Servings: 4-6

- 1 chuck roast (2-3 pounds)
- 1 package taco seasoning
- 1 can (10 ounces) beef consommé
- 16-20 street taco tortillas
- 1 package (8 ounces) shredded cheese
- 1/4 cup avocado oil
- salsa, for serving
- guacamole, for serving
- queso, for serving

1. Cover chuck roast with taco seasoning then place in slow cooker. Pour beef consommé over roast and cook on low 6 hours to braise.
2. Heat oven to 425 F.
3. Use fork to shred roast.
4. Brush outside of tortillas with avocado oil and fill with meat and shredded cheese. Place in casserole dish and bake 10-15 minutes until tacos reach desired crispiness.
5. Place on tray and serve with salsa, guacamole and queso.

TIP: Recipe can be doubled for large crowds.

Dear EarthTalk: Is the prevalence of processed foods an environmental threat?

—Lori P., via email

Warm supermarket bread. Mouth-watering hot dogs. Fizzy, sweet soda. Processed and ultra-processed foods (UPFs) are pervasive in American diets. In fact, the U.S. leads the world in UPF consumption, with over 60 percent of our daily caloric intake coming from these manufactured products. Despite their popularity, many people remain unaware of the environmental consequences of these convenient foods.

What exactly sets these processed variants apart from wholesome foods? According to the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA), processed foods are altered from their natural state through processes like canning, dehydrating and heating. Ultra-processed foods are more extreme, consisting mostly of substances and additives extracted from foods, such as fats, starches and preservatives. These products usually bear little resemblance to their original ingredients and are what most people imagine when they think of "processed foods."

Marco Springmann, Senior researcher at the University of Oxford's Environmental Change Institute, explains, "If you processed some food at home, the chances are you expend more energy doing that, as the process isn't as streamlined as a big factory." In other words, preparing minimally processed foods at home may require more energy than industrial production, which relies on highly efficient systems. However, the long-term environmental impact of UPFs expands beyond just energy consumption.

The abrupt rise in UPFs threatens agrobiodiversity, or the variety in animals and plants used in the

farming and food sectors. UPF production increases the demand for a narrow selection of high-yield crops—mainly rice, wheat, and corn—despite the existence of over 7,000 edible plants. This issue is further exacerbated by the widespread use of these limited crop species to feed livestock raised for processed meat production. Reducing agrobiodiversity diminishes the variety of consumable foods; during periods of underproduction or climate unpredictability, this could lead to issues in food security.

UPFs also contribute to environmental degradation through waste production: These products are often packaged in single-use plastics such as wrappers, bottles and containers. Each year, about nine million metric tons of plastic enter the oceans, where they can persist for centuries, breaking down into harmful microplastics that contaminate ecosystems.

In addition, UPFs carry a large water footprint, especially soft drinks, which require hundreds of liters of water for production, processing and packaging. They also require vast amounts of land, release greenhouse gases, and lead to eutrophication (the overflow of nutrients in marine settings).

Our eating habits do make a difference: the food supply chain leads to 26 percent of human-caused greenhouse gas emissions globally. But together, whether researching planet-healthy food alternatives or reducing reliance on single-use plastics, being environmentally conscious is a powerful step in deciding our planet's future.

Wear A Life Jacket And Always Boat Sober

The Coast Guard Auxiliary, Coeur d'Alene Flotilla 84



The Coast Guard Auxiliary, Coeur d'Alene Flotilla 84, in conjunction with the Safe Boating Campaign, a worldwide effort focused on responsible boating, reminds boaters to boat sober this Fourth of July. Boating under the influence, or BUI, is the leading contributing factor in recreational boater deaths, according to the U.S. Coast Guard.

Per Peg Phillips, executive director of the National Safe Boating Council, “The Fourth of July has unfortunately become known for drinking, boating, and deadly incidents. Never boat under the influence of alcohol or drugs – this is a danger to the boat operator, passengers, and others enjoying the water.”

The side effects of alcohol or drug use, such as impaired judgment, reduced balance, and poor coordination, are magnified while boating, due to environmental conditions from the sun, wind, and boat motion. Impaired boaters can easily fall overboard, swim near the propeller, lean over the side, or stand up in small boats causing the boat to capsize.

