

Innovia Foundation has opened a Wildfire Emergency Response Fund to support nonprofit organizations, businesses and community organizations working to meet the needs of those impacted by current wildfires in the region.

Antique Signs

With its simple shapes, copper frame and red glass panels, this might look like a hanging sculpture in a modern abstract style. It's really an optician's trade sign from the late 19th century.

Antique signs, advertising and medical paraphernalia are popular collectibles. Some collectors seek them out for their historical significance or subject matter. Others consider them works of art. Signs that sell as folk art tend to bring higher prices at auction.

This one sold for \$1,625 at Cowan's Auctions for more than twice the estimated value! The buyer might have had an interest in optometry or simply liked the look of the piece.

My husband and I were employees of the Borden Milk plant in Youngstown, Ohio, in the 1970s. We have an 8-ounce drinking cup with the "Elsie the Cow" logo on the cup. The cup is white, and the lettering is blue. We also have a 12-ounce drinking glass and eight 8-ounce glasses with the Elsie logo. Are these collectible? What are they worth?

The Borden company has been in business for more than 160 years. Gail Borden and his partner started the company after Borden was granted a patent for his process for condensing milk in 1856. The company was named the New York Condensed Milk Company until 1919, when it became the Borden Company. It was the world's largest dairy operator by the late 1980s. Income fell in the '90s, and the company was sold in 1995. It was sold again in 2009, and the name became Borden Dairy. Elsie the Cow first appeared in ads in 1936. Her image was also used on milk bottle caps. The first live cow dubbed "Elsie" appeared in Borden's exhibit at the 1939 World's Fair. She outdrew every other exhibit at the Fair. Elsie's image has appeared on bottles, glasses, cups, clocks, lamps, figurines, playing cards and many other items. Glasses and cups sell for about \$7 to \$10. You will find cups offered for sale at higher asking prices, but they often sell for \$10 or less.



'Hip Hold' Is No Way to Stretch Your Dog

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: My wife likes to pick up our dog's hind legs to help him stretch; that is, she holds Cheerio by the hips so his hind legs are up off the ground while he stands on his front legs. I thought I read once that this is not good and strains the dog's joints or back or something. Your advice would be appreciated. -- Zina J.

DEAR ZINA: The "hip hold" is a safety grip to pull your dog away from a fight with another dog. It's not a hold that should be forced or held for long periods.

Stretching should be performed by owners when the dog's joints are not weighted -- meaning the dog should not be standing or leaning on the leg being stretched. Holding Cheerio up by his hindquarters and forcing him to brace on his front legs puts him at greater risk for injury. It can cause great pain in older dogs with arthritis.

If your wife would truly like to keep Cheerio's joints healthy and improve his overall circulation and well-being, there are some great safe stretching methods, and safe massage techniques as well. Here's a YouTube video of safe dog stretching exercises by a veterinary therapist: tinyurl. com/4ay7sfjc. Notice that at no point does the therapist stretch a joint that the dog is standing on -- they are all unweighted stretches.

Dogs also stretch themselves frequently, especially when getting up after a long nap. Don't try to assist their natural stretching -- dogs stretch in a way that's comfortable for them. Therapeutic stretching and massage are designed to help facilitate a dog's natural movement without placing stress on the joints.

If you have more questions about your dog's mobility, talk with the vet at his next checkup.

Most Common Cause Behind Teary Eyes Are Dry Eyes

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am a 74-year-old woman who loves to read the newspaper every morning. I have a problem that's not serious, just annoying. My eyes tear up frequently while I read, causing me to wipe them. After I'm done reading, the problem stops. I see my ophthalmologist every year and have my vision glasses updated as needed. I am not yet a candidate for cataract surgery. Could you enlighten me about a probable cause for this irritating problem? - A.H.G.

ANSWER: By all means, ask your ophthalmologist at your next visit, but the most common cause I see for watery, tearing eyes are ... dry eyes! This apparent paradox is caused by the fact that your eyes have three different fluids.

One of them, called meibum, is a long-lasting, oily material secreted by the meibomian glands, found around the edges of the eyelids near the eyelashes. This covers the eye and prevents fluid from evaporating quickly. Without this fluid, the lacrimal gland (near the temple above each eye) then has to make a lot of its watery secretions, which cause symptoms

Most commonly, the meibomian glands get clogged up by secretions becoming dry. Gently cleansing the eyelash area with warm water and baby shampoo helps many people unclog these glands. Artificial

tears lubricate the eye and will reduce the symptoms of watery eyes (and maybe some eye irritation, too, which you might not have mentioned).

