding, but I still have my ovaries. I have had hot flashes since undergoing menopause – they usually last three to five minutes, and I have them about every two hours around the clock (which obviously interferes with my sleep).

Over the last 28 years, I have tried Premarin (which gave me bad headaches), gabapentin, venlafaxine, Bellergal, melatonin, black cohosh, clonidine, DHEA, Pro-Gest cream (chamomile, hops and valerian root), progesterone and estrogen (together), avoiding caffeine, and eliminating dairy products. TITLE: None of these has helped.

I would appreciate it if you could offer any suggestions. - L.E.

ANSWER: I'm sorry to hear of your difficulties. You have certainly tried about all the available therapies.

There are two additional ones you might want to consider: Megesterol is a hormonal therapy that is helpful for some women, but the fact that you haven't responded to estrogens and progestins is not promising. The other is called a stellate ganglion block. You can ask your physician about it.

DEAR DR. ROACH: After a patient has had megadoses of IV and oral antibiotics, is there anything they should do to restore the balance in their body, such as eating probiotics or yogurt? Or is that all nonsense? - N.W.

**ANSWER:** The idea makes perfect sense: Antibiotics not only kill the bad bacteria that is infecting us, they also kill many of the healthy bacteria that help us with digestion and other functions. (The whole

suite of healthy bacteria living in our gut is termed the "microbiome.") Why not help the gut return to normal by giving it some healthy bacteria, such as those found in yogurt with live cultures, or specific probiotics, which are just the healthy bacteria?

The answer is that it has been very hard to prove that there is any benefit in doing so. In people with no symptoms after finishing an antibiotic course, there probably aren't any benefits.

At least one study showed what researchers called a "very severe disturbance" in the person's microbiome and actually slowed the return to a person's normal microbiome, which they had prior to antibiotics. Worse still, very rarely, infections have been transmitted through probiotics.

Symptoms after antibiotic therapy, especially diarrhea and fever, could indicate a very severe infection called Clostridioides difficile ("C. diff"), which does not respond to probiotics and usually needs powerful antibiotics to treat. Probiotics have not been found to prevent C. diff.

DEAR DR. ROACH: Why are older patients always asked, "Have you ever fallen?" It is annoying, and I wish you would stop asking. - L.M.B.

ANSWER: Falls in older adults are a major cause of disability. Falls can lead to fractures, and fractures lead to poor movement, sometimes to a progressive decline.

A history of a fall is a major risk for future falls, so any person with a history of indoor falls should undergo a comprehensive evaluation as to why they fell and see what can be done to prevent future falls. This includes, of course, managing any chronic illness, but also correcting vision as much as possible; evaluating the home for risks such as poor lighting and area rugs; and evaluating gait and balance, with a referral to a physical therapist for exercises to improve these, and for assistive devices if necessary.

Falls may also be the first indication of a significant medical or neurological condition that may benefit from treatment. I'm sorry you find it annoying, but it's an important question.

# Protect Wintering Wildlife By Leaving Them Alone During The Winter

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game —



It's the hardest time of year to be a deer, elk or other wintering big game animal, and their livelihood literally gets chalked up to "every calorie counts"

Out of sight, out of mind, right? Wrong. Just because wildlife aren't as visible as they were in the shoulder seasons doesn't mean they're "living easy" on their wintering grounds. And if you are seeing wintering wildlife, you may be too close for comfort, which bring us to our next point: Protect wintering wildlife by leaving them along during the winter.

Winter is a hard time for Idaho's wildlife, especially for big game animals, like deer and elk, that migrate to lower elevations and spend winter closer to people than during other seasons.

As the snow deepens, forage starts to get limited, and animals usually can't meet their full nutritional needs by feeding on naturally available food, even at lower elevations where the ground isn't snow covered. Deer, elk and other big game animals accumulate fat reserves earlier in the year that typically allows them to survive most Idaho winters, but even the healthiest animals' limited reserves can be depleted, with fawns and calves being the most susceptible to malnutrition and winterkill.

During an average winter without extreme cold or unusually deep snow, more than 90 percent of adult deer and elk survive. But that number can be significantly lower for fawns and calves, which are smaller and less capable of withstanding winter. On average, about 40 percent of mule deer fawns perish during a normal Idaho winter — and more during a harsh one.

One way to avoid disturbing wintering wildlife is simply leaving them alone when you're outdoors. A simple rule of thumb is if your presence or actions cause them to move, you're too close.

#### Control your four-legged hiking companion

Even if your dog isn't chasing big game animals, its presence may be enough to cause animals to flee and expend unnecessary energy they would not have otherwise used.

