



EarthTalk® From the Editors of E - The **Environmental Magazine**



Dear EarthTalk: Have scientists been able to definitively prove links between global warming and more extreme weather phenomena in recent years, or is this still just a theory? - T.C., Chicago, IL

The question of whether science has been able to prove, let alone prove definitively, the connection between climate change and extreme weather is a very tricky one. This is because science is always reluctant to deal in certainty. "You can never have 100 percent proof of anything. There will always be doubt," reports Jack Fraser, an Oxford-trained astrophysics Ph.D. at the Wellcome Sanger Institute. "Proof can only exist when there is no doubt, and there is always doubt. You could be a brain in a vat, living in a crazy simulation. You could be hallucinating everything. You cannot prove anything."

Despite this embedded doubt in all things scientific, researchers have opened up a new branch of science called 'Extreme Event Attribution' in an attempt to work out the extent of man-made climate change's culpability. To discern this, scientists begin by setting criteria for what made the event extreme. They then turn to historical climate records and make comparisons with other similar events, checking them against the same criteria. They are looking for a change in the intensity or frequency of a certain extreme event.

If they find a change, they then work out what caused it. To do this, they use models. There are many different types of models; one example is creating two virtual worlds with exactly the same

conditions, except one is pumped full of greenhouse gasses. These simulations then create thousands of weather scenarios allowing a direct comparison between the polluted world and the non-polluted world. The difference between the two suggests man-made climate change's culpability in certain weather events.

Although new, this form of science has already gone as far as science permits into proving the role of climate change in certain extreme weather events. "The vast majority of extreme weather events reviewed by researchers since 2011 – 70 percent - were shown to be more likely to occur, or were made more severe, because of global warming," Eric Roston and Brian Sullivan report in The Washington

Take the floods in Pakistan in 2020, for instance. The World Weather Attribution scientists say that their "evidence suggests that climate change played an important role in the event, although our analysis doesn't allow us to quantify how big the role was." And Frederike Otto, a climatologist from Imperial College London, said that "the fingerprints of global warming [were] evident" in the disaster.

Extreme Event Attribution is a particular science that works on a case-by-case basis, but the trend is clear. Seventy percent of extreme weather events were made more likely or more damaging by manmade issues. Definitive proof will never be offered by science, but most studies point in the same direction: towards global warming.







A slice of this looks like a summer sunset or pretty sand art made on a seaside boardwalk. The best part: It's really easy – just scoop and freeze. Your kids can help.

- 1 pint raspberry sorbet or strawberry sorbet, softened
- 1 pint mango or passion fruit sorbet, softened
- 1 pint coconut sorbet, softened
- pint orange or peach sorbet, softened Shaved coconut, fresh raspberries and fresh mint leaves, for garnish
- 1. Spray 9- by 5-inch loaf pan with nonstick cooking spray. Line pan with plastic wrap.
- 2. Using 2-inch (1/4 cup) ice cream scoop, arrange 8 alternating scoops of sorbet (2 scoops of each sorbet) in 1 layer in pan. Place plastic wrap on sorbet scoops and press mixture down to flatten and eliminate air pockets; remove plastic wrap.
- 3. Repeat to make 2 more layers, alternating sorbets within each layer and from layer to layer, and making sure to press mixture down each time. Cover and freeze until firm, at least 6 hours.
- 4. To serve, uncover pan and invert onto platter. Wrap towels dampened with warm water on bottom and sides of pan for about 20 seconds to slightly soften sorbet. Remove pan and plastic wrap. Garnish loaf with coconut, raspberries, and mint. Makes 16 servings.





Cipro Prescription No Longer the First-Line Treatment for UTIs

DEAR DR. ROACH: I was diagnosed with a UTI on my yearly physical urinalysis, but I had no symptoms. I was prescribed Cipro. The five pages of warnings attached to the prescription scared me! So, I checked the FDA and Mayo Clinic websites. Both said that the "risks outweigh benefits" and it "should not be the first choice to treat a UTI." But my doctor says to take it, so I will - 500 mg twice a day for seven days.

