





New State Record Northern Pike Caught In North Idaho: 40.76 Pounds!

An angler on Hayden Lake in North Idaho recently landed the new state record northern pike

On March 21, 2023, Hayden Lake in North Idaho produced a new certified state record northern pike. The record fish weighed a whopping 40.76 pounds, was 49 inches in length and 26.5 inches in girth – a true monster of a fish!

The record was previously held by a fish that was also caught in North Idaho, in Lower Twin Lake. The fish, caught in 2010, weighed 40.13 pounds, was 50.75 inches long and 22.75 inches in girth.

The story

Thomas Francis is an avid northern pike angler and has been for some time.

"Pike is what I go after all the time. I spend almost everyday fishing for pike. As soon as the ice is off and until it comes back," Francis said.

Despite being an avid pike fisherman, nothing could have prepared him for the fish that would later latch on to the end of his line and lay claim to the Idaho state record.

Fancis' day of fishing on Hayden Lake started like any other - same gear, same approach and same goal, to catch big pike.

When he got to the lake that day, there was still some ice on the lake, so he couldn't cast right up to the shore, only to the edge of the ice.

"When my lure hit the water, I let it sink all the way to the bottom. As soon as my lure hit the bottom, I felt her hit. I fish with 80 pound-test line, and she almost immediately started peeling drag, a lot of it," said Francis.

Francis said he almost immediately knew this was a big fish.

"She pinned herself to the bottom and just kept going, peeling drag the whole time. I knew that wasn't

normal, and I could tell it was something special."

After peeling drag for a while, the behemoth changed her tactics.

"Suddenly I got slack line, as she was coming straight up from the bottom. She came flying out of the water, and it was obvious she was a huge fish," recalled Francis.

When he finally landed her, Francis said he knew she was going to be a state record fish, or at least a close contender.

"I immediately headed for the dock to try and find a boat with a scale and tape measure. We found a boat with a scale, and the fish pegged the scale out at 30 pounds, so we knew we needed to find a bigger scale."

After visiting a few different places to find a certified scale, they finally received a certified weight of 40.76 pounds, a new state record.

When asked what he thinks about pike fishing in North Idaho, Francis said, "I like having pike around; they are the biggest fish we can go after here in North Idaho, and I fish for them almost everyday."

From all of us at Idaho Fish and Game – congratulations, Thomas!

Maybe you're next!

Who knows what size fish may tug on your line next; maybe it will be the next state record! If you catch a fish you believe may be a state record, here's what you need to do to apply for the record spot.

- First you can visit our record page on our website for all the details you need.
- From there you'll need to fill out an Idaho state record fish application.
- As part of the application, you'll need to provide the method of catch, a weight from a certified scale along with a receipt documenting the weight, at least one photo of the fish and the signature of a witness.
- Lastly, you will need a signature from a Fish and Game staff person.

The best places to find certified scales are often post offices and grocery stores.

Did you know there are both certified weight records and catch-and-release records for all fish species? To learn more about submitting a fish for a catch-and-release record, check out this application form. Good luck fishing this spring and summer!

Dog's Driveway Poop Is a Bone of **Contention for Neighbors**

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: My next-door neighbor shares a driveway with me. We get along fine, organizing our cars so no one is blocked in. However, every morning she walks her dog up the side of the driveway and doesn't pick up after it. I've asked her to do so, but she said that since it's her side of the driveway she has the right to let him poop there. What can I do to solve this? -Stunk Out in Bradenton, Florida

DEAR STUNK: Neighbor disputes over dog droppings are always a bit nerve-wracking,

especially when the offending neighbor asserts their right to leave a mess.

your Check neighborhood homeowners association rules to see if this issue is addressed. If you don't live in an area with an HOA, check out your city or county's website to find out if there are any restrictions for this sort of behavior, and if it's possible to file a complaint.

Even though your neighbor is keeping the dog on her side of the driveway, it's shared property. Further, dog poop left lying around, even on the edge of the driveway, is a health hazard. Not to mention how ick it is for anyone who parks on that side and accidentally steps out onto one of those "gifts."

No matter what, don't lose your cool. Stay civil toward your neighbor. Keep asking her to pick up after the dog, and note down the date and time of each interaction and each time poop is left behind. Take pictures with your phone as well. If the issue can't be resolved by politely asking, you'll need to file a complaint with the HOA or your municipality, and may have to provide evidence (notes and pictures, not the actual poo) to back up your complaint.





