From tags sales to general season openers, there's a lot happening in Idaho during May that you should be aware of. Staying in the loop can be the difference between applying for that coveted controlled hunt tag and watching from the sidelines.

Be sure to stay up to date on all Fish and Game happenings. Here are some important dates you should know to help you plan.

MAY 2023

- 5/1 OPEN: Resident big game (deer, elk pronghorn, fall black bear), fall turkey and swan controlled hunt application period
- 5/10 Fish and Game Commission Meeting in Jerome: Public Hearing
- 5/11 Fish and Game Commission Meeting in Jerome: Business Meeting
- 5/18 Returned tag sale at 10 a.m. MDT
- **5/25** CLOSED: Spring general turkey season
- 5/29 Memorial Day (Fish and Game Offices Closed)
- 5/31 CLOSED: First Super Hunt drawing deadline

Note: Hunters, anglers and trappers should always double check the seasons and rules booklets to confirm opening and closing dates, as well as restrictions and rules pertaining to individual species.

Garnish Desserts With Chocolate Roses

When you stroll by the pastry section of your market or neighborhood bakery, do you ever wonder how they make the lovely roses that top the tempting cakes and tortes?

While there may be a variety of ingredients and techniques, this classic recipe invented by pastry chefs uses a simple combination of melted chocolate and light corn syrup. The edible clay can be transformed into just about any shape or decoration, but it's especially fun to include kids and create roses with my easy technique. You'll be all set to garnish a dessert with creativity, when there's something to celebrate with your family.

CHOCOLATE ROSES Makes 10-12 roses

- 10 ounces semisweet chocolate chips (about 1-1/2 cups)
- 1/3 cup light corn syrup

Melt the chocolate chips in a microwave-safe bowl in the microwave for about one and a half to two minutes in 30-second intervals, stirring each time. If you don't have a microwave, use a double boiler.

Add the corn syrup to the melted chocolate. Stir. The lovely smooth mixture will turn into a clay consistency.

Put a sheet of wax paper on a cutting board or kitchen counter and scoop the chocolate mixture onto it. Spread it out evenly with your fingers until it is about a 1/2 inch thick. Cover loosely with wax paper and let it rest for at least two hours. The clay will become pliable.

To make a rose, roll 10 smooth balls of chocolate clay a bit smaller than the size of a marble and line them up an inch apart on wax paper. Cover the little balls with a sheet of wax paper. Press down hard on the paper with your thumb to spread out the clay. Aim for the size of a half-dollar.

To create petals for a rose, remove one clay disk and curl it into a tepee shape, narrow at the top and wide at the bottom. Wrap the next disk around the opening of the tepee, as if you were making it a little door. The third disk goes at the back of the tepee, with the fourth going along the side. Layer as many of these clay disks as you'd like. Bend back the edges of the disks ever so slightly. Don't worry if little slits appear, because they will make the petals look more natural.


Set the finished rose on a cupcake or other dessert.

Note: Use up the clay the same day you make it while it is pliable. Candy melts (available at craft stores) and/or butterscotch chips may be substituted for the chocolate chips.

Chinese Porcelain

The Hundred Treasures theme was popular in Chinese art during the Qing dynasty (1644-1911). Many objects of daily life that impart symbolic meaning were incorporated into artwork. A single vase can be a symbol of female fertility, yet this red Chinese porcelain has several small relief vases on its surface to suggest even more meaning.

Flowers are not only painted to decorate the small raised vases, but are also painted on the red ground to look like they are floral arrangements in the raised vases. Flowers are eternal symbols of beauty, and the brilliant red color of the vase has many associations to China.

The country's flag is red, which is associated not only with power, but with luck, happiness and celebrations. Traditional Chinese brides wear red for luck, and the Lunar New Year is celebrated with red lanterns and many other red decorations. The blue seal mark on the bottom of the base is like those on Qing dynasty porcelain.

I'd like to know the value of a set of two deck chairs (possibly teak) from the SS Oceanic. They have their original blue cushions with "Home Lines" and a logo in gold. What do you think they are worth?

Home Lines was an Italian company that operated cruise ships and ocean liners. The company was in business from 1946 to 1988, when it merged with Holland America Line. SS Oceanic was one of Home Lines' cruise ships from 1965 to 1985, when it was sold to Premier Cruise Line. Most deck chairs don't sell for high prices. Chairs by important makers or those with a connection to an important or historic event do sell for high prices. A deck chair from the Titanic, one of seven known and with a letter of authenticity, sold for almost \$150,000 in 2015. The value of your deck chairs depends on condition and the history of the boat. They sell for \$100 to \$1,000.



