American Diabetes Association Alert Day is observed annually on the fourth Tuesday in March. This one-day "wake-up call" informs the American public about the seriousness of diabetes and encourages all to take the diabetes risk test and learn about your family's history of diabetes.

Diabetes Facts:

- Diabetes impacts approximately 34.2 million Americans. That's about 10.5 percent of the U.S. population.
- Of those living with diabetes, 7.3 million 1 in 7 adults - don't know they have it.
- · The risk of developing diabetes increases with age. But there are other factors, too. Ethnic background may increase your risk.
- · An additional 1.5 million Americans are diagnosed with diabetes each year.

There are two types of diabetes. While Type 1 diabetes is not as preventable, it can be managed well with insulin injections. Managing Type 1 diabetes might also require frequent blood sugar monitoring, eating healthy foods, exercising regularly, and maintaining a healthy weight. Education is key to learning how to manage symptoms of Type 1 diabetes. However, type 2 is much more preventable, and some actions can be taken.

Ways to Prevent Type 2 Diabetes:

- Eliminate sugar and refined carbs
- · Work out regularly and avoid a sedentary lifestyle
- · Make water the primary beverage
- · Maintain a healthy weight

Men With Factor V Leiden Can Still **Receive Testosterone Therapy**

DEAR DR. ROACH: I have Factor V Leiden, but I have been wanting to do testosterone replacement therapy. I have heard that testosterone causes blood clots. Obviously, with FVL, that would be a huge deal for me. Is this true? Does it cause clots, or is it safe for me to do? – R.C.

ANSWER: Factor V Leiden is a common genetic variant that increases a person's risk for developing a blood clot. However, a person who has never had a blood clot, but who is identified as heterozygous (meaning they only have one copy of the gene) for factor V Leiden, is still not likely to have a blood clot during their lifetime and is not recommended for treatment to prevent a blood clot.

Testosterone replacement therapy in men with FVL does increase the risk of blood clots in some studies, but not in others. In the studies that have shown an increase in risk, the risk has been estimated as approximately one person per thousand treated with testosterone each year. However, the risk occurs mostly during the first three months, and after two vears on treatment, there is no additional risk. Thus, roughly one man per 500 who has FVL and gets treated with testosterone will get a clot, according to the studies that show an increase in risk.

This is a small risk, but a blood clot is a significant potential problem. So, the risk of getting a clot should certainly go into the discussion about whether to give testosterone replacement to a man with FVL and symptomatic low testosterone levels. Most of the men I have seen with this issue have elected to take the replacement.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I would like to hear your views on the use of medium chain triglycerides (MCT) to slow down memory loss and dementia. Several articles I have read extol the biological process of MCTs, which - when ingested by an individual are quickly converted into ketones that provide energy to brain cells. It seems logical to provide such neurobiological support to brain cells, to help keep the brain working longer. – K.J.W.

ANSWER: There is some evidence that MCTs slow progression of dementia in people with Alzheimer's disease, although the degree of benefit seen was small. There is no evidence that ingesting MCTs will prevent a person from getting dementia in the first

Not every treatment that is used to treat a condition will be effective at preventing it. My opinion, based on what is known about what causes Alzheimer's and other forms of dementia, is that MCTs are not likely to prevent them, but they may be useful at slowing progression of the disease in people with existing dementia.

I want to emphasize that the benefit appears to be small. Of course, there aren't any treatments right now (not even the prescription medications for Alzheimer's disease) that dramatically improve Alzheimer's, so MCTs may be worth trying. They are generally well-tolerated and can be taken as a powder or an oil, but may cause nausea or diarrhea in a few people who take them.

Savvy Shopping: Why Frozen Spinach Is the Best Bargain for Healthy Eating

What's the best bargain in the frozen foods aisle? Want to guess, or shall I just tell you? OK, I'll tell you. It's frozen spinach in the little 10-ounce box. Tada!

Spinach makes me think of Popeye the Sailor Man. Every time he found himself in a perilous situation, he'd rip the top off a can of spinach, chug it down, and beat up the bad guys with his bulging forearms. The spinach was magical, like it was ... a superfood.

Now, we all know dark leafy greens actually are superfoods, and spinach is one of the most nutrient-dense of all foods. It's a great source of iron and other minerals, cancer-fighting antioxidants and vitamins A and K, which are important to bone health. It's good to note that cooking spinach increases access to nutrients. We should be eating more of this, right?

