#### **Cabaret Dinnerware**

To attract western travelers to Japan, the government of Japan commissioned American architect Frank Lloyd Wright (1867-1959) to design the Imperial Hotel in Tokyo. Wright's allencompassing designs for his buildings included almost every item, including dinnerware.

Known as the Cabaret pattern, this porcelain dinnerware was designed for the Cabaret Dining Room of the Imperial Hotel, which opened in 1923. The circular art-deco-inspired design was Wright's interpretation of champagne bubbles overflowing across the place settings. The strategically placed red on the cup's rim has been suggested to conceal lipstick prints from women drinking from the coffee cups.

The dinnerware was originally produced by Japan's Noritake company with reproductions made by Tiffany. The Imperial Hotel was demolished in 1968, but its entrance and lobby have been preserved and can be visited at Japan's Meiji-mura, an open-air architectural museum and park.

Can I treat my grandmother's dinner dishes and silverware like my everyday pieces and put them in the microwave and dishwasher if I use them at a holiday dinner?

If you have a dishwasher that is less than 10 years old, it probably washes most things safely. Exceptions include vintage, hollow-handled dinner knives, which can be a problem because old ones are sometimes filled with a substance that melts, and the knife blades loosen or turn. This also can happen to knives made with a stainless blade and different material for the handle. Don't wash your silver plate with any other metal tableware, or you can get a chemical reaction. Any dishes with metallic gold trim (it will spark) or metallic silver (the heat may turn the trim gray and poisonous) should not go in the microwave. Factorymade dishes should be OK; the decoration was put under clear glaze. But hand-painted trim could wash Kovel has the resources you're looking for.



### **National Crayon Day** March 31st

Each year, on March 31st, children and adults alike pick up their favorite colors for National Crayon Day. Opening up a box of crayons opens up a world of imagination and hours of fun.

Wax and chalk-based crayons have been used by artists around the world for centuries. Edwin Binney created the brightly colored crayons we are familiar with today. He was part owner of Binney & Smith, a company that produced products such as paint, pigments, and slate pencils for schools.

In 1903, Binney & Smith created the Crayola Division and produced colored wax crayons for children for the first time. Then in 1904, they presented their An-Du-Septic chalk at the Colombian Exposition in St. Louis winning a gold medal. The chalk was designed to be dustless at many teachers' requests and was an immediate success.



# Longtime Cannabis User Still Tests Positive Weeks After Quitting

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am a 68-year-old male who has used cannabis for 51 years. During that time span, I graduated from high school and college with two bachelor's degrees and two master's degrees, and I spent 35 years as an accomplished educator, motivational speaker and author. I have been married to the same person for 31 years and have a wide circle of friends.

Twenty-five years ago, I had my thyroid removed due to cancer, and I currently take medication. I also inject testosterone and take medications for blood pressure and cholesterol, as well as Xanax. I retired to a life that involves little travel, choosing instead to spend my time reading, researching, writing and being active in my community. Once I began to notice a loss of motivation and diminished memory, I became proactive and decided to give up cannabis.

I have had no trouble quitting cold turkey and have no desire to return to it. My memory has vastly improved, and I still enjoy all the things that made my retirement enjoyable before I made this decision. After 10 weeks of not using, I still test positive for the metabolites using THC testing

strips. I have read that normal detoxing for a heavy user is anywhere from six weeks to two months.

To aid in the process, I drink half a glass of lemon juice in the morning, drink two gallons of water or detox tea a day, cut red meat and dairy from my diet, spend an hour a day on the treadmill, and spend 40 minutes in a steam bath.

How long should I expect to continue testing positive? Is there anything else I can do to speed up the passing of the metabolites? – Anon.

**ANSWER:** The active form of THC, the primary chemical in cannabis that causes the psychoactive effects (i.e., the effects for people to feel "high"), accumulates in the fat cells, where it can be stored for long periods of time.