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am about to undergo gallbladder removal due to recurring pain from gallbladder sludge. Should I be taking replacements for the bile salts that I will no longer be able to produce, and if so, what is the best type of replacement? - S.C.

ANSWER: Your liver makes bile salts, which are necessary for fat absorption. The gallbladder doesn't make them at all; it just stores the bile until you eat a meal, at which point the gallbladder contracts and the bile salts are released into the small intestine to help you digest fat. Most bile salts will be reabsorbed later at the end of the small intestine, recirculating them for reuse.

In people without a gallbladder, the liver itself will continuously release bile salts into the small intestine, rather than on an as-needed basis by the gallbladder. Sometimes, the ability of the terminal ileum (the part of the intestine where bile salts are reabsorbed) gets overwhelmed, and bile acids enter the colon, causing diarrhea.


This is very common in the first few weeks after gallbladder surgery, but the small intestine usually 'learns" to absorb more bile salts. The colon also learns to live with bile salts, and the diarrhea mostly goes away. However, some people continue to have diarrhea after surgery, and medication to restrain bile salts (such as cholestyramine) can make a huge difference.

After surgery, avoiding a high-fat diet is prudent for a month or so to minimize the amount of bile needed.

Large Tracts Program Land **Closures Announced Due To Excessive Fire Danger**

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game –

Large Tracts Program partners have announced fire-related closures on some of their lands effective

North Idaho Timber Group, a partner in the Large Tracts Program (idfg.idaho.gov/d7/access/largetracts), just announced a closure of their lands in response to extreme fire danger. The closure is effective Aug. 23, 2023.

The press release below is from North Idaho Timber Group. Additional information will be released as it becomes available.

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE - August 22, 2023

In response to extreme fire danger and strained fire suppression resources in North Idaho, Idaho Fish and Game's corporate partners have implemented fire-related closures or restrictions on private lands enrolled in the Large Tracts Access Program.

The North Idaho Timber Group, which includes Manulife Investment Management Timberland and Agriculture, Molpus Woodlands Group, and Stimson Lumber Company lands in North Idaho, will close all public roads and walk-in access on August 23, 2023, until further notice.

"While this type of restriction is not necessary during most fire seasons, this year is extraordinary in terms of wildfire risk for Idaho and all neighboring western states," Peter Stegner said in a statement on behalf of the North Idaho Timber Group. "This precautionary closure is in the best interests of the community and the environment, and we appreciate everyone's cooperation with this request during these highly unusual times."

According to the contracts between Fish and Game and Large Tracts Program participants, private land managers reserve the right to temporarily close specific lands for management purposes like active forestry operations, high fire danger, or other management needs. When access has to be restricted for a period of time, the lease payments to program participants are adjusted accordingly.

Will Large Tracts Program closures affect access for hunters in the fall?

The only Large Tracts Program closure imminent is for lands under the North Idaho Timber Group umbrella. Of course, that could change as the fire season continues, and hunters and anglers can stay abreast of current restrictions and closures on Large Tracts properties by visiting Fish and Game's Fire Information webpage.

In regard to the North Idaho Timber Group announcement, it is impossible to say at this point in the middle of a volatile fire season when the closure may end. Hunters and anglers need to remember that these are private, working timberlands, and that managers need to consider not only their business assets, but also public safety when making a determination on closures and when they are lifted.

"The situation will be evaluated on an ongoing basis, but we anticipate the closure will last until wetting rains reduce the hazard later in the season," Stegner said in the statement.

Fish and Game resources for fire information

While Fish and Game's Fire Information webpage at idfg.idaho.gov/fire/home is not the official fire information resource for wildfires in Idaho, the agency's communications staff provide it as a tool to help Fish and Game customers in decision making.

To assist in your hunting, angling and outdoor adventures in summer and fall, Idaho Fish and Game will be working with the Forest Service, BLM, IDL and other resource agencies and Wildfire Teams to keep you up to date on fire closures as they are announced.