National Former Prisoner Of War Recognition Day - April 9th

— National Day Calendar —



National Former Prisoner of War Recognition Day on April 9th honors the courageous men and women who have endured brutal treatment at the hands of their captors. As a result, they've also suffered separation from family and displayed incredible endurance and faith during their captivity.

On this day in 1942, the largest number of U.S. Forces were captured by Japanese troops in the Bataan Peninsula in the Philippines. After battling through extreme conditions and prolonged battles, the captured troops were forced to march 65 miles to the prison camp. Without medical attention, food or water thousands died. The mistreatment continued for those who survived the brutal journey. In the compounds, deep in the unfamiliar jungle, the hardships, brutality, and suffering lasted more than two years for those who could survive.

Since the Revolutionary War, over half a million service members have been captured. This number does not reflect those lost or never recovered. However, each POW endures conditions much like the ones described above. These heroes deserve a day of recognition.

How To Observe #FormerPOWRecognitionDay

- Government officials, veterans, civic and private organizations observe the day with ceremonies and events.

National Former Pow Recognition Day History

In 1984, a movement led by former POWs began seeking a day recognizing former Prisoners of War on April 9th each year. In 1988, Congress approved legislation setting April 9th to commemorate the date the tragic number of captives were taken prisoner on Bataan. President Ronald Reagan proclaimed National Former Prisoners of War Recognition Day on April 1, 1988, through Presidential Proclamation 5788. He set the observance for April 9, 1988. Since then, through legislation and Presidential Proclamations, the observance carries on.

POW FAQ

- A. The National League of POW/MIA Families approved the flag in 1972.
- Q. What does it say at the bottom of the POW/MIA
- **A.** "You are not forgotten" is printed at the bottom of the POW/MIA flag representing the commitment to bring all POW and MIA personnel home.



Statewide Trout Stocking Highlights For April 2023

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game



Approximately 250,000 catchable-sized rainbow trout will be stocked throughout the state this April

Many of Idaho's lakes and ponds are soon going to be bolstered with Idaho Fish and Game stocking roughly 250,000 catchable-sized rainbow trout this April. Wondering if the stocking trucks are going to be backing up to your favorite fishing hole? We asked our Fish and Game hatchery staff to boil down some of the most notable stocking highlights coming to your local fishery this month.

Many of these fisheries highlighted below are easy to access, family-friendly fishing destinations. All you need to get started is a fishing license and some basic tackle. Annual adult fishing licenses cost around \$30, junior licenses (ages 14-17) cost \$16, and youth (under 14) fish for free. Go to Fish and Game's online vendor to buy a license.

Fishing for stocked rainbow trout can be a great way to introduce budding anglers to the sport by using simple, inexpensive setups like worm/marshmallow combinations or commercial baits like PowerBait® or Crave, placed either near the bottom or below a bobber; and as anglers know, there's nothing quite like a trout fighting on the end of your line. The Learn to Fish webpage offers diagrams for basic bait rigs.

Most Idaho waters are open to fishing year-round, but some may have slightly different rules. Be sure to pick up a 2022-2024 Idaho Fishing Seasons and Rules Booklet - available at any Idaho Fish and Game office or most sporting goods stores statewide - or download online to look at season dates, special regulations and bag limits.

April 2023 Fish Stocking Highlights

Southeast Region

American Falls Reservoir - 18,000 rainbow trout

These fish were not stocked in March due to lingering ice conditions on the reservoir.

Bannock Reservoir - 1,000 rainbow trout

Located within the Portneuf Wellness Complex Park near the County Fairgrounds in Pocatello, this community park offers trout fishing with many recreational amenities nearby. Multiple docks provide fishing access around this 5-acre pond.

Chesterfield Reservoir - 19,200 rainbow trout

Known for BIG fish, this reservoir in Caribou County is a popular spot to plan a great fishing trip!

Crowthers Reservoir - 2,200 rainbow trout

Tucked away on the northern edge of Malad City, this reservoir provides a nice local fishing spot.

Devil Creek Reservoir - 5,150 rainbow trout

This reservoir provides some of the best trout fishing in this region and is conveniently located right off I-15. Most anglers fish from boats or on the bank around the dam. These fish will be stocked in late April if the ice is off.

Edson Fichter Pond - 950 rainbow trout

This community pond is located along the Portneuf River at Edson Fichter Nature Area. It features several docks and a trail for access around the pond. Just minutes from downtown Pocatello, this site offers local anglers a convenient escape close to

Glendale Reservoir - 3,660 rainbow trout

This 200-plus acre reservoir provides good facilities and opportunities for anglers to catch a variety of warm water species and trout. Access is best using a small boat, but docks and limited shore access are available. Per Consolidated Irrigation Company access rules, all watercraft must be inspected by onsite irrigation company staff and users are subject to an inspection fee (Franklin County residents: \$10; nonresidents of Franklin County: \$20). No ballast compartment boats are allowed.

