

- Purifies water that runs to the ocean, evaporates and falls as rain
- Provides the basis for a large number of medicines

#### **HOW TO OBSERVE**

On social media, use #WorldOceansDay to follow the day.

Do an internet search of photographs to see diverse and beautiful ocean creatures. One place to visit is the National Geographic website.

Since garbage, biota, and bacteria from local streams end up in the ocean, the next time you go a stream, river, lake or the ocean, clean up after yourself and join a local beach cleanup.

#### HISTORY

The concept was initially proposed in 1992 by Canada's International Centre for Ocean Development (ICOD) and the Ocean Institute of Canada.

At the first World Oceans Day in 1992, the objectives were to move the oceans from the sidelines to the center of the international discussions and to strengthen the voice of marine and coastal constituencies worldwide.

World Oceans Day events are celebrated on 8 June, the closest weekend, the week, and the month of June. The day is marked in a variety of ways, including launching new campaigns and initiatives, special events at aquariums and zoos, outdoor explorations, aquatic and beach cleanups, educational and conservation action programs, art contests, film festivals, and sustainable seafood events.

The World Oceans Day Youth Advisory Council has been helping lead conservation awareness and action efforts globally since 2016.



#### Remember everyone was new to boating at some point, so be patient

As summer arrives, more people will be boating and boat ramps can get busy. To ensure things go as quickly and efficiently as possible, follow these tips. And remember that everyone is trying to enjoy their day on the water, so people need to work together.

Be patient, and don't let a short temper spoil a good day on the water.

#### When launching your boat:

- Prep your boat and have it ready to launch before backing down the boat ramp. Have your plugs in, boat unstrapped from the trailer, and everything loaded including coolers, life jackets, fishing gear, etc. This can go a long ways to limit congestion and the frustration that comes with it.
- If the ramp has multiple lanes, take advantage and use any open lane - even a middle one.

- Remember, boat launches have two-way traffic: "launch on the left, recover on the right."
- If you are new at backing up trailers, practice at home first. Busy boat ramps can be stressful enough already. Everyone had a first season launching a boat, and there are a lot of new boaters out there, and remember you were once one,
- · Boat ramps are not intended for fishing, picnicking, sunbathing, etc. Find other places better suited for those activities to avoid crowding boat launch facilities.







## Seared Steak with Minted Watermelon

Inspired by the exotic flavors of Asia, this dish is packed with water-melon, cucumber and mint, which provide a cool contrast to savory grilled steak.

- 8 ounces thin rice noodles
- 1 (1-pound) boneless 1-inchthick beef sirloin steak Salt Pepper
- 1 shallot, finely chopped
- 1 stalk lemongrass, yellow and pale green part only, finely chopped
- 1 teaspoon sugar
- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup fresh lime juice
- 1 tablespoon lower-sodium fish sauce
- ½ small (3 cups) watermelon, rind removed, cut in ½-inch cubes
- ½ seedless (English) cucumber, cut in half and thinly sliced
- ½ cup packed fresh mint leaves, finely chopped
- 1. Prepare outdoor grill for covered direct grilling on medium.
- 2. Prepare noodles as label directs. Drain, rinse under cold water and drain again.
- 3. Season steak with a quarter-teaspoon each salt and freshly ground black pepper. Place steak on hot grill; cover. Cook 12 to 13 minutes for medium-rare or until desired doneness, turning once. Transfer steak to cutting board; let rest 10 minutes.
- 4. Meanwhile, in large bowl, stir shallot, lemongrass, sugar, lime juice and fish sauce until sugar dissolves. Thinly slice steak across the grain. Add to bowl, along with watermelon, cucumber and mint. Toss gently until well mixed.
- 5. Divide noodles among serving plates. Top with steak mixture and accumulated juices. Serves 4.

And just a reminder, kids 13-years old and younger do not need a fishing license in Idaho, so fishing is an inexpensive summer activity. Catchable-sized trout ranging from about 10 to 13 inches are regularly stocked statewide and in many easily accessible fishing spots, including community ponds, local reservoirs and nearby lakes.

"In the month leading up to Free Fishing Day, Fish and Game hatcheries stocked about 500,000 catchable rainbow trout throughout the state," Fish and Game Hatchery Manager Bryan Grant said.