A number of Fish and Game regions have recently announced various levels of fire restrictions on department-owned property, including Wildlife Management Areas. The restrictions commonly reflect those on neighboring public lands managed by other federal and state agencies. Regional Fish and Game staff have and will continue to post updates on fire restrictions for department-owned lands to the Fire Information Page.

Fish and Game staff are compiling the latest fire activity and closures from InciWeb and making them available as real-time maps (idfg.idaho.gov/ifwis/ maps/realtime/fire/) and downloads on our website. As more information becomes available, this page will be updated.





Walleye Are Spreading Into Idaho

Anglers should keep any walleye they catch in the Snake and Salmon rivers.

Idaho Fish and Game has received more verified reports and pictures from people catching walleye in the Hells Canyon reach of the Snake River and Salmon River in 2023 than in all previous years. It is alarming to receive so many reports of walleye being caught upstream of Lower Granite Dam, and unfortunately there are indicators that more walleye are coming which is not good for salmon and steelhead.

If anglers catch walleye in rivers and streams where there are anadromous fish, do not release them back to the river alive and instead, enjoy a very tasty dinner.

Roughly 80 years ago, walleye were first identified in Lake Roosevelt in Washington through illegal introductions. It is likely that other illegal introductions of walleye in the Columbia River basin occurred and led to their spread in the mainstem Columbia and Snake rivers. Walleye are now established in the Columbia and lower Snake rivers and provide a popular fishery.

Now why would this be a bad thing? Walleye are opportunistic, apex predators that will eat any fish it can get its teeth into. These fish can greatly affect native species, including prized anadromous fish.

The Columbia River ecosystem has changed immensely since Bonneville Dam, the first Columbia River dam, was constructed in 1938. Some of what changed are the fish species that now occupy the large rivers. Walleye, smallmouth bass, channel catfish and even Northern pike now occupy the Columbia River basin and prey on native fish.

Salmon and steelhead did not evolve with these non-native predators and can be especially vulnerable to predation. Another recent change is that the big rivers seem to be warming up for longer periods of time, which can favor expansion of walleye into new areas. An average sized female (16 inches or 1.5 pounds) can produce 57,000 eggs in a year, whereas larger females (greater than 8 pounds) are known to produce over 300,000 eggs in a year! This means if conditions are favorable, walleye abundance in areas they are invading can increase quickly.

Several studies have looked at predation rates of salmonids in the Columbia River reservoirs, and many indicate that consumption rates of salmonids by walleye are similar to native Northern pikeminnow, especially for walleye that range in size between 10-16 inches, because small salmonids are the perfect prey size.

As walleye grow, they will include many other fish species on top of salmonids in their diet. Walleye only add to the many difficulties that salmon and steelhead face, and as they expand their range and abundance in large rivers, more hungry mouths will be eating salmon, steelhead and other native species. This is especially important for wild juvenile salmon and steelhead that often overwinter and rear in large rivers in Idaho before making their journey to the ocean.

The adult fish trap at Lower Granite Dam has been operated and used to monitor salmon and steelhead since the dam's completion in 1975. It wasn't until 2016 when the first walleye was collected at the fish trap. Since then, the number of walleye trapped has increased every year and in 2022, 74 walleye were handled (and lethally sampled) at the Lower Granite fish trap (Data shows increasing numbers of walleye at Lower Granite Dam near Lewiston | Idaho Fish and Game, see article at idfg.idaho.gov/blog/2022/09/ increasing-walleye-abundance-lower-granite-dam).

Many more walleye migrate up the fish ladder than are trapped because the trap operates periodically, and most smaller fish (less than 12 inches) are too small to be trapped. The Corps of Engineers records daily counts of fish at the window, and although they do not publish records of non-target species like walleye, they have indicated that counts have been exponentially increasing the past few years with recent annual estimates in the thousands. This is not good news for people trying to manage for salmon and steelhead and those hoping to catch them in the



Anadromous fisheries contribute billions of dollars annually to local economies, and to some small fishing towns like Riggins they are the bread and butter to the community.




Walleve (25 inches) caught by an angler on the Snake River at the mouth of Rush Creek in Hells Canyon in August *2023.*

This will help us in understanding their current range and size structure.







Bear Activity Is Picking Up, Taking Precautions At Camp And Home Can Help Avoid Problems

Proper food and garbage storage is especially important to avoid conflicts

While it is exciting to see a bear in the wild, it isn't so wonderful to have one in your campsite or trashing your cabin barbecue at midnight.