However, have you ever sauteed a huge mound of fresh spinach only to watch it wilt down to nothing? The major benefit of buying frozen spinach is having someone else do the wilting first, then pass the savings on to you.

Let's do a price comparison between fresh and frozen spinach, shall we?

One pound (16 ounces) of fresh spinach cooks down to 1 1/4 cups drained, which is equal to one (10ounce) frozen package. At the time of writing (and at various stores in the Pacific Northwest), one (8-ounce) bag of fresh spinach costs between \$3 and \$6, and a 10-ounce box of frozen spinach costs between \$1 and \$2 dollars.

Here's the deal: It'll take two 8-ounce bags of fresh spinach to equal 10 ounces frozen. That's \$6 to \$12 fresh compared to \$1 to \$2 frozen. So it's definitely cheaper to buy frozen, and that's a big bang for your buck.

But frozen spinach isn't just a great bargain, it's also incredibly versatile. You can use it in pretty much any recipe that calls for cooked fresh spinach. Just don't go tossing it in your salad. That's just weird.

EASY CHEESY SPINACH PIE

Yield: 6 pieces

Total Time: 50 minutes

1 box (10 ounce) frozen chopped spinach, thawed, drained

4 eggs

1 container (16 ounce) cottage cheese 2 cups mozzarella or Italian blend cheese, shredded

1/2 cup Parmesan cheese, grated 1 teaspoon Italian seasoning 1/4 teaspoon ground nutmeg See optional ingredients below.

Preheat oven to 350 F. Grease a 9-inch pie plate or spray with cooking spray. Defrost spinach and squeeze dry by wringing in a clean kitchen towel, then set aside.

In a mixing bowl, beat the eggs then add all the remaining ingredients, mixing until blended.

Pour the mixture into the prepared pie plate and bake for 40 minutes or until the center is set.

If you want to dirty a skillet, you could saute and add any (or all) of the following optional ingredients: 1/2 cup chopped onion, 1/2 cup chopped red peppers, or 1/2 cup sliced mushrooms.





- · The way some items are packaged these days, you need to be Houdini to get into them. When you're dealing with blister packs - items sealed inside a hard plastic wrapper that looks to be heat crimped on the outsides - try your can opener. You can run it around the edge of stubborn plastic packages, enough to get the item out. It's more secure than a carpet knife or razor.
- Want to be able to tell at a glance which key belongs to the front door, the shed, your grandma's house, etc.? Raid your (or your wife's or daughter's) stash of nail polish to paint the tops of keys to color code them.
- "Styrofoam trays that come with meat or in the produce area are very handy helpers for lots of little jobs. If yours are clean and unmarred, wash with hot, soapy water, rinse and dry for later. 



Lewiston High School Students Participating in UI Extension Program Discover New Aquatic Invader

University of Idaho —



MOSCOW, Idaho — March 9, 2023 — A Lewiston High School teacher and two of her former students recently became published authors in a peer-reviewed scientific journal based on their discovery while participating in a University of Idaho Extension citizens' science program.

For the past seven years, UI Extension's IDAH20 program has provided hands-on learning opportunities for Lewiston High School teacher Jamie Morton's ecology and environmental science classes, which sample water and trap invertebrates in local watersheds. Morton shares their data to help UI Extension assess the health of Idaho's waterways.

In October 2021, one of Morton's IDAH20 field trips uncovered an important scientific finding that led state and federal water managers to take action.

While investigating a pair of municipal stormwater ponds near the confluence of the Snake and Clearwater rivers, Morton's class trapped a crustacean they later confirmed to be Idaho's first known red swamp crayfish. If the aquatic invader multiplies in the surrounding environment, it could harm water quality and native species.

For their discovery, Morton and former students Elizabeth Connerley and Robert Bayless are among the listed authors of a paper published online this week in the journal "BioInvasions Records." Their publication will also appear in the quarterly journal's June print edition.

"It's a genuine, honest discovery. And I hope it creates more buy-in with my classes as we go on, especially when it's officially published," Morton said. "We can make a contribution just being normal citizens. You don't have to go to college and you don't have to become a scientist in your day job to be interested and take care of your environment."