Possible side effects include tendon ruptures (including the aorta), nerve damage and more. Scary! I am 71 and in good health with high blood pressure as my only problem, but it's under control. I wasn't told if my UTI is complicated or uncomplicated, but I assume uncomplicated, as my blood work, including kidney tests, were all normal.

Is this drug safe? Why does the FDA say not to prescribe this as the first choice? - C.J.

ANSWER: There is a lot wrong here.

First off, asymptomatic bacteria in the urine does not normally get treated, so I wouldn't have recommended treatment in the first place. I'm not even sure why your doctor ordered a urinalysis – it's not recommended as a screening test for most.

Second, I agree with your research that ciprofloxacin (Cipro) should not be the first-line treatment for symptomatic urine infections. Ciprofloxacin does increase risk of tendon rupture very slightly (three to four cases per 100,000 people treated); may damage the aorta (eight cases per 100,000 in one study, while another large study showed no risk); and may cause neuropathy in one case per 150,000.

Resistance to drugs like ciprofloxacin has been increasing. Other choices, like nitrofurantoin,

trimethoprim/sulfamethoxazole or cephalexin, have more effectiveness with less risk of toxicity. That's why Cipro is no longer a first-line choice. But it can be hard for doctors to unlearn behaviors.

Usually, Cipro is effective and doesn't cause side effects, but practicing evidence-based medicine means changing behaviors to reflect new information, even if your personal experience has generally been good. An individual doctor isn't likely to see damage to tendons, aorta or nerves, but if all doctors changed their behavior, there would be even fewer of these rare events.

When it is used, a short course of ciprofloxacin is normally prescribed for three days, not seven, for uncomplicated urine infections in women. The less a person uses this drug, the lower the risk of these rare but severe side effects. Three days is normally sufficient.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I want to know how to reduce my blood pressure because it is currently 142/90.

ANSWER: Treatment of mildly elevated blood pressure of the type you have starts with lifestyle changes. The first thing is to try to reduce sodium in your diet. Some sodium comes from what you add to food, but much more is in prepackaged foods, especially canned foods. Potassium, found in most fresh fruits and vegetables, has a beneficial effect on blood pressure, especially when sodium is also reduced.

Regular exercise can drop blood pressure by 3 to 5 points. Avoiding alcohol can reduce blood pressure as well. Excess alcohol – more than one drink a day for women or more than two drinks a day for men - is particularly likely to increase blood pressure, so cutting down or stopping helps reduce blood pressure.

Combining all of this advice can reduce the risk of requiring medicines by almost half. Additional treatments, such as meditation and stress reduction, further reduces blood pressure and the need for medication. However, some people, even if they do everything right, can still benefit from medication, which can reduce the risk of heart disease and stroke when appropriately given to patients.



Commission Approves Fishing Regulation Change For Paddlefish In Lower Yellowstone River

— Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks —

New regulation prohibits snagging in the intake fish bypass channel

HELENA - During its meeting on Feb. 22, the Fish and Wildlife Commission adopted a new regulation that prohibits snagging of paddlefish within the intake fish bypass channel on the Yellowstone River.

The intake fish bypass channel is part of a Yellowstone River intake diversion dam project. The project's objectives are to improve upstream and downstream fish passage for pallid sturgeon and other native species, including paddlefish, while maintaining water diversions into the lower Yellowstone project main canal.

Snagging for paddlefish is very popular in the lower Yellowstone and can lead to high concentrations of anglers targeting paddlefish during spawning migrations. Since it is not yet fully understood how the fish bypass channel will influence fish movements and angler behavior, the department proposed closing the bypass channel to snagging to avoid any unintentional catch of migrating pallid sturgeon and other native species.

Closing the bypass to snagging could also reduce potential conflicts between paddlefish anglers and FWP monitoring crews. The bypass channel will remain open for passage by boats and for angling by other methods.

Tiffany Studios

Tiffany Studios is synonymous with luxury and decorative items like jewelry, useful pieces made of precious metals and elaborate stained-glass lamps. The company also made practical objects, such as its line of commercial desk accessories made from about 1890 to the 1930s.

