



2024 In Review: Chronic **Wasting Disease In Unit 1** In The Panhandle Region

- Idaho Fish & Game -



Managing against chronic wasting disease requires playing the long game

Throughout the course of the 2024 hunting season, three additional white-tailed deer in Unit 1 tested positive for chronic wasting disease, bringing the total number of positive detections to six since the initial detection in July 2024. The three additional positives came from deer harvested by hunters within the bounds of the Unit 1 CWD management zone.

Timeline

- July 2024: CWD was first detected in Unit 1 roughly three miles outside of the town of Bonners Ferry
- · August 15, 2024: Idaho Fish and Game Commission approved a CWD surveillance hunt in a portion of Unit 1 to determine the initial prevalence of the disease.
- · August 20, 2024: CWD Community Chat open houses began each Tuesday evening in Bonners
- September 27, 2024: Sample results from the CWD surveillance hunt yielded two white-tailed deer that tested positive for CWD. Both deer were harvested within less than one mile of the original CWD detection.
- October 1, 2024: A CWD management zone was established in the portion of Unit 1 within Boundary County and east of the Selkirk Mountains crest. The establishment of the CWD management zone enacted mandatory CWD testing of all hunter-harvested mule deer and white-tailed



· November-December 2024: Idaho Fish and Game worked with hunters to gather as many CWD samples from within the CWD management zone as possible, resulting in three additional positive detections from white-tailed deer harvested within the management zone.

Takeaways

A total of 936 white-tailed deer was sampled within the Unit 1 CWD management zone during the 2024 regular deer season, representing a drastic increase from 2023. Fish and Game would like to genuinely thank hunters for their contributions of samples and therefore a better understanding of CWD in Unit 1.

Relative to many other states, the current estimated prevalence rate (less than 1%) of the disease in the management zone is low. Low prevalence rates suggest that Fish and Game in collaboration with hunters detected the disease early. Early detection of CWD is critical, as it creates opportunities to take action to slow the rate of spread of the disease. Recent studies in Wisconsin and Wyoming, states where CWD has been present for longer periods of time, have begun reporting major declines in big game herds, underscoring the potential risks of CWD in Idaho.



The Future

Recent studies have found that hunting can help keep CWD rates of spread and prevalence in check for the long haul. As such, during the 2025-26 Big Game Season Setting process, Fish and Game staff in the Panhandle Region proposed five new controlled hunts for white-tailed deer in the Unit 1 CWD management zone. All five hunts were well supported by the public; therefore, they were recommended to and adopted by the Fish and Game Commission at their March 2025 meeting.

The intent of the new hunts is to reduce CWD transmission and spread, consistent with Fish and Game's 2021 CWD management strategy. The new hunts numbers are 1115, 1116, 1120, 1121 and 1122 in the Idaho Big Game 2025 Seasons and Rules

Between the addition of 100 extra antlered whitetailed deer tags, addition of 1,000 extra antlerless white-tailed deer tags and reduction of 750 antlerless white-tailed deer tags in Unit 1, there is a net increase of 350 extra deer tags available in Unit 1, with a targeted focus to increase harvest within the CWD management zone.

Unit 1 is a popular hunting destination for many white-tailed deer hunters, with almost 7,100 Idaho hunters harvesting more than 2,900 white-tailed deer in Unit 1 in 2023. Fish and Game needs hunters' help to learn more about CWD to help keep white-tailed herds healthy in north Idaho.

Fish and Game's goal is to maintain healthy big game herds by slowing the spread of CWD and keeping the prevalence rate low. Achieving this goal is not possible without assistance from hunters.



Idaho Fish and Game encourages hunters to dust off their firearms or bows and visit their local shooting or archery ranges to get dialed in for hunting season.

Hunting season will be here before we know it. If you haven't already, here's why now is the perfect time to dust off that firearm or bow in preparation for the 2025 season.

Only accurate rifles (and bows) are interesting

In a 1957 issue of American Rifleman Magazine, famed writer and marksman Col. Townsend Whelen quipped that "only accurate rifles are interesting." Townsend argued that only those who spent the time sighting in and taking pride in their firearm we'll go ahead and assume he meant bows as well produced rewarding outcomes as their skillset and marksmanship increased. Shooters who neglected their firearms, on the other hand, found the road to proficiency to be long and arduous, eventually losing interest in their hobby and soon disposing of it altogether.

As hunting season approaches, let Whelen's remark serve as a reminder that taking pride in your firearm or bow is merely the prologue to yet another edition of the hunting season. An obvious, yet important, reminder: Your hunt will not end successfully if you can't deliver a bullet or arrow on target when it matters most.

"Taking the time to prepare and become a better marksman is a hallmark of an ethical hunter," said Brenda Beckley, Hunter Education Administrator. "And the better marksman you become, the better your chances of successfully harvesting an animal."

