

Review Process For Fishing Regulations To Begin Soon

— Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks —

Public meetings to be held around state

HELENA - Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks will host public meetings in each region to gather input for the 2025-26 fishing regulations.

Fishing regulations are now under a process like hunting regulations, going through a comprehensive public review every two years. Fishing regulations are printed during odd numbered years.

FWP's proposed regulation changes will be posted online later this month. FWP will also accept and review fishing regulations changes proposed by the public during the initial review time period.

Staff will use this public input to refine regulation proposals to the Fish and Wildlife Commission. The final fishing regulations proposals will be available for public comment in August, and the commission will adopt, modify or reject the proposals at its October meeting.

National Oregon Day March 8th

— National Day Calendar —



On March 8th, National Oregon Day recognizes the Beaver State. Valentine's Day 1859, Oregon became the 33rd state to join the Union.

Oregon's climate enjoys the warm Pacific air west of the Cascade Mountains and in the lush Willamette Valley. More extreme temperature ranges are experienced in Oregon's high desert.

Populations of Nez Perce, Chinook, Molalla, and others settled along the Columbia River Gorge, Klamath Basin, and points east. Many of the first European explorers to arrive sought the elusive Northwest Passage

The Corps of Discovery Expedition followed the Colombia River Gorge, reaching the Pacific Ocean in November of 1805. They would winter at Ft. Clatsop. Soon, pioneers would follow along what would become the Oregon Trail.

The gorge was created from volcanic lava flows and glacial floods. Windsurfers flock to the Columbia due to the powerful, steady winds off of the Cascade Mountains. Kayaking, biking, hiking, skiing, and many other outdoor adventures can be found up and down the Gorge, but its icy crown is Mt. Hood. The Stratovolcano's last eruption occurred in 1865 and was named after Lord Samuel Hood.

South along the Cascade Range, a sleeping volcano forms the mysterious Crater Lake. A well-planned hike along the trails to the remote brilliant, blue waters of the deepest lake in the U.S. is worth the effort. The pristine volcano is a wonder to see. Eastern Oregon takes on the color of a sunset in the undulating Painted Hills near Mitchell.

An expertly skilled navigator and negotiated, Chief Comcomly overcame the loss of an eye. The leader of the Chinook Indians, Comcomly traded with many different companies over his lifetime. During the Corp of Discovery Expedition, Meriwether Lewis

and William Clark recorded in their journals their impressions of Comcomly, the village and the surrounding area.

Tsin-is-tum was possibly one of the last living full-blooded Clatsop Indians. Also known as Jennie Michel, she was a Native American folklorist and told the oral history of her people. She was present at the time of the arrival of the Corps of Discovery Expedition and her testomony has been preserved by the Oregon Historical Society.

The real-life subject of urban legends and inspiration for Hollywood movies, George Dantzig is also a successful scientific mathematician. After returning to graduate work under Jerzy Neyman at Berkeley, Dantzig was late to class one day. On the board, there were two statistic problems that until Dantzig wrote them down for homework, had been unsolvable. And now they are part of a great story about a great mathematic mind.

As a respected member of the legal community, Minoru Yasui took a stand against the constitutionality of curfew placed on Japanese Americans following the bombing of Pearl Harbor. His arrest and the eventual ruling against him would strip him of his right to practice law. Yasui would suffer more injustice due to the fear rising up in Americans, but he never turned his back on his country.

Two-time Nobel prize winner, Linus Pauling contributed advancements to medical science. The theoretical chemist is the only person to earn two unshared Nobel prizes. Pauling counts among his other accomplishments discovering the cause of sickle cell anemia and helping to create a synthetic plasma.

Had James Beard been a better actor, the face of American cuisine might have an entirely different quality. Beard's call to the culinary world led to more than a dozen cookbooks. The James Beard Cooking School, cooking shows and inspired chefs and amateur cooks.