The National Association of State Boating Law Administrators, a partner of the Safe Boating Campaign, in collaboration with the U.S. Coast Guard and law enforcement agencies nationwide, is coordinating the annual Operation Dry Water three-day weekend. This heightened BUI awareness and enforcement effort will be held from July 1 to July 3 in every U.S. state and territory.

The Safe Boating Campaign also encourages boaters this Fourth of July to check that all equipment is present and working, share the details of their trip with someone trusted before leaving the dock, wear a U.S. Coast Guard approved life jacket, use an engine cut-off switch, watch the weather, and follow all navigation rules.

Wear a life jacket and always boat sober!

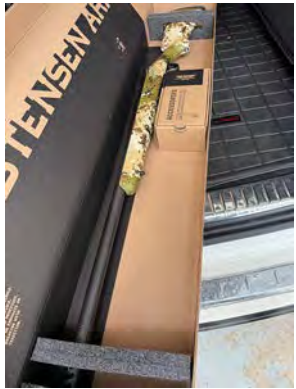

Found A Bat In Your Home? Don't Panic, Here Are Steps To Protect Yourself And The Bat

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game —



What to do if you encounter a bat in or near your home

Bats are found throughout Idaho, and homeowners may occasionally encounter bats in their houses, garages, outbuildings, or other structures. This can be a more common occurrence if you're in prime bat habitat near bodies of water, such as lakes, reservoirs, ponds, and rivers, or in forested or agricultural areas.

If you or your pets have any direct contact with a bat, especially if bitten or scratched, or you find a bat in the same room as someone who may be unaware of a bite (e.g., a sleeping person or a child), contact your healthcare provider, or local Public Health District for a risk assessment. They may direct you to safely capture the bat as described below and bring it in for rabies testing.

In most cases, bat encounters are harmless

situations. If you find a bat outdoors roosting (hanging upside down) on a wall or any other surface, such as trees, shrubs, garden plants, firewood piles, under a patio umbrella, etc., leave the bat alone and keep people and pets away from it. The bat is likely roosting for the day and will soon move on.

In other situations, you—or someone else—may have to intervene. Here's what to do if you encounter a bat indoors, or in other closed spaces:

- Never capture or handle a bat with bare hands.
- If you find a bat inside your home and are certain you have NOT had a rabies exposure (any direct contact through breaks in the skin such as a bite or scratch), safely capture and release the bat outside. Wear gloves (preferably leather or other heavy material), and don't let the bat contact any bare skin (wear long pants and sleeves). You can place a box or other container over the bat, then slide a thin piece of cardboard under the box to capture than bat without touching it. Learn more at batworld.org/what-to-do-if-youve-found-a-bat.
- If you have a bat colony in your attic, garage or outbuilding, contact Idaho Fish and Game regional offices for information on safely evicting and excluding them. Unless there's a public health threat (bats entering living spaces), the best time to evict bats from structures is early September to mid-October after bat maternity season and before hibernation.
- If you find a bat outdoors on the ground that appears weak, sick, or injured and is unable to fly, ensure the bat is separated from people, pets, and natural predators, then call a Fish and Game regional office for guidance.
- If you find five or more dead or sick bats at the same time in the same location, contact Fish and Game for guidance.
- Lastly, ensure your pets are vaccinated for rabies.

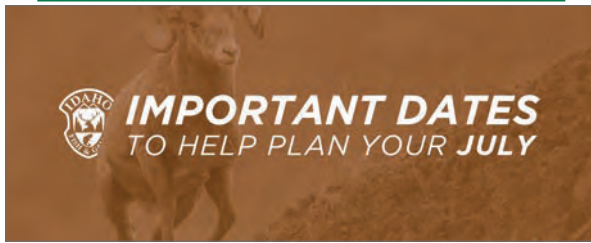

- **7/15** – ON SALE: Leftover fall turkey controlled hunt tags (if available)
- **7/15** – Fish and Game Commission Meeting in Jerome: Public Hearing
- **7/16** – Fish and Game Commission Meeting in Jerome: Business Meeting
- **7/21** – DEADLINE: Enter bighorn sheep raffle
- **7/31** – DEADLINE: Exchange general season deer and elk tags

