National Panda Day March 16th

— National Day Calendar —



On March 16, National Panda Day draws attention to one of the world's unique bears. Pandas are also one of the world's most endangered and adored animals. Conservationists and animal lovers alike spread the word about the increasing efforts of the international community dedicated to protecting and restoring habitats.

#NationalPandaDay

Native to China, giant pandas are members of the Bear (Ursidae) family. Their rapidly shrinking habitat is a major cause for concern. As an endangered species, successful panda breeding programs are rare. In the wild, there are approximately only 1,864 (according to the World Wide Fund for Nature) and 100 living in zoos around the world.

With their white face and black eyes and body, panda bears are easily identifiable. However, their black and white coloring was designed for their natural habitat. They disappear into the snowy mountains and temperate forests of southwest China. And despite their sweet disposition, they tend to isolate themselves in the wild. They eat mostly plants and do not hibernate in the winter like many other bears.

HOW TO OBSERVE NATIONAL PANDA DAY

- 1. Share your love for pandas! You can do that by learning more about them and supporting panda sanctuaries.
- 2. Promote ways to protect their shrinking habitat.
- 3. Support breeding and research programs.
- 4. Watch a documentary about pandas.

Panda FAQ

Q. Do pandas only eat bamboo?

A. No. Panda bears also forage for certain kinds of vegetables and grains. They will also eat eggs and small animals like carnivores do. Perhaps the most surprising thing they eat is carrion.

Q. Do pandas have thumbs?

A. No but they do have an enlarged wrist bone that functions much like a thumb.

Q. Do pandas climb trees?

A. Yes. They also swim.

Q. Do pandas hibernate?

A. Unlike other bears, pandas do not hibernate.



Open Space (Pilot) Program

A proposal for an affordable practical insurance policy for aquifer protection and water quality while lending to carbon, climate, and CO2 issues.

What is open space?

Different things to different people. A field, a farm, a forest, a ranch, a park. Lends itself to eco systems and wildlife. A place to produce food and fiber. Airshed, viewshed, and watershed.

What is the value?

Priceless and irreplaceable. Like lake front property, they aren't making it anymore. Top of the list should be to protect the aquifer. It is without a doubt the key to everything we value. At some point, a million people will depend on it for residential, commercial, industrial, recreation and the future. This program, while adding incentives for open space, would not completely lock up lands. Rather, it would give landowners the ability to opt in or opt out as dynamics required.

What lands and open space would qualify?

Example: 40 acres over or adjacent to the aquifer. Larger parcels with connectivity should have a higher value than smaller parcels. Sensitive parcels such as aquifer recharge zones, or lands that contribute to should also have a higher value. These working lands could be entered in 5 or 10 year intervals with the ability to opt in or opt out as needed with incentives to carry on.

Family owned farms or ranches would most likely use these funds for capital improvements. Land speculators or investors may not reinvest in their soil.

Who could score and rate these lands?

Kootenai Shoshone Soil & Water Conservation District (this district could also implement this plan, ie: boat check stations). Aquifer Protection District, Farm Service Administration — USDA (NRCS), Kootenai Shoshone Farm Bureau, Kootenai Shoshone Cattle Association. These boards and agencies would provide a built in check and balance, as they are either appointed or elected officials and non partisan.

How to raise funding to help preserve these lands?

Wait for donations and volunteers? How is that going so far? Grants? Bill Gates? Expand existing aquifer protection fee to include open space protection and retention. Based on a 100,000 taxable parcels in Kootenai County. Rental units? We need to look to Spokane County to contribute to this program. Industries could possibly purchase aquifer credits to facilitate funding. Conservation easements aren't doing the job alone.

Why work with agriculture and forestry?

We are the only industries that offer hope, and the ability to protect land, air, water, carbon, and climate. Airshed, viewshed, watershed. For the most part we are not causing problems and require very few services but yet subsidize growth. In a sense, these fees would pay for services already rendered.

In closing, we already have the **right people doing the right thing, agriculture and forestry**. A voluntary sign up program that land owners could partake in (per acre/per year) to help supplement ever increasing operating costs and the persistent drought patterns we are dealing with. This would be beneficial and offer some relief for the price of a Starbucks' coffee.

This is less of a tax and more an insurance policy for the future. Open space lends itself to positive mental health.

A successful politician once said, "it's the economy stupid." The aquifer is the economy!!!!!!

