### National Good Neighbor Day September 28th

#### **National Good Neighbor Day History**

In the early 1970s, Becky Mattson of Lakeside, Montana created National Good Neighbor Day. In 1978, United States President Jimmy Carter issued Proclamation 4601:

"As our Nation struggles to build friendship among

the peoples of this world, we are mindful that the noblest human concern is concern for others. Understanding, love and respect build cohesive families and communities. The same bonds cement our Nation and the nations of the world. For most of us, this sense of community is nurtured and expressed in our neighborhoods where we give each other an opportunity to share and feel part of a larger family...I call upon the people of the United States and interested groups and organizations to observe such day with appropriate ceremonies and activities."

The date changed in 2003 from the fourth Sunday in September to an annual observance on September 28th.

Healthy cells are the foundation of good health, and the antioxidants and other polyphenols naturally found in grapes help protect the health and function of cells. The good news is that improving your diet doesn't require a complete overhaul - small steps such as swapping in fresh California grapes for processed snacks or simply adding a handful of fresh grapes to your day will add these beneficial compounds to your daily routine.

Or, you can add grapes to recipes like this Lemony California Grape and Beet Salad, a vibrant and fresh melody of color and flavor. Roasted red and yellow beets meet sweet and juicy grapes, peppery arugula and pumpkin seeds all brought together with a zesty lemon vinaigrette.

Studies suggest some grape compounds may positively influence immune function, including resveratrol and certain flavonoids. Additional studies show adding heart-healthy grapes to your daily diet can help support brain, colon and skin health. Grapes

#### **Lemony California Grape and Beet Salad**

Servings: 6

1/4 cup, plus 1 tablespoon, extra-virgin olive oil,

3 tablespoons lemon juice

1 tablespoon honey

2 cups peeled and sliced (1/8-inch thick) raw red and yellow beets, cut into small half-moons or

1/2 teaspoon sea salt

3 cups halved red Grapes from California

1/2 cup roasted salted pumpkin seeds

2 green onions, thinly sliced

4 cups (3 ounces) baby arugula

freshly ground pepper, to taste

- 1. Heat oven to 400 F and line baking sheet with parchment paper. In large bowl, whisk 1/4 cup olive oil, lemon juice and honey; set aside.
- 2. Place sliced beets on prepared baking sheet and drizzle with remaining oil. Add salt and toss well to coat. Spread in single layer and bake 25 minutes, or until tender; let cool.
- 3. Add grapes and pumpkin seeds to bowl with dressing and toss well to coat. Add cooled beets, green onions and arugula. Toss lightly; season with pepper, to taste.



## **Pumpkin Spice**

The arrival of fall means two things: pumpkin spice in everything and jokes about pumpkin spice in everything. The flavor may have exploded in popularity during the last decade or so, but it's been around much longer than that. This tin by the Frank Tea and Spice Co., which sold for \$153 at Morford's Antique Advertising Auctions (AntiqueAdvertising.com), is proof.

The Frank Tea & Spice Company, probably best known as the inventor of Frank's Red Hot Sauce, was founded in Cincinnati in 1896 by salesman Jacob Frank and his brothers Emil and Charles. By the early 1900s, it was the fourth-largest manufacturer of spices in the United States. Pumpkin pie was well established by then. Indigenous Americans cultivated, cooked and ate pumpkin for thousands of years. British colonizers didn't take long to use this American vegetable the same way they did most other foods: putting it in pies.

The first known recipe for a "pumpion pye," as it was spelled then, is in a 17th-century British cookbook, but it's not quite the same as the pie we know today. The recipe instructs the cook to slice the "pumpion" and fry the slices, then bake them in a crust with apples and raisins. A recipe for custard-style pumpkin pie like the one we know today appeared in the first cookbook written and published in 1796's "American Cookery" by Amelia Simmons. Favorite spices like ginger, nutmeg and cinnamon crept into these recipes by the 19th century, and this version of the pie has been gracing holiday tables ever since.

wearable condition can be sold, and vintage clothing is extremely popular right now. Leather often gets better with age; many buyers prefer the wornin feel and distressed look of vintage leather jackets to new ones. Contact vintage clothing stores in vour area to see if they are interested in the jacket. Another possibility is selling online on a website like eBay or Etsy, or one of the popular clothing resale sites like Thredup, Poshmark or TheRealReal.

TIP: Never store an old painting on canvas flat and face up on the floor. The paint may crack at the stretcher. Store it upright.

