Give Pork Chops the Steakhouse Treatment for Father's Day

Father's Day meals don't have to be elaborate to feel special. Sometimes all it takes is setting aside a little extra time and serving something that says, "I thought you'd enjoy this."

Many Father's Day menus revolve around steaks, burgers and the backyard grill. This year let's give the humble pork chop the star treatment. Stuffed with apples and onions and finished with herbs and Dijon mustard, they deliver steakhouse flavor without the steakhouse price tag.

One of the things I love about cooking is its ability to turn ordinary ingredients into something extraordinary. A celebration doesn't come from the price tag attached to the meal. It comes from the thought behind it. Whether it's Father's Day, a birthday or simply a Tuesday when everyone is home at the same time, a little extra effort can make dinner feel like an occasion.

APPLE & HERB STUFFED PORK CHOPS

Yield: 4 Servings

Total Time: 50 mins.

4 thick-cut pork chops with bone if possible, about 1 1/2 inch thick

2 tablespoons olive oil, plus more as needed

1 teaspoon sea salt, plus more to taste

1 tablespoon butter, or more olive oil

1 apple, Granny Smith or similar, cored and thinly sliced

1 medium sweet onion, thinly sliced

1 tablespoon apple cider vinegar

1 cup panko breadcrumbs

2 tablespoons Dijon mustard

1/2 teaspoon garlic powder

1/2 teaspoon dried thyme or 2 teaspoons fresh thyme, chopped

1/2 teaspoon dried rosemary or 2 teaspoons fresh rosemary, chopped

1/2 teaspoon fresh ground black pepper, plus more to taste

Toothpicks to secure the stuffing

Preheat the oven to 375 F.



Stuffed with apples, onions and herbs, these juicy pork chops bring steakhouse flavor to the table.

Using a small sharp knife, cut a deep pocket into the side of each pork chop, being careful not to cut all the way through. Season the chops inside and out with salt.

Heat an oven-safe skillet over medium heat. Add the oil and brown the pork chops on both sides, about 4 to 5 minutes per side. If the chops have a fat cap, briefly brown it as well. Transfer to a plate. The centers will still be undercooked.

Add the butter to the skillet. Cook the onion for 2 to 3 minutes

until softened. Add the apple and cook until tender. Stir in the vinegar, then add the panko breadcrumbs and cook for 1 minute more. Remove from the heat.

In a small bowl, combine the Dijon mustard, garlic powder, thyme, rosemary and pepper. Spread the mixture over the pork chops and inside the pockets.

Fill each pocket generously with the apple mixture and secure with toothpicks if needed.

Arrange any remaining apple and onion mixture in the center of the skillet and place the pork chops on top. Cover and bake for 20 to 25 minutes, or until the pork reaches 145 F in the thickest part. Let rest for 5 to 10 minutes before serving.

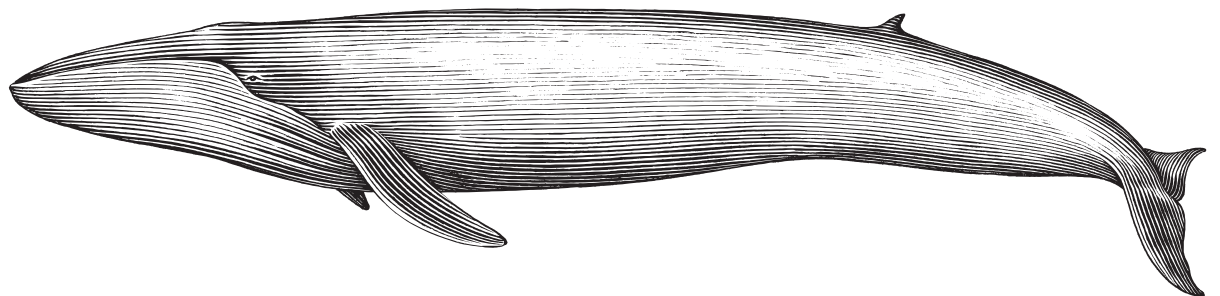
Make It Simpler

Don't feel like stuffing pork chops? No problem! This recipe is just as delicious served without the extra step. Simply skip cutting the pockets and reserve the apple-onion mixture. Before baking, spread the apples and onions into an even layer in the skillet and place the seasoned pork chops on top. Roast as directed until the pork reaches 145 F. You'll get all the same sweet-savory flavor with a little less fuss.