Research in laboratory animals confirms that losing weight over the long-term releases the stored THC from the fat, making it more likely that a urine test will be positive in people who are losing weight (which might be the case with you, given your exercise and diet). Heavy users have told me that they feel like they are "coming out of a fog" for up to six months after stopping the use of cannabis. However, I can't give you any evidence-based answer on how long you will continue to show positive results.

I don't think drinking water and tea, nor the steam bath, are significantly helping you get rid of the accumulated THC in the body, but the diet and exercise changes probably are, if you are losing fat as I suspect. Even if you aren't losing weight, you may be getting more muscular due to exercise and losing fat.



### St. Patrick's Day

St. Patrick's Day is celebrated each year on March 17 in the United States, but collectors found few postcards, greeting cards or objects to collect before 1900. The first St. Patrick's Day parade is said to have taken place in 1601 in St. Augustine, Florida. But a major event is the New York City parade, which started in 1762.

St. Patrick, the patron saint of Ireland, was born in Roman Britain and kidnapped in the late fourth century, when he was 14 years old. He was taken to Ireland as a slave, but he escaped in 431 A.D. and converted the Irish to Christianity. Parties, dances, drinking and celebrations started about 1600, and the observance has grown into an important celebration not only in Ireland but also in the U.S.

There have been many symbols of the past celebrations to collect. The leprechaun is an important symbol. The mischievous, red-haired elf is usually pictured in a top hat, green jacket, tie and vest standing with a pot of gold at the end of a rainbow. He represents the magic of fairies and the little people, and you are lucky if you find him and the gold.

#### • What are the symbols of St. • Patrick's Day, besides the leprechaun with the bucket of gold?

A • The shamrock is the first plant

#### **Clicker Training Can Help** Your Dog Love to Learn

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: What is the value of training dogs using a clicker? I have tried using a clicker to train my dog Atlas, but he didn't listen very well. When should I click at him when he's misbehaving? Or when he's doing something right? And how can he tell? - John H., Springfield, Massachusetts

DEAR JOHN: Clicker training, or "mark and reward" training, can seem almost magical in terms of how quickly and enthusiastically a dog learns. But that magic only happens when it's being done correctly.

Basically, you press the clicker device when your dog does precisely the thing that you are trying to train him to do. And you follow up immediately (like, within a second) with a reward -- usually a little bit of a treat. So, here's how it is done:

- Decide on one behavior that you want your dog to learn in your training session. Start with a basic behavior, like "sit," "come here," "lie down" or "give paw."
- · Give Atlas the command. If he doesn't follow the command, don't click.
- As soon as he follows the command, click once and give him a little treat.
- Repeat the process again and again until he follows the command immediately.

By associating the clicker noise with a command and a reward, Atlas will quickly build a positive association with the command. This works for many types of training, from basic obedience to agility to job-specific commands. But you start with just one command at a time.

Also, consider working with a trainer, either one on one or in a group training setting. You'll pick up many training skills quickly. It's worth the investment.

#### Triple-Cheese Mashed Potato Casserole


Mashed potatoes are always a popular dinner choice, and when you add three kinds of cheese to the mix, no one can resist a second helping.

- 2. Meanwhile, in a small bowl, heat 3 tablespoons margarine in microwave oven on high 30 seconds or until margarine melts. Stir in Parmesan and breadcrumbs; set aside.
- 3. Preheat oven to 325 F. Drain potatoes well; return to saucepot. With potato masher, mash potatoes with 2 teaspoons salt. Stir in milk, then Cheddar, Neufchatel and remaining margarine until cheese melts.
- 4. Grease 13- by 9-inch glass or ceramic baking dish. Spoon potato mixture into dish. Sprinkle breadcrumb mixture evenly over potatoes. Bake, uncovered, 15 minutes or until top is lightly browned.
- 5. Optional for storage: Follow recipe through step 3. Spread potato mixture into greased 13- by 9-inch glass or ceramic baking dish; cover with foil and refrigerate overnight. Refrigerate crumb mixture in a sealed plastic bag. To serve, let dish stand at room temperature for 30 minutes. Bake, covered, in preheated 325 F oven for 1 hour and 15 minutes; uncover, sprinkle with crumb mixture, and bake until browned, 15 minutes. Serves 20.