Throughout the past decade, IDAH2O has taught basic water quality monitoring techniques to more than 600 citizen scientists from throughout the Pacific Northwest. Active participants receive pH test strips, kits for measuring dissolved oxygen in water and other basic supplies to record stream data, which they upload via a web app.

In addition to having volunteers collect data on stream health, Jim Ekins, UI Extension water educator and director of IDAH20, trains his volunteers to identify and report crayfish species for River Mile, which is a network of educators and students who study crayfish in the Pacific Northwest to better understand stream health.

Ekins also partners with like-minded organizations in Idaho, eastern Washington and eastern Oregon, training other trainers for IDAH20.

"We think citizen science may be a good way to find new invasions of invasive species. There are that many more eyeballs," Ekins said. "Plus, we are teaching kids science, being observant and writing things down. Those are skills you need for any job."

Typically, Morton's classes trap and identify one of Idaho's three native crayfish species. The red coloration and bumpy, pointy claws made the red swamp crayfish specimen relatively easy for the class to identify by comparing it with River Mile photographs. A cravfish expert confirmed their suspicions, which were reaffirmed through DNA

Two of Morton's students — Connerley and Bayless were captivated by the discovery and continued trapping crayfish outside of class in the following weeks. They trapped six more red swamp crayfish from the ponds, proving the original finding wasn't an isolated occurrence. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has continued monitoring the ponds and the surrounding area.

"The best part was seeing the students who wanted to participate and were motivated to continue doing it because they wanted to," Morton said.



Unusual Coyote Behavior Reported In Bonner County In North Idaho

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game —



There have been several reports of highly unusual coyote behavior in and around Sandpoint in **North Idaho**

Idaho Fish and Game has received multiple reports of highly unusual coyote behavior in and around the city of Sandpoint in Bonner County.

In early Jan., reports were received of coyotes on Schweitzer Mountain Ski Resort that were chasing skiers as they navigated down the slopes. Fish and Game staff worked closely with resort staff to develop a plan to dispatch the coyotes in the interest of public safety.

Before the coyotes could be located and dispatched, one bit a female skier. Although her injuries were minor, Fish and Game and Schweitzer Mountain Resort took the matter very seriously. Collaborative efforts are still underway to trap and dispatch the offending covotes.

During the week of Jan. 22, Fish and Game received reports of two coyotes roaming a business district near downtown Sandpoint. The animals were reported to appear comfortable in the presence of human activity during daylight hours, which is highly unusual.

Fish and Game Conservation Officers consulted with local law enforcement to capture and dispatch the animals, again in the interest of public safety. One coyote was captured and dispatched, and efforts are still underway to capture the remaining animal.

The body of the dispatched coyote has been retained for further testing, if needed.

Coyote behavior

It is unknown what is causing these coyotes to behave so abnormally. Reports of coyotes being comfortable near and even attacking humans are extremely rare, as they are often secretive and largely nocturnal animals.

There are very few documented cases of rabies in land mammals in Idaho, so it is unlikely these coyotes are rabid. Although coyotes are known to defend dens with pups, pup season occurs in April and May, which is several months from now.

The most probable explanation for their behavior is habituation to humans, which most often occurs when wild animals are fed by humans. When wild animals become habituated to human presence or food sources, they can behave uncharacteristically and become dangerous to people. It is suspected this was the case with the coyotes involved in these incidents.

If you or someone you know sees a covote on Schweitzer Mountain Ski Resort or in and around Sandpoint, please contact the Panhandle Regional office immediately at (208) 769-1414 to report the incident. Please do not approach the animal or attempt to feed, touch or harass it.

March's Wildlife Express Newsletter Wades Through The Lives Of Idaho's Shorebirds

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game –



Of the 38 species that have been seen in Idaho, most only visit our state for brief stops during migration.

When folks think about tropical, sandy beaches, Idaho doesn't usually come to mind. Well, as far as humans go. As for the subjects of March's Wildlife Express newsletter, on the other hand, Idaho's shorelines are a five-star resort.

Shorebirds is a broad term, used to define birds that, you guessed it, inhabit shorelines. Composed of sandpipers, phalaropes, plovers, avocets and stilts, shorebirds are charismatic little birds that enjoy long walks on the beach—including river shores, marshes and mud flats. Their bodies are often small, supported by toothpick-like legs that enable them to wade through muddy terrain. Their beaks are typically long and narrow like needle-nose pliers, helping them pick up tiny invertebrates buried down in the water and mud.

Sandpipers tend to be the most recognizable member of the shorebird family; however, sandpiper is an umbrella term and is comprised of 87 individual species, including the recognizable least sandpiper and the long-billed curlew — the largest shorebird in North America.

Plovers are another interesting shorebird that have a clever trick. When a predator gets too close to their nest, killdeer and other plovers will fake a broken wing to lure the predator away. Once the predator is out of range, the bird flies off.

In fact, flying is a big part of a shorebird's daily routine. Of the 38 species that have been seen in Idaho, most only visit our state for brief stops during migration.

Shorebird Facts

- Almost 217 species have been identified around the world.
- Many sandpipers nest in the Arctic. The rest of the year is spent near open water.
- Plovers will sometimes hunt by tapping their feet which disturbs the water or soil. This makes prey animals move, so the plover can see the prey and grab it.
- Populations of many shorebirds are decreasing. Habitat loss is a major reason.
- One of the truly long-distance shorebird migrants is the bar-tailed godwit. This dove-sized shorebird makes a nonstop journey of 7,200 miles, traveling from Alaska to New Zealand for the winter.
- One banded red knot has flown the distance between the Earth and moon and half-way back in his lifetime of 21-plus years. This equals 358,500 miles!
- Birds that make nonstop flights, like the bartailed godwit, also shrink some of the body organs they do not need during migration.

The unique production features student dance choreography performed to original, live music composed by music faculty members and students. It is a family event, described as eclectic, playful, entertaining, high energy and imaginative.



Aquatic Invasive New Zealand Mudsnails Discovered In Silverbow Creek

– Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks –

Recreationists should clean, drain, dry all equipment to minimize spread

WARM SRPINGS- New Zealand mudsnails, an aquatic invasive species that can have a long-lasting impact on local waters, were discovered last week in Silverbow Creek near the outlet of Warm Springs Ponds. This is the first time mudsnails have been detected in the Upper Clark Fork watershed.

So far Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks fisheries staff have only found two dead mudsnails in Silverbow Creek but will conduct follow-up surveys when the weather warms and it is more effective to find snails.

New Zealand mud snails are an aquatic invasive species found in a variety of waterbodies across Montana. The snails have the ability to expand in population size and distribution very rapidly, potentially changing the ecology of waterbodies where they are located. Once established, they are hard, if not impossible to eradicate.

In Montana, New Zealand mud snails were first detected in 1995 in the Madison River and have since spread to the Beaverhead, Jefferson, Bighorn, Upper Missouri, and Upper Yellowstone Riv-

New Zealand mudsnails can survive for weeks out of the water and are easily transported on wading boots. The source of the recent mudsnail introduction was most likely due to angler wading gear that carried the snail from one body of water to another.

Prevention is the key to minimizing the spread of aquatic invasives. That's why FWP urges anglers to clean, drain, and dry all equipment after each use, especially after visiting infested waters. If you see what looks like a New Zealand mudsnail, report it at fwp.mt.gov/conservation/aquatic-invasive-species/report-an-ais.

North Idaho's Clagstone **Meadows After Five Years Of Being Open To The Public**

– Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game –



The public continues to enjoy access to Clagstone Meadows in Bonner County.

Clagstone Meadows, a well-known expanse of timberland in Bonner County, has been open to the public since 2017. Although the land is privately owned by Stimson Lumber Company, several partners worked with Stimson to permanently secure the land under a conservation easement that protects 13,169 acres of lands in Clagstone Meadows and 1,266 acres in the Cape Horn area.

Since 2018 and as part of the conservation easement, invested partners have worked diligently to monitor the public's use of the Clagstone Meadows property using registration cards (monitoring does not occur on the Cape Horn parcels). Below is a quick summary of what has been learned from 2018-2022.

- Average visitation is 2.9 people per day, or over 1,000 visitors annually
- The majority of use each year occurs during Oct. and Nov.
- Hunters are the most common user group of the property, most notably during Oct. and Nov.
- General recreational use of the property peaks in April and May
- Most visitors enter the property through the north gate
- · Over 90% of the users are Idaho residents

These metrics are important, as the intent of the conservation easement was to benefit local economies, wildlife, clean water and recreation.