Serve with mashed potatoes, sauteed green beans and a simple green salad for a complete meal. Then bring out dessert. Life offers plenty of reasons to skip dessert. Father's Day isn't one of them.

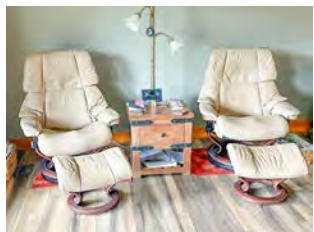

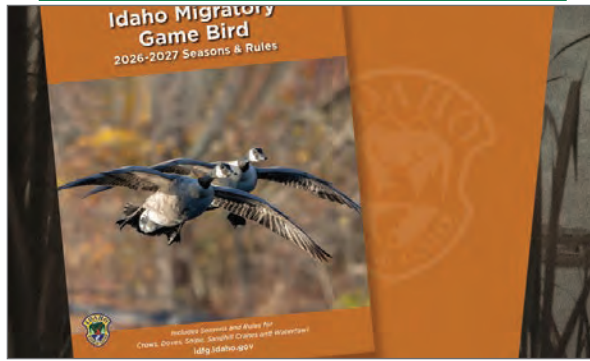

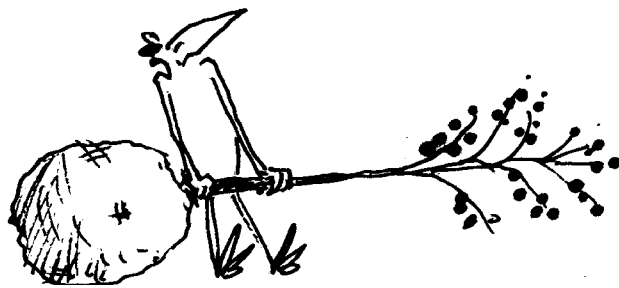

The daily bag limit was reduced from 10 to 6, in response to recent declines in the fall population index, as per the Pacific Flyway Management Plan. See page 10.

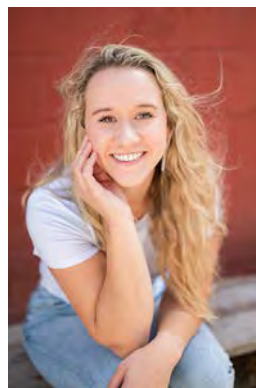

So You Want To Take Your Kids Fishing...

Follow these 10 tips to get your kiddos hooked on fishing.

If you want to be rock star to your kids this summer, there's one surefire way to achieve stardom: Taking them fishing.

From the fresh air to the excitement of feeling a tug on your line, fishing provides the perfect excuse to spend together-time outdoors. Plus, introducing young children to the sport — which may seem daunting for some — is actually quite easy if you do a little prep work ahead of time.

"Fishing is a great sport even for little kids, if you introduce it in a positive way," says Greg Schoby, Fish and Game Fisheries Manager in Salmon. "And remember: Keep it fun, short and simple, and the kids will be hooked."

No matter when you go, Fish and Game recommends keeping these 10 simple tips in mind to ensure your kid's first fishing experience isn't their last.

1. Catching is key

Getting kids hooked on fishing is about getting a fish on the line...fast. And for kids, it's about numbers caught, not how big. Taking them on a trip that produces the most fish possible should be your goal. Finding a well-stocked pond or lake is essential, and Fish and Game makes finding one easy. Check out our Learn to Fish webpage for close-to-home fishing holes, basic tips, fishing events, and more.

2. Keep it simple

If you and the kiddos have never fished before, don't worry about all the different types of fishing equipment. Push button reels and casting rods exist for a reason — they're easy to use.