Most conflicts with bears occur from July through September and are linked to careless handling of food and garbage. With thousands of campers, anglers, hikers, and soon-to-be hunters venturing outdoors, Idaho Fish and Game encourages people that most conflicts can be avoided by being extra mindful of their food and garbage. The same cautions apply to homeowners in bear country.

"Minimize the chances of a bear conflict for yourself and others by securing your food and garbage, basically anything that a bear might find tasty," said Dennis Newman, wildlife manager for Idaho Fish and Game's Salmon Region. "Bears are very opportunistic and once they find a food reward, they will be back for more."

Bears are always on the lookout for food sources. Like most animals, bears are interested in finding the most calories they can for the least amount of work, which can be daunting. Two to four pounds of fat must be stored on a daily basis, which means eating 20,000 calories a day, or the equivalent of 42 hamburgers. However, since up to 90 percent of its diet is vegetation, a black bear will spend up to 20 hours a day foraging for food. The beckoning scents of garbage, backyard barbeques, pet food and other animal feed, compost, and ripe fruit can quickly bring in a foraging bear from miles away. Minimizing tempting odors and easy to reach food for bears is critical.

"If a bear does not find anything to eat at your campsite or near your home, it will likely just move on," Newman noted.

To minimize chances of a bear causing problems, taking simple, preventive measures and using good old fashioned common sense will go a long way towards minimizing bear conflicts. Here are some

Tips around camp:

· Keep a clean camp. Store all food, garbage and even toothpaste, soap, lotions and bug spray in your vehicle or camper. If food storage in a vehicle is not possible, hang in a tree 10 to 15 feet off the ground, at least 100 yards from your campsite. Make sure that the bag is at least 4 feet from the tree trunk. Ideally, campers are encouraged to have a bear-resistant food canister to store their camp groceries.

- · Never cook in or near a tent or keep scented products in a tent.
- · Don't bury food scraps, pour out cooking grease, or leave anything that might be tasty on the ground or in the fire pit. Also, store barbecue grills or other smelly cooking gear inside your vehicle or within a sealed bear resistant container.
- · Never leave food outside or in an unattended or improperly stored cooler. A cooler is not bear-resistant. Remember that pet food can also attract bears to your campsite. Be sure and secure any pet food after feeding your pet.



Tips around home/cabin:

- · Keep garbage in bear-resistant containers or in a closed building.
- · Empty and remove bird feeders during the summer months when songbirds are able to forage on food provided by nature.
- · Clean up fruit that has fallen in your yard. Rotting fruit will attract bears as well as raccoons and skunks.
- · Feed pets inside or during daylight hours; don't leave pet food or food scraps outside of your home or camp, as it can attract bears, raccoons and skunks.
- · Store horse and livestock grains inside closed
- · Keep barbeque grills stored in closed buildings.

Black bears are typically shy and unaggressive, but the possibility of a bold bear near your campsite may increase if a bear loses its fear of humans because it has learned to associate food with campsites. These bears can become nuisances or even threats. In addition, live trapping and moving a bear does not always solve the problem, and bears conditioned to human food leaves Fish and Game officials with no choice but put the bear down to ensure public safety.

If a bear visits your campsite, make as much noise as possible such as yelling, waving your arms, or banging on pots and pans to quickly scare the bear away. Be sure to give the bear room to easily escape the area.