Hawkins Reservoir - 1,680 rainbow trout

Located near Downey, this reservoir provides good fishing opportunities for Yellowstone cutthroat trout, rainbow trout and cutbows.

Jensens Grove Pond - 4,500 rainbow trout

This 55-acre pond is located within Jensens Grove City Park along the greenbelt in the heart of Blackfoot.

Johnson Reservoir – 2,500 rainbow trout

This 50-acre irrigation reservoir located near Preston is surrounded by large cottonwood trees. It offers a boat ramp, dock and a variety of warm water game fish. Per Consolidated Irrigation Company access rules, all watercraft must be inspected by ISDA the day of your launch. Proof of inspection (ISDA written certification) should be displayed in dash of vehicle.

Lamont Reservoir - 2,760 rainbow trout

Located about 3 miles from Preston, this reservoir offers a nice boat ramp and good opportunity to catch trout, bass and panfish. Per Consolidated Irrigation Company access rules, all watercraft must be inspected by ISDA the day of your launch. Proof of inspection (ISDA written certification) should be displayed in dash of vehicle.

Upper Snake Region

Becker Pond (Ryder Park Pond) - 2,000 rainbow trout

This pond in Idaho Falls is located off Sunnyside Road. Catch rates are awesome, and it's a great place for new anglers or kids to try their hand at fishing.

Rexburg City Ponds - 1,200 rainbow trout

These ponds are located within Rexburg's 15-acre Nature Park and offer an enjoyable fishing atmosphere. The park has walking paths, a skate park and picnic areas in a tranquil environment away

Snake River - 2,400 rainbow trout

These fish will be stocked at John's Hole and South Tourist Park.

Salmon Region

Hayden Creek Pond – 1,100 rainbow trout

This is a family-friendly fishing area in the high desert along Hayden Creek. Anglers will find ample bank fishing opportunities and a dock for anglers with limited mobility.

Hyde Creek Pond - 200 rainbow trout

This small irrigation pond is surrounded by sagebrush. The open site and level terrain provide ideal bank fishing for beginning anglers.

Kids Creek Pond - 550 rainbow trout

Near downtown Salmon, this small fishing pond is regularly stocked with rainbow trout so catch rates should be good!





Meet Your New Favorite **Summer Condiment**

Let's talk chimichurri. Its garlicky and tangy with a spicy little kick, filled with lovely fresh herbs. Light and summery, grassy, verdant and ridiculously flavorful.

An essential element of Argentinean cuisine, a bowl of chimichurri can be found on every dinner table, and rightfully so. Once you make it, you'll put it on everything — no exaggeration!

Chimichurri verde is an uncooked condiment made from parsley and cilantro, garlic, olive oil, red wine vinegar and red pepper flakes. A variation called chimichurri rojo adds red bell pepper and tomato.

While mainly thought of as a condiment for grilled beef, it's beautiful on pork, chicken, shrimp and fish, too. But wait, there's more! It's amazing on tofu, eggs and lentils. Slather it on grilled or raw veggies or use it as salad dressing. Chimichurri can be used as a marinade or basted onto meat as it cooks, or onto cooked meat as it rests. Add it to sour cream or Greek yogurt to make a dip, or mayonnaise as an herbaceous sandwich spread. My family schmears it on bread and eats it with a spoon. Because it goes on everything!

This is a perfect recipe when you have too many herbs in the garden or fridge and want to use them up and make them last longer than they would otherwise. Every time I make it, it comes out a bit different because I use whatever I have on hand. Parsley is essential to this recipe but, sometimes I have more cilantro than parsley, or I might add other herbs. Sometimes I have shallots instead of green or purple onions. I've used lemon juice instead red wine vinegar. It's all delicious.

If you're a purist, you'll want to sharpen your knife and bust out the mortar and pestle. I have nothing but respect for that. Personally, I let my food processor do the work for me, just don't overprocess this sauce. It's supposed to be a little chunky.

CHIMICHURRI VERDE

The measurements are flexible. Use this as a place to begin, adjusting the recipe until it speaks or sings to your taste buds.

