Training Bird Dogs Using Birds Not Raised In Captivity – Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks – Training season with wild birds on public lands

License Required For

begins Aug. 1 for residents

HELENA –Anyone training bird dogs using game birds not raised in captivity needs to hold a bird dog training license, whether on private or public land. If you are training dogs with captive-reared birds, a license is not required.

These licenses can be purchased online through the FWP Online License Service, any FWP regional office or any license provider. The license is \$5 for residents ages 18 and over and \$10 for nonresidents 18 and over. For residents and nonresidents ages 12 to 17, the license is free.

Bird dog training season with wild birds on public lands begins Aug. 1 for residents and Aug. 15 for nonresidents and ends March 31, 2024.

The license is a new requirement that came from the 2023 Legislature. While the license requirement is not included in the printed 2023 Upland Game Bird Regulations booklet, it is included in the online version. Please contact your nearest FWP office for questions about dog training relative to this new license requirement.

For those commercially training bird dogs on state trust land, a special recreational use license (SRUL) is required from the Department of Natural Resources and Conservation.







Snorkel Surveys Help Guide Habitat Improvement Projects In The Potlatch River Basin

Steelhead parr density data collected during snorkel surveys help fisheries and other resource managers make informed decisions to enhance their survival with habitat improvement projects.

The Potlatch River is located in northwestern Idaho. Its seasonal flows can range from a trickle in some reaches during the summer to a raging torrent in the spring.

This river contains adult and juvenile steelhead trout. Adults enter the Potlatch to spawn during late winter and early spring. They will either die or move out soon after. Their young will remain to rear in the Potlatch and its tributaries.

Idaho Fish and Game, private land owners, and other cooperators are improving steelhead trout habitat. One method involves introducing large woody debris into the stream channel to increase habitat complexity. The wood provides cover for the fish. It also helps recharge the floodplain. These treatments should generate a fish response that can be detected with appropriate monitoring.

IDFG is especially interested in juvenile steel-head, known as parr. Snorkel surveys are one method to monitor the parrs' response to the treatments. Crews from across Idaho gather on the Potlatch each June to conduct surveys. The number of surveys each year is variable and depends upon the scale of the information needed. During 2023, crews will survey 160 sites scattered across the Potlatch River basin. They will record data about the fish and the stream environment.

Similar snorkel surveys will be conducted across Idaho this summer to benefit wild salmon and steelhead trout. They will help guide restoration actions such as identifying the need for large woody debris placement where cover is scarce or for managing water where stream channels go dry.

National Aviation Day August 19th

— National Day Calendar —



National Aviation Day on August 19th recognizes the pioneers of human flight.

For centuries, humans have been fascinated by flight. In ancient China, kites few to investigate the weather. Inventors such as Leonardo da Vinci developed many ideas about flight, too. Gliders and balloons lifted humans into the sky, but none of the inventions gave a person control of where they flew.

Before Powered Flight

The physics of flight and propulsion play key roles in who became pioneers. George Cayley used aerodynamics while designing fixed-wing aircraft. His designs would later inspire Orville and Wilbur Wright.

Since propulsion is one of the primary requirements to lift a human into the sky for flight, it would make sense that an engine could provide that power. Samuel Langley, an astronomer from Boston, designed a steam-powered model called an aerodrome in 1891. It flew for 3/4ths of a mile.

After receiving a grant to build a full-sized aerodrome, Langley's first test crashed. He never made another attempt.

First Powered Flight

In a bicycle shop in Dayton, Ohio, two inventors eagerly began testing their ideas about flight. Brothers, Orville and Wilbur Wright, had studied Octave Chanute's 1894 Progress in Flying Machines. The brothers set to work testing their designs, first with gliders. Eventually, they sought to add an engine.

Two American inventors and aviation pioneers, the Wright brothers are credited with inventing and building the world's first successful airplane and making the first controlled powered and sustained heavier-than-air human flight on December 17, 1903.

In 1902, Charles Edward Taylor joined their team in pursuit of powered flight. Since automobile companies couldn't supply an engine light enough and powerful enough, they would have to build it. Taylor, a machinist, set to work building the 12-horsepower engine. It took Taylor 6 weeks to build the engine.

After completing the design in September of 1903, the Wrights returned to Kitty Hawk, North Carolina. Just months before, they had successfully tested their glider. However, setbacks and weather postponed the powered flight.

It wasn't until mid-December that the brothers finally felt all was in order. After flipping a coin to decide who would pilot the machine, Wilbur climbed aboard. The first attempt failed, only flying 3.5 seconds. However, the brothers learned what worked.

The next attempt on December 17, 1903, Orville

took the controls. After launching, the machine flew for 120 feet. Man flew.

Since that day, aviation exploded into the skies. Its applications became immediately apparent to the military. The Wrights consulted with the Army for several years after their success.

Now that humans could fly, they set new challenges – flying across oceans, around the world, and into space.

NATIONAL AVIATION DAY HISTORY

In 1939, President Franklin Delano Roosevelt established National Aviation Day by presidential proclamation designating the anniversary of Orville Wright's birthday for the observance. Born August 19, 1871, Orville Wright was still living when President Roosevelt issued the proclamation. Orville Wright continued living for nine more years until his death in 1948.

Proclamation USC 36:I:A:1:118 allows the sitting United States President to proclaim August 19th as National Aviation Day each year. If desired, the President's proclamation may direct all federal buildings and installations to fly the U.S. flag on that day. The President may encourage citizens to observe the day with activities that promote interest in aviation.

Aviation FAQ

Q. What kind of jobs are in aviation?

A. Aviation is filled with opportunities and pilots aren't the only ones who can benefit. The field requires engineers, mechanics, safety specialists, air traffic controllers, airport managers, logistical engineers, and of course, pilots.

Q. Do pilots have to have 20/20 vision?

A. According to the Federal Aviation Administration, first-class and second-class pilots require 20/20 distance-vision with or without correction. A third-class private pilot requires 20/40 distance-vision or better with or without correction. All pilots require 20/40 near-vision or better with or without correction.

Q. Is there an age requirement to get a pilot's license?

A. Yes. Airplane pilots must be at least 16-years-old to begin flying lessons.







Statewide Trout Stocking Highlights For August 2023 Magic Valley, Southeast, Upper Snake and Salmon

Approximately 90,000 catchable-sized rainbow trout will be stocked throughout the state this August

Many of Idaho's lakes and ponds are soon going to be bolstered with Idaho Fish and Game stocking roughly 90,000 catchable-sized rainbow trout this August. Wondering if the stocking trucks are going to be backing up to your favorite fishing hole? We asked our Fish and Game hatchery staff to boil down some of the most notable stocking highlights coming to your local fishery this month.

Many of these fisheries highlighted below are easy to access, family-friendly fishing destinations. All you need to get started is a fishing license and some basic tackle. Annual adult fishing licenses cost around \$30, junior licenses (ages 14-17) cost \$16, and youth (under 14) fish for free. Go to Fish and Game's online vendor to buy a license.

Fishing for stocked rainbow trout can be a great way to introduce budding anglers to the sport by using simple, inexpensive setups like worm/marshmallow combinations or commercial baits like PowerBait® or Crave, placed either near the bottom or below a bobber; and as anglers know, there's nothing quite like a trout fighting on the end of your line. The Learn to Fish webpage offers diagrams for basic bait rigs at https://idfg.idaho.gov/fish/learn-to

Most Idaho waters are open to fishing year-round, but some may have slightly different rules. Be sure to pick up a 2022-2024 Idaho Fishing Seasons and Rules Booklet - available at any Idaho Fish and Game office or most sporting goods stores statewide- or download online to look at season dates, special regulations and bag limits at https://idfg.idaho.gov/rules/fish

Gavers Lagoon – 1,425 rainbow trout: This pond near the Hayspur Campground is a high-yield fishery. We encourage harvest, but please harvest what you need and consider leaving a few for your fellow anglers.

Hagerman Wildlife Management Area provides a variety of fishing opportunities and open space to explore.

Lake Cleveland - 3,000 rainbow trout: This is a very popular summer recreation area. The lake sits at over 8,000 feet in elevation below Mount Harrison. There are numerous campsites located around the lake.