Bill Bowerman's career started as a dedicated track coach who custom-made shoes for his athletes. His cobbling eventually turned into the company Nike. putting footwear on millions of athletes around the



VERY VERSATILE HOMEMADE MEATBALLS

Yield: 4 to 5 servings

Total Time: 22 to 35 minutes

- 1 pound ground meat (beef, pork, turkey, chicken, sausage or combination)
- 1/2 cup seasoned breadcrumbs
- 1/4 cup grated Parmesan cheese
- 1/4 cup milk
- 1 large egg
- 2 cloves garlic, minced

- 1 teaspoon dried Italian seasoning (or another seasoning blend)
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon black pepper

Olive oil (for cooking)

Preheat your oven to 375 F (190 C). Line a baking sheet with parchment paper or lightly grease it with olive oil.

In a large mixing bowl, combine the ground meat, breadcrumbs, Parmesan cheese, milk, egg, minced garlic, Italian seasoning, salt and black pepper. Use your hands or a spoon to mix until well combined. Be careful not to overmix, as this can result in tough meatballs.

Shape the meat mixture into meatballs about 1 to 1.5 inches in diameter. Place them on the prepared baking sheet, evenly spaced apart.

If baking, lightly brush or spray the meatballs with olive oil to help them brown and crisp up in the oven. Alternatively, if frying, heat a large skillet over medium heat and add a tablespoon of olive oil.

If baking, bake the meatballs in the preheated oven for 20-25 minutes, or until cooked through and browned on the outside. If frying, cook the meatballs in batches, turning occasionally, until browned on all sides and cooked through, about 10-12 minutes.

Once cooked, remove the meatballs from the oven or skillet and let them rest for a few minutes before serving.

Serve the meatballs hot with your choice of sauce. They pair well with marinara sauce, barbecue sauce, creamy Alfredo sauce, sweet and sour sauce or any other favorite sauce of yours.

Freezing meatballs is a smart way to save time and ensure you always have a delicious meal on hand. Once cooked, cool the meatballs completely, then transfer them to a freezer-safe container or resealable bag and store in the freezer for up to 3 months.

Meatballs are incredibly versatile and can be served in a variety of delicious ways. Here are some ideas beyond spaghetti and subs:

Meatball Sliders: Serve meatballs on mini slider buns with your favorite toppings like cheese, lettuce, tomato and a drizzle of sauce.

- pound boneless lamb leg, from shank
- 1/3 cup chili sauce
 - tablespoons teriyaki sauce
- head red cabbage 1/4
 - head romaine lettuce
 - 1 bunch green onions
 - 1 large navel orange
- 1/4 cup orange juice
 - tablespoons low-fat mayonnaise dressing
 - 1 tablespoon cider vinegar
- 1 teaspoon prepared mustard
- teaspoon cracked black pepper 1/4
- 1/8 teaspoon salt
- 1. Trim all fat from lamb. Cut lamb into 12 chunks. In medium bowl, mix lamb, chili sauce and teriyaki sauce; set aside.
- 2. Thinly slice cabbage; discard any tough ribs. Cut romaine crosswise into 1/4-inch-thick slices. Cut green onions into 2-inch pieces. Cut orange in half; cut each half into 3 wedges; cut each wedge crosswise in half.



Defining Hashimoto's Thyroiditis and Finding Out How to Treat It

DEAR DR. ROACH: Please explain Hashimoto's disease. I have heard that it is rare, but two colleagues have recently been diagnosed. We all work in a very high-stress field. -- J.H.

ANSWER: Hashimoto's thyroiditis is not at all a rare disease. It occurs in up to 10% of the population and much more frequently in women than men. Although people can be diagnosed at a young age, it is more common at older ages. It is caused by an autoimmune reaction to different parts of the thyroid, with thyroglobulin and thyroid peroxidase antibodies commonly found. TSH receptor antibodies are found on occasion.

Hashimoto's thyroiditis most commonly causes low thyroid levels, although there may be a period of time early in the disease where thyroid levels are high. Not everybody with antibodies will develop low thyroid levels. The thyroid is sometimes enlarged, but a careful exam will usually show that the gland is firm, showing that immune cells have infiltrated the gland.

