



This year's list includes avocados, sweet corn, pineapple, onions, papaya, frozen sweet peas, eggplant, asparagus, broccoli, cabbage, kiwi, cauliflower, mushrooms, honeydew melon and cantaloupe.

It's important to emphasize, just because a fruit or vegetable is on the Dirty Dozen list doesn't mean that it's unsafe to eat. It simply means that it may contain higher levels of pesticides than other items on the list.

The Environmental Working Group is a widely respected nonprofit organization that puts out these lists each year. They use data from the United States Department of Agriculture and the Food and Drug Administration to determine which fruits and vegetables are most and least likely to contain pesticide residue.

So, why should you pay attention to these lists? Mainly because buying organic produce is almost always more expensive than buying conventionally grown produce. By using the Dirty Dozen and Clean 15 lists, you can prioritize which produce items you should try to buy organic and which ones you can save money on by buying conventionally grown.

For example, strawberries are at the top of this year's Dirty Dozen list. If you eat lots of strawberries, it might be worth spending a little extra money to buy organic strawberries to avoid consuming potentially harmful levels of pesticide residue. Meanwhile, avocados are at the top of the Clean 15 list. If you eat a lot of avocados, you can save money by buying conventionally grown avocados without worrying too much about pesticide residue.

Of course, it's important to note that even conventionally grown produce is generally considered safe to eat. Additionally, you can further reduce

your exposure to pesticides by washing your produce thoroughly before eating or cooking.

Here's a fast, frugal and healthy recipe, featuring two Clean 15 ingredients: frozen peas and onion.

GREEN PEA SOUP

Yield: 4 servings Total Time: 35 minutes

1 tablespoon olive oil I cup sweet onion, chopped 3 cups vegetable stock 4 cups frozen peas

To serve: sour cream or Greek yogurt and green onion

In a large saucepan, heat the oil, then add the onion and cook on low heat for 5 minutes until softened but not browned. Add the stock, cover, and cook for 5 minutes. Stir in the peas, bring it back to a simmer and cook for 5 minutes, or until the peas are cooked. Puree the soup in batches in a blender or blend with an immersion blender. Collectors use the names "Amphora" or "Teplitz" for art pottery made in the Turn-Teplitz region of

Bohemia (now the Czech Republic) from the late 19th to the early 20th century. The best known and most elaborate examples are decorated with applied three-dimensional figures in an art nouveau style.

An Amphora piece might look like it has trees growing out of it, an animal's tail wrapped around the neck or base, or a human figure holding on to the rim or reaching for fruit on a molded branch.

Here, a stylized octopus appears to sit on top of the vase, with two of its tentacles forming side handles and the rest trailing down the vase's pear-shaped body. It sold for \$6,600 at Morphy Auctions. Early Amphora pieces (made before World War I) are higher quality, look more interesting and tend to get higher prices.

What is "bone china"? Is it another name for porcelain or something different?

Bone china is a type of porcelain. It is made by combining clay and minerals with the ash left from burning animal bones. This makes it stronger, thinner and more durable than hard-paste porcelain. It has to be fired at higher temperatures and is more difficult to make. It was first made in England in the late 1700s, when European ceramicists were trying to replicate Chinese porcelain. Some historians think bone ash was first added to the clay due to a mistranslation of a French description of Chinese porcelain making. Although bone china was made earlier, the words "bone china" started appearing in marks on pieces in 1915.

TIP: To cover a scratch in wooden furniture, mix a paste of instant coffee and water and rub it into the scratch. Another quick fix is to color the scratch with the proper color crayon.

Arts and Crafts

Arts and Crafts furniture was in style from the late 19th to the early 20th century. It was very different from the ornate styles of the earlier Victorian era. It had the advantage of new tools and mass production. The Arts and Crafts movement promoted skilled craftsmanship, quality work and simple, sturdy shapes.

Iconic Arts and Crafts and Mission workshops, like Stickley and Roycroft, are known for their simple furniture made in dark oak with little ornamentation. This doesn't mean that every Arts and Crafts piece is a plain, heavy box!

