Nonresident Hunters Can Sign Up Between Now And June 30 For Alternate's List

— Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks —

HELENA – Beginning now and running through June 30th, nonresident hunters can register their name to the Alternate's List on MyFWP at https:// myfwp.mt.gov/fwpExtPortal/login/login.jsp. Every year, Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks gets several unused nonresident combination licenses (big game, general elk and general deer combination licenses) returned by customers. FWP resells these returned licenses through the Alternate's

The Alternate's List is an option for nonresident hunters to express their interest in purchasing one of these returned licenses by registering their name to this listing. A hunter can register to purchase their choice of only one nonresident combination license per year (big game, general elk, or general deer combination licenses). The list is randomized in mid-July. The hunter in the uppermost randomized position on the list will be contacted by email in August to finalize the purchase of the license, and so on until the returned NR combo licenses are eventually exhausted.

Payment for the license fee is not required to sign up for the Alternate's List. If your randomized position falls at the top of the listing, you will be contacted by email with instructions on how to complete the purchase of the license. Being on this list or obtaining a license from this list has no effect on your existing preference points.


MyFWP also allows you to check where your position lands on this Alternate's List after the randomization process occurs in mid-July. Please be sure to check back after then.

The odds of getting a license from these lists vary greatly from year to year. Refunds and issuance may occur at any time after mid-July, but availability of these licenses increase between early fall and the opening of general hunting season in late

Eliminating energy consuming processes of industries and consumers that add carbon dioxide to the atmosphere is a goal shared by many. But, I feel the building of approximately 500,000 up to 600 foot tall electric power generating windmills across the United States to mitigate additions of carbon dioxide to the atmosphere is a solution to be avoided if at all possible as I feel they are unsightly eyesores.

If electric power consumers cut their need for power generated by electric power utilities enough, these utilities, having no market for their electric power would have to eliminate, by dismantlement, I would hope 100% of their windmills.

In this regard, locally, in the eastern Washington area humanitarian non-profit environmentalist concerns might re-purpose large mothballed or abandoned industrial sites (especially in Spokane County) for installation of solar electric power collectors that absorb sunlight for electric power. - slices uncooked bacon, chopped

 - 2 green onions, chopped
 - 3 tablespoons cider vinegar
 - 2 teaspoons sugar
- 1. In large bowl, toss potatoes with bacon, salt and pepper until potatoes are evenly coated.
- 2. Using 18-inch-wide heavy-duty foil, layer two 20-by-18-inch sheets to make a double thickness. Spray with nonstick cooking spray. Place potato mixture on center of stacked foil. Bring long sides of foil up and over potato mixture and fold over several times to seal well. Fold ends to seal in juices, making sure not to fold in too far in order to leave room for heat circulation inside.

Idaho's History Of Brave Heroes

Memorial Day weekend generally means a fun day hanging out with friends and family at a BBQ or time on the lake. It also marks the beginning of summer to a lot of people (me included), but to others it means a lot more than that. The very first observance of Memorial Day was May 30th, 1868, then called Decoration Day, by commander in chief John A. Logan of the Grand Army of the Republic to honor the union troops who died fighting in the civil war. Fast forward to 1971, when Congress standardized the day of remembrance as Memorial Day weekend. It is a day to remember the fallen troops of past and present for the price paid for our freedoms.

Idaho has a rich history of warriors who fought bravely for their family, God, and country but what most people might not know is amongst Idaho"s ranks of warriors is a good sized list of Medal of Honor recipients, which is the highest military award for going beyond the call of duty.

One of Idaho's medal of honor heroes is 1st Lt. Frank S. Reasoner, who was born in Spokane, Washington on September 16, 1937 and when he was ten his family moved to Kellogg, Idaho. After graduating high school in 1955, he enlisted in the US Marines. Frank graduated from Westpoint in June of 1962, he was appointed a marine second lieutenant and was assigned to the Third Reconnaissance Battalion company B in April of 1965. Reasoner was just given command of company A as a platoon leader when he opted to go with a small patrol in Dai Loc where his patrol was ambushed by what was later estimated to be 75 to 100 Viet Cong troops.

During the firefight, Reasoner repeatedly exposed himself to enemy fire giving his men encouragement and guidance when one of his radio operators lance corporal James Shockley was hit Reasoner ignored enemy fire to get to Shockley's side telling him he was going to get out of there, but unfortunately the VC saw Shockley try to move to a ditch and unleashed machine gun fire which hit Shockley a second time. Reasoner then tried to get Shockley to safety when machine gun fire tore through Shockley's stomach killing him. Reasoner died alongside Shockley where reinforcements retrieved their bodies.