Desk sets include items that office workers are unlikely to see today, like this rocker blotter in the Bookmark pattern. It sold for \$161 at Cowan's auctions in Cincinnati, Ohio.

The Tiffany Bookmark series featured the marks of early printers surrounded by panels of raised leaves and flowers. During the turn of the century, office workers would have used a rocker blotter along with a fountain pen and ink stand. Many people who have written with a ballpoint pen have smeared the ink. Fountain pen ink would have taken even longer to

People would speed up the drying with a sprinkle of sand or powder and, later, by blotting it with special paper. This rocker blotter would have held sheets of blotting paper to use on documents written in ink.

I inherited a set of very old metal cookie cutters from my mother. I've never used them but have childhood memories of the cookies made with them. Can you tell me a little about old cookie cutters? How can I determine the age and price?

With "farm" style currently a design favorite, early cookie cutters with their rustic look are fun to collect and display. Cookie cutters are thought to date from about 1475, with the first American cookie cutters made by tinsmiths in East Berlin, Connecticut, about 1720. Tin was the primary material for cookie cutters until 1920, when aluminum became popular. Plastic replaced aluminum after World War II. Metal cookie cutters with "bullet" handles are especially wanted by collectors. Early cutters usually have backs made of uneven pieces of scrap tin.





Young Puppy Just Can't 'Hold It'

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: We adopted a puppy last month. "Jake" is having some problems adjusting to his new home. He has soiled his own bed three times so far (we crate him at night) and doesn't make it through the day -- he starts whining by the door around lunchtime and, if we're not home, will just go anywhere in the house. How can we fix this? -- Carl B., via email

DEAR CARL: How old is Jake? It sounds like, barring any unknown physical issues or illness, he is a young puppy with a ask@pawscorner.com. ©2022 King Features Synd., Inc.

small bladder. He simply can't hold it as long as a fully grown dog.

The fact that Jake makes it a point to whine by the door means that the house training is effective, but you may be waiting much too long to take him out. When he has to go, he will go. That includes soiling his crate, which is an absolute last resort for a dog.

Follow this guideline, published by the American Kennel Club, called the "month-plus-one" rule: Take your puppy's age in months, and add one. That gives you a rough estimate of the maximum number of hours Jake should wait before going outside to pee or poop.

For example, if Jake is four months old, add one to that number. The total, five, means he should be taken outside every five hours. Every puppy is different, so Jake may need to go out a little sooner. And yes, that means he may need to go out in the middle of the night, or on a pee pad.

He should always be taken out just before bedtime and first thing in the morning, regardless of his age.



Don't Let An Extended Winter Put A Damper On Your Turkey Hunting Kickoff

- Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game -

With a little bit of flexibility and responsible outdoor stewardship, hunters should still be able to get on some birds in the coming weeks.

Spring turkey hunting season is upon us, despite what the view outside our windows may indicate. This seemingly eternal winter has been one for Idaho's record books and will no doubt shake up this year's spring turkey hunt.

That is, however, not a reason to sound the alarm and hang up the shotgun until fall. Fish and Game's wildlife managers still anticipate a healthy crop of spring turkeys – pun intended – and with a little bit of flexibility and responsible outdoor stewardship, hunters should still be able to get on some birds in the coming weeks.

Here are a few reminders and helpful tips to help navigate the fading winter and get the most out of your spring turkey hunt.

Snowbirds

"It's been a rough winter," Fish and Game's Upland Game and Migratory Game Bird Coordinator Jeff Knetter said. "We've seen record snow levels across the state, which could have an impact on turkey movements and where to find them."

While brutal winters may not have the same devastation on turkeys as they do other wintering wildlife, deep snow and prolonged freezing temperatures do shuffle the birds around.

Like other wildlife, turkeys typically leave higher elevation areas and ride out the winter in lowlands. Many of these lower elevation regions fall under private landownership. Agricultural fields can be a nice, tropical getaway for a wild turkey, where food is easier to find and snow is minimal to nonexistent.

"You tend to see turkeys concentrated during winter, and a lot of times they're in privately owned fields," Knetter said.

That effect is multiplied when you have a long, severe winter, which can bunch up turkeys even more. As you plan your hunt, be thinking about the lower elevation areas where turkeys may still be hanging

Ask for permission

With the potential for more turkeys to still be down low (and most likely on private land), Fish and Game wants to remind hunters to always ask permission well before they head out hoping to bag a bird.

"Don't be surprised to see even more turkeys hanging up on private land while we wait for the snow to melt," Knetter said.

Hunting on private land can be a new and enjoyable experience. Landowners who do allow hunting are more likely to grant access to their land to people who ask well in advance.

It also doesn't hurt to grease the wheels with a potential new landowner relationship by bringing them a small gift or writing them a letter. Sportsmen can improve landowner/sportsman relations considerably by looking at things from the perspective of a landowner. Landowners want gates left the way they had them (opened or closed) before the hunter arrived and don't want vehicles driven on soft ground, creating ruts or damaging crops.

Plain and simple: Always ask for permission and be sure to follow the landowner's rules when on their property.

Head for the hills (eventually)

Hunters looking to get after it on opening day and the subsequent first few weeks might have a harder time finding birds where they've historically had success. That lush mountain meadow or that mid-elevation hillside might still be buried under three feet of snow.

Wild turkeys typically spend the winter down low, then follow the snowline up as the snow recedes. With multiple feet of snow still blanketing some places, it could be several weeks before the turkeys start creeping back up to their summer homes.

"It may be a while before hunters start to see turkeys back in the places they hunted them during past, milder springs," Knetter said.

It might be a smart move to start low and work high. Think like a turkey.

Tread lightly

Access is another important factor this year as snow (hopefully) begins to recede. Afterall, all that water has to go somewhere. And nowhere is that more apparent than dirt roads.

Whether you're a turkey hunter, antler collector or mushroom picker, we're all eager to get out and hit the mountains as the temperatures start creeping back up. But with that excitement comes the responsibility to recreate and travel appropriately.

"Whether on public or private lands, traveling on wet and muddy roads causes unwanted and unnecessary damage, and also makes a mess of your vehicle. We're all excited to get outdoors, but to do it responsibly and wait until roads and trails are dry enough to be on," said Roger Phillips, Fish and Game's Public Information Supervisor.

Knetter adds there's no reason for turkey hunters to push into the higher elevations.

"Turkeys won't be up there anyway," he said. "Be patient, start low and follow the snowlines as they

The turkey season runs relatively long, until May 25 in most of the state. There will be time to access your favorite turkey hunting spots as the weather changes, so be patient and flexible in the early

Final reminders before you head out

Turkey hunting isn't dissimilar to other types of wild game hunting, but it does present some unique, important complexities due to the nature of closerange hunting, usage of full camouflage and calling.

Here are a few more important reminders before you head out this spring.

- 1. Positively identify your target.
- 2. Assume every noise and movement is another hunter.
- 3. Never stalk a turkey or turkey sound.
- 4. Don't wear red, white or blue.
- 5. Protect your back.
- 6. Shout "Stop" to alert approaching hunters.
- 7. Make your position known to other hunters.
- 8. Preselect a zone of fire.
- 9. Choose safe, ethical hunting companions.
- 10. Practice courtesy and self-control at all times.

All ethical wild turkey hunters support a series of rules that make wild turkey hunting the quality experience it can be. Following these rules will not only help maintain healthy flocks of wild turkeys in Idaho, but will also add to the challenge and excitement that is wild turkey hunting.

- Do not disturb nesting hen turkeys or their nests.
- Though it is legal (during legal hours) to shoot a tom out of a roost tree, this practice is unacceptable among most hunters.
- If you hear another hunter calling a bird, allow that hunter to continue undisturbed and leave

Have fun out there this spring and stay safe. Be sure to check Fish and Game's 2022-23 Upland Game, Furbearer and Turkey Seasons and Rules booklet available online, at regional offices or most license vendors - and review the rules and restrictions depending on when and where you'll be hunting.