### Statewide Trout Stocking Highlights For April 2023

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game —



Approximately 250,000 catchable-sized rainbow trout will be stocked throughout the state this April

Many of Idaho's lakes and ponds are soon going to be bolstered with Idaho Fish and Game stocking roughly 250,000 catchable-sized rainbow trout this April. Wondering if the stocking trucks are going to be backing up to your favorite fishing hole? We asked our Fish and Game hatchery staff to boil down some of the most notable stocking highlights coming to your local fishery this month.

Many of these fisheries highlighted below are easy to access, family-friendly fishing destinations. All you need to get started is a fishing license and some basic tackle. Annual adult fishing licenses cost around \$30, junior licenses (ages 14-17) cost \$16, and youth (under 14) fish for free. Go to Fish and Game's online vendor to buy a license.

Fishing for stocked rainbow trout can be a great way to introduce budding anglers to the sport by using simple, inexpensive setups like worm/marshmallow combinations or commercial baits like PowerBait® or Crave, placed either near the bottom or below a bobber; and as anglers know, there's nothing quite like a trout fighting on the end of your line. The Learn to Fish webpage offers diagrams for basic bait rigs.

Most Idaho waters are open to fishing year-round, but some may have slightly different rules. Be sure to pick up a 2022-2024 Idaho Fishing Seasons and Rules Booklet – available at any Idaho Fish and Game office or most sporting goods stores statewide – or download online to look at season dates, special regulations and bag limits.

# April 2023 Fish Stocking Highlights

#### **Southwest Region (Nampa)**

Arrowrock Reservoir - 9,000 rainbow trout

This reservoir offers a wide range of fishing opportunity. Fast-growing kokanee and rainbow trout are targeted by most anglers. However, other anglers choose to target smallmouth bass or yellow perch. Be sure to properly identify trout species as bull trout utilize the reservoir.

#### Crane Falls Reservoir – 1,200 rainbow trout

Located alongside the Snake River in the sagebrush south of Mountain Home, this lake is best fished from small boats and float craft, though several fishing docks are available.

#### Lucky Peak Reservoir - 13,550 rainbow trout

This reservoir is well-known for quality kokanee and rainbow trout fishing. In addition, some anglers choose to focus on smallmouth bass. The reservoir can be accessed at several well-developed sites.

#### Mann Creek Reservoir - 2,400 rainbow trout

This reservoir provides a diverse fishery where anglers can target crappie, largemouth bass and rainbow trout.

#### Marsing Pond – 550 rainbow trout

This pond is located off Highway 55 below the Snake River bridge.

#### Parkcenter Pond - 700 rainbow trout

Conveniently located near downtown Boise, the greenbelt and the BSU campus, this pond is a popular local fishing spot with a paved path alongside docks and tables.

#### Magic Valley Region

#### Blair Trail Fishing Pond - 1,000 rainbow trout

On Little Canyon Creek, this is a remote desert water surrounded by sagebrush solitude.

### Camas Pond #2 (Camas Kids Pond) – 1,500 rainbow trout

This is a small, scenic pond near Fairfield. The Centennial Marsh and Camas Prairie Wildlife Management Area are nearby and provide great bird watching opportunities.

#### Dierkes Lake - 2,500 rainbow trout

Conveniently located inside Shoshone Falls Park near Twin Falls, this scenic county park also features hiking, fishing docks, and picnic areas. Dierkes Lake is where thousands of kids have caught their first fish! Check out this video.

#### Gavers Lagoon - 1,425 rainbow trout

This pond is a high-yield fishery that is stocked frequently, but it is known to get fished out quickly after stocking. We encourage harvest, but please harvest what you need and consider leaving a few for your fellow anglers.