Now that we've established the when to get started improving your aim, here's the how.

Get in range time

Fish and Game offers several options for shooting and/or archery ranges around the state. Blacks Creek, Farragut, Nampa and Garden Valley Shooting Range are all Fish and Game-owned, public shooting ranges designed for safe firearm/bow practice by shooters of all abilities.

In the southwest, Nampa's public facility features both an indoor and outdoor archery range, as well as an indoor air gun range. There is also the Boise River WMA archery range complete with 20 three-dimensional foam targets. In the Panhandle, there is Farragut Public Shooting Range, which also includes a one-mile, walk-through archery range. Several Idaho state parks, in cooperation with Fish and Game, have archery ranges with life-sized, three-dimensional targets that mimic big game animals.

There are several other shooting ranges located across the state, some of which are co-managed by Idaho Fish and Game and the Shooting Range Development Grant program. This program's mission is to provide funds to assist organizations or agencies to establish, upgrade, expand or otherwise improve public firearms and archery ranges in Idaho.



For a more comprehensive list of shooting ranges in Idaho, go check out the National Shooting Sports Foundation's Where to Shoot webpage at www.nssf. org/shooting/where-to-shoot. This state-by-state shooting range directory lists contact information, facilities available, maps and more for each range.

Calling before you go is highly recommended, as hours of operation, services or shooting opportunities may change. If you've never been to a public shooting range, there is a beginner's guide to get you started at idfg.idaho.gov/press/ beginners-guide-public-shooting-ranges-0.

Pre-Season Prep Tips | Rifles

For rifle hunters, many shooting experts recommend setting your initial target at 25 yards to make sure you hit the paper if you have a new rifle, have replaced a scope or don't know where your rifle is hitting. After shooting at that distance, move your target out to 100 yards or more to finish the sighting-in process.



Consistent accuracy is the ultimate goal when practicing shooting skills, so it's important that hunters consider their effective shooting range and practice at all distances out to that maximum number.

It's also important to practice from a variety of shooting positions and not just from a bench. Think about it. When that 4-point buck or 6-point bull pauses along the hillside, you're not going to have the luxury of a bench rest and 5 minutes of slow breathing when you go to take that shot.

Shooters should try to replicate the conditions they are likely to encounter in the field as closely as possible, so after your rifle is sighted in, consider doing some exercise to get your heart rate elevated and your lungs working harder to mimic what shooting may feel like in the field.

"We stress in our hunter education courses that all hunters have an ethical obligation to know their personal limits and be prepared," Beckley said. "Practicing often, at a variety of distances and from a number of different shooting positions, will help hunters prepare for a variety of situations they may

Hunters: As Hunting Season Draws Near, Now Is The Perfect Time To Dial **In Your Bow Or Firearm**

Pre-Season Prep Tips | Shotguns

Don't let the Elmer Fudd cartoons fool you – there's a lot more to using a shotgun than just spraying a target with pellets. When it comes to preparation for wing shooting, hunters should focus on practicing different shots at different angles that may at first seem difficult.

Hot Tip: Be sure you use the choke and shell combination you plan to use for the hunting season. Modified chokes produce a moderately tight pattern, good for rabbits, quail and upland game birds. Full chokes have an even tighter pattern and are best suited for turkey, squirrels and other game at longer range.

Patterning a shotgun before the season is a fairly common practice with turkey hunters, but it's something upland and migratory bird hunters should consider, too. Knowing your pattern density at given distances can help you determine your effective range, and give you a good idea of how your shotgun performs with a particular choke and shell combination. Every shotgun is different, and your shotgun will likely perform differently if you change either of those variables.

Pre-Season Prep Tips | Bows

By this point in the game, most archery hunters using traditional and compound bows will already be dialed in as early-season and archery-only hunts kick off in late August.

But if you're new to the sport of bow hunting, you should start by visiting your local bow shop and get your bow tuned up, especially if you haven't shot much or at all since last fall.

After that, it's time to get your body back into shooting shape and practice at known and unknown distances. Archery ranges with life-sized, 3D targets are good place to practice your shooting and estimating distance in a field setting.

Hot Tip: Estimating distance is a lot more crucial in archery than in rifle hunting. To become proficient at gauging distances in the field, sharpen your eye by making estimates on various landmarks or 3D targets. Once you make an assessment, whip out your trusty rangefinder and confirm just how close or far off your naked eye was.

Fish and Game has ranges at its Boise River Wildlife Management Area and Farragut Shooting Range. You can also find archery ranges at some Idaho State Parks, including Hells Gate near Lewiston, Castle Rock near Albion and Dworshak near Orofino.

Remember that most ranges will not allow you to shoot broadheads, and they usually shoot differently than field tips, so you will need to resight in your bow when you make the switch.