Total Time: 15 minutes Servings: 1 1/2 cups total

2 cups flat-leaf parsley (or 1 cup each parsley and cilantro) 3 to 5 garlic cloves, peeled and

coarsely chopped 1/4 cup chopped onion (I used a combo of purple and green onions) 1/4 cup extra-virgin olive oil 3 tablespoons red wine vinegar 1/2 teaspoon dried oregano 1/2 teaspoon kosher salt 1/4 teaspoon red pepper

Start by preparing the herbs. Measure 2 packed cups of the washed leaves and tender stems of parsley and/or cilantro. I love that you can use stems in this recipe. They're so flavorful and they're often discarded.

flakes

In your food processor, process the garlic and onion until chopped. Add the herbs and process until finely chopped. Add the oil, vinegar, oregano, salt

and pepper flakes and process until combined. Let sit at least 10 minutes for flavors to meld. If making ahead of time, cover tightly (imagine that raw garlic and onion invading your fridge!) and chill until ready to use. Leftover sauce can be kept refrigerated for a week.

Here's my favorite appetizer using chimichurri; roast beef crostini. Heat oven to 400 F. Slice a French bread loaf into thin slices, brush with olive oil and toast in oven. Top with slices of deli roast beef drizzled with chimichurri.

Remember: Real friends tell you when you have parsley in your teeth. I am that kind of friend. Go check your teeth.

Les Lalanne Sculptures

In 1966, Claude and Francois-Xavier Lalanne became known as the co-creating duo "Les Lalanne" (The Lalannes). The husband-and-wife team made surrealist dreamlike sculpture, bridging the real and the unreal to create unique hybrid sculpture.

Francois-Xavier is best known as a creator of sculptural animals that were not only pieces of art but also were furniture. Claude's inspiration is drawn from vegetation and body parts, often combining the two to produce original surrealist forms.

Claude created cast body parts in the 1970s including the "Doigt" sculptures. "Doigt," which means "finger" in French, are realistic copper caps that can be slipped on the tips of fingers. They are each about 1 inch high. Some of the Doigt sculptures included parts of plants, flowers or insects to construct a new dreamlike being. Les Lalanne sculptures are well known and widely collected.

A compartment with a sliding lid holds extra letters and numbers, and an open section above it holds 16 word or number stencil cards. Fisher-Price was founded by Herman Fisher, Irving Price and Helen Schelle in East Aurora, New York, in 1930. The company was bought by Quaker Oats in 1969. It was spun off in 1991 and operated as an independent company until 1993, when it was bought by Mattel. Fisher-Price made the No. 176 School Days desk beginning in 1972. It came with chalk and an eraser. Sets that are missing some of the letters or cards sell today for Kovel has the resources you're looking for.



Springtime Perfection: Easy and Colorful Meringue Cookies With a Secret Twist!

Could these cookies be any more perfect for springtime? I think not. They're sweet, pastel and light as a feather. The technique of making meringue has been used in European baking since the 17th century and is a staple ingredient in classic desserts like pavlova and lemon meringue

While they look impressive, they're astonishingly easy to make. And if I can make these, you can make these. Let everyone think you moonlight as a pastry chef in a French patisserie. It'll be our secret.

Speaking of secret, there's an unexpected ingredient in these meringue-based cookies. We use gelatin dessert powder (such as Jell-O brand). Besides giving these cookies their beautiful colors and fun fruity flavors, the gelatin makes the meringue exceptionally stable and very easy to work with. The stable texture makes using a piping bag with a tip to create beautiful

flower shapes easy and fun.

I imagine my dear readers rolling their eyes thinking, "She's lost her mind. Not only is she expecting us to make meringue, but she wants us to use a piping bag." Believe me, I used

to be scared of both things, too. But as I said, if I can do this, anybody can.

If you can use a mixer, you can make meringue. You simply whip the egg whites, adding sugar and gelatin powder. If you choose not to pipe them, just plop by the spoonful and bake. Using a piping bag is great fun. I have no piping skills whatsoever! The internet is filled with easy instructional videos. You can invest in some reusable bags and a few tips for under \$5. Any mistakes you make you can scoop back into the bag and try again. Or just eat them. I won't tell.

PASTEL MERINGUE COOKIES

Yield: approximately 36 cookies Total Time: 2 1/2 hours 4 egg whites 1/4 teaspoon cream of tartar 1/2 cup sugar

1 (3 ounce) box gelatin, any flavor

These show-stopper cookies are perfect for Easter.

Preheat oven to 225 F. Carefully separate egg yolks from the whites, taking care that absolutely no yolks get in the whites. Reserve yolks for another purpose.

In a completely clean and dry mixing bowl, beat egg whites and cream of tartar on high speed. When whites

reach soft peak stage, gradually add the sugar one tablespoon at a time. Continue to beat until stiff peaks form. Turn mixer to low and gradually add gelatin powder until incorporated.