#### Magic Reservoir - 7,500 rainbow trout

A popular, diverse fishery with plenty of shoreline access, this reservoir is perfect for young anglers.

#### Mormon Reservoir – 6,000 rainbow trout

Located near Fairfield, efforts by Fish and Game staff and other agencies continue to improve fishing, water quality and access.

## Lower Goose Creek Reservoir (Oakley Reservoir) – 10,000 rainbow trout


Located south of Burley, this is a great place to recreate. Fishing opportunity includes perch, rainbow trout and walleye.

#### Penny Lake - 900 rainbow trout

This little lake provides a great rustic fishing opportunity in the Wood River Valley!

#### Salmon Falls Creek Reservoir – 18,000 rainbow trout

A short drive south of Twin Falls, this large reservoir in Idaho's high desert provides tons of fishing options with boat ramps and long shorelines. You can help maintain the natural beauty of this unique area by driving on existing roads when they are dry.

### FWP Reminder: Be Bear Aware When Recreating Outdoors

— Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks —

HELENA – Bears are emerging from dens with the onset of spring, and people are headed outdoors should "Be Bear Aware."

Bears can be found throughout Montana. In recent years, grizzly bear populations have expanded and bears are sometimes found in historic ranges beyond western Montana

As bears begin foraging for food, people can avoid conflict by removing or securing food attractants such as garbage, bird feeders and pet food. The most common human-bear conflicts involve unsecured food attractants.

People venturing into the outdoors can "Be Bear Aware" by following these precautionary steps:

- · Carry and know how to use bear spray.
- Travel in groups whenever possible and plan to be out in the daylight hours.
- Stay on trails or rural roads.
- Avoid carcass sites and concentrations of ravens and other scavengers.
- Watch for signs of bears such as bear scat, diggings, torn-up logs and turned over rocks, and partly consumed animal carcasses.
- · Keep children and pets close.
- Make noise, especially near streams or in thick forest where hearing and visibility is impaired. This can be the key to avoiding encounters. Most bears will avoid humans when they know humans are present.
- Don't approach a bear.

If you are camping in bear country, follow these guidelines:


- Camp away from areas where you see grizzly bear sign.
- Keep a clean camp at all times. Keep tents and sleeping bags free of food.
- Follow all food storage regulations. Contact
  the applicable land management agency to
  learn what food storage rules apply where
  you're recreating. Hang all food, trash and
  other odorous items well away from camp and
  at least 10 feet above ground and 4 feet from
  any vertical support, or store in a bear-proof
  container. Livestock feed should be treated the
  same as human food.

Anglers also need to practice safe behavior in bear country:

- Don't leave fish entrails on shorelines of lakes and streams.
- Sink entrails in deep water.
- If you don't properly dispose of entrails you increase danger to yourself and to the next person to use the area.
- Carry bear spray when fishing along rivers or streams with dense streamside cover.

- tablespoons fat-free milk Sugar substitute to equal 2 tablespoons sugar

#### **APRIL FOOLS' DAY HISTORY**

We would be fools to think we knew precisely when April Fools' Day was originally celebrated. However, April Fools Day shares similarities with other days full of fools, tricks, and merry-making.

Some believe the day is celebrated in honor of the trickery Mother Nature plays on us this time of year with her unpredictable weather. Another possible connection is the Indian tradition of Holi. The day is celebrated on March 31st and practices the same foolery as April Fools' Day. So does the Roman festival of Hilaria which was celebrated on March 25th.

The earliest known reference to April Fools' Day is in Chaucer's 1392 Nun's Priest's Tale. Even so, the

reference is so vague, and possibly not even occurring on the first of April, leaving doubt as to whether it is the first reference.

Other scholars point to the reformation of the calendar by Pope Gregory and the Gregorian calendar we used today in the 1500s in France. The new year would take place in April, not January as it does now. The theory is that those who continued to celebrate the new year on April 1st were called Poisson d'Avril (April fish) and pranks would be played on them.