Navy Secretary Paul H. Nitze presented the medal of honor posthumously to Reasoner's widow and son. Navy Secretary Nitze said "His complete disregard for his own welfare will serve as an inspiring example to others". Survived by his wife Sally and son Mike, Frank Reasoner died July 12th, 1965. He is buried in Kellogg Idaho. Let's spend this Memorial Day in remembrance of warriors like Reasoner who paid the ultimate price for freedom.







Forestry Shortcourse Offered In Sandpoint

Wednesday Mornings June-July, 2023

- University of Idaho Extension

Many Idaho forest landowners desire a better understanding of how forests grow and how they can better manage their forest property to meet their goals. Furthermore, forest landowners are often required to demonstrate planned, active forest management to qualify for lower forestry property tax rates and cost-share assistance for management activities such as thinning.

This summer, a 6-session program, titled the Forestry Shortcourse, will help enrich forest landowners' understanding of forest ecology, silviculture, forest health, wildlife habitat, and other forestry topics. In the process, participants are coached by natural resource professionals on how to develop a management plan for their forest.

The Forestry Shortcourse will be held Wednesday mornings, 9am to 12pm, June 14th, 21st, 28th and July 5th, 12th, 19th, 2023, at the University of Idaho Sandpoint Organic Agriculture Center, 10881 N. Boyer Road, in Sandpoint. A \$38 registration fee includes a large binder of forest stewardship resource materials, including a wooden USB flash drive with over 120 extension publications. To ensure an effective learning environment, the program is limited to 25 people. Those wishing to participate should pre-register by Wednesday, June 9th at the University of Idaho Extension office in Bonner County. Phone: 208-263-8511.

The program is eligible for 7 Idaho pesticide recertification credits. For \$120, teachers can also sign up for two University of Idaho credits for the program.

If you have questions on the program, contact Chris Schnepf at 208-292-1288. The Forestry Shortcourse is an Idaho Forest Stewardship program, co-sponsored by University of Idaho Extension, the Idaho Department of Lands, and many other agencies and organizations.

Get National Egg Day off to a Delicious Start With Budget-Friendly Shakshuka

Did you know that National Egg Day is coming up on June 3? I hope you're ready to celebrate and start your day with a delicious and nutritious meal, because I've got a recipe for you that's sure to impress: Shakshuka!

But first, let's talk about egg prices. Yes, it's true, the cost of eggs has doubled since this time last year, but there's hope on the horizon. Eggs are expected to drop a total of about 30% by the end of the year, according to the USDA. The price isn't back to where it was, but at least it's going in the right direction.

But fear not, dear readers, because even with these prices, eggs are still a nutritional bargain. Not only are they an affordable source of protein, but they're also packed with nutrients like vitamin D, choline and omega-3 fatty acids.

And what better way to enjoy these little nutritional powerhouses than in a classic dish like Shakshuka? For those who are new to this dish, Shakshuka is a Middle Eastern breakfast dish made with eggs poached in a flavorful tomato sauce. It's a delicious, easy-to-make one-pan wonder. And it's versatile enough to accommodate a range of dietary needs.

The history of Shakshuka is a bit murky, with some claiming it originated in Tunisia, while others say it was invented in Israel or North Africa. Regardless of its origins, Shakshuka has become a beloved dish around the world, and for good reason. It's a comforting, warming dish that's perfect for breakfast, brunch, lunch or dinner.

So, without further ado, here's the recipe for Shakshuka:

SKILLET SHAKSHUKA

Yield: 4 servings Total Time: 30 minutes

l tablespoon olive oil

1 medium onion, diced 2 bell peppers (any color), seeded

and chopped I (4 ounce) can mild green chilis

3 cloves garlic, minced

1 tablespoon paprika

l tablespoon cumin

I (28 ounce) can diced tomatoes 8 eggs

1/2 cup feta cheese, crumbled or sliced

Parsley or cilantro, chopped Salt and pepper



Shake up your morning with delicious Shakshuka.

4 thick slices of crusty bread

Note: Don't use a cast iron or aluminum skillet, as the highly acidic tomato sauce may cause a reaction with the metal. It won't hurt you, but the Shakshuka will taste metallic and may harm the seasoning of your cast iron pan.

In your skillet, warm the oil over medium heat. Once hot, add the onion and let that cook for a few minutes to soften. Add the bell peppers and green chilis, cooking for 5 minutes, stirring as needed.

Add the garlic, paprika and cumin and cook until fragrant, about 30 seconds. Add the tomatoes and their juices. Reduce heat and let this simmer for at least 10 minutes to allow the flavor to marry. At this time, if you choose, you can place the skillet on very low heat and let it simmer until you're ready to cook the eggs.