Treatment of Hashimoto's thyroiditis involves replacing the thyroid hormone that the gland can no longer make. The dose depends on body size to a certain extent, but needs to be adjusted based on lab results. Most people are treated with levothyroxine, also called T4, which is the primary hormone made by the thyroid.

T4 is converted to T3 (also called triiodothyronine, the active form of the hormone) in various tissues outside the thyroid. T3 only stays in the body for a short while before it is destroyed, so a once-daily treatment with T4, which lasts longer, allows the body to convert T4 to T3.

Most people do very well with T4 treatment. A minority of people cannot efficiently make the active T3 form, in which case-combination treatment can be considered. Unfortunately, T3 must be dosed twice daily.

It is thought that stress hormones play a role, since stress does seem to increase the risk of developing an autoimmune thyroid disease like Hashimoto's.

DEAR DR. ROACH: Huntington's disease runs in my family; my brother and sister started having symptoms in their early 60s. I am 80 and don't have any symptoms. Can I assume that I don't have it? I hear testing can be expensive. Are there any organizations that test for free? -- S.B.

ANSWER: Huntington's is a progressive, degenerative neurological disease that causes abnormal body movements, psychiatric changes and dementia. The movement disorder, called chorea, is the first symptom. It can begin very slowly, and people may not be aware of it. A careful exam can show the characteristic findings. A movement disorder specialist is the ideal person to see in this case.

It would be very unusual to begin having symptoms at, or after, the age of 80, so it is very likely that you do not have the disease if you don't have any symptoms and have received a normal exam by an expert.

Testing should be performed only after careful consideration and counseling by an expert such as a genetic counselor. According to the Huntington's Disease Society of America (see tinyurl.com/HDgenetictesting), testing can cost between \$315-\$1,500, but it is often covered by insurance. Free testing may be available as part of a research study.

Potted Shrimp

Lacking refrigeration, the early settlers preserved seafood and meats by "potting" them. They first cooked the food, then potted and sealed it with plenty of fat, often butter. Potting food is still quite popular throughout the Deep South, especially in the Carolinas.

PREP: 15 minutes plus chilling

COOK: 3 minutes MAKES: about 2 cups

- tablespoons (1 stick) unsalted butter, softened (do not use *margarine*)
- pound medium shrimp, shelled and deveined
- 3/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon ground red pepper (cayenne)
- tablespoons dry sherry Sesame crackers or toast
- 1. In 10-inch skillet, melt 1 tablespoon butter over medium-high heat. Add shrimp, salt and ground red pepper. Cook, stirring frequently, until shrimp are opaque throughout, about 2 minutes. Add sherry and cook 30 seconds.
- 2. Transfer shrimp and pan juices to food processor with knife blade attached and pulse until shrimp is finely chopped. Add remaining butter; process until blended.
- 3. Transfer shrimp mixture to serving bowl. Cover and refrigerate up to 24 hours. Let stand 30 minutes at room temperature before serving. Serve with sesame crackers or toast.

Gothic Revival

Despite the technological and manufacturing advancements of the 19th century, many artists of the time looked to the past for inspiration. Visual artists developed the Pre-Raphaelite style. Architecture and decorative arts had the Gothic Revival.

While it started earlier in England, the Gothic Revival lasted from about 1840 until 1860 in America. Buildings and furniture were decorated with towers, pointed arches, tracery and other features borrowed from medieval castles and cathedrals.

Of course, imitating medieval style didn't mean sticking to medieval technology. Homes in the Middle Ages would have been heated by hearths, but the Victorian era had more efficient and effective ways.

Cast-iron stoves were being made about 1728, and cast iron became popular for furniture in the mid-1800s. This box-shaped Victorian wood stove sold at a Conestoga auction for \$354. The designs embossed on its front, back and sides show the decorative potential for cast iron and provide an example of Gothic Revival style. There is a row of pointed arches, also known as the Gothic arch, on each side. As arguably the most distinctive feature of Gothic architecture, this arch was often incorporated into Gothic Revival designs.