In 1582, France accepted the Gregorian calendar, but reforms had already been taking place.

In Britain in 1776, there is a clear and reliable reference to April foolishness in an article in Gentlemans Magazine. Reference to a custom in the kingdom of making fools of people on the first day of April. It addresses the day being the culmination of an eight-day feast and the beginning of a new year.

#### **Noted Foolery**

Newspapers, television, radio, and social media have had their fun on April Fools' Day. Check out all this April 1 foolishness:

- *Times* of London reported in 1992 that Belgium was negotiating to join Holland.
- The *Evening Star* of Islington advertised in 1864 a display of donkeys at the Agricultural Hall the next day. Those who arrived early soon realized who the donkeys on display really were.
- In 1950, *The Progress* in Clearfield, Pennsylvania, published a picture of a UFO flying over the town. Claiming to have "scooped" larger publications of the first-ever published picture of a real flying saucer.
- In 2008, the BBC presented a documentary on flying penguins.

Q. Is April Fool's Day always on April 1st?

**A.** Yes. If your friends, coworkers and the news seems especially goofy on April 1st, this is why.

Q. Can anyone participate in April Fool's Day?

**A.** Yes. Silliness and practical joking are for everyone. It's important not to pull a prank that might be dangerous. Some fun and harmless ways to celebrate include:

- Slipping a rubber snake, worm, mouse, or other creature into food.
- Leaving a fake mess for someone to find like plastic puppy droppings or spilled milk.
- Switch the labels on a few cans of vegetables.
- Pour gravy over ice cream. Add sprinkles for an authentic look.
- Stick a sign on your friend's back that says, "Wish me a happy birthday!"
- Call the local radio station and wish your little sister "Happy 50th Birthday" ten years early.
- Post on social media that you're moving to a foreign country.

#### Slow and Steady Wins the Race: The Art of Crockpot Glazed Pork

Some things are perfect just as they are and don't require improvement. This is one of those things.

In these days of instant gratification, it isn't popular to take the slow road. I love my instant pot, don't get me wrong. But cooking a pork roast in the slow cooker or oven is better than using an instant pot because the slow and steady heat allows for even cooking and richer flavor.

If feeding a crowd or having leftovers are important to you, larger cuts of meat can also be cooked more evenly in an oven or slow cooker, which may not be possible in an instant pot. While an instant pot is convenient for quick cooking, an oven or slow cooker can result in a culinary masterpiece worthy of the wait.

The recipe I'm sharing today has been around forever. It's melt-in-your-mouth juicy pork, enrobed in a sweet and tangy glaze. It's all about the glaze. You could put this glaze on a flip-flop and I would eat it.

### CROCK-POT BROWN SUGAR & BALSAMIC GLAZED PORK

Yield: 8 generous servings Total time: 4 to 6 hours, plus glazing time

4 - 5 pounds boneless pork sirloin

2 teaspoons ground sage 1 1/2 teaspoons kosher salt

Freshly ground black pepper 4 cloves garlic, minced 1/2 cup water

For the glaze:
1 cup dark brown sugar
1/2 cup balsamic vinegar
1/4 cup soy sauce
2 tablespoons cornstarch
1/4 cup water

Season the pork roast on all sides with sage, salt and pepper. Place pork, fat cap side up, in the slow cooker and sprinkle the garlic evenly over the top. Carefully add water into the slow cooker so you don't wash off the seasoning. Cook on high for 4 to 6 hours, or until the pork shreds easily with a fork. Carefully pull the roast from the slow cooker and place on an aluminumlined sheet pan, and let it rest.

While the roast is resting, make the glaze. In a small saucepan, mix the ingredients for the glaze: brown sugar, balsamic vinegar, soy sauce and cornstarch mixed with the water. Heat over medium, stirring until mixture thickens, about 4 minutes.

Preheat your oven broiler. Pour

about half the glaze into a gravy boat and set aside. Brush about half of the remaining glaze onto the pork and set under broiler for 1 to 2 minutes, until bubbly and caramelized. Repeat 2 to 3 more times until desired coating is achieved. Shred or slice pork against the grain into individual portions. Serve with reserved glaze on the side.