Using the back of a spoon, make wells in the tomato mixture. Crack the eggs into the sauce, spacing them evenly apart. Cover and allow the eggs to cook until the whites are set and the yolk is cooked to your desired consistency, about 5-7 minutes. Taste and adjust seasonings.

Serve immediately, sprinkled with feta cheese, chopped parsley and lots

of crusty bread. **Diva Tip:** Use a vegetable peeler to thinly slice the feta cheese so it melts beautifully over everything.

And there you have it, folks. Celebrate the humble egg with Shakshuka. It's a delicious and affordable meal that's perfect any time of day. Bon appetit!



People who get COVID-19 vaccine less likely to die from any cause

DEAR DR. ROACH: In a recent column, you referred to a U.K. source that stated "all-cause mortality is very significantly reduced in people who have had the COVID-19 vaccine, compared to unvaccinated people." I wasn't sure what you meant by all-cause? Does this mean any and all deaths, with or without COVID-19, for any reason, have been very significantly reduced just by getting the COVID-19 shot? Or does it mean that any and all deaths associated with COVID-19 have been reduced in those who have been vaccinated? If it is the first, then fewer people should be dying, people should be living longer, and we should not see a decrease in life expectancy (except for the addition of those dying from COVID-19, which brings the age down). Anyway, if the first is true, then I will definitely continue getting the COVID-19 shot just to live longer, with or without getting **COVID-19! - C.P.**

ANSWER: The U.K. study looked at all-cause mortality, which means anyone who dies from any reason. The study found that getting the COVID-19 vaccine reduced the likelihood of dying from COVID-19 and non-COVID-19 causes.

One potential problem studies face is assigning cause of death. If a person with a very serious cancer who is expected to pass away within a few months gets COVID-19 and dies, did the cancer kill them, or did COVID-19? If you have to choose just one cause, the answer could be misleading. That's why the results of the U.K. study (and a Florida study that showed similar results) were so important. People who get the COVID-19 vaccine are less likely to die from any cause.

In the last few years in the U.S., the longstanding trend of improved mortality has reversed, and death rates are going up, partially due to COVID-19.

DEAR DR. ROACH: My husband has been diagnosed with cardiac amyloidosis. The doctor has started him on Vyndamax, a very expensive drug. Without this drug, he is lucky to live, at the most, two years. Is this drug a miracle, and does it guarantee that he will live many more years? - T.W.

ANSWER: There are several types of cardiac amyloidosis – a disease in which abnormal proteins are deposited in many tissues, including the heart, where the protein interferes with heart function and leads to heart failure. Tafadamis (also known by its brand name, Vyndamax) is used in transthyretin amyloid cardiomyopathy (ATTR, of which there are two types that both get treated with tafadamis).

Subjects in the trial on tafadamis were followed for two-and-a-half years. Half of the group were given tafadamis, while the other half were given a placebo, which looked like the real drug but had no activity. Of those who got the inactive placebo, 43% died in the two-and-a-half-year time span of the study, but of those who received tafadamis, 30% died. Thirteen percent, or about one in eight people, who received tafadamis lived, when they were expected to die. In addition, there were fewer hospitalizations and less loss of ability to exercise in those taking tafadamis, compared with the placebo. There were no serious side effects that were more frequent in the tafadamis group.

Tafadamis definitely affords a big improvement in the outcome of people with ATTR-CA. However, I would not call the drug a "miracle," nor is there a guarantee of living many more years. To me, a miracle is when someone recovers when no doctor expected them to. I have seen a few in my career, and they are very powerful. I have seen many treatments that have incremental improvements in outcomes. and over time, that has led to dramatic improvements in many diseases.

FWP Takes Closer Look At **Licensing Mistake, Makes** Allowances For Three **License Types**

— Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks –

HELENA - After a closer review of the licenses that were mistakenly over-drawn last week, Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks is going to allow the drawing to stand for one bighorn sheep license type and two moose license types.

For sheep license 482-20 the quota was supposed to be 15, but FWP mistakenly allocated 20 licenses to hunters. For moose licenses 270-50 and 341-50 the quota was two, but FWP mistakenly allocated three. In these three circumstances, the number of licenses drawn are within the quotas set by the Fish and Wildlife Commission and moving forward with the extra licenses will have no biological impact.

"With these three instances, the extra licenses will have no impact on the population," said Ken McDonald, chief of the Wildlife Division at FWP. "In the remaining circumstances where licenses were over-drawn, awarding additional licenses could detrimentally affect populations."