A few small hooks, a couple 1-inch bobbers, and sinkers is all you need to get started. And don't be afraid to ask others or visit your local sporting goods store. If you lack equipment, Fish and Game's Take Me Fishing trailers are loaded with loaner fishing rods, tackle, bait, and are staffed by experienced anglers that can help — all for free! These trailers make appearances at well-stocked fishing holes throughout the state, so be sure to check the schedule for when and where.

3. Keep it short

The younger the child, the shorter the attention span. If the fish aren't biting, don't keep kids held hostage watching their fishing poles. Allow some breaks for rock skipping, enjoying some beach time, picking up bugs, whatever keeps them happy and lets them enjoy the outdoors. And don't be surprised if catching fish isn't their first priority. Just remember, as your child's attention span gets longer, so will your fishing trips.

4. Fun times ahead

If you want your kids to go fishing again, the "fun" part is most important. Choose a sunny day, take photographs, bring the best snacks, and aim to have a good time watching them have a good time. Keep this in mind and each outing will be a success, regardless of the number of fish caught.

5. Be patient

Remember that it's not just your fishing trip, it's their fishing trip, too. Accept that you will be untangling lines, baiting hooks, and probably not fishing much yourself. They will probably get dirty or even a little wet. But the quickest way to turn children off to fishing is to get frustrated with them. Staying patient and keeping the outing short (under an hour for beginners) will set you on course for cultivating a lifelong fishing buddy.

6. Snack breaks

8. Never waste teaching moments

Fishing is not only about just catching fish. Creating memories and learning are what's important. Capitalize on moments to teach them — tell them about bugs, birds, plants, and fish. The outdoors is the best kind of classroom, and kids will soak it up like a sponge.

9. Keep a few

Catch and release is an important aspect of angling, but there's nothing wrong with keeping a few for the pan if the fishing rules allow. It can also open their minds on where the food they eat comes from. Just like agriculture, it is important to open your kid's mind on where people get their food.

10. Leave it better than you found it

Remember to pack out your garbage and encourage kids to pick up, too. These lessons mold responsible and conscientious anglers helping to ensure the future of our sport.

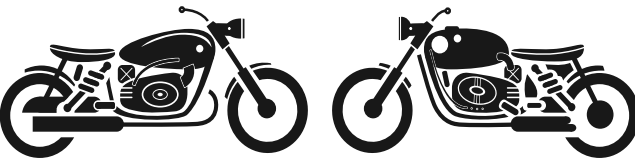

FWP to Auction Confiscated Antlers, Hides, Horns National Auction will host event at MetraPark on June 27

— Montana FWP —

BILLINGS — Antlers, horns, hides, mounts and skulls that were confiscated by Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks enforcement from all regions of the state will be auctioned on Saturday, June 27th, at the Expo Center at MetraPark in Billings. National Auction will run the live auction.

Most of the items for sale come from poaching incidents. Montana statute requires FWP to sell seized items at public auction. This includes all birds, animals, fish, heads, hides, teeth or other parts of any animal other than a grizzly bear. When a carcass is confiscated, FWP donates the meat to a charitable organization and removes the antlers to be sold at auction. When enough inventory is collected, FWP schedules an auction. The last auction, held in 2023, raised over \$82,000 for FWP's conservation and restoration programs.

Doors open at 8am for inspection and the live auction begins at 10am. The auction is open to the public and free to attend. Participants can register to bid at the door with photo ID. The Expo Center at MetraPark is located at 308 6th Avenue North in Billings.