Oven directions: Preheat your oven to 350 F. Following the recipe and directions above, place the ingredients into a covered roasting pan or Dutch oven. Bake, covered, in the preheated oven for approximately 90 minutes to 2 hours, or until the pork shreds easily with a fork. Follow the directions for glazing the pork shown above

It's important to note that oven cooking times can vary, so be sure to keep an eye on the pork as it cooks to ensure that it doesn't overcook or dry out.

And there you have it, slow and steady wins the race when it comes to making delicious, melt-in-your-mouth pork roast. Whether you choose to cook it in the oven or the slow cooker, this recipe for Crock-Pot Brown Sugar & Balsamic Glazed Pork is sure to be a crowd-pleaser. So take a break from instant gratification and give this recipe a try — your taste buds will thank you!

### Joint Project Underway To Reduce Big Game-Vehicle Collisions In North Idaho

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game —



The project began on March 20 and will not cause traffic delays during construction

The Idaho Fish and Wildlife Foundation, Idaho Fish and Game and the Yellowstone to Yukon Conservation Initiative recently announced a joint project to improve traffic safety and protect wildlife by repairing existing highway fencing and extending it by about a mile near wildlife underpasses on U.S. 95 north of Bonners Ferry.

In 2005, Idaho Department of Transportation rerouted a 3.8-mile section of the highway, converted it from two to four lanes and installed three wildlife underpasses. More than a decade of monitoring has shown that the wildlife underpasses reduce wildlife collisions, as well as decrease habitat fragmentation for white-tailed deer, elk, mule deer, black bears and other wildlife.

From 2017 to 2022, Fish and Game has documented an average of 3,500 animals per year using the underpasses, mostly big game species. Whitetailed deer are the most common species using the underpasses, but elk, black bears, moutain lions, bobcats, skunks among other species use them as well. Animals using the underpasses can migrate and access adjacent habitats without crossing over the road and endangering the traveling public.

However, periodic repairs and improvements to the fencing are needed to help the underpasses continue working effectively. Recent use of the underpasses has declined, as wildlife are crossing through breaks in the existing fencing and to the

north of the fencing. As a result, there have been more wildlife-vehicle collisions over the last several years. The Fish and Game website documents 19 big game animals that have been hit in the project area over the past two years. Repairing and adding fencing will funnel more animals into existing crossings and reduce the number of animals on the highway.

The Idaho Fish and Wildlife Foundation is managing a \$289,000 grant from the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation for fence repair and construction with all contributing entities providing in-kind and other funding to provide matching contributions required by the grant.

"This is a win for motorists and migrating animals. Extending the fence will reduce dangerous accidents that cause vehicle damage and can injure or kill motorists while also preventing deaths of deer, elk, moose and other important wildlife," said Hilarie Engle, Executive Director of the Idaho Fish and Wildlife Foundation.

The project started on March 20 and will not cause traffic delays during construction. The majority of the project will be completed on the shoulders of the highway, within the right-of-way. The project will not affect public access to adjacent Forest Service lands, except access to Brush Lake Road will be blocked for a day to install a cattle guard. The public will be notified of the date when the Brush Lake road will be blocked, and there is an alternate access route to the lake.

The project has the support of the Kootenai Valley Resource Initiative, which is co-chaired by the Kootenai Tribe of Idaho, Boundary County Commissioners and the Mayor of Bonners Ferry.

"The project has garnered a diverse range of support from local groups, conservation organizations and state and federal agencies," a letter from the Resource Initiative said.

The project is part of a collaboration between the Idaho Fish and Wildlife Foundation, Fish and Game, Idaho Panhandle National Forest, Idaho Department of Transportation, Yellowstone to Yukon Conservation Initiative and other agencies and groups.