My kids all have character lunch boxes. When I was in elementary school, everyone had lunch boxes with their favorite cartoon character, movie or band. When did they start making these and are old ones valuable?

The first character lunch box was made in 1950 when one was marketed with the cowboy movie star Hopalong Cassidy. The fictional hero walked with a limp in books, movies and television. Aladdin Industries was the first company to produce a lunch box and thermos with a licensed character. More than 60,000 Hopalong Cassidy

lunch boxes were sold in the first year, starting the character lunch box craze that continues to this day. Vintage metal lunch boxes recently have been selling for \$200 to \$775.



High Troponin Levels Follow After Bout of Food Poisoning

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am a 77-year-old male who apparently suffered a case of food poisoning. I say apparently because no cause was ever discovered for the uncontrollable vomiting and diarrhea that lasted for a whole day and recurred briefly the following morning.

A trip to the emergency room involved many tests, but nothing turned up except a troponin level well over 0.04 ng/mL, which prompted an angiogram that didn't reveal any problems with my heart. What else might have caused my high troponin level? -- Anon.

ANSWER: A troponin level is a standard blood test usually used to evaluate patients for heart attacks. However, newer, highly sensitive assays have proven that tiny levels of troponin may be detected in nearly

A level above 0.04 ng/mL is often used as the cutoff for the "normal" range, but depending on the assay and population studied, a few healthy people may have levels above this. People with heart attacks may have troponin levels in the hundreds or thousands. The higher the troponin level, the more muscle damage there is.

The fact that your coronary arteries don't show any blockages is very good news. Other types of heart

damage may also cause a high troponin level, including inflammation of the heart (myocarditis) and heart failure. Also, critical illnesses can cause high troponin levels (at much higher levels than you may have had) in people who don't have heart blockages. (A median of 0.57 ng/mL was found in people with septic shock.)

I found a long list of reported causes behind elevated troponin levels, but gastroenteritis was not on the list. I suspect your body was working so hard to fight off the infection without enough fluid that your heart needed more oxygen-carrying blood than it got, leading to tiny amounts of injury to the heart muscle despite normal heart arteries. You can lose a lot of fluid with vomiting and diarrhea, and people at age 77 don't have as much reserve as they did when they were younger.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I'm a 56-year-old male who never had the chicken pox. When the first of my children was born, I had blood tests done to see if I'd ever been exposed. I had not, so I received the chicken pox vaccine in case my children were to expose me.

ANSWER: Yes, the shingles vaccine is still recommended. Shingles is a recurrence of the chicken pox virus. The vaccine you got was a live but weakened form of chicken pox. It has a lower risk of causing shingles than getting the actual chicken pox, but there is still a risk.

Shingles is so bad that the vaccine is absolutely worth it, in my opinion. Even people who have had the old one-shot vaccine (Zostrix), as well as those who don't recall having had chicken pox, should get the new two-dose vaccine (Shingrix), which is not a live virus. It's better to just get the vaccine than doing blood testing in people who don't recall getting chicken pox as a child.







Daylight Saving Time Second Sunday in March

— National Day Calendar —



Daylight Saving Time begins on the second Sunday in March in the USA. The practice gives people an extra hour of sunlight in the evening by setting the clock ahead one hour on a predetermined date each

The practice of Daylight Saving Time (DST) advances clocks during the summer months. It causes us to lose an hour for one day. However, the practice allows people to get up earlier in the morning and experience more daylight in the evening. Typically, users of DST adjust clocks forward one hour near the start of spring. Then, they change them back again in the autumn.

The system has received both advocacy and criticism. Setting clocks forward benefits retail business, sports, and other activities by exploiting sunlight after working hours. However, the practice causes problems for evening entertainment and other activities tied to the sun or darkness. For example, farming and fireworks shows are both affected.

Although some early proponents of DST aimed to reduce the evening use of incandescent lighting, usage patterns differ greatly. Additionally, research about how DST currently affects energy use is limited or contradictory.

