Italian Furniture

With its carved giltwood trim and rich velvet upholstery, this sofa would look right at home among the opulent Baroque and extravagant Rococo styles of the 18th century. It was made much more recently, in fact, by Jumbo Collection, a contemporary Italian furniture company that was founded in 1985. It sold for \$1,188 at a Hindman auction.

Contemporary Italian furniture may be associated with postmodern, avant-garde trends like Radical Design, Studio Alchimia and Memphis, but older styles are always coming back. Rococo style was revived, like many other past design styles, in the 19th century, and came back into fashion once more in the early 20th century. Today's design may tend towards minimalism; the simple, functional mid-century modern look is popular, but the pendulum always swings back; decorations like elaborate carving, gilded trim and lush fabrics may come back again before we know it!

Q I was given this medicine cabinet by a dentist many years ago. Any idea on what it would be worth?

A: Medical and dental equipment, including cabinets, are popular with collectors. Value depends on their size, condition, material and unusual features like rotating cases or other movable parts. Your cabinet is by Clark & Roberts, a company that made dental cabinets, exam tables and other medical furniture in the early 20th century. A cabinet by Clark & Roberts sold at auction a few years ago for about \$500. More recently, similar cabinets by other or unknown manufacturers have sold for about \$200 to \$700. Having the label with the maker's name increases the value. Asking prices online can go from about \$400 to over \$1,000. An auction house or dealer who specializes in medical or dental collectibles may be able to give you a more precise estimate.



Sometimes the newest fashions repeat what came before -- lucky for antique collectors! Decorations on this contemporary sofa suggest the ornate design styles of the 18th century.

TIP: Don't retouch gold leaf picture frames or other gold trim with anything but real gold leaf.

“Jack’s Million-Dollar Bars” Are a Dessert Hit

Garage-sale season arrived in our neighborhood in grand style when a group of energetic teens and their parents recently put on a super sale under a big white tent in the middle of the block to raise money for their year-old, city-wide, co-ed youth rowing team.

Eager passersby snapped up the usual skates, skis and salad bowls, but the surprise attraction was the tempting “bake sale” table. This is where I spotted “Jack’s Million-Dollar Bars.” At only 75 cents each, how could I resist? One bite of the chocolaty, nutty confection, and I knew I had to have the recipe.

But who was Jack? He’s a 16-year-old high-school sophomore, who is not only active on the rowing team but also an enthusiastic cook who loves to dabble in the kitchen.

“I started making family dinners around 8th grade as an excuse to not do homework,” he admitted with a grin. “But now I take cooking seriously and enjoy sauteing meats, shellfish and vegetables, and experimenting with spices.”

Besides whatever gets Jack into the kitchen, the million-dollar bars could be his real success story. Try them at home, and you’ll be happy that I stopped by his bake-sale table to pass this recipe on:

JACK’S MILLION-DOLLAR BARS

Makes 30 bars

- 4 cups rolled oats
- 3/4 cup butter
- 1/4 cup light corn syrup

- 1 cup brown sugar
- 1/4 cup peanut butter
- 1 teaspoon vanilla

Topping Ingredients:

- 1 package (11-ounce) butterscotch chips
- 1 package (12-ounce) semi-sweet chocolate chips
- 1/3 cup peanut butter
- 1 cup salted, dry-roasted peanuts

Preheat oven to 350 F. Grease a 9-by-13-inch baking pan. Measure oats into a large mixing bowl. Set aside.

Melt together the butter, brown sugar, corn syrup, peanut butter and vanilla in a saucepan over low heat. Pour over oatmeal and mix together. Press into the greased pan and bake for 10 minutes, or until lightly brown. Cool for about 30 minutes.

Using the same saucepan, melt butterscotch chips, chocolate chips and peanut butter over low heat. Stir in peanuts and spread evenly over base. Cool to room temperature. Refrigerate 1 hour, until firm enough to cut neatly into squares. Or leave it on the counter and cut the next day. Jack suggests using a small metal spatula that doesn’t bend to cut and remove bars from the pan.