On a parchment lined baking sheet, drop mixture by tablespoonfuls or use your piping bag fitted with a decorative tip to pipe meringue mixture into shapes as desired. Bake for 1 hour, then turn off heat. Without opening the oven door, leave them in the oven for another hour to further dry.

Once dried, these cookies can be stored in an airtight container at room temperature for up to a week, or in the freezer for up to a month.

I made these cookies using five flavors of gelatin. Pineapple was the family favorite, but each flavor was enjoyable.

Unfortunately, adding the gelatin means they're not Kosher for

Passover. Of course, you can omit the gelatin, double the sugar, add a teaspoon of vanilla and a few drops of food coloring. Et Voila!

Perfect for Easter, bridal or baby showers, these cookies are a show-stopper. You can add sprinkles, top with colored sugar or dip the bottoms in melted chocolate. You can combine different colored batters in the piping bag for multicolor swirl effects. At a cost of under \$2 a batch, these spectacular cookies are certainly frugal and fabulous!

F&G Commission Set Big Game Seasons For 2023-24

- Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game -



New seasons and rules brochure will be available in mid April

Idaho Fish and Game Commission set 2023-24 Big Game seasons on March 17, and new seasons and rules brochures will be available on Fish and Game's website in mid April and printed brochures will be available before big game controlled hunt application period opens on May 1.

"We appreciate the public's participation in the season-setting process," Assistant Wildlife Bureau Chief Tricia Hebdon said. "Our sportsmen and women are integral to this process, and their comments helped the Department and the Commission fine-tune Idaho's 2023-24 hunting seasons. While we were unable to make all the requested changes, the public comments had a positive impact on the season-setting process."

Hunters will see a variety of changes from proposals presented to the public in February. Proposals were modified or withdrawn for a variety of reasons, including public comments and wildlife managers reacting severe winter conditions in Eastern Idaho and removing antlerless hunting proposals in anticipation of winter losses and to help herds rebound more quickly.

Fish and Game staff also removed landowner permission hunts from the seasons and rules brochure because there was often confusion about those hunts and who could participate.

"Landowner Permission Hunts are designed to address chronic depredation problems we have on some private lands," said Toby Boudreau, Fish and Game's Deer and Elk Coordinator.

"The private lands in these hunts often do not provide public hunting opportunity, rather, these hunts are a tool we use to resolve a depredation problem, so we thought it was best to put these hunts in supplemental brochure that will be available online, and at our regional offices."

Wildlife managers adjust proposals due to public comment and severe winter weather

The big game season setting process started last fall with Fish and Game staff evaluations of big game population status and management objectives and development of preliminary proposals for season changes. During winter, Fish and Game regions hosted 28 open houses and meetings throughout the state that gathered 766 hunters to review and discuss proposed season changes. Fish and Game staff also received more than 11,000 submissions during the public comment period.

After review of public comments, 21 proposals were dropped or modified, including five for deer, 14 for elk and one each for pronghorn and black bear. Also, four proposals were dropped based on new data, and winter severity caused three proposals to be dropped, one modified and two added.

Because the season setting cycle starts well before winter big game surveys and fawn survival monitoring takes place, late changes to proposals are common to reflect new information about weather conditions and herd health.

Here are some of the changes hunters will see in the 2023-24 Big Game Seasons and Rules brochure.

Changes to deer hunts

Deer hunters will see a variety of changes, includ-

ing already mentioned reductions in antlerless hunting due to winter severity.

There will also be more hunting opportunity in Unit 14 in response to chronic wasting disease.

Fish and Game staff and other agency partners have been busy this winter reducing deer herds in the vicinity of Slate Creek where CWD – a fatal, incurable and contagious neurological disease that affects deer, elk and moose - was first detected in the fall 2021.

Fish and Game's goal is to continue to use hunters during fall hunts to help slow and reduce the spread of the disease into adjacent areas, as well as get samples for more CWD testing to continue monitoring animals in the area.

White-tailed deer hunters will get more hunting opportunity with whitetail seasons expanded into November in units 19A, 23 and 24. Whitetail hunting seasons will also be extended in a portion of the Salmon Region.

Changes to elk hunts

Hunters in the popular Boise River Zone (Unit 39) will get an additional five days for the any-weapon "B-tag" season, which will also overlap with a portion of the October deer season.

Hunters will see a reduction in general-season antlerless elk hunting in the Weiser River Zone.

