Hello Dolly Snack Bars

I was always partial to the famous Hello Dolly Bars back in the day. Now, I can enjoy the flavors of those bars, but keep the fats and sugars in check! Who could ask for more?!

- cups reduced-fat biscuit bak- $1\frac{1}{2}$ ing mix Sugar substitute to equal 1/2
- cup sugar, suitable for baking 2/3*cup fat-free milk*
 - 2 tablespoons non-fat sour cream
 - 1 egg or equivalent in egg substitute
 - 1 teaspoon coconut extract
- *cup mini chocolate chips* 1/4
- 1/4 *cup chopped pecans*
- 1/4 *cup flaked coconut*

1. Preheat oven to 350 F. Spray an 8-by-8-inch baking dish with butter-flavored cooking spray.

2. In a large bowl, combine baking mix and sugar substitute. Add milk, sour cream, egg and coconut extract. Mix gently just to combine. Fold in chocolate chips, pecans and coconut. Spread batter into prepared baking dish.

3. Bake for 20 to 24 minutes or until a toothpick inserted near center comes out clean. Place baking dish on a wire rack and let set for at least 5 minutes. Cut into 24 bars. Makes 12 (2 bars each) servings. Freezes well.

Orchestrating Change tells the inspiring story of the only orchestra in the world created by and for people living with mental illness and those who support them. The mission of Me2/Orchestra is to erase mental health stigma one concert at a time.

This film follows Ronald Braunstein, a graduate of Julliard and the first American to win the Von Karajan Conducting Competition. When he made his bipolar disorder diagnosis public, he was shunned by the classical music community. He with his wife, diagnosed with anxiety and depression, founded the first Me2/Orchestra, in Vermont and later a second in Boston.





After a Cold

DEAR DR. ROACH: My daughter, 45, has had a paralyzed left vocal cord for about a year now. We have been to an ear, nose and throat (ENT) doctor who ran at least a half dozen tests, including several scans. These didn't show a reason for the problem, and everything else appeared to be normal. She had a cold before this happened, and we were treating her for a lingering sore throat.

The doctor has told us that there is nothing to be done to unfreeze the vocal cord. I would love your opinion on this matter, as she has a lot of pain associated with it, and she coughs trying to get out what feels stuck in there. -- K.P.

ANSWER: Paralysis of the vocal cord is often the result of damage to the nerve that leads to the vocal cord; there's one on each side. The left side is particularly vulnerable and may be damaged during surgery (especially thyroid surgery), but a big fear is that a mass (especially a cancerous one) can damage the nerve and cause paralysis of the vocal cord. This is why her doctor did a CT scan.

There are other less-common causes, such as nerve damage from other occurrences (stroke and multiple sclerosis); inflammatory diseases (lupus and others); and infections (such as Lyme disease). It sounds like the ENT doctor looked for other

possibilities such as these. (But if not, then it should be done.)

When a cause can't be found, we call it "idiopathic unilateral vocal cord paralysis." This often seems to happen after a viral infection, and it sounds like your daughter might have had one. Many people with this condition get better by themselves during the first year, but now that it has been about a year for her, she isn't likely to get better without treatment.

I am not an expert in treatment, but ENT surgeons have several types of surgical interventions to improve hoarseness, cough and discomfort. It's time to go back to her ENT doctor or get referred to an expert in the surgical treatment of this condition.

DEAR DR. ROACH: If exercise helps new arteries to grow, would it also help new veins to grow and alleviate varicose veins? -- M.D.

ANSWER: It's a good thought, but unfortunately, exercise does not make the body grow new arteries, which are the large blood vessels that bring oxygen-rich blood to our organs and muscles. Exercise increases the size of the arteries and can help keep them from getting stiffer with age. Exercise in combination with a good diet can also help keep them from getting blocked.

In addition, exercise can help with varicose veins, but once again, it isn't because the body grows new veins. Varicose veins are dilated veins that occur due to damage in the tiny valves inside the veins. Without those valves, the venous blood can pool under the effects of gravity, causing the veins to swell.

Exercise helps because of the pump effect of the intermittent muscle contraction, which forces blood back into the large veins and ultimately back into the heart. Exercise, compression stockings and elevation are among the most important lifestyle changes for varicose veins.

April's 'Wildlife Express' **Goes Hoppin' Down The Bunny Trail**

– Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game



Each Wildlife Express issue features an Idaho wildlife species and articles related to science and ecological concepts.