Extra Tip: For a bake sale, set each square on a paper cupcake cup for stability. Wrap with plastic wrap and top with a sticker or label.

A Beginner's Guide to Planting Trees

— Family Features —



From improved air quality and increased wildlife habitation to enhanced property values and aesthetics, planting trees offers numerous benefits that contribute to a healthier environment and more beautiful landscape.

However, selecting the right tree is crucial for ensuring its long-term health and compatibility with your property. Consider factors such as soil type, climate and the tree's size when fully mature as well as your purpose for planting the tree – such as shade, fruit or ornamental beauty – to help narrow down your choices and select a tree that meets your requirements.

Once you've selected the perfect tree (or trees) for your property, follow these steps to plant a tree that will thrive for years to come.

1. Choose a location that offers ample space for the tree's roots and canopy to grow. Avoid areas with overhead power lines or underground utilities.

2. Test the soil drainage in the chosen location by digging a hole and filling it with water. If the water drains within a few hours, the soil has acceptable drainage. If it takes longer, select a different site or add organic matter to the soil.
3. Dig a hole 2-3 three times wider than the tree's root ball but no deeper than its height to encourage the roots to grow outward into the surrounding soil.
4. Remove the tree from its container or burlap wrapping, taking care not to damage the roots.
5. Place the tree in the hole, ensuring the root flare (where the roots spread at the base of the tree) is level with or slightly above ground level.
6. Backfill the hole with excavated soil, tamping it down gently to eliminate air pockets.
7. Water the tree thoroughly to provide initial moisture to the roots.
8. Apply a 2-3-inch layer of mulch around the base, keeping it away from the trunk to prevent rot.

As your tree grows, periodic maintenance can help ensure its health and structural integrity. Water regularly, especially during dry periods, ensuring the soil remains consistently moist but not waterlogged. Prune the tree to remove dead or diseased branches and shape its growth. Fertilize as needed based on soil test results and tree species requirements.

Recreationists Can Help Reduce Conflicts On Idaho Fish And Game Properties

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game —



All users of Idaho Fish and Game properties can take steps to help reduce conflicts and enhance recreational experiences.

With summer winding down, the desire to get outside and enjoy all Idaho has to offer grows strong. With a renewed recreation focus and a growing population, publicly accessible lands in Idaho are seeing a lot of use. These publicly available lands fall under many different ownerships, ranging from federal public lands to privately owned lands that allow public access. In fact, over 70% of land in the Panhandle Region is publicly accessible. In short, there are a lot of places to go and things to see.

Fish and Game owns or manages only a small portion of these publicly accessible lands, and they are generally located in the valley bottoms and at key points to access various water bodies. Fish and Game properties are managed primarily for wildlife habitat and sportsman access for hunting, fishing, and trapping. Other uses, such as hiking, biking, kayaking, and horse riding are also allowed.

With growing use of Fish and Game lands, conflicts with the management goals and adjoining neighbors are increasing. Recreationists can take some simple steps to help reduce conflicts. The parking areas only have so much room, so when the parking lots are full, consider exploring new areas instead of parking outside of designated areas.

This simple step would reduce overcrowding of the property, prevent conflicts with neighboring property owners, and eliminate safety issues on adjacent roadways. If bringing a horse trailer, remember you're taking up several vehicle parking spots, so consider going at less crowded times.

Dogs are allowed on all Fish and Game properties, but please keep them under control to prevent them from chasing wildlife, disrupting nesting birds, affecting other visitors, or trespassing on neighboring properties. Many of our water access parcels have boat launches and provide parking for vehicles with trailers. Please don't block boat ramps or park vehicles without trailers in spaces designed for trailers. These actions would go a long way toward reducing conflicts, especially at the busier sites.

Hot and dry summer conditions have created extreme fire danger throughout the region. Please stay abreast of fire restrictions by visiting Fish and Game's Fire Information webpage at idfg.idaho.gov/fire.