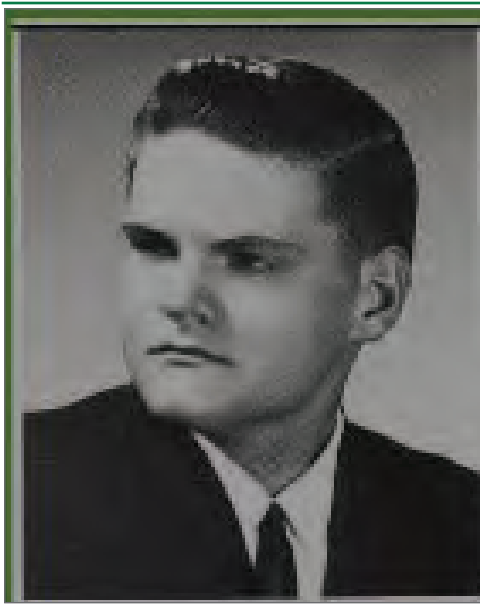

Fifty-Two Years Later: Remembering Fallen Fish and Game Conservation Officer Sam Buntrock

Part 1 of 2

Take a step back in time to learn more about one of Idaho Fish and Game's fallen conservation officers from southeast Idaho as told by one of our current officers. This is Sam Buntrock's story.

Former Idaho Fish and Game Conservation Officer Sam Buntrock lost his life in a plane crash in Bear Lake County in 1974 while in the line of duty. He was assigned to the Soda Springs patrol area in southeast Idaho until his death. The above is his photo from the 1965 Meridian High School yearbook.

I initially was drawn to the story of Sam Buntrock as I am currently the Idaho Fish and Game conservation officer that covers the area in Bear Lake County where Sam was killed in a plane crash during the spring of 1974. He was only 27 years old.

I was a little surprised at the lack of information about Sam, and in an attempt to not forget those who have laid down their lives in this line of work, I began asking questions. During my dive into the past, I uncovered a rather brave story.

Sam was born March 6, 1947, in Nampa, Idaho. In 1955, 8-year-old Sam, his father Walter, and older brother John were in a car accident when their family car collided with a county gravel truck. Sam's father and brother both died as a result of the crash. Sam survived but was reported to have a fractured arm and leg and many facial cuts that left him with scars for the rest of his life.

The accident left Sam as the only child of a widowed mother.

Before Sam graduated from high school in Meridian, tragedy struck again as a close friend died in a motorcycle accident. Sam later attended Boise State College and graduated from Oregon State University in 1970. During his senior year of college, his mother Helen passed away unexpectedly.

Despite the tragedy that surrounded Sam his entire life, every story I read and every person I talked to could only say good things about him. Quotes like "He was just an outstanding person in all respects... I sure miss that big character!" were very common.

Sam was described as a "big man" with a low voice that rivaled that of the late actor Burl Ives.

Based on my research, Sam worked for Idaho Fish and Game in various temporary positions in Boise and Island Park before joining the ranks as a conservation officer in 1972. Sam was assigned to the Soda Springs patrol area in the Southeast Region.

He immediately began to immerse himself in the Soda Springs community, being an active member of the Soda Springs Lions Club and serving on the Miss Caribou County Pageant Committee.

One former regional fisheries staff member stated that he and Sam spent many hours fishing together along a section of the Blackfoot River that is now part of a wildlife management area.

Multiple former colleagues of Sam's relayed that in the year or so before Sam was killed, he had been in another crash... involving a helicopter. The reported crash took place somewhere near Sulphur Canyon in southeast Idaho during what can be assumed to be a wildlife survey. The helicopter went down in deep snow, miles from anywhere. This would have been in the 1972-73 timeframe, meaning cell phones weren't even a thought and radio service was non-existent in the area. Reports say that Sam and the pilot were uninjured but had to wade through waist-deep snow back to Highway 30, where they eventually hitchhiked back to Soda Springs.