There will be a large reduction in tags from 2,500 to 500 in the Pioneer Elk Zone because herd size was previously over objectives and causing depredation problems. Those problems have largely been resolved, and herds are back within population objectives, prompting the tag reduction.

Hunters will also a see a shift in tag numbers in the Big Desert Elk Zone with one unit having fewer tags and the other unit having more tags in an effort to shift hunting pressure and address depredation

Additional antlerless elk tags may be issued for Landowner Permission Hunts to address chronic crop depredations. These hunts are often unpopular with the general hunting public, which was reflected in the public comments. However, these hunts are intended to eliminate or reduce crop damage.

Changes to pronghorn hunts

Overall number of pronghorn hunting opportunities will be similar to last year. A new youth hunt was added in the Southwest Region, and tags in Unit 63 were cut from 25 to 10 in response to winter

Changes to black bear hunts

A proposed change to general-hunt area boundaries in the Weiser area was dropped due to low support from hunters.

Electronic calls for black bear hunting will be allowed in the Salmon Region in Units 21 and 28.

Changes to mountain lion hunts

A second mountain lion tag will be allowed in Units 41 and 42, and electronic calls will be allowed in Units 21 and 28.

Changes to wolf trapping seasons

Foothold trapping in many units will open on Sept. 10 in an effort to standardize trapping seasons in most of the state.

Wolf trapping restrictions will remain unchanged in the Blaine County area, and also in areas where there are grizzly bears.

Wiener Dogs

It's a Wiener dog from a Wiener workshop! Vienna, Austria, or "Wien" in German, was a major European cultural center. The Weiner Werkstatte may be the most famous Viennese workshop of the 20th century, but it was not the only one.

This dachshund-shaped letter opener sold for \$813 at a Rago auction. It was made by Werkstatte Hagenauer, which was founded in Vienna by goldsmith Charles Hagenauer in 1898. Like many studios, it was a family business. Hagenauer's sons became influential art deco designers. The workshop closed in the 1980s. Now there is a museum and shop on its former premises.

Despite their name, Wiener dogs did not originate in Vienna, but in Germany. Officially called dachshunds, the breed has plenty of nicknames based on its long, thin, sausage-like shape.

I have a necklace made of clear faceted beads that I was told were crystal. Does this mean they are cut glass or rock crystal?

A "Crystal" can be used for both rock crystal and cut glass. Some makers and collectors use the term for any colorless clear glass. To add to the confusion, both rock crystal and glass beads are found in antique and vintage jewelry.

Rock crystal is a clear, colorless quartz stone fashionable in the late 19th and early 20th centuries. Some 19th-century cut glass was made to resemble rock crystal until about 1860, when colored glass

became popular. "Paste" stones, or glass stones that imitate precious gems, were invented around 1730 and have been used in costume jewelry since then. Glass jewelry was especially popular in the early 1900s. From about 1918 to the 1930s, Czechoslovakia (now the Czech Republic and Slovakia) exported glass beads, faceted glass stones and finished jewelry all over the world. The necklaces are often marked "Czechoslovakia" on the clasp.

To tell whether your beads are stone or glass, hold them in your hand. Glass feels about room temperature and will grow warmer as you hold it. Stone is colder to the touch and takes longer to warm up. Natural rock crystal is more valuable than cut glass.

TIP: Your diamond or precious-stone jewelry – antique or modern – should be reappraised every other year for insurance value.





Invading Spiders Endanger Cat

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: For some reason this winter, my new house has been invaded by spiders. They are building webs in every corner of the house and basement, and every day I'm knocking down another web with my broom. I'm worried about my cat, "Jameson," being bitten by a spider. What do I do if this happens? — Janine S., via email

DEAR JANIE: I'm a huge fan of spiders, because they are one of nature's best pest control services, trapping and disposing of many other tiny critters. They probably have much more to fear from Jameson than the other way around, because housecats see spiders as interesting prey.

Still, a spider invasion is not much fun to deal with. Look for something that is attracting spiders to your home. Do you have wood or leaves piled up against the foundation? Are there cracks in the foundation? Is your basement or attic damp? How clean are your HVAC vents and ductwork? Addressing the source of the problem can cut down quite a bit on the number of spiders invading your house.

As for Jameson being bitten by a spider — if you are concerned, do the same thing you would do when checking for evidence of fleas or ticks. Every evening put Jameson on your lap and run your hand over his coat, backwards. This lifts the hair away so you can see his skin. A spider bite on a cat will look similar to a spider bite on a human. If you do see a spider bite on Jameson, the best thing to do is observe. If he is behaving normally, not distressed or pawing/licking the bite, he's probably fine. If you have any concerns, contact his veterinarian.