# Planning for a Positive Economic Future

Financial literacy tips for teens

Financial literacy is a critical skill that helps set the foundation for a stable and prosperous future. By understanding the basics of money management, teens can make informed decisions and avoid common financial pitfalls.

According to the annual Teens and Personal Finance survey, a study of teens ages 13-18 conducted by Wakefield Research on behalf of Junior Achievement and MissionSquare Retirement's Foundation, 45% of high schoolers took a personal finance or financial literacy class at school. This is up from 31% in 2024, indicating the nation's youth are interested in building a strong financial foundation. What's more, of the students who took their school's curriculum, 64% found it extremely or very helpful, yet despite this increase, data reveals knowledge gaps remain. In fact, 42% of teens surveyed are terrified they won't have enough money to cover their future needs and goals.

"There is so much for teens to absorb when learning about finances and planning for their future, they often struggle to envision what lies ahead," said Andre Robinson, president and CEO of MissionSquare Retirement. "Offering engaging programs that can boost financial knowledge and decision-making skills can only help to inspire young individuals to build a strong foundation of lifelong financial resilience."

Consider discussing these economic topics with your teen to help make a positive impact on students' financial readiness and get them ready for financial decisions they'll face in adulthood.

Mastering Saving and Budgeting — A good starting point for teens is to create a simple budget that tracks income and expenses. Because only 36% of teens surveyed save a part for their futures when they receive money, this can help them understand where money is going and identify areas they may be able to save for the future. This is particularly important considering 68% of teens agree that saving for retirement is something they can think about later in life.

Understanding Credit — Credit is a powerful tool but can also be a source of financial trouble if not managed properly. It's essential to understand how financial behaviors, like paying bills on time and keeping credit card balances low, impact their credit scores. A higher FICO score, which 80% of teens surveyed had never heard of or did not fully understand, can lead to better interest rates and more favorable loan terms.

Managing Common Debt Pitfalls — According to the survey, 43% of teens believe an interest rate of 18% on debt is manageable and can be paid off over time. However, it's important to understand the true cost of debt and how interest rates can accumulate over time and lead to significant financial strain. Establishing good debt management habits early, such as avoiding high-interest debt and paying off balances quickly, can lead to a healthier financial future.

Investing and Planning Ahead — According to the survey, teenagers' most appealing investing strategies are savings accounts, side hustles and keeping cash at home, and only 13% invest a portion of their money. Encouraging teens to learn about different types of investments, such as stocks, bonds and mutual funds, can help them make informed decisions and begin to build long-term wealth.

As part of this work, United Way developed a Disaster Preparedness Guide – a curated list of preparedness tips and best practices from leading experts.

Here are five easy steps from this expert-vetted guide everyone can follow today to become more prepared for the next disaster:

#### 1. Identify your support network and emergency contacts

Add the phone numbers of family members, friends and neighbors to your mobile device - categorized as emergency contacts – and make sure they have yours. Also add 211 - the three-digit phone line that connects people to locally available resources – to your contacts. The line also provides emergency and resource information during times of disaster.

#### 2. Get connected

Make sure your phone is enabled to get local alerts and warnings. When emergencies happen, public safety officials use wireless emergency alerts to "ping" enabled mobile devices in those communities.

#### 3. Assess needs

Build an emergency kit for home and a "go bag" for the car. Keep a charged power bank in each. Add medical information. Ask yourself and others in your household questions about medical needs, animal care, shelter, food, water, clothing and more.

#### 4. Safeguard key records

Use your phone to take photos of key documents and valuables. Keep electronic copies of these important documents in a password-protected format on a removable flash or external hard drive in a fireproof and waterproof box or safe, or a secure cloudbased service.

#### 5. Engage your support network

Now that you've taken these steps, make sure vour family has done the same. Check in with your closest friends and extended family to share these tips. Discuss who may need extra help and designate someone to get to them in an emergency.



## **Reduce Your Home's Vulnerabilities to Wildfire**

– Family Features –



Don't wait for smoke on the horizon to prepare for a wildfire. While hot temperatures, dry conditions and strong winds increase wildfire threat, taking small manageable steps – like creating a noncombustible 5-foot buffer around your home – can significantly reduce its risk of ember ignition.

As fiery bits of debris, embers can travel miles ahead of the main fire front and often find vulnerable areas, including roofs; vegetation; landscaping; wood, wicker or plastic furniture; dried leaves; and other yard debris, making them the No. 1 reason homes ignite during wildfires.

To help homeowners take the guesswork out of wildfire prep and protect what matters most, experts at the Insurance Institute for Business & Home Safety (IBHS) developed science-based guidance to reduce your home's vulnerability and risk of ignition.

#### **Check and Maintain Your Roof**

More than 90% of U.S. homes already have a Class A fire-resistant-rated roof. However, if your roof is made of wood or other non-rated materials, replace it with a Class A roof to reduce fire risk. Also, regularly clear the roof of leaves, needles and other debris.

In addition, replace plastic or PVC gutters with noncombustible metal options, such as aluminum or steel, and regularly clear gutters and downspouts of all vegetative debris, which can provide fuel for embers to land on and ignite. When ignited, this debris could expose the fascia, roof and attic to flames.

#### Establish a Critical 0-5-Foot Noncombustible Zone

From the curb to just a few steps from the front door, lush lawn, native plants and healthy trees are part of a wildfire-prepared yard. However, the area closest to your home, a 5-foot buffer, often called "Zone Zero," is key to keeping embers at bay without any material in this area to ignite.

In fact, a study from IBHS and ZestyAI found property owners who clear vegetation from the perimeter

of their home can nearly double the likelihood of it surviving a wildfire.

This doesn't mean you need to leave this area barren; in fact, a wildfire-prepared landscape is beautiful, green and safe.

Design your yard with healthy trees, plants and grass up to the last few steps to your home. In the last 5 feet, top landscape pavers or river rocks with ceramic flowerpots or noncombustible planters that can easily be moved on Red Flag days - which indicate weather conditions are optimal for wildfire spread – for a beautiful setting that also acts as a fire-resistant buffer. Trees overhanging the zone can serve as a connective path for fire to travel from the vard to the house. Trim them to prevent this risk as well as reduce debris accumulation on the roof, gutters and at the base of exterior walls.

Don't forget to give the same care to your backyard. Just like looking in from the front curb, native landscaping, including trees and plants, as well as privacy fences, can extend all the way up to just a few steps from the back of your home. In the 5-foot area nearest your home, create an outdoor living space with hardscaping and add patio furniture, planters and other decor – choosing materials like ceramics and wrought iron that won't burn.

#### **Protect Exterior Features**

Vents are weak points where embers can enter your home or build up and ignite materials inside. Install flame- and ember-resistant vents or retrofit existing vents - including attic, soffits, wall and crawlspace vents as well as roof openings - with 1/8inch, corrosion-resistant metal mesh. Also ensure dryer vents have functional louvers or a self-closing flap to block embers.

Looking around your yard where blowing leaves gather is a good way to visualize the places embers can collect like at the base of a home's exterior walls. Ensure at least 6 inches of vertical, noncombustible material at ground level (and above decks or patios) below your siding to prevent ember ignition. Materials can include exposed concrete foundation, fiber-cement siding, brick, stone, stucco or metal flashing.

No longer just a threat for western states, these mitigations can reduce wildfire risk in communities across the country. Homeowners in certain states can use this system of mitigation actions to receive a Wildfire Prepared Home designation.

## Everything a Nonresident Hunter Needs to Know About the 2026 Tag Drawing

– Idaho Fish & Game –



Hunters will need to buy a nonresident hunting license in order to draw any 2026 tags.

If you're a nonresident hunter looking to hunt deer or elk in Idaho next year, the process is going to look a little different—and much improved.

This move to a draw should be celebrated as a win for nonresident hunters. The new framework replaces the historical first-come, first-served tag sale that occurred online and at license and tag vendors, which frustrated many out-of-state hunters.

Now, the modified nonresident tag framework does have one important caveat: Out-of-state hunters will be required to buy a nonresident hunting license in order to draw any 2026 tags. The sticker price on a nonresident license to hunt is \$185 and is nonrefundable. In other words, if you don't draw, you don't get your money back.

However, once you have your nonresident hunting license in your possession, you will be eligible to put in for a whole slew of tag opportunities, including deer, elk, and pronghorn controlled hunts, or moose, bighorn sheep, and mountain goat tags. Additionally, you could purchase returned or unsold tags.

- Jan. 20 | Deadline for successful applicants to buy their tags

- Feb. 5-15 | Second application period for any tags not drawn or not purchased
- March 2026 (early) | Results announced
- March 20 | Deadline to buy tags

The 2026 Nonresident Supplement and the Big Game Seasons and Rules will be available in October 2025. Hunters should know the deer hunting unit and/or elk zone for the tags for which they want to apply. The nonresident draw allows up to five hunt choices on an application and up to four hunters can be on one application, but all must have a valid annual hunting license.

#### Disabled American Veteran (DAV) tags

DAV tags will have a separate drawing for the reduced fee DAV tags. Hunters eligible for DAV may also apply for nonresident tags, but will pay full nonresident tag prices.



#### Junior mentored tags

Nonresident junior mentored tags will continue to be available, but junior mentored hunters only need to apply for elk tags in capped zones. Uncapped elk tags and deer tags will be available over-the-counter for junior mentored hunters after the nonresident draws are completed.

#### Lifetime license holders

Former Idaho residents who are lifetime license holders can buy tags outside of the nonresident quotas, so they will not have to apply for general season nonresident tags. Tags for lifetime license holders can be purchased in the summer when resident tags become available.

Hunters interested in applying for nonresident deer and elk tags in December should check back regularly for more information on the Nonresident Deer/Elk Tag webpage at idfg.idaho.gov/licenses/ tag/quotas/nonresident

## **Epizootic Hemorrhagic Disease and Bluetongue** Virus Detected in White-Tailed Deer in North Idaho

Fish and Game encourages the public to report sick or dead deer

In recent weeks, laboratory tests confirmed epizootic hemorrhagic disease and bluetongue virus in white-tailed deer in North Idaho. Deer from the Clearwater Region tested positive for EHD, while deer from the Panhandle Region tested positive for both diseases.

Although the two diseases are different, they are closely related. Both are a type of hemorrhagic disease spread by small biting flies, known as midges, which reproduce in and around warm, stagnant water. This summer's conditions likely created situations where midge populations "boomed" around limited water sources, leading to increased risk when deer gather at them.

Hemorrhagic disease outbreaks occur periodically in the Clearwater and Panhandle regions, often during hot, dry summers like 2025. In northern states and other regions where hemorrhagic disease is less common, deer have little to no immunity to the virus.

When outbreaks occur, they can be explosive and severe, causing high mortality in localized areas. The outbreaks tend to cycle, occurring every 3-5 years as herd immunity fluctuates, allowing deer populations to recover from hemorrhagic diseases quickly.

It is difficult to estimate how many deer are being affected in Idaho, but the number of reports received is currently less than 200 in the Panhandle and less than 600 in the Clearwater.

Outbreaks can generally be expected to continue until cool, wetter weather arrives or after a hard frost occurs and kills the midges that spread the disease. Fish and Game staff will continue to monitor the situation.

Idaho is not alone in experiencing hemorrhagic disease outbreaks. Reports of diseased deer are coming in across the country, likely due to the drought-like conditions of summer.



#### **FAQs**

Q: What's the difference between hemorrhagic disease and CWD?

A: Both diseases are distinctly different from and unrelated to chronic wasting disease. Chronic wasting disease is a fatal and contagious disease that affects the nervous systems of deer, elk, moose and reindeer. Its effect on populations is long-term and chronic. Conversely, hemorrhagic disease outbreaks can be explosive and severe, but they are often localized and short-lived.

Q: What are clinical signs of EHD and BTV in deer?

A: Signs may include:

Labored or difficulty breathing

Swelling of the head, neck, or tongue

Fluid in the lungs and internal hemorrhages

Abnormal hoof growth or hoof sloughing (in chronic cases)

Weakness, loss of appetite, bloody diarrhea, and excessive salivation

Fever— which is why deer are often found lying in or near water to cool down

Q: Can EHD and BTV be spread to humans or pets?

A: Humans and domestic pets such as dogs and cats cannot be infected with EHD or BTV. Whitetailed deer are particularly susceptible, but it can affect mule deer and elk. However, elk are less likely to develop severe forms of these diseases. Cattle and sheep can be exposed to both viruses, but they rarely exhibit clinical signs to EHD but are more susceptible to BTV.

Q: Is the meat of an EHD- or BTV-infected deer safe

A: Fish and Game veterinary staff do not recommend eating meat from deer found dead from EHD or BTV due to the possibility of secondary bacterial infections. Deer that recover from and survive an EHD or BTV infection are safe to eat.

#### How you can help

Please report sick or dead deer online via the Wildlife Health Reporting page. Public reports are vital in tracking the impact of hemorrhagic diseases on deer populations.







## **FWP Requests That Hunters And Other** Recreationists Be On The Lookout For Greater **Short-Horned Lizards**

– Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks –



GLASGOW - As you are hunting, hiking and exploring Montana this fall, be sure to take a break from scanning the horizon and look down at the ground once in a while. Not only will this help you avoid stepping on a cactus or a rattlesnake, but you might also see one of eastern Montana's rarely seen critters...the greater short-horned lizard, commonly known as a "horny toad." If you do, Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks would like to know about it.

These lizards are considered a 'Species of Greatest Inventory Need' in Montana due to insufficient data on their population and distribution.

According to Nicole Hussey, FWP wildlife biologist in Region 6, "We have been conducting surveys in eastern Montana to try to determine status and distribution as well as fill in data gaps; however, their elusive nature and cryptic coloration make them extremely difficult to locate."

"This is where we can use outdoor recreationists' help because oftentimes people just accidentally come across one," said Nicole Hussey, FWP wildlife biologist in Region 6.

Hussey and other biologists are seeking the help of folks out trekking around the countryside to provide incidental observations in addition to our structured survey efforts.

"If you happen to observe one anywhere in the state," says Hussey, "please record the location, get GPS coordinates if possible, and note the date,

number observed, and take a photo with something in the picture for scale if you can."

A few things about the greater short-horned lizard:

Adult greater short-horned lizards are diurnal, meaning they are most active during the warmer daylight hours.

Coloration blends in with the soil and can vary by

The broad, flattened body separates this lizard from the other three lizard species regularly documented in Montana, and the range overlaps only with the common sagebrush lizard, which is much more slender.

The head has a "heart-shaped" appearance when viewed from above.

They are usually easiest to spot when they move and catch your eye.

#### **Habitat:**

Greater short-horned lizards are found in the eastern half of Montana, but in scattered locations throughout their range.

They are often found on south or east-facing slopes of coulees and ridge tops, and some open flats.

They prefer habitats with sagebrush, creeping juniper or rabbitbrush with sparse bunch grass, patches of bare ground, and shale-like soil. They are even found in some ponderosa pine stands.

Although they seem like they would make a good pet, after you get a quick picture and GPS location, please leave these fascinating critters where you find them. Thank you for your help!



## **Interesting Facts You May Not Know About Idaho's** Deer and Elk

— Idaho Fish & Game –



You may know how to spot them, identify them, track them, shoot them and cook them, but did you know these things about Idaho's deer and elk?

#### Mule deer

Mule deer were uncommon in Idaho prior to white settlement. Early journals and observations from settlers and other historical documents rarely mention mule deer, but they frequently mention bison and bighorn sheep. Bighorns were also commonly depicted in Native American rock art throughout Idaho, but seldom mule deer.

Regulated deer hunting in Idaho predates statehood. The first hunting season for deer in what is now Idaho (then part of the Idaho Territory that included Idaho, Montana and part of Wyoming) was implemented in 1863, which closed deer hunting between Feb. 1 and June 30. The State of Idaho's first regulated deer season was in 1893, and a hunting license was first required in 1903.

Most mule deer in Idaho seasonally migrate twice yearly between summer and winter range (and back again). The longest documented mule deer migration is over 240 miles from winter range in the Red Desert of Wyoming to summer range near Island Park. Researchers believe mule deer learn migration routes from their mothers and continue that same route for the rest of their lives. (Source: Mule Deer Foundation)

Despite being associated with Idaho's deserts and mountainous country, mule deer are good swimmers and won't hesitate to swim across large rivers, large lakes and reservoirs.

Mule deer have up to 11 subspecies, which includes their close cousins, blacktail deer. Today, mule deer and subspecies inhabit every state west of the Mississippi River (except Hawaii) and as far south as Baja, Mexico. (Source: Mule Deer Foundation)



Unlike deer, which drop their antlers during winter, elk antlers typically remain until the growth of the new antlers pushes off the old ones. Full grown elk antlers can weigh up to 40 pounds per set, and can take up to 160 days to fully grow. A bull's antlers increase in size annually until at least its sixth set, then may increase or decrease in size according to several factors, including health and nutrition. (Source: Montana State University)

Idaho hunters have harvested more than 20,000 elk annually in nine of the last 10 years, which is a feat duplicated only one other time in Idaho's history from the mid-1980s to mid-1990s.

Elk have two canine teeth commonly referred to as "ivories." Biologists believe ivories are the remnants of saber-like tusks that ancestral elk used in combat. (Source: Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation)

Elk are the most vocal of Idaho's big game herbivores. They communicate through a variety of vocalizations. The most commonly heard are bulls bugling in the fall, but cows frequently converse among the herd through mews, chirps and barks. A cow elk can recognize her calf by the unique tone of

In 1909, elk populations in Idaho were so alarmingly low that a moratorium on elk hunting was declared in parts of the state. Elk herds from Yellowstone National Park were translocated to restore Idaho's population, which started in 1915 by railcar, then continued to various parts of the state until



#### White-Tailed Deer


Whitetails are not only the OG deer species of North America, they are also the oldest living deer species on earth. Their direct ancestors reached North America by crossing the Bering Land Bridge into Alaska, and fossils very difficult to distinguish from modern whitetails have been found in Florida that date back 5 million years. (Source: National Deer Association)

The size, shape and location of a whitetail's eyes give it vision 310 degrees around themselves, and their night vision is as good as their day vision. So if you think whitetails have eyes in the back of their heads and keep vampire hours, you may be right.

Idaho's whitetails are widely perceived as homebodies who live in a fairly small area year round. However, data from Fish and Game's GPS collar research has shown some does traveled 20-25 miles to have their fawns, then returned months later with their fawns in tow.

Whitetail fawns are small at birth, typically weighing 6-8 lbs, and some subspecies, like Florida's Keys deer, may weigh about 2 lbs at birth. But whitetail fawns can double their weight in their first week, and commonly weigh 10 times their birth weight by their first winter. (Source: National Deer Association)

Idaho's historic deer harvest has long been dominated by mule deer. In 1975, Fish and Game started tracking the harvest by species, and in 1994, whitetails topped mule deer for the first time ever. Since then, whitetail harvest has exceeded mule deer five more times, most recently in 2023. Mule deer continue to be the larger portion of the harvest in most years, but the percentage of whitetails has crept up due to healthy populations and increased interest in hunting them.

## **Caring for Indoor Plants**

Transforming your indoor space into a lush. green sanctuary starts with bringing in a bit of the outdoors by introducing houseplants to your living area. Once inside, though, it's important to properly care for them to keep your indoor garden thriving.

Understand Light Requirements. Light is a crucial element for indoor plant health. Different plants have varying light needs, and understanding these requirements is key to their survival. Low-light plants, such as snake plants and castiron plants, can thrive in areas with minimal natural light. Medium-light plants, like spider plants and ferns, prefer indirect sunlight and can be placed near windows with sheer curtains. Highlight plants, including succulents and cacti, need direct sunlight for optimal growth.

Water Indoor Plants Correctly. It's important to understand the specific watering needs of each plant. Typically, it's best to let the top inch of soil dry out between waterings. Remember, it's better to underwater than overwater, as most plants can recover more easily from slight dehydration than root rot. Consider using a moisture meter to accurately assess when your plants need water.

Choose the Right Pot and Soil. When choosing a pot, ensure it's slightly larger than the plant's current root system to allow for growth and features drainage holes to allow excess water to escape. Most indoor plants thrive in a well-draining potting mix that retains some moisture but doesn't become waterlogged. Specialty mixes are also available for specific plant types and can provide the ideal growing environment.

Deal with Common Problems. Even with the best care, plants can encounter problems. Common issues include pests like spider mites and aphids, which can be managed with natural insecticidal soap or neem oil. Yellowing leaves can indicate overwatering while brown leaf tips often signal underwatering or low humidity.

## Nearly 30,000 Acres **Removed from Large Tracts Program**

Sale between Stimson Lumber and the Coeur d'Alene Tribe

Land sales in Game Management Unit 5 remove nearly 30,000 acres from the program.

Since December 2024, close to 30,000 acres of private land enrolled in the Large Tracts Program has been sold by Stimson Lumber to the Coeur d'Alene Tribe. The land is located on the Coeur d'Alene Reservation and has always been an important part of the Tribe's homeland.

The sale of the lands has resulted in their removal from the Large Tracts Program, making them no longer accessible by the general public under the program. Entering any private land while access is closed or restricted is trespassing.

For more information about hunting on lands owned by the Coeur d'Alene Tribe, hunters are encouraged to contact the Tribe directly.

All of the 30,000 acres sold are located in the Panhandle Region's Game Management Unit 5, south of Coeur d'Alene. Please review the map below or visit the Idaho Hunt Planner to view all changes to parcel accessibility in the Large Tracts Program.

These sales are a reminder that all Large Tracts parcels are private lands and can change ownership at any time. Hunters, anglers and recreationists should never assume last season's access is still valid this season. Always confirm land status before your trip by checking the Idaho Hunt

- All Large Tracts lands are privately owned and only accessible to the public due to partnerships between Fish and Game and private landowners.