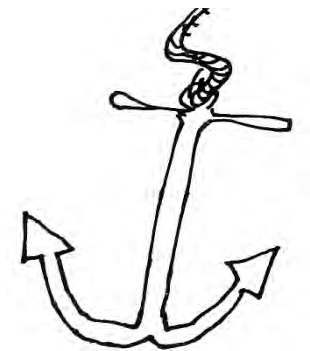

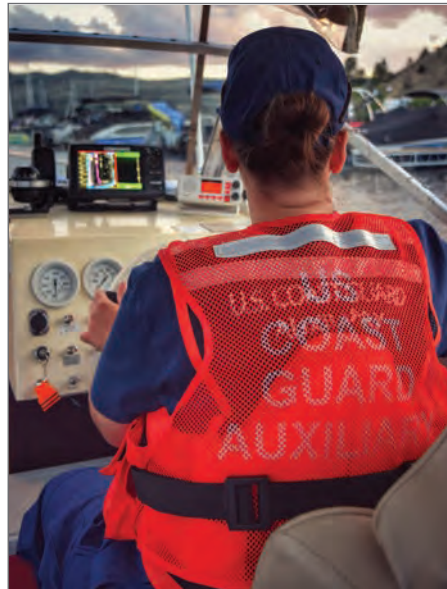

NORTHERN IDAHO — Summer has arrived across Idaho, and thousands of residents and visitors are heading to the state's lakes, reservoirs, rivers and waterways to enjoy boating, kayaking, canoeing and stand-up paddleboarding. From Lake Coeur d'Alene and Payette Lake to the Snake River and countless mountain reservoirs, Idaho offers some of the most scenic boating and paddling opportunities in the West. But while warm air temperatures draw people to the water, safety officials are reminding boaters and paddlecraft users that Idaho's waters can be surprisingly dangerous, even on beautiful summer days.

Whether operating a motorboat, paddling a kayak, or exploring on a stand-up paddleboard, wearing a life jacket remains the single most effective way to prevent drowning. According to Idaho boating safety officials, most boating fatalities involve victims who were not wearing a life jacket. Idaho law requires every vessel—including kayakers, canoes and paddleboards—to carry a properly sized U.S. Coast Guard-approved life jacket for each person on board. Children 14 years old and younger must wear a life jacket while underway on vessels 19 feet or less in length. Safety experts emphasize a simple message: life jackets only work when they are worn. Many paddlers mistakenly secure a life jacket to their kayak or paddleboard instead of wearing it. In a sudden capsized, cold-water immersion, or collision, there may not be time to put one on. While life jackets are essential in

any emergency, they become even more critical in Idaho, where one hidden danger catches many boaters and paddlers by surprise: cold water.

One of the biggest misconceptions about summer recreation is that warm weather means safe water temperatures. In reality, many Idaho lakes and rivers remain cold year-round. Where the average water temperature in Idaho is approximately 52 degrees, even during summer months. Cold water can trigger an immediate "cold shock" response, causing involuntary gasping, rapid breathing and loss of muscle control within minutes. Even strong swimmers can quickly become incapacitated. Hypothermia can develop much faster than many people realize because water removes body heat approximately 25 times faster than air. If a paddler or boater falls into cold water, wearing a life jacket helps keep them afloat while conserving energy and body heat. Safety officials recommend staying with a capsized vessel whenever possible, as boats and paddlecraft

are often easier for rescuers to spot than a person in the water. Even when boaters are prepared for Idaho's chilly waters, changing weather conditions can create another set of hazards that develop with little warning.

Summer afternoons often bring rapidly developing thunderstorms across Idaho, particularly in mountain regions. What begins as a calm morning on the water can quickly change as thunderheads build, bringing strong winds, lightning, rough waves and reduced visibility. For paddlecraft users, sudden winds can push kayakers and paddleboards far from shore, making it difficult or impossible to return safely. Small boats are also vulnerable to rapidly changing conditions. Safety officials recommend checking weather forecasts before launching and continuously monitoring the sky for developing storms. If thunder is heard or dark clouds begin forming, boaters and paddlers should head to shore immediately. When storms threaten, the safest decision is often to end the outing early. As storms bring darker skies, reduced visibility and rapidly changing conditions, being able to see and be seen on the water becomes increasingly important.

As summer days stretch into evening adventures, proper lighting becomes increasingly important. Idaho regulations require vessels to display navigation lights between sunset and sunrise and during periods of restricted visibility such as fog, heavy rain or smoke. Paddlecraft users should also consider carrying waterproof lights, headlamps or visibility beacons when recreating near dusk or

after dark. Bright clothing and reflective materials can help other boaters spot paddlers in low-light conditions. Many boating collisions occur because operators simply cannot see another vessel or paddlecraft in time to avoid it. Visibility is especially important for paddlecraft users, who often sit low on the water and can be difficult for other boaters to spot, particularly during busy summer weekends.