If you're new to fishing, or just new to fishing in Idaho, the state has hundreds of places to fish, and you can catch a variety of species ranging from bluegill to sturgeon. Check out Fish and Game's Fishing Planner webpage at idfg.idaho.gov/ifwis/fishingplanner to search for nearby fishing spots, the types of fish in those bodies of water and a list of when those places were last stocked.

Speaking of fishing stocking, Fish and Game stocks about 30 million fish annually for anglers, which includes millions of trout that are immediately available to catch.



#### Gearin' up for June 10

If you don't have fishing gear, it's fairly inexpensive to get started. A simple rod and reel combo goes for about \$25. All you need to for tackle is a few hooks, weights, bobbers and bait. It's tough to beat live worms for bait - nearly all fish will eat them - but if you don't want to deal with squirming live worms. there are many other options, including marshmallows, Powerbait, dough bait, imitation fish eggs and a plethora of other things.

If you're unsure how to rig a rod for fishing, Fish and Game provides simple instructions on its Learn to Fish webpage at idfg.idaho.gov/fish/learn-to.

For information about bag limits and other rules, see the 2022-2024 Idaho Fishing Seasons and Rules booklet (see idfg.idaho.gov/rules/fish), which is available in a printed booklet at Fish and Game offices and many license vendors and sporting goods stores.

Fishing can be a fun time for the whole family, too, and easy for kids to learn. Remember when taking young kids out to make sure they wear lifejackets and bring lots of snacks, a hat and sunscreen. Be patient with kids and enjoy your time outdoors with them, even if the kids decide they'd rather explore nature or do something other than fishing. #### **Bring Bowls of Food to Your Table**

Big bowls, tiny bowls, bowls that are just right. They're all part of the "bowl" craze that has grabbed the attention of the culinary world and landed on our kitchen tables. And I'm in. So is my son, Anders, who has a special bowl he uses day in and day out, starting with breakfast. Come dinnertime, he uses it again and often assembles last night's leftovers topped with veggies or herbs from the garden and grated cheese for bowl-food deliciousness. Of course, he could put everything on a plate, but bowls are unexpected, easy to hold and simply more fun.

Robin Asbell, cookbook author of "Great Bowls of Food" published by Countryman Press (2016), says that bowl meals are colorful and that their simplicity really appeals to all ages. "They are great for families, because they are so flexible and can be customized for each diner with no fuss," she explained. "If someone doesn't like beets, leave them out of their bowl or use a vegetable they prefer."

Her recipes reflect her commitment to healthy eating and trying new ingredients to make family meals interesting and tasty. Inspired by the many possibilities for creating bowls of food, I landed on 'Pizza Bowl With Soft Polenta, Spinach and Mozzarella." It is like a twist on pizza, full of good-for-you ingredients, and includes a fall comfort food, polen-

PIZZA BOWL WITH SOFT POLENTA, SPINACH AND **MOZZARELLA** Serves 4

- · 1 cup polenta
- · 3 cups water

- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 cup shredded Parmesan cheese
- · 4 ounces baby spinach
- · 1 cup prepared spaghetti sauce, heated
- 8 ounces fresh mozzarella, small balls or chopped
- 1/2 cup fresh basil, finely sliced

In a 2-quart saucepan, whisk the polenta, water and salt. On medium-high heat, stir until the mixture comes to a boil. Reduce heat to low and stir every 5 minutes, scraping the bottom of the pan. Cook for about 25 minutes, until thick. Stir in Parmesan cheese until melted. Keep warm.

To serve, divide the spinach between four bowls and top with polenta. Measure 1/4 cup of hot spaghetti sauce over each bowl and top with mozzarella. Then, top with shredded basil and serve.

Note: If preparing polenta in advance, transfer to a 9-inch pan after cooking, smooth the top and let cool. To serve, reheat in the microwave or cut in wedges and saute in olive oil until crisp and heated through.





## 2023 Recreations Trails Program Grants Awarded



According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, between April 2020 and April 2021, an estimated 100,306 drug overdose deaths occurred in the United States, an increase of 28.5% from the 78,056 deaths that occurred during the prior year. The Idaho Department of Health and Welfare reports that in 2021 there were over 2.6 million opioid prescriptions written in Idaho and over 5,000 emergency department visits related to non-fatal drug overdose.

"Substance use is a widespread issue that impacts communities across the nation and unfortunately, Idaho is no exception," said Young. "Our goal is to address this crisis by providing intervention and prevention education to health care professionals and first responders at the Summit. It's a great opportunity for our community to share best practices and connect with local partners."