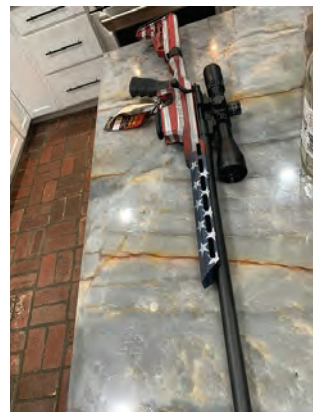

Moments in time

THE HISTORY CHANNEL

On July 6, 1900, Warren Earp, youngest of the famous gunfighting Earp brothers, was murdered at the Headquarters Saloon in Willcox, Arizona, by John Boyett. Reportedly, Warren had imbibed too much alcohol and begun abusing some of the customers. While Boyett was tried for murder, he was declared innocent on the grounds of acting in self-defense.

On July 7, 1456, Joan of Arc's conviction for heresy was overturned at an appeal proceeding held at the archbishop's palace in Rouen, France. Sadly, she had been burned at the stake 25 years earlier.

On July 8, 1853, Commodore Matthew Calbraith Perry sailed into Japan's Tokyo Bay with a squadron of four American vessels. At first officials refused to speak with him, but under threat of attack they accepted letters from President Millard Fillmore, making the U.S. the first Western nation to establish relations with Japan since the country declared itself closed to foreigners two centuries previously.

On July 9, 1948, baseball star Satchel Paige made his Major League debut with the Cleveland Indians, becoming, at age 42, the oldest rookie in the sport's history. As he notably remarked, "Age is a question of mind over matter. If you don't mind, it don't matter."

On July 10, 1962, the United States Patent Office issued Swedish engineer Nils Bohlin a patent for his three-point automobile safety belt. Consisting of two straps joined at the hip level and fastened into a single anchor point, it reduced injuries by holding both the upper and lower body and decreasing the impact of the swift deceleration that occurred in a crash.

On July 11, 1978, a truck carrying liquid gas crashed into a wall at a campsite of vacationers in San Carlos de la Rapita, Spain, resulting in an explosion that killed more than 200 people, with others suffering severe burns. The crash's cause was unknown, though some witnesses reported seeing a fire on the vehicle prior to the accident.

On July 12, 1990, two days after Mikhail Gorbachev was re-elected head of the Soviet Communist Party, Boris Yeltsin, president of the Republic of Russia, announced his resignation from the party.

Walleye are a Bad Match for Idaho Waters

F&G asks anglers to help stop their expansion

— Idaho Fish and Game —



Walleye are typically a bad match for Idaho because they are native to large Midwestern lakes that have nearly unlimited schools of minnows, shiners and other baitfish that walleye live on. Those large baitfish populations are unavailable in most Idaho waters, which means walleye consume game fish to survive, and most Idaho anglers prefer to catch those other game fish.

That's why Idaho Fish and Game is extremely selective where it manages for walleye fishing, which is limited to: Salmon Falls Creek Reservoir, Onieda Reservoir, and Oakley Reservoir.

Fish and Game biologists ask anglers to keep, kill and consume all walleye they catch outside of those waters. People should also never move walleye between bodies of water, and they should report anyone who does. It's not only illegal, it can be very harmful to other fish populations.



Walleye keep popping up in unexpected places

Walleye are being discovered in waters where they are unwanted, and were illegally released, which rarely benefits anyone. Some anglers have accused Fish and Game biologists of being biased against walleye, but that's not the case.

Fish and Game has spent decades surveying anglers for their fishing preferences, and the department tries to provide diverse fishing in suitable waters. In most places, biologists aren't managing a single species, they're managing multiple species that must be compatible with each other.

Any given water can only support so many fish and different species. It's common for these varied game fish to feed on each other, but there has to be a reasonable balance between species so they can coexist and provide diverse fishing opportunities.