Little Trinity Lake - 475 rainbow trout: Located north of Big Trinity Lake, there is a USFS picnic area available for use. Trailer traffic is not recommended.

South Fork Boise River – 2,900 rainbow trout

Fish will be stocked as follows:

- Featherville to Shake Creek 950
- Shake Creek to Skeleton Creek 1,000
- Pine to Grouse Creek 950

Southeast Region

Cub River - 500 rainbow trout: Fish are stocked in and around the Willow Flat Campground (50+ sites available), so make a fishing trip here an overnight adventure.

Montpelier Creek - 1,000 rainbow trout: Enjoy good creek fishing and a variety of camping options.



THE HISTORY CHANNEL

- On Aug. 28, 1789, William Herschel, court astronomer under England's King George III, discovered Enceladus, one of Saturn's innermost moons, while using his new 40-foot telescope for the first time. Enceladus reflects almost 100% of the sunlight that strikes it and has at least five different types of terrain.
- On Aug. 29, 1998, a strike by 6,200 Northwest Airlines pilots seeking a 15% pay raise left 70,000 frustrated passengers high and dry around the U.S. The pilots had been in contract negotiations for more than two years, and an agreement was finally reached on Sept. 10 after the strike had cost the airline \$26 million per day.
- On Aug. 30, 1951, Sgt. John R. Rice, a decorated World War II veteran and part-Native American soldier killed in the Korean War, was refused burial in Sioux City, Iowa's Memorial Park Cemetery on the grounds of his ethnicity. After hearing the news at a press conference, President Harry Truman authorized a telegram to Rice's widow, Evelyn, offering her a plot in Arlington National Cemetery, which she accepted.
- On Aug. 31, 1888, 43-year-old Mary Ann "Polly" Nichols, a prostitute from London's East End and married but separated mother of five, was found brutally murdered near Whitechapel Road, becoming the first known victim of serial killer Jack the Ripper.
- On Sept. 1, 2013, new internet restrictions imposed by the Vietnamese government prohibited the country's users from discussing current affairs, with social media and other sites, including blogs, limited to sharing personal information but not news stories. The law was criticized by both internet companies and a number of human rights groups.
- On Sept. 2, 1969, the original "Star Trek" TV series aired its final episode after running for just three years. While it never rose higher than No. 52 in the ratings, it remains a beloved cult classic, eventually generating movies and other series
- On Sept. 3, 1908, J.M. Barrie's play "What Every Woman Knows" debuted at London's Duke of York's Theatre. Written prior to the women's suffrage movement, the show's theme suggested that "every woman knows" she's really the invisible power behind the success of the men in her life.

What Is A Redd? Salmon Keep Cleaning Out A 'Nest' For Spawning

Chinook reshape river bottoms to better harbor their eggs

That's right- redd with two Ds. Another funny word that fish biologists use. In this blog post, I am talking about the nest where salmon, trout and steelhead lay their eggs in the gravel of a stream.

Every August and September in central Idaho's high country, the returning salmon start cleaning their spawning streams. The word "redd" comes from the Scottish dialect, meaning "to put in order, to tidy, or to clear." Female salmon do exactly that to prepare a good place to put their eggs.

When it comes time to spawn, female salmon will look for a spot with good gravel. "Good" gravel is free of mud and silt that can smother eggs and has the right sizes and shapes to incubate eggs and keep them safe, plus the right water speed to supply oxygen and keep eggs cool. Salmon will first dig a test pit with a few strokes of their tails, then slightly back over it. The theory is they are feeling the flow of water through the gravel with their fins because eggs need a good supply of clean, aerated water to develop properly. If the female likes the spot, they will dig further, excavating a deeper pit.




A salmon redd with the female in front of the cleaned and sorted gravel. Two males are competing behind her.

Male salmon don't do any digging, but compete amongst each other, with the largest trying to drive off the other males. The salmon then spawn as the female expels her eggs into the pit. A properly dug pit holds the eggs and milt together, ensuring good fertilization. The female salmon moves just upstream and digs again, covering the eggs and starting the next egg pocket. As she digs, the current flushes dirt, debris, and smaller gravels downstream. After all the digging and sweeping, the redd looks like a clean spot in the stream with neatly sorted gravel. This keeps the egg pocket clean and creates a hump in the water, which flows through the gravel and into the egg pocket.