This conservation easement protects working forests and supplies timber to the local saw mills, benefitting local economies. The properties provide important habitat for a variety of big game, small game and non-game species; land that is now preserved in perpetuity. The property sits above an important water recharge area for the Spokane Valley-Rathdrum Prairie Aquifer, which provides drinking water for over 500,000 people. Lastly the property is being used by a variety of recreational users each year. Across the board, partners are very pleased with the success of Clagstone Meadows.


Non-motorized access to the Clagstone property is available through 4 access points with parking areas, known as "Gates". Clagstone Meadows maps and access rules can found at idfg.idaho.gov/d7/ access/other.

A quick history lesson

Although the fate of Clagstone Meadows is now secure, this was not always the case. In 2010, a development plan for two golf courses and 1,200 homes was conditionally approved on the property. Thankfully, midway through the approval process, Stimson began evaluating alternatives which prompted conversations about a conservation easement with Idaho Department of Lands, Idaho Fish and Game and the Trust for Public Land.

Through close collaboration, project partners and Stimson were able to successfully craft the conservation easement, resulting in maintaining over 14,000 acres of working forests from development, while providing over 10,000 acres of land being opened to the public in perpetuity. Stimson and all project partners celebrated the conservation easement and the many benefits future generations would enjoy because of it.

Idaho Department of Lands Forest Legacy Program, Fish and Game and The Trust for Public Land raised \$9.5 million to purchase the easement, which included federal funding from the Forest Legacy Program and Pittman-Robertson Wildlife Restoration Act.



In conjunction with Stimson's collaboration on the crafting of the conservation easement, they sold the easement at significantly less than full market value – a conservation donation that will forever benefit the people of Idaho.

The Idaho Department of Lands administers Idaho's Forest Legacy Program through the Forestry Assistance Bureau. To date, this program has successfully conserved approximately 102,000 acres of privately owned working forestland in Idaho. In addition, IDL manages more than 2.4 million acres of Idaho endowment lands, for the benefit of endowments, primarily public schools.

The Trust for Public Land creates parks and protects land for people, ensuring healthy, livable communities for generations to come. Millions of people live within a ten-minute walk of a Trust for Public Land park, garden or natural area, and millions more visit these sites every year.



National Medal of Honor Day March 25th

- National Day Calendar -



National Medal of Honor Day on March 25th recognizes all Medal of Honor recipients. The Medal of Honor is the highest military award for valor in the United States and was created in 1861.

#MedalOfHonorDay

On March 25, 1863, Secretary of War, Edwin Stanton presented the first Medals of Honor (Army) to six members of "Andrews Raiders" for their volunteering and participation during an American Civil War raid in April of 1862.

The Medal of Honor is awarded only to US military personnel by the President of the United States in the name of Congress for personal acts of valor above and beyond the call of duty.

There are three versions of the Medal of Honor; one for the Army, one for the Navy, and one for the Air Force; Personnel of the Marine Corps and the Coast Guard receive the Navy version.

Since its creation, 3,468 Medals of Honor have been awarded to the country's soldiers, sailors, airmen, Marines, and coastguardsmen.

NATIONAL MEDAL OF HONOR DAY HISTORY

In 1990, the United States Congress designated March 25th of each year as National Medal of Honor Day.

Medal of Honor FAQ

Q. Have any women received the Medal of Honor?

A. Yes. Following the American Civil War, President Andrew Johnson presented Dr. Mary Edwards Walker with the Medal of Honor for her volunteer work with the Union Army, often going behind enemy lines to care for civilians.

Q. Has any U.S. president received the Medal of Honor?

A. Yes, but only one. Theodore Roosevelt received the honor for his services during the Spanish American War. It was awarded to Roosevelt posthumously by President Bill Clinton in 2001.

Q. Are the Congressional Medal of Honor and the Medal of Honor the same thing?

A. Yes, but Medal of Honor is the correct term.

March 25th Celebrated History

1807

The British Parliament passed the Abolition of the Slave Trade Act making the slave trade illegal in the British colonies. However, trade continued in the Caribbean until 1811.

1867

Three years after crews began, the Chicago Lake Tunnel is activated. The tunnel extends two miles

into Lake Michigan to collect fresh water and connects to the Water Supply System of Chicago. It is the first water supply tunnel for a U.S. city, and the first of many water supply tunnels for Chicago.

1949

Hamlet wins Best Picture at the 21st Academy Awards. It's the first British film to win an Oscar.