Rabbits, bunnies, hares, wabbits-whatever you call them, we know one when we see one. Every bunny knows that.

Believe it or not, there are five different members of the rabbit family found in Idaho, and divided amongst them are two groups: rabbits and hares. And there are several ways to tell them apart.

Idaho's hares include the black-tailed jackrabbit, white-tailed jackrabbit and snowshoe hare. As a group, hares tend to have larger ears and longer legs than rabbits. Young hares stay near their nest for a short time. In a few days, they leave and follow their mother to new locations.

Baby rabbits, also called kittens or kits, are born in a burrow in the ground. They are naked and their eyes are closed. It takes them several weeks to grow up enough to leave the safety of their nest. By the time the kits are five weeks old, they are independent and can live on their own. Idaho's rabbits include the mountain cottontail and pygmy rabbit.

Jackrabbits, on the other hand, are known for their enormous ears-up to seven inches long. While they give hares excellent hearing, they are also air conditioners. Jackrabbits tend to live in hot, dry places. This makes keeping cool very important. Their ears are filled with many small blood vessels. On a hot day, warm blood from inside a jackrabbit's body flows to these blood vessels.



Cat and Dog Can Coexist

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: I periodically dog-sit for a neighbor, keeping her small Beagle, Downy, at my house while she travels. The problem is my cat, Sparks. He is absolutely infuriated when I bring Downy home, even though Downy doesn't bark at him. Sparks will yowl and glare at the dog every time they're in the same room. And now, Sparks is peeing on the rug next to my bed the entire time that Downy visits. What can I do about this? - Cheryl J., Reno, Nevada

DEAR CHERYL: Ouch! Cats are notoriously territorial, not just with dogs but with other cats, too. And Sparks does not seem to be settling in to the notion that Downy is an OK guest to have.

It's clear that you'll have to keep the two of them separate when Downy is visiting. But by leaving a mess on your bedroom rug, Sparks is signaling that separation may not be enough. The situation is really stressing him out. He's drawing the line by marking your rug, a clear statement: This is my territory!

The quickest way to resolve the issue, of course, is to stop dog-sitting for your friend -- or dog-sit by periodically visiting her home throughout the day to spend time with Downy and make sure he has food and water.

But if that's not possible, and you intend to keep Downy at your house instead, you've got only a few options.

- Keep a clear separation between Downy and the cat. Place their food bowls in separate rooms with the door closed between them.
- Change out the rug in your bedroom for a new one, and spray it with cat pheromone (available at pet stores) to try to stop Sparks from peeing on it.
- · Consider giving Sparks an anti-anxiety medication (available from the veterinarian) to reduce his stress.

Best of luck. Be patient with both pets; they may never be comfortable around each other, but you may be able to keep them both from being too anxious.

Grape hyacinths start from small bulbs. Place them in groups of ten or more, with the bulbs twice as deep as they are tall and a couple of inches apart. They grow in sun or light shade. Don't plant them where it's too wet or too dry. They spread very quickly and can be quite invasive; plant them where it is acceptable for them to spread freely. The flower spikes don't appear until mid-spring. There may be some variation in color, depending on which ones you plant, but smoky blue is the most common color. Once their leaves die off, you can cut them back. - Brenda Weaver Source: www.gardeningknowhow.com

Elk Management Plan Available For Public Review And Comment; Deadline To Comment Is May 5

Plan will guide elk management for the next six years

Idaho Fish and Game is seeking comments on its draft Idaho Elk Management Plan 2024-2030. The plan will provide guidance for staff to implement management actions that will aid in managing elk populations and guide harvest recommendations.

It will function as the action plan for Idaho elk management through 2030 by guiding Fish and Game staff in annual work plan development and prioritization while providing direction for development of season recommendations.

Major sections in the plan include:

- Population Monitoring
- Hunting Opportunities
- Predation
- Private Lands and Elk
- Habitat
- Statewide Management Direction
- Elk Management Zones

See the elk management plan webpage at idfg. idaho.gov/form/elk-management-plan-2024 to read and comment. Deadline to comment is 6 p.m. on May 5.

Why is it important to hunters?

The updated plan is a revision and not a complete overhaul. The department and Commission are unlikely to drastically change the current foundation of elk hunting, which is the 28 Elk Zones with the A/B tag system and a mix of general and controlled hunts.