The female salmon will keep digging and cleaning the gravel until she has spawned all her eggs. Then she moves to the sides, digging trenches to focus the stream flow toward the redd and pushing more gravel on top of the egg pockets to protect their precious content. A female salmon will stay with her redd to put on the finishing touches and protect it from other females who might want to use the same spot. Eventually, she will drift downstream and die, while her eggs develop and hatch during the fall and winter, snug within their redd. In the spring, the young emerge through gaps in the gravel to start their life cycle again.

Can I Pet That K-9?

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: My parents and I were marching in a demonstration, and we passed two police officers who each had a police dog. I love German Shepherds and I wanted to pet one of their dogs, but my parents wouldn't let me. Why was it wrong to pet them? — David, via email

DEAR DAVID: K-9 police dogs, just like service animals, are working dogs that are trained to accomplish complicated tasks. When they're at work, they should not be disturbed, even with a well-meaning pat.

A K-9 may be trained to help apprehend suspects, or to detect illegal substances, or to perform search and rescue. They are large, energetic dogs, and though they're well-trained, they can be aggressive.

When a neighbor and their dog approach on the sidewalk, the polite way to interact is to ask permission to pet the dog. When K-9s and service animals are working, the best way to help them is to leave them be. Petting a service dog can confuse it or cause it to lose focus on the task it's supposed to be doing. Petting a K-9 trained in apprehension can get your fingers nipped, or worse.

If, and only if, a service dog's owner or a K-9's handler invites you to approach, should you do so.

Police departments sometimes put on demonstrations or other events with their K-9s to meet the public. If you want to meet the dogs and ask questions of the police officers about what their workday is like, these are good opportunities to do so. When fairs and other public events start up again, find out if and where any such demonstrations are taking place.





Patient With Osteoarthritis Develops Hives After Taking Ibuprofen

DEAR DR. ROACH: I took ibuprofen for my osteoarthritis, but developed hives. Does this mean I'm allergic to all NSAIDs? What other therapeutic options do I have? - J.B.

ANSWER: Anti-inflammatory drugs can have many allergic and allergic-type reactions, and ibuprofen is probably the most likely of all to do so.

For people with mild reactions (such as hives that go away) without swelling or shortness of breath, I recommend avoiding ibuprofen and similar medicines, such as naproxen (Aleve and Naprosyn, among others), as well as any other medication ending in "-profen," such as ketoprofen or flurbiprofen.

Aspirin is safe for most people as far as allergies go, although it is a little more likely to cause side effects at higher doses. The prescription medicines meloxicam (Mobic), nabumetone (Relafen) and celecoxib (Celebrex) are among the least likely to have any cross reaction with ibuprofen. Anti-inflammatory gels like diclofenac cream (Voltaren) should also be safe for topical use.

People with more serious reactions need a referral to an allergist, who may consider desensitization.

DEAR DR. ROACH: We had to get a router attached to our computer to get Wi-Fi for our house. Is there any health risk by sitting or sleeping near the router from the radio waves it puts out? – B.R.

ANSWER: The energy output from a typical

Wi-Fi router is about 10 watts, and the energy is the low-frequency, non-ionizing type. Very powerful radio sources, such as AM radio towers, can actually cause injury by heating tissues, but these have a power output in the thousands, or even tens of thousands, of watts. There has never been evidence of health effects on humans by low-output radio waves, such as the waves from Wi-Fi or cellphones.

DEAR DR. ROACH: One time, I drove a friend to the airport for an international flight. We were running late, and she feared missing the flight. My friend did not yell or even say much, but she got so stressed that her lips turned blue. And I mean both lips turned a deep, dark blue - nearly black.

That scared me then and still does now. I don't think that's normal. What could that have been, and could she possibly be in danger if she gets stressed like that again? - A.F.

ANSWER: Blue discoloration of skin or mucous membranes is called cyanosis. When the lips are affected, it's considered "central" cyanosis. The leading cause of this is low oxygen levels. Why a person would get low oxygen levels due to stress, without any physical activity, is a tough question – and not normal or common.