So whether you're hauling a rifle or a recurve out into the field with you this hunting season, proper maintenance and preparation is a must. Be sure to brush up on your marksmanship and take care of your weapon to ensure a fun, safe (and "interesting") hunt.

THE HISTORY CHANNEL

On Aug. 25, 1921, Franklin D. Roosevelt was diagnosed with polio -- also known as infantile paralysis because it usually strikes much younger people -- at the age of 39. He never regained the full use of his legs.

On Aug. 29, 1914, the Women's Defence Relief Corps was formed in Britain. Women's rights organizations in Britain at first opposed the country's entrance into the war, but reversed that position after recognizing the war effort's potential to gain advancement for British women on the home

On Aug. 30, 2006, the California State Senate passed the Global Warming Solutions Act, which made California the first state to place caps on carbon dioxide and other greenhouse gases, including those found in automobile emissions.

On Aug. 31, 1888, prostitute Mary Ann Nichols, the first known victim of a London serial killer called "Jack the Ripper," was found murdered and mutilated in the city's Whitechapel district. In 1892, with no leads found and no more murders recorded, the Ripper file was officially closed, but criminologists, historians and amateur sleuths still debate his true identity to this day.

Dear EarthTalk: How are Florida's manatees faring lately and what has the government and/or conservationists been doing to protect them?

—IoAnne B., Sumter, SC

Indeed, Florida's manatees have come back from where they stood on the brink of extinction in the late 1960s, when only a few hundred individuals remained in the wild. Today over 6,000 of the herbivorous "sea cows" swim the Indian River Lagoon and Florida's other near-shore waterways. But newer threats including the die-off of their preferred browse (seagrass), habitat destruction due to shoreline development and runoff, an uptick in commercial and recreational activities and global warming have put Florida's manatees back on the ropes, and conservationists are again ramping up efforts to protect them.

Given all we know about being respectful to wildlife and giving them space, it's hard to believe that 2021 has been the worst year in recorded history for manatees, with Florida wildlife officials reporting a whopping 1003 manatee deaths in state waters so far this year. That's a 37 percent increase in manatee deaths over 2020, when biologists recorded 637 kills.

More than half of 2021's deaths have been in the Indian River Lagoon, a 156-mile east central Florida coastal estuary that stretches across six counties. Manatees have long thrived in the Lagoon's warm, brackish waters and consumed its abundant seagrass. Over the past 20 years, however, tens of thousands of acres of seagrass have vanished; the University of Florida estimates that up to 95 percent of seagrass is gone from some areas of the Lagoon. The main culprit is runoff from fertilizer and septic systems, which has polluted the water and promoted toxic algae blooms. These blooms deplete the water's oxygen levels and cloud its surface, decreasing the amount of light available to seagrasses for photosynthesis.

While it is currently illegal in Florida to feed manatees in the wild, conservation groups like Save the Manatee Club are now considering taking matters into their own hands by providing "supplemental feedings" to halt the unprecedented starvations. Meanwhile, rescuing injured or starving manatees remains a top priority of the group, which has helped rescue upwards of 130 manatees in 2021 alone while also funding facilities to rehab injured manatees so they can return to the wild.

Meanwhile, biologists from the University of Florida, University of Central Florida and elsewhere are working to restore water-filtering oyster populations along the Lagoon. These bivalves consume and remove harmful contaminants from the water, nurturing otherwise dwindling seagrass communities that serve as the lifeblood and main nutrient of

Just four years ago, the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (FWS) down-listed the manatee from endangered to threatened. In light of this year's population plight, Florida Congressmen Vern Buchanan and Darren Soto are currently backing the Manatee Protection Act, which would place the manatee back into endangered status under the Endangered Species Act. An upgraded endangered status would require the FWS to accelerate action on manatee repopulation efforts.

Exploring Flathead Lake: A Journey To Its Islands

— Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks -

Prominently situated in northwest Montana, Flathead Lake is a grand source of natural wonder and adventure. It stretches 27 miles from its northernmost tip to its south side, and reaches 15 miles wide, making it the largest natural freshwater lake west of the Mississippi. Its crystal-clear waters are framed by the rugged Mission and Swan mountain ranges, equally awe-inspiring and adventurously attractive.

Another unique and underrated feature of the grand lake are its treasured islands.

Why Visit the Flathead Lake Islands?

Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks manages five islands on Flathead Lake. Different rules and regulations apply depending on the site, and information is listed below. These islands, ranging from tiny rocky outcrops to forested gems like Wild Horse Island, provide a fun daytrip or overnight adventure depending on the site. Wild Horse Island, the largest at 2,164 acres, is a state park teeming with wildlife — bighorn sheep, mule deer, and even its namesake wild horses. Smaller islands, like Bird or Douglas island, offer secluded beaches and nesting grounds for ospreys and bald eagles. Whether you're a kayaker, hiker or nature enthusiast, the islands offer an escape into a unique side of Flathead Lake.