National Cartoonists Day May 5

Observed on May 5th each year, National Cartoonists day honors all those creative ink-stained artists, past and present, and the fascinating pieces they have created. Throughout the years, their talents bring humor, entertainment into our lives while provoking thought and debate, too.

American comic strip writer and artist, Richard Outcault (January 14, 1863 – September 25, 1928) is considered the inventor of the modern comic strip. At 15 years of age, he studied for three years at the McMicken University's School of Design in Cincinnati. Outcault created the comic strips The Yellow Kid and Buster Brown.

Outcault was a 2008 Judges' Choice inductee into the Will Eisner Comic Book Hall of Fame.

On Sunday, May 5, 1895, the readers of the New York World discovered an exciting new addition in their morning paper. On the pages, they found Outcault's full-color drawings featuring a bigeared, barefoot little boy with a mischievous grin. The first color installment of the cartoon called Hogan's Alley would later become known as The Yellow Kid and was the first commercially successful cartoon icon.

Application Period For Fall 2023 Swan Controlled Hunt Opens May 1

- Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game -



50 swan tags were added to controlled hunts following a Fish and Game Commission decision in July 2021

Application period is May 1 through June 5 for fall 2023 swan controlled hunt in the Panhandle Region. Successful controlled hunt applicants will be notified by July 10.

Hunters with a valid 2023 Idaho hunting license may apply for controlled hunts at any license vendor, Fish and Game office, or with a credit card online at gooutdoorsidaho.com or by calling 1-800-554-8685. There is an additional fee for online and phone orders.

A total of 50 swan tags were added to the controlled hunt application process following a Fish and Game Commission decision in July 2021, and opportunities are limited to Benewah, Bonner, Boundary, and Kootenai counties.

The daily and season bag limit is one swan; any hunter killing a swan must, within three days of the date of kill, present the swan carcass (for measurement and identification) to a conservation officer, regional office or check station, and complete the relevant harvest report.

- Migratory Bird (HIP) Permit REQUIRED
- Federal Migratory Bird (Duck) Stamp
 REQUIRED
- Shotgun capable of carrying no more than three shells **REQUIRED**
- Nontoxic Shot **REQUIRED**
- Shot Size: No person shall take swans while in possession of shot larger than two tenths (0.2 inches) in diameter (size T)

"Ten Acres and a Dream" 1-day Workshop for Rural Landowners

University of Idaho —

Idaho is well known for extensive public lands; so much that people sometimes lose sight of how much private land we have in selected regions of the state. For example, Boundary, Bonner, Kootenai, and Benewah counties collectively have over 1.5 million acres of private lands- 47.5% of all lands in those counties.

Some of these private parcels are in large blocks, but most of them are smaller parcels owned by an ever-growing number of private landowners. Uses of these lands vary from forest, to pasture, to crops. People who move to these sites have many ideas as to what they want from the land but may be less aware of how to achieve those goals or the tasks associated with living on and maintaining rural property.

University of Idaho Extension is offering a 1-day program designed to help owners of small rural acreages manage their land meet their goals. The program, titled "10 Acres and a Dream", was the idea of Idaho Master Forest Stewards, most of whom are private landowners themselves, and have interacted with a variety of new rural landowners who have struggled with making their dream of owning and tending rural property a re-

"Ten Acres and a Dream" will be held in Sandpoint, Idaho on Saturday, May 13th. 



Layered Fresh Fiesta Dip for Cinco de Mayo

I'm always looking for a reason to celebrate, especially when food is part of the festivities. May has just arrived, and with it, so have many opportunities for family, food and fun, starting with May Day. Preschoolers delight in filling mini paper baskets with cookies, candies and a flower to secretly hang on neighbors' front doorknobs. Mother's Day on May 14 is a good excuse to serve breakfast in bed to a deserving mom. Start this colorful creation by mixing up your own taco seasoning mix. It's worth the effort, not only because you control the salt content, which is high in most commercial packets, but also you'll save monev. especially when you purchase the spices in bulk. Plus, your kids will gain skills in measuring and learning the names of spices from around the world.

TASTY TACO SEASONING MIX Makes 1/4 cup (about 4 tablespoons)

- 1 tablespoon salt-free chili powder
- 2 teaspoons ground cumin
- 1 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1 teaspoon onion powder
- 1 teaspoon paprika
- 1 teaspoon dried oregano

1/4 teaspoon red-pepper flakes (optional)

- 1 teaspoon sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon ground black pepper

Mix all ingredients in a bowl and store in a jar with a tight lid.