Background

As announced by FWP Tuesday, May 17, during the moose, sheep, goat and bison drawings, the wrong quotas were entered into the system for four sheep licenses and three moose licenses. In these four remaining circumstances, FWP will determine who was mistakenly awarded licenses beyond the appropriate quota, and those hunters will not receive a license. These licenses are:

- 482-30: drew 40 applicants, but the quota was five (sheep).
- 622-30: drew 20 applicants, but the quota was 10 (sheep).
- 680-31: drew 40 applicants, but the quota was 30 (sheep).
- 332-00: drew eight applicants, but the quota was six (moose).





Lederman Art

In the 1980s, a friend's mother decided to redecorate with unfamiliar modern-style furniture. She bought a small wooden table that was painted red and designed by Jeff Lederman, an Ohio artist. The table had won a prize for design in an Illinois state

Lederman was a busy artist who changed interests and occupations many times. He designed logos for companies in the 1970s and furniture in the 1980s. For a while, he put his art aside for a new career saving wildlife. He painted pictures again from 2014 to 2018 and started making digital art in 2020.

I am a realtor and am fortunate enough to go into older homes with many architectural elements still intact. I've become fascinated by the elaborate antique doorknobs I see. I bought one for \$25 in an architectural salvage store last week. It appears to be brass. Do you think I got a good deal?

Doorknob collecting can be a lot of fun. In the early 19th century, people still opened doors with their thumbs. Their doors were fitted with wrought-iron thumb latches. Some of the earliest brass doorknobs in the U.S. started appearing around that same time. They were fixed to surface-mounted locks. Brass, bronze, pottery and glass hardware were popular in the late 19th and early 20th centuries. In the 1950s to 1970s, urban renewal programs caused many aging Victorian houses to be destroyed, with the loss of artistic hardware. The destruction spurred the creation of the Antique Doorknob Collectors of America. Detailed information can be found at their website, www.AntiqueDoorKnobs.org. Knobs can be found in secondhand shops, at demolished building sites, flea markets, malls, online shops and auctions. It looks like what you paid is a fair price.

TIP: Bright sunlight will damage antiques by fading colors or drying wood. There are several brands of



The Three Birthdays of George Washington

George Washington has had at least three official birthdays. He was born Feb. 11, 1731. But that was according to the Julian calendar used at the time. When the Gregorian calendar was adopted, his birthday was recorded as Feb. 22, 1732. (Read about how the calendar was changed if you've never learned this.)

President Chester Arthur renamed Washington's official birthday as Presidents Day in 1885. Then in 1968, the Unified Monday Holiday Act was passed and became law in 1971. The act moved certain public holidays to Mondays to create three-day weekends, and the third Monday in February became the day for Washington's celebration (and an extra day off work). In 2022, Washington's birthday is observed on Feb. 21.

Tickets sold in advance were \$6 per day or \$18 for a three-day ticket. Those sold on-site cost \$8 or \$24 for a three-day ticket.

Watermelon And Berry Pizza For Dessert

Pizza for dessert? Here's a guilt-free, ridiculously simple and naturally sweet "pizza style" version of everyone's favorite locally grown foods - tasty watermelon and lots of berries. There are a few things in common with the pizza idea ... well, actually only two. The dessert presentation is round, and it has lots of tempting healthy, fresh toppings.

Plus, there's the wow factor when your kids proudly carry their work of culinary creativity to the table at an informal supper with your family and friends. They'll be so proud.

Kick it up for other events, too. We're making doubles for my son's birthday party this weekend, and topping them off with lots of bright candles.

WATERMELON AND BERRY PIZZA

Makes 6 servings

- 12 strawberries halved
- 6 mint leaves chopped
- 1 teaspoon balsamic vinegar
- 1 large watermelon slice (1 inch or more thick), 10 inches in diameter
- 6 ounces natural lemon-flavored vogurt, or 3 ounces creme fraiche
- 1/2 cup blueberries
- Mint sprigs for garnish (optional)

In a small bowl, drizzle balsamic vinegar over the strawberries, and stir. Set aside.

Let your junior chef wash and dry the whole watermelon. An adult should slice a 10-inch round at the center portion and set on a serving plate. (If your watermelon is smaller or larger, cut the widest portion for this dessert and adjust quantities.)

Evenly cut the slice into sixths. Pinch the cut triangles tightly together on the plate.

Ask your child to spread the yogurt or creme fraiche over the round.

Spoon the strawberries and blueberries over the yogurt. Sprinkle with chopped mint. I like to add an extra sprig of mint on the side or in the middle of the presentation.

Serve slices on a dessert plate.

ALTERNATE IDEAS

- Instead of using yogurt or creme fraiche, whip up a half cup of heavy cream with a 1/2 teaspoon of vanilla and a teaspoon of sugar, or whip cream with two teaspoons of honey.
- Fresh sliced peaches, nectarines and plums also are welcome add-ons to the dessert.