- Hydrocarbons from traffic.
- No meaningful production of agriculture or forestry.
- Lack of connectivity for wildlife and ecosystems.

What is the overall carbon footprint?

- The "build out" of the prairie is not the answer.
- We can not allow the airport and land applications sites for effluent to be the only open space on the Rathdrum





An Irish Twist on Potato Pancakes for St. Patrick's Day

I came across an old Irish rhyme that goes: "Boxty on the griddle, boxty in the pan, if you can't make boxty, you'll never get a man!" And thought, What? I don't need another man, but this "boxty" thing intrigues me.

So, this year I unearthed and reworked an old favorite, Irish Boxty, the holy grail of pancakes for potato lovers! They're made with a mix of mashed and grated potatoes. They're crispy on the edges, pillowy and creamy in the middle and exactly the kind of peasant food we love - hearty, economical and endlessly versatile.

Boxties can be served sweet or savory, just as you might serve biscuits alongside a meal. They can be enjoyed simply with butter or sprinkled with sugar, as a side dish for any meal, or as a base for wonderful toppings.

Our boxties are served with sausage and topped with a buttery, boozy mushroom mixture called Drunken Mushrooms. In honor of St. Paddy's Day, I added a handful of green spinach and used Irish whisky to deglaze the pan, but you could use other liquors or even just a splash of broth.

Yield: 4 to 6 servings

Total Time: 1 hour

2 pounds (6 to 8) russet potatoes 3/4 cup all-purpose flour

3/4 teaspoon kosher salt, plus more for water

1/2 teaspoon baking powder 1/4 teaspoon black pepper 1/2 cup whole milk

1 large egg 3 to 4 tablespoons butter

Peel half of the potatoes and cut into 1-inch pieces. Place them into a medium saucepan, cover with salted water by an inch, then bring to a simmer. Cook until the potatoes are tender, about 15 minutes. Drain the cooked

potatoes, mash until smooth and place into a large mixing bowl.

Meanwhile, as those potatoes are cooking, preheat oven to 200 F. Peel the remaining potatoes and grate with a box grater. Wrap the raw grated potatoes in a kitchen towel and squeeze out as much liquid as possible. Add the grated potatoes to the bowl with the mashed potatoes. Add the flour, salt, baking powder, pepper, milk and egg, stirring until incorporated.

Heat a large heavy skillet over medium heat until hot. Melt half the butter, then, cooking in small batches, add the batter 1/2 cup at a time, flattening the boxties with a spatula. Turn them occasionally, and cook until golden, about 8 minutes per batch. Make sure you get the edges browned and crispy, because they are to die for. Place cooked boxties on a baking sheet in the preheated oven to keep warm as you repeat with the remaining patties, adding butter to the pan as needed.

DRUNKEN MUSHROOMS

Yield: 2 cups Total Time: 15 minutes

2 tablespoons butter

2 cloves minced garlic 1 pound mushrooms (button or cremini), thinly sliced

I tablespoon liquor of choice (marsala, Irish whisky, sherry or broth) 1/2 teaspoon dried thyme

1 cup fresh spinach, optional

Heat a skillet over medium heat, add butter. Place minced garlic in the skillet and saute for 1 minute. Add the mushrooms and saute, stirring frequently, until mush-rooms are cooked through and golden. Add liquor of choice or broth, should you prefer sober mushrooms. Add thyme and stir, letting the liquor evaporate. Add spinach, if using. Stir to wilt the spinach. Serve with boxty.

While I can't guarantee you'll get a man, I guarantee you're in for a treat. This Irish Boxty recipe is simple, delicious and makes the best potato pancakes. Happy St. Patrick's





Wild Animal Threat in Tennessee

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: I read vour recent column about whether cats will be threatened by snakes or other wildlife in rural Tennessee. I lived over 50 years in Henrietta, New York; I had raccoons, possums, deer, foxes, skunks and a plethora of other animals in my backyard every night — many more than when I lived in Oak Ridge, Tennessee. Tell your reader not to worry: Almost all wild animals are much more (for good reason) afraid of you than you should be of them. Just ignore them, and you probably won't get to enjoy them and have all the pleasure I do in seeing them in my yard. If you have a cat, you should probably keep it in at night, but they should be in anyhow. Hope this helps. — N.Z.C.

DEAR N.Z.C.: Thank you for the information! Wild animal activity can vary quite a bit depending on your region, how close you are to a town or city, the amount of undeveloped property or a wildlife reserve adjacent to your home, and more.