A dog can be seen as another predator in the eyes of big game animals, and the impacts of free-running dogs on wintering game can be substantial. Remember: It is illegal to allow dogs to chase or harass big game.

#### Watch for big game along roads and highways

Auto collisions involving big game animals usually tick upward during winter, so drivers should practice extra caution, especially when traveling during the busy holidays.

"Being watchful is the best defense against a wildlife/vehicle collision," said Roger Phillips, Fish and Game Public Information Supervisor. "Drivers should be especially careful during times of low visibility. Collisions with wildlife are a serious matter and best avoided."

Wildlife collisions are not only harmful, they are expensive. Hitting a deer or elk often results in thousands of dollars in vehicle damage, not to mention potential injury to vehicle occupants and loss of wildlife.

# Follow these tips to help reduce your chances of an animal collision:

- Game animals are especially active at dawn, dusk and at night, so be extra watchful and cautious during those times.
- Scan ahead and watch for movement, especially near the fog line and side of the road. When driving at night, use your brights when appropriate and watch for shining eyes in headlights.
- If you see one animal cross the road, slow down immediately and look for more to follow. They usually aren't alone.
- Pay extra attention in areas posted with wildlife crossing signs, which signify common migration areas, or areas where big game winters.
- Don't swerve and risk losing control of your vehicle. Brake as much as possible, but stay on the roadway. The most serious crashes often occur when drivers lose control of their vehicles while trying to avoid an animal.

#### Don't feed wintering big game

It may seem counterintuitive when there's limited food available for deer, elk and other animals, but feeding big game can cause big problems, even when the intentions come from the right place.

Fish and Game's policy is that natural habitat and feed must sustain wildlife, except in emergency situations. Regardless of the severity of winter, some animals will naturally perish. That's an inescapable part of nature, and animals too stressed from winter can die even when food is available.

When big game animals are fed it can create a whole slew of problems. They can become habituated to handouts, change seasonal migrations, damage property, create traffic hazards and also attract predators, such as mountain lions. Congregated animals can also more readily transmit diseases, such as brucellosis and chronic wasting disease.



# Fish and Game has plans in place if emergency feeding is needed

Winter feeding advisory committees in different parts of the state monitor weather conditions and make recommendations if Fish and Game crews should feed animals.

Other situations may also arise where emergency feeding is required, but the main policy is that Idaho's wildlife should be self-sustaining and reliant on natural habitat, not supplemental feeding every winter.

If these situations occur due to extreme winter weather, the committees convene and make recommendations to Fish and Game whether to begin emergency winter feeding.

#### Moral of the story

At the end of the day, leave big game alone this time of year. It's the hardest time of year to be a deer, elk or other wintering big game animal, and their livelihood literally gets chalked up to "every calorie counts."

If you're looking for a fun, frosty winterscape to take Rover out on a walk, do your research. Avoid places designated as wintering grounds for deer and elk. We live in a state full of public land access where you (and your four-legged trail buddy) can explore and help pass the time this winter.

## Break Out The Neoprene: Winter Stream Fishing Is A Perfect Opportunity To Stay Outdoors And Catch Fish

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game -

Keep those off-season fishing mechanics sharp by getting out on your local stream or river this winter

Ask just about anyone if standing in two feet of 33-degree water while snow somehow finds its way down the back of their base layer sounds like their idea of a good time, and you'll probably get a resounding no. This time of year, it's tempting for anglers to stash the rods and hang up the waders 'til next spring. And that turnkey fireplace beside the 55-inch flat screen doesn't make the decision any easier.

But for those willing to don their thickest neoprene waders, set up shop on an icy riverbank for a few hours and fuss with frozen guides, there are still several opportunities to sharpen one's angling skills, take in Idaho's beautiful winterscape and hook a few fish.

#### The benefits and strategy of winter stream fishing

There are several benefits to fishing rivers and streams during the coldest part of the year. For starters, you may have the whole stretch of river bank to yourself. For a handful of folks, fishing plays second fiddle to other winter hobbies like fly tying, skiing or making a pot of chili in the slow cooker. It shouldn't be too difficult to find a nice stretch of river where you won't have to worry about summer crowds.

Seek out slow, deep water where trout and whitefish will most likely be holding, expending as little energy as possible. Look for slow pockets or pools where water is barely flowing.

#### Slow and hungry

Just because fish are moving slower in the winter doesn't mean they're not still looking for an easy meal. Insect hatches are sparse in winter, but that doesn't mean they still aren't around as a food source for slow-moving fish. Fish can be frustratingly picky this time of year, so presentation and food size is vital.