Dust off your fishing gear and head to one of these freshly stocked spots this April

If you're looking for a good excuse to enjoy some spring weather while soaking a line, look no further. Over 43,000 catchable-size (10 to 12 inch) rainbow trout will be stocked in the Panhandle Region in April.

Stocking of all waters is tentative and dependent on river/lake/pond conditions (angler safety concerns); dates may change due to weather or staffing constraints.

For maps of these fishing locations and other angling destinations in Idaho please visit the Idaho Fish Planner at idfg.idaho.gov/ifwis/fishingplanner.

Many of the waters highlighted below are easy to access, family-friendly fishing destinations. All you need to get started is a fishing license and some basic tackle. Annual adult fishing licenses cost around \$30, junior licenses (ages 14-17) cost \$16, and youth under 14 fish for free.

Fishing for stocked rainbow trout, particularly in community ponds, is a great way to introduce new anglers to the sport by using simple (and relatively thrifty) set-ups like worm/marshmallow combinations or commercial baits like Power Bait or Crave, either near the bottom or below a bobber. The Learn to Fish webpage (idfg.idaho.gov/fish/basics) offers diagrams for basic bait rigs.

Most Idaho waters are open to fishing year-round, but some may have slightly different rules. Be sure to pick up a 2022-24 Idaho Fishing Seasons and Rules booklet (idfg.idaho.gov/rules/fish), which outlines season dates, special regulations and bag limits at any Idaho Fish and Game offices or most sporting goods stores statewide.







Taking Zinc as Daily Supplement Won't Change Hair Loss

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am having trouble finding a reliable recommendation for the daily supplement zinc. I purchased 50-mg pills, but I think this may be too much. I am 74 and female, and I would like to include zinc in my daily supplements, as my hair has begun thinning quite a bit straight down the top of my head. – R.M.

ANSWER: Zinc is an important nutrient, and it is certainly true that zinc deficiency may lead to hair loss. However, most people with hair loss do not have a zinc deficiency, and there is no convincing data that giving extra zinc to a person with normal zinc levels will help with hair loss. Hair loss along the midline is consistent with female pattern hair loss, which is very common among women in their 70s and usually has nothing to do with zinc.

Very high amounts of zinc supplementation can be dangerous (and impair your body's ability to absorb other trace metals such as copper), but 50 mg is a safe amount. Still, the most effective therapies for female pattern hair loss include minoxidil (usually topical, but low-dose oral is increasingly used), spironolactone and finasteride. A dermatologist is the expert on hair loss and can give you a better diagnosis by exam than I can by your description.

DEAR DR. ROACH: My youngest son has to have both of his hips replaced. He is only 37, but is in a very strenuous job of being a boilermaker in an oil refinery. This is the hardest job in a heavy industry. His doctors are telling me that his hips deteriorated due to alcohol consumption – is this even possible? Even if he can get through this ordeal, he is still locked into this physical type of work.

The doctors say he will need another hip replacement in 10 to 15 years if he stays in this line of work. Do you agree with these statements? -RM

ANSWER: Let's take them one by one.

The most common cause of hip disease requiring hip replacement is osteoarthritis of the hips, but it is quite unusual to see someone of your son's age require a hip replacement. Alcohol is not a recognized risk factor for osteoarthritis of the hips, but it is a known underlying cause of a much less-common condition: osteonecrosis of the hips, also called avascular necrosis.

The more a person drinks, the more likely they are to get this rare condition, even though most heavy drinkers will never get this condition. Not every person with osteonecrosis of the hip will require a hip replacement. It is frequent to have both sides of the hip affected with disease.


Untreated congenital hip dysplasia may also lead to severe hip damage requiring a total hip replacement, and it is also one cause I see in a person of your son's age.

Prognosis after a modern hip replacement is very good. More than 90% of people are doing well, painfree and without complications 15 years after surgery takes place. Of course, some kinds of activities such as heavy lifting and high-impact movements could make the surgical prosthetics wear out faster, but regular activities such as walking, stair climbing and most sports that are not high-intensity or high-impact can be done without damage to the prosthetic.

Although further alcohol use will not affect the prosthetic hips or other bones, many other body systems are very much affected by alcohol. So, if he has been a heavy drinker for some time, it is now time to stop. His doctors can help him find many available resources.



Spring Turkey Hunting Outlook Looking Good For 2023, Similar To 2022

- Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game -



Season opens April 8 for youth, April 15 for general

Despite a heavy winter that's blanketed much of the state, Fish and Game biologists are optimistic about expectations for this year's spring turkey

Youth turkey season opens April 8, and the general turkey season and many controlled hunts open April 15. Hunters can see which units have general hunts in Fish and Game's turkey hunting rules, in addition to details about the seasons.

Hunters will find most general hunting opportunity in the Panhandle, Clearwater, Southwest and Southeast regions, while most other areas are limited to controlled hunts. In each of the regions with general hunting opportunity, turkey populations are faring well, and the hunting outlook is as good as or better than recent years.

"Idaho continues to provide some of the highest turkey hunting success rates in the country," said Jeff Knetter, Fish and Game Upland Game & Migratory Game Bird Coordinator. "While above average winter conditions will have likely impacted turkey numbers regionally, the general outlook for turkey hunting this spring is positive. Abundant turkeys and a wide variety of public and private land access make for excellent wild turkey hunting opportunities in Idaho."

Fish and Game wildlife managers from each of the state's seven regions have been monitoring regional turkey populations throughout winter and share some insights into how each region's turkey populations are looking so far this year.

Panhandle Region

Despite low-elevation snowfall that occurred earlier and persisted throughout the winter, we expect overwinter survival to be good. Panhandle turkey populations are often associated with lower elevations including agricultural areas where food resources tend to be available. Hunters should see plenty of turkeys again this year.

While all of the Panhandle Region is open to general season turkey hunting opportunity, hunters will find the highest concentrations of turkevs in the lower elevation Units 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5. Hunters may want to look towards the lower Priest River and lower Coeur d'Alene River drainages, as well as the lower elevations adjacent to the Kootenai River for higher densities of turkeys.

As a reminder, there is now an archery turkey hunting opportunity within the Farragut State Park/ WMA complex. This archery-only season, which occurs April 15-30, is only open to the use of archery equipment and all other turkey hunting rules must be followed. There are certain areas within the state park/WMA that are closed to hunting, and archery hunters should stop by the Farragut State Park visitor center during their normal business hours to learn more about this opportunity and to pick up a map of the hunting area.

As always, please remember to respect the land and the landowner, and to ask permission prior to hunting private lands.

Clearwater Region

Overall, the 2023 spring turkey hunting outlook for the Clearwater Region is looking good after mild winters the past five years. Turkey numbers this hunting season should be comparable to recent years.

Turkeys are present throughout all forested portions of the Clearwater Region with the highest densities found in and adjacent to the Clearwater River drainage up to the confluence of the Lochsa and Selway rivers, the Snake River drainage up to the confluence with the salmon River, the lower Salmon River drainage up to White Bird and the Dworshak Reservoir area.

Good turkey hunting opportunities can be found on Craig Mountain Wildlife Management Area south of Lewiston, state and federal property, private property and corporate timber lands such as Potlatch Timber Corporation and Bennett Lumber Company. For information on corporate timberland, visit Fish and Game's Large Tracts Access Program which provides public access to thousands of acres of private timberland.

Southwest Region - Nampa

The turkey outlook in the Nampa subregion of the Southwest Region is good. Winter conditions have been average in the Treasure Valley, and we anticipate a decent overwinter survival in Units 33, 38 and 39.

The region has similar hunting opportunities in 2023 as it did in 2022. Unit 38 has general youth opportunity and two controlled hunt opportunities with 100 tags each. The primary limitation in Unit 38 continues to be access to private property where most turkeys reside. We ask hunters to be respectful of landowners and to always ask permission before hunting on private property.

Unit 39 harvest and success rates were stable in 2022. Turkeys follow the spring green up to higher elevations as weather conditions warm, which should make turkeys available on public lands by the opener.

Unit 33 hunter numbers decreased in 2022, but saw a five-year high in harvest and success rate. Early season turkey opportunity is typically limited to private lands along the Middle Fork of the Payette. As the weather improves birds will move up onto public land.


Southwest Region - McCall

Overwinter survival is expected to be average or better, which should make for good turkey hunting this spring. A change in feed site locations as well as some unpredictable weather patterns this spring appear to have shifted turkey distribution along Highway 71. Turkey hunting opportunity in the McCall subregion remains unchanged with general spring turkey hunts in Units 22, 23, 31, most of 32

Snowpack is above average this year and melting slower, which means birds will still be concentrated at lower elevations for the opener and access into higher elevation habitat will likely be delayed this vear.

Motorized travel is restricted on Andrus WMA until May 1, but walk-in hunting is welcome. In addition, there is turkey hunting available on Access Yes! properties near Cambridge, Indian Valley and New Meadows, and several landowners allow access on a case-by-case basis.