Problems sometimes caused by DST clock shifts include:

- Complicating timekeeping.
- · Disrupting meetings, travel, billing, record keeping, medical devices, heavy equipment
- Impacting sleep patterns

Software often adjusts computer clocks automatically, but this can be limited and error-prone. In addition, programming is particularly problematic when various jurisdictions change the dates and timings of DST changes.

How To Observe Daylight Saving Time

- · Besides adjusting our clocks, it's important to adjust our sleep schedules, too. Many of us go into the time change sleep deprived. Don't do this during Daylight Saving weekend.
- · Start preparing your body and anyone in vour household for an earlier bedtime.
- · That includes pets. Their potty and feeding schedules will need to be adjusted, too. Start a few days before if at all possible.
- In the end, you and your entire household will be able to benefit from the additional sunlight in the evenings by enjoying outdoor activities without feeling the drag of lack of sleep.
- Another way to celebrate the day might include writing your representatives in Congress. According to the National Congress of State Legislatures, nearly every state has tackled the issue of daylight saving time and whether to end it or not. Even at a federal level, the issue has been brought to the table a time or two.
- Of course, most importantly, be sure to turn your clocks forward and use #DaylightSavingTime or #SpringForward to post on social media.

Daylight Saving Time History

George Vernon Hudson from New Zealand proposed the modern version of daylight saving in 1895. Germany and Austria-Hungary were the first countries to use it starting on 30 April 1916.

The energy crisis in the 1970s accelerated the growth of Daylight Saving Time. It has been argued that more natural light in the evening hours uses less electricity due to less artificial lighting requirements. As a result, many retail shops and tourist attractions also enjoy more business.

Daylight Saving FAQ

- **Q.** When does Daylight Saving end?
- A. Daylight Saving ends in November.
- Q. How much daylight is saved?
- A. None. It's just moved from one end of the day to the other.
- **Q.** Does every state participate in Daylight Saving?
- A. No. Arizona, Hawaii, and parts of Indiana do not participate in Daylight Saving. The U.S. territories do not, either.
- Q. Do other countries observe Daylight Saving?
- A. Yes. Many countries observe Daylight Saving including Australia, most areas in North America, and countries in Europe.

3 Ways to Support **Veterans in Your** Community

- Family Features -



As a group, United States military veterans have played an important role in protecting the rights and freedoms enjoyed today. However, the sacrifices made by service members can become easy to overlook with the passage of time.

For example, consider the experiences of Pfc. Antonio Ralph Martinez, one of 2,223 U.S. military servicemen aboard the Leopoldville, a Belgian transport ship. Ahead of the Battle of the Bulge, the last major German offensive of World War II, the Leopoldville was crossing the English Channel from England to France when a German U-boat struck it with a torpedo on Dec. 24, 1944.



In an interview for the Library of Congress Vet-

Of those on board the Leopoldville, 515 are presumed to have gone down with the ship while another 248 died from injuries, drowning or hypothermia. Martinez was awarded a Bronze Star for his combat service during World War II and later served in the Air Force during the Korean War.

Stories like Martinez's showcase the valor and sacrifice of veterans who deserve gratitude. Consider these three small gestures to help show appreciation to the veterans in your community as they reacclimate to civilian life following their service.

1. Send a "Thank You" Card

Offering a heartfelt acknowledgment of the challenges veterans faced is one of the simplest ways to show them your appreciation and provide an emotional boost. If you know a veteran in your community, consider sending a handwritten "thank you" note. Or consult with a local veterans service organization that may be able to help you share a letter, card, care package or supportive email with former military personnel in your area.

2. Encourage Veterans to Share Their Stories

The stories veterans carry with them are powerful and often help shape who they are. These stories can hold valuable lessons, details of accomplishments and battles won or memories of friendship and camaraderie. They can also serve as reminders of sacrifice and hardship.

Through the Veterans History Project, the Library of Congress collects and preserves the firsthand remembrances of U.S. military veterans like Martinez and makes them accessible. The project allows future generations to hear directly from veterans and better understand what they saw, did and felt during their service.