Getting There

Accessing the islands requires a boat, kayak or paddleboard. Boat rentals are available around the lake. Launch points like Big Arm State Park or West Shore State Park provide relatively easy access. Be mindful of the weather — Flathead Lake can whip up waves quickly, so check forecasts and stick to calm mornings for nonmotorized crafts.

Wild Horse Island State Park

This is the largest island on Flathead Lake and includes a 2,160-acre state park. Enjoy hiking on over 3 miles of trails throughout the island with vistas of Flathead Lake and the Mission Mountains, and excellent wildlife viewing opportunities. This park is day-use only, and pets are not allowed. There are six landing sites on the island, none of which have a dock. Any docks on the island are private property.

Bird Island

This island is located off the east shore near Finley Point. It caught fire in 2020, and the burn helped

rejuvenate the forest understory on the island and improved bird habitat. It is closed to all use from March 1 – July 15 to conserve bird nesting. Camping is allowed in designated sites. Three campsites are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Camping is limited to 3 days in a 14-day period. Camping fees are \$12/night for Montana residents, \$6/ night for Montana resident seniors and \$20/night for nonresidents. Pay at self-serve fee station on site; cash or check only. There is a latrine on the island. Fires and the use of camp stoves are prohibited.

Cedar Island

This island is located offshore from Rollins and is covered in a thick Douglas fir and juniper forest. Six campsites are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Camp only in designated sites. There is a latrine on the island. Fires and the use of camp stoves are prohibited.

Douglas Island

This is a small island located off the shore from the West Shore Unit of Flathead Lake State Park. Dayuse only. Camping prohibited. Fires and the use of camp stoves are prohibited.

Goose Island

This is a small island located off the shore from the West Shore Unit of Flathead Lake State Park. Closed to all use from March 1 – July 15 to conserve bird-nesting. Day-use only. Camping prohibited. Fires and the use of camp stoves are prohibited.

Tips for Adventuring

Pack Smart: Bring sunscreen, hats, and layers — Montana's weather shifts fast. Carry enough water and pack out all trash to preserve the islands' pristine state

Respect Wildlife and Regulations: Many islands are protected for nesting birds or sensitive ecosystems. Follow seasonal closures or camping rules. Never approach wildlife.

Safety First: Flathead Lake's size means sudden winds or storms. Wear life jackets and let someone know your plans.

Leave No Trace: These islands are pristine, keep them that way. Stick to established trails and avoid disturbing wildlife. Latrines are located on Cedar and Bird islands.

Parking: For more information on where to park before venturing to one of FWP's Flathead Lake sites, contact the Flathead Lake State Park Ranger Station at 406-837-3041.



When is the Best Time to Receive Your Flu Shot (if you want to get one)

– Panhandle Health District –

Waking up to recent cooler mornings, reminds us that kids will be going back to school soon and inevitably, winter is coming. Along with the cooler weather comes respiratory virus season, so part of your fall prep may include a flu vaccine. Although it may seem appealing to get your flu shot out of the way early, it isn't advisable by healthcare professionals.

"August is too early to receive a flu vaccine if you want to be protected through the entire flu season," said Katelin Arnold, Nurse Practitioner at Panhandle Health District (PHD). "The most opportune time to receive your flu shot is late September or early October. That way the vaccine won't wane before the flu season is over, giving you the greatest amount of protection throughout the entirety of the season."

Respiratory virus season, when flu, RSV and other bugs are circulating, typically begins in mid to late September and can last through April. The season usually peaks in January and February. Flu is different from a cold. Flu usually comes on suddenly and people who have flu often feel some or all of the symptoms of flu including fever, cough, sore throat, runny or stuffy nose, body aches, fatigue, and headaches. Flu vaccine has been shown to reduce flu related illnesses and the risk of serious flu complications that can result in hospitalization or even death.

Each year, the flu vaccine is updated to match the circulating flu viruses. Typically flu vaccines protect against the three or four viruses that research suggests will be most common for that flu season. Since

flu viruses are constantly changing, the vaccine is updated to provide the best protection.

In addition to being vaccinated, everyday preventive actions can stop the spread of viruses. Staying home from work or school when you're sick, covering your coughs and sneezes, washing your hands and disinfecting surfaces are all ways to keep your family and community healthy.

PHD offers vaccines to protect against flu, RSV, measles, whooping cough and many other illnesses by appointment at their locations in Hayden, Sandpoint, Bonners Ferry, St. Maries, and Kellogg. In addition to office appointments, the public may attend any of the following flu clinics to receive an influenza vaccine:
