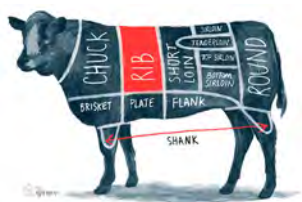

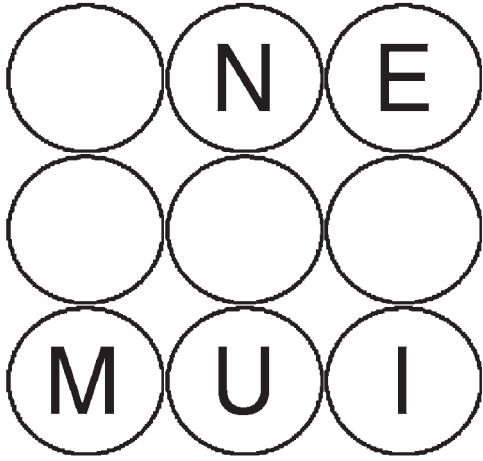

Economical Meal Prep Made Easy With Grain Bowls

People often ask me about suggestions for inexpensive meal prep ideas. I have two words: grain bowls.

But what are grain bowls, exactly?

Grain bowls are a complete meal composed of a grain base, greens, protein, veggies and interesting toppings all arranged in a way that's visually appealing.

Greens: Start with a giant handful of greens. Spinach, kale, arugula and mixed spring greens are favorites, but any leafy green works.

Grains: Add 1/2 to 1 cup cooked whole grains to your salad foundation. Any whole grain you like, such as brown rice, quinoa, wheat berries, barley or farro. You can cook up a batch of different grains each week for effortless variety.

Dressing: Dress the grains and greens before you add the other goodies, so the dressing is evenly distributed throughout the whole bowl. A squeeze of lemon or simple vinaigrette dressing is perfect, or use your favorite bottled salad dressing.

Alternatively, a dollop of salsa, hummus or plain Greek yogurt adds variety.

Beans or Legumes: Add in 1/2 cup cooked beans or legumes. Packed with protein and fiber, dry beans are most affordable, but canned beans are quick and easy. Try chickpeas, great northern beans, black beans or lentils.

Proteins: While beans and grains offer complete protein, boost your bowl by adding hardboiled eggs, sliced deli meats, tuna, chicken, steak, anything you desire. What a perfect use for leftovers!

Veggies and Fruits: Top your bowl with the crunch and color of chopped veggies and fruits. For veggies, think of tomatoes, sweet peppers, cucumbers, mushrooms, carrots, you name it! Don't forget roasted and cooked veggies, too — like sweet potatoes, caramelized Brussels sprouts, roast butternut squash. Many bowls benefit from a juicy burst of fruity sweetness, especially breakfast bowls. Enjoy chopped apple, pear, citrus, berries, grapes.

Healthy Fats: For flavor, texture and staying power, add healthy fats to your bowls. Ingredients like nuts, seeds, any kind of cheese and, of course, avocado belong everywhere!

My secret weapon for cheap and easy grain bowls is quinoa. One cup

cooked quinoa provides 8 grams of protein. Unlike some plant proteins, quinoa is a complete protein, meaning that it contains all nine essential amino acids that our bodies can't make on their own.

QUICK QUINOA

Yield: 1 1/2 cups
Time: 27 minutes

1 cup quinoa
1 3/4 cups water or vegetable broth
1/4 teaspoon salt

Rinse the quinoa under cold running water in a fine mesh strainer for 1-2 minutes. This helps remove any bitterness from the quinoa. In a medium saucepan, combine the quinoa and water or broth. Add a pinch of salt, if desired.

Bring the mixture to a boil, reduce the heat to low and cover with a lid. Simmer for 15 minutes. Remove the saucepan from the heat and let the quinoa sit, covered, for 10 more minutes.

Fluff the quinoa with a fork and serve.

The easiest way to cook other grains? Boil them like pasta. (I'm a rebel, I know.) Simmer the grains in a good amount of well-salted water, periodically tasting as they cook until they are the right texture, al dente. Then drain them in a fine-mesh strainer.

Now, go mix and match those greens, grains and goodies! See you next week!

Almond Thins

- 2 cups all-purpose flour
 3/4 cup cold butter or margarine (1 1/2 sticks), cut up
 1/3 cup plus 2 tablespoons sugar
 1 large egg, separated
 1 teaspoon almond extract
 1/8 teaspoon salt
 3/4 cup sliced natural almonds

1. Preheat oven to 375 F. In food processor, with knife blade attached, blend flour, butter and 1/3 cup sugar just until mixture forms coarse crumbs. Add egg yolk, almond extract and 2 tablespoons water, and blend until mixture just begins to form a ball (do not overmix).

2. With hand, press dough onto bottom of 15 1/2-by-10 1/2-inch jelly-roll pan. For easier spreading, place sheet of plastic wrap over dough and smooth dough evenly over bottom of pan. (To help make an even layer, use bottom of 8- or 9-inch square pan to press dough.) Discard plastic wrap.

3. In cup, with fork, beat egg white and salt; brush some over dough. Top dough with almonds; sprinkle with remaining 2 tablespoons sugar.

4. With knife, gently cut dough lengthwise into 6 strips, then cut each strip crosswise into 8 bars.

5. Bake cookies about 20 minutes or until golden. Transfer cookies in pan to wire rack to cool 5 minutes. While cookies are still warm, cut cookies again following cut marks. Cool cookies completely in pan. Makes 4 dozen cookies.

The Opportunity To Fish For Some Of The State's Biggest Bass Is Now

(And You Don't Need To Be A Seasoned Tournament Pro To Have A Successful Outing)

A guide to catching trophy-size bass during spring

During spring, the local weatherman stands before a green screen, strategically circling portions of the state with high and low pressure systems. Predicting spring weather in Idaho can be all over the map. While it might be weeks before most anglers wait for those warm, sunny days to pack coolers and slather on sunscreen, there is a group of die-hards who anxiously await these unpredictable days this May: We're looking at you, hardcore bass anglers.

The reason anglers go after bass during these next few weeks is simple: That's when the big, trophy-size bass are swimming up from the deeper pools to spawn in shallower water. Warmer temperatures mean more active bass. Imagine just how fun waking up at 4 a.m. to go for a jog in January sounds and you get the point.

While both largemouth and smallmouth bass can be targeted most of the year, the first few weeks of spring — as water temperatures begin to rise — mark the most exciting time to target trophy bass. And, no, you don't need to be a bass tournament pro to get in on the hunt, either.

All it takes is a little understanding of a bass's habitat, their spawning cycle, water temperature dynamics and directions to a nearby fishery. Put it all together and you got a recipe for one heck of a week-end fishing for America's most popular game fish.

A pain in the bass

Bass can be tricky. While found across most of the state, the opportunity to track them down during this pivotal season is often easier in theory than in reality. Understanding their habitat and the type of waterbody they inhabit is key to honing in on either small or largemouth bass.

Smallmouths tend to lurk in cooler waters, such as the Snake River and cooler lakes with deeper water and less vegetation. Largemouth, on the other hand, tend to be found in warmer, shallower bodies of water where rocks and vegetation provide ample coverage from overhead sun and predators. Think of that local pond or reservoir with fallen trees, rock crevices, cattails, over-hanging willows, cottonwoods, lily pads, etc.

Generally speaking, if you can see the structure above the water, or just below the surface, then it's more likely largemouth territory. And if it's too deep to tell or too cold to wade and find out, then you might be in smallmouth country.

As water temperatures slowly begin their spring and summer climb, it's worth noting that the window of opportunity to find these big fish is only open for a few weeks, sometimes less depending on the rate at which the temperatures rise and how, let's just say efficient, the bass are at spawning.

"At around 60 degrees, bass are full-on spawning," says Martin Koenig, Fish and Game's Sportfish Program Coordinator. "At that point, they are already thinking about digging their nests and depositing their eggs, which means that bass are very catchable in the mid-50 degree range."



Bodies of water warm up differently based on their size and location. Shallower water warms quicker than deeper water. That kiddie pool in your backyard is going to be a lot warmer (a lot quicker) than water flowing out the base of Arrowrock Dam, for instance. So monitoring the ongoing temperatures of whichever body of water you plan on fishing is key. Keep a thermometer handy inside your tackle box when you go out. In many bass fisheries in the southern part of the state (more on fishing destinations later), that clock is already counting down.

Check the weather

Spring fishing can be hit and miss, but it's usually best when the weather is stable. Bass will come into shallow waters as weather warms, and will stay there if conditions remain good. Spring cold fronts can interrupt this migration, when bass often turn back to deeper water. Anglers will have better luck fishing on bright, sunny days when the fish are more active. Cloudy or rainy days often push bass back down to their wintering levels, making the bite less predictable.



Boat or bank angler?

Normally the only way to target those big, deep-water bass during the year is by boat and some form of technology that monitors water depth. Shore anglers are usually pretty limited to how deep they can target fish since casting line out from dry land only gets you so far.

During much of the year, those larger bass (especially smallmouth) are down deep or hanging on offshore structure, making them tough for shore anglers to reach. However, as the temperatures rise

and into the first week of May, the playing field sort of levels out for anglers of both varieties.

Pre-spawn bass will be ascending from the deeper pockets of a lake or reservoir onto shallow gravelly flats. This is when shore anglers have a better chance to reach them with a jig or bait, and fancy sonar isn't necessary.

Full-on spawn

"It may just be three weeks out of the year, but the bigger smallmouth are going to be the ones ready to spawn," says Martin Koenig. "Those mature 15-19 inchers are seeking out the sandier, gravelly shallows to carve out little divots in the bottom and deposit their eggs in those spots."

Males will usually show up first to prep the nests in hopes of attracting a female. Once the work of digging the nests is done, females will show up (if the males' handiwork is up to snuff) and deposit their eggs.

The females don't stick around much longer after that, though. The males, on the other hand, will hang around to guard the nests and ward off any predators, such as bluegill or perch, which might see the eggs or newly-hatched bass fry as an easy meal. Males also work to keep the eggs oxygenated by fanning them.

"But seeking out the spawning beds is just an indicator," Koenig suggests. "Finding those transition zones in the water level, somewhere between the warm shallows and spots just below, is where you want to be targeting them."

F&G Reminds Folks To Leave Young Animals Alone As We Approach Spring Wildlife Baby Boom

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game —



The best thing you can do for them is to leave them be.

Spring is here, and so is the peak of baby wildlife season. People are bound to see young wildlife when they venture outdoors during the spring and early summer, and there is a pretty good chance that they will see a baby animal that appears to be alone, with mom nowhere in sight.

While a well-intentioned human's first instinct might be to rescue these cute, cuddly and seemingly helpless creatures, Fish and Game officials have a simple suggestion to people who discover baby animals that appear to be abandoned: The best thing you can do for them is to leave them be.

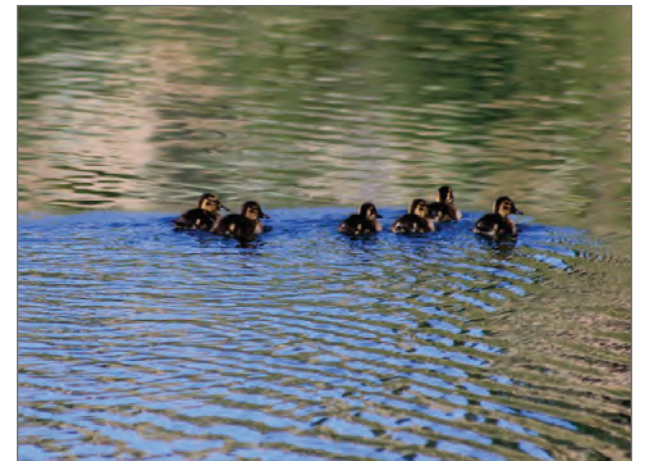


Every spring, Fish and Game receives calls from well intentioned humans who have "rescued" baby animals that they assume have been lost, abandoned or orphaned. While these people typically

mean well, they are often doing more damage than good when they intervene, and typically, mom was not far away to begin with.

Animal parents will periodically leave their young for an extended period of time for a myriad of reasons, whether it's to search for food, to rest, or to divert attention from their vulnerable offspring, especially if they sense danger. When it comes to wildlife babies, wildlife mothers know best.

Mammals such as deer, elk, and pronghorn routinely leave their young in a secure location, moving off to feed and returning later - sometimes several hours later - to quickly feed their young and leave again. The young animals know instinctively to remain still in the places their mother left them.



As baby birds mature, they often leave the nest in their efforts to hone their flying skills. Adult birds continue to feed their offspring until such time that the young birds can survive on their own, even if they fall out of the nest.

If you find a baby bird, duckling, deer fawn or other critter, the best approach is to leave it undisturbed. Then if you wish, contact your nearest Fish and Game office. Fish and Game employees are happy to take calls about apparently orphaned or injured animals, answer questions, and when necessary, retrieve animals.

In addition, do not plan to raise wild animals on your own. Young wild animals require special care and feeding that is beyond what the average household is prepared to manage. Additionally, possession of most species of wildlife taken from the wild is illegal in Idaho.

In the spring when wildlife baby boom is at its peak, you may have the good fortune to observe a nest of birds or a litter of young mammals with no adult in sight. Enjoy the sight, but remember it is best to leave young wildlife alone.

Save Lake City Playhouse!

When the humble little church on Garden Avenue was built in Coeur d'Alene, I doubt very much whether anyone could have anticipated just how important and integral the chapel-turned-theater would become to the North Idaho community.

Established in 1967, a 'summer stock' company, known then as the Carousel Players, began bringing Broadway-caliber talent from across the nation every summer to perform three to four classic and popular stage musicals from June through August. They called that 200-seat theater Home for over 20 years.

Over its 75+ year life, the theater now known as the Lake City Playhouse has showcased hundreds of musicals, plays, staged readings, and camps, and has affected and enriched the artistic lives of literal thousands, some of whom have gone on to grace Broadway stages, Las Vegas shows, and Hollywood film and television.

Theatre knits people together through stories and shared experiences, whether on the stage, behind the scenes, or in the audience. Oftentimes, it gives people who feel like outsiders a place to belong, friends who become like family, and a place to call

their own. Personally speaking, many of my friendships took root and blossomed through theater venues, and almost every one of my favorite theater memories feature the LCP as the setting.

I know I'm not the only one.

The building itself is over 100 years old; the theater community that surrounds the building is over 75 years old. Wouldn't it be a shame to lose such a precious, long-standing legacy? I know my heart would shatter if the LCP was lost, never to re-open, and I'm sure I'd be joined by hundreds of others—actors, technicians, and patrons—who would share in my grief and disappointment.

So here is where you come in!

According to the LCP's GoFundMe account: "In April of 2021, the Playhouse experienced a devastating flood which affected most of the plumbing in the building. To be fixed, all bathrooms had to be completely torn up and rebuilt from the pipes up. Almost immediately after an initial insurance payout, inflation made the cost of building supplies skyrocket and money ran out quickly with the bare minimum done. It is unknown whether or not insurance will cover direct costs related to ongoing renovation that does not include structural updates that need to be made." To put it bluntly, the Lake City Playhouse is in desperate need for every generous heart to pitch in! It will take an estimated \$125,000 to cover renovations directly related to the devastating flood (subflooring, flooring, supplies for raising walls, toilets, sinks, etc). NATIONAL BIKE TO WORK DAY HISTORY

National Bike to Work Day originated in 1955 by the League of American Bicyclists and is endorsed by the American Medical Association. However, the invention of the bike is highly debated. Do we give credit to the first introduction of a similar invention? Or, do we give credit to the modern version?

- 1791: Comte de Sivrac debuts a 2-wheeled scooting "bike" in Paris. The bike had two wheels that could only move forward and handbars.
- 1817: Baron Karl Drais invents the hobby horse, otherwise known as the "Draisienne." The hobby horse had two wheels and a saddle. Interestingly, you had to use your feet to make it move.
- 1880: Inventors Karl Kech and Pierre Lallement were the first to secure a US patent for the modern bike. Their invention included two wheels, a saddle, pedals and was made of wood.

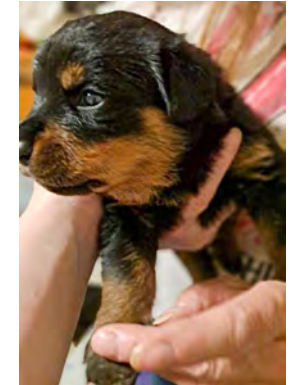

Lay Tile Like a Pro 11 steps to update bathroom flooring

— Family Features —



Updating the flooring can help infuse new life into tired, outdated bathrooms. For an upscale, polished look that doesn't have to break the bank, consider installing tile flooring.

Before you get started, you'll want to make some decisions about the look and feel of your flooring:

Ceramic or stone? Weigh factors such as porosity, how slippery the surface may be when wet and how well it retains heat or cold. Ultimately, your decision hinges on the needs and uses of your family.

Complement or contrast? Define the overall style you want as well as the colors and tones that will help best achieve your vision.

Big or small? Generally, the larger the tile, the fewer grout lines, and too many grout lines in a smaller space can create the illusion of clutter. However, smaller tiles can eliminate the need to make multiple awkward cuts, and small tiles are perfect for creating accent patterns or introducing a splash of color.

When you've got your overall look and materials selected, keep these steps in mind as you begin laying the flooring:

1. Prepare your subfloor. Use a level to check for uneven spots; you need an even surface to prevent cracks in the tile or grout as well as rough spots that could pose tripping hazards. Use patching and leveling material to create a consistent surface. Apply a thin layer of mortar then attach your cement backer board with screws. Cover joints with cement board tape, apply another thin layer of mortar, smooth and allow to dry.
2. To ensure square placement, draw reference lines on the subfloor using a level and carpenter square. Tile should start in the middle of the room and move out toward the walls, so make your initial reference lines as close to the center as possible. Mark additional reference lines as space allows, such as 2-foot-by-2-foot squares.
3. Do a test run with your chosen tile by laying it out on the floor. There are color variations in most tile patterns, so you'll want to verify each tile blends well with the next.
4. Mix tile mortar and use the thin side of a trowel to apply mortar at a 45-degree angle. Use the combed side to spread evenly and return excess mortar to the bucket. Remember to apply mortar in small areas, working as you go, so it doesn't dry before you're ready to lay the tile.
5. When laying tile, use your reference lines as guides. Press and wiggle tile slightly for the best adherence.
6. Use spacers to create even lines between one tile and the next, removing excess mortar with a damp sponge or rag.
7. As you complete a section of tile, use a level and mallet to verify the tiles are sitting evenly.
8. Let mortar dry 24 hours before grouting.
9. Remove spacers then apply grout to joints, removing excess as you go.
10. Allow grout to dry per the manufacturer's instructions then go back over tile with a damp sponge to set grout lines and clean grout residue.
11. Once grout has cured - usually at least a couple weeks - apply sealer to protect it.

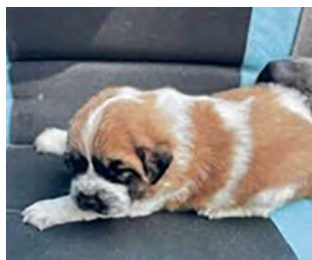

The Opportunity To Fish For Some Of The State's Biggest Bass Is Now

(And You Don't Need To Be A Seasoned Tournament Pro To Have A Successful Outing)

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game —

A Lesson from Oxbow Reservoir

Oxbow Reservoir, the 581-acre stretch of water along the lower Snake River, is a perfect example of how water temperature determines where bass are on their life cycle.

Oxbow's long and shallow water corridor, essentially a bloated section of the Snake River, doesn't provide many opportunities for deep sections of water that a larger lake might have. Water flowing into Oxbow from the base of Brownlee Dam is especially cold, roughly 55 degrees during spring. With colder water coming in, bass might be pre-spawn in the upper end of the reservoir.

Mid-way down, where the water temperatures have warmed to around 60 degrees, bass will have already moved on to the heart of the spawn, hugging those shallows closer to the bank to dig nests and lay eggs.

Near the lower end of the reservoir, the bass may have finished spawning and are already back in the deeper portions of the reservoir.

And the cool thing is: All of these behaviors and stages in the spawn can be witnessed on a single day. Where your fishing spot falls on the temperature scale will determine what part of the bass life cycle is happening there.

As seen in the Oxbow Reservoir example, there are many factors that drive water temperatures to fluctuate. It goes without saying that lakes at higher elevations take longer to warm up. For example, the higher elevation upper Snake River flowing into American Falls Reservoir is going to take a lot longer to reach those optimal 55-65 degree water temperatures than, say, C.J. Strike Reservoir in the southwest corner of the state, despite being on the same river system.



Anglers should be thinking about this when considering where to target big bass. Expect the bite to be earlier where the waters warm soonest. And that brings us to our final point.

Where to fish for bass around the state

There are dozens of fisheries all across the state

that hold decent populations of largemouth bass and smallmouth bass (and in a few cases, both). Depending on the region, consistent weather patterns and a preference on which type of bass you're going for, here is a list of some of the best bass fishing spots around Idaho.

LARGEMOUTH BASS

Shallower, warmer waters. Look for 5-10 feet of water, with flooded habitat, tree stumps, cover and vegetation.

Every day of fishing is a little different and every fish is a little different, but there's common traits that will help you catch bass during spring. They're still a little sluggish, so they aren't typically going to chase a fast-retrieved lure or bait.

That also means you might not get the savage strike for which bass are famous. It might feel as subtle as dragging your lure across a blade of grass, or a gentle, steady pull. Since they're spawning, or getting ready to spawn, they're likely going to be close to the bottom, so that's where you want to fish.

- 1 cup Major Grey's mango chutney

- 2 cloves garlic, crushed with press

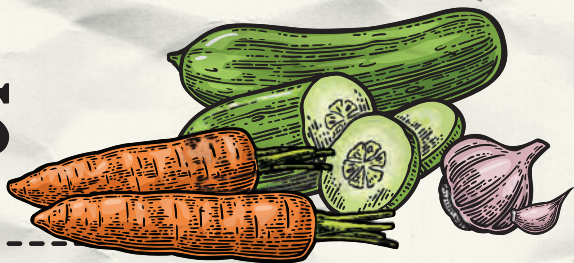

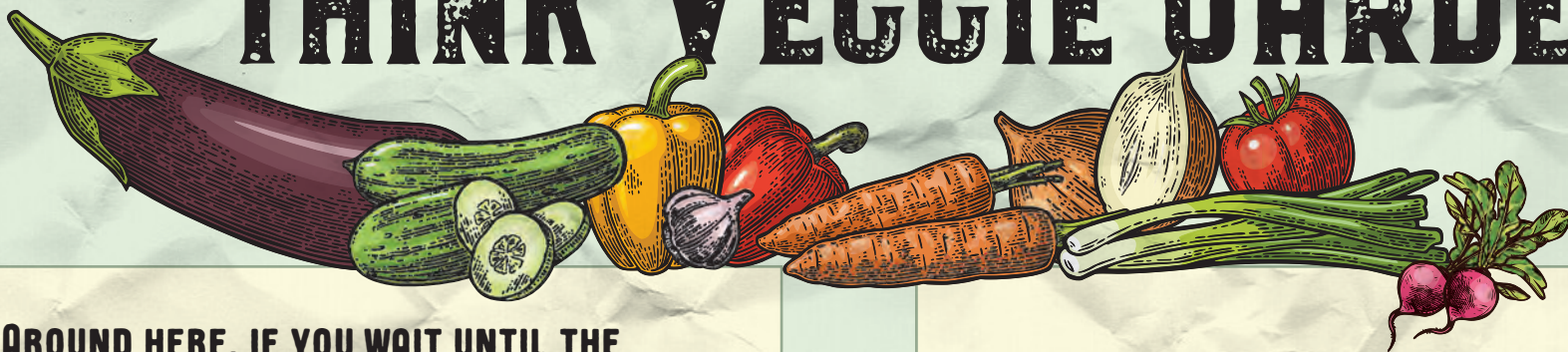

COMMENTS

It takes 2-3 years to reach their full producing potential. Don't harvest at all the first year, and wait for approximately 2 weeks the second year. Production and harvest window will increase over time. A perennial, asparagus will produce for years to come. Well weeded and soil consistently moist. Allow shoots to mature to "fern" stage to ensure perennial crop. The seeds overnight before planting as that can damage the seed. Plants small amounts of water frequently. Try 3-4 days; this will prevent the beans from getting over-mature (and tough) and to help them produce. Seed plenty of support, so pick a variety that will work for your garden.

Prescription Costs \$500 for a Month's Supply

DEAR DR. ROACH: What can you tell me about a prescription of 145 mcg of Linzess, and why a doctor would prescribe a pill over \$500? What are the advantages to taking this? Surely, there must be something less expensive that will provide the same results. – J.P.

ANSWER: Linaclotide (Linzess or Constella) is a medicine used for constipation, either in people with irritable bowel syndrome or in people with constipation for no particular reason. It works by activating a protein to allow chloride and bicarbonate (along with fluid) into the intestine.

Since it is not absorbed into the body, it has few side effects. The major side effect is that it can work too well and cause diarrhea. This is enough of a concern that the medicine is not used in children under the age of 2. There are three different strengths: 72, 145 and 290 mcg.

If you are asking me to defend pharmaceutical pricing, I can't do that. I very seldom use this medicine because there are so many other options for constipation – starting with a different diet without using any medicine at all. But in people with occasional constipation despite having a good diet, I usually start with fiber supplements.

If those don't work, I recommend a surfactant such as docusate (Colace), which allows more water to enter the stool. Yet another option would be nonabsorbable substances like polyethylene glycol (Miralax and others), lactulose, sorbitol and magnesium. All of these are much less expensive.

However, there are still people who don't do well with any of these less-expensive (and also

tried-and-true) alternatives. Linzess has made a real difference in the lives of several of my patients. It is usually prescribed by an expert (a gastroenterologist) at least in the case of my patients.

Finally, Linzess is roughly \$20 a pill or about \$500 for a month's supply in the U.S. without insurance. Some people only need it occasionally and are very willing to pay, even if insurance doesn't cover it.

DEAR DR. ROACH: The other day, when we were changing our bedsheets, my husband asked me if I knew why the sheets and pillowcases on his side of the bed were stained yellow and the ones on my side weren't. My only thought was that he has a very strong body odor. My high school biology classes came back to me, and I remembered that our sense of smell is a lock-and-key mechanism, where odor comes from a tiny particle that locks into the sensors within our olfactory system. So, I thought that the particles might be staining the bedding. Could this be so? – J.M.

ANSWER: Chromhidrosis is the name for colored sweat, and it isn't uncommon. Both men and women can have chromhidrosis. There are several possible causes. One is that the sweat glands themselves can excrete a colored substance, such as lipofuscin, which often causes a yellow discoloration.

I admire your using high school biology, but I don't think you are right in this case. The odor in sweat comes from bacteria that lives in and around the sweat glands. The bacteria themselves rarely cause discoloration, but yellow isn't typical for bacteria.

Occasionally, medicines can cause sweat to turn a different color. The laxative bisacodyl (Dulcolax and others) can cause people to have yellow sweat, and some antiperspirants will cause sweat to have a yellow color.

Since it's both the sheets and pillowcases, I suspect that it's the lipofuscin in this case. Treatment may not be necessary, but capsaicin cream (0.025%) has proven effective, although the mechanism behind how it works is unknown.

Avoid Conflicts With Wildlife As WMAs Open May 15th

— Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks —



Most of Montana's 76 Wildlife Management Areas opened at noon on May 15. The long winter and heavy snowpack have left a limited area for wildlife to forage. With grizzly bear activity increasing, people visiting WMAs should remain vigilant and practice techniques to avoid surprise encounters.

Bears, elk and shed-antler hunters will be sharing the same space. Most animals see, hear and smell humans long before humans detect the presence of animals. Depending on the distance between the animals and humans, the animals decide whether to stay, defend themselves or flee.

People venturing into the outdoors should "Be Bear Aware" by following these precautionary steps:

- Carry and know how to use bear spray.
- Travel in groups whenever possible and plan to be out in the daylight hours.
- Avoid carcass sites and concentrations of ravens and other scavengers.
- Watch for signs of bears such as bear scat, diggings, torn-up logs and turned over rocks, and partly consumed animal carcasses.
- Make noise, especially near streams or in thick forest where hearing and visibility is impaired. This can be the key to avoiding encounters. Most bears will avoid humans when they know humans are present.
- Don't approach a bear.