As the seasons change, many of the Fish and Game parcels will see hunters and trappers going afield looking for their quarry. When out in late-summer and through the fall, it's a good idea to wear hunter orange or hot pink clothing to make sure you're clearly visible. It's also a good time of the year to keep your dog from running far from the trail to prevent any inadvertent encounters with traps or hunters. Most sportsmen focus their efforts during the morning and evening, so going for a hike in the middle of the day could lessen impacts to hunters using the area.

No matter whose land you are recreating on, it is your responsibility to know the rules and be an ethical visitor. Being respectful of the property owners' rules and the surrounding residences helps to reduce conflicts and enhance the recreational experience for everyone.

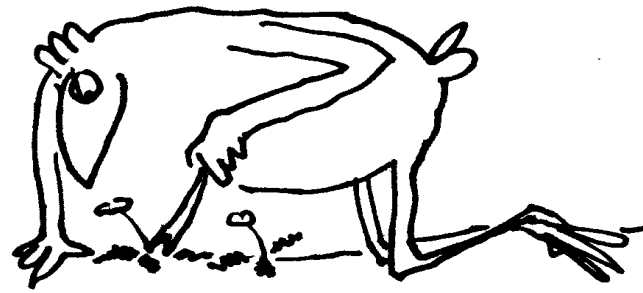

Hunters: As Hunting Season Draws Near, Now Is The Perfect Time To Dial In Your Bow Or Firearm

Idaho Fish and Game encourages hunters to dust off their firearms or bows and visit their local shooting or archery ranges to get dialed in for hunting season.

Hunting season will be here before we know it. If you haven't already, here's why now is the perfect time to dust off that firearm or bow in preparation for the 2025 season.

Only accurate rifles (and bows) are interesting

In a 1957 issue of American Rifleman Magazine, famed writer and marksman Col. Townsend Whelen quipped that "only accurate rifles are interesting." Townsend argued that only those who spent the time sighting in and taking pride in their firearm – we'll go ahead and assume he meant bows as well – produced rewarding outcomes as their skillset and marksmanship increased. Shooters who neglected their firearms, on the other hand, found the road to proficiency to be long and arduous, eventually losing interest in their hobby and soon disposing of it altogether.

As hunting season approaches, let Whelen's remark serve as a reminder that taking pride in your firearm or bow is merely the prologue to yet another edition of the hunting season. An obvious, yet important, reminder: Your hunt will not end successfully if you can't deliver a bullet or arrow on target when it matters most.

"Taking the time to prepare and become a better marksman is a hallmark of an ethical hunter," said Brenda Beckley, Hunter Education Administrator. "And the better marksman you become, the better your chances of successfully harvesting an animal."

Now that we've established the when to get started improving your aim, here's the how.

Get in range time

Fish and Game offers several options for shooting and/or archery ranges around the state. Blacks Creek, Farragut, Nampa and Garden Valley Shooting Range are all Fish and Game-owned, public shooting ranges designed for safe firearm/bow practice by shooters of all abilities.

In the southwest, Nampa's public facility features both an indoor and outdoor archery range, as well as an indoor air gun range. There is also the Boise River WMA archery range complete with 20 three-dimensional foam targets. In the Panhandle, there

is Farragut Public Shooting Range, which also includes a one-mile, walk-through archery range. Several Idaho state parks, in cooperation with Fish and Game, have archery ranges with life-sized, three-dimensional targets that mimic big game animals.

There are several other shooting ranges located across the state, some of which are co-managed by Idaho Fish and Game and the Shooting Range Development Grant program. This program's mission is to provide funds to assist organizations or agencies to establish, upgrade, expand or otherwise improve public firearms and archery ranges in Idaho.



For a more comprehensive list of shooting ranges in Idaho, go check out the National Shooting Sports Foundation's Where to Shoot webpage at www.nssf.org/shooting/where-to-shoot. This state-by-state shooting range directory lists contact information, facilities available, maps and more for each range.

Calling before you go is highly recommended, as hours of operation, services or shooting opportunities may change. If you've never been to a public shooting range, there is a beginner's guide to get you started at idfg.idaho.gov/press/beginners-guide-public-shooting-ranges-0.

Pre-Season Prep Tips | Rifles

For rifle hunters, many shooting experts recommend setting your initial target at 25 yards to make sure you hit the paper if you have a new rifle, have replaced a scope or don't know where your rifle is hitting. After shooting at that distance, move your target out to 100 yards or more to finish the sighting-in process.



Consistent accuracy is the ultimate goal when practicing shooting skills, so it's important that hunters consider their effective shooting range and practice at all distances out to that maximum number.

It's also important to practice from a variety of shooting positions and not just from a bench. Think about it. When that 4-point buck or 6-point bull pauses along the hillside, you're not going to have the luxury of a bench rest and 5 minutes of slow breathing when you go to take that shot.

Shooters should try to replicate the conditions they are likely to encounter in the field as closely as possible, so after your rifle is sighted in, consider doing some exercise to get your heart rate elevated and your lungs working harder to mimic what shooting may feel like in the field.

"We stress in our hunter education courses that all hunters have an ethical obligation to know their personal limits and be prepared," Beckley said. "Practicing often, at a variety of distances and from a number of different shooting positions, will help hunters prepare for a variety of situations they may encounter."

Hot Tip: Hunters should always use the same ammunition for hunting as they did when sighting in their rifle.

Pre-Season Prep Tips | Shotguns

Don't let the Elmer Fudd cartoons fool you – there's a lot more to using a shotgun than just spraying a target with pellets. When it comes to preparation for wing shooting, hunters should focus on practicing different shots at different angles that may at first seem difficult.

Hot Tip: Be sure you use the choke and shell combination you plan to use for the hunting season. Modified chokes produce a moderately tight pattern, good for rabbits, quail and upland game birds. Full chokes have an even tighter pattern and are best suited for turkey, squirrels and other game at longer range.

Patterning a shotgun before the season is a fairly common practice with turkey hunters, but it's something upland and migratory bird hunters should consider, too. Knowing your pattern density at given distances can help you determine your effective range, and give you a good idea of how your shotgun performs with a particular choke and shell combination. Every shotgun is different, and your shotgun will likely perform differently if you change either of those variables.

Pre-Season Prep Tips | Bows

By this point in the game, most archery hunters using traditional and compound bows will already

be dialed in as early-season and archery-only hunts kick off in late August.

But if you're new to the sport of bow hunting, you should start by visiting your local bow shop and get your bow tuned up, especially if you haven't shot much or at all since last fall.

After that, it's time to get your body back into shooting shape and practice at known and unknown distances. Archery ranges with life-sized, 3D targets are good place to practice your shooting and estimating distance in a field setting.

Hot Tip: Estimating distance is a lot more crucial in archery than in rifle hunting. To become proficient at gauging distances in the field, sharpen your eye by making estimates on various landmarks or 3D targets. Once you make an assessment, whip out your trusty rangefinder and confirm just how close or far off your naked eye was.

Fish and Game has ranges at its Boise River Wildlife Management Area and Farragut Shooting Range. You can also find archery ranges at some Idaho State Parks, including Hells Gate near Lewiston, Castle Rock near Albion and Dworshak near Orofino.

Remember that most ranges will not allow you to shoot broadheads, and they usually shoot differently than field tips, so you will need to resight in your bow when you make the switch.

So whether you're hauling a rifle or a recurve out into the field with you this hunting season, proper maintenance and preparation is a must. Be sure to brush up on your marksmanship and take care of your weapon to ensure a fun, safe (and "interesting") hunt.