The first thing that comes to mind is congenital heart disease, the type that allows unoxygenated blood to mix with oxygenated blood. However, having an adult with undiagnosed congenital heart disease is almost unheard of, and it would be likely that she would have many more symptoms. So, it's hard for me to believe it. Many of the other causes are potential emergencies, such as a blood clot in the lung.

Some people, when they get very nervous, breathe very shallowly. It is possible to have oxygen levels drop from this. If she had some mild heart, lung or hemoglobin disease, it could cause the oxygen level to go very low. That's probably my best guess, but I would be happy to hear from readers with other explanations.



FWP To Use Drought Restriction Criteria As In Years Past

— Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks —

HELENA - Last year, the Fish and Wildlife Commission approved an amendment to the "hoot owl" rule that directs fishing restrictions during drought. The amendment allowed Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks to implement restrictions in designated reaches of Montana streams according to the Statewide Fisheries Management Plan.

The Statewide Fisheries Management Plan is scheduled to be finalized later this fall after public review and comment this summer. Given this timeline, hoot owl restrictions this summer will continue to be implemented as they were in past years. Hoot owl restrictions prohibit fishing between 2 p.m. and midnight on drought-impacted streams until conditions improve. There are four criteria FWP biologists consider for setting hoot owl restrictions:

- · species of interest are present in significant number
- temperature criteria have been met
- · fishing pressure is high
- · stream flow conditions

These restrictions are designed to protect fish that become more susceptible to stress, disease and mortality when low and warm water condi-

Anglers can help reduce stress for fish by following these practices when catching and releasing fish, though fish mortality may still occur:

- · fish during the coolest times of day, where permitted
- land the fish quickly
- keep the fish in water as much as possible
- · remove the hook gently; using artificial lures with single and barbless hooks can make hook removal faster and easier
- let the fish recover before gently releasing it

Look at this device with toothed wheels and a hand crank that sold for \$266 at Conestoga Auction Company in Pennsylvania. Is it a kitchen gadget – perhaps a fruit or vegetable peeler? Some kind of grinder or chopper? In fact, it's a mechanical rope twister.

In the early 1900s, farmers made their own rope. Most people buy it ready-made today. The buyer probably intended to keep this rope twister as an antique instead of using it as a tool. But someone crafty, curious or very dedicated to "do-it-yourself" can buy modern, usable rope twisters or kits online.

I bought a vase shaped like a goose at a garage sale 20 years ago for 25 cents. It's about 12 inches tall and the back is open like a vase. It's marked "HB Quimper." It looks hand painted. What can you tell me about it and what, if anything, is it worth?

A It's worth more than 25 cents. Pottery was made by three different factories in Quimper, France, beginning in the late 17th century. Pierre Bousquet founded the first factory in 1708. It became the HB Factory (Hubaudiere-Bousquet) in 1782, after Antoine de la Hubaudiere became the factory manager. HB merged with two other factories in 1968. After more changes in ownership, the factory became Henriot-Quimper in 2011. Variations of the HB Quimper mark were used from 1895 to 1984. Your goose vase with an open back is a planter. One sold recently for \$40, although some sellers are asking higher prices.

TIP: Don't use rubber gloves when washing figurines with protruding arms and legs. The gloves may snag and cause damage.

Waste Bowls

I saw a beautiful antique Chinese porcelain bowl at an auction. It was blue and white with painted dragons, and it had an unusual shape -- rounded with a flared rim. The description called it a "zhadou," but did not say what that meant.

A zhadou is a bowl for discarding used tea leaves and other table scraps. They usually have a globular body, shoulders, a flared rim and a short foot. The shape resembles a squat vase. They are often porcelain, but some are made from pottery or cloisonne. Some auctions may list them as spittoons. In the early 20th century, the word "zhadou" was translated into English as "leys jar" from a Dutch term. Now, it is usually translated as "waste bowl" or "slop jar," but these are not the same thing.

European and American waste bowls, often part of 19th century silver or porcelain tea sets, are shaped like conventional bowls with straight sides and a round base. Some may be more elaborate, with features like a pedestal base, flared rim or side handles. Slop jars are not part of a table setting. They usually have handles and often have lids. They are used in a bathroom.