Kayaking, canoeing and stand-up paddleboarding continue to grow in popularity across Idaho. Paddlecraft offer an affordable and accessible way to explore the state's waterways, but they also place users closer to the water and more vulnerable to weather, waves and cold-water immersion. Because paddlecraft are small and lightweight, they can capsize unexpectedly due to wind, boat wakes, changing currents or shifting body weight. Wearing a life jacket, carrying a whistle, and informing someone of your planned route can dramatically improve safety. Whether enjoying a day on a motorboat, kayak, canoe or paddleboard, the same safety principles apply: prepare ahead, respect the water and be ready for changing conditions.

Idaho's waterways provide endless opportunities for adventure, relaxation and family fun. A few simple precautions can help ensure every trip ends safely:

- Wear a life jacket every time you are on the water.
- Check weather forecasts before launching.
- Watch for developing thunderstorms.
- Carry proper lighting when boating near dusk or after dark.
- Dress for water temperature, not air temperature.
- Tell someone where you are going and when you expect to return.

As boating season reaches its peak, safety officials hope Idahoans will remember that preparation is just as important as recreation. The best memories on Idaho waters are the ones that bring everyone home safely.

Fifty-Two Years Later: Remembering Fallen Fish and Game Conservation Officer Sam Buntrock

Part 2 of 2

Still after that incident, Sam was just as willing to help with whatever was needed. Such was the case on May 29, 1974. I spoke with Janna Phillips, wife of Blake Phillips (retired Assistant Chief of Enforcement for Idaho Fish and Game) and the daughter of retired Fish and Game Conservation Officer Perry Johnson, who shared more of the story of the plane crash that took Sam's life.

Janna remembers that it was actually her father, Perry, who was scheduled to be on the plane that morning to fly with some US Forest Service (USFS) employees. She said that her father had come down sick the night prior and asked if Sam would be able to take his place. Sam immediately said he would. Janna said her father was plagued with survivors' guilt for many years after the accident.

Unfortunately, time has washed away many of the details from the day, but what records I could find detail the following:

An aircraft was scheduled to fly to the Home Canyon area near the town of Montpelier to look at a possible timber sale, and how that could affect elk calving areas. There were 4 souls on board, Tom Stoor (Pocatello, Pilot), Tom Semrad (Montpelier, Forester USFS), Gary Richardson (Pocatello, Wildlife Biologist USFS) and Sam.

The group left the Montpelier Municipal Airport around 6 AM, with plans to be back by mid-morning. When they did not make it back in time, a search started at about 1:30 PM.

Aerial search planes spotted the wreckage at about 5:15 PM. Ground searchers under the direction of then Bear Lake County Sheriff Larry Lloyd reached the aircraft about 6 PM. It is reported that the aircraft clipped the top of a lodgepole pine stand and sent the plane into a nosedive. All passengers of the plane were pronounced dead on the scene.

Those I spoke with who worked for Fish and Game at the time all stated they were extremely devastated by the news of Sam's passing. They shut down the Southeast Region office in Pocatello, and all drove to Boise for his funeral. They all told me about the

positive impact Sam had on their lives, even though they only knew him for a short time.

When I began looking into the story of Sam's death, I was simply looking for a little more context on what had happened. However, what I really uncovered was a story of bravery and selflessness. I mean, we've all heard the expression "if you get bucked off, you gotta get back on", but that takes on a whole new level when it comes to aircraft. Out of anyone in the department, Sam had the best reason not to climb aboard that plane on that May morning. He could've blamed his previous aircraft debacle, and I don't think anyone would've held it against him. Instead, Sam answered the call of his fellow officer with "Sure Bud, I'll go."

Sam doesn't have any immediate family remaining, spare a few cousins with whom I have been in contact. So today, May 29, on this anniversary of his passing, let us remember our Brother in Conservation, who gave his life to "preserve, protect, perpetuate, and manage" the fish and wildlife of Idaho.