### FWP Opens Public Scoping On Proposed New Wolf Management Plan

— Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks —



HELENA - Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks will prepare an environmental impact statement (EIS) and conduct public scoping on a proposed action to develop a new wolf management plan.

The 2003 Montana Gray Wolf Conservation and Management Plan and associated EIS were developed 20 years ago. Since then, new, and improved research, management tools and methods have been developed and incorporated into Montana's gray wolf management strategy; however, they are not described in the 2003 Wolf Plan. Gov. Greg Gianforte asked FWP to create a new wolf management plan with broad public engagement due to the interest in wolf management across the state.

The new wolf management plan will include the latest science surrounding wolf management, better transparency on wolf management, and be easier to update in the future. More specifically, the new wolf plan will accomplish the following:

- · Articulate contemporary updates in wolf-related
- · Describe new and available wolf management tools and methods employed by FWP;

- · Provide FWP with the flexibility needed to incorporate new wolf management science and tools, as they become available;
- Describe the public engagement process as new information related to evolving wolf management strategies in Montana becomes available.

FWP invites comment identifying potential significant environmental issues associated with the proposed action of creating a new wolf plan and in determining the appropriate scope of the EIS. Public input received during the scoping period will help FWP staff determine public interest, identify potential issues that would require further analysis, and may provide further insights for creating the new wolf plan.

FWP will conduct two virtual public scoping meetings for this EIS; public input will also be taken during these meetings. The meetings will be held:

- April 4 from 6-8 p.m.
- April 11 from 6-8 p.m.

Login information will be posted on the FWP website before the meetings.

The deadline for scoping comments is April 22. These comments will be used to help shape the new plan and analysis. FWP will open public comment for the draft EIS and draft plan once they are com-

# How to Stop Dogs From Roughhousing

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: My girlfriend and I moved in together recently, and we each brought a dog with us. I've got a German Shepherd named Mac, and her Golden Retriever is Diz. Both are about 2 years old, and they get along fine. However, in the evenings they roughhouse in the living room. We want them to just settle down so we can watch TV. Is this possible? –Laura N., Augusta, Georgia

**DEAR LAURA:** It's very possible, even with younger dogs. And the sooner you establish behavior norms around a schedule, the better.

Diz's playful personality probably balances

out Mac's serious working dog persona, so take advantage of this.

Wear them out: Both of these breeds are energetic. It'll be much easier to keep them calm if you take them out for a walk or a romp at a dog park for about an hour before dinner and TV time.

Set the behavior: When it's TV time, bring them into the room and give the "sit" or "lie down" and "stay" commands to each dog. Give them a treat only when they obey the commands.

Correct and redirect: When the dogs begin to wrestle or steal each other's toys, tell them to stop. Call both dogs over and work on the basic commands again, then have them sit or lie down in the original spots.

Separate them: If they begin roughhousing again and no longer respond to commands, take Diz into one room and Mac into another.

This will take time and repetition. The goal is to get them to follow your commands for longer and longer periods until you no longer have to separate them. Be prepared to pause the TV and focus on their training for days or weeks. The long-term reward is worth it.

### **Local Librarian Receives American Library Association Prize**

— Community Library Network —



KOOTENAI AND SHOSHONE COUNTY, ID — Denise Neujahr, Young Adult Librarian for the Community Library Network is receiving the 2023 Lemony Snicket Prize for Nobel Librarians Faced with Adversity. This prize, which is administered by the American Library Association, is awarded each year to one librarian in the United States who has faced adversity with integrity and dignity intact.

Neujahr volunteered in libraries for years before she began her twenty-four-year career working with children in them. She worked for two different libraries before earning her Master of Library Science in 2005 and joining the Community Library Network twelve years ago. She's worked with children of all ages but has primarily focused on young adults and teens over the last eighteen years.

"I love the connections I make with the teens. Learning about who they are as people, how they think, and why they do the things they do is really rewarding. Teens are different. You can have great conversations with them and can be a positive adult for them when they may not get that elsewhere."