THE HISTORY CHANNEL

- On Sept. 4, 1925, laws were enacted to ensure that farm wagons would be equipped with lights for traveling at night, due to an increase in the number of accidents the wagons were involved in during peak corn-packing season.
- On Sept. 5, 1969, U.S. Army platoon leader Lt. William Calley was charged with premeditated murder in the death of 109 Vietnamese civilians at My Lai, where Calley had led his men in a massacre that included women and children. Though hushed up at first, the event was made public a year later.
- On Sept. 6, 1997, an estimated 2.5 billion people around the world watched the four-mile funeral procession of England's beloved Princess Diana as her coffin was carried to Westminster Abbey. After the formal service there, a private ceremony was held in which she was laid to rest on an island in the heart of her family's estate at Althorp.
- On Sept. 7, 1907, the RMS Lusitania set sail on her maiden vovage from Liverpool, England. setting a new trans-Atlantic record when she arrived in New York City a mere five days later.
- On Sept. 8, 2006, only a week after permission was granted for helicopter flights over the ancient Incan ruins of Machu Picchu in Peru, the country's government declared the area a no-fly zone following protests by environmentalists who claimed such flights would adversely affect rare plants and animals in the area.
- On Sept. 9. 2007, the NFL discovered that the New England Patriots were illegally videotaping coaching signals from the New York Jets at an unauthorized location in a Week 1 game in East Rutherford, New Jersey. News media quickly dubbed the scandal "Spygate."
- On Sept. 10, 1897, 25-year-old London taxi driver George Smith had the dubious honor of becoming the first person ever arrested for "being drunk when in charge of a motor car" after he slammed his cab into a building, breaking a water pipe and window. Smith later pleaded guilty and was fined 25 shillings.

Watermelon's Last Hurrah Is Here

As summer wanes, I'm all for bringing on one last hurrah for watermelon. It's such a convenient, "good for you" cooldown snack that quenches thirst and satisfies the sweet tooth all in one.

Refreshing with a squeeze of lime, or kicked up with a dusting of ground chili pepper and salt, it's versatile and fun to eat. No wonder it's hard to bid adieu to the flavorful, locally grown varieties until next year.

Think "watermelon" as you plan Labor Day weekend get-togethers and after-school snacks for the kids. And be choosy. Before you and your child hoist one out of a bin at your market, take note. The best feel heavy for their size. Also, look for a field spot, a creamy yellow-colored splotch. Then knock on it and listen for a deep, hollow (not dull) sound. When it passes the ripeness test, bring it home and get inspired. Here are some ideas:

CARVE IT

Don't wait until Halloween to display your creative carving skills. Make an eye-catching melon basket for serving a fruit salad or fruit kebabs.

Slightly trim off one end of a washed melon so that it stands upright. Slice off the other end 1/4 of the way down, then scoop out the flesh with a melon baller.

Use pumpkin-carving tools or a paring knife to

carve patterns or words on the outside without cutting through the rind. Cut zigzags around the rim, if you wish. Refill the cavity with fruit salad and garnish with fresh mint for a spectacular presentation.

DRINK IT

Make a big pitcher of "Watermelon Citrus Cooler." Mix seedless watermelon chunks in a blender with 4 tablespoons frozen limeade concentrate, 2 tablespoons fresh lemon juice and 1 1/2 cups crushed ice.

Let your child rub the rims of chilled, tall glasses with a lemon wedge. Swirl rims lightly in a plate of sugar for a tangy sip when you drink the cooler.

FREEZE IT

Cut 3 cups of watermelon flesh into chunks. Remove seeds and liquefy in a blender. Pour into icecube trays and freeze. Toss the cubes in a glass of juice or sparkling water with an after-school snack. Garnish with a whole strawberry or a thin, triangular slice of watermelon with the pointed end slid onto the rim of the glass.

- R.L. in Utah writes: "Do onions make you cry? Tip: Cut off root first. Cut off top second. Remove outer skin and discard the first outer layer of the onion. Slice/dice/rings. Works great." How do you cut your onions, and what helps to keep your eyes from watering? Write to us with your onion tips!
- · You may not think to do this often, but you should: Clean your laptop! Not just the screen or keys, but the exterior as well. Get a microfiber cloth, spritz the cloth (never the machine itself) with a bit of isopropyl alcohol and rub away dirt and grime.
- · "Grass stains can be removed from kids' clothing by rubbing the stains with a bar of Ivory soap. (I keep one just for stains.)" – M.F. in Washington
- Special for S.P. in California. To remove ball point ink from leather, your best weapon is a cotton swab and some rubbing alcohol. Be sure to test first in an inconspicuous spot, as not all leathers are equal. Certain synthetic leathers that are dyed may experience color loss in a spot cleaning with alcohol. Work slowly and don't rub too hard. Condition afterward to protect the leather.
- It's important to include only approved materials when recycling curbside, but conserving space allows the trucks to fit more per load, which is another great way to help the environment. A reader in North Carolina had something to say about this! They sent a great tip about nesting steel cans inside one another to compact space. You should also cut cardboard to smaller sizes and break down boxes, as well as crush plastic bottles and replace the caps.