This umbrella stand, which sold for \$300 at a Selkirk auction in St. Louis has a light, intricate look. However, its design uses straight lines and simple geometric shapes. Its ball feet create a sturdy look; and, as an umbrella stand, it was made with use in mind.

I found an old electric toaster from the 1920s at a flea market. I am using it as a decoration in my kitchen. What is the history of toasters?

Toasting bread with electricity and not over a fire was made possible in 1905, when American metallurgist Albert L. Marsh developed a nickel-chromium alloy he called "Chromel." It was low in electrical conductivity, infusible and resistant to oxidation, which made it the perfect metal to shape into filament wires and coils for heating elements. In 1908, General Electric patented its own nickel-chromium alloy that contained iron. It was called "calorite." In 1909, GE introduced its D-12 bread toaster, invented by Frank Shailor, which was a commercial success, 19 years before the invention of bread-slicing machines in 1928. Over the next 100 years, toasters were made of metal, wood, porcelain and Bakelite. The value of a vintage toaster depends on its rarity, aesthetics and the design of its electrical

and mechanical works. We are amused by a toaster twice as long as others that toasts the bread by sending it through the long toaster instead of popping up.

TIP: Save your broken dishes, vases and other decorative china to make mosaic stepping stones or tabletops for your garden. Chipped vases can still be used for flowers or turned upside down to make toad homes.



Prepare Fresh Pasta

Pasta is a favorite national food of Italy, where it is typically cut into a variety of shapes and eaten with a sauce, in a soup or incorporated into a baked dish. But it's not just a favorite in Italy! Kids everywhere love pasta. No wonder it regularly appears on our family table. Mysteriously, though, when the kids were young, they often claimed to love linguine but not spaghetti, or shells but not elbows. And no matter how many times I tried to explain that it's all the same thing, they insisted, "No! It tastes different!"

Here's your chance to see for yourself when making fresh pasta with kids. They can cut this dough into a variety of shapes right before their eyes. When it's cooked, they'll discover one thing is certain: Eating fresh pasta ("pasta fresca") opens the taste buds to something quite different from the standard dry pasta from a package.

And if, while slurping the pasta into their mouths, you hear, "We like the squiggly shapes better," then you'll have your answer. Maybe some forms are just a little more fun.

To cook pasta:

Boil the pasta in salted water for 4-5 minutes. Drain and serve with a pasta sauce and cheese. Or toss into a pot of simmering chicken soup and boil until cooked.

Can Toxin Affect Dogs Like It Does People?

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: My dog "Percy" loves to jump into the lake nearby for a swim every day, especially on a hot afternoon. But the last time we were at the shore, a neighbor said there was an algae warning and that dogs and people should stay out of the water. Percy has been in that lake all summer and hasn't been affected. Would that algae really do anything to him? — Pet Dad in Texas

DEAR PET DAD: If you doubt your neighbor's warning, check with the city or municipality that manages the lake to see if an algae advisory has been issued. Signs are often posted at boat ramps and swimming areas.

There is at least one type of algae that is particularly harmful to pets. Blue-green algae, also known as cyanobacteria, can build up around the shores of lakes and ponds where water does not flow quickly — especially during the hottest months of summer. It's not always visible, but when large amounts are present it may clump together and appear as a blue-green or "pea-soup"-like scum or foam.

Cyanobacteria can be fatal to dogs because it can cause liver failure, and lifelong health problems if a dog survives the initial exposure. Dogs that ingest the bacteria can show symptoms within a few minutes — vomiting, diarrhea, excessive drooling, breathing difficulties, confusion, seizures or collapse. Immediate treatment by a veterinarian is essential when symptoms appear.

So, if you hear a warning about letting your dog go into a specific lake or pond, whether from a neighbor or an official, take it seriously. Keep Percy out of the water until the all-clear is given.



Held on the last Saturday in April, National Sense of Smell Day celebrates one of the five senses. Our sense of smell is more than a way to know when dinner is ready. It also plays a role as an early warning system, triggers memories, and interacts with our other senses.

Did you know, scent cells renew every 30-60 days and are the only sense nerve cells that can regenerate. Those scent cells allow us to recognize smells from childhood, triggering memories of Play-doh, grandma's cookies or pipe smoke. It's also the only sense directly connected to the brain where all those memories are stored.

Take a woman when house shopping. She's more likely to smell unwelcome odors such as smoke, pet urine, or mold before a man. Women naturally have a better sense of smell.

While the loss of smell occurs naturally with age, it can also be a sign of illness, especially a neurological



Deadline Coming Up! Application Period For Moose, Bighorn Sheep And Mountain Goat Controlled Hunts Closes April 30

- Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game -



Moose, sheep and goat drawing results will be online in early June

A reminder to big game hunters that Sunday, April 30 is the deadline to apply for any moose, bighorn sheep and mountain goat controlled hunts. Folks can apply for one of these three species in a year, and those who apply for a moose, sheep or goat hunt are ineligible for most deer, elk and pronghorn controlled hunt drawings.

Please note that Fish and Game staff will be unavailable Saturday, April 29 and Sunday, April 30 to assist with questions or corrections for applications. If assistance is needed, please contact our Licenses office no later than Friday, April 28.

Hunters can apply online or at any Fish and Game office, license vendor or by telephone by calling (800) 554-8685.

Hunters are reminded that Fish and Game no longer accepts mail-in applications, and that moose, bighorn sheep and mountain goat controlled hunt tags are excluded from designation by any parent or grandparent to their minor child or grandchild.

Moose, bighorn sheep and mountain goat controlled hunts remain unchanged for nonresident hunters, who can still apply, and are limited to no more than 10 percent of the total number of tags for each species.

To apply for moose, bighorn sheep and mountain goat hunts, each applicant must possess a 2023 Idaho hunting or combination license. There is a non-refundable application fee of \$16.75 for residents and \$45.75 for nonresidents. Moose, sheep and goat hunt applicants must pay the tag fee along with the application fee when they apply. The total application fees for moose, bighorn sheep and mountain goat are:

- Residents under Price Lock: \$183.50
- Residents without Price Lock: \$216.50
- Nonresidents: \$2,672.50

Moose, sheep and goat drawing results will be online in early June. Tag fees will be refunded to those who did not draw, but not the hunting license or application fees.

A person is allowed to apply for one of these three species in a year, and those who apply for a moose, sheep or goat hunt are ineligible for most deer, elk and pronghorn controlled hunt drawings. For more details, see page 37 of the rules booklet.



Dear EarthTalk: What is "red tide" and is it caused by pollution or human activity? - Tamara G., Los Angeles, CA

Red tide is a phenomenon that occurs when algae in the ocean reproduce rapidly and create a large concentration of red pigments in the water, giving it a reddish-brown hue. These algae, also known as harmful algal blooms (HABs), can produce toxins that are harmful to marine life, including fish, shellfish, and mammals like dolphins and whales. Red tides can also pose a threat to human health if people consume contaminated seafood or come into contact with the water.

According to the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), red tides are a natural occurrence that happens in coastal waters all over the world. They can be caused by a variety of factors, including changes in water temperature, salinity and nutrient levels. However, some human activities, such as pollution and nutrient runoff from fertilizers, can exacerbate the growth of harmful algae and contribute to the frequency and severity of red tide

One of the primary nutrients that can contribute to red tide is nitrogen, which is commonly found in fertilizers and sewage. As Dr. David Anderson, a researcher at the University of Wisconsin-Madison who studies harmful algal blooms, explains, "when excess nutrients, especially nitrogen, are added to coastal waters from sources like sewage treatment plants and agricultural runoff, they can trigger explosive growth of certain algae species that produce toxins."

In addition to nutrient pollution, other human activities can contribute to the spread of harmful algal blooms. For example, boats and ships can carry invasive species of algae and other marine organisms from one area to another, which can disrupt the balance of the local ecosystem and create conditions that are favorable for red tides to occur. According to the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, human activities that can increase the likelihood and severity of red tide include nutrient pollution, shoreline development that alters water flow, and the release of exotic species.

While red tide is a natural phenomenon, it is clear that human activities can contribute to its frequency and severity. To mitigate the impact of harmful algal blooms on marine life and human health, it is important to reduce nutrient pollution and other forms of environmental degradation that can contribute to the growth of harmful algae. As Dr. Anderson notes, "reducing nutrient pollution is key to mitigating the impact of harmful algal blooms, and we need to do more to address this problem."

If you come into contact with red tide contaminated water, you could develop skin irritation on affected body parts and/or a cough/congestion due to breathing in contaminated fumes. Experts recommend washing off with soap and warm water and heading inside to an air-conditioned space. And if you eat shellfish affected by red tide's "brevotoxins" you could come down with Neurotoxic Shellfish Poisoning which can lead to gastrointestinal problems and a reversal of hot and cold sensitivity-if you are worried about something you ate and encounter any of these symptoms, seek medical help ASAP.

Adopting an Older Cat Can Bring Unexpected Issues

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: We recently adopted a 12-year-old orange tomcat. Abel is neutered and well behaved, but he has some health issues that we didn't bargain for. He's overweight (we're working on it) and recently needed a tooth pulled. He gets ear and eye infections frequently. I'm not about to give him up, but I wanted others to know that a senior cat often has more medical needs than younger cats. The tradeoff is that he's a sweet, gentle cat, well adapted to humans, and seems less inclined to escape from the house than a younger cat might. - Kelly B., Salt Lake City

DEAR KELLY: Thank you for sharing your experience! Abel sounds like a wonderful cat.

Senior cats, age 11 to 14, do need extra monitoring. They often have health issues specific to older cats, and can be more susceptible to infections, bad teeth, etc. Pretty much all the same issues humans face as we grow old!

As you've noted, Abel's diet is really important. Not just to lose weight and keep it off, but to make sure he's getting the right nutrition for a senior cat. A cat food formulated for older cats is helpful, but owners should work with the veterinarian to determine the amount and type of food to give their cat each day. Lots of protein is a must, as this article by VCA points out: vcahospitals.com/know-your-pet/ feeding-mature-senior-and-geriatric-cats

Dehydration is another factor for older cats. Empty and refill your cat's water bowl each morning and monitor how much the amount decreases throughout the day to determine how much he drinks.

Finally, monitor your cat's litter box habits. Write them down and take them to the next vet checkup to make sure there are no hidden health problems cropping up.



Spring has sprung! In honor of Earth Day and for your culinary enjoyment, let's chat about growing herbs. You don't get more bang for your buck than planting an herb garden.

Have you seen how expensive a bundle of fresh basil or dill is at the grocery store? It's crazy! For nearly the same price you can buy a live plant and enjoy a continuous harvest throughout the growing season and dried or frozen herbs all winter.

If you find yourself with an enthusiastic plant, just snip off the flower heads before they set seed. Or better yet, share your abundance with friends.

This means you can grow your own fruits and vegetables and save money in the long run.

Not only do they get to see the seeds germinate and grow into plants, but they can also learn about different types of herbs and their uses in cooking and beyond.

This classic Argentinean green sauce is used to accompany grilled steak, but it's also great with chicken, pork, vegetables, eggs or as a marinade for meat. The measurements are flexible. Use this as a place to begin, adjusting the recipe until it delights your taste buds.

CHIMICHURRI VERDE

Yield: 1 1/2 cups

Total Time: 15 minutes

- 2 cups parsley (or 1 cup each parsley and cilantro)
- 3-5 garlic cloves, peeled and coarsely chopped

1/4 cup chopped onion (I used a combo of purple and green onions) 1/4 cup extra virgin olive oil

3 tablespoons red wine vinegar

1/2 teaspoon dried Mexican oregano

1/2 teaspoon kosher salt

1/4 teaspoon crushed red pepper

Measure 2 packed cups of the washed leaves and tender stems of parsley and/or cilantro. (I love that we can use stems in this recipe! They're so flavorful, and they're often discarded.) In your food processor, process the garlic and onion until chopped. Add the herbs and process until fine-

ly chopped. Add the oil, vinegar, oregano, salt and pepper flakes, and process until combined. Let sit at least 10 minutes for flavors to meld. If making ahead of time, cover tightly (imagine that raw garlic and onion invading your fridge!) and chill until ready to use. Leftover sauce can be kept refrigerated for a week.

In conclusion, having fresh herbs on hand can make even the simplest of dishes feel gourmet. So why not grow your own herb garden and never pay for expensive herbs again? Your taste buds (and wallet) will thank you!





Grizzly And Black Bears Are Coming Out Of Hibernation, And Here's Some Helpful Tips For How To Live And Recreate In Bear Country

Get yourself and your property ready for living and recreating in bear country

North Idaho is home to both grizzly and black bears, and nearly all of Idaho has black bears. Each spring, they emerge from hibernation ready to feast and pack on fat for next winter. Unfortunately, this insatiable appetite can often land them in areas and situations where public safety is at risk. But there are some simple steps landowners and recreationists can take to make themselves and their properties less appealing to bears.

Spring and summer 2022 laid claim to unprecedented grizzly and human encounters in the Panhandle, particularly in Boundary county. Many of the recorded incidents occurred on private property and resulted in the loss of livestock. Thankfully none of the incidents resulted in human injury. A little preparation can go a long way to preventing more incidents from occurring this spring.

Get your property ready

- Electric fences are the most effective deterrent for grizzly bears.
- Dispose of carcasses and afterbirth through sanitation services, inside an electrified boneyard or by distributing away from people, buildings and livestock. Electric fences can be placed around fresh carcasses and bone piles until they can be permanently removed.
- Install electric fences around non-removable attractants, such as birthing grounds, sheep-bedding areas, chicken coops, bee apiaries, compost piles, gardens, fruit trees, berry bushes or corn fields.
- Vulnerable animals should be secured within an electric fence when unattended by people or at night. Vulnerable livestock include young, sick or injured livestock, and small livestock such as poultry, goats, sheep, rabbits, llamas and pigs.
- Properly dispose of attractants, including trash and compost.
- Securely store food, garbage, beehives, grain spills, scented products and other attractants in a bear-resistant place.
- Keep pet food secured as you do your own. Bears like pet food as much as your pet does.

- Many attractants can be secured in hard-sided buildings with four walls, a roof and locking door.
- Avoid filling bird feeders until wintertime.
- Do not bury or throw garbage into the nearby woods.
- Make sure to clean your grills and keep them in a building, if possible.

In addition, here are a few tips in the event you do encounter a bear either on your property or while out recreating:

- Never approach bears, always stay at least 300 feet away.
- · Do not interrupt bear activities.
- · Never feed bears.
- Carry bear spray and know how to use it.
- Never run if you encounter a bear.
- Avoid recreating alone, stay on maintained trails and make noise.
- · Avoid recreating at dusk, dawn or night.

We are here to help

Two Fish and Game employees are largely dedicated to grizzly bear management and education in the Panhandle Region. The first is a Grizzly Bear Enforcement and Education Senior Conservation Officer, and the second is a seasonal Grizzly Bear Management and Education Biologist.

The positions exist to respond to grizzly bear-human conflicts, work with landowners to prevent future bear conflicts and provide bear education and outreach. Both positions are based out of Boundary County, and as part of their program, supplies and support can be provided to the public for grizzly bear-human conflicts.

Landowners can request assistance and a variety of educational materials for "living in bear country" by contacting the Panhandle Regional office at (208) 769-1414. We encourage the public to take advantage of the resources we have available to help. In addition, other cost-sharing programs through other entities exist for reducing human-bear conflicts.