Numerous waters in the Northwest and Rocky Mountain states have shown a fairly predictable pattern after walleye populations become established. At best, another fishing opportunity is temporarily added. But most often, limited walleye fishing displaces other valued and established fish populations and fishing opportunities. The walleye fishery is

unlikely to be sustainable because they have a history of eating themselves out of house and home.

Biologists are currently experiencing that in two of the three Idaho waters managed for walleye. Walleye are plentiful, but small and skinny, because there's not enough prey fish remaining for them to get bigger.

Part of the problem is trying to hit an elusive sweet spot where there is an abundant enough walleye population to provide good fishing, and enough bigger fish to make it interesting.

When the walleye population is too big and the average size fish is too small, it's hard to bring it back into balance. It's difficult to reduce the walleye population and/or increase the forage base because there are so many hungry, predatory fish, and they can be prolific spawners.

"We will continue to try to improve these few reservoirs where we manage for walleye," State Fisheries Manager Joe Kozfkay said. "But if someone wants a glimpse into the future where an illegally stocked walleye population gets established, this is most likely what it will look like."

Walleye pose another challenge for salmon and steelhead

Salmon and steelhead have had a tough few years for a variety of reasons, and walleye are adding to their challenges.

"Salmon and steelhead did not evolve with these nonnative predators, and salmon and steelhead can be especially vulnerable to predation," Fish and Game anadromous fish biologist Marika Dobos said. "As walleye expand their range and abundance in Idaho's rivers, more hungry mouths will be eating salmon, steelhead and other native species, particularly the young fish that are trying to grow large enough to go to the ocean."

Walleye have long existed in the Columbia River, and they're steadily moving upstream into the Snake, Clearwater and Salmon rivers. Monitoring at Lower Granite Dam near Lewiston is showing more walleye passing through the dam each year, and walleye have been caught as far upstream as Riggin. Learn more about the threat walleye pose to salmon and steelhead rivers.

"We are still interested in monitoring these rivers, especially where we have low or no sightings to see if their presence continues to expand," Dobos said. "This is especially concerning in areas where hatchery salmon and steelhead are released and mainstem river areas where wild juvenile salmonids rear. Predatory fish like walleye can key in on these areas and consume a lot of fish. We want to know what the potential risks are on these important salmonids."

F&G isn't taking away, it's giving anglers what they want

Idahoans have repeatedly told Fish and Game biologists their preference is abundant trout populations, along with bass, panfish, salmon and steelhead, and catfish. Only a slim minority of anglers have asked for more walleye fishing opportunities in the state.

Biologists know they have to make tough choices because adding a predatory fish like walleye will come at the expense of other fish that Idaho anglers prefer.

That's why fish managers want to limit walleye populations and ask anglers catching walleye outside of the three designated reservoirs to keep all they catch and never move them around.

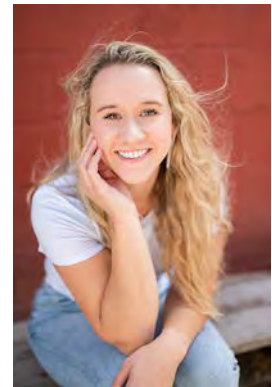

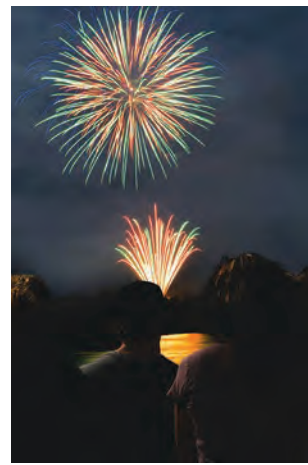

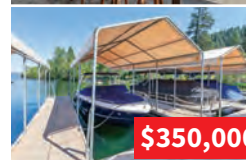

Questions & Answers About Our Environment

Dear EarthTalk: How has the huge footprint of humanity forced other animal and plant species to evolve differently than they might otherwise have without people around?