Apothecary Memorabilia

"Doctor Yourself," encourages this cabinet, made to hold the Munyon Remedies in a drug store. The cabinet lists the "remedies" it contains according to the ailments they claim to "Relieve Immediately." You won't find any ingredients lists, warnings or drug facts here. These are Munyon's Homeopathic Remedies from the early 20th century.

James M. Munyon was a businessman with a talent for marketing and a staff of chemists and physicians. He started selling homeopathic medicines in the 1890s. After some legal trouble following the passage of the Pure Food and Drug Act, he had to sell his products as "remedies" instead of "cures." This hasn't made Munyon's advertising any less appealing to collectors; this cabinet sold for \$1,850 at Morford's Antique Advertising auction.

Antique apothecary and drug store memorabilia are popular collectibles, but be careful! Antique medicine bottles and other packaging may contain harmful substances. Keep them away from children and pets. Handle them carefully; wear rubber gloves and clean the cabinets in a well-ventilated area.

I have a cream-colored vase with a young woman and pink flowers painted on it. It's about 18-inches tall, has a slender neck with curved handles and gold trim. On the bottom it has "Belleek" printed along with a mark that looks like a painter's palette. There's a circle with intersecting letters, but they're too hard to read. Can you give me any information about this vase?

The mark you describe was used by the Ceramic Art Company of Trenton, New Jersey, from 1894 to 1906. The intersecting script letters are "CAC" for Ceramic Art Company. Creamy white pottery has been made in Belleek, Ireland, since 1863. American pottery companies made china like Irish Belleek but warmer in color. After 1929, Belleek Pottery Limited was the only porcelain company that could use Belleek with a capital "B" on its marks. The Ceramic Art Company was founded by Walter Scott Lenox. After 1906, the Lenox name was added to the Ceramic Art Company mark. Vases similar to yours have recently sold for \$750.

Dear EarthTalk: Is America's electrician shortage hurting our ability to get away from fossil fuels?
- P. Simpson, Dallas, TX

A shift away from fossil fuels is necessary if we are to mitigate climate change, but a serious electrician shortage in the U.S. is proving to be one of the biggest barriers to reaching this goal. An American energy transition will be difficult to realize without enough people with the technical skills to implement it!

In August 2022, President Biden introduced the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) which included climate legislation aimed at lowering emissions and stimulating the green job economy. The act pledges a \$370 billion investment over the next decade in clean energy initiatives, and includes tax rebates to ensure that using renewable power sources is the accessible and attractive option.

The act thus increases the demand for the people who make these changes possible: electricians. To service the greater number of electric vehicles on roads (due to the \$7,500 tax rebate on new electric vehicles), electricians need to install hundreds of charging stations along highways. The shortage of electricians, particularly in California and the Northeastern states where demand for these developments is greatest, manifests as months-long waiting lists, discouraging consumers from going green.

Unfortunately, the rate at which electricians are retiring is greater than the rate at which new electricians are joining the workforce. Despite the median

electrician's salary being greater than the average American salary, it is proving difficult to recruit and retain younger electricians. A university education is often perceived to be the most desirable route out of high school. The director of a regional apprenticeship program of the Laborers' International Union of North America said to David Owen of The New York Times, that despite union members earning more than \$50 per hour (in wages and benefits) ...one challenge "is overcoming the hesitation of parents who worry that "laborer" means "sweeper."

Technical schools, for those few who decide to attend, lack funding and teachers—experts earn far more in industry than they do teaching. Similarly, many electricians choose not to take on apprentices because it drains company money and time. Fortunately, some states (see below) offer tax credits to employers who take on apprentices, an incentive which encourages experienced laborers to educate the next generation. If your state is not listed, appeal to your local congressperson for change.

The extent of the electrician shortage could also be reduced by resolving the gaping hole in the skilled-labor industry: women and people of color. Harassment, historically exclusionary unions and lack of childcare are sometimes insurmountable barriers to entry. Only seven percent of electricians are black, and less than two percent are women. Developing and diversifying the workforce is sorely needed, but while that will emerge as it is doing in many industries, consider becoming an electrician. As climate activist Bill McKibben told The New York Times in an interview: "If you know a young person who wants to do something that's going to help the world and wants to make a good living at the same time, tell them to go become an electrician."