LAYERED, FRESH FIESTA PARTY DIP

- 1 8-ounce package cream cheese, room temperature
- 1 8-ounce container sour cream
- 2 tablespoons "Tasty Taco Seasoning Mix" (see above)
- 1 cup shredded cheddar cheese
- 1 cup chopped fresh tomatoes
- 1/4 cup sliced green onions
- 1 ripe avocado, chopped
- 2 cups crisp lettuce, loosely chopped
- 1/4 cup sliced black olives (optional)
- Tortilla chips for dipping

Combine the cream cheese, sour cream and seasoning mix in a large mixing bowl. Spread evenly over a large dinner plate.

Sprinkle a 3/4 cup of the cheese evenly on top. Continue with the tomatoes, onions, avocado, lettuce and remaining cheese.

Serve with a basketful of tortilla chips.







Stuffed New Potatoes: A Spanish Tapas Snack

Do your kids snack all day? Some parents call it "grazing." And when kids grab a bite here or there, it's fine, as long as their quick forays into the kitchen are healthy ones.

Spanish tapas are hearty snacking heaven. They're a specialty of Spain, enjoyed between meals, and sometimes people combine many different tapas to make a full meal. Typically, tapas may include a simple bowl of cold marinated olives, mushrooms, artichoke hearts or popular, kid-friendly stuffed potatoes.

These handheld potatoes are a unique and fun after-school snack. Just pop them in the microwave, start reciting the rhyme "one potato, two," and they'll be baked in minutes.

You also might want to put them on your dinnertime menu once in a while. For a satisfying side, you can vary the chopped fixings with the meal and individual tastes.

SPANISH TAPAS STUFFED NEW POTATOES

Makes 12 handheld servings

6 red new potatoes, each about 2 inches across

1/2 cup sour cream

R.F.D.

Chopped toppings such as hard-boiled eggs, bacon, tomatoes, radishes, cucumber, salad onions, chives and dill

Take a few small bowls from the kitchen cabinet and fill them with the individual toppings. The results are always colorful and appetizing. Scrub and clean the potatoes with a little vegetable brush. It takes only a minute or two. Cut each potato in half, and then trim a flat piece off each bottom so that the potato halves sit upright.

Place them upright on a microwave-safe plate and cover with microwave-safe wax paper, parchment paper or a microwave-safe lid. Wrap or cover to allow steam to escape. Cook on high for about four minutes, or until tender.

Arrange the warm halves on a flat platter. Use a melon-ball scoop or a teaspoon to dig out a little pocket from the center of each half. (Save and refrigerate the scooped-out portion for a scrumptious Spanish omelet the next morning – just add a little onion and salsa!)

Now, it's "fill 'er up" time for your hungry grazers. Spoon a dollop of sour cream in each potato's cavity. Go to the bowls of delectable toppings and spoon or sprinkle choices over the top. Grab a napkin or small plate, and it's ready to enjoy!

Cook's note: To vary the look and flavor, I grab a variety bag at my local grocery store containing small red new potatoes, Yukon Gold and a purple variety. Look for fresh young potatoes at your farmer's markets this summer, too.

Pet Sitting Can Be More Than a Side Job

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: I was recently laid off from my job as a programmer, and have been thinking about taking a new career direction. I'm tired of being stuck in an office all day. And I love being around pets. But is it really possible to make a good living working as a dog walker or a pet sitter? - Barry J., Cambridge, Massachusetts

DEAR BARRY: I know more than a few people who are full-time pet sitters and dog walkers. Most have their own business, while a few are employees of pet care companies. As you can imagine, the pay rates vary widely from person to person. ZipRecruiter reports that the average hourly wage, nationally, for pet sitters is about \$19.23.

I think it's great that you're considering a career change. But I recommend testing out the world of pet sitting first. Consider working part time for a petsitting company. Even better, if you know someone who does dog walking, ask to accompany them for one day to see what their job entails. Find out what the pitfalls of this business may be, and what makes it fun to do. Finally, offer to pet sit for a friend who's going out of town for a day or two to get direct experience and really see if it's something that you'd like to do full time.

Next, visit the Small Business Administration's website (www.sba.gov) and check out its Learning Center section, which has several micro-courses that teach how to start up and run a small business. Being able to combine core business skills with a love for and dedication to pets is a great platform to start on. Best of luck.