Spring Turkey Hunting Outlook Looking Good For 2023, Similar To 2022

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game —



Season opens April 8 for youth, April 15 for general

Despite a heavy winter that's blanketed much of the state, Fish and Game biologists are optimistic about expectations for this year's spring turkey

Youth turkey season opens April 8, and the general turkey season and many controlled hunts open April 15. Hunters can see which units have general hunts in Fish and Game's turkey hunting rules, in addition to details about the seasons.

Hunters will find most general hunting opportunity in the Panhandle, Clearwater, Southwest and Southeast regions, while most other areas are limited to controlled hunts. In each of the regions with general hunting opportunity, turkey populations are faring well, and the hunting outlook is as good as or better than recent years.

"Idaho continues to provide some of the highest turkey hunting success rates in the country," said Jeff Knetter, Fish and Game Upland Game & Migratory Game Bird Coordinator. "While above average winter conditions will have likely impacted turkey numbers regionally, the general outlook for turkey hunting this spring is positive. Abundant turkeys and a wide variety of public and private land access make for excellent wild turkey hunting opportunities in Idaho."

Fish and Game wildlife managers from each of the state's seven regions have been monitoring regional turkey populations throughout winter and share some insights into how each region's turkey populations are looking so far this year.

Magic Valley Region

The Magic Valley Region has limited turkey hunting opportunities, with only two spring controlled hunts offered in Unit 54 with a total of 30 tags. Turkeys are primarily found on or near Big Cottonwood Wildlife Management Area. Turkeys follow the snow line up as spring progresses and are more widely distributed later in the hunting season.

Over the past several years this turkey population has declined due to a combination of several environmental conditions; however, a spike in reproduction during spring 2022 has bolstered the local population near the Big Cottonwood WMA. This boost in production should provide more opportunity for the lucky tag holders in this unit.

Southeast Region

Winter conditions were well above average this year, and as such, overwinter survival is expected to be below average. That being said, most turkeys in the Southeast Region find refuge on private lands in the winter months and may attain higher-than-expected survival rates. Drought conditions this past summer could have negatively impacted chick survival; however, Fish and Game did not measure drought impacts.

Hunters should expect slightly decreased turkey numbers compared to last spring. Turkey distribution may also be impacted by the significant snowpack still present across much of the region.

Hunters will find turkeys in Units 70, 71, 73, 74, 75, 77 and 78. Highest concentrations of turkeys are found on the western sides of the Bear River and Portneuf mountain ranges. Other portions of the region have more sporadic and patchy distributions of turkeys. Many birds are associated with private lands, and hunters are urged to be respectful of private properties and landowners when pursuing turkeys.

Upper Snake Region

Winter arrived early with snow and cold temperatures coming in November followed by above-normal snowpack across most of the region. Hunters will likely find most turkey hunting opportunities at lower elevations. Due to above average winter conditions, hunters should anticipate stable to slightly declining turkey populations in the region this spring.

Turkey populations in the Upper Snake Region are mainly found along the Henry's Fork and South Fork of the Snake River as well as major drainages that funnel to these two river systems. Turkey hunting is limited to controlled hunts for both spring and fall seasons in the region, and there are some youth-only hunts available for young hunters.

The region likely had some late-winter mortality, but hunting success rates should remain stable. The region is home to a lot of private property along the Henry's Fork and South Fork of the Snake River, so be sure to ask first to hunt on private land.

Salmon Region

With moderate to mild winter conditions, the Salmon Region is seeing good overwinter turkey survival. Winter population counts showed a relatively stable population in the Salmon area. Turkey distributions appear to be expanding, and although winter surveys were not conducted in the Challis area, anecdotal observations suggest numbers are slightly down from previous years.

Currently, all turkey hunting in the Salmon Region is regulated through controlled hunts for both spring and fall seasons. Hunting opportunities were expanded in 2022 for all spring and fall controlled hunts. This was in response to growing populations.

With expansion in turkey distribution, we are starting to see more birds on public land, but we still want everyone to know it is primarily a private-land hunt at this time.