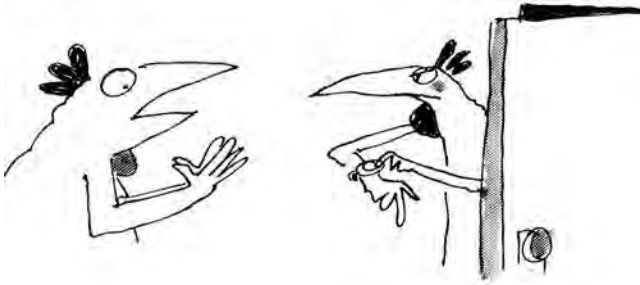

- Line your pots and pans with plain paper coffee filters to reduce scratches. Replace as needed.

DEAR GERALD: Dogs aren't always happy about their owners going away for 8 hours a day. They can develop separation anxiety. This can manifest as nonstop barking, whining or even acting out (like destroying your slippers, pooping in the living room or worse).

Try counterconditioning, a training method recommended by the ASPCA in its article "Separation Anxiety." Each time you leave home, give your dog a treat or a puzzle toy with treats inside (which will keep him occupied for several minutes). When you get home, put the toy out of sight. The idea is that Cookie will associate your leaving with an enjoyable treat.

You can also desensitize him to your leaving by getting Cookie used to your "departure cues." For example, if you always put on a coat and pick up your keys when you leave, have a training session where you do the same thing, but then sit down and watch TV instead of leaving. You'll need to do this (and probably other moves) for several weeks, but it could help.

These are very basic training exercises, and you may need to incorporate additional training. Check out the article on www.aspc.org, talk to Cookie's vet and consider working with a professional trainer to help curb his anxiety.

Trail Cameras Could Be Newest Tool for Estimating Idaho's Black Bear Populations

— Idaho Dept. of Fish & Game —



This summer, Idaho Fish and Game biologists are testing whether trail cameras can help estimate the number of black bears in one of the state's most popular bear hunting areas, Unit 32A.

The pilot project is designed to determine if remote cameras can produce a reliable population estimate for the 60-mile-long unit, located east of Council. Known for quality bear hunting, the unit's population trends have drawn increased attention from both hunters and wildlife managers following recent changes in hunting seasons.

Why it matters

In wildlife management, "abundance" refers to the number of animals of a species in a given area. Knowing how many animals are in a population, and how that number changes over time, helps biologists set hunting seasons and harvest limits that ensure sustainable populations.

Some species lend themselves to straightforward surveys. For example, deer and elk bunch up on open winter ranges where aerial counts work well. Black bears don't. They're mostly solitary, favor dense cover, are active mostly at dawn and dusk, and hibernate for months, which makes traditional counting methods tough.

"Bears are one of the hardest species to survey," said Regional Wildlife Manager Regan Berkley. "And

that makes obtaining adequate population data to inform decision making one of the biggest challenges of black bear management."

An evolution of methods

Across the state, Fish and Game biologists mostly rely on harvest data to monitor trends in bear numbers. It's useful data for wildlife managers, but it isn't perfect: Harvest data focuses on the portion of the population that are being harvested, and it doesn't offer a complete picture of the overall population size or dynamics.

Over the years, Fish and Game has continued to work on efficient and reliable methods of estimating black bear populations to supplement the metrics they get from harvest data. Prior to now, one preferred method has been using hair-snare sampling for DNA analysis.

The new camera-based method could offer another reliable way to estimate populations, adding another tool to Idaho's black bear monitoring toolbox.

This year's project

In early summer 2025, Fish and Game deployed 150 trail cameras at randomly assigned locations across 32A. The cameras span a variety of habitats, from sagebrush-covered rangelands to dense forests and alpine meadows.

Cameras will operate through the summer and early fall before being retrieved. Each unit is expected to record up to tens of thousands of images.

What's next

Biologists will begin reviewing and analyzing the images this fall. Processing the data will take months, meaning the first population estimate from this project is unlikely before spring 2026.

Until then, hunters and recreationists in Unit 32A may spot cameras in unexpected places. If you do, they are likely part of this study — quietly gathering information that could help shape the future of bear management in Idaho.