As a general rule of thumb, use smaller bait and flies than you would in spring and summer.

The same goes for tippet. River flows in winter slow down dramatically and tend to be lower and clearer. That means it's even easier for fish to see right through a poorly-executed presentation. It might be wise to downsize your tippet from what you usually run in the spring and summer, such as a 4X to a 5X.

#### Technique, technique, technique

Once you got your rig set up, it's good to try different techniques that you might not have tried before in the warmer months.

Dead drifting is critical in winter because trout won't chase a fly in cold water. To dead drift, simply let the slow-moving current carry the fly either on the surface (dry fly) or just beneath the surface in the upper column of water (bait, nymphs, midges). If you see dimples on the water, it may be fish feeding on drifting insects, which will likely be tiny midges or mayflies.

Occasionally stream fish will rise for dry flies, such as small midges or olive mayflies, during the winter. But it isn't too common. Instead, save yourself a few extra grams of weight and keep that box of dry flies at home. A small midge emerger or a tiny olive mayfly emerger will be the only surface flies you need.

If fishing for trout or steelhead, try swinging a fly by keeping the fly in the upper part of the water column. Steelhead and trout will often feed upwards, so a well-placed fly swinging across the upper portion of the water just may catch their eye.

If the fish aren't going for small flies like midges and stoneflies, it may not hurt to lob a streamer out there to test the waters, so to speak. Streamers can

look like a big, easy meal when presented slowly, but don't expect trout to vigorously chase them like they do in summer.

#### Hit the snooze

The only thing sweeter than netting a jumbo fish in the middle of winter is netting a jumbo fish in the middle of winter after 8 hours of uninterrupted sleep. Unplug the alarm clock. Disable your phone's sleep reminder. Brew that extra pot of bold roast, and slam that extra waffle. Winter fishing means one thing to many anglers: sleeping in. This time of year, fish will be right there with you, figuratively speaking.

With most winter fisheries, fish won't be getting after it until mid- to late-morning. Unlike peak summer conditions, fish will be most active during mid-afternoon on sunny days, and even longer into the afternoon on cloudy days.

It's easy to see how excited one might be about submerging their southern hemisphere in icy water all for the hopes of catching a fish, but rest easy (and long) knowing that those fish will still be waiting for you when you hit your local river or stream later in the morning.

#### Where to start

Now that you're well-rested and know what to try on fish, here's where to find them. See Fish and Game's Fishing Planner to learn more about each location.

Boise River: Don't overlook this river during late season because low winter flows actually make it more accessible and wader-friendly than during summer. It has healthy populations of rainbow trout, whitefish and brown trout. But don't expect gullible fish; these fish have seen almost every trick in the book from anglers.

South Fork of the Boise River: This popular stretch below Anderson Ranch Dam doesn't get any less popular during winter. Water coming out of the reservoir provides stable conditions and thousands of trout per mile make it a destination for late season anglers. Trout and whitefish tend to be above-average in size.

Payette River (Banks to Horseshoe Bend): This section of the Payette River supports a tremendously diverse fishery, including mountain whitefish. Whitefish will readily take a well-presented bait, fly or lure, they're scrappy when hooked, and they're tasty, yet admittedly, a little bony. Anglers have many access points along this stretch of river.

Big Wood River: This river has long been popular during winter for catch-and-release trout fishing. It rarely freezes, and if you fish it on the right day, you can catch trout on dry flies. Bring your midge and baetis patterns.

Malad River: This spring-fed stream is a fun winter fishing spot because it's easily accessible from the Hagerman area and has lots of trout. Bring your light tackle because they tend to run small, but they're plentiful and fiesty.

Lower Lochsa and Selway rivers: All provide good opportunities to catch whitefish during winter, and also have catch-and-release trout fishing.

**St. Joe River:** This river provides winter fishing opportunities for cutthroat trout and whitefish.

North Fork of the Coeur d'Alene River: Lower section also has fishing for whitefish and cutthroat trout and is accessible during winter.

Snake River below American Falls: This section of the Snake has produced some excellent trophy trout fishing in recent years. The relatively mild climate and dam release keeps this fishing accessible and productive during winter.

Snake River (Tilden to Shelley): This section is slated to get nearly 40,000 rainbow trout stocked in November. Several thousand fish will be released near Tilden, Blackfoot, Firth and Shelley.

**Portneuf River**: Upper section is your best bet, and Fish and Game provides several access areas so you can get to the river.

South Fork of the Snake River: This has year-round trout fishing and there's no limit on rainbow trout. There's also lots of opportunity to catch whitefish during winter.