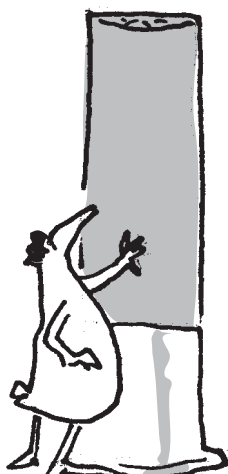

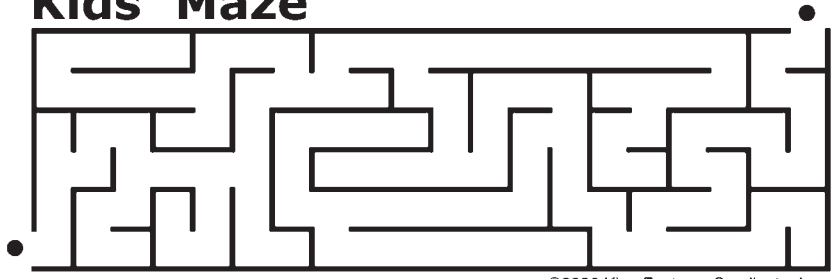

Over 11,000 Catchable Rainbow Trout Are Headed For Lakes In The Panhandle Region In June

School is almost out and fish are stocked and ready to be caught

Students will soon be released from school, and rainbow trout are being released in waters all over the Panhandle in June! Over 11,000 catchable-size (10 to 12 inch) rainbow trout will be stocked in the Panhandle Region in June.

Stocking of all waters is tentative and dependent on river/lake/pond conditions (angler safety concerns); dates may change due to weather or staffing constraints.

For maps of these fishing locations and other angling destinations in Idaho please visit the Idaho Fish Planner at idfg.idaho.gov/ifwis/fishingplanner.

Many of the waters highlighted below are easy to access, family-friendly fishing destinations. All you need to get started is a fishing license and some basic tackle. Annual adult fishing licenses cost around \$30, junior licenses (ages 14-17) cost \$16, and youth under 14 fish for free.

Fishing for stocked rainbow trout, particularly in community ponds, is a great way to introduce new anglers to the sport by using simple (and relatively thrifty) set-ups like worm/marshmallow combinations or commercial baits like Power Bait or Crave, either near the bottom or below a bobber. The Learn to Fish webpage (idfg.idaho.gov/fish/basics) offers diagrams for basic bait rigs.

Most Idaho waters are open to fishing year-round, but some may have slightly different rules. Be sure to pick up a 2025-27 Idaho Fishing Seasons and Rules booklet, which outlines season dates, special regulations and bag limits at any Idaho Fish and Game offices or most sporting goods stores statewide or see it online at idfg.idaho.gov/sites/default/files/seasons-rules-fish-2025-2027.pdf.

Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks' tagline is "The outside is in us all." At two state parks, this "all" has become more inclusive thanks to reservable all-terrain wheelchairs.

Lake Elmo State Park in Billings and Lone Pine State Park in Kalispell each have an Action Trackchair available for the public to use, free of charge. The all-terrain wheelchairs are designed to empower individuals of all abilities to explore the outdoors and enjoy Montana's state parks. Chairs were purchased through grants from Montana State Parks Foundation, the Christopher & Dana Reeve Foundation's Quality of Life Grant Program and Hydro Flask's Parks for All Grant Program.

This spring, Liz Alford, who holds the title of Ms. Wheelchair Montana 2026, made the trip to Lake Elmo to try out the trackchair for herself. With a platform centered on expanding accessible outdoor recreation, Alford 's visit to Lake Elmo was a firsthand look at the program in action. "Honestly getting to ride in a track chair was such an amazing experience that I hope to expand on to all other state parks within our state," said Alford, "The track chair allowed me to explore and be fully included in my family's adventure. As someone with a disability, having accessibility is huge and allows people like me to be fully included in the beauty of Montana."