It can even vary from neighborhood to neighborhood. For example, when I relocated from one area outside of Boston to another, the wildlife in my yard shifted drastically. I had put up with free-roaming turkeys and the occasional glimpse of a coyote in the early mornings on my suburban street for years; in my new neighborhood, the only wild pests were rabbits, with no nearby predators to keep their numbers down.

In short, enjoy the rural life, make sure trash-can lids are secure, and don't worry too much about predators menacing you and your pets. They prefer to stay out of your way.

NAC Supplement Helps Curb Cravings to Smoke

DEAR DR. ROACH: I'd like to have your thoughts on what value the NAC supplement may have in reducing cravings for marijuana or nicotine?

I'm 73 and have been smoking marijuana daily since I was 21. Now I'm quitting for health reasons. I've been taking 1,000 mg of NAC every morning, as I've read it helps with smoking cravings. It also seems to be used for anxiety and other mental health issues, lung and heart problems ... the list

I'm not going to smoke anymore, but I'm just wondering what your take is on this, as I'm thinking of sending it to my 38-year-old son who's been addicted to vaping/cigarettes since he was a young man. He has ADD, anxiety and problems with breath capacity, and he may have heart problems as well. He's smoking to relieve his ADD and anxiety. And, of course, he'd like to quit, but it's so hard to do so.

Can the NAC supplement help me with the urge to smoke? I think it has reduced the cravings, but how would I even know? - M.M.

ANSWER: N-acetyl cysteine, a precursor to the amino acid cysteine, has several roles in medicine, as you say. When inhaled, it breaks up mucous, which helps people cough out thick sputum. When used intravenously, it's a specific antidote to acetaminophen (Tylenol) overdose. It has been used

in these capacities for years and is safe and well-

But, in addition, there is data that shows oral NAC (sold as a dietary supplement) may have a role in helping people overcome addictions to tobacco, with small trials showing a reduction in smoking as well as the relapse rate in people using NAC compared with a placebo.

In people who want to reduce their cannabis use, most of the data on NAC has been on younger people (adolescents and young adults), but also shows some benefit. More stringent trials are ongoing.

It is very difficult for a single person (patient or physician) to tell whether it's a "real" effect or a placebo" effect that is causing the reduction in cravings. Only large-scale, placebo-controlled trials can show with confidence whether the treatment is more effective than a placebo. But, since the supplement is inexpensive and highly safe, and since a third-party lab found that the brands of NAC sold at reputable stores are what they say they are, I say it might be helpful.

However, there are many other products that are proven to be safe and effective to help with quitting smoking, ranging from group tobacco cessation classes, to nicotine replacement therapy, to prescription medications like varenicline and bupropion – all of which have many years of proven clinical efficacy.

Finally, there are a lot of people with attention deficit/hyperactivity disorder who are not getting appropriate treatment as adults. Getting treatment by an expert in ADD might make quitting smoking easier and may also improve many other areas of functioning for your son.



Edible Bird Nests Imitate Nature

Make simple no-bake bird's nest treats with your kids to celebrate spring. Drop peanut M&Ms or natural-looking candy eggs in each one. Or for Easter, substitute jelly beans, tucking the nests in Easter baskets or setting them at each table setting for Easter Sunday dinner. Either way, these nests that imitate nature are adorable to look at, and with the chocolate-peanut-butter combo, they taste so good too.


Bird's Nest Treats

- 2 1/2 cups plain crushed natural shredded wheat cereal (young kids like the job of crushing it in their hands)
- 1/2 cup chopped nuts, such as almonds and pecans (optional)
- 1 cup semisweet chocolate chips or butterscotch chips
- 1/2 cup creamy or crunchy peanut butter
- 1 tablespoon butter

- Jelly beans, peanut M&M's or candy that resembles speckled bird eggs
- 1. Stir together the crushed shredded wheat and chopped nuts in a large mixing bowl.
- 2. An adult should melt the chips, peanut butter and butter in a double boiler or heavy saucepan to a smooth consistency, stirring frequently. Pour the mixture over the shredded wheat cereal mixture and stir lightly until well-coated.
- 3. Drop 2 tablespoons of the "nest" ingredients in muffin pan cups lined with aluminum foil. Let your child shape the mini nests by making an indentation using their clean fingers or the back of a spoon. Chill to set.
- 4. Carefully peel off the foil and arrange molded nests on plates or set into baskets. Set "eggs" in the nests. Keep extra nests refrigerated until ready to serve. Makes about 18 small nests.