Neujahr is receiving the award based on her dedication to a library program that has garnered criticism from some in the community. The Rainbow Squad program is a regular Community Library Network program that seeks to provide a space for teens who identify as part of the LGBTQ+ community and their allies to interact without the fear of being harassed by others. The program is one of the highest attended teen programs that the library network offers, is primarily funded by donations, and is the only program the library network puts on that has been regularly met with protests.

Some community members have expressed concerns that the library network is perpetuating a particular sexual or gender-based agenda with the program. "We don't really focus on those issues. It's mostly just teens making friends. They don't even talk about dating. They just want people to be their friends. They don't want to feel alone or be judged and harassed," said Neujahr.

When asked why she started the Rainbow Squad programs Neujahr replied, "Libraries have always been a magnet for people who need a welcoming space. A lot of these kids identify as LGBTQ+. I had a lot of friends in high school who couldn't come out in the nineties-it just wasn't safe. Some of the teens we have now are much freer about that. A lot of them are very confident with who they are, which I love, but it's not always easy. They deal with a lot of scary situations, sometimes even violent ones. Having a place where they don't have to worry—having a night where they don't have to worry, it's good."

When asked about what the Rainbow Squad program means to them, one teen participant said. "Rainbow Squad lets teens learn more about themselves, as well as others. It helps them make friends and connections...it lets them be happy.

Neujar points out, "Being a librarian is so much more than quiet and books. You hear the horrible stories, sad things, and traumas that these teens go through. As a librarian, you have to stay strong and be there for your community. I'm happy to provide a space for them where they can be themselves and feel safe and welcomed."

The Rainbow Squad program isn't the only program Denise facilitates for the library network. Board games, art classes, pop culture themed events, TikTok taste challenges, trivia nights, cooking instruction, and anime clubs are just some of the events available for teens to participate in throughout the library network's seven physical locations. Denise is involved with all of them. "I think back when I started in the late nineties, the library was still that quiet place where you studied. The library is more of a community space now, which I really love," said Neujahr. "I listen to what the kids are talking about, what they're interested in, what are they watching on TV, what music they are listening to, what's the newest weird TikTok challenge or trend, and respond with programs that they'll engage with."

Neujahr will be honored at the American Library Association's annual conference in Chicago this June. She will receive the award from author Daniel Handler, better known as Lemony Snicket. Librarians across the United States are appreciative that she has represented the profession with dignity, poise, and integrity. Community Library Network interim director Lindsey Miller-Escarfuller said, "This award recognizes Denise's dedication to our community. We are proud to have her as an integral part of our team of librarians."







#### In Cats. Ear Infection Can Have **Subtle Symptoms**

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: My cat Chester seemed perfectly healthy, but when I brought him in for his annual checkup, the veterinarian said that he has an ear infection. I didn't notice any behavior or odd symptoms previously. I gave Chester the expensive eardrops he was prescribed, and he seems just fine. Was the vet just making up the infection? - Jeanine C., Buffalo, New York

**DEAR JEANINE:** Cats are really good at hiding the symptoms of an illness. I'm glad you brought Chester in for his regular checkup, because those are very

helpful in determining hidden acute problems like an ear infection, and noting potential problems (for example, if his weight is getting higher than normal, or he's developing arthritis).

Now that Chester has been treated, keep an eye out for signs of the infection recurring. Look, listen and smell (yes, smell!) around his ears periodically and note certain behaviors. Hold Chester on your lap and shine a little flashlight into each ear.

A healthy ear is pale pink, with little to no earwax visible and no debris.

Trouble signs include: A strong odor from the ear; lots of earwax buildup; debris or discharge that looks like coffee grounds; or discharge that is yellow or black. You (or the vet) may see redness or swelling of the ear flap or in the ear canal.

Ear infections cause behavioral changes, too. Some of them are subtle: Chester may shake his head after you scratch around his ears, or he may tilt his head more in one direction than another. More serious symptoms include loss of balance, disorientation, hearing loss or even facial paralysis.