Elvis Presley receives a regulation haircut from the U.S. Army.

March 25th Celebrated Birthdays

Gutzon Borglum - 1867

While Gutzon Borglum may be most known for his massive sculpture, Mount Rushmore, the artist created many more impressive works in his lifetime. Included in his collected works is a bust of President Abraham Lincoln carved directly from marble which is on display in the Crypt of the U.S. Capitol Building. Another is called, "Wars of America" and is displayed in Military Park in Newark, New Jersey. Borlum's sculpture represents the significant military conflicts the United States had been involved in up to World War I.

Howard Cosell - 1918

The Emmy-winning American sportscaster with the distinctive voice and personality was a pioneer in sports journalism during his 32 years with ABC Sports.

Flannery O'Connor - 1925

The American novelist is best known for her short story collections. Some of her short stories include "The Life You Save May Be Your Own" and "Good Country People" found in her short story collection A Good Man is Hard to Find.

James Lovell – 1928

NASA Astronaut, James Lovell, flew four missions to space including as the commander of the Apollo 13 mission successfully returning the damaged Lunar Module and all onboard safely back to Earth.

Gloria Steinem – 1934

Gloria Steinem began her path to activism through freelance writing. Known for expose on New York City's Playboy Club and launching magazines focusing on significant women's topics while garnering criticism along the way.

Aretha Franklin - 1942

With 18 Grammy Awards, the Queen of Soul earned more than R-E-S-P-E-C-T. Aretha Franklin started singing at a young age in the Baptist church of her father's congregation. She would go on to be an R&B legend who continues to collaborate with artists across genres today.

Elton John - 1947

The award-winning singer-songwriter, musician, and composer has been creating hit songs since the 1970s. His music and his elaborate performances have left an indelible mark on music, fans, and pop culture.

Sheryl Swoopes - 1971

In 1997, Swoopes became the first player to sign with the Women's National Basketball League (WNBA) in its inaugural season. As a guard and forward, Swoopes competed in 14 seasons in the WNBA for the Houston Comets, winning four WNBA championship titles. She also played for the Seattle Storm and the Tulsa Shock.

Important Nuances Of Hunting And Trapping On Large Tracts Program Lands

– Idaho Department of Fish & Game –



Nearly one million acres. That's the amount of privately owned timberland that is publicly accessible thanks to the Large Tracts Program.

All Large Tracts parcels are in the Panhandle and Clearwater regions, and over the first four years of the program, we have heard a couple of common questions.

Question: Relative to big game hunting rules and seasons, are Large Tracts parcels considered private or public land?

Answer: For all big game hunting rules and seasons, except for wolves, Large Tract parcels are considered private. This is a great question that stems from certain controlled and general elk and deer hunts with notes stating harvest is allowed, "within 1 mile of private land".

Most will be happy to hear that Large Tracts Parcels are, in fact, classified as private land for any of these hunts. Please note that some hunts state, "on or within 1 mile of private agricultural lands" which does not fit the bill for Large Tracts Parcels since they are managed for timber, not

Question: Relative to wolf hunting and trapping, are Large Tracts parcels considered private or public land?

Answer: For wolf hunting and trapping rules and seasons, Large Tract parcels are considered PUB-LIC. Yet another great question stemming from the differences in season dates, expanded take and methods of take for wolves between public and private lands.

Per the desire of the private corporate timberland owners participating the Large Tracts Program, all Large Tracts parcels fall under the seasons and rules for public land wolf hunting and trapping.

The Large Tracts Program currently includes 4 large corporate timber companies and is financed through purchases of hunting, fishing and trapping licenses.

The program was crafted specifically with hunters, trappers and anglers in mind, but the lands are also available for other recreational uses including wildlife viewing, hiking and berry and mushroom gathering. The Large Tracts Program provides for non-motorized access to all lands, while motorized access is only allowed on designated routes which can be viewed at https://idfg. idaho.gov/d7/access/large-tracts/maps

We recognize the Large Tracts Program has complexities and nuances that can be challenging, and we are doing all we can to alleviate those challenges. 



Meet February's Wildlife **Express Featured Critter,** The Bushy-Tailed Woodrat

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game –



Chances are good you know this nocturnal hoarder by a different name

We all know someone that would rather have a root canal than get rid of clutter. We call these acquaintances "pack rats" because rather than consistently get rid of things they no longer need, they instead build up mounds of miscellaneous knickknacks that only they and maybe a woodrat would find valuable.