The plan is the blueprint for sustaining healthy elk herds, rebuilding herds that are below objectives, and establishes goals that Fish and Game will work to achieve over the next six years.

Specifically, the plan:

• Sets elk management objectives for each of the

good strategy is to read the executive summary, which is a good overview of statewide management goals, and then read details about an individual Elk Zone, or zones, a hunter is most interested in.

Of course, people are welcome to read the whole thing, but most won't need to, and they shouldn't feel overwhelmed by the whole plan. Constructive comments should include references to specifics in the plan and why you think they should be different.

If hunters support the existing plan, they're welcome to say that so Fish and Game staff will get an idea of who's for and against certain things.

How does a management plan differ from season setting?

The plan creates sideboards for elk management, and season setting involves the actions within those sideboards that help carry out strategies in the plan. The two work hand-in-hand, but serve two different roles.

The management plan guides wildlife managers' decisions and allows different strategies to be applied to each elk zone.

Some zones might provide more opportunities for muzzleloader and archery seasons through A tags, others are better suited for any-weapon seasons through B tags, and some zones will be limited to controlled hunts.

Season setting is where much of the plan is implemented and uses specific actions – typically hunting seasons – to carry out the management plan.

"Every proposal made during the season-setting process aims to achieve at least one of three things," said Rick Ward, State Wildlife Manager. "Maintain the population within management plan's objectives, provide hunting opportunities, and make sure the elk populations are not causing problems, such as depredation on agriculture lands."

After a public comment period, Fish and Game staff will look at the public input and decide what, or whether, to change things. They will make those revisions and then forward the revised plan to the Fish and Game Commission for their approval. After the Commission approves it, it will guide elk management until at least 2030.



What are harvest statistics and why are they important to white-tailed deer?

Unlike portions of central and southern Idaho, northern Idaho's dense forests and brush provide excellent cover making it difficult to see animals. These forests provide great habitat for white-tailed deer but make counting them tough. In fact, these habitats do such a good job of hiding white-tails that the aerial surveys used by Fish and Game to estimate mule deer and elk populations in other parts of the state do not work here. So, if biologists cannot count them on the hoof, how do they track changes in white-tailed deer populations? Well, one starting point is to have a better grasp on is the graveyard.

Although the graveyard may not be as exciting as the white-tail woods, understanding how many and what sorts of deer were harvested in the past grants biologists a glimpse into white-tailed deer population trends through time. To do this, Idaho Fish and Game biologists use information provided by hunters during check stations and Mandatory Hunter Reports. With this information, biologists can determine harvest numbers, how many bucks and does were harvested, how many points were on the antlers of harvested bucks, hunter success rates, and the number of days hunters spent in the field. As this information builds up over time, biologists can compare similarities and differences in whitetailed deer harvest between seasons and gauge what is going on with white-tailed deer populations, even when we cannot count them from a helicopter!


When a shift in white-tailed deer harvest is detected between years, biologists look to identify the cause of that shift. For example, decrease in harvest could be expected and observed following a disease outbreak of Epizootic Hemorrhagic Disease (EHD). Alternatively, harvest will likely increase following multiple years of mild winter and summer conditions that result in high fawn survival. Because there are many factors that can influence a population, it is an important to consider all factors that could be impacting our white-tailed deer when preparing to make a management decision.

Since 1975, Fish and Game staff have relied on harvest information from hunters to determine what is happening with white-tails. Harvest information provides the basis for wildlife managers across the United States and Canada when it comes to whitetailed deer because they face the same challenges as we do in Idaho when it comes to estimating white-tail populations. This is why providing the Department with information about your hunting experience is so important. Your hunt provides a data point that will help inform biologists and be considered in Idaho's white-tail management.

Clearwater Region white-tailed deer example

Now that we understand the challenges of counting white-tail deer and how to overcome those challenges in a state like Idaho, we can look at an example of using harvest data to inform management in the Clearwater Region. The figure below charts the total white-tail deer harvest in Game Management Unit (GMU) 11A. Before reading ahead, you should look at the figure and consider:

- 1. What is the population is doing?
- 2. What other information may help me understand what is going on?
- 3. If a change in management is necessary?