TIP: Instead of candies, fill the nests with "fruity" bird eggs. Try red or green grapes, blueberries or melon balls.

Stoneware Crock

There were many small potteries making stoneware and other ceramics for use in the kitchen, bedroom or farm. Most utensils made in America by the 1800s were made with thick pottery sides in simple shapes with almost no decoration.

The most expensive examples collected today have a design or name on the crock to trace for the age and maker. But unsigned pieces are often identified when sold at auctions. That takes an expert; a family legend is not enough.

Conestoga Auction Company often sells antique and vintage stoneware. Is the side curved or straight? Is there a shaped rim? Is the interior glazed in the same color as the outside or is the inside different? Are there quirks in the shaping of the bottom? These clues can be recognized from a picture, but contact the auction and ask how they knew the maker of the unsigned piece.

This crock is similar to others attributed to Shenfelder Pottery of Reading, Pennsylvania. It has an impressed mark of the numeral "1" inside a coggle wheel circle. It has a blue hand-painted leafy branch on the outside. "Daniel Peter Shenfelder Reading Pa." is a known mark. The Conestoga catalog said it was "attributed," not definitely identified, but the auction house is close to the pottery building and has sold many stoneware utensils. This crock sold for \$170 after 10 bids.

• How can I tell new from old • milk glass?

• Antique bottles have become • collectors' items, especially those made in rare colors. Less-expensive bottles with secure closures were used by the 1930s. Milk glass bottles with attractive women's portraits as the label-under-glass were often the decorations in a Victorian barber shop. Modern copies have been made. Old milk glass is opaque and may be pure white, pale green, robin's-egg blue, pink or black. Milk glass was not used for dinner plates but was used for doorknobs, lamps, vases and knickknacks like salt and peppers. They

even made reusable figural milk glass store contains for mustard. When buying, look at milk glass carefully. Old glass is smooth and often marked with a shape or pattern number. There are many vintage and new copies that sell for very low prices.

Make Pounded Pansy Pouches



I don't know a young child who doesn't love a hammer. Watch when kids grab one tightly in both small hands, lift it high and pound. Thud! They see it do something. It might only be a nick on a board, or, if lucky, they'll hit a nail square on. Throughout the action, it's a thrilling feeling of control and an introduction to the adult world.

Hammers can be the perfect tool for kids to make imprints of fragile flowers, too. When they tap, tap, tap a

wax-paper-covered flower on fabric, they magically see the bloom's natural colors and shapes appear right before their eyes.

No wonder families recently filled the benches at a craft booth at our local weekend farmer's market. Pounding natural designs of violet pansies onto fabric was the first step. Then the children learned to hand-sew pouches with simple stitches after the pounding. Even some preschoolers could sew handily with adult assistance.

Here's how:

- 1. Cut two pieces of plain white cotton or muslin fabric 2-3/4 inch wide by 3 inches long with pinking shears.
- 2. Put one of the fabric pieces on a cutting board or a flat piece of wood. Carefully set a fresh pansy bloom in the middle of the fabric -- front side down and stem side up. Cover it with a sheet of wax paper and hammer over the wax-paper-covered flower until its color has been absorbed into the fabric. Remove the wax paper and pansy to reveal the natural, colorful floral design.
- 3. It's time to sew the two fabric pieces together to form the neck pouch. Thread a large needle with a 30-inch length of embroidery floss. Stack the fabric pieces with the floral print on top and, beginning at the top right corner, sew the sides and bottom together with a running stitch. Guide your child's hands when needed. When complete, remove the needle and knot the end of the floss to the starting corner of the pouch.

Place the pouch around your child's neck and put a coin or some treasure inside.



Speedy Spanish Rice Is Easy, Versatile and

This week we have a very popular one-pot meal seasoned with a little bit of versatility. This family-friendly dinner is an extremely inexpensive yet soul-satisfying meal. It comes together fast, making it perfect for busy weeknight dinners. And one skillet? Yes, please and thank you!

The real beauty of the recipe is you can substitute any kind of protein for the hamburger I used. You could use ground or shredded turkey, pork, chicken, or go meatless with beans or meat-free crumbles. This makes it a perfect recipe to have on repeat, knowing you can make it with whatever is on sale this week.