Now, no disrespect to the bushy-tailed woodrat, February's Wildlife Express featured critter. These literal pack rats, as they're more commonly known, make it their life's work to collect enough objects to furnish their home, otherwise known as a midden, and do so mostly under cover of dark-

If you've ever laid eyes on a woodrat, you'd see just how big their eyes and whiskers are. These two features give the woodrat a huge advantage when scurrying around at night, collecting shredded plants and twigs. It is here, within the walls of the woodrat's midden, that they build dens, where the female can give birth to typically three pups per litter. A female can have as many as three litters a year.

Bushy-Tailed Woodrat Facts

- Male bushy-tailed woodrats are called bucks; females are called does. Toss that little fact out there to your buddies next time you're sitting around the fire at hunting camp.
- · Newborn bushy-tailed woodrats are called pin-
- · A woodrat will poop 40-50 times per day.
- Aside from being called packrats, these critters are also known as trade rats.
- Some middens can reach up to 6 feet tall.
- Woodrats don't hibernate, so they must store enough food to get them through winter.
- · Woodrats don't have to drink water because they get their hydration from plants.
- Paleontologists have discovered woodrat middens that date over 40,000 year old.
- Their middens can act as time capsules. When their urine crystalizes, it can trap (or fossilize) other biological matter, including plants, insects and pollen.

There's a whole fascinating, hidden world lurking in the lives of bushy-tailed woodrats. Check out Fish and Game's Wildlife Express newsletter webpage to read a whole lot more about the kleptomaniac pack rats living in just about every corner of Idaho.



F&G Monitoring Of Mule Deer Fawn And Elk Calf Survival Through February Is Tracking Lower Than In Recent Years

Statewide, 72% of fawns and 92% of calves with tracking collars have survived through February

Statewide winter survival for mule deer fawns and elk calves fitted with tracking collars has shown to be slightly lower through the end of February.

"From an overview perspective, winter survival is tracking about average to a little below average from what we've seen in the past two years," said Toby Boudreau, Fish and Game's Deer and Elk Coordinator. "But, in the southeast part of the state, where winters have been long and severe, it's not looking too good."

Fish and Game biologists are monitoring 182 mule deer fawns and 149 elk calves that were captured in early winter and fitted with tracking collars.



Through the end of February this year, 72% of the collared fawns and 92% of the collared calves were still alive, and here's how that compares with recent years:

- 84% and 92% in 2021-22
- 83% and 92% in 2020-21
- 84% and 92% in 2019-20
- 78% and 93% in 2018-19
- 88% and 91% in 2017-18

Snow accumulation has been average to slightly above average across most of Idaho. Mule deer and, even more so, elk are built to withstand winter weather, and throughout the state, have been fairing relatively well, with roughly three quarters (72%) of all radio-collared mule deer fawns having survived through February.

Mule deer doe survival rates are also doing well, Boudreau says. "We're seeing pretty decent survival rates right now in our adult deer populations." Adult deer tend to have higher survival rates and aren't as susceptible to winter conditions as fawns.

Depending on weather, March and April are often when fawn and calf mortality is the highest because the young animals' fat reserves are largely depleted, and their digestive systems need time to convert to digesting fresh, green forage.

"We'll know more at the end of each coming month," Boudreau said. "It's too early to tell right now, but survival will be lower than average."



For mule deer fawns in particular, a stretch of cold, wet weather in the early spring can substantially decrease survival, and biologists can see winter-related mortality as late as May. And nowhere has winter been such a factor as in Southeast Idaho.

"It's been a really hard year on our southeastern herds," Boudreau said. "As of March 9, the southeast portion of the state is at roughly 145% of its typical snowpack. Critical deer and elk wintering ranges — including Portneuf, Montpelier, Georgetown Summit and Blackfoot WMAs — have been hit hard by this year's winter weather, and with no certainty when temperatures will start to climb again, it's not looking good."

In Unit 69 near Idaho Falls, 43% mule deer fawns have died. And in Unit 76 along the Wyoming border, 67% of fawns did not survive the region's severe winter.

Fawn and calf survival is critical to growing herds, or sustaining current populations, and survival of young mule deer has a direct relation on the fall deer harvest because yearling bucks typically make a up a significant portion of the overall mule deer harvest.