Participating in the program involves submitting a 30-minute (or longer) unedited video or audio interview sharing service details and/or a collection of original photographs or correspondence. Veterans, or families of deceased veterans on their behalf, may also submit a minimum 20-page journal or unpublished memoir and/or 10 or more original photos or letters. To get started, visit loc.gov/vets and click "How to Participate" to download a how-to field kit for details, instructions and required forms.

3. Volunteer at Veterans Facilities or Organizations

Many veterans organizations, including Department of Veterans Affairs hospitals and medical facilities, welcome volunteers to assist with a variety of tasks such as clerical work, organization, transportation and simply visiting with wounded veterans to brighten their days. After locating a facility near you, contact the staff to arrange a visit and learn more about opportunities to volunteer your time

2024 Migratory Bird Stamp Unveiled In Ceremony At Capitol

— Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks —



Stamp to help raise awareness for wetlands conservation

Gov. Greg Gianforte unveiled the winner of the 2024 Migratory Bird Stamp art contest at the Capitol Rotunda in a small ceremony Monday. The winning work will be on display for a week at the Capitol and then at Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks' headquarters in Helena.

The winning artwork is by Florida artist John Nelson Harris. His painting of a northern pintail duck was selected from among more than 70 submissions from artists around the United States. Harris is the designer of more than a dozen conservation prints and stamps, including duck stamps for California, Oklahoma and Washington.

FWP launched the art contest this year to help raise additional awareness and appreciation for wetlands conservation and the benefits of intact wetlands to people and wildlife. Artists were invited to submit their work from Nov. 1 through Dec. 31. The Wetlands Protection Advisory Council selected the winner in January.

"Wetland restoration and conservation is a key part of the work we do at FWP," said FWP Director Dustin Temple. "Intact wetlands benefit fish and wildlife, as well as landowners and communities."

Wetlands are critical for many wildlife and aquatic species, as well providing critical ecosystem functions like flood control, groundwater recharge and water purification. FWP's Migratory Bird Wetland Program helps landowners and other conservation partners develop and fund projects that protect, conserve, enhance or create high-quality wetland

The 2024 Migratory Bird Stamp will not be required to hunt migratory birds in Montana. But those who purchase a migratory bird license will receive a free collectable sticker showing the winning artwork, information about the Migratory Bird Wetland Program and information about how to make additional contributions.

For winning the 2024 Migratory Bird Stamp contest, Nelson receives a \$2,000 prize paid for by contributions from the Montana Outdoor Legacy Foundation, Montana Backcountry Hunters and Anglers, and Montana Audubon.

"We're grateful for partners like these who step forward in support of conservation," Temple said.

Trimming Nails

When your dog's nails nearly touch the ground, it's time for a trim, typically every 3-4 weeks. Trimming the part of the nail that turns down helps prevent pain and damage to paws.

If your dog has white nails, avoid cutting the "quick," the pink part that's visible on white nails,

which bleeds when cut. For dark nails, simply trim a bit at a time until evidence of the quick is visible.

Bathing and Brushing

Frequency for baths and brushing depends on your dog's coat type - be sure to research optimal grooming schedules based on his or her breed. In general, The Humane Society of the United States recommends these guidelines:

- Short, smooth or wiry coat: Brush once a week with a rubber-bristled brush.
- Long, silky or curly coat: Brush once a day with a rubber-bristled brush or wire slicker brush.
 Use a steel comb to prevent tangles or mats, if necessary.
- Double coat: Use an undercoat rake or de-shedding tool to gently de-shed once a week in addition to regular brushing routines.

When it's bath time, use a shampoo formulated for dogs and a damp cloth or cotton ball to clean around the eyes and ears without pushing anything into the eyes or ears. Dry with a microfiber towel or hair dryer on a low setting.

Cutting Fur

Be careful and work slowly to avoid mistakes and keep your dog calm and comfortable. Brush, bathe and completely dry prior to cutting fur with blunt-ended shears or small clippers with guide combs. Specifically trim hair covering the eyes and private areas and between your pup's paw pads. It may be helpful to watch a tutorial online to ensure success.