Using brown rice in this recipe boosts nutrition and fiber. But because brown rice takes 45 minutes to cook, this speedy recipe calls for pre-cooked rice. Considering it takes the same 45 minutes to make four cups of brown rice or 12 cups of brown rice. I recommend making a big pot o'rice then dividing and freezing it into meal-ready portions. Anything that helps get a healthy meal on the table quickly is a good thing.

If you prefer white rice or don't happen to have cooked rice on hand, I've included the white rice quick fix.

SPEEDY SPANISH RICE

Yield: 4 servings Total Time: 20 minutes

What You'll Need: 1 pound (85/15) ground beef Salt and pepper to taste

1 (16 ounce) bag frozen pepper and onion blend, thawed

(8 ounce) can tomato sauce (14.5 ounce) can diced tomatoes

with green chilies

1 teaspoon ground cumin

1 teaspoon chili powder

1/2 teaspoon garlic powder 1/4 teaspoon salt

3 cups cooked brown rice (see note

below)* 1 cup cheddar or Mexican blend

cheese, shredded Chopped green onions and/or cilantro, optional



This Spanish rice dish is comforting and delicious.

Here's How:

In a large skillet, over medium-high heat, cook hamburger, breaking it into crumbles, until beef is no longer pink. Season with salt and pepper to taste. Drain the excess fat and liquid from the pan. You don't have to drain it all; a little liquid is good. Next, add the onion and pepper blend and cook until the onion is translucent. Stir in the tomato sauce, tomatoes and seasonings; bring to a boil. Add rice; heat through, stirring occasionally. Let this simmer for at least 5 minutes to marry the flavors. Before serving, sprinkle cheese on top and cover with a lid for a minute to melt the cheese. Garnish with green onions and cilantro, if desired. And trust me, you desire. Serving suggestions: All you need is a big salad and call it done.

*Note: If you don't have pre-cooked rice, just add 1 cup of uncooked white rice (not brown, it takes too long) and 2 cups chicken broth when you add the tomatoes and bring to a boil. Cover and reduce heat to a simmer for 20 minutes. Continue as written above.

This popular dish has many variations. I believe every family has their own "perfect and only" way to prepare Spanish rice. Here's a list of items you could add, and no

one would be mad at you: green or black olives; corn; sour cream; green chilis; pinto, black or red kidney beans. And more cheese. We always need more cheese,

What's the difference between Spanish rice and Mexican rice? Spanish rice gets its yellow color from saffron (which is ridiculously expensive!). Mexican rice, meanwhile, takes on a unique reddish orange color by adding cumin and chili powder.

No matter how you make it, you'll love this simply comforting delish Spanish dish.

New Boat Validation Decals Required

— Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks —

HELENA - Owners of motorboats, sailboats or personal watercraft need to get new, free 2023-2026 validation decals for their watercraft soon. The current red decals expire Feb. 28.

Boaters who have permanently registered their boats, sailboats, or PWC must still obtain two free boat validation decals every three years at FWP regional and area offices, or by going to the FWP website at fwp.mt.gov/activities/boating.

Owners who order validation decals on the FWP website will receive the decals in the mail. Information included on a current boat registration receipt issued by the county treasurer is needed to obtain the decals in person or on FWP's website.

For new boat or personal watercraft owners, the county treasurer's office will provide the first set of validation decals when the watercraft is registered. Boat owners will obtain subsequent sets of validation decals at a FWP regional or area office, or online.

National K9 Veterans Day March 13th

— National Day Calendar —



March 13th recognizes National K9 Veterans Day and the dedicated K9 units who've served since World War II.

A lot of things changed after the bombing of Pearl Harbor in 1941. We rationed oil, leather, and rubber. The military draft men into service. Women rolled up their sleeves and built war supplies.

And dogs were called to duty. During the first world war, the United States took notice of the European use of canines as sentries, message carriers, and several other functions.

A private citizen, Mrs. Alene Erlanger initiated a program called Dogs for Defense. Along with the American Kennel Club and a handful of breeders, the group aimed to train the dogs for military use.

By November of 1942, the military prepared the first Dogs for Defense for duty in North Africa. While they were gun shy at first, they proved to be well trained.

As the war progressed, Dogs for Defense was unable to keep up with the demand, and the Remount Branch, Service Installations Divisions took over the training of the dogs.

Over the years, the military, police, and rescue have developed a variety of training methods for K9 units. Their training is tailored to meet the demands of the iob, and each animal and handler carries out his or her duties to the fullest.