"We'd like to see more mediated temperatures," Boudreau said. "But at this rate, it's going to take a few years for this year's herd to rebound."



Dive Right Into Baked Black Bean Dip

A good appetizer brings everyone together, whether you're craving something homemade and warm after an afternoon of chilly weather or you're gathering around with friends and family for a dinner party.

This Baked Black Bean dip definitely fits the bill. It's a crowd favorite every time I serve it at home or when I bring it with a bag of tortilla chips to a potluck. It's both chunky and creamy, with a yummy chipotle flavor that keeps you dipping for

BAKED BLACK BEAN DIP Serves 12

- 1 tablespoon vegetable oil
- large onion, diced
- teaspoon salt
- cloves garlic, minced
- teaspoon chili powder
- 1/8 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper
- chipotle chilies in adobo sauce, plus 3 tablespoons of sauce (You can find canned chipotle chilies in adobo sauce in the Latin/Mexican food section of your grocery store.)
- (15-1/2 ounce) cans black beans, rinsed and drained
- 1/2cup water
 - tablespoon cider vinegar
 - medium tomatoes, chopped
- cups thawed frozen corn kernels or drained canned corn
 - cups grated four-cheese blend, Mexicanstyle

1 cup grated Monterey Jack cheese Fresh cilantro, chopped (optional)

Heat oven to 400° F. Grease a 1-1/2-quart baking dish. I use a souffle-style baking dish.

Heat the oil in a 12-inch skillet over mediumhigh heat. Add the onion, reduce the heat to medium and season with the salt. Cook, stirring occasionally, until the onions are soft, about 4 minutes. Add the garlic, chili powder and pepper; stir and cook for one minute.

Loosely chop the chipotle chilies in adobo. Add to the skillet along with 3 tablespoons of adobo sauce, one can of black beans and the water. Bring to a boil and simmer for four minutes, stirring occasionally.

Transfer to a mixing bowl. Add the vinegar. Use an immersion blender to process the mixture until smooth. (Or use a food processor and transfer to a mixing bowl.)

Add the second can of drained beans, tomatoes, corn and grated Mexican-style cheese. Stir well. Transfer to the baking dish. Sprinkle grated Monterey Jack cheese on top. Bake 15-20 minutes, or until bubbly and cheese melts.

Top with cilantro. Serve warm with tortilla chips for scooping.

Tip: Freeze leftovers. Thaw and reheat with a fresh sprinkling of cheese on top.

F&G Commission Sets Spring Chinook Season To Open April 22

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game —



Chinook fishing will be available on the Snake, Clearwater and Salmon River systems

Idaho Fish and Game Commission set the 2023 spring Chinook salmon fishing seasons for the Clearwater, Salmon and Snake rivers to open on April 22. The preseason forecast is for 49,291 hatchery adults to return to Lower Granite Dam, which is located about 35 miles downstream from Lewiston.

Chinook fishing will be open 7 days per week on the main Clearwater, South Fork Clearwater and Middle Fork Clearwater rivers, Salmon and Little Salmon rivers, and in the Snake River. Fishing will be open four days per week (Thursday through Sundays) on the North Fork of the Clearwater River.

The updated Chinook Seasons and Rules will available soon on the Chinook Salmon Fishing webpage.

This year's forecast is larger than last year's preseason forecast and above the 10-year average of 43,788. If the actual run matches the forecast, about 7,000 Chinook will be available for sport anglers to harvest.

Harvest limits will be:

- Clearwater River system: four per day of which only one may be an adult longer than 24 inches.
 Possession limit is 12 of which only three may be adults.
- Salmon River, Little Salmon River and Snake River: four per day, of which two may be adults longer than 24 inches. Possession limit is 12, of which only six may be adults.

The preseason forecast is an estimate based on last year's return of "Jack" Chinook that returned after only a year in the ocean and gives fisheries managers an indicator of the following year's return of fish that spend two years in the ocean, which make up the majority of the annual Chinook return.

Fisheries managers will monitor the run and update anglers as it progresses. Fishing seasons for summer Chinook on the South Fork of the Salmon River, Upper Salmon River and Lochsa River will be considered at the May 10-11 Commission meeting in Jerome. Those fishing seasons typically open in mid-to-late June.