Someone set off a string of firecrackers a few feet from the booth they were visiting. Bliss bolted and pulled her leash out of my son's hand. She ran straight out into the road. Luckily, the cars all stopped, and one of the drivers caught her. Afterward she remained very anxious. Bliss now takes medication to stay calm, and it's difficult to take her to unfamiliar places. Please urge people not to set off fireworks; go to a professional display and leave the pets at home. -- Judith in Lake City, Florida

**DEAR JUDITH:** You told them, and I thank you! I'm very sorry to hear that Bliss was traumatized, and I hope your son is able, through medication and training, to improve her confidence.

Bliss' parents didn't do anything wrong in taking her to the festival, but their experience shows how others' irresponsibility can have consequences for pets, and that owners have to be alert and ready to handle potential problems.

The Fourth of July can be a trying day for pets. Crowded parties and loud fireworks can really stress them out. Large fireworks displays are no different than big thunderstorms to most pets, and should be treated as such.

If fireworks will be within earshot of your home this holiday, prepare a safe area for your pet to shelter where the noise will not bother it as badly. If a ThunderShirt works for your dog (or cat), use it. Don't bring pets to fireworks displays, and if you're setting off backyard fireworks, put your pets inside.







# KOVELS **Antiques & Collecting**

#### **Silver Plate**

This silver on copper "bisquit jar" is a classic Victorian piece. It uses an old spelling for "biscuit," a British-English term. In present day American English, we would call it a cookie jar.

Silver and silver plate were popular in the Victorian era. Almost every type of food had its own specific serving dish or utensil made of silver.

"Old Sheffield" refers to a special kind of silver plate made in Sheffield, England, in the 18th century. The silver was hand-rolled in sheets over copper. Most silver plate made in the 19th century is electroplated.

This jar may not be Old Sheffield silver, but it was made in the city of Sheffield. It sold for \$270 at a Selkirk auction. Its pelican hallmark identifies it as the work of Thomas Wilkinson's firm, which received a Royal Warrant from Queen Victoria in the 1840s.

When I was young, my mother made braided rugs from old wool coats. I braided the strips of fabric she created from the coats. Two large rugs that we made have been in daily use for 85 years and show very little wear. I am now 90. I might sell them and would like to know what they are worth. Do they have any resale value?

There's a rich history of braided rug making in the United States that began in the American colonies. The craft was inspired by Native American weaving techniques. The process is the same way the settlers recycled and repurposed worn clothing into rugs, giving them a new, useful purpose, Large handmade rugs similar to yours have recently sold for \$65 to \$175.







- 1. Most adult dragonflies live for only a few weeks, but some do live up to a year.
- 2. The average dragonfly has nearly 30,000 eye facets. In fact, they have 360-degree vision, including the ability to see behind them.
- Dragonflies help control the mosquito population, eating up to 100 mosquitos per day.
- Dragonflies can live in the winter but are normally small and stumpy in size.
- 5. Dragonflies use their feet to catch their food.

6. Dragonflies can live for years underwater.

The dragonfly has symbolic meaning in almost every part of the world. In fact, many cultures believe this insect symbolizes good luck. Because dragonflies have such short lifespans, they also represent new beginnings and change, especially for strength, growth, courage, and happiness. A few ancient cultures say dreaming about a dragonfly indicates you are in a powerful transition in your life.

#### 5 Symbolic Dragonfly Beliefs

- 1. Asian culture believes the dragonfly represents good luck, prosperity, and new beginnings.
- Native Americans believe a dragonfly symbolizes life transformations.
- 3. South American cultures believe the dragonfly symbolizes good luck and prosperity. In fact, artists include the dragonfly in their pieces
- 4. Africans believe dragonflies are a sign of spirits and bring good luck. Africans also hold dragonflies in high regard because they are water gods who bring rain.
- 5. European cultures see the dragonfly as a symbol of change and adaptability. Unsurprisingly, you can find dragonflies included in many European folklore stories and beliefs.

There are around 5,000 species of dragonflies around the world. A dragonfly is classified as an Odonata, which is a family of flying insects that includes dragonflies and damselflies. Though insects are considered unpopular, dragonflies tend to be watched with fascination because of their beauty.

#### What are the 3 classifications of dragonflies?

- 1. Aeshnoidea Super Family is the first classification of dragonflies.
- 2. Cordulegastridae Super Family are also known as the Flying Adders and have yellow, black, or brown bodies.
- 3. Libelluilode Super Family is the most commonly seen dragonfly. This classification is the largest family of dragonflies and is often referred to as the skimmer dragonfly.