Let's Toast to Toast

"I'd like to make a toast!" said my friend at a happy family celebration. Without missing a beat, her 3-year-old nephew burst out, "Don't we need to get the toaster first?"

With all the toasting we do during celebrations and events throughout the year, I thought I'd get literal and stretch the meaning, just like that spontaneous child, and provide two recipes using toast that the whole family can enjoy.

So, "here's a toast to toast!"

AVOCADO TOAST

I keep a stash of avocados in different stages of ripeness on my kitchen counter, never knowing when I'll need one to slice on a bed of fresh greens or to mash, season and spread on toast for a tasty morning energy boost. I've been making the latter for years, so no wonder I was surprised while whiling away time on Instagram, to find that avocado toast is "on trend," with multiple ways to enjoy it.

Here's how to prepare "Avocado Toast" for two:

Peel and pit a ripe avocado. Mash in a bowl with a fork, leaving some chunks. Add a pinch of sea salt and juice from half of a lemon.

Toast two slices of your favorite bread. Spread half of the mixture on each slice and garnish with some red pepper flakes and a drizzle of good olive oil (optional).

Tips: Get creative by topping the spread mixture with chopped, cooked bacon and goat cheese; salsa and crushed tortilla chips; or cracked pepper, sliced cherry tomatoes and basil.

EGG IN A HOLE

Create memorable family traditions with your kids and grandkids starting at breakfast with this whimsical presentation of eggs and toast. Some families call it "Toad in the Hole" or "Bird in a Nest" - the list goes on. It's really nothing more than an egg cooked in the cut-out center of a piece of panmade toast, but it's the off-kilter presentation that fancies it up.

Here's how to make one "Egg in a Hole":

Use a 2-inch circle biscuit cutter or similar sized metal cookie cutter to cut out the center of a slice

In a well-buttered pan, toast one side of the slice and cut-out piece for about 1-1/2 minutes. Flip.

Add more butter to the pan. Crack egg in the open center of the slice. Cover pan and cook slowly until whites are set and yolk thickens, about 3-1/2 to 4 minutes.

Season with salt and pepper. Serve with the toasted cutout.





How to Stop an Overweight Dog From Howling for Food

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: My Labrador-mix, Seeker, has always been a pretty big guy. But lately he's turned into a very round dog. If I don't feed him throughout the day, he sits beside his bowl and howls - making it impossible for me to work at my desk. What can I do to calm him down and help him lose weight? - Jim G., Quincy, Massachusetts

Dear Jim: It's difficult to help overweight pets lose those extra pounds, and it's clear that Seeker has no qualms about complaining about it!

Since you're working from home, one way to mitigate the howling is to implement a divert-and-reward system to take his mind off his empty bowl. In essence, keep Seeker away from the kitchen and as busy as your schedule allows.

Immediately after his breakfast, close off the kitchen. Use a baby gate or shut the door, and hide the food bowl out of sight. Take Seeker outside for a short walk to burn off extra energy and a few calories. If you're in a high-rise apartment or another situation where going outside frequently is more difficult, opt for a five-minute training and play session instead.

While you're working, Seeker should be separated from the kitchen - either in a closed-off room or with you in your office (but in his own corner) - and given plenty of toys to chew on. Spend time with Seeker on each break from work. Play, work on basic obedience, or just hang out. Once you're finished with work for the day, take Seeker out for a long walk before giving him dinner.

Stick with the diet prescribed by the vet. Be patient but consistent with Seeker to change his behavior. He can and will lose the weight, because you care about him!

Tundra Swans Shot And Left To Waste Near Saint Maries In North Idaho

Fish and Game asks for the public to report information about illegal harvest and waste of tundra swans in the Panhandle

Idaho Fish and Game has received information about six tundra swans that were shot and left to waste near Saint Maries in North Idaho. Fish and Game is requesting the public to report any information about the incident.

Tundra swans are protected under the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, all six birds were killed during a closed season and their bodies were left to waste.

The swans are believed to have been killed on the weekend of March 25-26. The bodies of the birds were found approximately one mile upriver of Saint Maries on the Railroad Grade Road in a private, flooded field.

Anyone who might have seen or heard something related to the incident is encouraged to contact Conservation Officer Dustin Horn at (208) 916-6871 or call the Citizen Against Poaching hotline at 1-(800) 632-5999. Information can also be reported online.

A Citizens Against Poaching monetary reward will be requested for individuals who provide credible, detailed information which significantly helps to identify person(s) involved and which leads to any relevant charges.