Pack a Week's Worth of Salad in a Jar

Food is a real and delicious way for people to share themselves and engage with each other and a greater cause, as my neighbor, Emily Torgrimson, has found. She is co-founder and executive director of Eat for Equity, a nonprofit that builds a culture of generosity through sustainable community feasts (www.eatforequity.org). By inviting people to gather to eat and give what they can, the organization raises thousands of dollars for local and international nonprofit causes.

Emily's creative approach to cooking features flavorful and simple recipes for busy families, and her own household, developed by cooking for hundreds of people in home kitchens.

No wonder I was eager to join her to prepare a week's worth of "salad-in-a-jar." Improvising with the resources at hand, she scanned the refrigerator for the forgotten carrot, leftover black beans and other fresh odds and ends of inspiration. She lined up a row of sparkling pint- and quart-sized canning jars, and together, we packed them to the brim. The carrot went into an Asian salad with sesame dressing, tofu, oranges, spring onions and spinach. The beans became a Southwestern salad with roasted poblano dressing, corn, tomatoes, cilantro and greens. The result was a rainbow shelf of grab-and-go meals.

Make salad-in-a-jar with your kids for healthy portable lunches or use a large quart-sized jar for a last-minute complement to an evening meal.

Gather the ingredients and get layering. You'll have salads for the week, with only a meal's worth of cleanup and dishes.

#### SALAD-IN-A-JAR BASICS

For one salad, use a wide-mouth pint-sized jar, such as a canning jar with a tight-fitting lid.

Here's the hands-on fun:

- 1. Pour 1-2 tablespoons of salad dressing into the bottom of the jar.
- 2. Layer small handfuls of your favorite raw vegetables such as grated carrots, chopped celery, sweet peppers, scallions and cucumbers on top of the dressing.
- 3. Add softer ingredients such as cubed tofu, pasta, grains, grated cheese, beans, cooked vegetables, tomatoes, citrus, berries and dried fruit.
- 4. Pack the remaining space with salad greens or spinach.
- 5. Screw the lid on and refrigerate upright for up to five days.

To serve, shake the salad into a bowl. Add croutons and nuts, if you wish.

Note: If you desire a salad with meat, fish or hardboiled eggs, add it to the jar the same day you plan to eat the salad.





# North Idaho's Priest River: A River In Need

#### Warm summertime water temperatures are the plight of fish in the Priest River

Not all rivers are created equal. Some, like the St. Joe River in North Idaho, boast good habitat and reliably cold water, resulting in robust coldwater fish populations, such as westslope cutthroat and bull trout. However, others, like the Priest River, are not so fortunate.

For decades, Priest River has suffered from warm water temperatures during the summer months. Coldwater fish and warm water don't mix well, and that reality came to a head in July 2021 with an unprecedented fish kill.

"My wife and I have lived and recreated on the Priest River for almost 42-years," said Jon Quinn-Hurst, a local on the river. "The fish kill of July 2021 was devastating. It was heartbreaking to see hundreds of dead fish littering the shoreline."

Rob Ryan, Regional Fisheries Biologist for Idaho Fish and Game, said the fish kill was not a surprise relative to the Priest River.

"Trout are coldwater fish, and the Priest River is too warm." Ryan said. "Temperatures in the 50–60 degree Fahrenheit range are great for trout. When temperatures exceed 70 degrees, trout start to get stressed and potentially die because of warm water temperatures, especially when the warm temperatures are prolonged."

Temperatures in excess of 70 degrees for extended periods of time occur annually in Priest River, typically during July and August.

Priest River is fed by water from the surface of Priest Lake, which warms during the summer, so it has likely always been warmer than other regional rivers. However, operations of Outlet Dam at the south end of Priest Lake along with warming trends in climate have likely exacerbated the issue. Thankfully, opportunity to improve temperature, habitat and the fish community the river supports may exist.

The local community along with many organizations are becoming more aware of the plight of Priest River, and they are beginning to organize.

"The fish kill has been a catalyst of some really great things over the past year," said Quinn-Hurst. "People are becoming more aware of the health of the river and are exploring options to help Priest River and the fish that call it home."

#### **Priest River Watershed Group and other resources**

Fish and Game, the Kalispel Tribe of Indians, Trout Unlimited and many other organizations and local residents desire to restore and enhance the Priest River and its fisheries to ensure it can be enjoyed by future generations in perpetuity.

Trout Unlimited is organizing a Priest River Watershed Group, which will host its first public meeting on Dec. 7 from 5:30-7 p.m. at the Priest River Event Center at 5399 U.S. Route 2 in the town of Priest River. The meeting is the first of many, and it is open to anyone interested in improving the fishery in the Priest River.