After review,

- 1. What is the population doing? -Dropping, and fast! What gives? It looks like everything was doing alright until 2020 but then our harvest dropped and it looks like our population took a turn for the worst!
- 2. What other information may help me understand what is going on? -Since hunters provide information every year, it would be helpful to look at this harvest trend over a longer time period and see if our harvest is way outside of the norm. Also, what happened in 2020? Why did harvest drop off so quickly? Lastly, we should look at how many hunters were out during this same time period to see if that number may have changed.


Clearwater Wildlife Blog Series: Installment #2- How Harvest Statistics Are Used! *Part 2 of 2*

- Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game -

Before we get to a management decision, it is time to put on our biologist cap, do some homework, and put our knowledge of harvest statistics to work

- After doing some digging, we found harvest information dating all the way back to 2001, thankfully hunters were reporting all the way back then! The data submitted by those hunters' shows that our current harvest is below the usual harvest for the unit.
- So what happened in 2021? We traced the decline in 2021 harvest back to a documented EHD outbreak in the region. Unfortunately, the 2021 EHD outbreak resulted in many white-tails becoming sick and succumbing to the disease. So, this could explain our dramatic decline in harvest, right!? Possibly, but one more thing...
- One final important piece of information that should be considered is how many hunters were in the unit during this time. Although giving up your 'good' hunting spot is unheard of, many hunters are more willing to share where not to go when hunting is 'poor' - want to know how I know?

GMU 11A White-tailed deer harvest and hunter numbers



White-tailed deer harvest dropped around 67% in GMU 11A in 2021. That is a cause for concern! Especially because this trend falls outside the norm for white-tail harvest in this unit since 2001. However, what is going on with hunter numbers around the same time? Hunter numbers dropped nearly 40% across the unit in the same year! In fact, hunter numbers, like total harvest, are at an all-time low for the unit. Deer numbers were down, but how can managers expect harvest to remain stable with less hunters? The short answer, we can't.

3. So, is a management change necessary?


In this instance, Fish and Game shortened the season in unit 11A by 11 days to help white-tailed deer populations recover from the effects of EHD. Thankfully, Fish and Game had hunter information to help inform this recommendation and make a decision based on past harvest and hunter effort. All things considered, a change was still recommended but the severity of the change could have been much different without the full picture.

With this example in mind, next time you wrapup a hunting season with or without a filled tag, remember that the information right in front of you helps provide Fish and Game with the data to make these types of decisions.

Moments in time

THE HISTORY CHANNEL

- **On April 29, 2004,** the World War II Memorial opened in Washington, D.C. The granite and bronze monument stands on 7.4 acres on the former site of the Rainbow Pool at the National Mall, between the Washington Monument and the Lincoln Memorial.
- **On April 30, 1993,** tennis player Monica Seles was stabbed between the shoulder blades by Gunter Parche during a match in Hamburg. Parche, a fan of German tennis star Steffi Graf, apparently hoped that by injuring Seles, his idol would be able to regain her No. 1 ranking.
- **On May 1, 1963,** Gloria Steinem published the first half of "A Bunny's Tale" in SHOW magazine, recounting her brief stint as a Bunny in Manhattan's Playboy Club. Steinem's undercover reporting revealed a culture of misogyny and exploitation behind the glamorous facade of Hugh Hefner's empire.
- On May 2, 1924, Patrick Mahon was arrested at London's Waterloo train station on suspicion of murder. He was executed later that year for killing his pregnant mistress, but an important innovation resulted from the crime scene: The officers, who had no gloves, were forced to handle the victim's remains with their bare hands. After the investigation, rubber gloves became standard equipment at murder scenes.
- **On May 3, 1980,** 13-year-old Cari Lightner of Fair Oaks, California, was walking to a church carnival when she was struck and killed by an out-of-control car driven by an intoxicated Clarence Busch. Her death led her mother, Candy Lightner, to found the organization Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD), which would grow into one of the country's most influential nonprofit organizations.
- **On May 4, 1776,** Rhode Island, which was founded by the most radical religious dissenters from the Puritans of Massachusetts Bay Colony, became the first North American colony to renounce its allegiance to King George III. It would also be the last state to ratify the new American Constitution more than 14 years later.
- On May 5, 1816, the first published poem by John Keats, the sonnet "To Solitude", appeared in the London journal The Examiner. Keats' sadly brief but overall brilliant span of work includes "Ode on a Grecian Urn," "La Belle Dame Sans Merci" and "Ode to a Nightingale."