## F&G Commission Approves Wolf Management Plan

— Idaho Fish and Game —

Six-year plan aims to reduce wolf populations to balance with prey and reduce livestock conflicts

The Idaho Fish and Game Commission unanimously approved a new wolf management plan during its May 11 meeting in Jerome. The wolf plan drew roughly 2,500 comments during a 32-day public comment period, and it will shape Idaho's wolf management over the next six years by outlining goals and strategies to manage Idaho's wolf population to fluctuate around 500 animals.

The plan calls for managing wolves in balance with other big game, particularly elk, and minimizing conflicts with livestock. It incorporates knowledge gained from nearly three decades of wolf monitoring, management and understanding how wolves interact with other game animals and livestock, and react to different levels and types of harvest.

Commissioner Don Ebert of Weippe, who recently took over as Commission chair, reflected on the decision by saying the Commission understands many people in Idaho don't support killing wolves, which was reflected in public comments.

"I want those people to know I hear what they say, and I take it to heart," he said. "I think all of us on the Commission give them due consideration, and I am the last person who wants to go out and kill all the wolves."

But he also noted wolves have recovered well beyond minimums outlined in the Endangered Species Act recovery plan, and current hunting, trapping and management actions have barely kept their populations in check.

The goal is to gradually reduce the wolf population while carefully monitoring the progress and adjusting as needed while re-establishing balance with prey species and reducing wolf conflict with livestock.

"We're not going to eradicate wolves. It is not our intention, and I do not believe we would have that ability even if it was our intention," Ebert said. "We preserve, protect and perpetuate species as a whole, and all species in tandem, so the question in my mind becomes about balance, and I believe things are out of balance with the wolf population."

Ebert noted the Commission will continue to be involved in wolf management and change course if needed.

"I think we need to have the ability to control wolf populations, and I honestly look forward to the day when I can sit here and say 'I think we need to back off on our wolf harvest,' but I don't think we are there yet."

Fish and Game's wolf population estimates are based on annual camera surveys and other methodology that showed about 1,337 wolves statewide during the summer of 2022, which is about 13% fewer than the 2021. Population estimates are based on camera surveys that measure the population near its annual peak.

At the end of 2022, Idaho had met or exceeded the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Services minimum recovery goals for wolves for 25 consecutive years. The Federal delisting rule published when wolves were removed from federal protection in the northern Rocky Mountains in 2009 stated that wolf population would be managed by the state in Idaho to average around 500 wolves. The delisting rule also stated that maintaining the wolf population at a higher level would reduce wild prey abundance and result in higher rates of livestock depredation.

Currently, Idaho has abundant and healthy elk populations statewide, however herds are unevenly distributed, and eight of Fish and Game's 28 elk management zones are below objectives. In five of those zones, Fish and Game biologists have determined that predation and other factors are limiting herd growth.

#### FRUITY WATERMELON ICE POPS

Makes 12

- 1/4 medium seedless watermelon
- 1/2 cup fresh blueberries
- 1/4 cup chopped fresh strawberries
- 1 kiwi, peeled and sliced
- 1 peach or nectarine, peeled and diced
- · 6 cherries, pitted and chopped
- 12 ice pop molds and sticks

Cut watermelon flesh into chunks. Puree in a blender or food processor until smooth, to yield approximately 3 cups. Pour into a measuring cup or container with a spout.

Set out ice pop molds. Fill each one 3/4 full with the fresh fruit; then, pour in the watermelon puree until each mold is full. Insert ice pop sticks in molds and freeze. Serve when completely solid.

#### WATERMELON AND FETA SALAD WITH MINT

Serves 4 as a side dish

- 1 tablespoon rice wine vinegar
- 2 tablespoons vegetable oil
- 1/4 red onion, thinly sliced
- · Pinch of salt
- 1/4 medium seedless watermelon
- 1/4 cup sliced or crumbled feta cheese
- 1/4 cup fresh mint leaves
- Freshly ground pepper (optional)

In a small mixing bowl, combine the vinegar, oil, sliced onion and salt. Set aside.

Cut watermelon flesh into bite-sized chunks and place on a medium-sized serving platter or in a bowl. Sprinkle with feta cheese and mint. Top with onion mixture. Toss lightly and serve immediately, garnished with a sprig of fresh mint. Grind fresh pepper on top, if you wish.