Brushing Teeth

You can prevent gum disease and plaque buildup by brushing your dog's teeth with a soft toothbrush and dog-friendly toothpaste. Make sure your pet is comfortable and start slow, staying on the outside surfaces of teeth and gently rubbing back and forth. Focus on the area where the tooth surface meets the gum.



As the official hard cards start to hit the market, we sit down with local artists Ed Anderson and Josh Udesen to learn what experiences drive their imagination.

Cataloging Americana with Ed Anderson

From tarpon fishing in the Gulf of Mexico to tracking big mule deer bucks in Idaho's backcountry, Ed Anderson has compiled quite the collection of hunting and fishing adventures. Anderson, known all over the country for his stylistic wildlife paintings, murals and graphic design work, believes every artist has a cool story to tell.

"That's what the West is about now. There's a story of the West that's yet to be told," he said.



Anderson calls his style a "big controlled mess," a way of "cataloging Americana." Using mostly acrylic and Sharpies, Anderson's designs of trout, elk, deer and even turkeys are iconic here in Idaho and have been featured in many outdoor publications.

After growing up in Minnesota, Anderson taught himself the finer stylings of painting and soon found work at the J.N. "Ding" Darling National Wildlife Refuge in Florida. There Anderson cut his teeth on saltwater fly fishing, going after redfish and tarpon.

But it wasn't the shallow fish themselves that drove Anderson's vision for his artwork. It was something deeper.

"I have a terrible memory for hunting and fishing stories, but I remember the experiences," he said. "I never remember the fish, but I remember the times we spent fishing. It's the food, it's the people I was with. It's about watching elk with your kids. We're lucky we get to live in a state where you have great experiences every time you go out."

Drawing Tightlines with Josh Udesen

If a picture is worth a 'thousand words,' where does that leave a painting or crosshatch drawing of said picture? If you ask artist and angler Josh Udesen, the answer is priceless.

Udesen-the artist behind that second Fish and Game hard card design featuring a cobble-lined stream full of colorful trout-has tapped into a unique style of art that harkens back to his days as a fly fishing guide.



"I used to guide up in Alaska and on the Deschutes River before moving to Idaho, and in those places there are fish you're not allowed to take home, even the biggest ones," Udesen said. "I started getting requests to paint other clients' photograph grip-andgrins who wanted a life-size memento of their trophy catch."

Another product of Minnesota-there must be something in the water-Udesen was largely selftaught as a painter and illustrator, his primary method of design. Now, Udesen balances his time as a professional artist with teaching (high school art, naturally).

"A lot of the paintings I do of clients' fish are lifesize. Sometimes it's a 32-inch canvas with a 29-inch fish on it," Udesen said. You can check out more of Josh Udesen's detailed artwork over at his website (www.tightlinestudio.com).

It's not just the fish featured on Josh's and Ed's canvas or sketchpad that catch the eyes of fish-minded art lovers. Whip out that 2024 hard card and see for yourself. Whether you're sporting Ed Anderson's struttin' tom turkey or Josh Udesen's mosaic trout stream, the 2024 Idaho Fish and Game hard cards serve as not only a handy way to keep your fish and hunting license with your gear, but they are literally a work of art.



"They're great," Udesen added. "It's cool to see artists given a chance of sharing their artwork with other likeminded outdoorsmen. I just keep it tucked away in my waders' pocket. You never forget where vou left vour license."

HOT TIP: Want to avoid that moment of all-out panic as you frantically search for your hunting or fishing license while the car idles and the kids try to break free of their car seats? Consider purchasing an extra hard card—maybe one of each design—one for your tacklebox and the other in your hunting pack.

The year is just beginning to hatch, folks. Do yourself a favor and pick yourself up one of two license hard cards and avoid the headache of misplacing your rolodex of hunting and fishing licenses. For just \$6, it'll be one of the smartest moves you can make.