- Lois V., New York, NY

Humans have profoundly altered the planet, driving plants and animals to adapt in ways they never would have without our impact. Through activities like habitat destruction, pollution, climate change, hunting and introducing invasive species, humans have significantly accelerated evolutionary changes, transforming ecosystems in dramatic and often unpredictable ways.

One example is the rise of tuskless elephants. Decades of ivory poaching have created intense pressure on African elephants. In regions of heavy poaching, up to half of female elephants are now tuskless, an adaptation showing how humans can profoundly alter the genetic makeup of another animal population.

Urban environments have also become hotspots for what some researchers consider accelerated evolution. During the Industrial Revolution, peppered moths in England evolved darker colors to blend into soot-covered trees. Today, insects and city-dwelling birds are similarly adapting to human-made conditions. Pigeons have modified their eating habits to thrive on discarded food, and some mosquito species have adapted to reproduce in tiny water collections present in city environments. These alterations illustrate the adaptability of species adjusting to environments changed by humans.

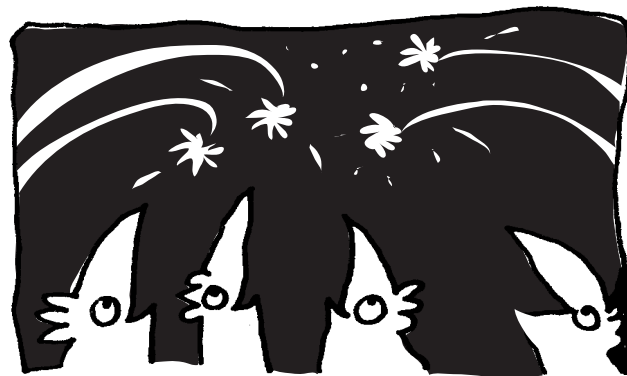
Chemical resistance is another area where human influence is clear. The widespread use of pesticides and antibiotics has driven the evolution of resistant pests and bacteria. Farmers battle "superweeds" that can survive herbicides, and healthcare providers face rising concerns over antibiotic-resistant bacteria.

Climate change has further expedited evolutionary shifts. Animals are altering their migration patterns and breeding seasons to adapt to warmer temperatures. Birds like the great tit in Europe are laying eggs earlier in the spring to align with the availability of insects. Similarly, marine species are moving to cooler waters. This disrupts ecosystems and fisheries

These adaptations showcase the nature's incredible resilience, despite some notable drawbacks. Rapid evolution can lead to reduced biodiversity, as species unable to adapt face extinction. Ecosystem imbalances arise as invasive species prevail, pushing out native organisms. According to the National Wildlife Federation, human activities are driving an unprecedented rate of evolutionary change. To help, choose sustainably sourced products, reduce waste, and support conservation efforts to protect habitats and species. Advocacy for policies that address climate change and pollution is also key.

7 Adoption Tips

Follow the shelter's guidelines and keep these tips in mind when adopting:

1. There's an application process. Read through it and understand it. The guidelines are for the

safety of the animals, the employees, and you.

2. Ask questions. It's important there's an understanding between you and the shelter. Most shelters have volunteers and paid employees. However, they work on a very tight budget. Please don't expect any special accommodations.
3. A good shelter will place the interests of the animal first. They want the cat to have a successful placement. Some animals have anxiety while others get along with anyone and every type of animal.
4. Consider the size of your home and where you live - an apartment or house.
5. Who lives with you? That includes people and pets - does everyone get along and does anyone have allergies?
6. How much time do you have for a pet?
7. So you've spotted the kitten for you. Be sure to make several visits to the shelter. Play with the kitten. Spend time grooming them. See how the kitten reacts to other cats. Learn the kitten's behavior.

Maybe Fuzzy Bear has health issues or doesn't get along with children. Perhaps another kitten gets along better with dogs. All these factors will be considered on your application.

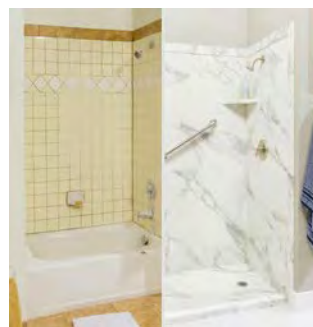
